

PREFACE



This clan documents a clan from Morley in Wilmslow and connects it to a family in Ashley within Bowdon parish that is descended from Josiah (died 1764) and Martha nee Bradbury. Josiah's origins are uncertain but he is possibly the Josiah son of John who was baptised in Northenden in 1715.

The Josiah name, which occurs throughout the clan, suggested that this clan is linked to the Hale Barns clan. However DNA shows it is unrelated, it being linked to the Nottinghamshire clan with a common ancestor who probably lived before 1600 AD. A number of links in the first couple of generations are 'most likely' rather than proven. Future DNA results might help here, though single mismatches might result from a non paternal event rather than signifying an error in the tree.

First Generation

1. John Warburton.

The only known reference to John is as the father of a Josiah born in 1715 in Northenden. He could have been a nephew of Josiah of Hale Barns, possibly a son of his youngest brother Enoch of Mobberley whose will referred to children, though there are no baptisms for them.

2. Josiah Warburton (*John*¹). Josiah was born in Northenden, Cheshire, in 1715. He was christened in Northenden, St Wilfred, Cheshire, on 15 Nov 1716. Josiah died in Ashley, Cheshire, in 1764. He was buried in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 26 Sep 1764.

Josiah's origin is uncertain. The only recorded baptism is the one at Northenden but many nonconformist baptisms were unrecorded at this time. There are many references in the parish and other records to people for whom no baptism is recorded.

The use of the name Josiah is possibly in honour of Josiah Warburton of Hale Barns who was a leading Presbyterian, and involved in the founding of Hale Chapel. He was living in Northenden when he died in 1730 and could have been there by 1715 as he married a lady from Northenden in 1711. This might imply a family connection.

He is called Isaiah of Ashley on his burial record.

Many lines of Josiah's descendants have yet to be explored fully.

On 27 Dec 1737 when Josiah was 22, he married **Martha Bradbury** in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire. Both were 'of this parish'. Martha died in Ashley, Cheshire, in 1764. She was buried in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 26 May 1764.

Martha is described as the wife of Josiah of Ashley on her burial record.

Second Generation

They had the following children:

- i. **John Warburton**. John was born in Mobberley, Cheshire, in 1739. He was christened in Mobberley, St Wilfred, Cheshire, on 20 May 1739.
- 3 ii. **Thomas Warburton** (~1741-1794)
- 4 iii. **Josiah Warburton** (~1744-1818)
- iv. **Martha Warburton**. Martha was born in Ashley, Cheshire, abt 1745. Martha died in 1745. She was buried in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 26 May 1745.

Martha's burial is the clue that Josiah and Martha had children between John in 1739, and Jacob in 1747 whose baptisms at Hale or Ringway Chapels was not recorded.
- 5 v. **Jacob Warburton** (1747-)
- vi. **Samuel Warburton**. Samuel was born in Ashley, Cheshire, abt 1750. He was christened in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 25 Feb 1750. Samuel died bef 1756.

It is presumed Samuel died young as a second Samuel was baptised in 1756, though no burial record has been found.

3. Thomas Warburton (*Josiah², John¹*). Thomas was born in Ashley, Cheshire, abt 1741. Thomas died in Hale, Cheshire, in 1794. He was buried in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 30 Dec 1794.

Thomas is considered to be the probable son of Josiah and Martha of Ashley because:

1. His age at death puts his birth in the period between 1739 and 1747 when no records of baptisms of children of Josiah and Martha exist but the burial of a daughter suggests at least one child was born. This is a time when baptisms were being conducted at Hale Chapel but records no longer exist. Josiah and Martha's home at Ashley was close to Hale Chapel.

2. There is no matching baptism at Bowdon, though there is one at Flixton, father John.

3. Thomas, like Josiah was from Ashley on the baptisms of his first two children.

4. The names George, Samuel, John and Martha were also used by Josiah and Martha.

On 27 Dec 1770 when Thomas was 29, he married **Sarah Shaw** in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire. Sarah was born abt 1741. Sarah died in 1815. She was buried in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 24 Aug 1815.

Sarah was 74 when she died according to the parish record of her burial.

They had the following children:

- i. **Ann Warburton**. Ann was born in Ashley, Cheshire, in 1771. She was christened in Hale Chapel, Cheshire, on 12 May 1776.
- ii. **George Warburton**. George was born in Ashley, Cheshire, on 13 Feb 1774. He was christened in Hale Chapel, Cheshire, on 13 Mar 1774.
- iii. **Hannah Warburton**. Hannah was born in Hale, Cheshire, in 1776. She was christened in Hale Chapel, Cheshire, on 2 Jun 1776.
- iv. **Samuel Warburton**. Samuel was born in Hale, Cheshire, in 1779. He was christened in Hale Chapel, Cheshire, on 13 Jun 1779.
- v. **Joseph Warburton**. Joseph was born in Hale, Cheshire, in 1781. He was christened in Hale Chapel, Cheshire, on 25 Feb 1781.
- vi. **Betty Warburton**. Betty was born in Hale, Cheshire, in 1783. She was christened in Hale Chapel, Cheshire, on 23 Mar 1783.
- vii. **John Warburton**. John was born in Hale, Cheshire, in 1785. He was christened in Hale Chapel, Cheshire, on 13 Mar 1785. John died in Hale, Cheshire, in 1786. He was buried in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 19 Apr 1786.

John was aged 1 on his burial record.

- viii. **Martha Warburton**. Martha was born in Hale, Cheshire, on 2 Dec 1786. She was christened in Hale Chapel, Cheshire, on 7 Jan 1787.

4. Josiah Warburton (*Josiah², John¹*). Josiah was born in Ashley, Cheshire, abt 1744. Josiah died in Altrincham, Cheshire, in 1818. He was buried in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 17 Mar 1818.

Josiah is considered to be the probable son of Josiah and Martha of Ashley because:

1. His age at death (73 on his burial record) puts his birth in the period between 1739 and 1747 when no records of baptisms of children of Josiah and Martha exist but the burial of a daughter suggests at least one child was born. This a time when baptisms were being conducted at Hale Chapel but records no longer exist. Josiah and Martha's home at Ashley was close to Hale Chapel.

2. There is no matching baptism at Bowdon, and Josiah's born elsewhere at the time are already known.

3. Although his children were all baptised from Altrincham, he was from Hale at the time of his marriage.

4. The use of the name Josiah.

On 2 Jul 1769 when Josiah was 25, he married **Martha Henshaw** in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire. Josiah was a husbandman from Hale.

They had the following children:

 - ii. **John Warburton**. John was born in Altrincham, Cheshire, in 1771. He was christened in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 17 Nov 1771.

 - vii. **Jane Warburton**. Jane was born in Altrincham, Cheshire, in 1781. She was christened in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 13 May 1781.

5. Jacob Warburton (*Josiah², John¹*). Jacob was born in Ashley, Cheshire, in 1747. He was christened in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 29 Mar 1747.

Jacob is considered to be the one who married Jane Faulkner because a Jacob and Jane had a son baptised at Rostherne in 1772 and there are no records of another Jacob in the area, the nearest being in Bury, Lancashire.

Jacob and his brother Samuel were married at Manchester Cathedral and had children baptised there. Brother George married in Bowdon but had his later children baptised at Manchester Cathedral. This suggests they may have been involved in a family enterprise in Manchester.

Third Generation

No death or burial record has been found for Jacob.

On 21 Sep 1771 when Jacob was 24, he married **Jane Faulkner** in Manchester Cathedral, Lancashire.

They had the following children:

- i. **John Warburton**. John was born in 1772. He was christened in Rostherne, St Mary, Cheshire, on 29 Mar 1772.
- ii. **Martha Warburton**. Martha was born in 1775. She was christened in Manchester Cathedral, Lancashire, on 5 Mar 1775. Martha died abt 1775.

It is presumed Martha died an infant as a second Martha was baptised in 1776. However no burial record has been found.

- iii. **Martha Warburton**. Martha was born in 1776. She was christened in Manchester Cathedral, Lancashire, on 16 Jun 1776.
- iv. **Jacob Warburton**. Jacob was born in 1778. He was christened in Manchester Cathedral, Lancashire, on 26 Apr 1778.
- v. **Sarah Warburton**. Sarah was born in 1780. She was christened in Manchester Cathedral, Lancashire, on 5 Mar 1780.
- vi. **Henry Warburton**. Henry was born in 1782. He was christened in Manchester Cathedral, Lancashire, on 27 Jan 1782.

6. George Warburton (*Josiah², John¹*). George was born in Ashley, Cheshire, in 1751. He was christened in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 27 Oct 1751.

The George who married Ellen Blease is considered to be the probable son of Josiah and Martha of Ashley because:

1. His first two children were baptised from Ashley and Hale. They subsequently had children baptised at Manchester Cathedral.

2. One of his later children was called Josiah. He also repeated the names Martha, John, William, and Joseph used by Josiah and Martha.

3. When his youngest child Isaac died and was buried aged 4 months he returned to Bowdon for the burial where he was recorded as the son of George and Ellen of Manchester .

No death record has been identified for George.

On 5 Sep 1773 when George was 22, he married **Ellen Blease** in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire.

They had the following children:

- i. **Mary Warburton**. Mary was born in Ashley, Cheshire, in 1773. She was christened in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 7 Dec 1773.
- ii. **George Warburton**. George was born in Hale, Cheshire, in 1776. He was christened in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 30 Jun 1776.
- iii. **John Warburton**. John was born in 1780. He was christened in Manchester Cathedral, Lancashire, on 6 Feb 1780.
- 13 iv. **William Warburton** (1782-1837)
- v. **Josiah Warburton**. Josiah was born in 1784. He was christened in Manchester Cathedral, Lancashire, on 4 Jul 1784.
- vi. **Martha Warburton**. Martha was born in 1786. She was christened in Manchester Cathedral, Lancashire, on 3 Dec 1786.
- vii. **Joseph Warburton**. Joseph was born in 1789. He was christened in Manchester Cathedral, Lancashire, on 25 Jan 1789.
- viii. **James Warburton**. James was born in 1791. He was christened in Manchester Cathedral, Lancashire, on 3 Apr 1791.
- ix. **Isaac Warburton**. Isaac was born in 1793. He was christened in Manchester Cathedral, Lancashire, on 15 Sep 1793. Isaac died in Manchester, Lancashire, in 1794. He was buried in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 11 Apr 1794.

Isaac was buried aged 4 months, the son of George and Ellen of Manchester.

- 14 x. **Isaac Warburton** (1796-1866)

7. William Warburton (*Josiah*², *John*¹). William was born in Ashley, Cheshire, abt 1754. He was christened in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 13 Jan 1754. William died in Morley, Cheshire, in 1806. He was buried in Wilmslow, St Bartholemew, Cheshire, on 30 Oct 1806.

The William who married Catherine Hooley is considered to be the son of Josiah and Martha because:

- 1. His abode at Morley is quite close to his parents' abode at Ashley and the link is strengthened because he returned to Ringway Chapel, near Hale for the baptisms of three of his children.
- 2. The use of the name Josiah several times amongst his desendants, including his own son.
- 3. There is no case to support other Williams of an appropriate age, including one from Wilmslow who can be linked to a family in Dean Row.

