PREFACE

This family is descended from Joseph Warburton (abt 1767-1844) who appeared in Marple, near Stockport, Cheshire in the 1790s and later moved to Torkington. Many of his descendants worked in the coal mines at Poynton.

Descendants of Joseph Warburton & Hannah Marsland

First Generation

1. Joseph Warburton. Joseph was born abt 1767. ■ Census for Torkington, Cheshire, in 1841. Joseph (72) is a labourer living with Hannah (66), Charles (20) a coal miner, Hannah (16) a reeler of cotton, Ellis (26) a coal miner, Mary (22), and grandchildren David (2), and Margaret (2 mths), the children of his son Ellis. Son Martin is living with, or next door to Joseph. Joseph died in Torkington, Cheshire, in 1844. He was buried in Marple, All Saints, Cheshire, on 8 Mar 1844.

No reliable baptism has been identified for Joseph. There are possibles at Manchester Cathedral and Ashton-Under-Lyne, based on his census age, but these are too late for his age at burial.

Also there is no marriage for Joseph and Sarah which, given Sarah's age at death, must have been close to the birth of their first child. The only marriage that fits on date was in Malpas.

Joseph's children include some conjecture. There are baptisms for the children of his first marriage, and for Martin and Sarah at Marple. No baptisms can be found for Thomas and James, and their marriage records don't include their father's name. They were, however, born in Torkington on censuses. There is a baptism for Samuel but none for Ellis, Charles, or Hannah though they are living at home in the 1841 census and Ellis and Hannah's father is named as Joseph on their marriages.

Finally Peter was baptised at Stockport but his parents are given as John and Hannah of Torkington. There is no other evidence of John and Hannah. Peter calls his youngest son Ellis, the same as Joseph and Hannah's youngest son, and he is a collier like many of Joseph's sons. It is therefore presumed that Peter's baptism record is in error and his father should be Joseph.

Joseph is described as a weaver on the baptisms of Sarah and Samuel.

Joseph was 77 years old on his burial record.

Joseph first married **Sarah**. Sarah was born abt 1774. Sarah died in 1795. She was buried in Marple, All Saints, Cheshire, on 1 May 1795.

Sarah was buried aged 21.

They had the following children:

- **2** i. **John Warburton** (1791-1849)
 - ii. Mary Warburton. Mary was born in Marple, Cheshire, in 1792. She was christened in Marple, All Saints, Cheshire, on 11 Nov 1792. Mary died in 1794. She was buried in Marple, All Saints, Cheshire, on 16 Nov 1794.

Mary was the daughter of Joseph and Sarah of Torkington on her burial record.

3 iii. **Joseph Warburton** (1794-1865)

First Generation

On 29 Aug 1796 when Joseph was 29, he second married **Hannah Marsland** in Stockport, St Mary, Cheshire. Hannah was born abt 1775. Hannah died in Torkington, Cheshire, in 1848. She was buried in Marple, All Saints, Cheshire, on 19 Mar 1848.

Hannah was 73 years old on her burial record.

They had the following children:

- 4 i. **Martin Warburton** (1797-1880)
 - Sarah Warburton. Sarah was born in Torkington, Cheshire, in 1800. She was christened in Poynton, St George, Cheshire, on 12 Mar 1800. Sarah died in Norbury, Cheshire, in 1878.

Sarah's death was registered in 2q 1878 Stockport 8a 69, aged 78.

On 25 Dec 1819 when Sarah was 19, she married **Matthew Bennett** in Stockport, St Mary, Cheshire. Matthew was a husbandman, and both were of this parish. Sarah's name is misspelled as Warbutton. Matthew and Sarah had a large family with 4 sons and 9 daughters appearing in censuses. Matthew was born in Norbury, Cheshire, abt 1798. Matthew died in Norbury, Cheshire, in 1857.

Matthew's death was registered in 1q 1857 Stockport 8a 47, aged 58.

 - vi. Samuel Warburton. Samuel was born in Torkington, Cheshire, in 1813. He was christened in Stockport, St Mary, Cheshire, on 30 Jun 1813. Census for Worth, Cheshire, in 1841. Samuel (25) is a coal miner living at Dale House Fold with Mary (20). Census for Macclesfield, Cheshire, in 1851. Samuel (36) is a private watchman living in Buxton Road with Mary (34) a laundress. Census for Macclesfield, Cheshire, in 1861. Samuel (49) is a private watchman living at 16 Balehall Yard with Mary (44) a laundress. Census for Macclesfield, Cheshire, in 1871. Samuel (57) is a watchman living 14 King Edward Street with Mary (55). Census for Norbury, Cheshire, in 1881. Samuel (68) is a widowed watchman (cotton mill) living in Man[chester] and Buxton Road with his brother Ellis and his family. Samuel died in Norbury, Cheshire, in 1883.

Samuel's death was registered in 3q 1883 Stockport 8a 66, aged 70.

On 25 Sep 1836 when Samuel was 23, he married **Mary Hammond** in Stockport, St Mary, Cheshire. Both Samuel and Mary were from Torkington. Mary was born in Bramall, Cheshire, abt 1816. Mary died in Macclesfield, Cheshire, in 1874.

Mary's death was registered in 2q 1874 Macclesfield 8a 93, aged 57.

 - ix. Charles Warburton. Charles was born in Torkington, Cheshire, abt 1820. ■
 Census for Marple, Cheshire, in 1851. Charles (31) is a coal miner living in High
 Lane with Hannah Goodwin (13) neice and housekeeper. Census for Norbury,
 Cheshire, in 1861. Charles (40) is a widowed coal miner lodging with his sister
 Elizabeth Goodwin and her family in High Lane. Census for Stockport, Cheshire,
 in 1871. Charles (50) is a publican living at 11 High Street with Elizabeth (60). ■
 Census for Stockport, Cheshire, in 1881. Charles (61) is a retired licensed victualler
 living at 35 Thomson Street with Elizabeth (71). Census for Cheadle, Cheshire, in
 1891. Charles (70) is a widowed, retired publican lodging at 51 Castle Street. ■
 Census for Stockport, Cheshire, in 1901. Charles (81) is a retired coal miner living
 at 65 York Street. Charles died in Stockport, Cheshire, in 1904.

Although Charles is described as a widower in the 1861 census no certain wedding has been identified. His death was registered in 1q 1904 Stockport 8a 24, aged 83.

In 1865 when Charles was 45, he married **Elizabeth Chatterton** in High Lane, St Thomas, Cheshire. The marriage was registered in 4q 1865 Stockport 8a 81. Elizabeth was born in Stockport, Cheshire, abt 1810. Elizabeth died in 1885.

Elizabeth was born Elizabeth Mason, and was previously married (probably to Joseph Chatterton). Her death was registered in 2q 1885 Stockport 8a 42, aged 75.

x. **Hannah Warburton**. Hannah was born in Torkington, Cheshire, abt 1824. Hannah died in Stockport, Cheshire, in 1901.

Hannah is probably the one whose death was registered in 1q 1901 Stockport 8a 19, aged 77. She was a widow by 1881 and lived in Hyde with her married daughter in 1891.

On 20 Aug 1849 when Hannah was 25, she married **William Hibbert** in Prestbury, St Peter, Cheshire. William was a weaver from Adlington, father William. Hannah was also living in Adlington, father Joseph a labourer, but appears in censuses as Hannah Hibbert, born Torkington. They had one daughter. William was born abt 1823.

2. John Warburton (*Joseph*¹). John was born in Marple, Cheshire, in 1791. He was christened in Marple, All Saints, Cheshire, on 11 Sep 1791. ■ Census for Torkington, Cheshire, in 1841. John (45) is a labourer living with Hannah (55), Betty Barratt (35), Martha Barratt (20), Eli Warburton (11), and James Barratt (3). John died in Torkington, Cheshire, in 1849. He was buried in Marple, All Saints, Cheshire, on 5 Sep 1849.

John is aged 59 on his burial record.

On 12 Sep 1825 when John was 34, he married **Hannah Barratt** in Stockport, St Mary, Cheshire. John was a bachelor and labourer, and Hannah was a widow according to the marriage record. Hannah was born in Torkington, Cheshire, abt 1786. ■ Census for Torkington, Cheshire, in 1851. Hannah (64) is a widow living with daughters Betty Barratt (45), and Martha Barratt (26), son Eli (20), and grandson George Barratt (2). Hannah died in Torkington, Cheshire, in 1854. She was buried in Marple, All Saints, Cheshire, on 2 Oct 1854.

Betty and Martha Barratt were Hannah's daughters by her previous marriage. Grandson George (2 in 1851), and presumed grandson James (3 in 1841) would appear to be the illegitimate sons of one of her daughters, though their baptisms haven't been found.

Hannah of Torkington was buried aged 68. Her death was registered in 3q 1854 Stockport 8a 62, aged 68.

They had one child:

- Eli John Warburton. Eli John was born in 1830. He was christened in Hazel Grove, Ebenezer Congregational, Cheshire, on 24 Jan 1831. Eli John died in 1860. He was buried in Stockport, Cheshire, on 23 Jun 1860.
 - Eli of Torkington was buried at age 30. His death was registered in 2q 1860 Stockport 8a 64, aged 28 (according to Cheshire BMD). There is no evidence he ever married.
- **3. Joseph Warburton** (*Joseph*¹). Joseph was born in Torkington, Cheshire, in 1794. He was christened in Marple, All Saints, Cheshire, on 24 Aug 1794. Census for Torkington, Cheshire, in 1841. Joseph (46) is a labourer living with Jane (40). Their sons James (17), William (15), and Richard (12) are servants on the farm of Matthew Cumston in Torkington. Census for Torkington, Cheshire, in 1851. Joseph (56) is a widowed agricultural labourer living with James (29), William (25), and Richard (23) also agricultural labourers. Census for Torkington, Cheshire, in 1861. Joseph (66) is a widowed agricultural labourer living with James (39) also an agricultural labourer. Joseph died in Norbury, Cheshire, in 1865. He was buried in Norbury, St Thomas, Cheshire, on 2 Feb 1865.

Joseph's death was regisitered in 1q 1865 Stockport 8a 62, aged 70.

On 24 Sep 1820 when Joseph was 26, he married **Jane Compstone** in Stockport, St Mary, Cheshire. Jane was born abt 1799. Jane died in Hazel Grove, Cheshire, in 1850. She was buried in Marple, All Saints, Cheshire, on 17 Nov 1850.

Jane's husband was a widower by 1851 so she is probably the Jane Torkington Warburton of Hazel Grove whose death was registered in 4q 1850 Stockport 19 181, aged 51, and who was buried at Marple. There is no other likely record.

