PREFACE



This clan documents the ancestors of Leon Warburton, a DNA project participant. It is based on inputs from Leon, and his distant relations

Mark and Scott Warbuurton.

It consists of the descendants of William Warburton born in Marthall, Cheshire in 1760, one of the children of John. William moved to Audley in Staffordshire where he married in 1788.

It includes Rear Admiral Audley Lyne Warburton US Navy, who fought at Pear Harbour and on D-Day. His father Christopher had emigrated to Milwaukee, Wisconsin circa 1880.

The clan has since been matched with the Coppenhall clan, though the exact link has not been found.



First Generation

1. John Warburton. John died in Marthall, Cheshire, in 1797. He was buried in Over Peover, St Lawrence, Cheshire, on 3 Apr 1797.

John is described as a husbandman from Marthall on his children's baptisms. However no mother's name is given and there is no obviously related marriage, the closest being to Mary Baguely at Knutsford in 1753.

John married **Unknown**.

They had the following children:

 Ralph Warburton. Ralph was born in Marthall, Cheshire, in 1756. He was christened in Over Peover, St Lawrence, Cheshire, on 4 Jul 1756. Ralph died in Marthall, Cheshire, in 1762. He was buried in Over Peover, St Lawrence, Cheshire, on 5 Jul 1762.

According to his burial record, Ralph was drowned.

- ii. **John Warburton**. John was born in Marthall, Cheshire, in 1758. He was christened in Over Peover, St Lawrence, Cheshire, on 20 Aug 1758.
- **2** iii. **William Warburton** (1760-1827)
 - iv. Mary Warburton. Mary was born in Marthall, Cheshire, in 1763. She was christened in Over Peover, St Lawrence, Cheshire, on 30 Oct 1763. Mary died in Marthall, Cheshire, in 1795. She was buried in Over Peover, St Lawrence, Cheshire, on 25 Jan 1795.
 - v. **Judith Warburton**. Judith was born in Marthall, Cheshire, in 1766. She was christened in Over Peover, St Lawrence, Cheshire, on 3 Jan 1767. Judith died in Marthall, Cheshire, in 1791. She was buried in Over Peover, St Lawrence, Cheshire, on 23 Apr 1791.

Second Generation

2. William Warburton (John¹). William was born in Marthall, Cheshire, in 1760. He was christened in Over Peover, St Lawrence, Cheshire, on 21 Dec 1760. William died in Audley, Staffordshire, in 1827. He was buried in Audley, St James, Staffordshire, on 31 Aug 1827.

William was aged 66 from Ravens Lane on his burial record. This is the correct age for the William baptised at Over Peover. The fact this William had a brother called Ralph, a name used by William of Audley and his descendants, makes it probable they are the same William.

On 8 Jan 1788 when William was 28, he married **Elizabeth (Betty) Bowers** in Audley, St James, Staffordshire. Elizabeth was called Betty on the marriage record, but Elizabeth on the baptisms of her children. It is the only marriage of a William at Audley and the date fits with the birth of their first child.

They had the following children:

- i. Ralph Warburton (1790-1868)
 - ii. **John Warburton**. John was born in Audley, Staffordshire, on 20 May 1792. He was christened in Audley, St James, Staffordshire, on 10 Jun 1792.

John and his brother Joseph moved to Tunstall to work in the pottery industry. They lived in houses owned by their brother Ralph.

- **4** iii. **Joseph Warburton** (1794-1853)
- 5 iv. **William Warburton** (1797-1869)
 - v. **Mary Warburton**. Mary was born in Audley, Staffordshire, on 28 Feb 1799. She was christened in Audley, St James, Staffordshire, on 24 Mar 1799. Mary died in Audley, Staffordshire, on 28 Jun 1829. She was buried in Audley, St James, Staffordshire, on 30 Jun 1829.

Mary was living in Ravens Lane at the time of her death. She was buried aged 30.

On 23 Feb 1819 when Mary was 19, she married **William Goodwin** in Sandbach, St Mary, Cheshire. William and Mary were both 'of this parish'. John Warburton and Hannah Goodwin (probably siblings of the bride and groom) were witnesses. William and Mary lived in Ravens Lane, Audley. They had six children all christened at Audley, St.James. Mary died shortly after giving birth to the sixth in 1829, the baby died soon after. William was born in Betchton, Sandbach, Cheshire, in 1798.

vi. **Sarah Warburton**. Sarah was born in Audley, Staffordshire, on 2 Feb 1800. She was buried in Audley, Staffordshire, in 1886.