The identification of William's death is based on the abode of Morley but there is no corroborating evidence.

On 27 Feb 1775 when William was 21, he married **Catherine Hooley** in Wilmslow, St Bartholemew, Cheshire. The marriage was also listed at Cheadle. Catherine was born abt 1749. Catherine died in Morley, Cheshire, in 1834. She was buried in Wilmslow, St Bartholemew,

Cheshire, on 12 Jan 1834.

Catherine was aged 85 of Morley on her burial record.

They had the following children:

- i. **Thomas Warburton**. Thomas was born in Morley, Cheshire, in 1775. He was christened in Ringway Chapel, Cheshire, on 16 Jul 1775.
- ii. **George Warburton**. George was born in Morley, Cheshire, in 1777. He was christened in Wilmslow, St Bartholemew, Cheshire, on 15 Mar 1777.

Curiously the parish record also has George's baptism on April 20th implying he was baptised twice.

- iii. **Jane Warburton**. Jane was born in Morley, Cheshire, in 1780. She was christened in Wilmslow, St Bartholemew, Cheshire, on 4 Jun 1780.
- 15 iv. **William Warburton** (~1782-1875)
- v. **Martha Warburton**. Martha was born in Morley, Cheshire, in 1783. She was christened in Ringway Chapel, Cheshire, on 13 Apr 1783.
- vi. **Catherine Warburton**. Catherine was born in Morley, Cheshire, abt 1785. She was christened in Wilmslow, St Bartholemew, Cheshire, on 3 Feb 1785.

Catherine was baptised on the same day as her brother William, though they are not referred to as twins.

- vii. **Hannah Warburton**. Hannah was born in Morley, Cheshire, in 1788. She was christened in Ringway Chapel, Cheshire, on 6 Jul 1788. Hannah died in 1852.

On 18 Jan 1807 when Hannah was 19, she married **Matthew Bradley** in Wilmslow, St Bartholemew, Cheshire.

Matthew's father was Josiah Bradley.

- viii. **Ellen Warburton**. Ellen was born in Morley, Cheshire, in 1790. She was christened in Wilmslow, St Bartholemew, Cheshire, on 17 May 1790. Ellen died in Morley, Cheshire, in 1791. She was buried in Wilmslow, St Bartholemew, Cheshire, on 1 May 1791.

Ellen was baptised with brother Josiah but they are not said to be twins.

- ix. **Josiah Warburton**. Josiah was born in Morley, Cheshire, abt 1790. He was christened in Wilmslow, St Bartholemew, Cheshire, on 24 Jan 1790. Josiah died in Morley, Cheshire, in 1791. He was buried in Wilmslow, St Bartholemew, Cheshire, on 24 Jan 1791.

Josiah was baptised the same day as his sister Ellen but they are not said to be twins. Josiah may have been born earlier than 1790 and only baptised when Ellen came along.

Third Generation

8. Joseph Warburton (*Josiah², John¹*). Joseph was born in Ashley, Cheshire, in 1756. He was christened in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 21 Nov 1756. Joseph died in Stockport, Cheshire, in 1818. He was buried in Warburton, St Werbergh, Cheshire, on 15 Jan 1818.

Joseph was baptised with his brother Samuel but the parish record does not state they were twins.

The Joseph who married Mary Barlow is considered to be the likely son of Josiah and Martha of Ashley because:

1. His age on his marriage and burial fit (though on the marriage he is only 21 and up).
2. No other Joseph was baptised in the area at that time.

At some time he moved to Stockport but returned to Warburton to be buried. Two further children of a Joseph and Mary were baptised in Stockport in the 1790s which might be theirs, depending on when they moved. They were Thomas in 1792 and Betty in 1795.

On 27 Nov 1777 when Joseph was 21, he married **Mary Barlow** in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire. Joseph was a chairmaker living in Warburton on his marriage license.

They had the following children:

- i. **John Warburton**. John was born in Warburton, Cheshire, in 1778. He was christened in Warburton, St Werburgh, Cheshire, on 20 Sep 1778.
- ii. **Sarah Warburton**. Sarah was born in Warburton, Cheshire, in 1780. She was christened in Warburton, St Werburgh, Cheshire, on 17 Sep 1780.
- iii. **Mary Warburton**. Mary was born in Warburton, Cheshire, in 1783. She was christened in Warburton, St Werburgh, Cheshire, on 23 Feb 1783.
- iv. **Martha Warburton**. Martha was born in Warburton, Cheshire, in 1785. She was christened in Warburton, St Werburgh, Cheshire, on 7 Aug 1788. Martha died in Warburton, Cheshire, in 1791. She was buried in Warburton, St Werburgh, Cheshire, on 22 Dec 1791.
- v. **William Warburton**. William was born in Warburton, Cheshire, in 1788. He was christened in Warburton, St Werburgh, Cheshire, on 3 Feb 1788.
- vi. **Betty Warburton**. Betty was born in Warburton, Cheshire, in 1790. She was christened in Warburton, Cheshire, on 4 Apr 1790. Betty died in Warburton, Cheshire, in 1791. She was buried in Warburton, St Werburgh, Cheshire, on 6 Jun 1791.

9. Samuel Warburton (*Josiah², John¹*). Samuel was born in Ashley, Cheshire, in 1756. He was christened in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 21 Nov 1756.

Samuel was baptised with his brother Joseph but the parish record does not state they were twins.

The Samuel who married Hannah Dickenson is considered to be the likely son of Josiah and

Martha of Ashley because:

1. He named one of his sons Josiah, and also used family names George, William, and John.
2. He followed the example of brothers Jacob and George in marrying and having children baptised at Manchester Cathedral.

Samuel's burial record has not been found.

On 3 Aug 1778 when Samuel was 22, he married **Hannah Dickenson** in Manchester Cathedral, Lancashire. Hannah was born in Salford, Sacred Trinity, Lancashire, on 10 Apr 1757.

Hannah was the daughter of James and Mary Dickenson.

They had the following children:

- i. **Martha Warburton**. Martha was born in 1778. She was christened in Manchester Cathedral, Lancashire, on 25 Dec 1778.
- ii. **James Warburton**. James was born in 1780. He was christened in Manchester Cathedral, Lancashire, on 19 Nov 1780.
- iii. **Samuel Warburton**. Samuel was born in 1782. He was christened in Manchester Cathedral, Lancashire, on 6 Oct 1782.
- 16 iv. **John Warburton** (1784-)
- v. **Mary Warburton**. Mary was born in 1789. She was christened in Manchester Cathedral, Lancashire, on 21 Jun 1789.
- vi. **William Warburton**. William was born in 1791. He was christened in Manchester Cathedral, Lancashire, on 17 Apr 1791.
- vii. **Josiah Warburton**. Josiah was born in 1793. He was christened in Manchester Cathedral, Lancashire, on 1 Apr 1793.

No further evidence of Josiah can be found, though the death of a Josiah aged 75 was registered in 2q 1870 Altrincham 8a 131. Cheshire BMD has the subdistrict as Knutsford. No unaccounted Josiah of a similar age has been found in any census.

- ix. **George Warburton**. George was born in 1804. He was christened in Manchester Cathedral, Lancashire, on 26 Feb 1804.

Fourth Generation

10. John Warburton (*Thomas³, Josiah², John¹*). John was born in Hale, Cheshire, on 9 Mar 1788. He was christened in Hale Chapel, Cheshire, on 23 Mar 1788.

The identification of the father of the Josiah born in 1818 with the son of Thomas and Sarah Shaw is discussed in detail in an article in Issue 7 of The Button Files. It is the most likely of four possibilities, once all other known candidates have been eliminated, but is not certain. The association with Hale, and the naming of his son Josiah are considerations.

Mary Hulbert is one of three Mary's who are known to have married a John in the relevant timeframe. The other marriages were at Manchester Cathedral, but are possible given that two of John's likely uncles were married there. That in 1804 to Mary Henshall seems a bit early, but that to Mary Cooke on 11th October 1807, which was followed by two baptisms at Manchester, is possible.

There were three baptisms in Bowdon parish to parents called John and Mary, but two not only predate the marriage to Mary Hulbert, but are too close together to be the same family. That of Eliza is also from a family living in Hale but was at Hale Chapel whereas Josiah was baptised at the parish church in Bowdon.

No burial or death registration has been found for John to enable a check of his age at death.

On 31 Aug 1817 when John was 29, he married **Mary Hulbert** in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire.

They had one child:

- 18** i. **Josiah Warburton** (1818-1883)

11. Thomas Warburton (*Josiah³, Josiah², John¹*). Thomas was born in Altrincham, Cheshire, in 1770. He was christened in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 29 Apr 1770. Thomas died in Altrincham, Cheshire, in 1848. He was buried in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 5 Mar 1848.

Thomas's age on his burial record is 78, although his death was registered in 1q 1848 Altrincham 19 5, aged 77. This fits the baptism date of the son of Josiah and Martha nee Henshaw, assuming they typical one month gap between birth and baptism.

On 22 Jan 1805 when Thomas was 35, he married **Sarah Davenport** in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire. Both were of Bowdon parish, Thomas was a husbandman. Sarah was born abt 1778. Sarah died in Altrincham, Cheshire, in 1854. She was buried in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 7 Jul 1854.

Sarah was a widow aged 72 and living with son John in the 1851 census, and the widow of Thomas of Altrincham, aged 76 on her burial record in 1854.

Fourth Generation

They had the following children:

- 19 i. **Samuel Warburton** (1806-1865)
- 20 ii. **John Warburton** (1810-1885)
- iii. **William Warburton**. William was born in Altrincham, Cheshire, on 11 Nov 1812. He was christened in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 6 Dec 1812.
- iv. **James Warburton**. James was born in Altrincham, Cheshire, in 1815. He was christened in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 6 Aug 1815.

James's father is a farmer on his baptism record.

- v. **Elizabeth Warburton**. Elizabeth was born in Altrincham, Cheshire, in 1817. She was christened in Altrincham, St George, Cheshire, on 28 Dec 1817.

12. William Warburton (*Josiah*³, *Josiah*², *John*¹). William was born in Altrincham, Cheshire, in 1779. He was christened in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 23 May 1779. William died in Bolton, Lancashire, in 1817. He was buried in Bolton, St Peter, Lancashire, on 13 May 1817.

William of Haulgh was buried aged 37, which is consistent with the baptism of William, son of Josiah and Martha.

On 20 Oct 1802 when William was 23, he married **Sarah Cartwright** in Manchester Cathedral, Lancashire. There are two William and Sarah marriages at Manchester Cathedral in 1802. William's occupation is given as dyer on the marriage to Sarah Cartwright, which is more consistent with his later occupation of weaver, than blacksmith, the other William's occupation. No other candidate marriage has been found. ■ Census for Bolton, Lancashire, in 1841. Sarah Clough (58) is a farm labourer living in Bury Street, Little Bolton with Job (25) a cotton spinner, Richard (38) a cotton carder, Josiah (28) a cotton carder, and William (2). It is the presence of Sarah's three sons, including Richard, that ties together the Altrincham and Bolton halves of the family. Sarah died in Little Bolton, Lancashire, in 1849. She was buried in Bolton, St Peter, Lancashire, on 1 Oct 1849.

