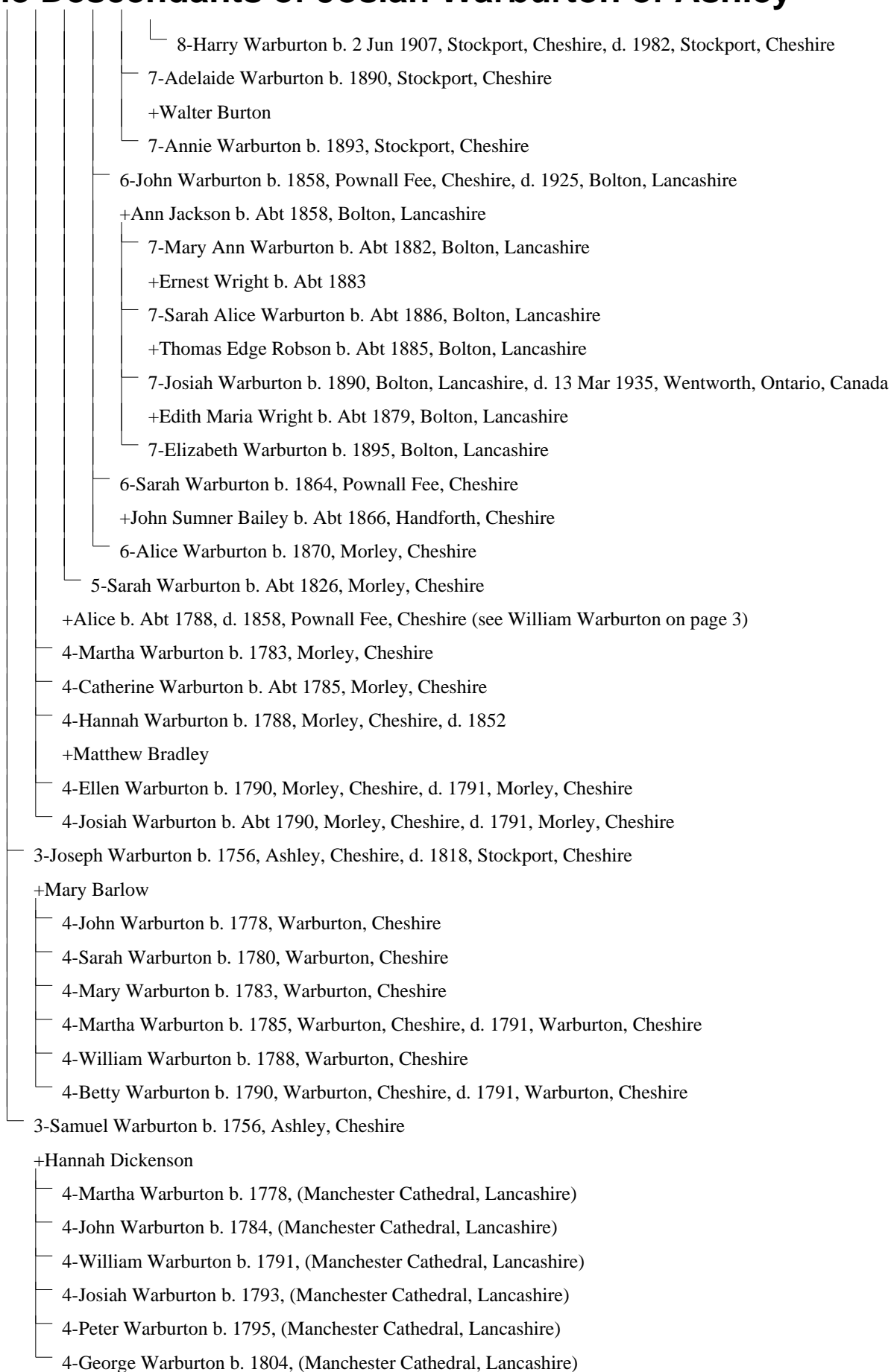

First Generation

1. John Warburton

General Notes: The only known reference to John is as the father of a Josiah born in 1715 in Northenden. He could have been a nephew of Josiah of Hale Barns, possibly a son of his youngest brother Enoch of Mobberley whose will referred to children, though there are no baptisms for them.