They had the following children:

- James Warburton. James was born in Torkington, Cheshire, on 29 Dec 1821. He was christened in Norbury, St Thomas, Cheshire, on 20 Jan 1822. James died in Torkington, Cheshire, in 1862. He was buried in Norbury, St Thomas, Cheshire, on 20 Apr 1862.
 - James's death was registered in 2q 1862 Stockport 8a 71 (or 24, there are 2 entries), aged 40. The Cheshire BMD reference is HAZ/6/12.
- ii. William Warburton. William was born in Torkington, Cheshire, on 22 May 1825. He was christened in Norbury, St Thomas, Cheshire, on 14 Aug 1825. William died in Torkington, Cheshire, in 1860. He was buried in Norbury, St Thomas, Cheshire, on 12 Jan 1860.
 - William's death was registered in 1q 1860 Stockport 8a 71, aged 34.
- iii. **Richard Warburton**. Richard was born in Torkington, Cheshire, on 22 Mar 1828. He was christened in Norbury, St Thomas, Cheshire, on 20 Apr 1828.
 - Richard has not been found in censuses after 1851 but there is no obvious death or marriage registration.
- **4. Martin Warburton** (*Joseph*¹). Martin was born in Torkington, Cheshire, in 1797. He was christened in Marple, All Saints, Cheshire, on 15 Oct 1797. Census for Torkington, Cheshire, in 1841. Martin (42) is a labourer living with Ann (42), Betty (20) a hand loom worker, Hannah (18), William (16) a coal miner, Samuel (14) a coal miner, Ann (12), Ellis (7), Annis (4), Charles (2), Elias (1) the son of Betty, and Eliza (7 mths). Census for Torkington, Cheshire, in 1851. Martin (54) is an agricultural labourer living with Ann (53), Hannah (29), Samuel (23) a coal miner, Ann (21) a throstle spinner, Ellis (17) a coal miner, Annis (15) a carder (cotton mill), Charles (13) a coal miner, Elias (11) a coal miner refered to as grandson, and Eliza (10). Census for Torkington, Cheshire, in 1861. Martin (63) is a farmer of 6 acres living with Ann (62), Hannah (38), Ann (30) a dress maker, Charles (21), a collier, Eliza (20) a cotton weaver, and grandsons Charles (3), and John (7 mths) the children of daughter Ann. Census for Torkington, Cheshire, in 1871. Martin (74) is an agricultural labourer living in Torkington Lane with Ann (73), and Hannah (49). Martin died in

Torkington, Cheshire, in 1880. He was buried in Norbury, St Thomas, Cheshire, on 19 Jun 1880.

Martin's death was registered in 2q 1880 Stockport 8a 80, aged 82.

On 9 Aug 1818 when Martin was 21, he married **Ann Jackson** in Stockport, St Mary, Cheshire. Martin was described as a weaver on the parish register. Ann was born in Torkington, Cheshire, abt 1798. ■ Census for Torkington, Cheshire, in 1881. Ann (82) is living in Torkington Lane with Hannah (59). Ann died in 1884. She was buried in Norbury, St Thomas, Cheshire, on 11 Oct 1884.

Ann's death was registered in 4q 1884 Stockport 8a 67, aged 86.

They had the following children:

- **10** i. **Betty Warburton** (1820-)
 - ii. Hannah Warburton. Hannah was born in Torkington, Cheshire, on 28 Jan 1822. She was christened in Bullock Smithy Wesleyan Methodist, Cheshire, on 8 Sep 1822. ■ Census for Torkington, Cheshire, in 1891. Hannah (69) is living in Torkington Lane with brother-in-law Jesse Wilson and his family. Hannah died in Torkington, Cheshire, in 1892. She was buried in Norbury, St Thomas, Cheshire, on 26 Jan 1892.

Hannah's death was registered in 1q 1892 Stockport 8a 92, aged 69. Her burial record says she was living in Threakhurst Lane at the time of her death.

- **13** v. **Ann Warburton** (1830-1893)
 - vi. Ellis Warburton. Ellis was born in Torkington, Cheshire, in 1834. He was christened in Stockport, St Mary, Cheshire, on 9 Feb 1834. ■ Census for Bosden, Cheshire, in 1861. Ellis (called Elias, aged 27) is a coal miner living in Bosden Gate Cottages with Martha (25) a cotton reeler. ■ Census for Marple, Cheshire, in 1871. Ellis (transcribed as Eller on Ancestry, aged 36) is a plumber and glazier living in Sunny Bank, New Road with lodger Annie Turner (22) a school teacher. Ellis is married but his wife isn't mentioned at home, or elsewhere.

 Census for Marple, Cheshire, in 1881. Ellis (46) is a plumber and glazier living in Stockport Road with Martha (45), niece Sarah A Waine (8), and lodger Arthur M Cresswell (28) a salesman. ■ Census for Marple, Cheshire, in 1891. Ellis (55) is living off his own means in Sunny Bank with niece Sarah A Waine (18), and lodger Alfred Cresswell (31) a buyer in the cotton goods trade. ■ Census for Marple, Cheshire, in 1901. Ellis (66) is a retired plumber living in Church Lane with Alice (49), and niece Sarah A Wain (27) a dressmaker. ■ Census for Marple, Cheshire, in 1911. Ellis (77) is living off private means at 11 Sunny Side, Church Lane with Alice (60), niece Sarah Ann Wain (38). Ellis and Alice have been married 20 years and had no children.

Ellis died in Marple, Cheshire, in 1912. He was buried in Marple, All Saints, Cheshire, on 26 Dec 1912.

It seems that Ellis was baptised as Alice in error. His death was registered in 4q 1912 Macclesfield 8a 187, aged 78.

Ellis's niece Sarah Ann Wain lived with Ellis for many years but her exact relationship is unclear. No Wain - Warburton marriage has been found. She is probably a niece from his wife's family.

On 22 Feb 1857 when Ellis was 23, he first married **Martha Bowler** in Stockport, St Mary, Cheshire. Ellis of Torkington was a colllier, father Martin, a labourer. Martha was of Torkington, father William, a stonemason. The marriage was registered in 1q 1857 Stockport 8a 92. Martha was born in Bosden, Cheshire, abt 1835. Martha died in Marple, Cheshire, in 1891. She was buried in Marple, All Saints, Cheshire, on 4 Feb 1891.

Martha's death was registered in 1q 1891 Stockport 8a 2, aged 55.

On 15 Sep 1891 when Ellis was 57, he second married **Alice Metcalfe** in Poulton-le-Sands, Holy Trinity, Lancashire. The marriage was registered in 3q 1891 Lancaster 8e 1243. Their parents were Martin Warburton and John Metcalfe. Alice was born in Manchester, Lancashire, abt 1851. Alice died in Marple, Cheshire, in 1912.

Alice's death was registered in 4q 1912 Stockport 8a 2, aged 62.

vii. **Annis Warburton**. Annis was born in Torkington, Cheshire, in 1836. She was christened in Stockport, St Mary, Cheshire, on 3 Jul 1836. Annis died in 1920.

Annis's death was registered in 1q 1920 Macclesfield 8a 159, aged 84.

On 15 Jun 1857 when Annis was 21, she married **John Siddall** in Stockport, St Mary, Cheshire. Annis (transcribed as Annie) Warbutton was of Hazel Grove, father Martin, a farmer. John was a collier of Hazel Grove, father Thomas, a labourer. The marriage was registered (as Annis Warburton) in 2q 1857 Stockport 8a 101. They had at least 7 children. John was born in Poynton, Cheshire, abt 1833. John died in 1894.

John's death was registered in 4q 1894 Stockport 8a 39, aged 50.

- **14** viii. **Charles Warburton** (1838-1911)
 - ix. Eliza Warburton. Eliza was born in Torkington, Cheshire, in 1840.

Eliza's birth was registered in 4q 1840 Stockport 19 219. No baptism record has been found. Eliza and James have not been found in censuses.

On 19 Oct 1862 when Eliza was 22, she married **James Barratt** in Stockport, St Mary, Cheshire. The marriage was registered in 4q 1862 Stockport 8a 69. James and Eliza were living in Little Moor, Stockport a the time of their marriage, parents Ralph Barratt and Martin Warburton, both labourers.

5. Thomas Warburton (*Joseph*¹). Thomas was born in Torkington, Cheshire, abt 1803. ■ Census for Marple, Cheshire, in 1841. Thomas (36) is a coal miner living at [Windlehurst] with Ann (32), Eli (7), Richard (6), Hannah (2), and Mary (1 month). ■ Census for Poynton, Cheshire, in 1851. Thomas (47) is a coal miner living in Jarmans Square with Ann (43), Eli (17) a coal miner, Richard (15) a coal miner, Hannah (12), Jane (6), Martha (3), and Thomas (1). Note that the same address can be reported as in Poynton, Worth, or Poynton with Worth depending on the year of the census. ■ Census for Poynton, Cheshire, in 1861. Thomas (58) is a coal miner living in German Square with Ann (53), Richard (25) a coal miner, Jane (16), and Martha (13) cotton weavers (steam powered), and Thomas (11) a coal miner. ■ Census for Poynton, Cheshire, in 1871. Thomas (68) is a coal miner living in German Square with Ann (63), and Thomas (21) a coal miner. ■ Census for Poynton, Cheshire, in 1881. Thomas (age indistict but transcribed as 72 by Ancestry) is a widowed collier living at 26 German Square. Thomas died in Poynton, Cheshire, in 1883.

No baptism records have been found for Thomas, or his children.

Thomas's death was probably that registered in 1g 1883 Macclesfield 8a 83, aged 80.

On 29 Jul 1833 when Thomas was 30, he married **Ann Rowbotham** in Cheadle, St Mary, Cheshire. Ann was born in Marple, Cheshire, abt 1807. Ann died in Poynton, Cheshire, in 1873.

Ann's death was probably that registered in 2q 1873 Stockport 8a 64, aged 66.

They had the following children:

- **15** i. **Eli Warburton** (~1833-1909)
- 16 ii. Richard Warburton (~1835->1880)
 - iii. **Hannah Warburton**. Hannah was born in Marple, Cheshire, abt 1838. Hannah died in Pemberton, Lancashire, in 1908.

Hannah's birth was registered in 4q 1838 Stockport 19 228. Her death was registered in 3q 1908 Wigan 8c 79, aged 70.

On 15 Aug 1859 when Hannah was 21, she married **Luke Butterworth** in Prestbury, St Peter, Cheshire. Hannah (20) was of Poynton, father Thomas, a collier. Luke (21) was a blacksmith of Adlington, father Thomas, a blacksmith. The marriage was registered in 3q 1859 Macclesfield 8a 189. Luke and Hannah had 7 children in the 1881 census. Luke was born in Adlington, Cheshire, abt 1838. Luke died in Poynton, Cheshire, in 1882.

Luke's death was registered in 3q 1882 Macclesfield 8a 72, aged 44.

iv. Mary Warburton. Mary was born in Marple, Cheshire, in 1841. Mary died in Marple, Cheshire, in 1841. She was buried in Marple, All Saints, Cheshire, on 9 Jun 1841.

Mary's birth was registered in 2q 1841 Stockport 19 284 or 267 (2 Marys were registered). Her death was registered in 2q 1841 Stockport 19 206. She was buried aged 4 weeks.

v. **Jane Warburton**. Jane was born in Poynton, Cheshire, abt 1845. Jane died in Poynton, Cheshire, in 1921.

Jane's birth was registered in 1q 1845 Macclesfield 19 135.. Her death was probably that registered in 2q 1921 Macclesfield 8a 123, aged 76.

On 25 Sep 1865 when Jane was 20, she married **James Clayton** in Prestbury, St Peter, Cheshire. Jane (21) was from Poynton, father Thomas a miner. James (23) was a brakesman from Adlington, father Nathan, a miner. The marriage was registered in 3q 1865 Macclesfield 8a 200. James and Jane had 9 children, 6 still living in 1911. James was born in Adlington, Cheshire, abt 1841. James died in 1908.

