


Samuel Warburton's Western Australian Family

PREFACE



This is the family of Samuel Warburton who was transported to Western Australia. In 1881, aged 60, he married Alice Adams aged 13. They nominally had 11 children, the last when he was over 80. However it is known at least one was the son of a neighbouring farmer.

First Generation

1. Samuel Warburton. Samuel was born in Manchester, Lancashire, abt 1821. Samuel died in Brunswick, Western Australia, on 6 Jul 1904; he was 83. He was buried in Bunbury Anglican Cemetery, Western Australia, on 7 Jun 1904.

The following information was provided by Pam Lofthouse:

“After several convictions for larceny in Manchester (1853, 1854, 1855) Samuel was convicted at the Manchester Quarter Sessions in 1857 of a felony, and was sentenced to 6 years of penal servitude. He was shipped off to Bermuda to work building the British docks, and while he was there he tried to kill a warder (10 years sentence) and a foreman (8 years sentence). By the time he was transported to Western Australia in 1861 he had served the original 6 years, and on a technicality was told he did not have to serve the 18 extra years.

“Unfortunately, Samuel was very economical with the truth on official documents. His age on his death certificate suggests he was born circa 1821. This is consistent with his stated age (60) when he married. His ages on other documents suggest birth years of 1824 and even 1830.

“Other fragments of information include his occupation is labourer on his court records, and a weaver on one convict document. His father is Paul, a ship’s carpenter, on his marriage certificate. The only Paul Warburton found in records was a clogger from Oldham, Lancashire, but the records do not show a Samuel as one of his children. One convict record states that he had a wife and one child in England, although on another document they are not mentioned. Without any family names, the census records of 1841 and 1851 are of little help in identifying which Samuel he might be.”

The Australian Convict Transportation Records show his Court Martial in Bermuda on 16th August 1862 when he was sentenced to 10 years. The record also show he was transported on the "Lord Dalhousie", leaving Bermuda on the 19th September 1863 and arriving in the Swan River Colony on 28 Dec 1863.

David Bell, the grandson of Samuel’s eldest daughter, sent me a copy of Samuel’s discharge record showing that Samuel, (Reg: 7594) was discharged on January 15th 1864, from Fremantle Convict Gaol to Bunbury Convict Depot. Samuel was granted a "Ticket of Leave" on 26 Jun 1865. This allowed him to work and travel within a specific area. He was given his Certificate of Freedom on 10 January 1866 which allowed him to live a normal life. Samuel subsequently became a farmer.

Samuel’s Death Certificate records he was aged 83, and he had suffered a softening of the brain and asthenia (lack of energy and strength) for 2 months. The certificate also records he was born in Manchester, had lived in Western Australia for 61 years (he had actually been there for 41 years), and had married Alice Emma Lucy Adams at aged 60 years. It also lists his 10 living children. Major

Ernest Warburton was the informant.

Samual was over 80 when the last of his 11 supposed children was born. It is known from DNA that his second son was in fact the son of a neighbouring farmer, Peter McKellar, and his son Wilfred was the son of an Aboriginal stockman, so it is likely that others of his recorded children were also not in fact his.

On 11 Feb 1881 when Samuel was 60, he married **Alice Emma Lucy Adams** in Picton, Western Australia. Samuel's age was 60 on the marriage certificate. Alice's age is stated as "over 21" though her actual age was 13. Alice Emma Lucy was born in New Headington, Oxfordshire, on 5 Dec 1867. She was christened in Headington, St Andrew, Oxfordshire, on 26 Jan 1868. Alice Emma Lucy died in Bunbury, Western Australia, on 28 Nov 1907; she was 39.

Alice's birth was registered in 4q 1867 Headington 3a 574, mother's maiden name Walker. She was the daughter of William Adams and Sophia Walker, who married in 3q 1867. She was the eldest of 7 children (5 girls and 2 boys). The family emigrated to Australia between 1874 and 1876.