Sarah was aged 66 on her burial record, and 58 in the 1841 census giving a date of birth of circa 1803. Several Sarah Cartwrights were baptised at that time, mostly in Shropshire and Staffordshire.

They had the following children:

- i. **Richard Warburton**. Richard was born in Altrincham, Cheshire, on 9 Jul 1803. He was christened in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 7 Aug 1803. Richard died in Bolton, Lancashire, in 1849. He was buried in Bolton, St Peter, Lancashire, on 1 Oct 1849.

Richard's parents were from Altrincham on his baptism record. He is not in the 1851 census so is probably the Richard whose death was registered in 4q 1849 Bolton 21 79, aged 46. He was 47, and from Little Bolton on his burial record, though the age on his registration is the correct one.

- ii. **John Warburton**. John was born in Altrincham, Cheshire, on 13 May 1805. He was christened in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 9 Jun 1805. John died in Bolton, Lancashire, in 1823. He was buried in Bolton, St Peter, Lancashire, on 31 Aug 1823.

John has not been found in censuses so he is probably the John from Haulgh who was buried 1n 1823, aged 19. He would in fact be 18, but his brother Richard's age was also increased by one on his burial at the same church.

- iii. **Betty Warburton**. Betty was born in Altrincham, Cheshire, on 28 May 1807. She was christened in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 5 Jul 1807.
- iv. **Elizabeth Warburton**. Elizabeth was born in Bolton, Lancashire, in 1810. She was christened in Bolton, St Peter, Lancashire, on 1 Jul 1810.

Elizabeth's parents were from Haulgh on her baptism record. She had a son Thomas by her first marriage whose birth was registered in 3q 1844 Bolton 21 86, mother's maiden name Warburton. He was living with her and her second husband in the 1861 census.

No Warburton-Thomason marriages have been found in the period when Elizabeth first married Thomas Thomason, and later married William Warburton.

Elizabeth first married **Thomas Thomason**.

Thomas's first name is deduced from the possible baptism of his son Thomas, whose birth was registered in 1844. Thomas son of Thomas and Betty was baptised at Bolton, St Peter on March 2nd 1845, son of Thomas and Betty.

Elizabeth second married **William Warburton**. William was born in Chorley, Lancashire, abt 1810.

William was previously married to Betty Knowles and had three sons, John, Robert, and William. Their marriage has not been found, but Betty's surname is known from the registration of their son William.

13. William Warburton (*George*³, *Josiah*², *John*¹). William was born in Manchester, Lancashire, in 1782. He was christened in Manchester Cathedral, Lancashire, on 21 Jul 1782. William died in Pendleton, Lancashire, in 1837. He was buried in Didsbury, St James, Lancashire, on 2 Apr 1837.

William's wife is a widow in the 1851 census. His son Joseph was baptised in June 1837.

William of Pendleton was buried at Didsbury St James on April 2nd 1837, aged 54. This matches the baptism of the son of George and Ellen on 21st July 1782 at Manchester Cathedral.

Dated 22 March 1837

Will of Mr William Warburton

I William Warburton of Charlestown within Pendleton near Manchester in the County of Lancashire late Blacksmith but now Coal Merchant do hereby revoke all Wills Codicils and other testamentary dispositions by me at any time heretofore made and do declare this to be me last Will and Testament. I give and bequeath all the household furniture beds and bedding linen and other effects which shall be in the house where I reside at the time of my decease unto my wife during her widowhood and at her deceased or second marriage the same to sink into my estate and effects.

And I give devise and bequeath all the freehold leasehold and real property messuages lands tenements and hereditaments and all the personal estate of what kind soever of or to which I or any person or persons in trust for me shall be seised or entitled at the time of my decease (except what I otherwise dispose of by this my Will or any Codicil or Codicils thereto) unto my friends James Higginbottom of Withington near Manchester aforesaid Farmer and James Dean of the same place Farmer their heirs executors administrators and assigns Upon trust that they the said James Higginbottom and James Dean and the survivor of them and the executors and administrators of such survivor shall call in and convert into money my said personal estate or such part thereof as shall not consist of money and sell and dispose of my said freehold leasehold and real property either entirely and altogether or in parcels by public auction or private contract to any person or persons willing to become the purchaser or purchasers thereof upon trust that they my said trustees or trustee for the time being do and shall in the first place pay, satisfy and discharge all my just debt, funeral and testamentary expenses and do and shall lay out

and invest the surplus or residue thereof in their or his names or name at interest upon government or seal or leasehold securities in England or Wales Upon trust that they my said trustees and trustee for the time being do and shall pay said interest and annual produce unto my said wife during her widowhood to be by her applied in and towards the maintenance of herself and the maintenance and education of such of my said children and after the death or second marriage of my said wife. Upon trust that they my said trustees or trustee do and shall pay and apply the same interest and education of such of my children as in the judgement of my said trustees or trustee shall have occasion for the same until the youngest of my children shall attain the age of twenty one years, the residue of such interest and annual produce being allowed to accumulate for the benefit of the persons ultimately entitled to the same by virtue of this my Will

and when so soon as the youngest of my said children shall attain the age of twenty one years. Upon trust that they my said trustees or trustee for the time being do and shall stand possessed of the said trust monies and securities and the accumulations of interest and annual produce thereof. Upon trust for and to be divided equally between and amongst such of my children as shall be their living and the issue of such of them as shall be then dead and shall attain the age of twenty one years such issue to take equally amongst them if more than one share to which their his or her parent or parents would have been entitled if living.

The witness whereof I the said William Warburton at the bottom of the final sheet of this my Will have set my hand and to this second and last sheet set in my hand and seal this twenty second day of March One thousand eight hundred and thirty seven.

The second day of September 1837 James Higginbotham one of the Executors in this will named was sworn in common form further made oath of the Personal Estate & Effects of the Testator (within the Diocese of Chester) were under the value of eight hundred pounds.

On 15 Nov 1802 when William was 20, he first married **Sarah Bancroft** in Manchester Cathedral, Lancashire. William was a blacksmith of the parish and town of Manchester. Sarah was a spinster from Manchester. Sarah was born abt 1781. Sarah died in Didsbury, Lancashire, in 1818. She was buried in Didsbury, St James, Lancashire, on 21 Aug 1817.

Sarah of Didsbury was buried aged 37 years.

Sarah was baptised and buried as the daughter of William and Sarah of Didsbury.

- iii. **William Warburton**. William was born in Didsbury, Lancashire, in 1812. He was christened in Didsbury, St James, Lancashire, on 16 Aug 1812. William died in Didsbury, Lancashire, in 1813. He was buried in Didsbury, St James, Lancashire, on 9 May 1813.

William was baptised as the son of William and Sarah of Didsbury. He was buried the son of William, a blacksmith, and Sarah of Didsbury aged 10 months.

- iv. **William Warburton**. William was born in Didsbury, Lancashire, in 1815. He was christened in Didsbury, St James, Lancashire, on 27 Aug 1815.

William was baptised as the son of William, a blacksmith, and Sarah of Didsbury. He has not been identified in censuses.

- v. **James Warburton**. James was born in Didsbury, Lancashire, in 1817. He was christened in Didsbury, St James, Lancashire, on 21 Mar 1817. James died in Didsbury, Lancashire, in 1817. He was buried in Didsbury, St James, Lancashire, on 24 Mar 1817.

James was baptised as the son of William, a blacksmith, and Sarah of Didsbury. He was buried the son of William and Sarah, aged 12 days.

On 27 Jan 1823 when William was 41, he second married **Mary Wood** in Manchester Cathedral, Lancashire. William was a widowed blacksmith from Didsbury. Mary was a spinster from Didsbury. Mary was born abt 1785. Mary died in Didsbury, Lancashire, in 1830. She was buried in Didsbury, Lancashire, on 27 Oct 1830.

Mary of Didsbury was buried aged 45.

On 7 May 1832 when William was 50, he third married **Hannah Oakley Fisher** in Eccles, St Mary, Lancashire. William and Hannah were both 'of this parish'. Hannah Oakley was born in Kingsley, Staffordshire, in 1795. She was christened in Kingsley, Staffordshire, on 8 Nov 1795. ■ Census for Salford, Lancashire, in 1851. Hannah (55) is widowed proprietor of houses living at 2 Richardson Street with Joseph (13) an errand boy. Hannah Oakley died in Salford, Lancashire, in 1864.

Hannah was the daughter of Thomas Oakley (b1765) and Ann Osborne (b1766). They had ten children, some of whom had Osborne as a middle name. Hannah's baptism record does not include the Osborne name. As she is referred to as 'Oakley Fisher' on her marriage record to William, it is assumed that she had been married before.

Hannah's death was registered in 3q 1864 Salford 8d 34, as Hannah Osbourne Warburton, aged 68. Two of her grandchildren were also given Osbourne as a middle name, though the spelling adds a 'u' to her mother's name.

Middle names were unusual when Hannah was born, but it was not unusual for them to be adopted in later life.

Ancestry transcribes it as Isaac, but FindMypast has Job. ■ Census for Manchester, Lancashire, in 1861. Isaac (66) a cotton carder from Manchester is an inmate in the District Sick and Infirm Workhouse, New Bridge Street. Isaac died in Manchester Workhouse, Lancashire, on 18 Dec 1866. He was buried in Newton Heath, All Saints, Lancashire.

Isaac's death was registered in 4q 1866 Manchester 8d 203, aged 72.

On 22 Feb 1818 when Isaac was 22, he married **Mary Partington** in Eccles, St Mary, Lancashire. Isaac (21) and Mary (19) were both 'of this parish'. Isaac's surname was written as Warbutton. Mary was born abt 1798. Mary died in Manchester, Lancashire, in 1849.

Isaac was living with his son in 1851 so Mary's death was probably that registered in 3q 1849 Manchester 20 928, aged 52.

They had the following children:

- i. **Elizabeth Warburton**. Elizabeth was born in Manchester, Lancashire, in 1824. She was christened in Manchester Cathedral, Lancashire, on 18 Apr 1824. Elizabeth died in Manchester, Lancashire, in 1873.

Elizabeth's father was a carder from Manchester on her baptism record. The date clashes with that of her brother James, suggesting she was a late baptism. Her census age would also suggest this. Therefore her death registration is probably that registered in 2q 1873 Manchester 8d 155, aged 53.

On 21 Jul 1844 when Elizabeth was 20, she married **Samuel Stringer** in Eccles, St Mary, Lancashire. Samuel was of full age, a marker up from Pendleton, father William, a fustian cutter. Elizabeth was of full age, from Pendleton, father Isaac, an overlooker. Four boys and 2 girls were registered in Manchester with mother's maiden name Warburton, and Samuel and Elizabeth were witnesses at Elizabeth's sister Sarah's wedding in 1863, but they haven't been found in censuses. Samuel was born in Manchester, Lancashire, abt 1821. Samuel died in Manchester, Lancashire, in 1865.