James's death is probably that registered in 4q 1908 Macclesfield 8a 85, aged 66.

vi. **Martha Warburton**. Martha was born in Poynton, Cheshire, abt 1847. Martha died in Mottram, Cheshire, in 1883.

Martha's birth was registered in 2q 1847 Macclesfield 19 135. Her death was registered in 2q 1883 Ashton 8d 397, aged 36. She was living in Mottram in 1881

so it assumed she was still there in 1883 as it is in the Ashton registration district.

On 5 Mar 1867 when Martha was 20, she married **Joseph Arnfield Barnes** in Stockport, St Mary, Cheshire. Martha was from Marple, father Thomas, a collier. Joseph was a printer from Marple, father Samuel, a printer. The marriage was registered in 1q 1867 Stockport 8a 69. Joseph and Martha had 6 children in the 1881 census. Joseph Arnfield was born in Marple, Cheshire, abt 1843.

Joseph remarried to Elizabeth Wilcox at Godley, St John, Cheshire in 1883.

vii. Thomas Warburton. Thomas was born in Poynton, Cheshire, abt 1849.

Thomas's birth was registered in 4q 1849 Macclesfield 19 116. He has not been found in censuses after 1871, but there is no obvious death registration either.

6. James Warburton (*Joseph*¹). James was born in Torkington, Cheshire, abt 1806. ■ Census for Poynton, Cheshire, in 1841. James (35) is a coal miner living in Jarmans Square with Nancy (33), sons Thomas (15), Ellis (13), and Samuel (10) all coal miners, Jane (7), Betty (4), and Sarah (1). ■ Census for Poynton, Cheshire, in 1851. James (45) is a coal miner living in Jarmans Square with Nancy (43), sons Thomas (23), Ellis (22), and Samuel (20) all coal miners, Jane (17), Betty (13), Mary (8), James (5), and Charles (2). ■ Census for Worth, Cheshire, in 1861. James (55) is a coal miner living in Park Lane with Nancy (52), Samuel (30) a widowed coal miner, Mary (18), James (15) a coal miner, and Charles (12) a coal miner. ■ Census for Worth, Cheshire, in 1871. James (65) is a coal miner living in Park Lane with Nancy (63). James died in 1872.

James's death was registered in 1g 1872 Macclesfield 8a 78, aged 66.

On 30 Oct 1825 when James was 19, he married **Nancy Richardson** in Stockport, St Mary, Cheshire. Nancy was born in Norbury, Cheshire, abt 1807. ■ Census for Poynton, Cheshire, in 1881. Nancy (73) is an annuitant living in Clayton Field with her widowed son-in-law William Wild and his family. Nancy died in 1889.

Nancy's death was registered in 2q 1889 Macclesfield 8a 74, aged 82.

They had the following children:

i. Thomas Warburton. Thomas was born in Torkington, Cheshire, in 1826. He was christened in Disley, St Mary, Cheshire, on 26 Mar 1826. ■ Census for Worth, Cheshire, in 1861. Thomas (35) is a coal miner (fireman) living in Park Lane with Sarah (39). ■ Census for Worth, Cheshire, in 1871. Thomas (45) is a coal miner living in Park Lane (next to his brother Ellis and his parents) with Sarah (49). ■ Census for Poynton, Cheshire, in 1881. Thomas (56) is a coal mine fireman living at Clayton Field with Sarah (59). ■ Census for Poynton, Cheshire, in 1891. Thomas (66) is a coal miner living at Clayton Field with Sarah (68). ■ Census for Poynton, Cheshire, in 1901. Thomas (78) is a fireman in a coal mine living at Clayton Field with Sarah (79). Thomas died in Poynton, Cheshire, in 1906. He was buried in Poynton, St George, Cheshire, in Aug 1906.

Thomas's death was registered in 3q 1906 Macclesfield 8a 89, aged 81. He was buried in grave C 183. He was childless (or no children survived).

On 20 Sep 1852 when Thomas was 26, he married **Sarah Handford (nee Newton)** in Prestbury, St Peter, Cheshire. Thomas (27) was a collier from Worth, father James, a collier. Sarah (30) was a widow from Worth, father Peter Newton, a weaver. Jane Warburton was a witness. The marriage was registered in 3q 1852 Macclesfield 8a 216 (though Thomas is omitted from the FreeBMD index). Sarah was born in Woodford, Cheshire, abt 1822. Sarah died in 1905. She was buried in Poynton, St George, Cheshire, in Apr 1905.

Sarah's death was registered in 2q 1905 Macclesfield 8a 71, aged 86. She was buried in grave C 183.

 - iii. Samuel Warburton. Samuel was born in Torkington, Cheshire, abt 1830. ■
 Census for Worth, Cheshire, in 1861. Samuel (30) is a widowed coal miner living with his parents. Census for Worth, Cheshire, in 1871. Samuel (40) is a coal miner living in Park Lane with Elizabeth (42). Census for Worth, Cheshire, in 1881. Sam'l (50) is a coal miner living in Hockley with Elizabeth (52), and brother-in-law William Clayton (55) a colliery engine tester. Census for Poynton-with-Worth, Cheshire, in 1891. Samuel (60) is a widowed coal miner living in Hockley with niece Mary Hallam (28) housekeeper, and a boarder William Clayton (66). Census for Poynton-with-Worth, Cheshire, in 1901. Sam'l (70) is a retired miner living in Marlfield Cottages with Mary (64). Samuel died in 1913.

Samuel's death is probably that registered in 3q 1913 Macclesfield 8a 141, aged 82.

On 11 May 1857 when Samuel was 27, he first married **Julia Mottershead** in Prestbury, St Peter, Cheshire. Samuel (25) was a collier living in Worth, father James, a collier. Julia (33) was a spinster from Worth, father Samuel, a collier. The marriage was registered in 2q 1857 Macclesfield 8a 171. Julia was born abt 1823. Julia died in 1860. She was buried in Poynton, St George, Cheshire, on 1 Jun 1860.

Julia's death was registered in 2q 1860 Macclesfield 8a 67. She was buried aged 37.

On 3 Nov 1862 when Samuel was 32, he second married **Elizabeth Hallam** in Poynton, St George, Cheshire. Samuel was a widowed collier from Worth, father James, a collier. Elizabeth was a spinster from Worth, father John, a blacksmith. The marriage was registered in 4q 1862 Macclesfield 8a 133. Elizabeth was born in Poynton, Cheshire, abt 1828. Elizabeth died in Worth, Cheshire, in 1886.

Elizabeth's death is probably that registered in 2q 1886 Macclesfield 8a 75, aged 57.

On 2 May 1892 when Samuel was 62, he third married **Mary Torkington (nee Oldham)** in Poynton, St George, Cheshire. Samuel (60) was a widowed collier from Poynton, father James, a collier. Mary (55) was a widow from Poynton, father William Oldham, a farmer. The marriage was registered in 2q 1892 Macclesfield 8a 219. Mary was born in Bosden, Cheshire, abt 1837.

iv. Jane Warburton. Jane was born in Torkington, Cheshire, abt 1833. She was christened in Marple Bridge, Derbyshire, on 13 Jan 1834. Jane died in Worth, Cheshire, in 1865. She was buried in Poynton, St George, Cheshire, on 25 Oct 1865.

Jane's baptism is listed in the non-conformist record indexes, parents James and Nancy. It is unclear why she was baptised in Derbyshire. Her death was registered in 4q 1865 Macclesfield 8a 75. She was buried aged 32.

On 27 Mar 1854 when Jane was 21, she married **David Hallam** in Prestbury, St Peter, Cheshire. Jane (20) was from Worth, father James, a collier. David (22) was a blacksmith from Poynton, father John, a blacksmith. The marriage was registered in 1q 1854 Macclesfield 8a 199. Jane and David had 2 children in the 1861 census. David was born in Poynton, Cheshire, abt 1831.

From censuses it appears that David remarrried to a Charlotte before 1871, and moved to Toxteth, but the only likely marriage is to a Catherine Taylor at Cheadle in 1867.

v. Hannah Warburton. Hannah was born in Poynton, Cheshire, in 1836. She was

christened in Poynton, St George, Cheshire, on 31 Jul 1836. Hannah died in Poynton, Cheshire, in 1836. She was buried in Norbury, St Thomas, Cheshire, on 11 Sep 1836.

Hannah was buried aged 4 months.

vi. **Betty Warburton**. Betty was born in Poynton, Cheshire, in 1837. She was christened in Poynton, St George, Cheshire, on 17 Sep 1837. Betty died in Worth, Cheshire, in 1854. She was buried in Poynton, St George, Cheshire, on 14 Sep 1854.

Betty's death registration is not on FreeBMD but CheshireBMD has a registration at Presbury ref: PRE/4/49. She was buried aged 17.

vii. **Mary Warburton**. Mary was born in Poynton, Cheshire, abt 1842. Mary died in Poynton, Cheshire, in 1878. She was buried in Poynton, St George, Cheshire, on 4 Dec 1878.

Mary's birth was registered in 4q 1842 Macclesfield 19 113. Her death was registered (as Mary Wild) in 4q 1878 Macclesfield 8a 82, aged 36. She was from Worth in Poynton on her burial record.

On 28 Jul 1862 when Mary was 20, she married **William Wilde** in Poynton, St George, Cheshire. William (19) was a collier, father John, a joiner. Mary (20) was a spinster, father James, a collier. Both were living in Worth. The marriage was registered in 3q 1862 Macclesfield 8a 139. Three sons and two daughters are living with Mary's widowed husband in the 1881 census (along with Mary's mother). William was born in Bosden, Cheshire, abt 1843. William died in Poynton, Cheshire, in 1891.

William married two Warburtons, firstly Mary, and then Martha Potts nee Warburton. His death was registerd in 2q 1891 Macclesfield 8a 114, aged 47.

- **7. Peter Warburton** (*Joseph*¹). Peter was born in Torkington, Cheshire, on 15 Sep 1810. He was christened in Stockport, St Mary, Cheshire, on 26 Oct 1810. Census for Torkington, Cheshire, in 1841. Peter (30) is a coal miner living with Ann (28) a hand loom weaver, Enos (7), Rachel (5), and Martha (3). Census for Poynton, Cheshire, in 1851. Peter (40) is a coal miner living in Park Lane with Ann (38), Enos (16), Rachel (15), Martha (13), Sarah (8), and James (5). Census for Poynton, Cheshire, in 1861. Peter (50) is a coal miner living in Park Lane with Ann (48), James (15) a coalminer, Francis Ayre (9), Ellis (6), grandson Joseph (2) the son of daughter Rachel, daughter Sarah Jackson (18), and her husband John Jackson (23) a coal miner. Census for Poynton, Cheshire, in 1871. Peter (60) is a coal miner living in Park Lane with Ann (58), Francis

Ayre (19) a coal miner, and Joseph (12) who is described as son, but is the son of daughter Rachel. Daughters Martha, and Sarah, neice Mary, and nephew Eli all live in adjacent properties. Peter died in 1871. He was buried in Stockport, Cheshire, on 25 Jul 1871.

