PREFACE

This tree is the clan of Eric Warburton of The Lancashire Group. It is taken from Eric's own family tree which I have modified to focus on the Warburtons and match the style of other trees. Eric is from a branch of the family who emigrated to Massachusetts.

However one branch of the tree, descending from Jonathan, son of William and Mary nee Yates, proved incorrect and has been replaced by the descendants of Jonathan and Anne nee Siddall that is described on an Ancestry Tree by Laura Vizard.

1. William Warburton.

William's first wife is assumed to be Ann as the only wife of William buried at Bury in the 10 years before his second marriage was named Ann.

There were two mariages of a William and Ann at Bury in the 20 years before Ann died, These were to Ann Taylor in 1796, and Ann Beckett in 1799. Ann Taylor is the most likely because the only child of William and Ann who was baptised in the relevant period was born before the second marriage, and had an abode of Bury which is the same as Ann's on her burial. Furthermore the William who married Ann Taylor was a soldier, while the William who married Ann Beckett was a weaver. As William was subsequently described as a dyer it seems more likely an ex-soldier would train as a dyer than someone who was already skilled as a weaver.

The baptisms of his children would suggest he first lived in Elton which was his abode on the baptisms of Jonathan and the first Richard. Between September 1804 and November 1805 he moved to Rochdale, which was his abode on the baptisms of Joseph, and a second Richard, which still took place at Bury. Walter was baptised at Edenfield with an abode of Shuttleworth suggesting William had moved back to the Ramsbottom area by then.

Walter is shown to belong to the same family by his presence in the 1891 and 1901 censuses living with Mathew Dilworth, whose wife Elizabeth was the daughter of his sister Harriet. Harriet's own baptism is confusing as it took place when she was 20 years old, at Bury, but with an abode of Spotland in Rochdale.

George and William are assumed to belong to the family because their parents, and father's occupation are the same, though they have now moved again to Oxhey (it is not clear exactly where this is). Also on George's marriage is father is William, a dyer. However it must be noted thet if the burial and age at death for Mary in 1829 are correct she would be rather old at 49 when William was born.

On 2 Feb 1796 William first married **Ann Taylor** in Bury, St Mary, Lancashire. William was a soldier of the parish, Ann a spinster of the parish. Ann died in Bury, Lancashire, on 9 May 1801. She was buried in Bury, St Mary, Lancashire, on 11 May 1801.

They had one child:

i. Mary Warburton. Mary was born in Bury, Lancashire, on 31 Aug 1799. She was christened in Bury, St Mary, Lancashire, on 6 Oct 1799.

On 22 Mar 1802 William second married Mary Yates in Bury, St Mary, Lancashire. William was a

widower of the parish, Mary a spinster of the parish. John Warburton was a witness. Mary was born abt 1774. Mary died in Holcombe, Lancashire, in 1829. She was buried in Bury, St Mary, Lancashire, on 8 Jan 1829.

This is a probable burial for Mary who was described as the wife of William, aged 55 on her burial record.

They had the following children:

- 2 i. Jonathan Warburton (1802-1873)
 - Richard Warburton. Richard was born in Elton, Lancashire, on 27 Aug 1804. He was christened in Bury, St Mary, Lancashire, on 27 Aug 1804. Richard died in Bury, Lancashire, on 26 Sep 1804. He was buried in Bury, St Mary, Lancashire, on 26 Sep 1804.
- 3 iii. Joseph Warburton (1805-1882)
- 4 iv. Richard Warburton (1808-1886)
 - v. **Harriet Warburton**. Harriet was born in Spotland, Rochdale, Lancashire, on 20 Jan 1810. She was christened in Bury, St Mary, Lancashire, on 2 May 1830.

Curiously Harriet was baptised aged 20 when she was described as the daughter of William amd Mary. William is a dyer from Spotland.

On 27 May 1831 when Harriet was 21, she married **Richard Coop** in Bury, St Mary, Lancashire. Harriet and Richard had seven sons and four daughters. One daughter, Elizabeth Alice, married Matthew Dilworth and her Uncle Walter is living with them in 1891 and 1901. Richard was born in Bury, Lancashire, abt 1810.

- 6 vii. George Warburton (1818-1864)
 - viii. William Warburton. William was born in 1823. He was christened in Holcombe, Emmanuel Chapel, Lancashire, on 28 Dec 1823.

William's father is described as a dyer from Oxhey on his baptism. No census entry, or likely burial record, has been found for William.

2. Jonathan Warburton (*William*¹). Jonathan was born in Elton, Lancashire, on 11 Aug 1802. He was christened in Bury, St Mary, Lancashire, on 3 Oct 1802. ■ Census for Elton, Lancashire, in 1841. Jonathan (30) is a blacksmith living in Brooksmouth with Ann (30), Edmund (11), Joseph (9), Sarah (5), Thomas (3), Berry (8 mths), and Sarah Berry (14) a cotton piecer. ■ Census for Elton, Lancashire, in 1851. Jonathan (46) is a blacksmith living in Waterloo Street with Ann (43), Joseph (19) a carter, Sarah (15), Thomas (12) a cotton doffer, and Samuel (8). ■ Census for Elton, Lancashire, in 1861. Jonathan (55) is a blacksmith living 10 Jackson Street with Ann (54), Joseph (29) a carter at Colliery, and Thomas (23) a blacksmith. ■ Census for Elton, Lancashire, in 1871. Jonathan (67) is an unemployed blacksmith living 18 Victoria Street with Ann (66 recorded as blind), Joseph (40) a carter, son-in-law James Lowe (44) a labourer, daughter Sarah Ann Lowe (34) a quilter, and a boarder. Jonathan died in Bury, Lancashire, in 1873.