Samuel's death was probably that registered in 4q 1865 Manchester 8d 199, aged 44, as his wife Elizabeth was a widow with 2 children in the 1871 census.

Samuel is only known from his presence on the 1841 and 1851 censuses. In 1851 he is described as James's brother. No baptism record has been found, he doesn't appear in censuses after 1851, and no death or marriage registration has been identified.

Sarah's father was a carder from Manchester on her baptism record. Her birth was registered in 1q 1840 Manchester 20 540, mother's maiden name Partington. Her death registration is possibly that registered in 3q 1876 Salford 8d 70, aged 36. However she has not been identified in the 1871 census.

On 11 Jan 1863 when Sarah was 24, she married **John Rothwell** in Manchester Cathedral, Lancashire. John (22) was a waterman from 6 Ashton Street, father John, a waterman. Sarah (22) was from 6 Ashton Street, father Isaac, an overlooker. Samuel and Elizabeth Stringer were witnesses. John was born abt 1840.

- x. **Mary Warburton**. Mary was born in Manchester, Lancashire, in 1841. She was christened in Manchester Cathedral, Lancashire, on 3 Oct 1841.

Mary's father was a carder from Manchester on her baptism record. Her birth was registered in 3q 1841 Manchester 20 531, mother's maiden name Partington. No marriage has been found for a Mary with father's name Isaac.

William (67) is a hand loom weaver living with wife Alice (62) who is on parish relief. ■ Census for Pownall Fee, Cheshire, in 1861. William (77) is a widowed hand loom weaver living in Altrincham Road with son Josiah (37) an agricultural labourer, Josiah's wife Margaret (35) a laundress, Arthur (5), and John (2). ■ Census for Pownall Fee, Cheshire, in 1871. William (88) is a widower living in Pownall Cottages with daughter-in-law Mary Ann (45) an agricultural labourer's wife, Arthur (15), John (12), Sarah (6), and Alice (8 months). William died in 1875.

William's death is probably that registered in 1q 1875 Stockport 8a 86, aged 93. His age in censuses and at death suggest he was born between early 1781 and March 1784 suggesting his baptism was performed late, along with his younger sibling, rather than he was a twin.

On 29 Dec 1803 when William was 21, he first married **Sarah Goubourn** in Wilmslow, St Bartholemew, Cheshire. Sarah was born in Morley, Cheshire, in 1781. She was christened in Wilmslow, St Bartholemew, Cheshire, on 30 May 1781. Sarah died in 1827. She was buried in Wilmslow, St Bartholemew, Cheshire, on 15 Aug 1827.

Sarah was the daughter of James and Elizabeth.

Josiah (32) is a labourer living with Mary Ann (26), and Mary (3 mths). ■ Census for Bowdon, Cheshire, in 1861. Josiah (39) is a labourer living with Mary Ann (37), Ellen H (6), and three infant lodgers. ■ Census for Didsbury, Lancashire, in 1871. Josiah (50) is a gardener living in Grove Lane with Mary A (47), Charlotte H (4), and Elener L (6). ■ Census for Didsbury, Lancashire, in 1881. Josiah (56) is gardener/domestic servant living at Brown Cross Lodge with Mary Ann (50), Charlotte (14) and Georgina (4). Josiah died in Didsbury, Lancashire, in 1883.

Josiah's father is a gardener from Hale on his baptism record, and a provision dealer from Hale on his marriage. His death was registered in 2q 1883 Chorlton 8c 379, aged 67.

On 15 Feb 1850 when Josiah was 32, he married **Mary Ann Johnson** in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire. Josiah is a labourer from Hale, father John, a provision dealer. Mary Ann is from Hale, father William, a joiner. Mary Ann was born in Chorlton, Lancashire, in 1825. She was christened in Chorlton, St Clement, Lancashire, on 17 Oct 1825.

They had the following children:

- i. **Mary Warburton**. Mary was born in Hulme, Manchester, Lancashire, in 1850.

Mary's birth was registered in 1q 1851 Chorlton 20 214. She doesn't appear in censuses after 1851 so may be the 1 year old whose death was registered at Altrincham in 1q 1852. (CheshireBMD).

- ii. **Harriet Warburton**. Harriet was born in Hulme, Manchester, Lancashire, in Apr 1851.

Harriet's birth was registered in 2q 1851 Manchester 20 763.

Harriet married **Samuel Jones**. Harriet and Samuel's marriage registration has not been found but they had twin sons William and Henry registered in 1q 1870 Altrincham 8a 164. Samuel was born in Rostherne, Cheshire, in 1845.

- 30 iii. **Ellen Holland Warburton** (1855-)
- iv. **Eleanor L Warburton**. Eleanor L was born in Levenshulme, Lancashire, abt 1864.

Eleanor's birth registration has not been found.

- 31 v. **Charlotte Holland Warburton** (1867-)
- vi. **Georgina Warburton**. Georgina was born in Bowdon, Cheshire, in 1877.

Georgina's birth was registered in 4q 1877 Altrincham 8a 181. She is my contact

Leslie Barton's grandmother.

In 1896 when Georgina was 19, she married **James Taberner** in Altrincham, St George, Cheshire. The marriage was registered in 1q 1896 Altrincham 8a 202. James and Georgina had 21 children, including two sets of twins. By the 1911 census they had had 13, but only 4 were living. Six more were registered at Bucklow by 1920. James was born in Altrincham, Cheshire, in 1876.

19. Samuel Warburton (*Thomas⁴, Josiah³, Josiah², John¹*). Samuel was born in Altrincham, Cheshire, on 16 Oct 1806. He was christened in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 16 Nov 1806. Samuel died in Altrincham, Cheshire, on 14 Jul 1865. He was buried in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 18 Jul 1865.

Samuel is buried in grave 811 which was previously used by Samuel of Timperley and his wife Mary nee Clark, who both died before Samuel was born. No connection between the two families is evident.

Samuel and Mary had a son Thomas baptised in March 1785 but I have found no other record of this Thomas. Meanwhile Samuel's mother Sarah was a widow on the 1851 census, and the widow of Thomas of Altrincham on her burial. This fits with the burial of Thomas of Altrincham in 1848, and Thomas's age means he was born around 1770. Thomas and Sarah are not in the 1841 census, but it seems most likely that Sarah married the son of Josiah and Martha, who was 8 year older, than the son of Samuel and Mary, who was 6 years younger and appears in no other records.

On 26 Nov 1826 when Samuel was 20, he married **Abigail Watkinson** in Lymm, St Mary, Cheshire.

They had the following children:

- i. **John Warburton**. John was born in Altrincham, Cheshire, in 1827. He was christened in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 25 Feb 1827. John died in Altrincham, Cheshire, on 29 Dec 1848. He was buried in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 1 Jan 1849.

John's father was a labourer on his baptism (but incorrectly named Thomas). He was buried, the son of Samuel and Abigail, in grave 811, aged 22.

- iii. **William Warburton**. William was born in Altrincham, Cheshire, in 1832. He was christened in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 1 Jul 1832.

William's father was a labourer on his baptism record.

20. John Warburton (*Thomas⁴, Josiah³, Josiah², John¹*). John was born in Altrincham, Cheshire,

on 24 Feb 1810. He was christened in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 25 Mar 1810. ■ Census for Altrincham, Cheshire, in 1851. John (38) is a fustian cutter living n Goose Green with Catherine (44), William (15) a labourer, James (10), Sarah Jane (10), Samuel (8), George (6) and mother Sarah (72). John died in Altrincham, Cheshire, on 24 May 1885. He was buried in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 27 May 1885.

John is buried in grave 1219 with Catherine, two of their children, and Catherine's parents. He has shaved a couple of years of his age but is the only son of Sarah baptised at Bowdon around that time.

On 13 Aug 1832 when John was 22, he married **Catherine Erlam** in Manchester Cathedral, Lancashire. Catherine was born in Hale, Cheshire, abt 1808. Catherine died in Altrincham, Cheshire, on 22 Feb 1867. She was buried in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 26 Feb 1867.

They had the following children:

- i. **Jane Warburton**. Jane was born in Bollington, Cheshire, in 1833. He was christened in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 30 Jun 1833. Jane died in Altrincham, Cheshire, in 1838. He was buried in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 2 Nov 1838.

Jane's father was a fustian cutter from Bollington on her baptism. She died aged 5.

- ii. **William Warburton**. William was born in Bollington, Cheshire, in 1835. He was christened in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 22 Mar 1835. William died in Altrincham, Cheshire, on 28 Jun 1883. He was buried on 2 Jul 1883.

William's father is called William, a fustian cutter from Bollington, on his baptism but this is an error. He is buried in grave 1219 with his (Erlam) grandparents, parents, and sister, aged 48.

- iii. **Isaac Warburton**. Isaac was born in Altrincham, Cheshire, in 1838. He was christened in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 7 Oct 1838. Isaac died in Altrincham, St George, Cheshire, in 1839. He was buried in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 14 May 1839.

Isaac died aged 8 months.

- iv. **Sarah Jane Warburton**. Sarah Jane was born in Altrincham, Cheshire, in 1840. She was christened in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 13 Sep 1840. Sarah Jane died in Altrincham, Cheshire, on 25 Apr 1869. She was buried in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 29 Apr 1869.

Sarah Jane's father was a fustian cutter on her baptism. She is the daughter of John and Catherine of Altrincham, aged 27 on her burial record but 31 on her headstone (both are wrong as she was probably 28). She is buried in grave 1219 with her (Erlam) grandparents, parents, and brother William.

- v. **James Warburton**. James was born in Altrincham, Cheshire, in 1840.

James's birth was registered at the same time as Sarah Jane's, 3q 1840 Altrincham 19 1. However he doesn't appear on Sarah's baptism record, though it is likely he was baptised at the same time. They are assumed to be twins.

- vi. **Samuel Warburton**. Samuel was born in Altrincham, Cheshire, in 1842. He was christened in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 26 Jun 1842.

Samuel's father was a fustian cutter on his baptism record.

- vii. **George Warburton**. George was born in Altrincham, Cheshire, in 1844. He was christened in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 27 Oct 1844.

George's father was a fustian cutter on his baptism record.

- viii. **Elizabeth Warburton**. Elizabeth was born in Altrincham, Cheshire, in 1847. She was christened in Altrincham, St George, Cheshire, on 30 Jul 1847. Elizabeth died in Altrincham, Cheshire, in 1848. She was buried in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 7 Jun 1848.

21. Josiah Warburton (*William*⁴, *Josiah*³, *Josiah*², *John*¹). Josiah was born in Bolton, Lancashire, in 1813. He was christened in Bolton, St Peter, Lancashire, on 28 Feb 1813. ■ Census for Bolton, Lancashire, in 1851. Josiah (38) is a widowed cotton weaver living at 36 Nailor Row with Joseph (12), William (9), James (5), and Thomas (2). Josiah died in Bolton, Lancashire, in 1858. He was buried in Bolton, Tonge Cemetery, Lancashire, on 19 Nov 1857.

Josiah's father was a weaver from Haulgh on his baptism record. Josiah was a counterpane weaver living at 35 Well Street, Little Bolton when he died. He was buried as a nonconformist in unconsecrated ground (in Div 4 Sec a 74), aged 44.