Although Peter's parents are described as John and Hannah, it is believed this is a mistake and his father was Joseph. This is because there is no evidence of other children of John and Hannah, and no satisfactory marriage. However there are a number of baptisms of children of Joseph and Hannah of Torkington, and a corresponding marriage at Stockport. Also Peter calls his youngest son Ellis, the same as Joseph and Hannah's youngest son (i.e. his brother), and he is a collier like many of Joseph's sons.

His death was registered in 3q 1871 Stockport 8a 33, aged 60. He was also 60 on his burial record.

On 12 Aug 1832 when Peter was 21, he married **Ann Oldham** in Cheadle, St Mary, Cheshire. Ann was born in Gorton, Lancashire, abt 1812. Ann died in Poynton, Cheshire, in 1876. She was buried in Poynton, St George, Cheshire, on 15 Mar 1876.

Ann's death was registered in 1q 1876 Macclesfield 8a 89, aged 63.

They had the following children:

- i. **Enos Warburton**. Enos was born in Stockport, Cheshire, on 25 May 1834. He was christened in Hazel Grove, Ebenezer Congregational, Cheshire, on 14 Jul 1834.
 - Enos cannot be found in censuses after 1851 but there is no death or marriage registration either. It seems he either emigrated or changed his name.
- 20 ii. Rachel Warburton (1836-1926)
 - iii. Martha Warburton. Martha was born in Prestbury, Cheshire, in 1837. She was christened in Norbury, St Thomas, Cheshire, on 3 Dec 1837. Martha died aft 1911.

On 29 Aug 1859 when Martha was 22, she first married **William Potts** in Prestbury, St Peter, Cheshire. William (24) was a collier, father Daniel. Martha (21) was a spinster, father Peter. The marriage was registered in 3q 1859 Macclesfield 8a 196. From the censuses it would appear that William and Martha were childless (or had no children that survived). William was born in Adlington, Cheshire, abt 1834. William died in 1882.

William's death is probably that registered in 3q 1882 Macclesfield 8a 74, aged 47.

On 31 Mar 1884 when Martha was 47, she second married **William Wilde** in Poynton, St George, Cheshire. Martha Potts (45) was the widowed daughter of Peter Warburton, collier. William Wild (40) was a widowed collier, father John (deceased), a joiner. William was born in Bosden, Cheshire, abt 1843. William died

in Poynton, Cheshire, in 1891.

William married two Warburtons, firstly Mary, and then Martha Potts nee Warburton. His death was registerd in 2q 1891 Macclesfield 8a 114, aged 47.

iv. **Sarah Warburton**. Sarah was born in Torkington, Cheshire, abt 1842. Sarah died in Newton, Cheshire, in 1904.

Sarah's birth was registered in 1q 1843 Stockport 19 242, mother's maiden name Oldham. Her death is probably that registered in 4q 1904 Ashton 8d 372, aged 62.

On 5 Nov 1860 when Sarah was 18, she married **John Jackson** in Poynton, St George, Cheshire. Sarah (18) was from Worth, father Peter, a collier. John (23) was a collier from Worth, father Moses, a clogger. The marriage was registered in 4q 1860 Macclesfield 8a 199. John and Sarah had three daughters. John was born in Kettleshulme, Cheshire, abt 1837. John died aft 1901.

John's death registration has not been isolated, but he hasn't been found in the 1911 census either.

Census for Norbury, Cheshire, in 1851. Ellis (35) is a coal miner living in Church Cottages, Buxton Road with Elizabeth (28) a hand loom worker (silk), David (11), Margaret (10), and Joseph (8). Census for Norbury, Cheshire, in 1861. Ellis (45) is a coal miner living in Church Cottages, Manchester and Buxton Road with Elizabeth (38), David (21) a coal miner, and Joseph (18) a coal miner. Census for Norbury, Cheshire, in 1871. Ellis (55) is a clock and watch dealer living in London Road with Elizabeth (48). Census for Norbury, Cheshire, in 1881. Ellis (65) is a watch maker living in Man[chester] and Buxton Road with Elizabeth (59), widowed brother Samuel (68) a watchman in a cotton mill, and Margaret (12) described as a lodger, but daughter of son Joseph. Census for Norbury, Cheshire, in 1891. Ellis (75) is a widowed watch maker living at 361 London Road with grandchildren Mary (23) a calico weaver, and Ellis (13) a shoemaker, plus a lodger Jane Mather (32) a calico weaver. Ellis died in Norbury, Cheshire, in 1899. He was buried in Norbury, St Thomas, Cheshire, on 29 Jul 1899.

Ellis's death was registered in 3q 1899 Stockport 8a 91, aged 84.

On 25 Nov 1838 when Ellis was 23, he first married **Mary Oldham** in Stockport, St Mary, Cheshire. Ellis was a collier of Torkington, father Joseph. Mary was from Bosden, father John. The marriage was registered in 4q 1838 Stockport 19 248. Mary was born abt 1817. Mary died in Torkington,

Cheshire, in 1843. She was buried in Norbury, St Thomas, Cheshire, on 24 Sep 1843.

Mary of Torkington was buried aged 26. Her death was registered in 3q 1843 Stockport 19 184.

They had the following children:

- **24** i. **David Warburton** (1839-1875)
 - ii. Margaret Warburton. Margaret was born in 1841.

There is no obvious birth registration or baptism for Margaret.

25 iii. **Joseph Warburton** (1842-1901)

On 16 Jul 1848 when Ellis was 33, he second married **Elizabeth Malpas** in Macclesfield, St Michael, Cheshire. Ellis was a widowed collier of Macclesfield, father Joseph, husbandman. Elizabeth was a spinster of Macclesfield, father Edward, a sadler. The marriage was registered in 3q 1848 Macclesfield 19 115. Elizabeth was born in Bosden, Cheshire, abt 1822. Elizabeth died in 1887. She was buried in Norbury, St Thomas, Cheshire, on 25 Jun 1887.

Elizabeth was living in London Road at the time of her death, aged 65. The only death registered in the 2nd quarter was for a Betty Warburton aged 67, Stockport 8a 73, which may be her despite the incorrect age and the fact she was buried as Elizabeth..

9. Elizabeth Warburton (Joseph¹). Elizabeth was born in Torkington, Cheshire, abt 1817.

Elizabeth was only discovered because her daughter Hannah was living with her uncle Charles in 1851.

She first did not marry **Unknown**.

They had one child:

i. **Hannah Warburton**. Hannah was born in Torkington, Cheshire, in 1837. She was christened in Norbury, Cheshire, on 5 Dec 1837.

Hannah still had the name Warburton in 1841, but by 1851 was known as Hannah Goodwin after her mother's husband.

On 24 Dec 1838 when Elizabeth was 21, she second married **John Goodwin** in Stockport, St Mary, Cheshire. Elizabeth was a spinster of Torkington, father Joseph, a labourer. John was an engineer of Marple, father George, an agent. John was born in Marple, Cheshire, abt 1817.

10. Betty Warburton (*Martin*², *Joseph*¹). Betty was born in Torkington, Cheshire, in 1820. She was christened on 25 Feb 1820.

Martin was described as a weaver on Betty's baptism. Betty has not been found in censuses after 1841, nor has a marriage or death been found.

She did not marry Unknown.

They had one child:

26 i. **Elias Warburton** (1839-1874)

11. William Warburton (*Martin*², *Joseph*¹). William was born in Torkington, Cheshire, in 1824. He was christened in Stockport, St Mary, Cheshire, on 25 May 1824. ■ Census for Marple, Cheshire, in 1851. William (26) is a coal miner living at Dold Field with Martha (27) who is employed at a cotton mill. ■ Census for Marple, Cheshire, in 1861. William (37) is a coal miner living at Dood Field with Martha (37) a cotton cut hooker, Jane (7), and Martin (4). ■ Census for Marple, Cheshire, in 1871. William (46) is a foreman living in Ridge Fold with Martha (47), Jane (18), and Martin (14). Both children are cotton weavers. ■ Census for Marple, Cheshire, in 1881. William (56) is a coal miner living at Carrington Barn with Martha (57), and Martin (24) a general labourer. William died in Marple, Cheshire, in 1888.

Martin is described as a labourer on William's baptism. William's death was registered in 2q 1888 Stockport 8a 2, aged 64.

On 23 Nov 1846 when William was 22, he married **Martha Howard** in Stockport, St Mary, Cheshire. William was a collier of Torkington, father Martin, a labourer. Martha was from Marple, father George, a sawyer. The marriage was registered in 4q 1846 Stockport 19 269. Martha was born in Compstall, Marple, Cheshire, abt 1823. • Census for Marple, Cheshire, in 1891. Martha (64) is a widow living in Chapel or Station Street (sic) with Martin (34) a blacksmith's striker. Martha died in Hazel Grove, Cheshire, in 1895.

Martha's death was registered in 2q 1895 Stockport 8a 73, aged 71.

They had the following children:

- i. Jane Warburton. Jane was born in Marple, Cheshire, in 1852. Jane died in 1931.
 - Jane's birth was registered in 2q 1852 Stockport 8a 4, mother's maiden name Howard. Her death was registered in 4q 1931 West Derby 8b 457, aged 79.
 - In 1875 when Jane was 23, she married **Joseph Mottram** in Stockport, St Thomas, Cheshire. The marriage was registered in 4q 1875 Stockport 8a 135. Joseph and Jane had 2 sons and lived in Walton-on-the Hill, Liverpool. Joseph was born in Compstall, Marple, Cheshire, abt 1843.
- ii. Martin Warburton. Martin was born in Marple, Cheshire, abt 1857. Census for Marple, Cheshire, in 1901. Martin (44) is a labourer in an engineering works living at 20 Reuben Street with Sarah (42) and a boarder. Census for Heaton Norris, Cheshire, in 1911. Martin (54) is a labourer at a printers living at 9 Morton Street with Sarah (52) and a boarder. Martin and Sarah have been married 14 years but had no children. Martin died in 1931.

Martin's birth was registered in 1q 1857 Stockport 8a 2, mother's maiden name Howard. His death was registered in 1q 1931 Stockport 8a 145, aged 73.

In 1897 when Martin was 40, he married **Sarah Mountany** in Heaton Norris, All Saints, Cheshire. The marriage was registered in 2q 1897 Stockport 8a 35. Sarah was born in Stockport, Cheshire, abt 1858.

12. Samuel Warburton (*Martin*², *Joseph*¹). Samuel was born in Torkington, Cheshire, abt 1827. He was christened in Stockport, St Mary, Cheshire, on 20 Apr 1828. ■ Census for Worsborough, Yorkshire, in 1861. Samuel (33) is an iron miner living in Birdwell with Hannah (36). ■ Census for Nether Hoyland, Barnsley, South Yorkshire, in 1871. Samuel (44) is a miner living with Hannah (46), Lucy Ann (7), and Herbert (3). ■ Census for Nether Hoyland, Barnsley, South Yorkshire, in 1881. Samuel (53) is a coal miner living in Warburton House with Hannah (55), and Herbert (13). Samuel died in 1885.

Martin is described as a labourer on Samuel's baptism. Samuel's death was registered in 1q 1885 Wortley 9c 194, aged 60.