Jonathan's death was registered in 3q 1873 Bury 8c 300, aged 70.

On 9 Nov 1828 when Jonathan was 26, he married **Hannah (Anne) Siddall** in Bury, St Mary, Lancashire. Jonathan was a blacksmith of the parish. Anne's name was transcribed as Seddon, but in the image it looks more like Seddow. Joseph Warburton was a witness. Hannah (Anne) was born in Whitefield, Lancashire, on 17 Nov 1807. She was christened in Prestwich, St Mary, Lancashire, on 13 Dec 1807. Hannah (Anne) died in Elton, Lancashire, in 1878. She was buried in Elton, All Saints, Lancashire, on 1 Jun 1878.

Hannah was known as Ann(e), but baptised Hannah illegitimate daughter of Mark Berry and Sally Siddall.

Ann's death was registered in 2q 1878 Bury 8c 314, aged 73.

They had the following children:

i. Mark Berry. Mark was born in Elton, Lancashire, on 8 Jul 1827. He was christened in Bury, St Mary, Lancashire, on 12 Jul 1827. Mark died in Elton, Lancashire, in 1828. He was buried in Bury, St Mary, Lancashire, on 19 Jul 1828.

Mark was baptised and buries as the son of Jonathan Warburton, blacksmith, and Ann Berry. Jonathan and Ann married i4 months after he died.

7 ii. Edmund Warburton (1830-1896)

iii. **Joseph Warburton**. Joseph was born in Elton abt 1831. Joseph died in Bury, Lancashire, in 1877.

Joseph's death was registered in 1q 1877 Bury 8c 372, aged 45.

On 23 Aug 1863 when Joseph was 32, he married **Elizabeth Jepson** in Elton, All Saints, Lancashire. Joseph (32) was a carter from Elton, father Jonathan, a blacksmith. Elizabeth (30) was from Elton, farther Nathan, a bleacher. Thomas Warburton was a bleacher. Elizabeth was born abt 1833. Elizabeth died in Bury, Lancashire, in 1868. She was buried in Bury, St Paul, Lancashire, on 7 Jun 1868.

Joseph is a widower in the 1871 census, so Elizabeth's death is probably that registered in 2q 1868 Bury 8c 275, aged 35. An Elizabeth was buried at Elton the year before but her age of 37 is a little high.

iv. James Warburton. James was born in Elton, Lancashire, on 12 Jan 1834. He was christened in Bury, St Mary, Lancashire, on 14 Jan 1834.

James was baptised the son of Jonathan, a blacksmith from Elton, and Ann.

v. Sarah Ann Warburton. Sarah Ann was born in Bury, Lancashire, abt 1836.

Sarah Ann married James Lowe.

- vi. Thomas Warburton. Thomas was born in Elton, Lancashire, in 1838.
- vii. **Berry Warburton**. Berry was born in Elton, Lancashire, on 22 Nov 1840. Berry died in Elton, Lancashire, in Oct 1848.

Berry's birth was registered as the son of Jonathan, a blacksmith at Brooksmouth, and Ann, formerly Berry.

8 viii. Samuel Warburton (1843-)

3. Joseph Warburton (*William*¹). Joseph was born in Rochdale, Lancashire, on 28 Nov 1805. He was christened in Bury, St Mary, Lancashire, on 26 Jan 1806. ■ Census for Elton, Lancashire, in 1841. Joseph (35) is a cotton printer living at Dairy Field with Alice (35), Selina (13) a cotton winder, Alice (11) a cotton spinner, Mary (9), Pamela (7), Lucy (5), Elizabeth (2), and Taylor (1). ■ Census

for Elton, Lancashire, in 1851. Joseph (45) is a calico block printer living at Higher Woodhill with Alice (45), Selina (22) a cotton reeler, Mary (18) a throstle spinner, Pamela (16) a cotton reeler, Lucy (13) a throstle spinner, Elizabeth (11), and Taylor (9). Joseph died in Chicopee, Hampden Co, Massachusetts, on 30 Dec 1882.

Joseph emigrated to Massachusetts but the date is unknown. He did not travel with his four children in 1863, and has not been found in the1861 census when the four children are living in the family home. He may already have been in America.

On 25 Jun 1827 when Joseph was 21, he first married **Alice Townson** in Bury, St Mary, Lancashire. Joseph was a calico printer and batchelor, Alice was a spinster. Witness was Richard Warburton. Alice was born in Summerseat, Lancashire, on 1 Mar 1806. She was christened in Bury, St Mary, Lancashire, on 25 May 1806. Alice died in Elton, Lancashire, in 1854.

Alice was the daughter of John and Ann nee Smith. Her death was registered in 2 q 1854 Bury 8c 245, aged 48 on LancashireBMD.

They had the following children:

i. **Selina Warburton**. Selina was born in Chatterton, Lancashire, abt 1829. Selina died in Chicopee, Hampden Co, Massachusetts, on 27 Apr 1881.

Selina arrived in New York on the Hecla on August 10th 1863 with her siblings Taylor, Elizabeth, and Lucy, and Taylor's bride Alice. She lived in Chicopee, Hampden, MA.