Alice's death certificate states she died in Bunbury Hospital of septicaemia and asthenia and had been ill for 18 days. She had married Richard Franklin the day before her death. The certificate lists her 2 husbands and 11 living children, including 9 month old Eileen Pansey, the probable daughter of Richard Franklin, who died the following month. One other male child had also died. Her age is given as 41 although she was actually one week short of her 40th birthday. Her age when she married Samuel Warburton was given as 14 years, and she had lived in Western Australia for 34 years.

They had the following children:

- 2 i. **James William Warburton** (1882-1911)
- 3 ii. **Arthur Samuel Warburton** (1884-1951)
- iii. **Elizabeth Alice Warburton**. Elizabeth Alice was born in Perth, Western Australia, on 1 Jan 1886. Elizabeth Alice died in Northam, Western Australia, in 1948; she was 61.

On 9 Sep 1903 when Elizabeth Alice was 17, she married **Lionel Edward Bell** in Benger, Western Australia. Lionel and Elizabeth had 11 children in total. The first was Albert Edward who was born on June 2nd 1902. His birth registration was as Warburton, illegitimate and with unknown father. However, although never formally adopted, he was always known as Albert Edward Bell, though his parentage was only confirmed when he applied for his pension. On August 16th 1965 a note was added to his original birth registration that "Albert Edward Warburton lawfully assumed the name of Albert Edward Bell. This entry is made by virtue of a declaration made at Perth on the 9th August 1965 by a person declaring himself to be Albert Edward Bell and to be identical with the person whose birth is recorded in [the] registration". Lionel Edward was born in Perth, Western Australia, on 8 Nov 1884. Lionel Edward died in Perth, Western Australia, on 6 Oct 1960; he was 75.

- iv. **Amy Agnes Warburton**. Amy Agnes was born in Benger, Western Australia, on 6 Oct 1888. Amy Agnes died in Carlisle, Western Australia, on 15 Jan 1976; she was 87.

On 17 Aug 1907 when Amy Agnes was 18, she married **David George Devereux** in Swan, Perth, Western Australia. Amy and David had 3 sons and 2 daughters. David George was born in Guildford, Western Australia, on 8 Aug 1880. David George died in Merredin, Western Australia, on 18 May 1944; he was 63.

- v. **Mary Ellen Warburton**. Mary Ellen was born in Benger, Western Australia, in 1889. Mary Ellen died in Williams, Western Australia, in 1955; she was 66.

Mary was known as Nell.

In 1914 when Mary Ellen was 25, she first married **Frank Burke** in Williams, Western Australia. Frank died in Fremantle, Western Australia in 1916.

In 1919 when Mary Ellen was 30, she second married **Frank Amyas Dench** in Beverley, Western Australia. Frank and Mary had one son and were living in Beverley, Swan, Western Australia on the 1925 Electoral Roll. Frank Amyas was born in Hindmarsh, South Australia, on 3 Feb 1877. Frank Amyas died in Narrogin, Western Australia, on 27 Nov 1952; he was 75.

- vi. **Joseph Sullivan Charles Warburton**. Joseph Sullivan Charles was born in Benger, Western Australia, in 1890. Joseph Sullivan Charles died in Burekup, Western

Australia, on 27 Jan 1913; he was 23.

- vii. **Gordon Stanley Warburton**. Gordon Stanley was born in Benger, Western Australia, on 8 Sep 1892. He was christened in Bunbury, Western Australia, on 28 Mar 1893. Gordon Stanley died in Wellington, Western Australia, on 1 Dec 1964; he was 72.

Gordon served in WW1 from 1916 to 1919. He was posted to Egypt and received a gunshot wound to his right forearm (no disability). He also served in WW2 in the Citizen Military forces.

In 1919 when Gordon Stanley was 26, he married **Isabella May Gamble** in Perth, Western Australia. There is no evidence in Public Trees on Ancestry that Gordon and Isabella had children. Isabella May was born in Western Australia, in 1883. Isabella May died in Wellington, Western Australia, on 20 Sep 1951; she was 68.

- viii. **Lilian Clara Maud Warburton**. Lilian Clara Maud was born in Bunbury, Western Australia, on 17 Nov 1894. Lilian Clara Maud died in Wooroloo, Western Australia, on 19 Oct 1939; she was 44.