Sarah's baptism isn't recorded at Audley.

An inscription on Sarah's father's tomb reads: "Sarah Hay relict of the late David

Second Generation

Hay paymaster of the 88th Regiment {The Connaught Rangers} who died on the island of Malta 5th March 1841.

Sarah married David Hay. David died in Malta on 5 Mar 1841.

vii. **George Warburton**. George was born in Audley, Staffordshire, on 10 Feb 1803. He was christened in Audley, St James, Staffordshire, on 13 Mar 1803.

Third Generation

3. Ralph Warburton (William², John¹). Ralph was born in Audley, Staffordshire, in 1790. He was christened in Audley, St James, Staffordshire, on 14 Feb 1790. Ralph died in 1868.

Ralph owned Diglake Farm in Audley. The farm was still in the family 100 years later when Ralph's great great nephew Ralph was born there. Ralph's death was registered in 2q 1868 Newcastle under Lyme b 44, aged 78.

On 26 Feb 1811 when Ralph was 21, he married **Hannah White** in Audley, St James, Staffordshire.

They had one child:

- i. **James Warburton**. James was born in 1812. James died in Audley, Staffordshire, in 1824. He was buried in Audley, St James, Staffordshire, on 9 Jul 1824.
- **4. Joseph Warburton** (William², John¹). Joseph was born in Audley, Staffordshire, on 16 Aug 1794. He was christened in Audley, St James, Staffordshire, on 7 Sep 1794. Census for Tunstall, Staffordshire, in 1841. Joseph (45) is a labourer living with Hannah (10), and James (10).
- Census for Burslem, Staffordshire, in 1851. Joseph (54) is a labourer lodging with Jane and Helen Miles. Joseph died in 1853. He was buried in Shelton, St Mark, Staffordshire, on 27 Apr 1853.

Joseph and his brother John moved to Tunstall to work in the pottery industry. They lived in houses owned by their brother Ralph.

Joseph's marriage has not been found. His burial is possibly that recorded at Shelton, St Mark on 27th April 1853, aged 58. The age is correct and it follows his last census appearance.

Little is known of his family. He is in the 1841 census with 2 children, Hannah and James, both aged 10 (1841 ages were rounded down, though children were supposed to be correct). The baptism of Hannah daughter of Joseph and Frances of Ravens Lane links him to the rest of the family, but no details of a marriage to Frances, or of her death have been found. James is only known from the 1841 census. He might have just been visiting. No baptism has ben found.

Joseph married Frances.

They had the following children:

i. **Hannah Warburton**. Hannah was born in Audley, Staffordshire, in 1828. She was christened in Audley, St James, Staffordshire, on 4 Jan 1829.

Hannah is the daughter of Joseph and Frances of Ravens Lane on her baptism.

ii. James Warburton. James was born in Audley, Staffordshire, abt 1831.

James is only known from his presence in the 1841 census.

5. William Warburton (William², John¹). William was born in Audley, Staffordshire, on 7 Jan 1797. He was christened in Audley, St James, Staffordshire, on 29 Jan 1797. ■ Census for Audley, Staffordshire, in 1841. William (45) is a brick m[aker] living in Ravens Lane with Hannah (43), Julia (19), Louisa (14), Christopher (11), Frederic (7), Wilmot (5), Elizabeth (3), and Sabina (3 mths). ■ Census for Audley, Staffordshire, in 1851. William (54) is a brick maker living in Ravens Lane with Hannah (53), Christopher (21) brick maker, Wilmot (15) brick maker's assistant, Sabina (10), daughter Julia Smith (29), Elizabeth Smith (10 mths), grandson Frederic (3), father-in-law Thomas Browning, and a servant. ■ Census for Audley, Staffordshire, in 1861. William (64) is a brick and tile manufacturer living in Ravens Lane with Hannah (63), Sabina (20), and grandson Frederic (13). William died in Audley, Staffordshire, in 1869.

William's death was registered in 1q 1869 Newcastle under Lyme 6b 64, aged 72.