On 4 Aug 1841 when Josiah was 28, he married **Jane Hyde** in Deane, St Mary, Lancashire. Josiah was a weaver from Halliwell (Bolton), father William, a weaver. Jane Hyde was a spinster from Halliwell, father Joseph, a spinner. Jane was born abt 1813. Jane died in Bolton, Lancashire, in 1850. She was buried in Bolton, St Peter, Lancashire, on 13 Mar 1850.

Jane, wife of Josiah of Little Bolton, was buried aged 37.

They had the following children:

- i. **William Warburton**. William was born in Bolton, Lancashire, in 1841. William died in Farnworth, Lancashire, in 1869.

William's birth was registered in 3q 1841 Bolton 21 104, mother's maiden name Hyde. He hasn't been found in censuses after 1861 so he is possibly the William whose death was registered in 1q 1869 Bolton 8c 206, aged 28.

- ii. **John Warburton**. John was born in Bolton, Lancashire, in 1843. John died in Bolton, Lancashire, in 1844.

John's birth was registered in 3q 1843 Bolton 21 109, mother's maiden name Hyde. He is missing from the 1851 census so his death is probably that registered in 4q 1844 Bolton 21 90, aged 1.

- iii. **James Warburton**. James was born in Bolton, Lancashire, abt 1845.

James's birth was probably that registered in 4q 1845 Bolton 21 112, mother's maiden name Hoyle, sub-district Little Bolton (LancashireBMD).

He was christened in Bolton, St Peter, Lancashire, on 28 May 1815. ■ Census for Bolton, Lancashire, in 1871. Job (55) is a beer seller living at 166 Fold Road with Ann (35). Josiah (25) and his family are a separate household at the same address.

Job's father was a weaver from Harwood on his baptism record, though this may be an error as the family were back in Haulgh for the baptism of Jane in 1817.

Job's death registration has not been found, nor have census entries after 1871. Also no children are registered apart from William. Josiah is an assumed son on the basis they were sharing the same house in 1871.

On 12 Jun 1836 when Job was 21, he first married **Maria Johnson** in Ainsworth, Christ Church, Lancashire. Both were 'of this parish'. Maria was born abt 1815. Maria died in Bolton, Lancashire, in 1840.

Maria's death was registered in 2q 1840 Bolton 21 84, aged 25.

They had one child:

- i. **William Warburton**. William was born in 1838.

William's birth was registered in 3q 1838 Bolton 21 125, mother's maiden name Johnson. He has not been investigated further.

Job second married **Unknown**.

They had one child:

34 i. **Josiah Warburton** (~1845-1905)

In 1862 when Job was 47, he third married **Ann Wallace** in Bolton, St James the Apostle, Lancashire. The marriage was registered in 1q 1862 Bolton 8c 333. Ann was born in Bolton, Lancashire, abt 1835.

23. Joseph Warburton (*William⁴, George³, Josiah², John¹*). Joseph was born in Pendleton, Lancashire, in 1837. He was christened in Pendleton, St Thomas, Lancashire, on 18 Jun 1837. ■ Census for Salford, Lancashire, in 1861. Joseph (23) is a woollen warehouseman living at 5 Burgess Street with Rachel (27), Ann (4), Sarah (2), Hannah O (6 months), and mother Hannah O (64) a widowed proprietor of houses. ■ Census for Salford, Lancashire, in 1871. Joseph (33) is a warehouseman living at 1 Burgess Street with Rachel (36), Ann (14), Sarah (12), Mary (8), Louisa (7), William (5), John (3), and Lucy (1). ■ Census for Salford, Lancashire, in 1881. Joseph (43) is a woollen warehouseman living at 1 Burgess Street with Rachel (45), Ann (24), Mary (18), and Louisa (17) smallware hands, William (15) and John (13) office boys, Lucy (11), Joseph (10), Thomas (7), and Clara (5). ■ Census for Salford, Lancashire, in 1891. Joseph (53) is an organist and music teacher living at 12 Upper Cleminson Street with Rachel (57), Ann (34), William (25) a clerk, John (23) a clerk, Lucy (21) a dressmaker, Joseph (20) a merchant's salesman, Thomas (16) a warehouseman, Clara (15) a draper's assistant, and boarder Mary A E Calder (24) a dressmaker. ■ Census for Salford, Lancashire, in 1901. Joseph (63) is a teacher of music living at 12 Upper Cleminson Street with Rachel (67), and Ann (43). ■ Census for Pendleton, Lancashire, in 1911. Joseph (73) is a widowed teacher of music (piano and organ) living at 4 Blenheim Place (5 rooms) with single daughter Ann (54). Joseph died in Pendleton, Lancashire, on 27 Nov 1915. He was buried in Salford Borough Cemetery, Weast, Lancashire, on 1 Dec 1915.

Joseph was the son of William, a Blacksmith, and Hannah on his baptism record. The 1861 and 1881 censuses give his birthplace as Charlestown, which is adjacent to Pendleton in Salford.

He was a warehouseman living in Burgess Street on the baptisms of all his children, but he moved from number 5 to number 1 between the baptism of John in 1867, and Lucy in 1869.

Joseph's death was registered in 4q 1915 Salford 8d 145, aged 78.

Death of Mr J Warburton

The musical world will learn with regret of the death, in his 79th year, of one of Salford's oldest organists. Mr Joseph Warburton who passed peacefully to his rest at his residence 4, Blenheim Place, Pendleton on November 27. He was born in 1836 at Pendleton, and was educated at the

Christ Church (Hope Street) School, Salford being (prior to his death) the oldest living scholar. Early in life he started his musical career as a pupil of the late Mr Meadowcroft. His first appointment as organist and choirmaster was at St Michael's Church, Angel Meadow. He was afterwards offered and accepted the position of organist and choirmaster at St Matthias' Church, Salford. His last appointment, which he held for upwards of 25 years, was at St Philip's Church, Salford, his retirement being due to failing health. He was a musician of the old school and thorough in his work. Many of his old pupils now occupy good positions. He was a firm believer in punctuality and was never known to be late once in all his many engagements. Many of his old choristers will have happy reminiscences of the time spent under his tuition in the past. His last hours were soothed by the members of his family, and after many strenuous years he now sleeps his last long sleep, reaping the reward of a well-spent life.

The funeral took place on Wednesday last at the Salford Borough Cemetery..... Prior to the interment a choral service was held at Christ Church, Salford, at 12 o'clock conducted by the Rev A W Thompson, Rural Dean, assisted by the Rev Canon Green, Rector of St Philip's Church, Salford..... A letter of condolence to the family was sent by the Bishop of Lincoln*, along with many other expressions of sympathy from old friends. Many beautiful wreaths were sent from family and friends The mourners in the first carriage were – Mr W Warburton (son William) and Miss Warburton (eldest daughter Ann); second carriage, Mr John Warburton (son), Mrs Deakin (daughter Sarah), Mr T O Warburton (son Thomas Osbourne), and Mrs J Garner (daughter Louisa); third carriage, Mr W J Smith (William James, son-in-law and husband of daughter Mary), Mrs W Warburton (son William's wife Sarah nee Eccles), Mr and Mrs J Barnes (daughter Lucy and her husband James), and in the fourth carriage, Mr J Garner (son-in-law James), Mrs Jos Warburton Laura Sherlock nee Holt, wife of son Joseph), Mr Pitman Carson and the Rev A W Thompson, Rural Dean.....

Notes

*Edward Lee Hicks, born in Oxford but in 1901 lived close to Warburton family in Salford. Became Bishop of Lincoln in 1910.

Mourners included Mr WT Blease, a possible connection to Joseph's grandmother Ellen Blease. Missing from the mourners are daughter Mary Smith, son Joseph, and daughter Clara and her husband.

On 29 Jun 1856 when Joseph was 19, he married **Rachel Hamer** in Manchester Cathedral, Lancashire. Joseph (19) was a warehouseman of 12 Heart Street, Salford, father William, a smith. Rachel (22) was from 8 Cranbourn Street, Salford, father John, a weaver. Rachel was born in Ardwick, Manchester, Lancashire, abt 1833.

On 16 Nov 1879 when Sarah was 20, she married **William Deakin** in Salford, St Philip, Lancashire. The marriage was registered in 4q 1879 Salford 8d 15. William and Sarah have several children in censuses. William was born in Manchester, Lancashire, abt 1854.

- iii. **Hannah Osbourne Warburton**. Hannah Osbourne was born in Salford, Lancashire, in 1860. She was christened in Salford, Christ Church, Lancashire, on 28 Oct 1860. Hannah Osbourne died in Salford, Lancashire, in 1865.

Hannah's birth was registered in 3q 1860 Salford 8d 75, mother's maiden name Hamer. Her middle name of Osbourne is included in her baptism record, but not the registration. The death of Hannah Osborne was registered in 4q 1865 Salford 8d 53, aged 5.

- iv. **Mary Warburton**. Mary was born in Salford, Lancashire, in 1862. She was christened in Salford, Christ Church, Lancashire, on 22 Jun 1862.

Mary's birth was registered in 2q 1862 Salford 8d 61, mother's maiden name Hamer.

On 29 Jun 1887 when Mary was 25, she married **William James Smith** in Salford, St Philip, Lancashire. William (24) was a tube drawer from 2 Olive Street, Lower Boughton, father Thomas, a turner (deceased). Mary (25) was from 12 Upper Cleminson Street, father Joseph, a warehouseman. William and Ann Warburton were witnesses. William James was born abt 1863.

- v. **Louisa Warburton**. Louisa was born in Salford, Lancashire, in 1863. She was christened in Salford, Christ Church, Lancashire, on 24 Jan 1864.

Louisa's birth was registered in 24q 1863 Salford 8d 62, mother's maiden name Hamer.

In 1888 when Louisa was 25, she married **James Garner** in Salford, St Matthias, Lancashire. The marriage was registered in 3q 1888 Salford 8d 115. In the 1911

24. James Warburton (*Isaac⁴, George³, Josiah², John¹*). James was born in Manchester, Lancashire, on 7 Jul 1824. He was christened in Hulme, Christ Church, Lancashire, on 15 Jul 1824. He was christened in Manchester Cathedral, Lancashire, on 28 Aug 1825. ■ Census for Manchester, Lancashire, in 1851. James (27) is a cotton spinner living at 8 Lombard Street with Mary Ann (25), Mary Ann (3), Elizabeth (1), father Isaac (54) a carder, brother Samuel (18) a piecer, and sisters Sarah (13) a silk winder, and Mary (11). ■ Census for Hulme, Manchester, Lancashire, in 1861. James (37) is a selfacting(?) minder living at 33 Foster Street with Mary A (36), Mary A (13), Elizabeth (11), Martha (9), Ellen (7), and Sarah (4). At the same address but a separate household are John Rothwell (20) a boatman, and his wife Sarah (21). This is probably James's sister Sarah though she didn't actually marry John Rothwell until 1863. ■ Census for Salford, Lancashire, in 1871. James (47) is a mule spinner living at 11 Vine Street with Mary A

(46), Elizabeth (21) a silk weaver, Martha (18) a braid tenter, Ellen (16) a silk winder, Sarah (14) a silk winder, James (8), and Caroline (6). ■ Census for Salford, Lancashire, in 1881. James (56) is a labourer living at 11 Vine Grove with Margaret M (56), James (18) occupation illegible, Caroline (16) occupation illegible, and 2 boarders. As James's wife Mary Ann outlived him, the reference to Margaret M is probably a mistake, and should refer to Mary Ann. James died in Salford, Lancashire, in 1886.

