



## First Generation

---

### 1. John Warburton.

On 8 Nov 1772 John married **Sarah Jackson** in Great Budworth, St Mary and All Saints, Cheshire. This marriage is speculative. It is the only the only marriage of a John Warburton to a Sarah in the years before the first Samuel was born, but it implies they moved to Bolton soon after the marriage. There don't seem to be any children of John and Sarah in baptised in Great Budworth.

They had the following children:

- i. **Samuel Warburton**. Samuel was born in Bolton, Lancashire, on 6 Aug 1776. Samuel died in Bolton, Lancashire, on 11 Mar 1777. He was buried in Edgworth, Lancashire, on 13 Mar 1777.

Samuel's birth and death were recorded at the Quaterly Quaker Meeting of Lancashire, daughter of John and Sarah of Little Bolton.

- ii. **Ellen Warburton**. Ellen was born in Bolton, Lancashire, on 20 Feb 1778.

Ellen's birth was recorded at the Quaterly Quaker Meeting of Lancashire, daughter of John and Sarah of Little Bolton.

- 2 iii. **Paul Warburton** (1780-1839)

- iv. **Samuel Warburton**. Samuel was born in Bolton, Lancashire, on 25 Apr 1783.

Samuel's birth was recorded at the Quaterly Quaker Meeting of Lancashire, daughter of John and Sarah of Great Bolton.

## Second Generation

---

**2. Paul Warburton** (*John*<sup>1</sup>). Paul was born in Bolton, Lancashire, on 11 Jul 1780. Paul died in Oldham, Lancashire, in 1839.

Paul's birth was recorded at the Quaterly Quaker Meeting of Lancashire, son of John and Sarah of Bolton, His death was registered in 2q 1839 Ashton and Oldham 20 140. He was aged 60, district Oldham Above Town on Lancashire BMD.

On 18 Nov 1800 when Paul was 20, he married **Mary Hey** in Prestwich, Lancashire.

They had the following children:

- i. **Robert Warburton**. Robert was born in 1804. He was christened in Oldham, St Peter, Lancashire, on 4 Oct 1804. Robert died in 1805. He was buried in Oldham, St Peter, Lancashire, on 12 May 1805.

Roberts parents are Paul, a clogger of Oldham, and Mary on his baprisim. He was the son of Paul a clogger of Newroad on his buial.

- 3 ii. **Hiram Warburton** (1806-1855)

- iii. **Joseph Warburton**. Joseph was born in Oldham, Lancashire, on 3 Oct 1811.

Joseph's birth was recorded at the Quaterly Quaker Meeting of Lancashire, son of Paul, a clogger of Mumps Brook, and Mary.

- iv. **Hannah Warburton**. Hannah was born in Oldham, Lancashire, on 22 Oct 1814.

Hannah's birth was recorded at the Quaterly Quaker Meeting of Lancashire, daughter of Paul, a clogger of Mumps Brook, and Mary.

On 5 Jan 1836 when Hannah was 21, she first married **Thomas Mellor** in Prestwich, St Mary, Lancashire. Hannah and Thomas were both from Oldham. Thomas died in Oldham, Lancashire, in 1859.

The death registered in 3q 1859 Oldham 8d 384, aged 49 is the best fit based on age, location, and proximity to Hannah's remarriage.

On 30 Sep 1861 when Hannah was 46, she second married **Samuel Hoyle** in Leesfield, St Thomas. Hannah (48) is a widowed dressmaker of Milking Green, father Paul, a clogger. Samuel (52) is a widowed cotton warper from Milking Green, father John, a farm labourer. Samuel Hoyle was born abt 1809.

- v. **Henry Warburton**. Henry was born in Oldham, Lancashire, on 22 Jan 1817.

Henry died in Oldham, Lancashire, on 7 Nov 1818. He was buried in Oldham, Lancashire, on 12 Nov 1818.

Henry's birth and death were recorded at the Quaterly Quaker Meetings of Lancashire, son of Paul, a clogger of Mumps Brook, and Mary. He was buried at Turf Lane End, aged 1 year and 9 months.

- vi. **Henry Warburton**. Henry was born in Oldham, Lancashire, on 12 Apr 1819.

Henry's birth was recorded at the Quaterly Quaker Meeting of Lancashire, son of Paul, a clogger of Mumps Brook, and Mary.

### Third Generation

---

**3. Hiram Warburton** (*Paul<sup>2</sup>, John<sup>1</sup>*). Hiram was born in Cockton, Yorkshire, in 1806. He was christened in Heptonstall, Yorkshire, on 21 Sep 1806. ■ Census for Prestwich, Lancashire, in 1841. Hiram (35) is a clogger living in Ironmonger Lane with Martha (30), Hannah (14) a cotton piecer, Mary (8), Paul (6), James, and Alice (ages illegible). ■ Census for Oldham, Lancashire, in 1851. Hiram (44) is a clog pattern maker living at 8 Peter Street, Old Town with Martha (43), Paul (16) a cotton piecer, Emma (14) a cotton piecer, Alice (11), Isabella (9), William (5), and daughter Mary Jackson (19) and her husband Samuel Jackson (21) both cotton piecers. Hiram died in 1855.

Hiram's birth place of Cockton on the 1851 census has not been located on modern maps. His death was registered in 3q 1855 Oldham 8d 350.

On 4 Feb 1827 when Hiram was 21, he married **Martha Thompson** in Oldham, St Mary, Lancashire. Martha was born in Openshaw, Lancashire, abt 1807. Martha died in Oldham, Lancashire, in 1852.

Martha is missing from the 1861 census and her youngest children are living with their older married sister so Martha is presumed to have died, but the closest registration is in 4q 1852 Oldham 8d 375, where LancashireBMD records her age as 40 which is 4 years under her census age.



They had the following children:

- i. **Hannah Warburton**. Hannah was born in Oldham, Lancashire, in 1827. She was christened in Oldham, Hope Independent, Lancashire, on 9 Sep 1837.

On 1 Sep 1845 when Hannah was 18, she married **William Dalton** in Oldham, Lancashire. Hannah's father is Hiram, William's father is William.

- ii. **Alice Warburton**. Alice was born in Oldham, Lancashire, in 1830. She was christened in Oldham, St Peter, Lancashire, on 7 Oct 1830.
- iii. **Mary Warburton**. Mary was born in Oldham, Lancashire, in 1833. She was christened in Oldham, St Peter, Lancashire, on 7 Apr 1833.

On 16 Dec 1850 when Mary was 17, she married **Samuel Jackson** in Oldham, Holy Trinity, Lancashire. Samuel is a piecer from Coldhurst Hollow, father John a weaver (deceased). Mary (18) is a twiner's piecer from Coldhurst Hollow, father Hiram, a clogger. Samuel was born abt 1829.

- 4 iv. **Paul Warburton** (1835-1895)
- v. **Emma Warburton**. Emma was born in Oldham, Lancashire, in 1837.
- vi. **James Warburton**. James was born in Oldham, Lancashire, in 1838. He was christened in Oldham, St Peter, Lancashire, on 29 Apr 1838.
- vii. **Alice Warburton**. Alice was born in Oldham, Lancashire, abt 1840.

On 13 May 1860 when Alice was 20, she married **Joseph Taylor** in Prestwich, St Mary, Lancashire. Joseph (21) is a turner from Werneth, Oldham, father Joseph an overlooker. Alice (19) is a servant from Tonge, father Hiram, a clogger. Joseph was born abt 1839.

- viii. **Isabella Warburton**. Isabella was born in Oldham, Lancashire, on 21 Sep 1843. She was christened in Oldham, St Peter, Lancashire, on 22 Aug 1844.

On 21 Mar 1863 when Isabella was 19, she first married **John Sherliker** in Chadderton, Lancashire. John (23) is a tin-plate worker from Chadderton father John a cotton spinner. Isabella (19) is a twiner's piecer from Wellington Street, father Hiram, a clogger. John was born abt 1840.

On 7 Feb 1876 when Isabella was 32, she second married **Arthur Hailey** in Oldham, St Peter, Lancashire. Both aged 29, Isabella is a widow. Arthur was born in 1847.

- ix. **William Warburton**. William was born in Oldham, Lancashire, in 1846.
- x. **Jeremiah Thompson Warburton**. Jeremiah Thompson was born in Oldham,

Lancashire, in 1852. He was christened in Oldham, St Peter, Lancashire, on 25 Nov 1852. Jeremiah Thompson died in Oldham, Lancashire, in 1853.