On 13 Feb 1820 when William was 23, he married **Hannah Browning** in Norton in the Moors, St Bartholemew, Staffordshire. It is not clear why the marriage was in Norton in the Moors as Hannah is from Audley in the censuses, but the date fits with the birth of their first child, and there is no other William and Hannah marriage in Staffordshire at this time. Hannah was born in Audley, Staffordshire, abt 1797. Hannah died in Audley, Staffordshire, in 1870.

Hannah's death was registered in 3q 1870 Newcastle under Lyme 6b 64, aged 72.

They had the following children:

- 8 iii. George Warburton (1828-)
 - iv. Louisa Warburton. Louisa was born in Audley, Staffordshire, on 20 Jun 1827. She was christened in Audley, St James, Staffordshire, on 3 Aug 1828. Louisa died on 5 Feb 1905.

Louisa's death was registered in 1q 1905 Newcastle under Lyme 6b 54, aged 77.

In 1844 when Louisa was 16, she married **Charles Smith** in Stoke, St Peter, Staffordshire. Charles and Louise had 18 children. Charles was born in Audley, Staffordshire, on 2 Nov 1818. Charles died in Audley, Staffordshire, on 23 Jun 1907.

Charles's death was registered in 2q 1907 Newcastle under Lyne 6b 44, aged 88.

- 9 v. Christopher Warburton (~1830-1918)
 - vi. **Frederick Warburton**. Frederick was born in Audley, Staffordshire, in 1833. He was christened in Audley, St James, Staffordshire, on 22 Sep 1833.
- 10 vii. Wilmot Warburton (~1836-1862)
 - viii. **Elizabeth Warburton**. Elizabeth was born in Audley, Staffordshire, in 1838. She was christened in Audley, St James, Staffordshire, on 18 Feb 1838.
 - ix. **Sabina Warburton**. Sabina was born in Audley, Staffordshire, in 1841. She was christened in Audley, St James, Staffordshire, on 25 Jan 1846.

Sabina and Moses lived in Tunstall, Ecclestone, Lancashire, and Crewe, Cheshire, having at least 4 children. Moses died, though his death registration hasn't been found, and Sabina emigrated to the USA with a son and a daughter and settled in Wisconsin near nephew Christopher.

In 1861 when Sabina was 20, she married **Moses Barlow** in Burslem, St John, Staffordshire. The marriage was registered in 4q 1861 Wolstanton 6b 121.

Fourth Generation

6. Ralph Warburton (William³, William², John¹). Ralph was born in Audley, Staffordshire, in 1820. He was christened in Audley, St James, Staffordshire, on 4 Aug 1822. ■ Census for Audley, Staffordshire, in 1871. Ralph (51) is a brick maker living in Ravens Lane with Ann (50), John (23) a coal miner, Hannah (14), Ralph (8), and Wilmot (5). Ralph died in 1904.

Ralph and Julia were baptised on the same day but it isn't known if they were twins. Ralph's date of birth is 1820 based on his census age in 1871 and his age at death. His death was registered in 3q 1904 Newcastle under Lyme 6b 43, aged 84.

In 1840 when Ralph was 20, he married **Ann Colclough** in Wolstanton, St Margaret, Staffordshire.

They had the following children:

- i. John Warburton. John was born in Audley, Staffordshire, abt 1847.
- ii. Hannah Warburton. Hannah was born in Audley, Staffordshire, abt 1856.
- **11** iii. **Ralph Warburton** (~1862-1906)

- **7. Julia Warburton** (William³, William², John¹). Julia was born in Audley, Staffordshire, abt 1822. She was christened in Audley, St James, Staffordshire, on 4 Aug 1822.

Ralph and Julia were baptised on the same day but it isn't known if they were twins.

She first did not marry **Unknown**.

They had one child:

i. Frederick George Warburton (1847-)

In 1849 when Julia was 27, she second married **Jonathan Smith** in Manchester, St Thomas Red Bank, Lancashire. The marriage was registered in 2q 1849 Manchester 20 701.

8. George Warburton (William³, William², John¹). George was born in Audley, Staffordshire, in 1828. He was christened in Audley, St James, Staffordshire, on 3 Aug 1828.

George farmed at Wyn Bank farm.

Child:

i. Daughter Warburton.

Daughter married Glover.

