
## **PREFACE**



This clan was formerly the Shocklach clan until it was discovered that two key members of the clan were more probably descended from a family at Tilston. Tilston and Shocklach are neighbouring parishes in the south west corner of Cheshire near the Welsh and Shropshire boarders. A DNA result from the clan is a match for one in the Liverpool and Oldham clan, showing a common ancestor. These two clans now form the West Cheshire Group.

The clan also includes the descendants of Thomas Warburton (born 1848), the illegitimate son of Elizabeth, though which of two possible Elizabeths is uncertain. It also includes a second DNA profile with strong Stewart connections.

The tree is based on information from Robert Warburton that had been collected by his father and himself over a number of years. Additional information has been provided by Richard Warburton, Diana Corbyn, Hilary Williams, and Paul Straney.

#### **First Generation**

**1. John Warburton**. John died in Tilston, Cheshire, in 1723. He was buried in Tilston, St Mary, Cheshire.

The early parish registers at Tilston do not paint a consistent picture. A John son of John was baptised on 16th March 1683/4. There are two burials which are assumed to be these Johns, in 1723 and 1761. However the pattern of marriages and baptisms is confusing. A Hellen, wife of John was buried in 1715. Three children, father John were baptised between 1712 and 1716. As Hellen died before the last of these was baptised it is assumed she wasn't the mother of any of them, and therefore probably the wife of John senior.

A John married Ann Williams in 1720, a month after the baptism of James son of John. It is therefore possible a third John with an unknown wife was the father of some, if not all the children born between 1712 and 1729, whose father was John. However a more likely explanation is that the John born in 1683 was the father of all the children and died in 1761. He had an unknown first wife (no marriage or burial at Tilston), and married Ann Williams after the birth of their first child.

Alternatively Hellen was married to the younger John and the spouse of the older John is unknown. In this scenario the baptism of Elenor was delayed several months, maybe due to the death of her mother.

John married **Hellen**. Hellen died in Tilston, Cheshire, in 1715. She was buried in Tilston, St Mary, Cheshire, on 27 Jul 1715.

They had the following children:

- **2** i. **John Warburton** (1684-1761)
  - ii. Mary Warburton. Mary was born in 1676. She was christened in Tilston, St Mary, Cheshire, on 11 Feb 1677.

#### **Second Generation**

**2. John Warburton** (John<sup>1</sup>). John was born in 1684. He was christened in Tilston, St Mary, Cheshire, on 16 Mar 1684. John died in Tilston, Cheshire, in 1761. He was buried in Tilston, St Mary, Cheshire, on 6 Mar 1761.

There are three children of a John baptised between 1712 and 1715. However, these are followed by the death of Hellen, wife of John on 27/7/1715, and of a John on 31/1/1724 (modern date).

James is born a month before the marriage of John Warburton and Anne Williams but there is no alternative family at Tilston, the only recent baptism of a John (son of John) being in 1683.

John first married **Unknown**.

They had the following children:

- i. **Thomas Warburton**. Thomas was born in Tilston, Cheshire, in 1712. He was christened in Tilston, St Mary, Cheshire, on 30 Nov 1712.
- ii. **Ann Warburton**. Ann was born in Tilston, Cheshire, in 1714. She was christened in Tilston, St Mary, Cheshire, on 29 Aug 1714.
- iii. **Elenor Warburton**. Elenor was born in Tilston, Cheshire, abt 1715. She was christened in Tilston, St Mary, Cheshire, on 9 Jan 1716.

On 21 May 1720 when John was 36, he second married **Anne Williams** in Tilston, St Mary, Cheshire.

They had the following children:

- i. James Warburton (1720-)
- 4 ii. Peter Warburton (1722-)
  - iii. **Samuel Warburton**. Samuel was born in Tilston, Cheshire, in 1725. He was christened in Tilston, St Mary, Cheshire, on 16 Jun 1725. Samuel died in Tilston, Cheshire, in 1726. He was buried in Tilston, St Mary, Cheshire, on 26 Jun 1726.
- 5 iv. **Samuel Warburton** (1729-1814)

#### **Third Generation**

**3. James Warburton** (John<sup>2</sup>, John<sup>1</sup>). James was born in Tilston, Cheshire, in 1720. He was christened in Tilston, St Mary, Cheshire, on 29 Apr 1720.

The only marriage of a John took place a month after James's birth, so it is possible he didn't belong to this family.

Child:

- 6 i. **Samuel Warburton** (1744-1825)
- **4. Peter Warburton** (John<sup>2</sup>, John<sup>1</sup>). Peter was born in Tilston, Cheshire, in 1722. He was christened in Tilston, St Mary, Cheshire, on 21 Oct 1722.

Peter was originally reported as the son of Thomas and Christian Brown of Shocklach but Peter's baptism is not recorded at Shocklach. This may have been an assumption because his own children were baptised at Shocklach. However the only recorded that is close in time and place is the one at Tilston.

On 29 May 1751 when Peter was 29, he married **Sarah Edwards** in Shocklach, St Edith, Cheshire.

They had the following children:

- 7 i. Thomas Warburton (1752-)
- 8 ii. John Warburton (1760-)
  - iii. **Peter Warburton**. Peter was born in Shocklach, Cheshire, in 1767. He was christened in Shocklach, St Edith, Cheshire, on 22 Mar 1767.
  - iv. Mary Warburton. She was christened in Shocklach, St Edith, Cheshire, on 25 Jul 1754.
  - v. **Anne Warburton**. She was christened in Shocklach, St Edith, Cheshire, on 2 Oct 1758.
- **5. Samuel Warburton** (John<sup>2</sup>, John<sup>1</sup>). Samuel was born in Tilston, Cheshire, in 1729. He was christened in Tilston, St Mary, Cheshire, on 6 Jan 1730. Samuel died in Tilston, Cheshire, in 1814. He was buried in Tilston, St Mary, Cheshire, on 23 Nov 1814.

Samuel was buried aged 86.

On 27 Dec 1751 when Samuel was 22, he first married **Eleanor Povey** in Tilston, St Mary, Cheshire. Eleanor died in 1768. She was buried in Tilston, St Mary, Cheshire, on 25 Mar 1768.

- i. **John Warburton**. John was born in Tilston, Cheshire, in 1753. He was christened in Tilston, St Mary, Cheshire, on 31 Mar 1753.
- ii. **Thomas Warburton**. Thomas was born in Tilston, Cheshire, in 1755. He was christened in Tilston, St Mary, Cheshire, on 30 Dec 1755.
- iii. **William Warburton**. William was born in Tilston, Cheshire, in 1759. He was christened in Tilston, St Mary, Cheshire, on 31 Mar 1759.

On 30 Sep 1768 when Samuel was 39, he second married **Mary Yardley** in Tilston, St Mary, Cheshire. Mary was born abt 1740. Mary died in Tilston, Cheshire, in 1826. She was buried in Tilston, St Mary, Cheshire, on 21 May 1826.

This is a likely burial record for Mary. She was aged 86 on her burial record, which woud be about the right age based on the ages of her children.

#### They had the following children:

- i. **Samuel Warburton**. Samuel was born in Tilston, Cheshire, in 1769. He was christened in Tilston, Cheshire, on 28 Aug 1769.
- ii. **Mary Warburton**. Mary was born in Tilston, Cheshire, in 1771. She was christened in Tilston, Cheshire, on 14 Apr 1771.
- **9** iii. **Peter Warburton** (1773-1847)
  - iv. **Hannah Warburton**. Hannah was born in Tilston, Cheshire, in 1773. She was christened in Tilston, Cheshire, on 4 Apr 1773.