On 1 Feb 1912 when Lilian Clara Maud was 17, she married **Charles Henry Harris** in Wellington District, Western Australia. Charles and Lilian had 4 sons and 2 daughters. Charles Henry was born in Australind, Western Australia, in 1874. Charles Henry died in Bunbury, Western Australia, on 13 Oct 1950; he was 76.

- ix. **Wilfred Harold John Warburton**. Wilfred Harold John was born in Mornington, Western Australia, on 29 Jul 1896. Wilfred Harold John died in Wellington, Western Australia, on 28 May 1966; he was 69.

Wilfred was half Aborigine so is not Samuel's natural son. His father was a stockman living on the farm.

Wilfred was a farm hand at Cleary farm, Dardanup in the 1925 and 1936 Electoral Rolls. There is no evidence in Public Trees on Ancestry that he ever married.

- x. **Violet Pearl Warburton**. Violet Pearl was born in Mornington, Western Australia, on 21 Jul 1899. Violet Pearl died in Bunbury, Western Australia, on 7 Oct 1972; she was 73.

In 1919 when Violet Pearl was 19, she married **William Waters** in Wellington District, Western Australia. There is no evidence in Public Trees on Ancestry that William and Violet had children. William was born in Geelong, Victoria, abt 1893. William died in Bunbury, Western Australia, on 22 Mar 1960; he was 67.

- xi. **Samuel Thomas Charles Warburton**. Samuel Thomas Charles was born in Benger, Western Australia, in Dec 1903. Samuel Thomas Charles died in Benger, Western

Australia, in Apr 1904; he was <1.

Second Generation

2. James William Warburton (*Samuel*¹). James William was born in Harvey, Western Australia, on 31 Jan 1882. He was christened in Picton, Western Australia, on 17 Dec 1882. James William died in Perth, Western Australia, on 21 Apr 1911; he was 29. He was buried in Kana Katta, Anglican Cemetery, Western Australia, on 21 Apr 1911.

The name on James's baptism is Mager Ernest Warburton. However there is no baptism for James William, and no birth for Mager Ernest. Major Ernest is also the informant on Samuel's death certificated where he is referred to as his eldest son. The name Major is associated with John William in an **In Memorium** placed in **The West Australian** by his brother Arthur, and as a name used by his son Ernest. It is therefore presumed that James William and Major Ernest are the same person.

James died in Stubbs Hospital of typhoid fever.

On 31 Jan 1907 when James William was 25, he married **Violet Florence Victoria Brown** in Brunswick Junction, Western Australia. Violet Florence Victoria was born in Echua, Victoria, on 2 Apr 1889. Violet Florence Victoria died in Bunbury, Western Australia, on 3 Dec 1924; she was 35.

They had the following children:

- 4 i. **John Arthur Warburton** (1908-1991)
- ii. **Jessie Eileen Warburton**. Jessie Eileen was born in Bunbury, Western Australia, in 1910. Jessie Eileen died in Bunbury, Western Australia, on 25 Oct 1989; she was 79.

In 1939 when Jessie Eileen was 29, she married **Robert Jarvie** in Wellington, Western Australia. There is no evidence in Public Trees on Ancestry that Robert and Jessie had children. Robert was born in 1909. Robert died in Bunbury, Western Australia, on 5 Dec 1977; he was 68.

- iii. **Major Ernest Warburton**. Major Ernest was born in Glen Iris, Bunbury, Western Australia, on 28 Sep 1911. Major Ernest died in Bunbury, Western Australia, on 17 Jun 1993; he was 81.

Ernest's birth certificate states his first name as Major. His parents are named Violet Florence Victoria nee Brown aged 22, born Euchuca, Victoria, and James Willaim Warburton aged 29 born at Harvey, Western Australia. The date given for their marriage (3rd January 1908) doesn't match the actual date. Their 2 elder children are also listed.

Y-chromosome results from Ernest's son show a match with two families in England described as the Nottinghamshire, and the Ashley and Morley clans.

In 1938 when Major Ernest was 26, he married **Mary Theresa Howe** in Western Australia. Ernest and Mary had 4 sons and 4 daughters including William who DNA tested. Mary Theresa was born in Western Australia, abt 1918. Mary Theresa died in Bunbury, Western Australia, on 1 Nov 1996; she was 78.