9. Christopher Warburton (William³, William², John¹). Christopher was born in Audley, Staffordshire, abt 1830. He was christened in Audley, St James, Staffordshire, on 22 Sep 1833. ■ Census for Audley, Staffordshire, in 1861. Christopher (31) is a brick and tile manufacturer living in

Audley village with Emily (24), Harry (6), Elizabeth Ann (4), Georgina (1), and 2 servants. ■ Census for Audley, Staffordshire, in 1871. Christopher (41) is a brick and tile manufacturer living with Emily (34), Harry (16), Elizabeth (14), Georgina (12), Christopher (9), Emily Frances (7), Evaline Emma (2), William Edwin (4 mths, and nephew Wilmot Andrew (9). ■ Census for Audley, Staffordshire, in 1881. Christopher (51) is widowed a brick and pipe manufacturer living with Harry (26) a brick and pipe manufacturer, Elizabeth A (24), Evaline (12), William E (10), and Clara H (8). ■ Census for Audley, Staffordshire, in 1891. Christopher (61) is widowed surveyor living in Church Street with Elizabeth A (33) no occupation, Emily (24) a school mistress, William E (21) an assisitant surveyor, and Clara H (18) a school mistress. ■ Census for Whitwell, Derbyshire, in 1901. Christopher (71) is a retired surveyor living with daughter Clara Hannah Barber (28) and her family. ■ Census for Hornsea, East Yorkshire, in 1911. Christopher (82) is a retired engineer and surveyor living at 8 Wilton Terrace with Elizabeth Anna (49), and William Edwin (39) a cicil engineer manager. William and Elizabeth are unmarried. Christopher has had nine children, seven still living. Christopher died in Hornsea, East Yorkshire, in 1918.

Christopher's death was registered in 2q 1918 Skirlaugh 9d 420, aged 89.

In 1854 when Christopher was 24, he married **Emily Smith** in Tunstall, Christ Church, Staffordshire. The marriage was registered in 3q 1854 Wolstanton 6b 142. Emily was born in Audley, Staffordshire, abt 1836. Emily died in Audley, Staffordshire, in 1874.

Emily's death was registered in 2q 1874 Newcastle under Lyme 6b 43, aged 37.

Fourth Generation

They had the following children:

i. Harry Warburton. Harry was born in Audley, Staffordshire, in 1855.

Harry's birth was registered in 1q 1855 Newcastle under Lyme 6b 63.

 Elizabeth Ann Warburton. Elizabeth Ann was born in Audley, Staffordshire, in 1856.

Elizabeth's birth was registered in 1q 1857 Newcastle under Lyme 6b 58.

iii. **Georgina Warburton**. Georgina was born in Audley, Staffordshire, in 1859. Georgina died in Nebraska in 1933.

Georgina's birth was registered in 2q 1859 Newcastle under Lyme 6b 73. She followed her brother to the USA. her Sutherland descendants live in California.

Georgina married **Sutherland**.

- iv. Christopher Booth Warburton (1861-1942)
 - v. **Emily Frances Warburton**. Emily Frances was born in Audley, Staffordshire, in 1864.

Emily's birth was registered in 2q 1864 Newcastle under Lyme 6b 77.

vi. **Eveline Emma Warburton**. Eveline Emma was born in Audley, Staffordshire, in 1869.

Eveline's birth was registered in 1q 1869 Newcastle under Lyme 6b 74.

vii. **William Edwin Warburton**. William Edwin was born in Audley, Staffordshire, in 1870.

William's birth was registered in 1q 1871 Newcastle under Lyme 6b 78.

viii. **Clara Hannah Warburton**. Clara Hannah was born in Audley, Staffordshire, in 1872.

Clara's birth was registered in 2q 1872 Newcastle under Lyme 6b 79.

In 1899 when Clara Hannah was 27, she married **Edward Hazeldine Barber** in Suffolk. The marriage was registered in 2q 1899 Wangford 4a 1852. Edward Hazeldine was born in Rawtenstall, Lancashire, abt 1869.

ix. Eleanor Warburton. Eleanor was born in Audley, Staffordshire, in 1874.

Eleanor's birth was registered in 1q 1874 Newcastle under Lyme 6b 89.

10. Wilmot Warburton (William³, William², John¹). Wilmot was born in Audley, Staffordshire, abt 1836. He was christened in Audley, St James, Staffordshire, on 12 Feb 1837. Wilmot died in New York State, in 1862.