It would seem Hannah and Peter were twins.

- v. **Elizabeth Warburton**. Elizabeth was born in Tilston, Cheshire, in 1775. She was christened in Tilston, Cheshire, on 7 May 1775.
- vi. **Sarah Warburton**. Sarah was born in Tilston, Cheshire, in 1777. She was christened in Tilston, Cheshire, on 9 Nov 1777.

#### **Fourth Generation**

**6. Samuel Warburton** (James<sup>3</sup>, John<sup>2</sup>, John<sup>1</sup>). Samuel was born in Tilston, Cheshire, in 1744. He was christened in Tilston, St Mary, Cheshire, on 11 Apr 1744. Samuel died in Thornton-le-Moors, Cheshire, in 1825. He was buried in Thormton-le-Moors, St Mary, Cheshire, on 19 Aug 1825.

Samuel is the ancestor of my contact Paul Straney. He was 81 on his burial record.

On 22 Sep 1773 when Samuel was 29, he married **Elizabeth Yewd** in Thormton-le-Moors, St Mary, Cheshire.

They had one child:

i. James Warburton.

James's marriage licence bond dated August 1797 signed by "James Warburton of the Parish of Saint Oswald in the City and Diocese of Chester Taylor and Peter Warburton of Tattenhall in the County and Diocese aforesaid".

On 10 Aug 1797 James married Elizabeth Nixon in Chester, St. Oswald, Cheshire.

**7. Thomas Warburton** (Peter<sup>3</sup>, John<sup>2</sup>, John<sup>1</sup>). Thomas was born in 1752. He was christened in Shocklach, St Edith, Cheshire, on 29 May 1752.

The identification of Samuel as the son of Thomas and Margaret is by Diana Corbyn and is based on the fact that both Thomas and Samuel were tailors. The baptisms of the children of Thomas and Margaret fit with the date of their wedding, and there is no other Thomas and Margaret wedding in the area.

On 4 Aug 1770 when Thomas was 18, he first married **Jane Phillips** in Shocklach, St Edith, Cheshire.

On 19 Apr 1780 when Thomas was 28, he second married **Margaret Davies** in Shocklach, St Edith, Cheshire. Witnesses to the marriage were William Hopley and Richard Griffiths.

- i. **Christian Warburton**. Christian was born in Farndon, Cheshire, in 1780. He was christened in Farndon, Cheshire, on 12 Nov 1780.
- ii. **John Warburton**. John was born in Malpas, Cheshire, abt 1783. He was christened in Malpas, St Oswald, Cheshire, on 22 Jan 1783.
- iii. Samuel Warburton. Samuel was born in Malpas, Cheshire, in 1786. He was christened in Malpas, St Oswald, Cheshire, on 22 Jan 1786. Samuel died in Malpas, Cheshire, in 1793. He was buried in Malpas, St Oswald, Cheshire, on 17 Sep 1793.
- iv. **Margaret Warburton**. Margaret was born in Malpas, Cheshire, in 1788. She was christened in Malpas, St Oswald, Cheshire, on 24 Sep 1788.
- v. **Thomas Warburton**. Thomas was born in Malpas, Cheshire, in 1792. He was christened in Malpas, St Oswald, Cheshire, on 6 May 1792.
- 10 vi. **Samuel Warburton** (1793-1833)
  - vii. **Elizabeth Warburton**. Elizabeth was born in Chester, Cheshire, in 1796. She was christened in Chester, St Michael, Cheshire, on 28 Jul 1796.
- **8. John Warburton** (Peter<sup>3</sup>, John<sup>2</sup>, John<sup>1</sup>). John was born in Shocklach, Cheshire, in 1760. He was christened in Shocklach, St Edith, Cheshire, on 26 Oct 1760.

On 8 Aug 1784 when John was 24, he married **Mary Tomlinson** in Shocklach, St Edith, Cheshire.

- Elizabeth Warburton. She was christened in Shocklach, St Edith, Cheshire, on 12 Dec 1784.
- ii. **Joseph Warburton**. Joseph was born in 1786. He was christened in Shocklach, St Edith, Cheshire, on 16 Jul 1786.
- 11 iii. Peter Warburton (1788-)
  - iv. **Ann Warburton**. She was christened in Shocklach, St Edith, Cheshire, on 29 Aug 1790.
  - v. **Thomas Warburton**. Thomas was born in 1793. He was christened in Shocklach, St Edith, Cheshire, on 17 Jun 1793.
  - vi. **Samuel Warburton**. Samuel was born in 1795. He was christened in Shocklach, St Edith, Cheshire, on 15 Apr 1795.
- **12** vii. **John Warburton** (~1797-)
- viii. James Warburton (1799-)
- 14 ix. Joseph Warburton
- 15 x. William Warburton (1804-<1891)
  - xi. **Mary Warburton**. She was christened in Shocklach, St Edith, Cheshire, on 30 Nov 1806.
    - In May 1830 Mary married John Hughes in Shocklach, St Edith, Cheshire.
  - xii. **Sarah Warburton**. She was christened in Shocklach, St Edith, Cheshire, on 31 Dec 1809.
- **9. Peter Warburton** (Samuel<sup>3</sup>, John<sup>2</sup>, John<sup>1</sup>). Peter was born in Tilston, Cheshire, in 1773. He was christened in Tilston, Cheshire, on 4 Apr 1773. Census for Tattenhall, Cheshire, in 1841. Peter (68) is a tailor living with Mariah (56), and Joseph (15). Peter died in Tattenhall, Cheshire, in 1847. He was buried in Tattenhall, Cheshire, on 28 Nov 1847.

The first four of Peter's children by his first wife Mary are listed in a Family Bible owned by Peter's descendant Richard Warburton. The information on Peter's descendants is based on information from Richard, and his cousin Sue Pickering, expanded by me.

It would seem Peter and Hannah were twins.

Peter's death was registered in 4q 1847 Great Boughton 19 50, aged 74. This gives a birth date of 1773, and the only matching baptism record is for the son of Samuel and Mary.

On 11 Dec 1792 when Peter was 19, he first married **Mary Morgan** in Tattenhall, Cheshire. Mary was born in Tattenhall, Cheshire, in 1769. She was christened in Tattenhall, Cheshire, on 1 Jan 1770. Mary died in Tattenhall, Cheshire, in 1813. She was buried in Tattenhall, Cheshire, on 16 Jun 1813.

Mary's dates are the most likely events at Tattenhall that fit.

- **16** i. **Samuel Warburton** (1793-)
  - ii. **Ann Warburton**. Ann was born in Tattenhall, Cheshire, on 19 Nov 1795. She was christened in Tattenhall, St Alban, Cheshire, on 27 Dec 1795.
  - iii. **Peter Warburton**. Peter was born in Tattenhall, Cheshire, in 1798. He was christened in Manchester Cathedral, Lancashire, on 1 Jul 1798.

Peter is only known from the copy of an original family bible held by Richard Warburton (descendant of Peter's brother Samuel). There baptism at Manchester Cathedral is the only Peter son of Peter and Mary baptised around this time.

Peter has not been found in any census.

- **17** iv. **John Warburton** (1801-1881)
  - v. **Thomas Warburton**. Thomas was born in Tattenhall, Cheshire, on 2 Apr 1804. He was christened in Tattenhall, St Alban, Cheshire, on 24 Jun 1804.

Thomas has not been found in censuses.

vi. **William Warburton**. William was born in Tattenhall, Cheshire, on 12 Feb 1807. He was christened in Tattenhall, St Alban, Cheshire, on 28 Jun 1807.

