



# Lancashire Group Haplotree

<b>Notes:</b>									
1. Although Thomas of Edenfield is estimated to be born circa 1490, it is known there were Warburtons renting land in Tottington Manor in 1442.									
1. The structure below Thomas (c1490-c1559) of the Edenfield clan is based on STR TMRCA calculations as there are no known shared SNPs below A15056.									
2. The four closely related clans in the structure are assumed to be branches of the Edenfield clan because it has th deepest history, even if the average TMRCA is slightly older, as the dates come with wide ranges.									
4. The positioning of the three clans not yet SNP tested is speculative. Follow up tests are not possible as one tester has died, one is unwilling, and I've lost contact with the other. New testers are needed from these clans.									
5. Whilst the STR TMRCA calculations for the Haslingden clan produce dates that are before surnames were adopted, the possible range would encompass a link to the Edenfield clan. SNP tests are needed to confirm.									
6. The STR TMRCA range for Haslingden/Utah is even older than for Tottington so it is only assumed, not certain that it is even S6881 positive.									
7. The Haslingden and Haslingden/Utah tests were on descendants of two supposed half brothers from the mid 19th century, but the genetic distance between the two is 6 implying they were only distantly related.