Fourth Generation

In 1861 when Wilmot was 25, he married Margaret Bayne in New York State.

They had one child:

 Wilmot Andrew Warburton. Wilmot Andrew was born in New York State, in Dec 1861. ■ Census for Monks Coppenhall, Cheshire, in 1881. Wilmot (19) is a railway clerk boarding with John and Sarah Robinson and their family at 28 Gatefield Street. Wilmot Andrew died in 1913.

Wilmot got a job on the railway at Crewe, and lodged in Monks Coppenhall. He then returned to the USA and worked in a large insurance company possibly owned by his mothers family.

He is presumed to have divorced as Jessie is referred to in his Will as his former wife. No children are mentioned in his will.

He evidently prospered as he purchased a large fruit plantation and spent the winters there. He was also a mason and a member of many similar organisations. He died suddenly of what was described in his obituary as indigestion.

On 10 Aug 1887 when Wilmot Andrew was 25, he married **Jessie Gertrude Smith** in New York, NY.

11. Ralph Warburton (Ralph⁴, William³, William², John¹). Ralph was born in Audley, Staffordshire, abt 1862. ■ Census for Audley, Staffordshire, in 1901. Ralph (38) is a colliery brakesman living with his father-in-law Jonathan Smith (41), a widowed farmer, Jonathan's mother Julia Smith (79), his wife Marion (45), and Ralph (2). Ralph died in Audley, Staffordshire, in 1906.

Ralph's birth registration has not been found. His death was registered in 4q 1906 Newcastle under Lyme 6b 42, aged 44.

In 1897 when Ralph was 35, he married **Marion Smith** in Talke, St Martin, Staffordshire.

They had one child:

- **15** i. **Ralph Warburton** (1899-1986)
- **12. Wilmot Warburton** (Ralph⁴, William³, William², John¹). Wilmot was born in Audley, Staffordshire, in 1865. Census for Audley, Staffordshire, in 1911. Wilmot (45) is a coal miner living at 45 Ravens Lane with Kate (32), Wilmot (2), Norah (5), and Mary (4). Wilmot and Kate have been married 7 years and had three children, all living.

In 1904 when Wilmot was 39, he married **Kate Elizabeth Bailey** in Audley, St James, Staffordshire. The marriage was registered in 2q 1904 Newcastle under Lyme 6b 95.

Fifth Generation

They had the following children:

 Norah Warburton. Norah was born in Audley, Staffordshire, abt 1905. Norah died in Audley, Staffordshire, on 25 Dec 1912.

Norah died of scarlet fever. Her death was registered in 4q 1912 Wolstanton 6b 83.

ii. Mary Warburton. Mary was born in Audley, Staffordshire, abt 1906. Mary died in 1981

In 1931 when Mary was 25, she married **Harry Booth** in Audley, St James, Staffordshire. The marriage was registered in 3q 1931 Newcastle under Lyme 6b 107. Harry was a tenant farmer and they lived in Scholar Green, Cheshire. They had a boy and a girl.

 Wilmot Warburton. Wilmot was born in Audley, Staffordshire, abt 1908. Wilmot died in 1990.

Wilmot was a coal miner and survived the Holditch Colliery disaster which killed 36 miners.

In 1938 when Wilmot was 30, he married **Florance Parton** in Newcastle, St George, Staffordshire. The marriage was registered in 2q 1938 Newcastle under Lyme 6b 206. Wilmot and Florence had a boy and a girl.

 George Warburton. George was born in Audley, Staffordshire, in 1911. George died in 1980.

George was the father of Leon, my contact and DNA project participant. He was a coal miner.

In 1944 when George was 33, he married **Freda Chesworth** in Audley, St James, Staffordshire. The marriage was registered in 1q 1944 Newcastle under Lyme 6b 99.

- **16** v. **Henry James Warburton** (1915-1981)
- **13. Frederick George Warburton** (Julia⁴, William³, William², John¹). Frederick George was born in Audley, Staffordshire, in 1847. Census for Tunstall, Staffordshire, in 1891. Fredrick G (43) is a colliery accountant living in Ravenscliff Road with Anne (45), Fredrick G (20) an iron merchants clerk, Marion Annie (18) a governess, Alice Maude May (17), Gertrude Emily (14), Jessie Eveline (13) and a servant.