William appears with his family in censuses but has not been explored further.

On 6 Jun 1816 when Peter was 43, he second married **Maria Harding** in Chester, St John, Cheshire. Peter is described as a widow in the parish register. Maria was born abt 1774. Maria died in Tattenhall, Cheshire, in 1849. She was buried in Tattenhall, Cheshire, on 22 Apr 1849.

Maria's death was registered in 2q 1849 Great Boughton 19 50, aged 75.

They had the following children:

- **18** i. **George Warburton** (1817-1896)
  - ii. **James Warburton**. James was born in Tattenhall, Cheshire, on 27 Feb 1819. He was christened in Tattenhall, Cheshire, on 27 Jun 1819.

James appears with his family in censuses but has not been explored further.

- iii. Mary Warburton. Mary was born in Tattenhall, Cheshire, in 1822. She was christened in Tattenhall, Cheshire, on 30 Jun 1822.
- iv. Joseph Warburton. Joseph was born in Tattenhall, Cheshire, in 1825. He was christened in Tattenhall, Cheshire, on 27 Feb 1825.

Joseph's mother would be about 50 when he was born. He appears in the 1861 census as an unmarried tailor but he has not been found in subsequent censuses nor explored further.

#### **Fifth Generation**

**10. Samuel Warburton** (Thomas<sup>4</sup>, Peter<sup>3</sup>, John<sup>2</sup>, John<sup>1</sup>). Samuel was born in Malpas, Cheshire, in 1793. He was christened in Malpas, St Oswald, Cheshire, on 8 Sep 1793. Samuel died in Shocklach, Cheshire, in 1833. He was buried in Shocklach, St Edith, Cheshire, on 5 Sep 1833.

There is no age on the on-line burial record to confirm the birth and death are the same Samuel.

On 30 Oct 1815 when Samuel was 22, he married **Sarah Richards** in Chester, St. Oswald, Cheshire.

Sarah remarried on 28 December 1839 to James Jones (info from Diane Corbyn).

They had the following children:

- i. Mary Warburton. Mary was born in 1816. She was buried on 9 Jul 1816.
- **19** ii. **Elizabeth Warburton** (~1820-1894)
  - iii. **Martha Warburton**. Martha was born in Chorlton, Cheshire, in 1822. She was christened in Malpas, St Oswald, Cheshire, on 26 May 1822.
  - iv. **Ann Warburton**. Ann was born in Chorlton, Cheshire, in 1824. She was christened in Malpas, St Oswald, Cheshire, on 15 Apr 1824.
  - v. **Thomas Warburton**. Thomas was born in Chorlton, Cheshire, in 1827. He was christened in Malpas, St Oswald, Cheshire, on 13 Apr 1827.

Thomas cannot be found in the censuses.

- **20** vi. **Jane Warburton** (1829-)
  - vii. **Margaret Warburton**. Margaret was born in Chorlton, Cheshire, in 1832. She was christened in Malpas, St Oswald, Cheshire, on 3 Mar 1832. Margaret died in 1867.
    - Census for Malpas, Cheshire, in 1861. William Barlow (30) is a shoemaker living in Well Street with Margaret (28), and James (7).

On 29 Sep 1853 when Margaret was 21, she married **William Barlow**. Margaret and William had a son James born in 1854. William was born in Oldcastle, Cheshire, abt 1830.

William is the son of John Barlow, shoemaker. His brother John married Jane Steen the mother of Sarah Steen, the wife of the illegitimate Thomas Warburton born in 1848. After Margaret's death in 1867 William married an Elizabeth (info from Diana Corbyn).

**11. Peter Warburton** (John<sup>4</sup>, Peter<sup>3</sup>, John<sup>2</sup>, John<sup>1</sup>). Peter was born in Shocklach, Cheshire, in 1788. He was christened in Shocklach, St Edith, Cheshire, on 16 Jul 1788. ■ Census for Shocklach Oviatt, Cheshire, in 1851. Peter, a widower aged 64, is an agricultural labourer living with Eliza (9), and Ellen (7).

On 20 Jan 1825 when Peter was 37, he married **Sarah Parrey** in Marbury, Nr Nantwich, Cheshire.

Sarah was born abt 1799. She was buried in Shocklach, St Edith, Cheshire, on 5 Mar 1849.

They had the following children:

- i. Mary Warburton. Mary was born bef 1827.
  - On 4 Dec 1849 when Mary was 22, she married **Samuel Mellor** in Shocklach, St Edith, Cheshire. Reference C BMD CE40/1/27.
- ii. **Sarah Warburton**. She was christened in Shocklach, St Edith, Cheshire, on 11 Nov 1827.
  - On 25 Nov 1850 Sarah married **Isaac Jones** in Shocklach, St Edith, Cheshire. Reference C BMD CE40/1/32.
- iii. Elizabeth Warburton. She was christened in Shocklach, St Edith, Cheshire, on 30 Jun 1830. Census for Shocklach Oviatt, Cheshire, in 1851. Elizabeth (22), is a house servant in the home of Elizabeth Mullock. Census for Edge, Cheshire, in 1861. Elizabeth (31) is living with William (37) a blacksmith, James (7), and Thomas (2).
  - On 28 Dec 1858 Elizabeth married **William Barlow** in Malpas, St Oswald, Cheshire. Elizabeth 29, spinster of Hampton, daughter of Peter, labourer. William 34, Smith of Edge, son of William, also a Smith. Witnesses James Duckers and Mary Mellor (Elizabeth's married sister). William was born abt 1824.
- **21** iv. **Thomas Warburton** (1832-1894)
  - v. Rachel Warburton. Rachel was born in Shocklach Oviatt, Cheshire, in 1834. She was christened in Steam Mill Street Primitive Methodist, Chester, Cheshire, on 16 Aug 1834. Census for Church Shocklach, Cheshire, in 1851. Rachel (16) is a house servant in the home of Elias Threadgold. Census for Tilston, Cheshire, in 1861. Rachel (25), is living with husband George (29) an agricultural labourer, step daughter (to George) Sarah Ann Warburton (5), and son George Brown (4 months).
    - On 25 Dec 1858 when Rachel was 24, she married **George Brown** in Shocklach, St Edith, Cheshire. Rachel and George had a son George (bap. April 1860). Rachel apppears to have had 2 illegitimate children before marrying. However John is not present in the 1861 census with his sister and step brother, nor is he apparent in other censuses so he probably died young.
  - vi. **Peter Warburton**. Peter was born in 1836. He was christened in Shocklach, St Edith, Cheshire, on 26 Jun 1836.
    - Peter cannot be found in any census.
  - vii. **Hannah Warburton**. She was christened in Tilston, St Mary, Cheshire, on 13 Oct 1839.
    - Hannah is not on the list of Peter and Sarah's Shocklach baptisms, but her baptism

is reported by Diana Corbyn.

- viii. **Ellen Warburton**. She was christened in Shocklach, St Edith, Cheshire, on 24 Mar 1843.
- **12. John Warburton** (John<sup>4</sup>, Peter<sup>3</sup>, John<sup>2</sup>, John<sup>1</sup>). John was born abt 1797. He was christened in Shocklach, St Edith, Cheshire, on 23 Apr 1797. Child:
  - i. George Warburton (1822-)
- **13. James Warburton** (John<sup>4</sup>, Peter<sup>3</sup>, John<sup>2</sup>, John<sup>1</sup>). James was born in Shocklach, Cheshire, in 1799. He was christened in Shocklach, St Edith, Cheshire, on 20 Jun 1799. Census for Tilston, Cheshire, in 1841. James (35), Jane (42), Emma (15), John (12), Elizabeth (10), Samuel (7), and Jane (1) are present. Census for Overton, Cheshire, in 1851. James (48) of Shocklach, is an agricultural labourer living with wife Jane (51) from Hamner, Flintshire, Samuel (16) and Jane (11), both born in Tilston. Census for Overton, Cheshire, in 1861. James (54) of Shocklach, and Jane (60) of Hanmer, Flintshire are now alone. Overton is placed in Shropshire by Ancestry.