3. Arthur Samuel Warburton (*Samuel*¹). Arthur Samuel was born in Harvey, Western Australia, on 23 Jan 1884. He was christened in Bunbury, Western Australia, on 21 Dec 1884. Arthur Samuel died in Perth, Western Australia, on 26 Aug 1951; he was 67.

Arthur was a mechanic when he signed up for active service on 24th March 1917. He was described as 6ft tall with dark hair and a dark complexion. He declared he had previously been rejected as unfit because of an operation.

He was accepted into the Pioneers on 21st July. On 22nd August 1917 he was discharged as permanently unfit for active service, not due to misconduct.

Y-chromosome DNA from Arthur's grandson Kevin shows a match with the McKellar family. Investigations indicate his father was in fact Peter McKellar (1837-1915) a neighbouring farmer.

On 30 Sep 1908 when Arthur Samuel was 24, he married **Violet Centennial Simms** in Brunswick Junction, St Peter, Western Australia. Violet Centennial was born in Footscray, Victoria, on 26 Jan 1888. Violet Centennial died in Bunbury, Western Australia, on 12 Mar 1948; she was 60. She was buried in Bunbury Cemetery, Western Australia, on 17 Mar 1948.

The FindAGrave entry for Violet gives a death date of 17th March 1846, which contradicts the death registration in 1948. It is assumed it is the burial date, and the year has been entered incorrectly.

They had the following children:

- i. **Ivy Victoria Warburton**. Ivy Victoria was born in Bunbury, Western Australia, on 24 May 1910. Ivy Victoria died in Bunbury, Western Australia, on 27 Nov 1982; she was 72.

In 1935 when Ivy Victoria was 24, she married **Edward Clarke McConkey** in Brunswick Junction, St Peter, Western Australia. Edward and Ivy had one child. Edward Clarke was born in Oakabella, Northampton, Western Australia, on 20 Nov 1907. Edward Clarke died in Bunbury, Western Australia, on 11 May 1973; he was 65.

- ii. **Mary Margaret Warburton**. Mary Margaret was born in Perth, Western Australia, on 13 Mar 1912. Mary Margaret died in Perth, Western Australia, on 16 Mar 1912; she was <1.
- iii. **Phylis Minnie Warburton**. Phylis Minnie was born in Brunswick Junction, Western Australia, on 27 Apr 1913. Phylis Minnie died in Bunbury, Western Australia, on 19 Aug 1973; she was 60.

In 1930 when Phylis Minnie was 16, she married **Owen John Piggott** in Wellington, Western Australia. There is no evidence in Public Trees on Ancestry that Phylis and Owen had children. Owen John was born in Brunswick Junction, Western Australia, on 2 Jun 1911. Owen John died in Perth, Western Australia, on 25 Apr 1969; he was 57. He was buried in Bunbury Cemetery, Western Australia.

- iv. **John Ernest Warburton**. John Ernest was born in Brunswick Junction, Western Australia, on 19 Apr 1915. John Ernest died in Bunbury, Western Australia, on 13 Dec 1989; he was 74. He was buried in Bunbury Cemetery, Western Australia.

John served in the military between 1939 and 1948. On electoral rolls from 1963 to 1980 he is a farm worker at Research Station, Wokalup. There is no evidence in Public Trees on Ancestry that he ever married.

- v. **Charles Albert Warburton**. Charles Albert was born in Brunswick Junction, Western Australia, on 15 Sep 1916. Charles Albert died in Perth, Western Australia, on 5 Nov 1991; he was 75.

There is no evidence in Public Trees on Ancestry that Charles ever married.

- vi. **Edward Stanley Warburton**. Edward Stanley was born in Brunswick Junction, Western Australia, on 6 Jun 1918. Edward Stanley died in Brunswick Junction, Western Australia, on 24 Aug 1991; he was 73.