In 1858 when Samuel was 31, he married **Hannah Gelder** in Wortley, Yorkshire. The marriage was registered in 4q 1860 Wortley 9c 247. Hannah was born in Ardsley, Yorkshire, abt 1825.

Hannah's identity, and therefore her marriage are speculative. There are 2 marriages registered at Wortley where the spouse may be named Hannah. The other is in 1860 to either Hannah Platts or Ann Milne. Hannah Gelder is most likely because there is no alternative bride in the index, and there are Gelders from Ardsley, though Hannah cannot be found in 1851.

They had the following children:

 i. Lucy Ann Warburton. Lucy Ann was born in Hoyland Common, Barnsley, South Yorkshire, in 1863. ■ Census for Fairfield, Derbyshire, in 1871. Lucy (17) is an under house maid at Holme Leigh School.

Lucy's birth was registered in 2q 1863 Barnsley 9c 158.

In 1883 when Lucy Ann was 20, she married **William Arthur Bell** in Wortley, Yorkshire. The marriage was registered in 4q 1883 Wortley 9c 387. She and her husband William Bell had 2 sons and moved to Gorton and Droylsden in Lancashire. One son was still living in 1911.

ii. Herbert Warburton. Herbert was born in Hoyland Common, Barnsley, South Yorkshire, in 1867. ■ Census for Barnsley, Yorkshire, in 1891. Herbert (24) is an inmate in the Barnsley Union Workhouse, and described as an imbecile. Herbert died in Barnsley, Yorkshire, in 1895.

Herbert's birth was registered in 2q 1867 Barnsley 9c 192. His death was probably that registered in 3q 1895 Barnsley 9c 118, aged 27.

13. Ann Warburton (*Martin*², *Joseph*¹). Ann was born in Torkington, Cheshire, in 1830. She was christened in Stockport, St Mary, Cheshire, on 26 Feb 1830. Ann died in Green Clough farm, Torkington, Cheshire, in 1893. She was buried in Norbury, St Thomas, Cheshire, on 25 Jan 1893.

Martin is described as a labourer on Ann's baptism. Ann and her husband are found living next door to her parents in several censuses. Her death was registered in 1q 1893 Stockport 8a 77, aged 63.

She first did not marry **Unknown**.

They had the following children:

i. **Charles Warburton**. Charles was born in Bosden, Cheshire, in 1857. Charles died in Torkington, Cheshire, in 1861.

Charles's birth was registered in 3q 1857 Stockport 8a 85, and his death in 3q 1861 Stockport 8a 63, aged 4. No baptism has been found so it is unclear who his mother is. However he is one of two grandsons living with his grandfather Martin in 1861 and as the other is living as Ann's son in 1871, Ann is assumed to be Charles's mother also, pending sight of the birth certificate.

ii. **John Warburton**. John was born in Torkington, Cheshire, in 1860.

John's birth was registered in 3q 1860 Stockport 8a 73 or 77. He appears as John Warburton in the 1861 and 1871 censuses but subsequently is known as John Wilson.

On 29 Mar 1868 when Ann was 38, she second married **Jesse Wilson** in Stockport, St Mary, Cheshire. Jesse was a widowed labourer, father James, a labourer. Ann's father was Martin, a labourer. Jesse's death was registered in 2q 1895 Stockport 8a 73, aged 66.

14. Charles Warburton (*Martin*², *Joseph*¹). Charles was born in Torkington, Cheshire, on 12 Nov 1838. He was christened in Norbury, St Thomas, Cheshire, on 9 Dec 1838. ■ Census for Bosden, Stockport, Cheshire, in 1871. Charles (32) is a hatter lodging with the Malpas family in London Road with Betty (31), and Isaac (7). ■ Census for Bredbury, Cheshire, in 1881. Charles (41) is a farmer of 38 acres employing 1 boy, and living at Bank Farm with Ann (36), Isaac (17) a farmer's son, Annie (4), James (1), and a servant. ■ Census for Bredbury, Cheshire, in 1891. Charles (52) is a farmer living in Hall Lane with Ann (47), Maria (14), and James (11). Maria would appear to be a mistake, as she should be Annie. ■ Census for Denton, Lancashire, in 1901. Charles (62) is a farmer living at 143 Haughton Green with Ann (55), Annie (24), and James (21). Charles died in 1911.

Charles's birth was registerd in 4q 1838 Stockport 19 195. His death is probably that registered in 4q 1911 Ashton 8d 586, aged 73, though he has not been found in the 1911 census.

In 1862 when Charles was 23, he first married **Betty Pearson** in Cheadle, St Mary, Cheshire. The marriage was registered in 2q 1862 Stockport 8a 16. Betty was born in Bramall, Cheshire, abt 1839. Betty died in Stockport, Cheshire, in 1871.

Betty's death was registered in 2q 1871 Stockport 8a 56, aged 31.

They had one child:

27 i. **Isaac Warburton** (1863-)

In 1872 when Charles was 33, he second married **Ann Langton** in Cheadle, St Mary, Cheshire. The marriage was registered in 2q 1872 Stockport 8a 29. Ann was born in Denton, Lancashire, abt 1844. Ann died in Denton, Lancashire, in 1907.

Ann's death is probably that registered in 4q 1907 Ashton 8d 366, aged 63.

Eli (47) is a coal miner and farmer of 15 acres living at Etchells Farm with Hannah (45), George (16) a farmer's son, Eli (8), Elizabeth (6), and Sarah (4). ■ Census for Torkington, Cheshire, in 1891. Eli (57) is a farmer living at Etchells Farm with Hannah (54), Eli (18), Elizabeth (16), and Sarah (14). Both daughters are cotton weavers. ■ Census for Poynton, Cheshire, in 1901. Eli (66) is a widower working (exact job indistinct) in a coal mine and living with his sister Jane Clayton (55), her husband James (58) and three of their children. Eli died in 1909.

Eli's death was registered in 2q 1909 Stockport 8a 4, aged 75.

On 14 Feb 1861 when Eli was 28, he married **Hannah Booth** in Stockport, St Mary, Cheshire. Eli was a collier of Marple, father Thomas, a collier. Hannah was of Marple, father John, a farmer. Eli's brother Richard was a witness. The marriage was registered in 1q 1861 Stockport 8a 88. Hannah was born in Marple, Cheshire, abt 1836. Hannah died in 1897. She was buried in Poynton, St George, Cheshire, in Mar 1897.

Hannah's death was registered in 1q 1897 Stockport 8a 81, aged 60. She was buried in grave B 47.

They had the following children:

- 30 ii. Eli Warburton (~1872-)
 - iii. Elizabeth Warburton. Elizabeth was born in Poynton, Cheshire, in 1874.

In 1898 when Elizabeth was 24, she married **Joseph Shaw** in Stockport, Cheshire (Civil Marriage). The marriage was registered in 2q 1898 Stockport 8a 190. By 1911 Elizabeth was a widow with five children. Joseph was born in Ashton, Lancashire, abt 1873.

Sarah's birth was registered in 3q 1876 Macclesfield 8a 112.

James (22) was a fireman from Marple, father George, an engine driver. The marriage was registered in 4q 1900 Stockport 8a 61. Eli (probably Sarah's brother) was a witness. By the 1911 census Sarah and James had had two children, both living. James Thomas was born in Marple, Cheshire, abt 1878.

Ellis (33) is a coal miner living in Park Lane (next door to his parents) with Fanny (28), James (6), Betty (2), and Samuel (2 mths). ■ Census for Worth, Cheshire, in 1871. Ellis (42) is a coal miner living in Park Lane (next door to his parents) with Frances (28), James (16), Betty (12), Thomas (8), William (5), and Ellen (1 mth). ■ Census for Poynton, Cheshire, in 1881. Ellis (52) is an underlooker in a coal mine living in Park Lane with Frances (48), James (26) a coal miner, Betty (22) a hat trimmer, Thomas (18) a coal miner, William (15) a pupil teacher, and Emily (7). Although the location is now Poynton, not Worth, it seems Ellis has not actually moved. ■ Census for Worth, Cheshire, in 1891. Ellis (62) is an underlooker in a coal mine living in Park Lane with Frances (58), and Emily (17) a hat trimmer. ■ Census for Poynton-with-Worth, Cheshire, in 1901. Ellis (72) is a retired underlooker living in Park Lane, with son-in-law John Beard (28), daughter Emily Beard (27), and their son Arthur (2). Ellis died in 1902. He was buried in Poynton, St George, Cheshire, in Apr 1902.

Ellis's death was registered in 2q 1902 Macclesfield 8a 79, aged 74. He was buried in grave C 154.

On 20 Nov 1854 when Ellis was 26, he married **Frances Hartley** in Prestbury, St Peter, Cheshire. The marriage was registered in 4q 1854 Macclesfield 8a 176. Frances was born in Poynton, Cheshire, abt 1833. Frances died in 1893. She was buried in Poynton, St George, Cheshire, in Mar 1893.

Frances's death was registered in 1q 1893 Macclesfield 8a 74, aged 60. She was buried in grave C 154. The North Cheshire Memorial Inscription transcript has the date as March 1895 but this would seem to be an error.

i. James Warburton. James was born in Worth, Cheshire, in 1855. ■ Census for Worth, Cheshire, in 1891. James (36) is a coal miner living in Park Lane with Hannah (37), and father-in-law James Pearson (60) a coal miner. James's name is transcribed as Warrender by Ancestry. ■ Census for Poynton-with-Worth, Cheshire, in 1901. James junior (46) is a widowed colliery fireman living alone, next door to his father in Park Road. ■ Census for Poynton, Cheshire, in 1911. James junior (56) is a coal miner (shot firer) living at 314 Park Lane with Eliza (57). They have been married 8 years, and had no children. James died aft 1911.

James's birth was registered in 1q 1855 Macclesfield 8a 101.

On 25 Jul 1883 when James was 28, he first married **Hannah Pearson** in Macclesfield, St Paul, Cheshire. James (28) was a miner of Macclesfield, father Ellis, an overlooker. Hannah (29) was of Macclesfield, father Thomas Clayton, a miner. The fathers are switched on the parish record. James's brother Thomas, and his future wife Martha Ellen Jackson were witnesses. The marriage was registered in 3q 1883 Macclesfield 8a 198. Hannah was born abt 1854. Hannah died in 1900. She was buried in Poynton, St George, Cheshire, in May 1900.

Hannah was buried in grave C 143, aged 46. her death was registered in 2q 1900 Macclesfield 8a 89.

In 1902 when James was 47, he second married **Elizabeth Howells** in Poynton, St George, Cheshire. The marriage was registered in 4q 1902 Macclesfield 8a 251. Elizabeth was born in Holdgate, Shropshire, abt 1854.

ii. Betty Warburton. Betty was born in Worth, Cheshire, in 1858. Betty died in 1948.

Betty's birth was registered in 4q 1858 Macclesfield 8a 78. Her death was registered in 1q 1948 Macclesfield 10a 371, aged 89.

On 25 Jul 1883 when Betty was 25, she married **John Clayton** in Macclesfield, St Paul, Cheshire. Betty (24) was from Macclesfield, father Ellis, an overlooker. John (25) was a miner from Macclesfield, father Thomas, a miner. The marriage was registered in 3q 1883 Macclesfield 8a 197. In 1911 John and Betty were living at 318 Park Lane, Poynton, but have had no children. John was born in Poynton, Cheshire, abt 1858. John died in 1925.