John married.

His child was:

- + 2 M i. **Josiah Warburton** was born in 1715 in Northenden, Cheshire, was christened on 15 Nov 1716 in Northenden, St Wilfred, Cheshire, died in 1764 in Ashley, Cheshire aged 49, and was buried on 26 Sep 1764 in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire.

Second Generation (Children)

2. Josiah Warburton (*John*¹) was born in 1715 in Northenden, Cheshire, was christened on 15 Nov 1716 in Northenden, St Wilfred, Cheshire, died in 1764 in Ashley, Cheshire aged 49, and was buried on 26 Sep 1764 in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire.

General Notes: Josiah's origin is uncertain. The only recorded baptism is the one at Northenden but many nonconformist baptisms were unrecorded at this time. There are many references in the parish and other records to people for whom no baptism is recorded.

The use of the name Josiah is possibly in honour of Josiah Warburton of Hale Barns who was a leading Presbyterian, and involved in the founding of Hale Chapel. He was living in Northenden when he died in 1730 and could have been there by 1715 as he married a lady from Northenden in 1711. This might imply a family connection.

He is called Isaiah of Ashley on his burial record.

Many lines of Josiah's descendants have yet to be explored fully.

Josiah married **Martha Bradbury** on 27 Dec 1737 in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire. Martha died in 1764 in Ashley, Cheshire and was buried on 26 May 1764 in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire.

Marriage Notes: Both were 'of this parish'.

General Notes: Martha is described as the wife of Josiah of Ashley on her burial record.

Children from this marriage were:

- 3 M i. **John Warburton** was born in 1739 in Mobberley, Cheshire and was christened on 20 May 1739 in Mobberley, St Wilfred, Cheshire.
- + 4 M ii. **Thomas Warburton** was born about 1741 in Ashley, Cheshire, died in 1794 in Hale, Cheshire aged about 53, and was buried on 30 Dec 1794 in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire.
- + 5 M iii. **Josiah Warburton** was born about 1744 in Ashley, Cheshire, died in 1818 in Altrincham, Cheshire aged about 74, and was buried on 17 Mar 1818 in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire.
- 6 F iv. **Martha Warburton** was born about 1745 in Ashley, Cheshire, died in 1745, and was buried on 26 May 1745 in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire.

General Notes: Martha's burial is the clue that Josiah and Martha had children between John in 1739, and Jacob in 1747 whose baptisms at Hale or Ringway Chapels was not recorded.
- + 7 M v. **Jacob Warburton** was born in 1747 in Ashley, Cheshire and was christened on 29 Mar 1747 in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire.
- 8 M vi. **Samuel Warburton** was born about 1750 in Ashley, Cheshire, was christened on 25 Feb 1750 in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, and died before 1756.

General Notes: It is presumed Samuel died young as a second Samuel was baptised in 1756, though no burial record has been found.
- + 9 M vii. **George Warburton** was born in 1751 in Ashley, Cheshire and was christened on 27 Oct 1751 in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire.
- + 10 M viii. **William Warburton** was born about 1754 in Ashley, Cheshire, was christened on 13 Jan 1754 in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, died in 1806 in Morley, Cheshire aged about 52, and was buried on 30 Oct 1806 in Wilmslow, St Bartholemew, Cheshire.

Ancestors of John Warburton

- + 11 M ix. **Joseph Warburton** was born in 1756 in Ashley, Cheshire, was christened on 21 Nov 1756 in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, died in 1818 in Stockport, Cheshire aged 62, and was buried on 15 Jan 1818 in Warburton, St Werbergh, Cheshire.
- + 12 M x. **Samuel Warburton** was born in 1756 in Ashley, Cheshire and was christened on 21 Nov 1756 in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire.