In 1950 when Edward Stanley was 31, he married **Emily Elizabeth Little** in Blackwood, Western Australia. Edward and Emily had a daughter, and a son Kevin, who has DNA tested. Emily Elizabeth was born in Manjimup, Blackwood District,

Western Australia, on 20 Apr 1923. Emily Elizabeth died in Bunbury, Western Australia, on 1 Aug 1995; she was 72.

- vii. **Samuel Warburton**. Samuel was born in Brunswick Junction, Western Australia, on 9 Feb 1919. Samuel died in Brunswick Junction, Western Australia, on 9 Feb 1919; he was <1.
- viii. **Elsie Violet Warburton**. Elsie Violet was born in Wellington District, Western Australia, on 17 Aug 1920. Elsie Violet died in Brunswick Junction, Western Australia, on 3 Dec 1983; she was 63.

In 1946 when Elsie Violet was 25, she married **Alexander John Campbell** in Wellington District, Western Australia. There is no evidence in Public Trees on Ancestry that Elsie and Alexander had children. Alexander John was born in Perth, Western Australia, on 9 Mar 1919. Alexander John died in Bunbury, Western Australia, on 16 Mar 1994; he was 75.

- ix. **Dorothy Olive Warburton**. Dorothy Olive was born on 7 Dec 1921. She was christened in Brunswick Junction, Western Australia. Dorothy Olive died in Bunbury, Western Australia, on 10 Jul 1924; she was 2.

- xi. **May Lilian Warburton**. May Lilian was born in Bunbury, Western Australia, on 18 Jul 1924. May Lilian died in Bunbury, Western Australia, on 24 Apr 2004; she was 79.

In 1949 when May Lilian was 24, she married **Kevin Thomas Lofthouse** in Wellington District, Western Australia. Kevin and May had a son, and a daughter Pam who is my contact. Kevin Thomas was born in Bunbury, Western Australia, on 24 Jul 1923. Kevin Thomas died in Bunbury, Western Australia, on 16 Jun 2015; he was 91.

- xii. **Rita Margaret Warburton**. Rita Margaret was born in Wellington District, Western Australia, on 9 Nov 1926. Rita Margaret died in Bunbury, Western Australia, on 6 Jan 1928; she was 1.

Third Generation

4. John Arthur Warburton (*James William², Samuel¹*). John Arthur was born in Bunbury, Western Australia, in 1908. John Arthur died in Western Australia, on 26 Sep 1991; he was 83.

John was known as Jack.

In 1936 when John Arthur was 28, he married **Ivy Florence Hogan** in Wellington District, Western Australia. Jack and Ivy had a son and two daughters. Ivy Florence was born in Western Australia, on 19 Feb 1916. Ivy Florence died in Western Australia, on 6 Oct 1995; she was 79.

They had one child:

i. **Living Warburton.**

On 30 Mar 1968 Living married **Robert Norman Rinaldi** in Perth, Western Australia. Robert and his wife had 2 children. Robert Norman was born in Meekatharra, Western Australia, on 9 Sep 1936. Robert Norman died in Port Douglas, Queensland, on 12 Oct 2009; he was 73.

5. Thomas Roy Warburton (*Arthur Samuel², Samuel¹*). Thomas Roy was born in Wellington District, Western Australia, on 28 Feb 1923. Thomas Roy died in Brunswick Junction, Western Australia, on 20 Jan 1976; he was 52. He was buried in Bunbury Cemetery, Western Australia.

Thomas was a farmer at Brunswick.

In 1951 when Thomas Roy was 27, he married **Elsie Ellen Marston** in Wellington District, Western Australia. Thomas and Elsie had three other children as well as Geoffrey. Elsie Ellen was born in Bunbury, Western Australia, on 23 Sep 1927. Elsie Ellen died in Bunbury, Western Australia, on 15 Mar 2005; she was 77. She was buried in Bunbury Cemetery, Western Australia.

Elsie was born in St Clair's Hospital.

They had one child:

i. **Geoffrey Matthew Warburton.** Geoffrey Matthew was born in Western Australia, on 5 Mar 1959. Geoffrey Matthew died in Bunbury, Western Australia, on 14 Jan 1978; he was 18. He was buried in Bunbury Cemetery, Western Australia.