There is no death record on Cheshire BMD for James or Jane. Eliza is known fron Shocklach parish records, the others from censuses, but their baptisms are not on IGI.

On 31 Dec 1821 when James was 22, he married **Jane Clay** in Shocklach, St Edith, Cheshire. Jane was born in Hamner, Flintshire, abt 1800. ■ Census for Church Shocklach, Cheshire, in 1881. A Jane (79), widow is living at Church Shocklach. This is probably this James' widow despite the incorrect date of birth.

They had the following children:

- Eliza Warburton. She was christened in Shocklach, St Edith, Cheshire, on 14 Apr 1822.
- ii. Emma Warburton. Emma was born in Tilston, Cheshire, abt 1825.
- iii. **Sarah Warburton**. She was christened in Tilston, St Mary, Cheshire, on 26 Nov 1826.

Sarah is not on the list of Shocklach baptisms but is reported by Diana Corbyn, as is her marriage.

Sarah married James Meredith.

- **14.** Joseph Warburton (John<sup>4</sup>, Peter<sup>3</sup>, John<sup>2</sup>, John<sup>1</sup>). He was christened in Shocklach, St Edith, Cheshire, on 17 Mar 1801. He was buried in Shocklach, St Edith, Cheshire, on 6 Jan 1875. ■

Census for Horton, Cheshire, in 1851. Joseph (48) of Shocklach is an agricultural labourer living with Jane (45) of Horton, Samuel (13) of Tilston, Ann (10) of Chorlton, Mary (8) of Horton, John (3 or 5) of Chorlton, and Thomas (2) of Horton. The places of birth of Jane, Ann, Mary, John and Thomas were crossed out and replaced with the parish of Tilston except for John where it is the parish of Malpas. • Census for Shocklach Oviatt, Cheshire, in 1861. Joseph (57) of Shocklach is a pauper living with his wife Jane (52) of Horton, son Thomas (11) of Horton, grandchildren John Povey (4) of Woodstock, Staffordshire, and Thomas Povey (2) of Shocklach, plus a boarder. • Census for Church Shocklach, Cheshire, in 1871. This record cannot be found on Ancestry but Robert Warburton records that Joseph (65) a pauper born at Socklach, also described as an idiot, and Jane (65), his wife, also born at Scocklach, are at The Groves. (RG10 5651 2/4/1871). Probably implies he was suffering from dementia.

Joseph cannot be found in the 1841 census. He is an agricultural labourer on subsequent censuses, and is not to be confused with Joseph the husband of Jane Roberts who was a plasterer.

In Oct 1836 Joseph married **Jane Smith**. Jane was born in Chorlton, Cheshire, abt 1806.

#### They had the following children:

- i. Samuel Warburton. Samuel was born in Tilston, Cheshire, abt 1837. Census for Horton, Cheshire, in 1861. Samuel (22) of Chorlton (which is near Malpas) is a carter on a farm. Chorlton is nearer to Tilston than Bickerton where the other Samuel of the same age hails from.
- ii. **Ann Warburton**. Ann was born in Tilston, Cheshire, in 1840. She was christened in Malpas, St Oswald, Cheshire, on 11 Oct 1840.
  - The girls baptised at Malpas are mainly the daughters of Joseph the plasterer and Jane Roberts. However the only Ann in the census belongs to Joseph and Jane Smith and the baptism is very close to Mary, the daughter of Joseph the plasterer.
- iii. Mary Warburton. Mary was born in Tilston, Cheshire, abt 1842. Census for Church Shocklach, Cheshire, in 1861. Mary (17) is a house servaant on the farm of Owen Maddocks. Brother John is a cowhand.

- **15. William Warburton** (John<sup>4</sup>, Peter<sup>3</sup>, John<sup>2</sup>, John<sup>1</sup>). William was born in Shocklach Oviatt, Cheshire, in 1804. He was christened in Shocklach, St Edith, Cheshire, on 13 May 1804. William died bef 1891. Census for Horton, Cheshire, in 1851. William (44) is an agricultural labourer living with Sarah (46), Thomas (15), and William (14). plus unmarried visitors Mary Davison (36) of Liverpool, and Mary Davison (13) of Malpas. Census for Horton, Cheshire, in 1861. William (55) is an agricultural labourer living in Horton Road with Sarah (57) and John (25) a wheelwright. John is probably a mistake and it should be Thomas. Census for Horton, Cheshire, in 1871. William

(66) is an agricultural labourer living with Sarah (68), Thomas (35) also an agricultural labourer, and Ann (40), Thomas's wife. ■ Census for Horton, Cheshire, in 1881. William (76) now a widower is an agricultural labourer living with son Thomas (45), who is now head of the household and is described as a wheelwright. Also present is Thomas's wife Ann (50).

William is described as a plasterer and shopkeeper of Chorlton on the baptism of his two sons, but is always an agricultural labourer on the censuses. This could imply there were 2 Williams but no evidence has been found of another William.

There is a death registration on C BMD at Tattenhall in 1890 for a William of the correct age (86): TAT/17/14.

On 14 Dec 1834 when William was 30, he married **Sarah Jones** in Malpas, St Oswald, Cheshire. Sarah was born in Church Shocklach, Cheshire, abt 1804. Sarah died bef 1881.

They had the following children:

i. **Thomas Warburton**. Thomas was born in Chorlton, Cheshire, in 1836. He was christened in Malpas, St Oswald, Cheshire, on 6 Mar 1836.

Thomas and Ann are missing from the 1891 and 1901 censuses.

Thomas married Ann. Ann was born in Shocklach, Cheshire, abt 1830.

ii. William Warburton. William was born in Chorlton, Cheshire, in 1837. He was christened in Malpas, St Oswald, Cheshire, on 7 Jan 1838.

William does not appear in any census after 1851.

**16. Samuel Warburton** (Peter<sup>4</sup>, Samuel<sup>3</sup>, John<sup>2</sup>, John<sup>1</sup>). Samuel was born in Tattenhall, Cheshire, on 1 Dec 1793. He was christened in 1793. ■ Census for Liverpool, Lancashire, in 1851. Samuel (transcribed Warberton on Ancestry) is a tailor, aged 57, employing 2 men and living at 41 Brownlow St with Elizabeth (56), Thomas (22) a painter, William (21) a sugar maker, Richard (19) a tailor, Henry (16) a painter, Elizabeth (13), and a servant. ■ Census for Douglas, Isle of Man, in 1861. Samuel (67) is a tobacconist living at 50 North Quay with Elizabeth (66), Elizabeth Jones, daughter (21), and Emeline Jones (1). ■ Census for Douglas, Isle of Man, in 1871. Samuel (77) is a widowed tobacconist living at 56 Quay, with daughter Anne Worrall (45) a piano teacher also widowed, and her 2 children.

The Tattenhall parish register records his birth date but not his baptism date (according to FamilySearch).

On 11 May 1813 when Samuel was 19, he married **Elizabeth Spencer** in Tilston, Cheshire. Elizabeth was born in Tattenhall, Cheshire, abt 1794. Elizabeth died bef 1871.