Frederic's birth was registered in 2q 1847 Newcastle under Lyme 17 96. Staffordshire BMD has the sub district as Audley and mother's maiden name Warburton.

In 1867 when Frederick George was 20, he married **Ann Smallwood** in Hartshill, Holy Trinity, Staffordshire. Ann was born in Lawton, Cheshire, abt 1845.

 - ii. Marion Annie Warburton. Marion Annie was born in Alsager, Cheshire, in 1872.

Marion's birth was registered in 4q 1872 Congleton 8a 293.

iii. Alice Maude May Warburton. Alice Maude May was born in Alsager, Cheshire, abt 1874.

Alice's birth was registered in 1q 1874 Congleton 8a 311.

iv. **Gertrude Emily Warburton**. Gertrude Emily was born in Alsager, Cheshire, in 1876.

Gertrude's birth was registered in 2q 1876 Congleton 8a 342.

v. **Jessie Eveline Warburton**. Jessie Eveline was born in Alsager, Cheshire, abt 1878.

Jessie's birth was registered in 1q 1878 Congleton 8a 321.

14. Christopher Booth Warburton (Christopher⁴, William³, William², John¹). Christopher Booth was born in Audley, Staffordshire, on 15 Dec 1861. ■ Census for Milwaukee, WI, in 1900. Christopher (37) is an R.R. (Railroad) Engineer living at 355 29th Avenue (owned and paid for) with Charlotte (35), Mabel (17), Francis (12), Evelyn (10), and Harrison (7). Christopher and Charlotte have been married 12 years (sic) and had 6 children, 4 still living. ■ Census for Milwaukee, WI, in 1910. Christopher B (48) is a Local Railroad Engineer living at 391 29th Avenue (owned but mortgaged) with Charlotte G (45), Francis I (21) a piano teacher, Evelyn A (19), Harrison C (17), and Audley S (9). Christopher and Charlotte have been married 29 years and had 7 children, 5 still living. ■ Census for Milwaukee, WI, in 1920. Christopher (57) is Railway Engineer living at 391 29th Avenue (owned and paid for) with Charlotte (54), Franckie (32) a school teacher, Evelyn (28) a school teacher, Harriy (26), and Audley (19). ■ Census for Milwaukee, WI, in 1930. Christopher (68) is Locomotive Engineer living at 1014 Downer Avenue (rented at \$75 per month) with Charlotte (65), Franckie (38) a graded school teacher, Evelyn (36) a graded school teacher, and Harriy (34) a malted milk salesman. Christopher Booth died in Milwaukee, WI, on 9 Feb 1942. He was buried in Milwaukee, Forest Home Cemetery, WI.

Christopher's birth was registered in 1q 1862 Newcastle under Lyme 6b 63, mother's maiden name Smith. The US Naturalisation Index states he was born on December 15th 1862, but his registration record implies this should be 1861. It also sates that Christopher arrived in the US on May 12th 1882 at Port Huron and was naturalised in October 6th 1914. However some census records state he arrived in 1880, and the 1910 census says he was married 29 years, implying he married in 1881.

Charlotte is Charlotte Lyne on her husbands death notice, but Find A Grave gives her maiden name as Jahn. This is presumed to be a misreading of Lyne.

Charlotte's obituary staes she died at home, 2320 E Bradford Avenue, after a short illness. She was the widow of Christopher who was for many years an engineer for the Milwaukee R[ailr]oad. She was survived by two sons, including Audley, Commander of the supply ship USS Guadaloupe of the 7th US Fleet., and two daughters who teach in Milwaukee Public schools.

vii. **Audley Lyne Warburton**. Audley Lyne was born in Milwaukee, WI, on 24 Aug 1900. Audley Lyne died in Miami, FL, on 7 Apr 1974. He was buried in US Navy Academy Cemetery, Annapolis, MA.

Audley served for 32 years ic the US Navy, reaching the reank of Rear Admiral. He graduated from the US Naval Academy in 1924 On 6th December 1941 he took command of the gunboat USS Sacramento, and saw action during the Japanese attack the following day. He also commanded a force of landing craft attacking Utah beach on D Day. He remained in the navy until he retired to Miami, Florida in