John's death was registered in 2q 1925 Macclesfield 8a 120, aged 67.

iii. Samuel Warburton. Samuel was born in Worth, Cheshire, in 1861. Samuel died in Worth, Cheshire, in 1862. He was buried in Poynton, St George, Cheshire, on 8 Oct 1862.

In 1898 when Emily was 24, she married **John Beard** in Macclesfield, Cheshire (Civil Marriage). The marriage was registered in 1q 1898 Macclesfield 8a 200. In the 1911 census Emily and John have had 3 children, all living. John was born in Poynton, Cheshire, abt 1872.

18. James Warburton (*James*², *Joseph*¹). James was born in Poynton, Cheshire, abt 1845. ■ Census for Worth, Cheshire, in 1871. James (25) is a coal miner living in Park Lane with Mary (24), William (3), and Alfred (1). ■ Census for Poynton, Cheshire, in 1881. James (35) is a coal miner living in Hockley with Mary (34), William (13), Alfred (11), Henry (8), Elizabeth (6), Hannah (3) and Frank (1). ■ Census for Worth, Cheshire, in 1891. James (45) is a coal miner living in Hockley with Mary (44), William (26) a coal miner, Alfred (21) a coal miner, Henry (18) a coal miner, Elizabeth (16) a factory operative, Frank (11), and Ethel (9). ■ Census for Poynton-with-Worth, Cheshire, in 1901. James Senr. (55) is a coal hewer living in Park Lane with Mary (54), Ethel (19) a cotton card room hand, and niece Mary Hallam (38) an assistant schoolmistress. Mary was the daughter of James's sister Jane. ■ Census for Poynton-with-Worth, Cheshire, in 1911. James (65) is a coal miner, road repairer living at 1336 Park Lane with Mary (64). James and Mary have benn married 44 years and had 8 children, 6 still living.

James's birth was registered in 3q 1845 Macclesfield 19 119. His death registration is probably that registered in 2q 1919 Macclesfield 8a 128, aged 73.

On 21 Jan 1867 when James was 22, he married **Mary Lloyd** in Prestbury, St Peter, Cheshire. James (21) was a collier from Adlington, father James, a collier. Mary was from Poynton father James, an underlooker. Charles Warburton and Emma Lloyd are witnesses. The marriage was registered in 1q 1867 Macclesfield 8a 160. Mary was born in Poynton, Cheshire, abt 1843.

They had the following children:

- **34** i. **William Warburton** (1867-1949)
- 35 ii. Alfred Warburton (1869-1935)
- **36** iii. **Henry Warburton** (1872-1920)
 - iv. **Elizabeth Warburton**. Elizabeth was born in Poynton, Cheshire, in 1875. Elizabeth died in 1946.

Elizabeth's birth was probably that registered in 2q 1875 Macclesfield 8a 106, based on her age at marriage. Her most likely death registration is in 1q 1946 Macclesfield 8a 244, aged 70, though there are other possibilities.

On 11 Mar 1897 when Elizabeth was 22, she married **Samuel Ridgway** in Poynton, St George, Cheshire. Elizabeth (21) was from Poynton, father James, an underloooker. Samuel (25) was a collier from Poynton, father Charles, a collier. The marriage was registered in 1q 1897 Macclesfield 8a 170. In the 1911 census Samuel and Elizabeth have had 3 children, 2 still living. Samuel was born abt 1871.

v. **Hannah Warburton**. Hannah was born in Poynton, Cheshire, in 1877. Hannah died in Poynton, Cheshire, in 1881.

Hannah's birth was registered in 2q 1877 Macclesfield 8a 111. Her death was registered in 4q 1881 Macclesfield 8a 67, aged 4.

 - vii. Ethel Warburton. Ethel was born in Poynton, Cheshire, in 1881. Ethel died in 1925.

Ethel's birth was registered in 4q 1881 Macclesfield 8a 106. Her death is probably that registered in 4q 1925 Macclesfield 8a 163, aged 44.

In 1906 when Ethel was 25, she married **Seth Ridgway** in Poynton, Methodist Chapel (Park Lane), Cheshire. The marriage was registered in 4q 1906 Macclesfield 8a 285. In the 1911 census Ethel and Seth have had 2 children, one still living. Seth was born in Poynton, Cheshire, abt 1879.

Seth was a coal miner.

19. Charles Warburton (*James*², *Joseph*¹). Charles was born in Poynton, Cheshire, in 1849. ■ Census for Worth, Cheshire, in 1871. Charles (22) is a coal miner living in Heply Yard with Emma (20), and Albert (1). ■ Census for Bollin Fee, Cheshire, in 1881. Charles (32) is a coal agent living in Hawthorn Street with Emma (30), Albert (11), Betty (9), Edith (5), and Fred (3). ■ Census for Stockport, Cheshire, in 1891. Charles (42) is a weighing machine clerk living at 10 Wellington Road with Emma (40), Albert (21) a telegraph mechanic, Edith (15) a hat trimmer, Fred (13) an errand boy, and Ellen (6). ■ Census for Stockport, Cheshire, in 1901. Charles (52) is a coal merchant's clerk living at 28 Wellington Road South with Emma (50), Edith (25), Fred (23) a

labourer in a coal yard, and Ellen (16) a pupil teacher. ■ Census for Stockport, Cheshire, in 1911. Charles (62) is a clerk in a coal office living 42 Wellington Road South with Emma (60), Albert (41) and electrical instrument maker in a railway company, Edith (35), Fred (33) a foreman in a coal yard, grandchildren Dorothy (12), and Lilian (9), and a boarder. Charles and Emma have been married 42 years and had 5 children, all living. Albert has been married 16 years and had 3 children, all living. Charles died in 1923.

Charles's birth was registered in 2q 1849 Macclesfield 19 155. His death was registered in 2q 1923 Stockport 8a 83, aged 74.

On 4 Jan 1869 when Charles was 20, he married **Emma Lloyd** in Prestbury, St Peter, Cheshire. Charles (21) was a collier of Poynton, father James, a collier. Emma (21) was from Adington, father James, an overlooker. James Warburton and Janet Lloyd were witnesses. The marriage was registered in 1q 1869 Macclesfield 8a 141. Emma was born in Poynton, Cheshire, abt 1850. Emma died in 1929.

Emma's death was registered in 1q 1929 Stockport 8a 167, aged 78.

They had the following children:

- **38** i. **Albert Warburton** (1869-)
 - ii. Betty Warburton. Betty was born in Poynton, Cheshire, in 1871.

Betty's birth was registered in 3q 1871 Macclesfield 8a 100.

In 1896 when Betty was 25, she married **Harry King** in Stockport, Cheshire (Civil Marriage). The marriage was registered in 1q 1896 Stockport 8a 115. In 1901 Betty was living with her mother-in-law. She wasn't described as a widow but Harry cannot be found, and by 1911 they are both missing, though there are no obvious death registrations. Harry was born in Stockport, Cheshire, abt 1871.

 Edith Warburton. Edith was born in Poynton, Cheshire, in 1875. Edith died aft 1911.

Edith's birth was registered in 4q 1875 Macclesfield 8a 100. She was still unmaried in 1911, but no death registration matches her birth so she may have subsequently married.

iv. Fred Warburton. Fred was born in Poynton, Cheshire, in 1877. Fred died in 1942.

Fred's birth was registered in 4q 1877 Macclesfield 8a 111. His death was probably that registered in 3q 1942 Stockport 8a 42, aged 64.

v. **Ellen Warburton**. Ellen was born in Wilmslow, Cheshire, in 1885. Ellen died in 1950.

Ellen's birth was registered in 2q 1885 Altrincham 8a 159. Her death was probably

that registered in 4q 1950 Stockport 10a 635, aged 65. There are many Ellen Bennetts born around 1885 but only one whose death was registered in Stockport.

In 1910 when Ellen was 25, she married **Thomas Leigh Bennett** in Stockport, Trinity Methodist Church, Cheshire. The marriage was registered in 1q 1910 Stockport 8a 153. Three daughters were subsequently registered at Stockport with a mother's maiden name of Warburton, and a second given name of Leigh. Thomas Leigh was born in Stockport, Cheshire, abt 1885. Thomas Leigh died in 1953.

Thomas was a pharmacist and optician. His death was probably that registered in 2q 1953 Stockport 10a 490, aged 67.

20. Rachel Warburton (*Peter*², *Joseph*¹). Rachel was born in Prestbury, Cheshire, in 1836. She was christened in Norbury, St Thomas, Cheshire, on 22 May 1836. Rachel died in 1926.

Rachel's death was registered in 2q 1926 Nantwich 8a 406, aged 90.

She first did not marry Unknown.

They had one child:

39 i. Joseph Warburton (1858-1922)

On 9 Feb 1865 when Rachel was 29, she second married **John Kinsey** in Prestbury, St Peter, Cheshire. Rachel (28) was a spinster of Poynton, father Peter. John (24) was an engine driver of Macclesfield father Lownes, a plate layer. The marriage was registered in 1q 1865 Macclesfield 8a 152. John was born abt 1840. John died in 1908.

John's death is possibly that registered in 2q 1908 Stockport 8a 31, aged 67.

21. James Warburton (*Peter*², *Joseph*¹). James was born in Poynton, Cheshire, in 1845. ■ Census for Penwortham, Lancashire, in 1881. James Walburton (35) is an railway engine driver living off New Road with Sarah (32), and Peter (7). ■ Census for Chedworth, Gloucestershire, in 1891. James (45) is a railway contractor's foreman (engine driver and carpenter) living in the village with Sarah (42). ■ Census for Pleasley, Derbyshire, in 1901. James (56) is probably the auctioneer's clerk lodging in Main Street with Thomas and Sarah Johnson. He is described as married. ■ Census for Hever, Kent, in 1911. James is probably the James Walburton (65) a metal broker boarding with George Millen, the Station Master, and his family, at Station House. James says he is married and has been for 10 years but this is crossed out. James died aft 1911.

James's birth was probably that registered in 3q 1845 Stockport 19 227, mother's maiden name Oldham. He is a railway stoker on Enos's birth registration, and an engine driver on Enos's death certificate. His claim in the 1911 census to have been married 10 years implies a second marriage but the details cannot be identified.

On 17 Jun 1867 when James was 22, he married **Sarah Ward** in Heaton Norris, St Thomas, Cheshire. James and Sarah's ages are given as 21, his father is Peter, hers Thomas. The marriage was registered in 2q 1867 Stockport 8a 47. Sarah was born in Hazel Grove, Cheshire, abt 1848. Sarah died abt 1900.

Sarah is missing from the 1901 and 1911 censuses, and given John's claim to have been married 10 years in 1911 she probably died before 1901. The registration in 4q 1900 Chorlton 8c 503, aged 41, is a posible fit,

They had the following children:

- Enos Warburton. Enos was born in Ardwick, Lancashire, in 1868. Enos died in Poynton, Cheshire, in 1876. He was buried in Poynton, St George, Cheshire, on 19 Feb 1876.
 - Enos was discovered accidentally through his burial, aged 8 in grave B.188. His birth was registered in 1q 1868 Chorlton 8c 613. His death was registered in 1q 1876 Macclesfield 8a 88. He is not present in the 1871 census.
- ii. Peter Warburton. Peter was born in Gorton, Lancashire, in 1874.