Third Generation (Grandchildren)

4. Thomas Warburton (*Josiah², John¹*) was born about 1741 in Ashley, Cheshire, died in 1794 in Hale, Cheshire aged about 53, and was buried on 30 Dec 1794 in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire.

General Notes: Thomas is considered to be the probable son of Josiah and Martha of Ashley because:

1. His age at death puts his birth in the period between 1739 and 1747 when no records of baptisms of children of Josiah and Martha exist but the burial of a daughter suggests at least one child was born. This is a time when baptisms were being conducted at Hale Chapel but records no longer exist. Josiah and Martha's home at Ashley was close to Hale Chapel.
2. There is no matching baptism at Bowdon, though there is one at Flixton, father John.
3. Thomas, like Josiah was from Ashley on the baptisms of his first two children.
4. The names George, Samuel, John and Martha were also used by Josiah and Martha.

Thomas married **Sarah Shaw** on 27 Dec 1770 in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire. Sarah was born about 1741, died in 1815 aged about 74, and was buried on 24 Aug 1815 in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire.

General Notes: Sarah was 74 when she died according to the parish record of her burial.

- 15 F iii. **Hannah Warburton** was born in 1776 in Hale, Cheshire and was christened on 2 Jun 1776 in Hale Chapel, Cheshire.

General Notes: John was aged 1 on his burial record.

- + 21 M ix. **John Warburton** was born on 9 Mar 1788 in Hale, Cheshire and was christened on 23 Mar 1788 in Hale Chapel, Cheshire.

5. Josiah Warburton (*Josiah², John¹*) was born about 1744 in Ashley, Cheshire, died in 1818 in Altrincham, Cheshire aged about 74, and was buried on 17 Mar 1818 in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire.

General Notes: Josiah is considered to be the probable son of Josiah and Martha of Ashley because:

1. His age at death (73 on his burial record) puts his birth in the period between 1739 and 1747 when no records of baptisms of children of Josiah and Martha exist but the burial of a daughter suggests at least one child was born. This a time when baptisms were being conducted at Hale Chapel but records no longer exist. Josiah and Martha's home at Ashley was close to Hale Chapel.
2. There is no matching baptism at Bowdon, and Josiah's born elsewhere at the time are already known.
3. Although his children were all baptised from Altrincham, he was from Hale at the time of his marriage.
4. The use of the name Josiah.

Josiah married **Martha Henshaw** on 2 Jul 1769 in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire.

Marriage Notes: Josiah was a husbandman from Hale.

7. Jacob Warburton (*Josiah*², *John*¹) was born in 1747 in Ashley, Cheshire and was christened on 29 Mar 1747 in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire.

General Notes: Jacob is considered to be the one who married Jane Faulkner because a Jacob and Jane had a son baptised at Rostherne in 1772 and there are no records of another Jacob in the area, the nearest being in Bury, Lancashire.

Jacob and his brother Samuel were married at Manchester Cathedral and had children baptised there. Brother George married in Bowden but had his later children baptised at Manchester Cathedral. This suggests they may have been involved in a family enterprise in Manchester.

No death or burial record has been found for Jacob.

Jacob married **Jane Faulkner** on 21 Sep 1771 in Manchester Cathedral, Lancashire.

Children from this marriage were:

General Notes: The George who married Ellen Blease is considered to be the probable son of Josiah and Martha of Ashley because:

1. His first two children were baptised from Ashley and Hale. They subsequently had children baptised at Manchester Cathedral.
2. One of his later children was called Josiah. He also repeated the names Martha, John, William, and Joseph used by Josiah and Martha.
3. When his youngest child Isaac died and was buried aged 4 months he returned to Bowdon for the burial where he was recorded as the son of George and Ellen of Manchester .

No death record has been identified for George.

General Notes: The William who married Catherine Hooley is considered to be the son of Josiah and Martha because:

1. His abode at Morley is quite close to his parents' abode at Ashley and the link is strengthened because he returned to Ringway Chapel, near Hale for the baptisms of three of his children.
2. The use of the name Josiah several times amongst his descendants, including his own son.
3. There is no case to support other Williams of an appropriate age, including one from Wilmslow who can be linked to a family in Dean Row.