On 24 Nov 1864 when Selina was 35, she first married **William Banks** in Chicopee, Hampden Co, Massachusetts. William was born in England abt 1830. William died in Chicopee, Hampden Co, Massachusetts, on 23 May 1868.

William's parents were Robert and Ann nee Sharp.

On 10 Jun 1876 when Selina was 47, she second married **Charles Walmsley** in Chicopee, Hampden Co, Massachusetts. Charles was born in England abt 1815. Charles died in Chicopee, Hampden Co, Massachusetts, on 1 Sep 1891.

Charles was the son of John and Mary nee Parks.

ii. Alice Warburton. Alice was born abt 1830.

Alice is only known from her presence in the 1841 census. She is not present in 1851 but there is no matching marriage or death registration.

iii. Mary Warburton. Mary was born in Holcombe, Lancashire, abt 1833.

Mary has not been researched after 1851.

iv. Pamela Warburton. Pamela was born in Irwell Springs, Lancashire, abt 1835.

In 1859 when Pamela was 24, she married **Robert Purcell** in Bury Register Office or Registrar attended, Lancashire. The marriage was registered in 2q 1859 Bury 8c 489. Pamela and Robert had a son.

v. Lucy Warburton. Lucy was born in Whitefield, Lancashire, abt 1838. Lucy died in Chicopee, Hampden Co, Massachusetts, on 9 Nov 1886.

Lucy's birth registration and baptism have not been found. She arrived in New York on the Hecla on August 10th 1863 with her siblings Taylor, Elizabeth, and Sabina, and Taylor's bride Alice. She lived in Chicopee, Massachusetts.

On 2 Jan 1869 when Lucy was 31, she married **George Warburton** in Agawam, Hampden, Massachusetts. George was born in Lymm, Cheshire, in 1830. He was christened in Warringon, St Elphin, Lancashire, on 13 Jun 1830.

George is from the Houghton Clan. It appears that his marriage to Lucy was bigamous as he had left a wife and 5 children in Lymm, Cheshire, that last of them born in 1868. It is the same George because he names his parents on his marriage to Lucy.

vi. **Elizabeth Warburton**. Elizabeth died in Chicopee, Hampden Co, Massachusetts, on 18 Jan 1902. Elizabeth was born in Whitefield, Lancashire, in 1839.

Elizabeth's place of birth is given as Handforth Mill in 1851, and Whitefield in 1861. She arrived in New York on the Hecla on August 10th 1863 with her siblings Taylor, Selina, and Lucy, and Taylor's bride Alice. She lived in Chicopee, Hampden, MA.

9 vii. **Taylor Warburton** (1841-1878)

On 27 Oct 1867 when Joseph was 61, he second married **Rosanna (Rose Ann) Daily** in Springfield, Hampden Co, Massachusetts. Rosanna (Rose Ann) was born in Ireland abt 1820.

Rosanna's parents were William and Mary.

4. Richard Warburton (*William*¹). Richard was born in Spotland, Rochdale, Lancashire, on 10 Mar 1808. He was christened in Bury, St Mary, Lancashire, on 17 Jul 1808. ■ Census for Tottington Lower End, Lancashire, in 1841. Richard (30) is a calico printer living in Ramsbottom Lane with Susan (30), William (12), Mary (10), Thomas (3), and Ambrose (1). ■ Census for New Accrington, Lancashire, in 1851. Richard (42) is a calico block printer living in Baxenden with Susannah (42), William (22) a calico block printer, Thomas (13) assistant at calico printing machine, Ambrose (10) a teaser at print works, James (8) a teaser, John (5), and Edward (2). ■ Census for New Accrington, Lancashire, in 1861. Richard (53) is a block printer living at 23 Haslingden Road, Lower Baxenden with Susannah (53), James (18) a block printer, John (14) a cotton weaver, Edward (13) a labourer

in coal mine, and a boarder. ■ Census for New Accrington, Lancashire, in 1871. Richard (63) is a block printer living in Lower Baxenden with Susan (42), James (28) a block printer, John (24) a railway guard, and Edward (23) a railway guard. ■ Census for Accrington, Lancashire, in 1881. Richard (73) is a widowed block printer living with his son Edward and his family at 3 Eagle Street. Richard died in Blackburn Infirmary, Lancashire, on 19 Mar 1886.

Richard's death was registered in 1q 1886 Blackburn 8e 331, aged 77. He was recorded as a block printer of 72 Frederick Street, Accrington. He died of gangrene (3 months) and exhaustion for some weeks. His death was registered by his grand-daughter Susan Jane Entwistle of the same address.

On 23 Jul 1828 when Richard was 20, he married **Susannah Bentley** in Bury, St Mary, Lancashire. Richard was a master dyer and batchelor, Susy was a spinster. Witness was Joseph Warburton. Susannah was born in Altham, Lancashire, on 29 Feb 1808. She was christened in Altham, St James, Lanashire, on 10 Mar 1808. Susannah died in Accrington, Lancashire, in Nov 1872. She was buried in Altham, St James, Lanashire, on 28 Nov 1872.

Susannah was the daughter of John and Margaret nee Pilkington. She died aged 64 and was buried in grave 32. Her death was registered in 4q 1872 Haslingden 8e 118.

They had the following children:

- **10** i. **William Warburton** (1828-1892)
 - ii. Mary Ann Warburton. Mary Ann was born in Ramsbottom, Lancashire, in 1830. She was christened in Holcombe, Emmanuel Chapel, Lancashire, on 28 Nov 1830. Mary Ann died in Bury, Lancashire, in 1914.

Mary's father was a printer, abode Oxhey on her baptism record.

On 29 Aug 1852 when Mary Ann was 22, she married **Abraham Kay** in Bury, St Mary, Lancashire. Mary and Abraham had a son and four daughters. Abraham was born in Tottington, Lancashire, in 1827. He was christened in Holcombe, Lancashire, on 22 Apr 1827. Abraham died in Bury, Lancashire, in 1906.

Abraham was the son of Richard and Maria nee Hay.

 iii. Amos Warburton. Amos was born in Ramsbottom, Lancashire, in 1835. Amos died in Ramsbottom, Lancashire, in 1838. He was buried in Holcombe, Emmanuel Chapel, Lancashire, on 15 Apr 1838. He was christened in Holcombe, Emmanuel Chapel, Lancashire, on 4 Oct 1835.

Amos's father was a printer, abode Oxhey on his baptism record. His abode was Stubbins, and age 2 on his burial record.

- **11** iv. **Thomas Warburton** (~1838-1898)
 - v. Ambrose Warburton. Ambrose was born in Ramsbottom, Lancashire, in 1840. Ambrose died in Accrington, Lancashire, in 1853. He was buried in Christ Church, Accrington, Lancashire, on 10 Jul 1853.

Ambrose died aged 14.

vi. James Warburton. James was born in Ramsbottom, Lancashire, in 1843. Census for Burnley, Lancashire, in 1871. James (27) is a labourer in iron works living at 4 Back Shorey with Hannah (29) a cotton weaver. Census for Burnley, Lancashire, in 1881. James (40) is a calico block printer living at 1 Shorey Court with Hannah Jane (39) a cotton winder. Census for Baxenden, Lancashire, in 1891. James (48) is a block printer living at 493 Manchester Road with Hannah Jane (49). Census for Haslingden, Lancashire, in 1901. James (58) is a calico printer living at 14 Deardengate Croft with Hannah (59). James died in Haslingden, Lancashire, in 1910.

On 5 Sep 1863 when James was 20, he married **Hannah Jane Noble** in Accrington, Lancashire. Hannah Jane was born in Accrington, Lancashire, in 1841. She was christened in Accrington, Lancashire, on 16 May 1841. Hannah Jane died in Haslingden, Lancashire, in 1906.

Hannah was the daughter of Mark and Mary. her birth was registerd in 2q 1841 Haslingden 21 445. Her death was registered in 1q 1906 Haslingden 8e 89, aged 57 (this should be 65 but there is no other Hannah Jane's death registered).

vii. John Warburton. John was born in Stubbins, Ramsbottom, Lancashire, in 1845. Census for Accrington, Lancashire, in 1881. John (37) is a railway goods guard living at 5 Peter Street with Elizabeth A Barnes (36) housekeeper and mistress, and her children Betsy Ann (6), John (4), and Fred (2). John is described as married. ■ Census for Accrington, Lancashire, in 1891. John (45) is a railway guard living at 48 Portland Street with wife Elizabeth A B (46), Betsy A B (15) a cotton weaver, John B (13) a printworks labourer, Fred B (12) a cotton mill warehouseman, James W B (9), Thomas C B (7), and Susan B (4). ■ Census for Accrington, Lancashire, in 1901. John (46) is a railway goods guard living at 42 Frederick Street with wife Elizabeth A (56) Betsy Ann Barnes (25) a cotton weaver, Fred Barnes (22) a railway shunter, James W Barnes (19) a printworks labourer, Thos C W Barnes a printworks labourer, and Susan Barnes a cotton weaver. The children are described as sons and daughters. ■ Census for Accrington, Lancashire, in 1911. John (64) is a porter living at 46 Richmond Street with Elizabeth Ann (65), and daughter Susan Barnes (24) a cotton weaver. John and Elizabeth have been married 20 years and had 7 children, 6 living, though the children are aged 24 and upwards. John died in 1917.

It would seem that some if not all the seven children born to Elizabeth Barnes were John's. They were living together before the last four were born. A couple used Warburton as a middle name. However John and Elizabeth didn't marry until after they were all born and they seem to have maintained the Barnes surname.

A clue may be that John described himself as married in 1881. Maybe he married in the early 1870s and was estranged but not free to remarry until 1889. The only marriage in Accrington during that time was to Susannah Coupe in 1873.

John's death was registered in 4q 1917 Haslingden 8e 150, aged 72.

In 1889 when John was 44, he married **Elizabeth Ann Barnes** in Bolton, Lancashire. The marriage was registered in 3q 1889 Bolton 8c 514. Elizabeth Ann was born in Haslingden, Lancashire, abt 1845. Elizabeth Ann died in 1915.