Peter's birth was registered in 2q 1874 Chorlton 8c 660. He has not been identified in censuses after 1881 but there is no death registration either.

22. Francis Ayre Warburton (*Peter*², *Joseph*¹). Francis Ayre was born in Poynton, Cheshire, in 1851. ■ Census for Worsbrough, Yorkshire, in 1881. Frank (30) is a coal miner living at 4 The Square with Eliza (29), Ruth (9), Martha (5), Emma (3), and Frederick (1 month). ■ Census for Worth, Cheshire, in 1891. Frank (38) is a coal hewer living in Park Lane Terrace with Eliza (37), Ruth (18), Martha (17), Emily (15), Frederick (10), Ann (5), Enos (3), James (1), and mother-in-law Mary Sanders (70). ■ Census for Poynton, Cheshire, in 1901. Francis Eyres (50) is a widowed coal hewer living at Clayton Field with widowed sister Martha Wild (64), Ann (15), Enos (13), James (11), and Ada (9). ■ Census for Poynton, Cheshire, in 1911. Frank (61) is a widowed road servant for the parish council living at Clayton Field with widowed sister Martha Wild (73), Enos (23) a collier, and grandaughter Doris Sellars (9). Francis Ayre died in 1937.

Francis's birth was registered in 2q 1851 Macclesfield 19 161. His death is possibly that of Francis A registered in 4q 1937 Manchester North 8d 616, aged 85.

On 9 Apr 1872 when Francis Ayre was 21, he married **Eliza Ann Sanders** in Prestbury, St Peter, Cheshire. Frank (19) was a collier from Macclesfield father Peter, a collier. Eliza (18) was from Macclesfield, father Joseph, a watch maker. The marriage was registered in 2q 1872 Macclesfield 8a 187. Eliza Ann was born in Macclesfield, Cheshire, abt 1853. Eliza Ann died in 1894.

Eliza is referred to as Eliza on her wedding records and in censuses, but as Eliza Ann on at least two of her children's baptisms. She died between 1891 and 1901, so she is probably the Eliza Ann

whose death was registered in 4q 1894 Macclesfield 8a 80, aged 38, though her age is a little low. There are no other registrations that fit.

They had the following children:

i. Ruth Warburton. Ruth was born in Macclesfield, Cheshire, in 1872.

ii. Martha Warburton. Martha was born in Poynton, Cheshire, abt 1875.

Martha's birth registration is uncertain as there is none that fits on place and date.

Emma's birth was registered in 4q 1876 Macclesfield 8a 127.

On 4 Nov 1901 when Emma was 25, she married **John Thomas Sellers** in Macclesfield, St Michael, Cheshire. Emma (26) was a spinster living at 1 Court, Hibel Road, father Frank, a collier. John (32) was a widowed weaver, also living at 1 Court, Hibel Road, father George, a weaver. The marriage was registered in 4q 1901 Macclesfield 8a 19 5. They cannot been found in the 1911 census, though a Doris Sellars, granddaughter, is living with Emma's father.

- vii. **James Warburton**. James was born in Poynton, Cheshire, abt 1890. He was christened in Poynton, St George, Cheshire, on 26 Aug 1900. Census for Oswaldtwistle, Lancashire, in 1911. James (21) is a lap (?) piecer in the cotton trade boarding with the Savage family.
 - James's birth was registered in 1q 1890 Macclesfield 8a 110.
- viii. **Francis Eyre Warburton**. Francis Eyre was born in Poynton, Cheshire, in 1892. He was christened in Poynton, St George, Cheshire, on 24 Nov 1892. Francis Eyre died in 1892. He was buried in Poynton, St George, Cheshire.
 - Francis's birth was registered in 2q 1892 Macclesfield 8a 111. His death was registered in 4q 1892 Macclesfield 8a 74. He was Francis Air on his birth and death registrations, and Francis Eyre on his baptism.
- 23. Ellis Warburton (*Peter*², *Joseph*¹). Ellis was born in Poynton, Cheshire, in 1854. Census for Sudbury, Derbyshire, in 1871. Ellis (16) is a footman at Sudbury hall. Census for Gorton, Lancashire, in 1881. Ellis (26) is a coal agent living at 33 Queen Street with Annie (22). Census for Gorton, Lancashire, in 1891. Ellis (36) is a dairyman living at 280 New Bank Street with Annie (32), and Albert (9). Census for Rusholme, Manchester, Lancashire, in 1901. Ellis (41) is a dairyman living at 752 Stockport Road with Annis (41), Albert (19) a carrier, and sister-in-law Clara Aldred (29). Ellis, Annis, and Clara have their place of birth given as Alderley Edge. Census for Levenshulme, Manchester, Lancashire, in 1911. Ellis (56) is a coal agent living at 15 Fortuna House with Annie (52), Albert (29), and Mary Ann Aldred (75) his mother-in-law. Ellis and Annie have been married 30 years and had one child. Ellis died in 1930.

Ellis's birth was registered in 4q 1854 Macclesfield 8a 80. His death was registered in 2q 1930, South Manchester 8d 72, aged 74.

On 3 Nov 1879 when Ellis was 25, he married **Annie Aldred** in Poynton, St George, Cheshire. Ellis was 24, a coal agent of Poynton, father Peter deceased. Annie was 21, of Poynton, father Thomas, a collier. The marriage was registered in 4q 1879 Macclesfield 8a 145. Annie was born in Poynton, Cheshire, abt 1858.

They had one child:

- i. Albert Warburton. Albert was born in Gorton, Lancashire, abt 1882.
 - Albert's birth was registered in 1q 1882 Chorlton 8c 701.
- **24.** David Warburton (*Ellis*², *Joseph*¹). David was born in Poynton, Cheshire, on 1 Jun 1839. He was christened in Norbury, St Thomas, Cheshire, on 7 Jul 1839. Census for Norbury, Cheshire, in 1871. David (31) is a coal miner living in New Street with Hannah (32), Mary (5), and Joseph (1

On 9 May 1864 when David was 24, he married Hannah Bennett in Stockport, St Mary, Cheshire. David was a collier of Norbury, father Ellis, a collier. Hannah was of Norbury, father Joseph, a silk weaver. The marriage was registered in 2q 1864 Stockport 8a 78. Hannah was born in Bosden, Cheshire, abt 1838. Census for Bramall, Cheshire, in 1881. Hannah (42) is a silk weaver living Brewers Green with Mary (15) a silk weaver, and Charles E (8). Census for Bramall, Cheshire, in 1891. Hannah Bennett (52) is a silk weaver living with her father Joseph Bennett (77) and brother Joseph (48), both silk weavers, at 47 Mount Pleasant together with her children Mary (25) a cotton weaver, Charles E (18) a hatter, and Harriet (15) a hat trimmer. Census for Bramall, Cheshire, in 1901. Hannah (62) is a housekeeper living with her brother Joseph Bennett (58) a silk weaver at 47 Mount Pleasant. Also there are Hannah's daughter Harriet Brookes (25), her husband Walter (24), and son Josiah (2). Hannah died in 1909.

Hannah's death is possibly that registered in 1q 1909 Stockport 8a 19, but her age at 67 is 3 years too young. However there is no obvious entry in the 1911 census apart from a lodger in Cheadle aged 70, said to be born in Cheadle, and whose death was registered in 3q 1912 Cheadle 6b 321 aged 71 which is still 2 years too young. There is no obvious remarriage either.

Charles (38) is a hatter living at 13 Alpine Road with Elizabeth (37) a draper. They have been married 15 years but haven't entered any details of children. Charles Enos died in 1962.

Charles's birth was registered in 3q 1872 Stockport 8a 97. His death was probably that of Charles E registered in 1q 1962 Stockport 10a 707, aged 89.

On 21 Dec 1895 when Charles Enos was 23, he married **Elizabeth Still** in Portwood, St Paul, Cheshire. Charles (23) was a hatter father David, a collier. Elizabeth (22) was from Brinnington, father John Henry, a mechanic. Elizabeth was born in Manchester, Lancashire, abt 1873.

iv. Harriet Warburton. Harriet was born in Norbury, Cheshire, on 15 Dec 1875. She was christened in Hazel Grove, Cheshire (Non-Conformist Records), on 20 Jul 1876. Harriet died in 1939.

Harriet's birth was registered in 1q 1876 Stockport 8a 101. Although she and Walter are not obvious in the 1911 census she is probably the Harriet whose death was registered in 2q 1935 Stockport 8a 119, aged 59.

Joseph (38) is a watch maker living in Man[chester] and Buxton Road (next door to his father) with Susannah (32), Mary (13), William (9), Elizabeth (7), Ellis (3), and John (6 mths). Margaret is lodging next door with her grandfather Ellis. ■ Census for Norbury, Cheshire, in 1891. Joseph (48) is a watch maker living at 363 London Road (next door to his father) with Susannah (42), Margaret (21), Elizabeth (17), and John (10). ■ Census for Hazel Grove, Cheshire, in 1901. Joseph (58) is a gold jeweller living at 359 London road with Susannah (52). Joseph died in Hazel Grove, Cheshire, in 1901. He was buried in Norbury, St Thomas, Cheshire, on 11 Apr 1901.

Joseph's birth was registered in 4q 1842 Stockport 19 212, mother's maiden name Oldham. His death was registered in 2q 1901 Stockport 8a 75, aged 58.

On 11 Mar 1867 when Joseph was 25, he married **Susannah Broom** in Stockport, St Mary, Cheshire. Joseph was a collier of Hazel Grove, father Ellis, a collier. Susannah was of Hazel Grove, father John, a silk weaver. Susannah was born in Bosden, Cheshire, abt 1848. ■ Census for Hazel Grove, Cheshire, in 1911. Susannah (62) is a widow living at 361 London Road with daughter Margaret Platt (41) a calico weaver and her three children Hilda (16) a calico weaver, Phyllis (14) a bobin rover, and Irvine (12). Susannah had been married 44 years and had 6 children, 5 still living. Margaret has been married 17 years and had 3 children. Her husband Samuel Platt (28) is a drawer in and twister of cotton, boardng with Ann Wolfenden at 235 Manchester Road, Castleton, Rochdale. Susannah died in Hazel Grove, Cheshire, in 1914. She was buried in Norbury, St Thomas, Cheshire, on 25 Feb 1914.

Susannah's death was registered in 1g 1914 Stockport 8a 6, aged 65.

 Mary Warburton. Mary was born in Norbury, Cheshire, on 8 Oct 1867. She was christened in Hazel Grove, Cheshire (Non-Conformist Records), on 17 Dec 1867.

Mary's birth was registered in 4q 1867 Stockport 8a 77.

On 6 Feb 1896 when Mary was 28, she married **Henry Marshall** in Norbury, St Thomas, Cheshire. Mary (28) was living at 363 London Road, father Joseph, a watchmaker. Henry (30) was a joiner living at 221 London Road, father George, a wheelwright. Thomas Davenport and Elizabeth Warburton were witnesses. The marriage was registered in 1q 1896 Stockport 8a 52. Henry was born in Hazel Grove, Cheshire, abt 1865.