The identification of William's death is based on the abode of Morley but there is no corroborating evidence.

William married **Catherine Hooley** on 27 Feb 1775 in Wilmslow, St Bartholemew, Cheshire. Catherine was born about 1749, died in 1834 in Morley, Cheshire aged about 85, and was buried on 12 Jan 1834 in Wilmslow, St Bartholemew, Cheshire.

Marriage Notes: The marriage was also listed at Cheadle.

General Notes: Catherine was aged 85 of Morley on her burial record.

General Notes: Joseph was baptised with his brother Samuel but the parish record does not state they were twins.

The Joseph who married Mary Barlow is considered to be the likely son of Josiah and Martha of Ashley because:

1. His age on his marriage and burial fit (though on the marriage he is only 21 and up).
2. No other Joseph was baptised in the area at that time.

At some time he moved to Stockport but returned to Warburton to be buried. Two further children of a Joseph and Mary were baptised in Stockport in the 1790s which might be theirs, depending on when they moved. They were Thomas in 1792 and Betty in 1795.

Joseph married **Mary Barlow** on 27 Nov 1777 in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire.

Marriage Notes: Joseph was a chairmaker living in Warburton on his marriage license.

2. He followed the example of brothers Jacob and George in marrying and having children baptised at Manchester Cathedral.

Samuel's burial record has not been found.

General Notes: The identification of the father of the Josiah born in 1818 with the son of Thomas and Sarah Shaw is discussed in detail in an article in Issue 7 of The Button Files. It is the most likely of four possibilities, once all other known candidates have been eliminated, but is not certain. The association with Hale, and the naming of his son Josiah are considerations.

Mary Hulbert is one of three Mary's who are known to have married a John in the relevant timeframe. The other marriages were at Manchester Cathedral, but are possible given that two of John's likely uncles were married there. That in 1804 to Mary Henshall seems a bit early, but that to Mary Cooke on 11th October 1807, which was followed by two baptisms at Manchester, is possible.

There were three baptisms in Bowdon parish to parents called John and Mary, but two not only predate the marriage to Mary Hulbert, but are too close together to be the same family. That of Eliza is also from a family living in Hale but was at Hale Chapel whereas Josiah was baptised at the parish church in Bowdon.

No burial or death registration has been found for John to enable a check of his age at death.

John married **Mary Hulbert** on 31 Aug 1817 in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire.

The child from this marriage was:

- + 65 M i. **Josiah Warburton** was born in 1818 in Hale, Cheshire, was christened on 19 Jun 1818 in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, and died in 1883 in Didsbury, Lancashire aged 65.

General Notes: Sarah was a widow aged 72 and living with son John in the 1851 census, and the widow of Thomas of Altrincham, aged 76 on her bural record in 1854.

General Notes: William's death is probably that registered in 1q 1875 Stockport 8a 86, aged 93. His age in censuses and at death suggest he was born between early 1781 and March 1784 suggesting his baptism was performed late, along with his younger sibling, rather than he was a twin.

85 F vi. **Georgina Warburton** was born in 1877 in Bowdon, Cheshire.

General Notes: Georgina's birth was registered in 4q 1877 Altrincham 8a 181. She is my contact Leslie Barton's grandmother.

Georgina married **James Taberner** in 1896 in Altrincham, St George, Cheshire. James was born in 1876 in Altrincham, Cheshire.

Marriage Notes: The marriage was registered in 1q 1896 Altrincham 8a 202. James and Georgina had 21 children, including two sets of twins. By the 1911 census they had had 13, but only 4 were living. Six more were registered at Bucklow by 1920.

66. Samuel Warburton (*Thomas⁴, Josiah³, Josiah², John¹*) was born on 16 Oct 1806 in Altrincham, Cheshire, was christened on 16 Nov 1806 in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, died on 14 Jul 1865 in Altrincham, Cheshire aged 58, and was buried on 18 Jul 1865 in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire.