12 viii. **Edward Warburton** (1848-1910)

5. Walter Warburton (*William*¹). Walter was born in Ramsbottom, Lancashire, in 1815. He was christened in Edenfield Chapel, Lancashire, on 1 Jan 1816. ■ Census for Tottington Higher End, Lancashire, in 1841. Walter (20) is a crofter living at Stubbins with Alice (25), and Robert (3). ■ Census for Tottington Lower End, Lancashire, in 1851. Walter (34) is a dyer living in Ramsbottom Lane with Alice (38), Robert (12) a weaver, and 3 lodgers. ■ Census for Bury, Lancashire, in 1861. Walter (45) is a beer seller living at 38 Princess Street with Alice (47), Robert (23) a labourer in an iron foundry, and 5 boarders and lodgers. ■ Census for Tottington Lower End, Lancashire, in 1891. Walter (70) is a widowed stone waller described as Uncle, living at 20 Union Street with Matthew Dilworth and his family. It is Matthew's wife Elizabeth who is Walter's niece. ■ Census for Ramsbottom, Lancashire, in 1901. Walter (82) is a widowed stone waller lodging at 16 Union Street with Matthew Dilworth and his family.

Walter's father is described as a crofter from Shuttleworth on his baptism.

No census entries have been found for Walter in 1871 or 1881, and no matching death registration has been found.

On 31 Dec 1838 when Walter was 23, he married **Alice Greenhalgh** in Bury, St Mary, Lancashire. The marriage was registered in 4q 1838 Bury 21 161. Alice was born in Tottington, Lancashire, abt 1813.

Alice was the daughter of Robert. Her death registration has not been found.

They had one child:

i. **Robert Warburton**. Robert was born in Tottington, Lancashire, in 1839. He was christened in Holcombe, Lancashire, on 14 Jul 1839.

There is no birth registration evident for Robert, and no census entry or death registration can be found for him after 1861.

6. George Warburton (*William*¹). George was born in Bury, Lancashire, in 1818. He was christened in Holcombe, Emmanuel Chapel, Lancashire, on 2 Mar 1818. ■ Census for Tottington Lower End, Lancashire, in 1861. George (43) is a cotton card loom grinder living in Back Bolton Street with Sarah (45) a cotton weaver, John (17) and Benjamin (15) also cotton weavers, and widowed mother-in-law Alice Haworth (73). George died in 1864.

George's father is described as a crofter from Oxhey on his baptism. He is missing from censuses before 1861. His death was registered in 4q 1864 Bury 8c 233 0r 275. LancashireBMD gives his age at death as 45, district Holcombe.

On 26 Dec 1840 when George was 22, he married **Sarah Haworth** in Bury, St Mary, Lancashire. George was a printer from Bury, father William, a dyer. Sarah was also from Bury, father George, a weaver. Sarah was born in Bury, Lancashire, abt 1816. Census for Tottington Lower End, Lancashire, in 1871. Sarah (55) is a widowed weaver living at 31 Back Bolton Street with sons John (26), and Benjamin (22) weavers, mother Alice Haworth (85), and lodger Nancy Wolstenholm (3). Census for Tottington Lower End, Lancashire, in 1881. Sarah (66) is a widow living in Nuttall Lane with John (28 sic) a carter, and nephew James Haworth (6).

Edmund died in Unsworth, Lancashire, in 1896.

Alice and Isaac have been married 29 years but had no children. Elizabeth died in Haslingden, Lancashire, in 1912.

Mary J is a widowed invalid living at 35 Chapel Lane with Eastwood P, a motor driver delivering petrol for the Petroleum Pool Board. Eastwood is described as single. Mary Jane died in Accrington, Lancashire, in 1943.

Mary's death is probably that regisstered in 4q 1943 Haslingden 83 143, aged 77. Lancashire BMD gives the district as Accrington.

They had the following children:

 William Henry Warburton. William Henry was born in Accrington, Lancashire, on 3 Feb 1886. ■ Census for Southport, Lancashire, in 1911. William Hy junior (25) is a hospital porter at the Convalescent Hospital. in 1939 Accrington, Lancashire. William H is a motor driver heavy works living at 8 Birkett Road with Ann M. William Henry died in Blackburn, Lancashire, in 1956.

Williams's birth was registered in 1q 1886 Haslingden 8e 161. His death is possibly that of William H registered in 4q 1956 Blackburn 10b 353, aged 71.

In 1916 when William Henry was 29, he married **Ann Mary Sellars** in Chorley, Trinity Methodist Church, Lancashire. The marriage was registered in 1q 1916 Chorley 8e 947. No children were registered in the next 20 years with mother's maiden name Sellars. Ann Mary was born on 29 Apr 1880.

 Henry Eastwood Pickup Warburton. Henry Eastwood Pickup was born in Accrington, Lancashire, on 8 Nov 1887. Henry Eastwood Pickup died in Accrington, Lancashire, in 1959.

Eastwood's birth was registered in 4q 1888 Haslingden 8e 160. Although Henry appears on his birth registration it is not used thereafter. His death was registered in 2q 1959 Haslingden 10c 303, aged 70. It would seem he never married.

21. Albert Warburton (*William*³, *Richard*², *William*¹). Albert was born in Haslingden, Lancashire, in 1870. ■ Census for Nelson, Lancashire, in 1901. Albert (31) is a railway signalman living 24 Thomas Street with Hannah (35), Albert (7), and boarder Joseph Whitehead (26) a railway porter. ■ Census for Burnley, Lancashire, in 1911. Albert (41) is a railway signalman living at 15 Dane Street with Elizabeth (35), Albert (17) a muffin and crumpet baker, Elizabeth (9 mths), and brothers-in-law

John William Simpson (17) a railway wagon number jakes(?), and James Edward Simpson (13) a warehouse lad in a cotton mill. Albert and Elizabeth have been married 2 years and had one child, still living. Albert died in Burnley, Lancashire, in 1933.