Margaret Warburton. Margaret was born in Norbury, Cheshire, on 27 Aug 1869.
 She was christened in Hazel Grove, Cheshire (Non-Conformist Records), on 17 Oct 1869.

Margaret's birth was registered in 3q 1869 Stockport 8a 89.

In 1894 when Margaret was 24, she married **Samuel Potts** in Stockport, Cheshire (Civil Marriage). The marriage was registered in 3q 1894 Stockport 8a 168. Margaret and Samuel had 3 children but are apart in 1911, Margaret and the children living with her mother. Samuel was born in Bredbury, Cheshire, abt 1872.

Elias (31) is a railway pointsman living in Close Lanes with Mary (30), John (2), and Richard (8 months). Elias died in Hindley, Lancashire, in 1874.

Elias is described as the son of Elizabeth Warburton, spinster on the parish record of his baptism. His birth was not registered. His death was registered in 3q 1874 Wigan 8c 67, aged 34.

On 16 Feb 1868 when Elias was 28, he married **Mary Tickle** in Wigan, St Catherine, Lancashire. Elias (29) was a porter of Upper Morris Street, Scholes, father Martin, a labourer. Mary (27) was from Scholes, father William, a carpenter. The marriage was regiesterd in 1q 1868 Wigan 8c 72. Mary was born in Hindley, Lancashire, abt 1840. • Census for Hindley, Lancashire, in 1881. Mary (40) is living at 754 Atherton Road with her second husband Daniel Oliver, and sons John (12), and Richard (10). Her sons are described as Daniel's nephews. • Census for Hindley, Lancashire, in 1891. Mary (50) is living at 683 Atherton Road with sons John (22), and Richard Warbutton (20) both coal miners. Mary died in 1905.

Mary remarried on 2nd April 1877 to Daniel Oliver at Hindley, All Saints. She is not obvious in the 1911 census and the most likely death registration is in 3q 1905 Prescot 8b 509, aged 65.

They had the following children:

- i. **John Warburton**. John was born in Hindley, Lancashire, on 3 Dec 1868. He was christened in Hindley, All Saints, Lancashire, on 23 May 1869.

James's birth was registered in 4q 1879 Stockport 8a 25. His death is probably that registered in 1q 1951 Hyde 10a 531, aged 71.

In 1908 when James was 29, he married **Annie Hopwood** in Stockport, Cheshire (Civil Marriage). The marriage was registered in 1q 1908 Stockport 8a 124. The identity of the second child they say they have on the 1911 census has yet to be determined. Two other children, Harry in 1915 and Bessie in 1918 are also registered at Ashton with mother's maiden name Hopwood. Annie was born in Hyde, Cheshire, abt 1880.

The marriage to Annie Hopwood is the most likely as it fits with them being married 3 years in 1911, and there is record of an Annie Hopwood of the right age born in Hyde.

 George (36) is a farmer living at Etchells Farm with Melinda (37), Emily (13) a servant at home half time, Olive (11), James T (9), Stanley (6), Ethel (4), and George W (3 mths).
 Census for Torkington, Cheshire, in 1911. George (46) is a farmer living at Etchells Farm with Melinda (47),

Emily (23) a winder at the cotton mill, James Thomas (19) working on farm, Stanley (16) working on farm, Ethel (14), George William (10), Ada (6), and Arthur (4). George and Melinda have been married 23 years and had 8 children, all living. George died in 1947.

George's birth was registered in 2q 1865 Stockport 8a 1. He is probably the George whose death was registered in 4q 1947 North East Cheshire 10a 391, aged 82.

In 1887 when George was 22, he married **Melinda Bennett** in Gorton, St James, Lancashire. The marriage was registerd in 2q 1887 Chorlton 8c 944. Melinda was born in Norbury, Cheshire, abt 1865.

The only record of a Melinda's death registration is in 1q 1929 Stockport 8a 5, but the age of 59 is 8 years too low.

They had the following children:

i. Emily Warburton. Emily was born in Torkington, Cheshire, in 1887.

Emily's birth was registered in 4q 1887 Stockport 8a 114.

ii. Olive Warburton. Olive was born in Torkington, Cheshire, in 1890.

Olive's birth was registered in 2q 1890 Stockport 8a 101.

In 1911 when Olive was 21, she married **Fred Nicholls** in Cheadle, St Mary, Cheshire. The marriage was registered in 1q 1911 Stockport 8a 9. Fred was born in Prestwich, Lancashire abt 1890.

iii. **James Thomas Warburton**. James Thomas was born in Torkington, Cheshire, on 11 Feb 1892. James Thomas died in 1973.

James's birth was registered in 2q 1892 Stockport 8a 105. The death of a James Thomas was registered in 4q 1973 Chapel-en-le-Frith 10a 2309, age 81, date of birth 11th Feb 1892, but this implies his birth was registered a little late.

 Stanley Warburton. Stanley was born in Torkington, Cheshire, in 1894. Stanley died aft 1911.

Stanley's birth was registered in 4q 1894 Stockport 8a 104. There is no obvious death registration.

v. **Ethel Warburton**. Ethel was born in Norbury, Cheshire, abt 1897.

Ethel's birth was registered in either 1q 1897 Stockport 8a 112, or 2q 1897 Stockport 8a 75.

vi. **George William Warburton**. George William was born in Torkington, Cheshire, on 2 Jan 1901. George William died in 1981.

George's birth was registered in 1q 1901 Stockport 8a 104. His death was

registered in 3q 1981 Stockport 39 1085, aged 80.

vii. Ada Warburton. Ada was born in Torkington, Cheshire, in 1904.

Ada's birth was registered in 2q 1904 Stockport 8a 113.

viii. **Arthur Warburton**. Arthur was born in Torkington, Cheshire, in 1906. Arthur died aft 1911.

Arthur's birth was registered in 3q 1906 Stockport 8a 111. There is no death registration that fits exactly.

30. Eli Warburton (*Eli*³, *Thomas*², *Joseph*¹). Eli was born in Poynton, Cheshire, abt 1872. ■ Census for Marple, Cheshire, in 1901. Eli (28) is a platelayer on the railway living in Derby Street with Amelia (32) a cotton weaver, and sister-in-law Catherine D Booth, a cotton weaver.

There is no evidence of Eli and Amelia in the 1911 census, but there is also no death registration for either of them. The birth of a Beatrice was registered in 3q 1901 Stockport 8a 64, mother's maiden name Booth, but she is also missing from the 1911 census and death registers. This would suggest they probably emigrated.

In 1900 when Eli was 28, he married **Amelia Booth** in Stockport, Cheshire (Civil Marriage). The marriage was registered in 3q 1900 Stockport 8a 215. Amelia was born in Romiley, Cheshire, abt 1868.

They had one child:

i. **Beatrice Warburton**. Beatrice was born in 1901.

Beatrice's birth was registered in 3q 1901 Stockport 8a 64, mother's maiden name Booth. She subsequently disappeared with her parents.

31. John Thomas Warburton (*Richard*³, *Thomas*², *Joseph*¹). John Thomas was born in 1868. John Thomas died in 1957.

William (45) is head teacher at an elementary school living at 21 Guywood Lane with Edith (46), Edgar Allen (17) a warehouseman, Kenneth (16) an office boy, and niece Edith Allen (19) a stenographer and typist. William and Edith have been married 18 years and had 2 children. William died in 1947.

William's birth was registered in 2q 1865 Macclesfield 8a 95. His death was probably that registered in 3q 1947 Macclesfield 10a 277, aged 82.

On 24 Jul 1892 when William was 27, he married **Edith Allen** in Sudbury, All Saints, Derbyshire. The marriage was registered in 3q 1892 Uttoxeter 6b 505. Edith was born in Sudbury, Derbyshire, abt 1864. Edith died in 1946.

Edith was a pupil teacher, staying with her step-sister Fanny Hill in Poynton in 1881. Her death was probably that registered in 3q 1946 Macclesfield 10a 290, aged 81.

 Edgar Allen died in 1981.

William (43) is a coal miner living in Alma Cottages with Alice (44), James (13), Charles (11), and Muriel (8). William and Alice have been married 15 years and had 4 children, 3 still living. William died in 1949.

The births of 3 Williams were registered at Macclesfield in 1867, two in the 2nd quarter (8a 121, and 8a 124), and one in the 4th quarter (8a 82). His death was probably that registered in 3q 1949 Macclesfield 10a 289, aged 81, which makes the 4th quarter birth registration the most likely.

Joseph (22) is a general labourer living in Clayton Field with his aunt Martha Potts (43) and her husband William (46), a carrier by road. ■ Census for Worth, Cheshire, in 1891. Joseph (32) is a carrier and farmer living at Brook Farm with Elizabeth Ann (29), Martha Bowden (6), Mary Ann (3), and Albert (1). ■ Census for Worth, Cheshire, in 1901. Joseph (41) is a farmer and employer living at Brook Farm with Emma (sic) Ann (39), Mary Ann (13), Emily (7), Alice (5), Joseph (2), and Charles (1), plus one servant. ■ Census for Stockport, Cheshire, in 1911. Census for Ashton-under-Lyne, Lancashire, in 1911. Frederick Ralph Walburton (Ancestry transcription error), aged 29, is a boot repairer living at 29 Marlborough Street with Nellie (25), Frederick (3), Enos (1), and a boarder. Frederick and Nellie have been married 4 years and had 2 children, both living. Frederick Ralph died in Ashton-under-Lyne, Lancashire, in 1957.

Frederick's birth was registered in 2q 1881 Barnsley 9c 227. His middle name of Ralph is only used on his marriage and in the 1911 census. His death was registered in 4q 1957 Ashton 10b 164, aged 76.

In 1906 when Frederick Ralph was 25, he married **Nellie Moorhouse** in St Stephen, Audenshaw, Lancashire. Nellie was born in Ardwick, Manchester, Lancashire, abt 1885.

They had the following children:

 Frederick Warburton. Frederick was born in Ashton-under-Lyne, Lancashire, on 12 Sep 1907. Frederick died in Jun 1996.

Frederick's birth was registered in 4q 1907 Stockport 8a 12. His death was registered in Jun 1996 Tameside A49A 0141A, aged 88.

Frederick's son, also Frederick, is a participant in the Warburton DNA Project.

In 1931 when Frederick was 23, he married **Emily Olga Clegg** in Ashton-under-Lyne, St Peter, Lancashire. Emily Olga was born in Uttoxeter, Staffordshire, in 1905.

 Enos Eric Warburton. Enos Eric was born in Ashton-under-Lyne, Lancashire, on 5 Mar 1910. Enos Eric died in Nov 1990.

He was christened in Hazel Grove, Cheshire (Non-Conformist Records), on 20 Aug 1871. ■ Census for Bosden, Cheshire, in 1891. William (19) is shoe malter marker (?) living at 27 London Road with Elizabeth (21) a cotton winder. ■ Census for Marple, Cheshire, in 1901. William (29) is a shoemaker living in High Lane with Elizabeth (31) a confectioner, Maggie (8), Ellis (5), and Elsie

William's birth was registered in 3q 1871 Stockport 8a 91.