General Notes: Samuel is buried in grave 811 which was previously used by Samuel of Timperley and his wife Mary nee Clark, who both died before Samuel was born. No connection between the two families is evident.

Samuel and Mary had a son Thomas baptised in March 1785 but I have found no other record of this Thomas. Meanwhile Samuel's mother Sarah was a widow on the 1851 census, and the widow of Thomas of Altrincham on her burial. This fits with the burial of Thomas of Altrincham in 1848, and Thomas's age means he was born around 1770. Thomas and Sarah are not in the 1841 census, but it seems most likely that Sarah married the son of Josiah and Martha, who was 8 year older, than the son of Samuel and Mary, who was 6 years younger and appears in no other records.

Samuel married **Abigail Watkinson** on 26 Nov 1826 in Lymm, St Mary, Cheshire.

88 M iii. **William Warburton** was born in 1832 in Altrincham, Cheshire and was christened on 1 Jul 1832 in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire.

General Notes: William's father was a labourer on his baptism record.

67. John Warburton (*Thomas⁴, Josiah³, Josiah², John¹*) was born on 24 Feb 1810 in Altrincham, Cheshire, was christened on 25 Mar 1810 in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, died on 24 May 1885 in Altrincham, Cheshire aged 75, and was buried on 27 May 1885 in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire.

General Notes: John is buried in grave 1219 with Catherine, two of their children, and Catherine's parents. He has shaved a couple of years of his age but is the only son of Sarah baptised at Bowdon around that time.

Noted events in his life were:

- He appeared on the census in 1851 in Altrincham, Cheshire. John (38) is a fustian cutter living n Goose Green with Catherine (44), William (15) a labourer, James (10), Sarah Jane (10), Samuel (8), George (6) and mother Sarah (72).

John married **Catherine Erlam** on 13 Aug 1832 in Manchester Cathedral, Lancashire. Catherine was born about 1808 in Hale, Cheshire, died on 22 Feb 1867 in Altrincham, Cheshire aged about 59, and was buried on 26 Feb 1867 in Bowdon, St Mary,

Children from this marriage were:

- General Notes: Isaac died aged 8 months.
- 92 F iv. **Sarah Jane Warburton** was born in 1840 in Altrincham, Cheshire, was christened on 13 Sep 1840 in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, died on 25 Apr 1869 in Altrincham, Cheshire aged 29, and was buried on 29 Apr 1869 in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire.
- General Notes: Sarah Jane's father was a fustian cutter on her baptism. She is the daughter of John and Catherine of Altrincham, aged 27 on her burial record but 31 on her headstone (both are wrong as she was probably 28). She is buried in grave 1219 with her (Erlam) grandparents, parents, and brother William.
- 93 M v. **James Warburton** was born in 1840 in Altrincham, Cheshire.
- General Notes: James's birth was registered at the same time as Sarah Jane's, 3q 1840 Altrincham 19 1. However he doesn't appear on Sarah's baptism record, though it is likely he was baptised at the same time. They are assumed to be twins.

 Elizabeth married **William Sadler** in 1858 in Cheadle, St Mary, Cheshire. William was born in 1858 and was christened in Cheadle, St Mary, Cheshire.
 Marriage Notes: The marriage wa registered in 2q 1858 Stockport 8a 25.
- 100 F iv. **Amelia Boulton Warburton** was born on 30 Apr 1841 in Morley, Cheshire and was christened on 4 Sep 1853 in Wilmslow, St Bartholemew, Cheshire.
 General Notes: Amelia's birth was registered in 2q 1841 Altrincham 19 27 (Wilmslow district on Cheshire BMD).
 Amelia married **Joseph Boon** on 19 Feb 1866 in Wilmslow, St Bartholemew, Cheshire. Joseph was born in 1844 in Mobberley, Cheshire.
 Marriage Notes: Joseph (22) was a labourer from Wilmslow, father Faithful, a labourer. Amelia (24) was from Wilmslow father James a labourer. The marriage was registered in 1q 1866 Altrincham 8a 216. Amelia and Joseph had 2 sons and a daughter.