Albert's birth was registered in 1q 1870 Haslingden 8e 154. His death was registered in 2q 1933 Burnley 8e 193, aged 63.

No further children were registered at Burnley, mother's maiden name Simpson.

In 1892 when Albert was 22, he first married **Hannah Winterbottom** in Hyndburn Register Office or Registrar Attended, Lancashire. The marriage was registered in 4q 1892 Haslingden 8e 259. Hannah was born in Hoyland, Yorkshire, abt 1865. Hannah died in Burnley, Lancashire, in 1907.

Hannah's death is probably that registered in 4q 1907 Burnley 8e 139, aged 43.

They had one child:

i. Albert Warburton. Albert was born in Accrington, Lancashire, in 1893. Albert died in Burnley, Lancashire, in 1936.

Albert's birth was registered in 3q 1893 Haslingden 8e 161. His death is probaly that registered in 4q 1936 Burnley 8e 221, aged 43 as he doesn't appear in the 1939 Register.

There were several Alberts who married at Burnley so his marriage (if any) hasn't been identified.

In 1909 when Albert was 39, he second married **Elizabeth Simpson** in Burnley Register Office or Registrar attended, Lancashire. The marriage was registered in 1q 1909 Burnley 8e 432. Elizabeth was born in Burnley, Lancashire, on 25 Mar 1876. in 1939 Burnley, Lancashire. Elizabeth is a widowed cotton weaver living at 17 Granville Street with George and Elizabeth Wilkinson. Elizabeth died in 1958. She was buried in Burnley, Lancashire.

Elizabeth's death is probably that registered in 1q 1958 Burnley 10b 942, aged81.

They had one child:

i. Elizabeth Warburton. Elizabeth was born in Burnley, Lancashire, in 1910.

Elizabeth's birth was registered in 3q 1910 Burnley 8e 141.

22. John Warburton (*William*³, *Richard*², *William*¹). John was born in Haslingden, Lancashire, on 23 Jun 1871. ■ Census for Accrington, Lancashire, in 1901. John (29) is a cotton bleacher living at 22 Clement Street with Emma (33) and Alice (5). ■ Census for Accrington, Lancashire, in 1911.

John (39) is a church and schools caretaker living at 140 Dowery Street with Emma (43), and Alice (15) a cotton winder. John and Emma have been married 16 years and had one child, still living. in 1939 Accrington, Lancashire. John, a widower, is a retired school caretaker living with Alice, a cop winder, at 140 Dowry Street. John died in Accrington, Lancashire, in 1944.

John's birth was registered in 2q 1871 Haslingden 8e 173. His death was registered in 1q 1944 Haslingden 8e 112, aged 72. Lancashire BMD has the sub-district as Accrington.

John worked for a short time at Howard & Bullough, a well known engineering firm in Accrington, and following an accident there, had one of his toes amputated. This was carried out by the family doctor in the kitchen over an enamel bowl, and his wife Emma collapsed at the sight of the doctor sawing off his toe.

A German clock long case was presented to John on his retirement in the early 1930's after 32 years as caretaker of St John's School, and St John's Church, Accrington. John lived opposite the church at 140 Dowry Street.

In 1894 when John was 22, he married **Emma Duckworth** in Accrington, Christ Church, Lancashire. The marriage was registered in 2q 1894 Haslingden 8e 140. Emma was born in Accrington, Lancashire, abt 1868. Emma died in Accrington, Lancashire, in 1931.

Emma was related to Lady Randall. who lived in the Lake District. Emma benefitted from Lady Randall's estate when when she died.

Emma's death was registered in 3q 1931 Haslingden 8e 134, aged 63.

They had one child:

i. Alice Warburton. Alice was born in Accrington, Lancashire, on 9 Jun 1895. Alice died in London in 1973.

Alice's birth was registered in 3q 1895 Haslingden 8e 140, mother's maiden name Duckworth. Her death was registered in 4q 1973 Greenwich 5b 1303, aged 78.

On 18 Aug 1964 when Alice was 69, she married **Reginald James Burbridge** in London. The marriage was registered in 2q 1964 Woolwich 5d 1538. A note on the 1939 Register gives Alice the name Burbridge and a date of August 1964, though it doesn't match the registration which was in the second quarter. Reginald James was born on 8 Jul 1894. Reginald James died in 1974.

Reginald, who was born in India to English parents. Reginald came to Britain after India was granted Independence.

Reginald's death was registered in 3q 1974 Dartford 16 0784, aged 80.

23. Jackson Warburton (*Thomas*³, *Richard*², *William*¹). Jackson was born in Accrington, Lancashire, on 2 Jun 1859. ■ Census for Baxenden, Lancashire, in 1881. Jackson (2) is a dye worker living at 4 Hunstead Street with Hannah (21) a cotton weaver, and Maria (1) at the home of his parents-in-law William and Ellen Jones , and brother-in-law Henry (18). ■ Census for Baxenden, Lancashire, in 1891. Jackson (31) is a cotton dyer living at 661 Manchester Road with Hannah (31) a cotton weaver, and Maria (10). ■ Census for Lower Booths, Haslingden, Lancashire, in 1901. Jackson (41) is a beer seller living at 651 Blackburn Road with Eleanora (30), and niece Annie Warburton (6). ■ Census for Accrington, Lancashire, in 1911. Jackson (51) is a licensed victualler living at 11-13 Arnold Street with Eleanora (41), Lena (9), and niece Annie (16). Jackson and Eleanora have been married 17 years and had one child, still living. Jackson died in Accrington, Lancashire, on 7 Jan 1920. He was christened in Accrington, St James, Lanashire, on 22 Jan 1860.