Only one marriage of an Isaac Warburton to a Mary has been identified, so it is assumed that both baptisms relate to James. James's father was a carder from Manchester on his second baptism record, but his age in censuses fits more closely (but not exactly) with his date of birth from the first baptism.

As he is reported as deceased on his daughter Caroline's marriage record, he is probably the James whose death was registered in 1q 1886 Salford 8d 124, aged 62.

On 28 Mar 1847 when James was 22, he married **Mary Ann Jones** in Manchester Cathedral, Lancashire. James was a spinner from Lombard Street, father Isaac, a carder. Mary was from Bridgewater Street, father Henry, a painter. The marriage was registered in 1q 1847 Manchester 20 515. Mary Ann was born in Manchester, Lancashire, abt 1825. Mary Ann died in Salford, Lancashire, in 1899.

Mary Ann was living with her son James in the 1891 census, but not in the 1901 census, so her death is probably that registered in 3q 1899 Salford 8d 114, aged 74.

On 4 Feb 1872 when Elizabeth was 22, she married **William Kershaw** in Manchester Cathedral, Lancashire. William (24) was a lithographic printer from 64 Welcomb Street, Hulme, father William, a warehouseman. Elizabeth (22) was from 1 Primrose Street, Hulme, father James, a spinner. Censuses show 5 sons and 2 daughters. William was born abt 1847.

Ellen's birth was registered in 4q 1854 Chorlton 8c 535, mother's maiden name Jones. No death registration or satisfactory marriage record has been found.

No birth registration, death registration or satisfactory marriage record have been found for Sarah.

- vii. **Caroline Warburton**. Caroline was born in Manchester, Lancashire, in 1864. Caroline died in Salford, Lancashire, in 1931.

Caroline's birth was registered in 4q 1864 Chorlton 8c 585, mother's maiden name Jones. Her death was registered in 1q 1931 Salford 8d 449, aged 67.

On 24 Apr 1886 when Caroline was 22, she married **William James Whittingham** in Salford, Stowell Memorial, Lancashire. William (21) was a velvet finisher from 247 Robert Hall Street, father William, a velvet finisher. Caroline (21) was a spinner from 30 Strasburg Street, father James (deceased), a spinner. James Warburton was a witness. By the 1911 census William and Caroline had been married 25 years and had 8 children, 4 still living. A son and 2 daughters were still at home.

William James was born in Manchester, Lancashire, abt 1866. William James died in Salford, Lancashire, in 1930.

William's death was registered in 3q 1930 Salford 8d 308, aged 64.

25. James Warburton (*William⁴, William³, Josiah², John¹*). James was born in Morley, Cheshire, on 31 Mar 1804. He was christened in Wilmslow, Dean Row Presbyterian Chapel, Cheshire, on 7 Jun 1804. ■ Census for Pownall Fee, Cheshire, in 1851. James (46) is a hand loom weaver living with Ann (44), Betty (15) a pin winder, Amelia (9), and Thomas (7). ■ Census for Pownall Fee, Cheshire, in 1861. James (57) is an agricultural labourer and weaver living in Morely Green with Ann (54), Amelia B (19) a cotton carder, Thomas (17) a carrier in a cotton [mill], daughter Agnes Oaks (34) and her husband John (40) a cotton hand loom weaver, and their 3 children. James died in Morley, Cheshire, on 3 Jan 1862. He was buried in Wilmslow, St Bartholemew, Cheshire, on 7 Jan 1862.

James was accidentally decapitated and killed by the fly wheel of a steam engine, aged 57 (58 on his burial record). He was an agricultural laborer of Pownall Fee.

On 29 Jun 1824 when James was 20, he married **Ann Boulton** in Cheadle, St Mary, Cheshire. Ann was born in Stockport, Cheshire, in 1805.

Ann's name is sometimes spelt without the 'u' (Bolton).

Agnes is from Morley, father James, a weaver. John and Agnes had a son and two daughters. John was born in Adlington, Cheshire, abt 1821. John died in Wilmslow, Cheshire, in 1862.

- iii. **Elizabeth Hodkinson Warburton**. Elizabeth Hodkinson was born in Morley, Cheshire, in 1837.

In 1858 when Elizabeth Hodkinson was 21, she married **William Sadler** in Cheadle, St Mary, Cheshire. The marriage was registered in 2q 1858 Stockport 8a 25. William was born in 1858. He was christened in Cheadle, St Mary, Cheshire.

Joseph was born in Mobberley, Cheshire, in 1844.

William (30) is an agricultural labourer and beerhouse keeper living at The Prince of Wales with Mary (33). ■ Census for Kearsley, Lancashire, in 1861. William (42) is an agricultural labourer living at Riley Row with Mary (43), John (6), Mary A (4), and a lodger. ■ Census for Kearsley, Lancashire, in 1871. William (51) is an agricultural labourer living at Royley Row with Mary (53), John (16) an agricultural labourer, Mary A (14) a cotton operative, and a lodger. ■ Census for Kearsley, Lancashire, in 1881. William (63) is a farm labourer living at Royley Row with Mary (63), John (26) an unmarried carter, grandson John Wm (4), and a lodger. ■ Census for Kearsley, Lancashire, in 1891. William (70) is a widowed farm labourer living with son John and his family. William died in Kearsley, Lancashire, in 1892. He was buried in Farnworth Cemetery, Lancashire.

William's father is a weaver from Morley on his baptism record. His death was registered in 2q 1892 Bolton 8c 200, aged 71.

John (46) is a general carter living at 12 Kay Street with Margaret (57), stepson John Rigby (22), grandson George Hayter (3) and a lodger. ■ Census for Farnworth, Lancashire, in 1911. John (56) is a carter for a farmer living at 54 Crompton Street with Margaret (67), and Joseph Rigby (32) who is a cripple with no occupation. John and Margaret have been married for 24 years and had no children. John died in Farnworth, Lancashire, in 1933.

John's birth is probably that registered in 3q 1854 Stockport 8a 77. CheshireBMD records his mother's maiden name as Johnson. His death was probably that registered in 1q 1933 Bolton 8c 423, aged 78. This is the closest on age and was in Farnworth sub-district (LancashireBMD).

In 1886 when John was 32, he married **Margaret Rigby** in Farnworth and Kearsley, St John the Evangelist, Lancashire. The marriage was registered in 4q 1886 Bolton 8c 427. Margaret was born in Astley, Lancashire, abt 1843. Margaret died in Farnworth, Lancashire, in 1920.

Margaret's death was probably that registered in 4q 1920 Bolton 8c 342, aged 76. This is the closest on age and was in Farnworth sub-district (LancashireBMD).

He was christened in Wilmslow, Dean Row Presbyterian Chapel, Cheshire, on 16 Jan 1823. ■ Census for Bollin Fee, Cheshire, in 1851. George (29) is an agricultural labourer living in Deanrow Lane with Mary (24) a silk weaver, and Elizabeth (5). The identity of Elizabeth is

uncertain as George and Mary were only married a few weeks before the census, and were described as bachelor and spinster. Also the only Elizabeth registered at Altrincham belongs to a different family. There is no Elizabeth Culley that fits either. ■ Census for Pownall Fee, Cheshire, in 1861. George (40) is an agricultural labourer living in [.] Altrincham Road with Ellen (33), and a lodger. ■ Census for Adlington, Cheshire, in 1871. George (50) is an agricultural labourer living in Brookhouse with Ellen (43), George (9), Thomas (6), Mary (3), and Hannah (3 mths). ■ Census for Adlington, Cheshire, in 1881. George (60) is a farm labourer living at Whitley Green Cottage with Ellen (53), George (19) a cotton weaver, Thomas (16) a farm labourer, Mary (13), Hannah (10), and Reginald Evans (5) a nurse child. Reginald was in fact adopted. George died in Adlington, Cheshire, on 28 Aug 1885. He was buried in Prestbury, St Peter, Cheshire.

George married Mary Culley in 1851, Mary's death is probably that registered in 1855. By 1861 George is living with Mary's sister Ellen and the first of their children arrived in 1862.

As brother and sister-in-law it was illegal to marry until it was allowed by Act of Parliament in 1907. Therefore there is no record of a marriage. However they lived as husband and wife until George's death in 1885.

George was buried in a new family grave at Prestbury where he was eventually joined by an infant grandson, Wilfred, his 'wife' Ellen, sons Thomas and George, George's wife Emily, and George senior's daughter Hannah.

On 3 Feb 1851 when George was 29, he first married **Mary Culley** in Stockport, St Mary, Cheshire. The marriage was registered in 1q 1851 Stockport 19 228. On the parish record George was a bachelor of full age, a labourer from Marple, father William, a weaver. Mary was a spinster of full age from Marple, father James, a weaver. Mary was born in Macclesfield, Cheshire, in 1827. She was christened in Macclesfield, St Michael, Cheshire, on 15 Apr 1827. Mary died in 1855.

Mary's death is probably that registered in 4q 1855 Altrincham 8a 110, aged 29. If this age is correct it implies she was born a few months before her baptism.

He second common-law married **Ellen Culley**. Ellen was born in Macclesfield, Cheshire, in 1829. She was christened in Macclesfield, St Michael, Cheshire, on 31 May 1829. ■ Census for Bollington, Cheshire, in 1891. Ellen (63) is a widowed housekeeper living on Adlington Road with Mary (23) a cotton weaver, Hannah (20) a cotton reeler, Thomas (25) a lorry driver, and Thomas's wife Elizabeth (27) a cotton reeler, plus 2 lodgers Reginald Evans and Mary Robinson who were in fact adopted. ■ Census for Bollington, Cheshire, in 1901. Ellen (73) is a widow living on Adlington Road with Thomas (36) a gardener, Hannah (30) a cotton reeler, grandson Arthur (9) plus 2 lodgers Reginald Evans and Mary Robinson who were in fact adopted. Thomas's wife Margaret is staying with her sisters at Tower Hill, Rainow. Ellen died in Bollington, Cheshire, on 3 Apr 1910. She was buried in Prestbury, St Peter, Cheshire.

Ellen was buried in the family grave at Prestbury, aged 82.

28. Josiah Warburton (*William⁴, William³, Josiah², John¹*). Josiah was born in Morley, Cheshire, in Apr 1824. He was christened in Wilmslow, Dean Row Presbyterian Chapel, Cheshire, on 28 Aug 1824. ■ Census for Wilmslow, Cheshire, in 1841. Josiah is aged 15 but the image is too feint to read. ■ Census for Pownall Fee, Cheshire, in 1851. Josiah (transcribed Isiah, 26) an agricultural labourer, and Mary (24) a domestic are lodging with Isaac Johnson. Isaac is a widowed Chelsea Pensioner from Flixton. ■ Census for Pownall Fee, Cheshire, in 1861. Josiah (37) is an agricultural labourer living with Margaret (should be Mary, 35), Arthur (5), John (2), and father William (77) a hand loom cotton weaver. ■ Census for Bramhall, Cheshire, in 1871. Josiah (44) is a farm servant on the farm of Thomas Garner at Woodsmoor. ■ Census for Bramhall, Cheshire, in 1881. Isiah (51) is a farm labourer living at Woods Moor with Mary A (51) Sarah (16) a hat former, and Alice (10). ■ Census for Bramhall, Cheshire, in 1891. Josiah (68) is widowed farm servant living at Woodsmoor with son-in-law John Bailey (24) a West Indian and South American merchant's clerk, Sarah (26), and 2 children. Josiah died in Ramsbottom, Lancashire, in 1899.

Josiah' was the son of William and Sarah nee Goulden (sic) of Morley on his baptism record. He is also identified as William's son by William's presence at his home on the 1861 census, and on his marriage record in the parish records.

His death is probably that registered in 1q 1899 Bury 8c 338, aged 69. Although the age is low

Mary Ann's death is probably that registered in 3q 1884 Altrincham 8a 119, aged 58.

Sarah (22) is a hat trimmer of Wood Moor, Bramhall, father Josiah, an agricultural labourer. The marriage was registered in 4q 1887 Stockport 8a 111. John and Sarah had 2 sons and 4 daughters. John Sumner was born in Handforth, Cheshire, abt 1866.

John was a commercial traveller in the 1901 census.

Alice's birth is probably that registered in 2q 1870 8a 54. She has not been identified after 1901.

29. Benjamin Warburton (*John⁴, Samuel³, Josiah², John¹*). Benjamin was born in Manchester, Lancashire, in 1816. He was christened in Manchester Cathedral, Lancashire, on 2 Feb 1816.

Peter and Benjamin were baptised on the same day (possibly twins). Their father was a velvet dresser from Manchester on their baptism record.

On 23 Feb 1835 when Benjamin was 19, he first married **Ann Smith** in Manchester Cathedral,

Elizabeth is from Long Millgate father Timothy, a japanner. The marriage was registered in 4q 1839 Manchester 20 386. Elizabeth was born in Salford, Lancashire, in 1823.

Eliza's birth was registered in 3q 1875 Chorlton 8c 644, mother's maiden name Warburton, su-district Didsbury (LancashireBMD). She hasn't been found after 1911 and possibly remarried.

On 29 Nov 1901 when Eliza Jane was 26, she married **Harry Norbury** in Marthall, All Saints, Cheshire. A transcript of Cheshire Marriage Licence Bonds and Allegations describes Harry as a grocer's assistant from Toft, and Eliza as a spinster from Marthall. The marriage was registered in 4q 1901 Bucklow 8a 283. Harry and Eliza had a son and a daughter. Harry was born abt 1878. Harry died in 1910.

Harry's death was registered in 1q 1910 Bucklow 8a 142, aged 31.

In 1879 when Ellen Holland was 24, she second married **Joseph Rawlins** in Altrincham, Cheshire. It was a civil marriage registered in 1q 1879 Altrincham 8a 253. Ellen and John had 4 children, including twins born in 4q 1879. Joseph was born in Altrincham, Cheshire, in 1856.

31. Charlotte Holland Warburton (*Josiah⁵, John⁴, Thomas³, Josiah², John¹*). Charlotte Holland was born in Didsbury, Lancashire, on 14 Jul 1867.

Charlotte's birth was registered in 2q 1867 Chorlton 8c 541. She had a daughter Amelia, in 1883 before her first marriage.

She first did not marry **Unknown**.

In 1887 when Charlotte Holland was 19, she second married **Robert Rustage** in Altrincham, Cheshire. It was a civil marriage. Charlotte and Robert had two sons, though one died an infant. Robert was born in Altrincham, Cheshire, in 1859. Robert died in Alderley, Cheshire, in 1890.

Robert's death was registered in 1q 1890 Altrincham 8a 159, aged 31.

In 1894 when Charlotte Holland was 26, she third married **Charles Robert Blinkhorn** in Altrincham, St George, Cheshire. The marriage was registered in 4q 1894 Altrincham 8a 237. Charlotte and Charles had 3 sons. Charles Robert was born in Eccles, Lancashire, in 1862.

Joseph (31) is a policeman living at Bramhall Green with Elizabeth (33), William (5), and Emma (5). ■ Census for Altrincham, Cheshire, in 1871. Joseph (42) is a widowed labourer living at 1 Lord Street with mother Abigail (70) a carter employing 2 labourers, William (15) a pupil teacher, and Emma (15) a dressmaker. ■ Census for Altrincham, Cheshire, in 1881. William and his son were from Chorley, so it is Elizabeth, who was born in Bolton and is the right age for Josiah's sister, who is James's, and Thomas's aunt. The stepson implies she first married a Thomason, and then William Warburton from Chorley, though the marriages have yet to be found. ■ Census for Bolton, Lancashire, in 1871. Thomas (24) is a machine joiner living at 22 Willows Lane with Mary (20), Elizabeth (2), and John (1). ■ Census for Bolton, Lancashire, in 1881. Thomas (33) is a machine joiner living at 22 Thos Rostron Street with Mary (30), Maud (8), Richard (4), and Walter (2). ■ Census for Bolton, Lancashire, in 1891. Thomas (43) is a miller in foundry living at 22 Thomas Rostron Street with Mary (40), Maud (18) a fly tenter in cotton mill, Richard (14), a drawer-in in cotton mill, and Walter (12). ■ Census for Bolton, Lancashire, in 1901. Thos (53) is a joiner's machinist living at 262 Willow Lane with Mary (50), Maud (28) a card room hand, Richard (24) a cotton twister, and Walter (22) a stone mason. ■ Census for Bolton, Lancashire, in 1911. Thomas (65) is a machine joiner living at 10 Oswald Street (3 rooms) with Mary (60), and nephew Fred Horridge (29) a millerwright. Josiah (35) is a cotton spinner living at 9 Snowdon Street, Little Bolton with Mary (36), Alice A (13) a piecer, Eliz E (12) a piecer, Emma (10) a piecer, Josiah (8), Maria (4), William (2), and Mary (8 months). ■ Census for Halliwell, Lancashire, in 1891. Josiah (45) is a cotton spinner living at 20 Waldeck Street with Mary (6), Alice A (23) a jack frame tenter in cotton mill, Elizabeth E (22) a roller coverer, Emma (20) a jack frame tenter, Maria (14) a calico weaver, William (12) a music shop assistant, and Mary (10). ■ Census for Halliwell, Lancashire, in 1901. Josiah (55) is a music dealer living at 156 Chorley Old Road, Little Bolton with Mary (56), Alice Ann (33) a cotton jack frame tenter, William (22) a music teacher and dealer, and Mary (20) an assistant in a music shop. Josiah died in Halliwell, Lancashire, in

William and Sarah had been married for 18 years and had 5 children, all living.

In WW1 Percy enlisted in the Royal Fusiliers and was wounded in 1915. He returned to France as second Lieutenant, with the East Surrey Regiment. He survived the war and became an artist, head of Bury School of Art and close friend of the renowned painter L. S. Lowry.

On 29 Jul 1925 when Percy was 30, he married **Miriam Fletcher** in Prestwich, St Mary, Lancashire. Percy (30) was an art lecturer from The Nook, Egerton Park, Worsley, father John, an Accountant. Miriam (28) was from 6 York Avenue, Prestwich, father Samuel, a cap manufacturer (deceased). Miriam was born on 26 Mar 1897. Miriam died in 1968.

Miriam's death was probably that registered in 4q 1967 Westmoreland South 1b 607, aged 70.

Signalman Harold John Warburton, Royal Naval Volunteer Reserve, was born on the 19th of July 1897 to John and Mary Warburton (née Smith).

His parents were both born and raised in Salford. They married in St Philip's Church Salford, on June 29th 1891. Their first two children, Douglas and Eva, were born in Salford and by the time their third son Percy was born in 1895 the family had moved a few miles west, to Winton, Eccles. When their youngest child Harold John was born the family were living in Clayton, Bradford.

At the time of the 1901 census the family were still in Bradford. John was working as a Clerk and Amy was a Draper & Outfitter. The four children were at school.

By the spring of 1911 the Warburtons had moved back to Salford and were living at

78 Hayfield Rd Pendleton. John Warburton was working as a Clerk (commercial); Douglas, following in his fathers footsteps, was also a Clerk; Eva was an Embroideress and Percy was an Art Student. Harold John was still at school.

The following obituary published at the time of Harold John's death paints a vivid picture of the tragically short life of this promising young man.

" Signaller Harold John Warburton, of Spring Bank, Manchester, Irlam-O'th'-Height, who was on board the auxiliary cruiser Laurentic, when she was mined off the coast on the 25th inst., is believed to have been killed. His father, Mr John Warburton, received a letter from the Admiralty on Sunday to the effect that his name was not amongst the list of those saved, and the usual note of sympathy was enclosed. Deceased, who was of fine physique, being over 6ft. in height, joined the R.N.V.R. about Easter last year, and was on his first voyage when he met his death. He commenced his education at the Tootall Road School, Weaste, and won a scholarship to the Salford Secondary School. During his connexion with the latter he was captain of the school, and also of the football club. From there he went to the Manchester University, where he matriculated and took Honours in Chemistry. His death at the early age of 19 years has cut short a very promising career. He secured his Intermediate BSc (Lond.) about two years ago. A keen athlete, he was always to the fore in the school sports, and held several medals gained by swimming. Much sympathy is felt with the family, who are well known in the district and this is the second bereavement they have suffered in a short time. Mrs Warburton, mother of the deceased, died only a month ago. Two elder brothers of the deceased are serving in the army. Percy, who enlisted in the Royal Fusiliers, was wounded about 19 months ago and is now in France as second Lieutenant, with the East Surrey Regiment. Sergeant Douglas Warburton went though the Gallipoli Campaign with the Eccles Company of the 16th Lancashire Fusiliers. He was wounded and afterwards suffered from dysentery and fever, and is now training in England."

Harold's brother Percy survived the war and became an artist, head of Bury School of Art and close friend of the renowned painter L. S. Lowry.

It is not clear whether Harold John Warburton managed to get to a lifeboat but we do know that his body was never recovered. He is commemorated on the Plymouth Naval Memorial. He is also commemorated on the Memorial Plaque of the Old Salfordians' Association, which originally hung in the Salford Municipal School for Boys, Leaf Square premises, now re-erected in the Peel Building, University of Salford, the original site of the Salford Municipal School for Boys, where all the boys who died in the war would have studied.

Laura was from 3 Bank Place, father William, a solicitor's managing clerk. The marriage was registered in 3q 1893 Salford 8d 146. Laura Sherlock was born in Salford, Lancashire, on 24 May 1870. Laura Sherlock died in Manchester, Withington Hospital, Lancashire, on 11 Nov 1942.