William married **Mary Johnson** on 3 Jan 1844 in Manchester Cathedral, Lancashire. Mary was born about 1817 in Flixton, Lancashire and died in 1883 in Kearsley, Lancashire aged about 66.

Marriage Notes: William was from Withington, a husbandman, father William, a weaver. Mary was from Withington father John, a farmer.

General Notes: Mary's father John was a farmer in Flixton. Her death is probably that registered in 4q 1883 Bolton 8c 182. aged 66 (Farnworth sub-district on CheshireBMD).

Children from this marriage were:

- 102 M i. **John Warburton** was born in 1854 in Gatley, Cheshire, was christened in 1857 in Little Hulton, St Paul, Lancashire, and died in 1933 in Farnworth, Lancashire aged 79.
 General Notes: John's birth is probably that registered in 3q 1854 Stockport 8a 77. CheshireBMD records his mother's maiden name as Johnson. His death was probably that registered in 1q 1933 Bolton 8c 423, aged 78. This is the closest on age and was in Farnworth sub-district (LancashireBMD).
 Noted events in his life were:
- He appeared on the census in 1891 in Kearsley, Lancashire. John (37) is a carter living at 95 Moss Road with

Margaret (47), Mary E. Rigby (15), and Joseph Rigby (12), Margaret's children from her first marriage, and widowed father William (76).

- He appeared on the census in 1901 in Farnworth, Lancashire. John (46) is a general carter living at 12 Kay Street with Margaret (57), stepson John Rigby (22), grandson George Hayter (3) and a lodger.

- He appeared on the census in 1871 in Adlington, Cheshire. George (50) is an agricultural labourer living in Brookhouse with Ellen (43), George (9), Thomas (6), Mary (3), and Hannah (3 mths).
- He appeared on the census in 1881 in Adlington, Cheshire. George (60) is a farm labourer living at Whitley Green Cottage with Ellen (53), George (19) a cotton weaver, Thomas (16) a farm labourer, Mary (13), Hannah (10), and Reginald Evans (5) a nurse child. Reginald was in fact adopted.

George married **Mary Culley** on 3 Feb 1851 in Stockport, St Mary, Cheshire. Mary was born in 1827 in Macclesfield, Cheshire, was christened on 15 Apr 1827 in Macclesfield, St Michael, Cheshire, and died in 1855 aged 28.

Marriage Notes: The marriage was registered in 1q 1851 Stockport 19 228. On the parish record George was a bachelor of full age, a labourer from Marple, father William, a weaver. Mary was a spinster of full age from Marple, father James, a weaver.

General Notes: Mary's death is probably that registered in 4q 1855 Altrincham 8a 110, aged 29. If this age is correct it implies she was born a few months before her baptism.

George next married **Ellen Culley**. Marriage status: common law. Ellen was born in 1829 in Macclesfield, Cheshire, was christened on 31 May 1829 in Macclesfield, St Michael, Cheshire, died on 3 Apr 1910 in Bollington, Cheshire aged 81, and was buried in Prestbury, St Peter, Cheshire.

General Notes: Ellen was buried in the family grave at Prestbury, aged 82.

Noted events in her life were:

- She appeared on the census in 1891 in Bollington, Cheshire. Ellen (63) is a widowed housekeeper living on Adlington Road with Mary (23) a cotton weaver, Hannah (20) a cotton reeler, Thomas (25) a lorry driver, and Thomas's wife Elizabeth (27) a cotton reeler, plus 2 lodgers Reginald Evans and Mary Robinson who were in fact adopted.

Hannah married **John Swindells**.

78. Josiah Warburton (*William*⁴, *William*³, *Josiah*², *John*¹) was born in Apr 1824 in Morley, Cheshire, was christened on 28 Aug 1824 in Wilmslow, Dean Row Presbyterian Chapel, Cheshire, and died in 1899 in Ramsbottom, Lancashire aged 75.

General Notes: Josiah' was the son of William and Sarah nee Goulden (sic) of Morley on his baptism record. He is also identified as William's son by William's presence at his home on the 1861 census, and on his marriage record in the parish records.