In 1879 when Jackson was 19, he first married **Hannah Jones** in Hyndburn Register Office or Registrar Attended, Lancashire. The marriage was registered in 2q 1879 Haslingden 8e 233. Hannah was born in Baxenden, Lancashire, abt 1860. Hannah died in Haslingden, Lancashire, Oct-Nov-Dec 1892. Age at Death: 33.

They had one child:

i. Maria Warburton. Maria was born in Baxenden, Lancashire, abt 1891.

On 3 Feb 1894 when Jackson was 34, he second married **Eleanora Kirkham** in Salford, St Bartholomew, Lancashire. Eleanora was born in Bolton, Lancashire, on 4 Aug 1869. She was christened in Bolton, Bradshawgate Wesleyan Methodist Chapel, Lancashire, on 26 Sep 1869.

Eleanor was the daughter of William Austin Kirkham and Selina Radcliffe.

They had one child:

27 i. Lena Warburton (1901-1968)

24. Richard Warburton (*Thomas*³, *Richard*², *William*¹). Richard was born in Accrington, Lancashire, on 24 Oct 1865. He was christened in Accrington, Lancashire, on 14 Dec 1865. ■ Census for Baxenden, Lancashire, in 1911. Richard (46) is a widowed yarn dyer living with his married sister Amelia Knowles (33) a cotton weaver, and her husband John (32) a cotton spinning labourer. John and Amelia have been married 9 years and had no children. Richard died in Accrington, Lancashire, on 16 Oct 1929.

Richard is a widow in censuses after 1901. The identity of his wife is uncertain but is the best fit.

In 1891 when Richard was 25, he married **Mary Barlow** in Hyndburn Register Office or Registrar Attended, Lancashire. This is the only marriage of a Richard in Accrington. Hyndburn is the name of the District Council that includes Accington. Mary died in 1894. Mary was born abt 1868.

The most likely death of a Mary was that registered in 4q 1894 Haslingden 8e 94, aged 26, but it doesn't appear on LancashireBMD.

They had one child:

i. Sarah Warburton. Sarah was born in 1893.

The only birth of a Sarah registered in Haslingden in the 1890s is that registered in 1q 1893 Haslingden 8e 129, but it does not appear on LancashireBMD.

In 1917 when Sarah was 24, she married **Fred Hill** in Haslingden, Trinity Baptist, Lancashire. The marriage was registered in 3q 1917 Haslingden 8e 275.

25. Thomas Warburton (*Thomas*³, *Richard*², *William*¹). Thomas was born in Baxenden, Lancashire, on 16 Mar 1875. He was christened in Accrington, St James, Lanashire, on 15 Apr 1875. ■ Census for Lower Booths, Haslingden, Lancashire, in 1901. Thomas (26) is a yarn dyer living at 4 Hoyle Street with Rachel (27) a cotton weaver, and Thomas (1). ■ Census for Baxenden, Lancashire, in 1911. Thomas (36) is a publican living at the Craven Arms with Rachel (37), and Ralph (8). Thomas and Rachel have been married 14 years and had 3 children, 1 still living. Thomas died in Accrington, Lancashire, on 17 Jan 1950.

No registration details of Thomas's marriage to Sarah Ann Cunliffe, or of Sarah's death have been found, and the evidence for the marriage is unknown.

Thomas first married **Sarah Ann Cunliffe**.

On 6 Feb 1897 when Thomas was 21, he second married **Rachel Knowles** in Stonefold, St John, Accrington, Lancashire. Rachel was born in Baxenden, Lancashire, abt 1875. Rachel died in Accrington, Lancashire, on 17 Dec 1936.

Rachel was the daughter of Thomas.

They had the following children:

- i. **Eva Warburton**. Eva was born in Baxenden, Lancashire, on 25 Jun 1898. Eva died in Baxenden, Lancashire, on 25 Jul 1900.
- ii. Thomas Warburton. Thomas was born in Baxenden, Lancashire, on 11 Feb 1900. He was christened in Stonefold, St John, Accrington, Lancashire, on 4 Mar 1900. Thomas died in Haslingden, Lancashire, in 1902.

Thomas's birth was registered in 1q 1900 Haslingden 8e 58. His death was registered in 2q 1902 Haslingden 8e 93, aged 2.

28 iii. **Ralph Warburton** (~1903-1930)

26. George Warburton (Benjamin³, George², William¹). George was born in Ramsbottom, Lancashire, on 1 Sep 1883. ■ Census for Wilmslow, Cheshire, in 1911. George (27) is a pork butcher living at Newgate with Kate (26), Phyllis Mary (3), and John Clifford (2). George and Kate have been married 4 years and had 2 children, both living. in 1939 Wilmslow, Cheshire. George is a pork butcher on the 1939 Register, living at 12 Hawthorn Walk with Kate, Constance Kirwan a shopp assistant, Joan Morris a shop assistant, and Peter H Morris unemployed, Phyllis Hope a confectioner, and Arthur Hope a clerk chartered accountant. Constance is listed on the transcript but the image shows the record closed. Peter is missing from the transcript and shown on the image. George died in 1952.

George's birth was probably registered in 4q 1883 Bury 8c 459, district Holcombe. His death was registered in 4q 1952 Bucklow 10a 111, aged 69.

In 1906 when George was 22, he married **Kate Wilson** in Ramsbottom, St Paul, Lancashire. The marriage was registered in 3q 1906 Bury 8c 1055. Kate was born in Ramsbottom, Lancashire, on 1 Jul 1884. Kate died in Wilmslow, Cheshire, in 1961.

Kate's death was registered in 1q 1961 Bucklow 10a 139, aged 76.

They had the following children:

i. **Phyllis Mary Warburton**. Phyllis Mary was born in Padiham, Lancashire, on 17 May 1907. Phyllis Mary died in 1991.

Phyllis's birth was registered in 2q 1907 Burnley 8e 248. Her death was registered in May 1991 Macclesfield 35 825, aged 84.

In 1936 when Phyllis Mary was 28, she married **Arthur Hope** in Stockport Civil Marriage or Registrar Attended, Cheshire. The marriage was registered in 2q 1936 Stockport 8a 199. Arthur was born on 16 Aug 1908. Arthur died in 1977.

Arthur's death was registered in 2q 1977 Macclesfield 35 0575, aged 69.

ii. John Clifford Warburton. John Clifford was born in Wilmslow, Cheshire, on 12 Dec 1908. in 1939 Stoke-on-Trent, Staffordshire. John is a boot and shoe manager living at 233 Hanley Road with Constance, and Clara C Tucker, a retired widow. There is one closed record. John Clifford died in Norfolk in 1974.

John's birth was registered in 1q 1909 Bucklow 8a 149. His death is probably that registered i 4q 1974 Norwich Outer 10 2029. Constance's death was not registered in Norfolk however. His date of birth on the 1939 register differs from that on the death register (which states December 1st).

The closed record on the 1939 register is probably their son John born 1936. There is

no evidence of other children.

In 1935 when John Clifford was 26, he married **Constance M Munday** in Coppenhal, St Michael, Cheshire. This marriage, registered in 3q 1935 Nantwich 8a 1040, is the most likely for John. A son was registered at Stoke on Trent, mother's maiden name Munday, the following year.

iii. **Constance Warburton**. Constance was born in Wilmslow, Cheshire, on 6 May 1912.

Constance's birth was registered in 2q 1912 Bucklow 8a 288, mother's maiden name Wilson, district Wilmslow (CheshireBMD).

In 1940 when Constance was 27, she married **Stanley Kirwan** in Bucklow Civil Marriage, Cheshire. The marriage was registered in 2q 1940 Bucklow 8a 834. Curiously Constance is called Constance Kirwan, single on the 1939 Register.

iv. Joan Warburton. Joan was born in Oldham, Lancashire, on 25 Jul 1919.

Joan's birth was registered in 3q 1919 Oldham 8d 998, mother's maiden name Wilson. Her death was registered in May 1988 Macclesfield 35 840, aged 68.

In 1939 when Joan was 19, she married **Kenneth G Morris** in Bucklow Civil Marriage, Cheshire. The marriage was registered in 4q 1939 Bucklow 8a 800. Joan is listed as Joan Morris, but single on the 1939 Register.

v. **Peter Hodson Warburton**. Peter Hodson was born in Wilmslow, Cheshire, on 23 Jun 1925.

Peter's birth was registered in 3q 1925 Bucklow 8a 239, mother's maiden name Wilson. His death was registered in September 1988 Macclesfield 35 716, aged 63.

There are 3 marriages of Peter H Warburton between 1943 and 1963, the most likely to Marie Dale at Bucklow in 1963, but the late date means it could be a second marriage.

27. Lena Warburton (*Jackson⁴, Thomas³, Richard², William¹*). Lena was born in Haslingden, Lancashire, in 1901. Lena died in Haslingden, Lancashire, in 1968.

Lena's birth was registered in 4q 1901 Haslingden 8e 119. Her death was registered in 2q 1968 Haslingden 10c 356, aged 66.

In 1922 when Lena was 21, she married **Robert Warburton** in Haslingden, Lancashire. The marriage was registered in 4q 1922 Haslingden 8e 184.

They had one child:

i. Jackson Warburton. Jackson was born in Accrington, Lancashire, on 19 Feb 1925. Jackson died in Blackpool and Fylde, Lancashire, in Feb 1998.

In 1949 when Jackson was 23, he married **Sheila Elizabeth Wallwork** in Haslingden, Lancashire. The marriage was registered in 3q 1949 Haslingden 10c 793. Jackson and Sheila had one son and one daughter. Sheila Elizabeth was born in Haslingden, Lancashire, in 1928.

28. Ralph Warburton (*Thomas*⁴, *Thomas*³, *Richard*², *William*¹). Ralph was born in Haslingden, Lancashire, abt 1903. Ralph died in Haslingden, Lancashire, on 24 Mar 1930.

Ralph's death was registered in 1q 1930 Haslingden 8e 145, aged 27.

In 1924 when Ralph was 21, he married **Josephine Gallagher** in Hyndburn Register Office or Registrar Attended, Lancashire. The marriage was registered in 3q 924 Haslingden 8e 308.

They had one child:

i. Eileen Warburton. Eileen was born in Rawtenstall, Lancashire, in 1925.