Laura's death was registered in 4q 1942 Manchester 8d 222, aged 72. Administration (with will) for Laura Sherlock of 215 Barlow Road was granted to Arthur Reginald Warburton, insurance official. Her effects were £320 16s 7d.

Thomas O is incapacitated, living at 15 Lawsons with Annie M, and a domestic worker. Thomas Osbourne died in Thornton Cleveleys, Lancashire, on 9 Dec 1946. He was buried in Pendleton, St John, Lancashire, on 12 Dec 1946.

Thomas Osbourne's birth was registered in 2q 1874 Salford 8d 93, mother's maiden name Hamer. His death was registered in 4q 1946 Fylde 10c 267, aged 72. Administration for Thomas of 15 Lawsons Road was granted to Herbert Saunders Warburton, company director. His effects were £5,197 2s 4d.

Thomas joined his father-in-law Samuel Saunders in a corn and hay merchants. Samuel had joined his uncle Timothy Boddington's firm Boddington and Leigh, at the age of 9 in 1862. Timothy was the younger brother of Henry Boddington who founded Boddington's Brewery.

The business ultimately comprised 3 firms, Boddington and Leigh, Saunders an Warburton, and E Denson and Co., trading in Pendleton and Manchester.

During WW1 Thomas was active in the equitable distribution of forage supplies and in 1920 he was elected president of the British Hay Traders' Association.

In 1922 the partnership between Thomas and Samuel Saunders was dissolved with Samuel and his son Samuel percy Boddington Saunders continuing to trade as E Denson and Co., and Thomas, along with John Binns continuing to trade as saunders and Warburton, and Boddington and Leigh. John Binns retired in 1926, leaving Thomas in sole charge.

On 21 Feb 1900 when Thomas Osbourne was 25, he married **Annie Maria Saunders** in Salford, Christ Church, Lancashire. Thomas (25) was a clerk from 12 Upper Cleminson Street, father Joseph, a music teacher. Annie (23) was a telegraphist from 6 Albion Place, father Samuel, a manager. The marriage was registered in 1q 1900 Salford 8d 82. Annie Maria was born in Pendleton, Lancashire, on 17 Oct 1876. Annie Maria died in Eccles, Lancashire, on 22 Apr 1943.

Annie's death was registered in Barton-upon-Irwell 8c 579, aged 66. Probate for Annie Maria of 15 Lawsons Road, Thornton-le-Fylde, wife of Thomas Osborne Warburton, was granted to Annie Osborne Hawkins, wife of Robert Henry Hawkins, and Arthur Neville Warburton, lieutenant HM army. Her effects were £1659 12s 6d.

Melonie is presumably Thomas's niece, daughter of his sister Annie, but her birth registration hasn't been found. Also there isn't a death registration so she presumably recovered.

Arthur (45) is a stonemason's labourer living at 9 Wild Street with Harriet (43), James (19) a hatter, Adelaide (10), and Annie (7). ■ Census for Stockport, Cheshire, in 1911. Arthur (55) is a mason's labourer living at 5 Bannister Street with Harriet (53) a cotton spinner, Adelaide (20) a confectioner, and Annie (17) a cotton spinner. Arthur and Harriet have been married 33 years and had 2 children, both living (this seems to be a misunderstanding of the census rules as they had 4 children, 2 living with them in 1911). Arthur died in Stockport, Cheshire, in 1926.

Arthur's birth was registered in 3q 1855 Altrincham 8a 152. His death was registered in 2q 1926 Stockport 8a 60, aged 70.

In 1876 when Arthur was 21, he married **Harriet Fallows** in Cheadle, St Mary, Cheshire. The marriage was registered in 3q 1876 Stockport 8a 24. Harriet was born in Hazel Grove, Cheshire, abt 1857. Harriet died in Stockport, Cheshire, in 1937.

Harry (22) is a bleacher living at 6 Birch Street, father John, a bleacher. The marriage was registered in 3q 1903 Stockport 8a 8. Harry was born in Cheadle, Cheshire, abt 1881.

John (44) is a brewer's drayman living at 4 John Alfred Street with Ann (45), Mary A (18), and Sarah A (15) cardroom hands, Josiah (10), and Elizabeth (5). ■ Census for Bolton, Lancashire, in 1911. John (52) is a carter at a brewery living at 4 John Alfred Street with Ann (53), Lizzie (15) a mill hand, Sarah Alice Robson (25), her husband Thomas Robson (25) and Joseph Robson (1). John and Ann have been married 28 years and had 5 children, 4 living. Sarah and Thomas have been married 3 years and had one child still living. John died in Bolton, Lancashire, in 1925.

John's baptism was probably that registered in 2q 1858 Altrincham 8a 156. His death was probably that registered in 1q 1925 Bolton 8c 532, aged 66.

Walter's birth was registered in 4q 1878 Bolton 8c 445, mother's maiden name Heaton. His death was registered in 3q 1947 Bolton 10b 456.

In 1904 when Walter was 25, he married **Margaret Fairhurst** in Bolton, St George the Martyr,

William Eric died in Manchester, Lancashire, on 24 May 1982.

William's birth was registered in 2q 1898 Salford 8d 47, mother's maiden name Holt. His death was registered in 2q 1982 Manchester 38 1133, aged 84.

William is married in the 1939 Register so had a wife before Isabella. The most likely marriage is between William E Warburton and Louisa Payne who married in 1927 at the Union Chapel, Rochdale Road, Queens Park, registered in 3q 1927 Manchester North 8d 1610.

In 1924 when William Eric was 25, he first married **Edith Alice Logue** in Chorlton-on-Medlock Register Office or Registrar Attended, Lancashire. The marriage was registered in 2q 1924 Chorlton 8c 1936. Eric and Edith had no children.

He is at 9 Knowsley, Billings End, Road, Pleasington with Jesse Worrall (born 5th November 1875) a retired surveyor, and Patricia Warburton or Worrall (born 17th March 1910). No matching birth registration has been found for Patricia. Herbert Saunders died in Culcheth, Lancashire, on 4 Jan 1958.

Herbert's birth was registered in 2q 1904 Salford 8d 160, mother's maiden name Saunders. His death was registered in 1q 1958 Newton 10f 21, aged 53. Probate for Herbert Saunders of 101 Wigshaw Lane, Culcheth, Warrington was granted to James Hacking, chartered accountant. His effects were £3,874 11s 4d.

In 1932 when Herbert Saunders was 27, he married **Gladys Whittingham** in Worsley, St Mark, Lancashire. The marriage was registered in 2q 1932 Barton upon Irwell 8c 1209. Gladys was born on 6 Jan 1900. ■ Census for Worsley, Lancashire, in 1939. Gladys is living at 23 Egerton Park with Emily Whittingham born 9th January 1866, and Annie Whittingham born 20th December 1889, and single. These are probably her mother and sister. Also present is Ellen MacFarlane born 2nd October 1934. Gladys died in Worsley, Lancashire, on 11 May 1977.

Gladys's death was registered in 2q 1977 Barton upon Irwell 39 735. Administration was granted for Gladys of 23 Egerton Park, Worsley. Her effects were £16,181.

Arthur (19) is a warehouse clerk living at 82 Chester Road with his widowed step mother Phoebe (38) a confectioner, and a boarder. ■ Census for Sale, Cheshire, in 1939. Arthur is an agent (ladies wear) living at Green Gables, 41 Hillington Road with Winifred, Leonard A a representative in the family business, and Ronald E a salesman (soft furnishings). Arthur died on 29 May 1973.

Arthur's birth was registered in 3q 1891 Maclesfield 8a 113, mother's maiden name Joule. His death was registered in 2q 1973 Bucklow 10a 299.

Arthur served in the Shropshire Yeomanry in WW1. In 1925 he established a business in Manchester as a Ladies Fashion Agent. His sons Len and Ron later joined the business, Len in 1936, and Ron in 1940, and the business became Arthur Warburton & Sons, Fashion Agents (for ladies coats, suits, dresses & ensembles). Both sons retired in 1982 when the business closed.

On 14 Nov 1914 when Arthur was 23, he married **Winifred Freda Rickelton** in Chorlton on Medlock, Union Chapel, Lancashire. Winifred Freda was born in Chorlton on Medlock, Lancashire, on 17 Oct 1892. Winifred Freda died in Sale, Cheshire, on 29 Jan 1971.

James (30) is a packer in a bleach works living at 8 Buckley Street, Edgeley with Ellen Jane (31), Harry (4), and a lodger. James and Ellen have been married 9 years, and had 3 children, one living. James Hermon died in 1949.

James's birth was registered in 1q 1882 Stockport 8a 56. His death was registered in 2q 1949 Stockport 10a 563.

In 1902 when James Hermon was 20, he married **Ellen Jane Francis** in Stockport, St Matthew, Cheshire. The marriage was registered in 2q 1902 Stockport 8a 103. Ellen Jane was born in Birmingham, Warwickshire, abt 1880.

Seventh Generation

They had one child:

- i. **Harry Warburton**. Harry was born in Stockport, Cheshire, on 2 Jun 1907. Harry died in Stockport, Cheshire, in 1982.

Harry's birth was registered in 3q 1907 Stockport 8a 32. His death was registered in 4q 1982, aged 75. He appears on the 1939 Register at 68 Chapel Street with his parents. He is married but his wife isn't present. Possible marriages at Stockport are in 3q 1928 8a 183 to Doris Fairbrother, and 2q 1929 8a 45 to Edna Hammond.

Benjamin (21) is a cycle maker living at 7 Hill Street with Amelia (21) and Amelia (1 month). ■ Census for Hulme, Manchester, Lancashire, in 1911. Benjamin (31) is a cycle repairer living at 48 Byrom Street (5 rooms) with Amelia (31), Amelia (10), Benjamin (8), Edwin (6), Agnes (4), Thomas (3), and William (7 months). Benjamin nad Amelia had been married 10 years and had 6 children, all living. ■ Census for Manchester, Lancashire, in 1939. Benjamin is cycle maker and repairer, and wheel builder living at 195 Platt Lane with Amelia, Thomas a shipping warehouseman, Alfred a home trade warehouseman, and Stanley a showcard maker.

Benjamin's birth was registered in 1q 1880 Manchester 8d 306, mother's maiden name Ingham.

On 5 Jan 1901 when Benjamin was 21, he married **Amelia Shipley** in Hulme, St Philip, Lancashire. Benjamin (22) was a cycle maker from 2 Devonshire Street, father Peter, a confectioner. Amelia (21) was an umbrella maker from 5 Ripley Street, Hulme, father Edwin, a cabinet maker. Peter Warburton was a witness. The marriage was registered in 1q 1901 Chorlton 8c 1001. Amelia was born in Manchester, Lancashire, on 28 Mar 1880.

In 1929 when Benjamin was 26, he married **Constance Parsons** in Chorlton on Medlock Register Office or Registrar Attended, Lancashire. The marriage was registered in 3q 1929 Manchester South 8d 657. No children were registered with mother's maiden name Parsons. Constance was born on 24 Apr 1901. Constance died in Manchester, Lancashire, in 1979.

Constance's death was registered in 4q 1979 Manchester 38 1086, aged 78.