- 28 i. John Warburton (1816->1851)
  - ii. **Edward Warburton**. Edward was born in Tattenhall, Cheshire, in 1818. He was christened in Tattenhall, St Alban, Cheshire, on 15 Mar 1818.

Edward has not been found in censuses.

iii. Ann(e) Warburton. Ann(e) was born in Tattenhall, Cheshire, in 1826. She was christened in Tattenhall, St Alban, Cheshire, on 25 Jun 1826.

Ann had at least 2 children (George and Elizabeth).

In 1846 when Ann(e) was 20, she married **George Worrall** in Liverpool Register Office, or Registrar attended. The marriage was registered in 1q 1846 Liverpool 20 362. George died bef 1871.

- **29** iv. **Thomas Warburton** (1828-1902)
  - v. William Warburton. William was born in Liverpool, Lancashire, in 1830. He was christened in Liverpool, St Peter, Lancashire, on 12 Apr 1830. Census for Conchan, Isle of Man, in 1861. William (31) is a cigar manufacturer employing 2 men and 2 boys and living at 8 Duke St with Ann (35), niece Amelia Waneck (14) and a servant.

On 20 Sep 1853 when William was 23, he married **Ann Gurney** in Braddan, Isle of Man. Ann was born in Peel, Isle of Man, abt 1813. Ann died in Douglas, isle of Man, in 1883.

Ann appears in the 1861 census aged 35 but in 1871 she is a widow (and sister-in-law to Richard) aged 54. By 1881 she is 66, (a retired tobacconist with her own household). and an Annie's death is registered in 1883 aged 70. This suggests she was a lot older than her husband William, but reduced her age significantly at first. There is, however, no baptism or birth record on FamilySearch to verify this.

In 1856 when Elizabeth was 18, she married **William Jones** in West Derby Register Office, or Registrar attended. The marriage was registered in 4q 1856 West Derby 8b 766.

**17. John Warburton** (Peter<sup>4</sup>, Samuel<sup>3</sup>, John<sup>2</sup>, John<sup>1</sup>). John was born in Tattenhall, Cheshire, on 11 Jun 1801. He was christened in Tattenhall, St Alban, Cheshire, on 16 Aug 1801. ■ Census for Poulton cum Spital, Cheshire, in 1841. John (35) is a farmer living with Ann (35), Esther (14), Mary

(12), Ann (10), Elizabeth (8), and Thomas (1). ■ Census for Poulton cum Spital, Cheshire, in 1851. John (49) is a farmer of 40 acres employing 1 labourer, living with Ann (51), Mary (23), Ann (21), Elizabeth (18), Thomas (11), William (9),and visitors Samuel and Esther Rowe. ■ Census for Poulton cum Spital, Cheshire, in 1861. John (59) is a farmer of 40 acres living with Sarah (51), and 2 servants. ■ Census for Poulton cum Spital, Cheshire, in 1871. John (69) is a farmer of 42 acres living with Sarah (61), a visitor and 2 servants. John died in 1881.

John's death was registered in 1q 1881 Wirral 8a 310, aged 79.

On 24 Feb 1824 when John was 22, he first married **Ann Fletcher** in Tattenhall, St Alban, Cheshire. Ann was born in Bunbury, Cheshire, abt 1799. Ann died in Poulton cum Spital, Cheshire, in 1851.

Ann's death was registered in 4q 1851 Wirral 19 275, aged 52.

They had the following children:

- i. Esther Warburton. Esther was born abt 1827.
- ii. Mary Warburton. Mary was born in Tarvin, Cheshire, abt 1828.
- iii. Ann Warburton. Ann was born in Tarvin, Cheshire, abt 1830.
- iv. Elizabeth Warburton. Elizabeth was born in Bebington, Cheshire, abt 1832.
- **32** v. **Thomas Warburton** (1839-)
- 33 vi. William Cornelius Warburton (1842-1888)

John second married Sarah. Sarah was born in Frodsham, Cheshire, in 1810. Sarah died in 1878.

Sarah's death was registered in 1q 1878 Wirral 8a 302, aged 67. There is no unmistakable wedding that identifies Sarah. The closest is in 3q 1852 at Everton, St Peter to Sarah Minshull, registered at West Derby 8b 582.

**18. George Warburton** (Peter<sup>4</sup>, Samuel<sup>3</sup>, John<sup>2</sup>, John<sup>1</sup>). George was born in Tattenhall, Cheshire, in 1817. He was christened in Tattenhall, Cheshire, on 29 Jun 1817. ■ Census for Tattenhall, Cheshire, in 1841. George (24) is a tailor living with Kittey (20), Mary (2), and Martha (1). ■ Census for Tattenhall, Cheshire, in 1851. George (34) is a tailor living with Ann (33), Mary (12), Martha (10), Ann (2 months) stepson Samuel Phillips (6), brother Joseph (26) a tailor, and an apprentice. ■ Census for Tattenhall, Cheshire, in 1861. George (44) is a tailor living at Nesie Houses with Anne (43), stepson Samuel Phillips (16), Anne (10), and Ellen (9). ■ Census for Tattenhall, Cheshire, in 1871. George (54) is a tailor living in the High Street with Ann (57). ■ Census for Tattenhall, St Alban, Cheshire, in 1881. George (64) is a tailor employing 1 man, living in the village with Ann (67). ■ Census for Tattenhall, Cheshire, in 1891. George (74) is a widowed tailor living alone. George died in Tattenhall, Cheshire, in 1896. He was buried in Tattenhall, St Alban, Cheshire, on 30 Apr 1896.

George's death was registered in 2q 1896 Chester 8a 230, aged 80.

On 6 Mar 1837 when George was 20, he first married **Catherine Griffiths** in Chester, St. Oswald, Cheshire. Catherine was born abt 1820. Catherine died in Tattenhall, Cheshire, in 1848. She was buried in Tattenhall, St Alban, Cheshire, on 10 Aug 1848.

#### They had the following children:

i. Mary Warburton. Mary was born in Tattenhall, Cheshire, in 1838. She was christened in Tattenhall, St Alban, Cheshire, on 2 Jul 1838.

Mary's birth was registered in 2q 1838 Great Boughton 19 61.

ii. Martha Warburton. Martha was born in Tattenhall, Cheshire, in 1840.

Martha's birth was registered in 2q 1840 Great Boughton 19 61. No baptism is recorded at Tattenhall, according to FamilySearch.

iii. Thomas Warburton. Thomas was born in Tattenhall, Cheshire, in 1843. He was christened in Tattenhall, St Alban, Cheshire, on 16 Jul 1843. Thomas died in Tattenhall, Cheshire, in 1850. He was buried in Tattenhall, St Alban, Cheshire, on 9 May 1850.

Thomas's death was registered in 2q 1850 Great Boughton 19 50, aged 6.

iv. Ellen Warburton. Ellen was born in Tattenhall, Cheshire, in 1845. She was christened in Tattenhall, St Alban, Cheshire, on 20 Jul 1845. Ellen died in Tattenhall, Cheshire, in 1848. She was buried in Tattenhall, St Alban, Cheshire, on 16 May 1848.

Ellen's death was registered in 2q 1848 Great Boughton 19 52, aged 2.

In 1850 when George was 33, he second married **Ann Phillips** in Chester, St John, Cheshire. The marriage was registered in 1q 1850 Great Boughton 19 24. Ann was born in Chowley, Cheshire, abt 1817. Ann died in Tattenhall, Cheshire, in 1889. She was buried in Tattenhall, St Alban, Cheshire, on 18 Apr 1889.

Ann's death was registered in 2q 1889 Chester 8a 235, aged 71.

#### They had the following children:

- i. **Anne Warburton**. Anne was born in Tattenhall, Cheshire, in 1851. She was christened in Tattenhall, St Alban, Cheshire, on 8 Mar 1851.
- ii. **Ellen Warburton**. Ellen was born in Tattenhall, Cheshire, in 1852. She was christened in Tattenhall, St Alban, Cheshire, on 18 Apr 1852.

**19. Elizabeth Warburton** (Samuel<sup>5</sup>, Thomas<sup>4</sup>, Peter<sup>3</sup>, John<sup>2</sup>, John<sup>1</sup>). Elizabeth was born in Chorlton, Cheshire, abt 1820. She was christened in Malpas, St Oswald, Cheshire, on 6 Feb 1820. Elizabeth died in Malpas, Cheshire, in 1894. ■ Census for Agden, Malpas, Cheshire, in 1851. An Elizabeth (30), born Chorlton, is a general servant on the farm of Robert Lowe. This entry cannot currently be found on Ancestry. ■ Census for Coddington, Cheshire, in 1861. Elizabeth (41) of Shocklach, is living with husband Samuel (34) of Tilston, and Margaret (10), Jane (8), John (5), and Elizabeth (2), all of Malpas. Ancestry places Cuddington in Shropshire. ■ Census for Coddington, Cheshire, in 1871. Elizabeth (49) of Shocklach, Samuel (48), and Sarah (9) are living together with John Jackson (83), father of Edge. ■ Census for Malpas, Cheshire, in 1881. Elizabeth (60) of Cuddington, and Samuel (50) of Broxton are living alone. ■ Census for Malpas, Cheshire, in 1891. Elizabeth (71), and Samuel (61) are now described as of Malpas.

This Elizabeth is favoured as the mother of the illegitimate Thomas because Thomas named his father as Samuel Warburton on his marriage certificate. Assuming Elizabeth's dalliance wasn't with a cousin Samuel, Thomas probably 'borrowed' either his grandfather's or step father's name. The witnesses at her wedding are Jane and John Warburton. Her sister Jane married John Warburton, son of James Warburton and Jane Clay, and so the brother of the other Elizabeth who is candidate for Thomas's mother.

Death registration 1q1894 Witchurch 6a569 age 74.

Elizabeth first married **Unknown**.

They had the following children:

  - ii. Margaret Warburton. Margaret was born on 15 Jun 1851.

On 21 Jul 1853 when Elizabeth was 33, she second married **Samuel Jackson** in Malpas, St Oswald, Cheshire. Elizabeth 30, spinster of Wycough, daughter of Samuel, labourer. Samuel 25, labourer at Oldcastle, son of John. Witnesses John and Jane Warburton. This probably Elizabeth's sister Jane and her husband John Warburton. Elizabeth seems to have knocked 3 years off her age. Most census entries and her age at death make her birth circa 1820. Elizabeth and Samuel's children were Jane (b. circa 1853), John (b. circa 1855), Elizabeth (b. circa 1858), and Sarah (b. circa 1861). Samuel was born abt 1828. Census for Malpas, Cheshire, in 1901. After Elizabeth's death Samuel (74) of Malpas is boarding with the Hewitt family.

**20.** Jane Warburton (Samuel<sup>5</sup>, Thomas<sup>4</sup>, Peter<sup>3</sup>, John<sup>2</sup>, John<sup>1</sup>). Jane was born in Chorlton, Cheshire, in 1829. She was christened in Malpas, St Oswald, Cheshire, on 20 Sep 1829.

On 22 Jan 1855 when Jane was 26, she married **John Warburton** (23), son of 13. **James** Warburton & Jane Clay, in Malpas, St Oswald, Cheshire. John 26, labourer of Chorlton, father

James, labourer. Jane 25, father Samuel Warburton, tailor. Assuming Samuel's father is correctly identified, John and Jane were 2nd cousins. John was born in Tilston, Cheshire, abt 1829. He was christened in Tilston, St Mary, Cheshire, on 1 Mar 1829. ■ Census for Duckington, Cheshire, in 1851. John (19) of Horton is a farm labourer in the Morris household. Also present are Samuel (14) and Mary (20) of Duckinfield who are brother and sister, but not closely related to John. ■ Census for Birkenhead, Cheshire, in 1861. John (30) is a dock labourer living with Jane (30), James (5), Ann (3), and John (1) at 49 Cathcart St. Another Warburton family are in a separate household at the same address. They are Samuel (26), Harriet (25), Thomas (2) and Jane (1). A Samuel Warburton married Harriet Davies at Malpas in 1859.

John and his young family cannot be traced in censuses after 1861. Nor can brother Samuel's family who were living at the same address.

#### They had the following children:

 James Warburton. He was christened in Malpas, St Oswald, Cheshire, on 26 Aug 1855.

A James from Malpas is present on the 1871 and 1891 censuses in Chesterton and Cheslyn Hay, Staffordshire, and whose death is registered 2q1891 at Cannock 6b 376 aged 38. In all references he is, however, 2 years too old.

- ii. **Ann Warburton**. She was christened in Malpas, St Oswald, Cheshire, on 4 Nov 1857.
- iii. John Warburton. John was born in Malpas, St Oswald, Cheshire, on 11 Sep 1859.
- **21. Thomas Warburton** (Peter<sup>5</sup>, John<sup>4</sup>, Peter<sup>3</sup>, John<sup>2</sup>, John<sup>1</sup>). Thomas was born in 1832. He was christened in Shocklach, St Edith, Cheshire, on 12 Aug 1832. Thomas died in Wolstanton, Staffordshire, in 1894. Census for Burwardsley, Cheshire, in 1861. Thomas Warberton (28) is an agricultural labourer living at Bodnock with Hannah (28), William (1), and Sarah (2 months). Census for Newcastle-under-Lyne, Staffordshire, in 1871. Thomas Warbuton (38) is a labourer in a brickyard living at 21 Union Street with Hannah (38) a washerwoman, William (11), Sarah (10), Hannah (5), Thomas (2), and John (4 months). Census for Wolstanton, Staffordshire, in 1881. Thomas (48) is a general labourer living at Cross Heath with Hannah (48), William (21) a miner, Hannah (15), John (10), and Martha (8). Thomas, Hannah and the 2 eldest children are of Burwardsley, Cheshire. The younger children are of Newcastle, Staffordshire. Census for Wolstanton, Staffordshire, in 1891. Thomas (59) is a general labourer living at Cross Heath with Hannah (59). He is of Shocklege, Wales, she of Burwardsley, Cheshire.

Probable death registration is 2q1894 Wolstanton 6b 54, aged 61.

On 17 Jan 1859 when Thomas was 27, he married **Hannah Brown**. Hannah was born in Burwardsley, Cheshire, abt 1832.

- i. William Warburton. William was born in Burwardsley, Cheshire, abt 1859.
  - William is not on the 1891 or 1901 censuses, nor is his death registered on FreeBMD in 1881-91.
- ii. **Sarah Warburton**. Sarah was born in Burwardsley, Cheshire, in 1861. Sarah died in Wolstanton, Staffordshire, in 1882.
  - Death ref 4q1882 Wolstanton 6b95 aged 21 is probably this Sarah.
- iii. Hannah Warburton. Hannah was born in Burwardsley, Cheshire, abt 1866.
- iv. **Thomas Warburton**. Thomas was born in Newcastle-under-Lyne, Staffordshire, in 1869. Thomas died in Newcastle-under-Lyne, Staffordshire, in 1872.
  - Death reference 4q1872 Newcastle-under-Lyne 6b38, aged 3 is probably this Thomas who is missing from the 1881 census.
- v. **John Warburton**. John was born in Newcastle-under-Lyne, Staffordshire, in 1870.
  - John cannot be found in the 1891 or 1901 censuses.
- vi. **Martha Warburton**. Martha was born in Newcastle-under-Lyne, Staffordshire, abt 1872.
- **22. George Warburton** (John<sup>5</sup>, John<sup>4</sup>, Peter<sup>3</sup>, John<sup>2</sup>, John<sup>1</sup>). George was born in Shocklach, Cheshire, in 1822. He was christened in Shocklach, St Edith, Cheshire, on 6 Mar 1822. Census for Hanmer, Flintshire, in 1841. George (20) is probably the agricultural labourer on the farm of Thomas Warver (transcribed Merburton on Ancestry). Census for Tilston, Cheshire, in 1851. George (29) is an agricultural labourer living at Littlehill with Emma (28), Mary (7), Jane (5) and Ann (2).

Although there are birth registrations and baptisms for 2 Anns, daughter of George and Emma, there is no record of an Ann's death or burial. It would seem that the first Ann died. Though the age of the Ann in the 1851 census fits the first, not the second, in 1861 when she is living with uncle Thomas Wright in Handley her age fits the second one.

There is evidence of George in censuses after 1861, when his youngest daughter is with her uncle. However ther is also no obvious death registration or burial.

On 13 Nov 1843 when George was 21, he married **Emma Wright** in Shocklach, St Edith, Cheshire. It is known from the marriage register that George's father was John. Emma was born in Tattenhall, Cheshire, abt 1822. Emma died in Tilston, Cheshire, in 1852. She was buried in Tilston, Cheshire, on 12 Jul 1852.

Emma's death was registered in 3q 1852 Great Boughton 8a 235, aged 29.

- i. Mary Warburton. Mary was born in Tilston, Cheshire, in 1844. She was christened in Tilston, Cheshire, on 11 Aug 1844.
- ii. **Jane Warburton**. Jane was born in Tilston, Cheshire, in 1846. She was christened in Tilston, Cheshire, on 8 Mar 1846.
- iii. **Ann Warburton**. Ann was born in Tilston, Cheshire, in 1848. She was christened in Tilston, Cheshire, on 25 Jun 1848. Ann died abt 1848.
- iv. **Ann Warburton**. Ann was born in Tilston, Cheshire, in 1849. She was christened in Tilston, Cheshire, on 8 Sep 1849.
- **23. John Warburton** (James<sup>5</sup>, John<sup>4</sup>, Peter<sup>3</sup>, John<sup>2</sup>, John<sup>1</sup>). John was born in Tilston, Cheshire, abt 1829. He was christened in Tilston, St Mary, Cheshire, on 1 Mar 1829. Census for Duckington, Cheshire, in 1851. John (19) of Horton is a farm labourer in the Morris household. Also present are Samuel (14) and Mary (20) of Duckinfield who are brother and sister, but not closely related to John. Census for Birkenhead, Cheshire, in 1861. John (30) is a dock labourer living with Jane (30), James (5), Ann (3), and John (1) at 49 Cathcart St. Another Warburton family are in a separate household at the same address. - ii. **Ann Warburton**. She was christened in Malpas, St Oswald, Cheshire, on 4 Nov 1857.

- **24. Elizabeth Warburton** (James<sup>5</sup>, John<sup>4</sup>, Peter<sup>3</sup>, John<sup>2</sup>, John<sup>1</sup>). Elizabeth was born in Horton, Cheshire, abt 1831. She was christened in Tilston, St Mary, Cheshire, on 28 Aug 1831. Elizabeth died in Malpas, Cheshire, in 1878. Census for Coddington, Cheshire, in 1861. Elizabeth (30) of Tilston is living with husband Joseph (33) of Malpas and Jane (4), Anne (2), and Emma (2 months)

all of Malpas. ■ Census for Malpas, Cheshire, in 1871. Elizabeth (43) of Horton, Joseph (46) of Cuddington, Ann (12) of Oldcastle, Emma (10) of Cuddington, and Joseph (8) of Malpas are present.

Elizabeth variously gives her place of birth as Tilston and Horton.

Elizabeth first married Unknown.

 William Warburton. He was christened on 8 Nov 1850. He was buried on 17 Dec 1850.

On 29 Jan 1857 when Elizabeth was 26, she second married **Joseph Jackson** in Malpas, St Oswald, Cheshire. Elizabeth 26, spinster of Overton, daughter of James. Joseph 29, labourer of Oldcastle, son of William. Witnesses Samuel (brother), and James (father). Joseph and Elizabeth's children were Jane (b. circa 1857), Ann (b. circa 1858), Emma (b. circa 1861), and Joseph (b. circa 1863). Joseph was born abt 1828. ■ Census for Malpas, Cheshire, in 1881. Following Elizabeth's death, Joseph (54) is living with Ann (22).

Samuel (26), Harriet (25), Thomas (2) and Jane (1) are living at 49 Cathcart St. Another Warburton family are in a separate household at the same address. They are John (30) a dock labourer living with Jane (30), James (5), Ann (3), and John (1).

Samuel and his young family cannot be traced in censuses after 1861. Nor can brother John's family who were living at the same address.

In 1859 when Samuel was 22, he married **Harriet Davies** in Malpas, St Oswald, Cheshire. Harriet was born abt 1835.

Census for Sutton, Isycoed, Denbighshire, in 1871. John is (26) a labourer living with wife Harriet (22), and Martha (11 months). Census for Sutton, Isycoed, Denbighshire, in 1881. John (35) is an agricultural labourer living on Bowlingbank Road with Harriet (32), Martha (11), Margaret (2) and John (3 months). Census for Sutton, Isycoed, Denbighshire, in 1891. John (45) is an agricultural labourer living with Harriet (42), Margaret (12),

John (10), Thomas (7), Jessie (5), Harriet (3), and William (11 months). Also present is lodger Mary Ann Jepson (68) a pauper born in Chester. ■ Census for Sutton, Isycoed, Denbighshire, in 1901. John (55) is an agricultural labourer living with Harriet (52), Harriet (13), Aaron(6), and their grandson Levi (5).

Grandson Levi age 5 is present in the 1901 census but he is too old to be the son of one of John's sons. He is more likely the illegitimate son of Martha or Margaret.

John was born in Tattenhall, Cheshire, in 1816. ■ Census for Tattenhall, Cheshire, in 1841. John (25) is a cabinet maker living with Isabella (24). ■ Census for Liverpool, Lancashire, in 1851. John (34) is a cabinet maker living with Isabella (33) and John (1). John died aft 1851.

John and his family have not been found in censuses after 1851.

In 1840 when John was 24, he married **Isabella Tyson** in Liverpool, St Anne, Lancashire. The marriage was registered in 1q 1840 Liverpool 20 142. John's father is named Samuel on the parish register (though FamilySearch doesn't give the exact date). Isabella was born in Whiehaven, Cumberland, abt 1817.

It is not clear who this Louisa is as there is no matching birth registration. ■ Census for West Derby, Liverpool, Lancashire, in 1881. Thomas (52) is a dealer in dunnage mats, is living at 26 Marlborough Road with Elizabeth (52), Thomas Alfred (14), and nephew Frederick Newcombe (8). ■ Census for West Derby, Liverpool, Lancashire, in 1891. Thomas (62) is living on his own means at 38 Marlborough

Road with Elizabeth (62), and nephew Frederick Newcombe (18). • Census for West Derby, Liverpool, Lancashire, in 1901. Thomas (72) is a widowed father living with son Thomas at 60 Kremlin Drive. Thomas died on 2 Mar 1902. He was buried in Kirkdale Cemetery, Liverpool, Lancashire, on 5 Mar 1902.

On 18 Apr 1851 when Thomas was 23, he married **Elizabeth Aykroyd** in Liverpool, Lancashire. The marriage was registered in 2q 1851 Liverpool 20 395. Elizabeth was living in Dale, St., Liverpool, father John a hairdresser. Elizabeth was born in Melbourne, Lancashire, on 11 Oct 1828. Elizabeth died in West Derby, Liverpool, Lancashire, on 4 Jul 1894. She was buried in Kirkdale Cemetery, Liverpool, Lancashire.

Elizabeth's death was registered in 3q 1894 West Derby 8b 296, aged 65. She died at 12 Ellerslie Road, Tue Brook, Liverpool.

Richard (39) is a widowed tobacco manufacturer employing 3 men, 9 boys, and 9 girls, living at 7 Mount Pleasant with Sarah (43), Margaret (18), Celia (16), widowed sister-in-law Anne (54) who is living off money invested, neice Annie Worrall (18), and neice Annie Rogerson (28). ■ Census for Onchan, Isle of Man, in 1881. Richard (49) is a retired tobacco manufacturer living at 13 East Field with Sarah (53). ■ Census for Onchan, Isle of Man, in 1891. Richard (59) is a tobacco manufacturer (temporarily out of business) living at 13 East Field with Sarah (63). ■ Census for Onchan, Isle of Man, in 1901. Richard (69) is living on his own means at 13 East Field with Sarah (74). ■ Census for Conchan, Isle of Man, in 1911. Richard (79) is a retired tobacco manufacturer living at 13 East Field with daughter Celia Adelsberg (55). Richard died in Douglas, Isle of Man, in 1913.

Richard was 81 on his death registration.

On 25 Dec 1851 when Richard was 20, he first married **Martha Aykroyd** in Liverpool, Our Lady & St Nicholas & St Anne, Lancashire. Martha died in Liverpool, Lancashire, in 1854.

Martha died before the 1861 census when Richard was a widower. Her's is probably the death recorded in 4q 1854 Liverpool 8b 215, though there is one other in Liverpool, before 1861.

Rasmus was a Danish Sea Captain.

ii. **Celia Warburton**. Celia was born in 1854. She was christened in Liverpool, St Peter, Lancashire, on 24 Jul 1854.

In 1875 when Celia was 21, she married **Henry Albert Adelsberg** in Register Office, or Registrar attended. The marriage was registered in 3q 1875 West Derby 8b 924.

On 23 Apr 1862 when Richard was 31, he second married **Sarah Mehew** in Braddan, Isle of Man. Sarah was born abt 1827. Sarah died in Douglas, isle of Man, in 1903.

Sarah was 75 on her death registration.

Louisa is Louisa Mercy on her baptism as recorded on the FamilySearch beta site, but Louisa Mary on her birth registration.

Henry (36) is a tobacconist and cigar manufacturer employing 1 man, 1 boy, and 1 girl, and living at 7 Duke St with Elizabeth (34), William (10 mths), Mary (5), and a servant. ■ Census for Onchan, Isle of Man, in 1881. Henry (46) is a tobacconist and cigar manufacturer employing 1 man, 1 boy, and 1 girl, and living at 10 East Field with Elizabeth (44), May (15), William (10), Charlotte (9), Samuel (7), John (3). and a servant. ■ Census for Conchan, Isle of Man, in 1891. Henry (56) is a widowed tobacconist living in Brunswick Road with William (20), Charlotte (19), Samuel (17), and Gertrude (8). ■ Census for Conchan, Isle of Man, in 1901. William (39) is a commercial clerk living at 7 Florence Street with Matilda (41), William (16) a grocer's assistant, George (11) Annie (9), Charles (7), Samuel (5), Esther (1), and a servant. William Cornelius died in 1888.

William's birth was registered in 2q 1842 Wirral 19 326. His death was registered in 2q 1888 Liverpool 8b 40, aged 46.

In 1864 when William Cornelius was 22, he married **Matilda Myers** in Birkenhead, St Mary, Cheshire. The marriage was registered in 1q 1864 Birkenhead 8a 521. Matilda was born in Birkenhead, Cheshire, abt 1839. ■ Census for Kirkdale, Liverpool, Lancashire, in 1891. Matilda (51) is a widow living at 28 Chirkdale Street with George (21) a warehouseman, Annie (20), Charles (17) an apprentice, Samuel (15) an office boy, Esther (11), and Matilda (8). Matilda died in 1896.

Matilda's death was registered in 1g 1896 West Derby 8b 295, aged 56.

Thomas (31) is an agricultural labourer at Overton Heath, with Sarah (31), Harry (7), Annie (4), Sarah Ann (1), Frederick Cadman (2, a boarder), and Sarah Davenport (33), a lodger and dressmaker. The name is spelt Warberton. ■ Census for Hampton, Cheshire, in 1891. Thomas (41) is an agricultural labourer, living with his wife Sarah (41), Harry (18) a farm servant, Annie (15) a general domestic, Sarah A (10), Thomas (9), and Martha J (3). Also present is Frederick Cadman (11), a visitor. ■ Census for Handley, Cheshire, in 1901. Thomas (53), is a waggoner on a farm, living at Clayley Cottage, with wife Sarah (53), and Sarah Davenport (55) a dressmaker. Thomas died on 11 Mar 1931.

Thomas was the illegitimate son of Elizabeth Warburton. There are two possibilities for this Elizabeth. The most likely, based on the fact that Thomas gave his father's name as Samuel Warburton on his marriage certificate, is the daughter of Samuel Warburton and Sarah Richards, who later married Samuel Jackson. The other possibility is the daughter of James Warburton and Jane Clay who later married Joseph Jackson. It is known within the family that Thomas sometimes used the name Jackson.

See Thomas Warburton husband of Sarah Steen. As an illegitimate son Thomas is head of a new clan. An alternative to this Elizabeth as his mother is Elizabeth the daughter of James Warburton and Jane Clay.

On 18 Nov 1873 when Thomas was 25, he married **Sarah Steen** in Whitchurch, Staffordshire. By Licence. Thomas was 25, a bachelor, and labourer of Manor House, Hampton. He gave his father as Samuel Warburton, labourer. Is this his stepfather Samuel Jackson, his grandfather, or was his father a Warburton cousin? Sarah was 25, a spinster of Broadoak, Iscoed. Her father was Thomas, a labourer. Sarah was born in Malpas, Cheshire, in 1848. She was christened in Malpas, Cheshire, on 10 Jan 1848. She was buried in Handley, Cheshire, on 26 Dec 1939.

i. Harry Warburton. Harry was born in Malpas, Cheshire, in 1874. Harry died bef 1939

Harry's birth was registered in the first quarter at Whitchurch. He married a nurse from Stockport but died without issue.

ii. **Annie Warburton**. Annie was born in Malpas, Cheshire, in 1877. Annie died abt 1967.

Annie's birth was registered in the second quarter at Whitchurch.

In 1904 when Annie was 27, she married **Alf Vernon**. The wedding was registered in the second quarter at Whitchurch. They had 3 girls including Janet and Ethel.

She was buried in West Kirby, St Bridget, Cheshire.
