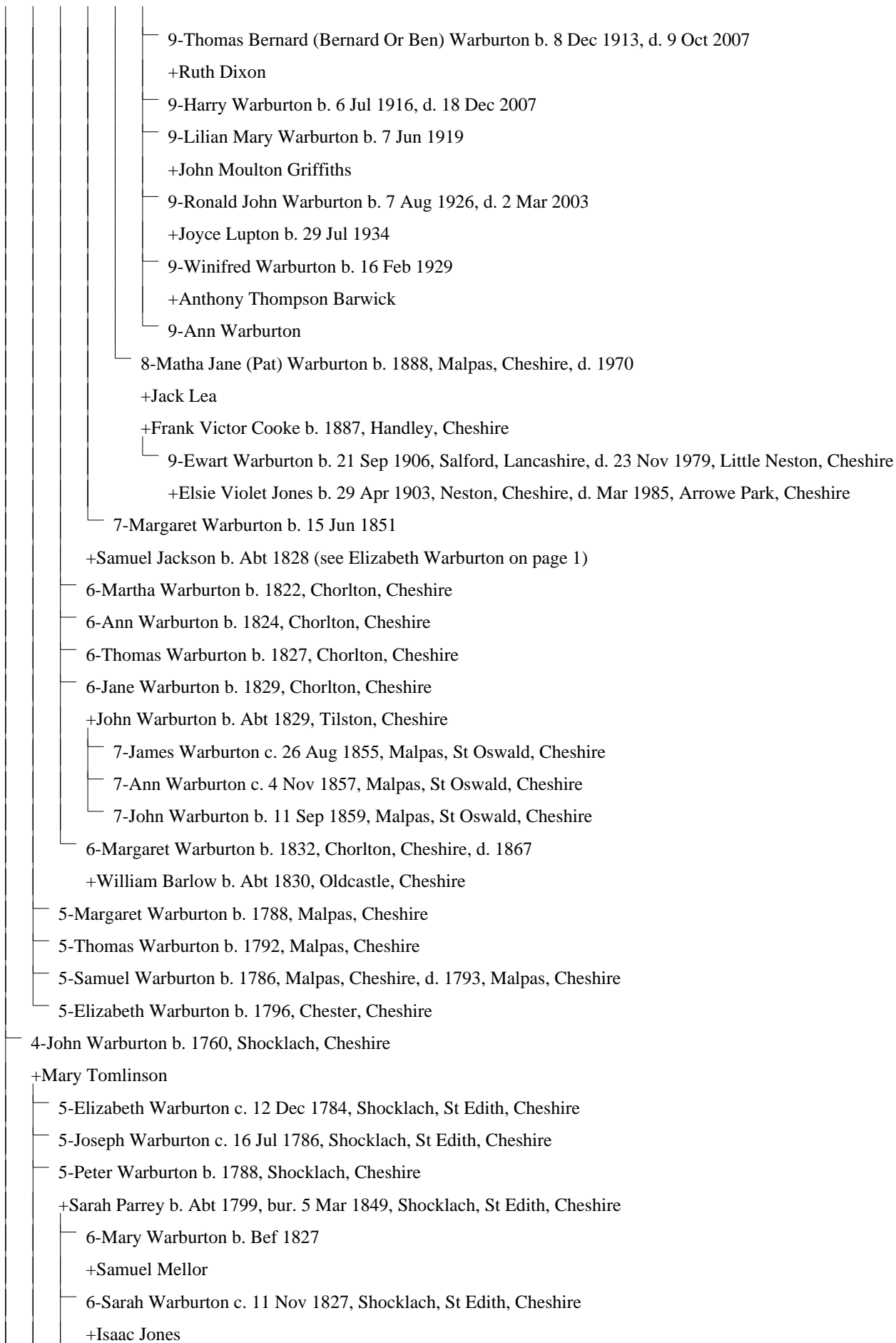

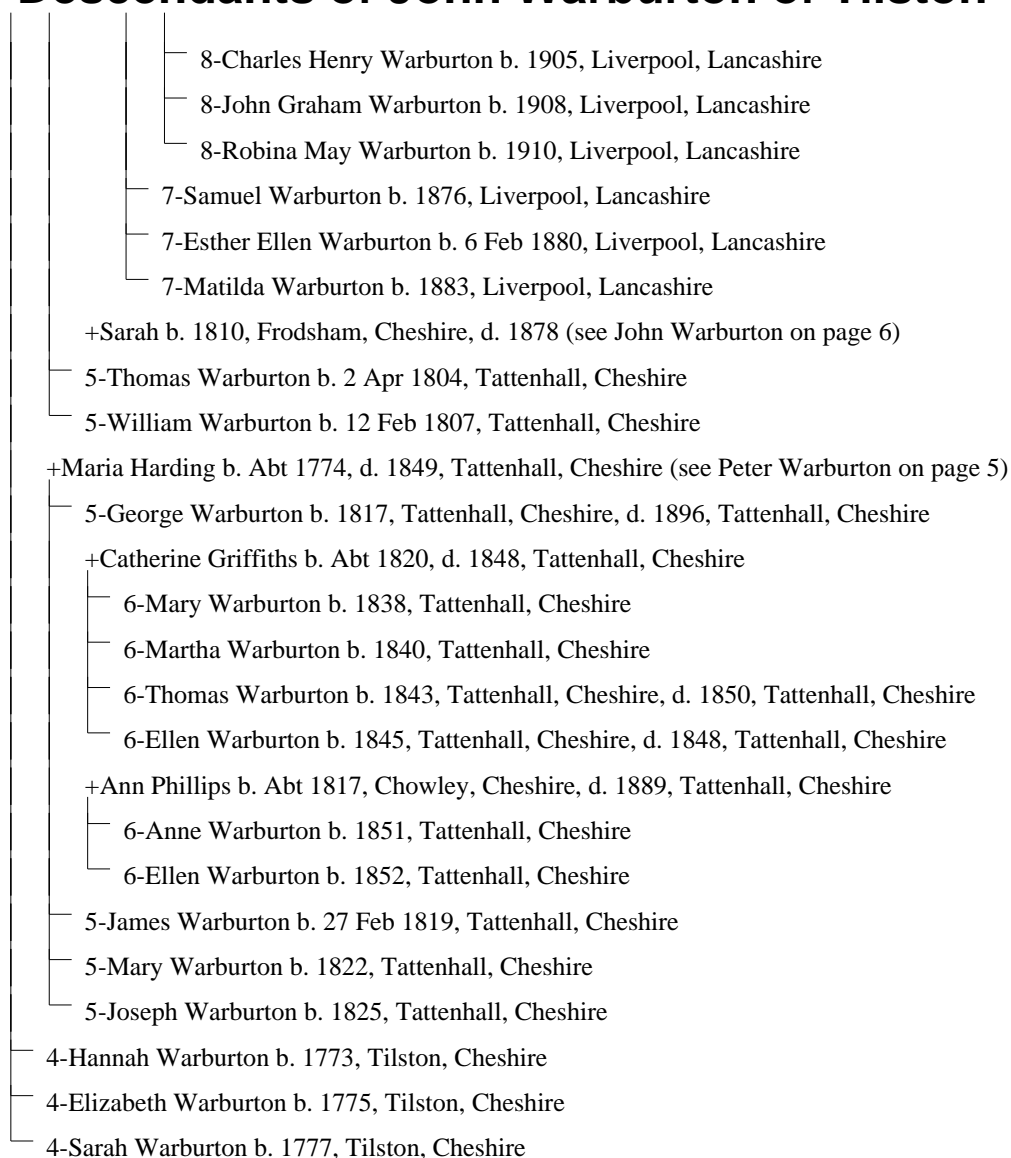

# Descendants of John Warburton

## First Generation

### 1. John Warburton

General Notes: The early parish registers at Tilston do not paint a consistent picture. A John son of John was baptised on 16th March 1683/4. There are two burials which are assumed to be these Johns, in 1723 and 1761. However the pattern of marriages and baptisms is confusing. A Hellen, wife of John was buried in 1715. Three children, father John were baptised between 1712 and 1716. As Hellen died before the last of these was baptised it is assumed she wasn't the mother of any of them, and therefore probably the wife of John senior.