Jeremiah's birth was registered in 4q 1852 Oldham 8d 472, and his death in 1q 1853 8d 401.

## Fourth Generation

---

**4. Paul Warburton** (*Hiram<sup>3</sup>, Paul<sup>2</sup>, John<sup>1</sup>*). Paul was born in Oldham, Lancashire, in 1835. He was christened in Oldham, St Peter, Lancashire, on 29 Mar 1835. ■ Census for Glasgow, Scotland, in 1861. Paul (26) is a clogmaker lodging at 18 Saltmarket, Clyde. ■ Census for Glasgow, Scotland, in 1871. Paul (36) is a patient in City House Hospital, Parliamentary Road. ■ Census for Oldham, Lancashire, in 1891. Paul (59) is a clog maker lodging at 15 Spring Garden Street. Paul died in Oldham, Lancashire, in 1895.

Paul's abode is Lees on his baptism record. His death is probably that registered in 3q 1895 Oldham 8d 497, aged 55 although the age is 5 year too low.

No death registration had been found for his wife Hannah but by 1861 Paul had moved to Glasgow. The only evidence of his relationship with Ann Tait is his presence, with Ann as the parents of daughter Martha on her marriage. Also Ann is using the name Warburton in the 1871 census though they are not living together. It is likely but uncertain that Ann's son Henry was also Paul's son though he reverted to his mother's name Tait after 1871.

Ann Tait originally married Robert Pope in 1859 so it is possible either Ann, Paul or both were married to others during their relationship. After Paul returned to Oldham, Ann had a child by Robert Porter.

On 12 Dec 1853 when Paul was 18, he first married **Hannah Jones** in Oldham, St Mary, Lancashire. Paul was aged 20, father Hiram, Hannah was also 20, father William. The marriage was registered in 4q 1853 Oldham 8d 1008. Hannah was born in 1835.

He second common-law married **Ann Tait**. Ann was born in Glasgow, Scotland, in 1838. ■ Census for Glasgow, Scotland, in 1871. Ann (29) a married washerwoman, Martha (5), and Henry (5 mths) are lodging with John McDonald and his family at 8 Hitherson(?) Street. ■ Census for Glasgow, Scotland, in 1881. Ann Tait (36?) is a widowed washerwoman born in England living with Martha Tait (16) a domestic servant, Henry Tait (10), Robert Tait (3), and Robert Porter (35) an unmarried lodger who works as a carter. Ann died in Glasgow, Scotland, in 1894.

Ann was the daughter of Robert Tait and Ann nee Welsh. Robert was a soldier and is so described on Ann's marriage to Robert Poper. The family are present on the 1841 census in Halifax where Robert is serving in a Temporary Barracks. Ann, aged 5, is said to be born abroad, but in the 1881 census she was born in England.

By 1851 Ann is back in Glasgow with her widowed mother, though her age is now given as 10, and her place of birth is Ireland. She married Robert Pope in 1859, but reverted to her maiden name soon after, suggesting the marriage was unsuccessful. It is possible it was a Catholic marriage so Ann was not free to remarry until Robert died. Her sons Henry (possibly Paul's), and Robert Porter (son of Robert Porter) were both described as illegitimate. They both used the name Tait.

They had the following children:

- i. **Martha Warburton**. Martha was born in Glasgow, Scotland, abt 1865.

On 25 Aug 1882 when Martha was 17, she married **James Main** in Dunn Street, Glasgow, Scotland. Martha is called Martha Warbitten, aged 17, a winder from Dunn Street, Glasgow, parents Paul a clogger, and Ann, formally Tait. She was married at Dunn Street according to the forms of the Free Church of Scotland. Martha and James had 7 children and were the grandparents of Bill Buchanan.

- ii. **Henry Warburton**. Henry was born in Glasgow, Scotland, on 7 Nov 1870. Henry died in Glasgow, Scotland, on 4 Feb 1904.

Henry Warburton who is 5 months old in the 1871 census was actually born Henry Tait, illegitimate son of Ann Tait, washerwoman, on November 7th 1870. He died on February 4th 1904 aged 33 as Henry Tait.