His death is probably that registered in 1q 1899 Bury 8c 338, aged 69. Although the age is low compared with his census entries, he was last living with his married daughter Sarah Bailey who had moved to Ramsbottom by 1901. LancashireBMD records the death registration in Ramsbottom district.

Noted events in his life were:

Arthur served in the Shropshire Yeomanry in WW1. In 1925 he established a business in Manchester as a Ladies Fashion Agent. His sons Len and Ron later joined the business, Len in 1936, and Ron in 1940, and the business became Arthur Warburton & Sons, Fashion Agents (for ladies coats, suits, dresses & ensembles). Both sons retired in 1982 when the business closed.

Noted events in his life were:

- He appeared on the census in 1911 in Hulme, Lancashire. Arthur (19) is a warehouse clerk living at 82 Chester Road with his widowed step mother Phoebe (38) a confectioner, and a boarder.
- He appeared on the census in 1939 in Sale, Cheshire. Arthur is an agent (ladies wear) living at Green Gables, 41 Hillington Road with Winifred, Leonard A a representative in the family business, and Ronald E a salesman (soft furnishings).

Arthur married **Winifred Freda Rickelton** on 14 Nov 1914 in Chorlton on Medlock, Union Chapel, Lancashire. Winifred was born on 17 Oct 1892 in Chorlton on Medlock, Lancashire and died on 29 Jan 1971 in Sale, Cheshire aged 78.

Children from this marriage were:

- 144 M i. **Ronald Warburton** was born on 5 Sep 1917 in Chorlton cum Hardy, Lancashire and died on 26 Sep 2010 in Wythenshawe Hospital, Manchester aged 93.

General Notes: Ronald and Elizabeth had a son (my contact Martin) and a daughter.

Ronald married **Elizabeth Mayor** on 9 May 1942 in Brooklands, St John, Cheshire. Elizabeth was born on 10 Jan 1920 in Chorlton cum Hardy, Lancashire and died on 20 Feb 2003 in Wythenshawe Hospital, Manchester aged 83.

- 145 M ii. **Leonard Arthur Warburton** was born on 30 May 1915 in Chorlton cum Hardy, Lancashire and died on 3 Jul 1989 in Wythenshawe Hospital, Manchester aged 74.

General Notes: Len's birth was registered in 3q 1915 Chorlton 8c 1122, mother's maiden name Rickelton. His death was registered in July 1918 Manchester 38 1124. Len and Alice had no children.

Len was in the RAF and shot down over Belgium in 1941. He evaded capture with the help of the Belgian Resistance and was repatriated via the Comete Line, an escape route through France and Spain. His story is told in more detail in my post *The Cross in the Heather* (which will also be a future Newsletter article).

After the war Len lived in Sale, Cheshire and worked with his brother Ron in the business established in Manchester by their father in 1925 - Arthur Warburton and Sons, Fashion Agents (for ladies coats, suits, dresses & ensembles).

- He appeared on the census in 1911 in Stockport, Cheshire. James (30) is a packer in a bleach works living at 8 Buckley Street, Edgeley with Ellen Jane (31), Harry (4), and a lodger. James and Ellen have been married 9 years, and had 3 children, one living.

James married **Ellen Jane Francis** in 1902 in Stockport, St Matthew, Cheshire. Ellen was born about 1880 in Birmingham, Warwickshire.

Marriage Notes: The marriage was registered in 2q 1902 Stockport 8a 103.

The child from this marriage was:

- 146 M i. **Harry Warburton** was born on 2 Jun 1907 in Stockport, Cheshire and died in 1982 in Stockport, Cheshire aged 75.

General Notes: Harry's birth was registered in 3q 1907 Stockport 8a 32. His death was registered in 4q 1982, aged 75. He appears on the 1939 Register at 68 Chapel Street with his parents. He is married but his wife isn't present. Possible marriages at Stockport are in 3q 1928 8a 183 to Doris Fairbrother, and 2q 1929 8a 45 to Edna Hammond.