A John married Ann Williams in 1720, a month after the baptism of James son of John. It is therefore possible a third John with an unknown wife was the father of some, if not all the children born between 1712 and 1729, whose father was John. However a more likely explanation is that the John born in 1683 was the father of all the children and died in 1761. He had an unknown first wife (no marriage or burial at Tilston), and married Ann Williams after the birth of their first child.

Alternatively Hellen was married to the younger John and the spouse of the older John is unknown. In this scenario the baptism of Elenor was delayed several months, maybe due to the death of her mother.

John married **Hellen**. Hellen died in 1715 in Tilston, Cheshire and was buried on 27 Jul 1715 in Tilston, St Mary, Cheshire.

Children from this marriage were:

- 2 F i. **Mary Warburton** was born in 1676 and was christened on 11 Feb 1677 in Tilston, St Mary, Cheshire.
- + 3 M ii. **John Warburton** was born in 1684, was christened on 16 Mar 1684 in Tilston, St Mary, Cheshire, died in 1761 in Tilston, Cheshire aged 77, and was buried on 6 Mar 1761 in Tilston, St Mary, Cheshire.

## Second Generation (Children)

**3. John Warburton** (*John<sup>1</sup>*) was born in 1684, was christened on 16 Mar 1684 in Tilston, St Mary, Cheshire, died in 1761 in Tilston, Cheshire aged 77, and was buried on 6 Mar 1761 in Tilston, St Mary, Cheshire.

General Notes: There are three children of a John baptised between 1712 and 1716, who are assumed to be John's by a first marriage.

James is born a month before the marriage of John Warburton and Anne Williams but there is no alternative family at Tilston, the only recent baptism of a John (son of John) being in 1683.

John married **Unknown**.

Children from this marriage were:

- 4 M i. **Thomas Warburton** was born in 1712 in Tilston, Cheshire and was christened on 30 Nov 1712 in Tilston, St Mary, Cheshire.

## Third Generation (Grandchildren)

**7. James Warburton** (*John<sup>2</sup>, John<sup>1</sup>*) was born in 1720 in Tilston, Cheshire and was christened on 29 Apr 1720 in Tilston, St Mary, Cheshire.

General Notes: The only marriage of a John took place a month after James's birth, so it is possible he didn't belong to this family.

James married.

His child was:

- + 11 M i. **Samuel Warburton** was born in 1744 in Tilston, Cheshire, was christened on 11 Apr 1744 in Tilston, St Mary, Cheshire, died in 1825 in Thornton-Le-Moors, Cheshire aged 81, and was buried on 19 Aug 1825 in Thornton-Le-Moors, St Mary, Cheshire.

**8. Peter Warburton** (*John<sup>2</sup>, John<sup>1</sup>*) was born in 1722 in Tilston, Cheshire and was christened on 21 Oct 1722 in Tilston, St Mary, Cheshire.

General Notes: Peter was originally reported as the son of Thomas and Christian Brown of Shocklach but Peter's baptism is not recorded at Shocklach. This may have been an assumption because his own children were baptised at Shocklach. However the only recorded baptism that is close in time and place is the one at Tilston.

Peter married **Sarah Edwards** on 29 May 1751 in Shocklach, St Edith, Cheshire.

**10. Samuel Warburton** (*John<sup>2</sup>, John<sup>1</sup>*) was born in 1729 in Tilston, Cheshire, was christened on 6 Jan 1730 in Tilston, St Mary, Cheshire, died in 1814 in Tilston, Cheshire aged 85, and was buried on 23 Nov 1814 in Tilston, St Mary, Cheshire.

General Notes: Samuel was buried aged 86.

Samuel married **Eleanor Povey** on 27 Dec 1751 in Tilston, St Mary, Cheshire. Eleanor died in 1768 and was buried on 25 Mar 1768 in Tilston, St Mary, Cheshire.

Children from this marriage were:
