



## First Generation

**1. Samuel Warburton.** Samuel was born in Clutton, Cheshire, abt 1806. Samuel died aft 1881. ■ Census for Duckington, Cheshire, in 1841. Samuel (30) is an agricultural labourer living with Margaret (35), Mary (10), Sarah (8), Martha (6), Samuel (3) and Margaret (2). ■ Census for Duckington, Cheshire, in 1851. Samuel (44) is an agricultural labourer living with Margaret (50), Sarah (19), Margaret (12), William (8), and grandchildren Emma (2) and John (1). ■ Census for Duckingfield in 1871. Samuel (65) is a widowed agricultural labourer born in Clutton living with Margaret (31), William (27) an agricultural labourer, and granddaughter Elizabeth A (1 month), Margaret's daughter. They are indexed as Warberton on Ancestry. ■ Census for Duckington, Cheshire, in 1881. Samuel (72) a widowed agricultural labourer born in Tilston, is living with daughter Margaret (40) and granddaughter Elizabeth (10), both born in Duckingfield. He is indexed by Ancestry as Saint Warberton.

The information on Samuel and his family comes mainly from the tree of Joyce Lawrence on Genes Reunited. She is descended from Sarah Warburton and John Aldersley. Further detail was provided by Kate Probyn.

The young grandchildren Emma and John who are with Samuel in 1851 are an enigma. They were born before any of his known children married and do not appear in subsequent censuses.

On 15 May 1828 when Samuel was 22, he married **Margaret Probin** in Malpas, Cheshire. Margaret was born in Duckington, Cheshire, in 1798. She was christened in Malpas, St Oswald, Cheshire, on 25 Mar 1798. Margaret died in Malpas, Cheshire, in 1868.

Margaret's parents were Uriah and mary Probin. She was recorded as age 70 on her death certificate.

- i. **John Warburton** (1828-1905)
  - ii. **Mary Warburton**. Mary was born in Duckington, Cheshire, in 1831. ■ Census for Duckington, Cheshire, in 1851. Mary (20) is a house servant on the farm of John Morris. Brother Samuel is an agricultural labourer.

In 1853 when Mary was 22, she married **Thomas Carter** in Malpas, St Oswald, Cheshire. Thomas and Mary's children were Martha (b. 1854), John (b. 1858), Thomas (b. 1866), Mary (b. 1869), and William (b. 1877). Thomas was born in Duckington, Cheshire, in 1828. ■ Census for Duckington, Cheshire, in 1851. Mary (20) is a house servant on the farm of John Morris. Brother Samuel is an agricultural labourer.

- iii. **Sarah Warburton**. Sarah was born in Duckington, Cheshire, in 1832. Sarah died in Malpas, Cheshire, on 23 Oct 1924. She was buried in Brown Knowle Methodist Church, Harthill, in 1924.

In 1881 she is widowed, living next door but one to her father, Samuel Warburton.

Her Monumental Inscription, along with her husband and mothetr-in-law reads:

On 14 Sep 1855 when Sarah was 23, she married **John Aldersey** in Chester, St. John, Cheshire. From the parish register: John Aldersley aged 35, bachelor,

A Cordwainer of Francis Street, Chester, father John Aldersey, Gentleman. Sarah Warburton aged 23, a spinster of Francis Street, Chester, father Samuel Warburton. Witnesses George Cross and John Robertson. Sarah and John's children were Justina (bap. 9 March 1856 at Bickerton, died 1930), Susan (b. 1858), Louisa (bap. 21 Aug 1859), Thomas (1862-1907), and Alfred (1866-1923). Previously Sarah had two illegitimate children Emma (1849-91), and John (1850-1926). John was born in Duckington, Cheshire, in 1817. John died in Duckington, Cheshire, on 23 Apr 1869. He was buried in Brown Knowle Methodist Church, Harthill, in 1869.

Cheshire BMD, MAL/3/29 Cause of death Pnuemonia Samuel Warburton, Father in law, present at death.

- iv. **Martha Warburton**. Martha was born in Duckington, Cheshire, in 1834. Martha died in Tattenhall, Cheshire, in 1904.

On 21 Aug 1854 when Martha was 20, she married **John Shone** in Malpas, St Oswald, Cheshire. Martha and John's children were Charles (bap. 11 Feb 1855 at Bickerton, buried 13 March 1855 at Malpas, aged 8 weeks), John (bap. 16 March 1856 at Bickerton, died 1929), Thomas (bap. 19 September 1858 at Bickerton, died 1933), William (bap. 19 April 1867 at Brown Knowle Methodist, died 1941), Margaret (24 Sept 1870 at Brown Knowle Methodist, died 1944), and Arthur (bap. 23 Oct 1876 at Bickerton, died 1951). John was born in Coddington, Cheshire, in 1832. John died in Tattenhall, Cheshire, in 1900.

- vii. **William Warburton**. William was born in Duckington, Cheshire, in 1843. William died poss 1855.

William appears in no censuses after 1851. C BMD has the death of a William registered at Tattenhall (TAT/5/99) but the age is given as 17. It might be a 12 misread.

**2. John Warburton** (*Samuel<sup>1</sup>*). John was born in Duckington, Cheshire, in 1828. John died in Brown Knowle Methodist Church, Harthill, on 5 May 1905. He was buried in 1905. ■ Census for Broxton, Cheshire, in 1851. John (21) is an agricultural labourer living at Bolesworth Hill with Mary (26) and Margaret (3). ■ Census for Harthill, Cheshire, in 1861. John (32) is an agricultural labourer living at 3 Harthill Village with Mary (37), Margaret (14) and niece Elizabeth Warburton (3). ■ Census for Broxton, Cheshire, in 1871. John (43) is an agricultural labourer living with Mary (48) and Elizabeth (14) a boarder. ■ Census for Broxton, Cheshire, in 1881. John (52) is a general labourer living with Mary (57), daughter Elizabeth (24), and son-in-law Henry Haycock (26) and their son John A (4 months). ■ Census for Broxton, Cheshire, in 1891. John (61) is an agricultural labourer living with Mary (68) and the growing family of Henry and Elizabeth Haycock. ■ Census for Broxton, Cheshire, in 1901. John (72) is a widower and general agricultural labourer. The Haycock family are still living with him. He is indexed as Warbinton on Ancestry.

Probable death registration is C BMD CAS/60/35, age 76.

Probate CHESTER 8th March to the Rev Thomas Frederick Robathan and the Rev Henry William Comber clerks. Effects £857 18s 6d.

His Monumental Inscription at Brown Knowle Methodist Church, Harthill reads:

SACRED TO THE MEMORY  
OF MARGARET  
DAUGHTER OF JOHN AND MARY WARBURTON  
OF BROXTON  
WHO DEPARTED THIS LIFE  
NOVEMBER 17TH 1863  
AGED 16 YEARS

THERE WILL BE A CROWN FOR YOU  
  
ALSO MARY  
THE BELOVED WIFE OF THE ABOVE

On 19 Jan 1850 when John was 22, he married **Mary Lightfoot** in Malpas, St Oswald, Cheshire. Mary was born in Duckington, Cheshire, abt 1823. Mary died on 27 Apr 1897. She was buried in Brown Knowle Methodist Church, Harthill, in 1897.

Death registration C BMD TAT/20/2 aged 71. The age is a little lower than her census ages.

They had the following children:

- i. **Margaret Warburton**. Margaret was born in 1847. Margaret died in Broxton, Cheshire, on 17 Nov 1863. She was buried in Brown Knowle Methodist Church, Harthill, in 1863.
- ii. **Elizabeth Warburton**. Elizabeth was born in Duckington, Cheshire, abt 1856. Elizabeth died in 1922.

Elizabeth is described as a neice on the 1861 census, and a servant on the 1871 census, and only becomes a daughter on the 1881 census.

Her probable birth registration is C BMD MAL/1/56. She is probably the daughter of one of John's sisters, though they were all married by 1856 except Martha who is reported to have another illegitimate daughter called Elizabeth in 1871.

Elizabeth married **Henry Haycock**. Elizabeth and Henry's children were Albert (b. 1871), Annie (b. 1874), and Alice (1878-1986). Henry was born in Malpas, Cheshire, in 1845. Henry died in 1922.

**3. Samuel Warburton** (*Samuel*<sup>1</sup>). Samuel was born in Duckington, Cheshire, abt 1837. Samuel died in Chowley, Cheshire, in 1923. He was buried in Coddington, St Mary the Virgin, Cheshire, on 3 Jan 1923. ■ Census for Duckington, Cheshire, in 1851. Samuel (14) is an agricultural labourer on the farm of John Morris. Sister Mary is a house servant. ■ Census for Larkton, Cheshire, in 1861. Samuel (24) of Malpas is a carter on the farm of William Eardley. ■ Census for Harthill, Cheshire, in 1871. Samuel (33) of Malpas is an

agricultural labourer, living at 10 Harthill Village with Elizabeth (29), of Malpas, and John (3) of Harthill. Elizabeth is presumably a mistake and should be Eliza. ■ Census for Harthill, Cheshire, in 1881. Samuel (43) of Duckington (which is in Malpas parish) is an agricultural labourer, living with Eliza (39) of Shocklach, John (13), and Emily (9) both of Harthill. ■ Census for Chowley, Cheshire, in 1891. Samuel (53) of Malpas, is an agricultural labourer, living at Chowley Lodge with Eliza (49). ■ Census for Chowley, Cheshire, in 1901. Samuel (63) of Malpas, is a waggoner on a farm, and living at Bolesworth Lodge with Eliza (59) of Malpas and Emily (29) of Harthill.

He is of Bowlesworth Lodge, Chowley, aged 85, on his burial in the parish register.

Samuel and Eliza's Monumental Inscription:

On 6 Nov 1866 when Samuel was 29, he married **Eliza Warburton** in Malpas, St Oswald, Cheshire. Parish register: Samuel Warburton, 29, bachelor, labourer of Larkton, father Samuel Warburton, labourer. Eliza Warburton, 25, spinster of Edge, father Peter Warburton, labourer. One of the witnesses was Mary Mellor, Eliza's married sister, the other William Warburton, Samuel's brother. Eliza was born in 1841. She was christened in Shocklach, St Edith, Cheshire, on 12 Dec 1841. Eliza died in 1911. She was buried in Coddington, St Mary the Virgin, Cheshire, on 25 Oct 1911.

She is of Chowley Lodge, aged 69, on her burial in the parish register.

They had the following children:

- i. **John Warburton**. John was born in Harthill, Cheshire, in 1867. He was christened in Harthill, All Saints, Cheshire, on 26 Oct 1867. John died in Harthill, Cheshire, in 1929. He was buried in Coddington, St Mary the Virgin, Cheshire, on 9 Feb 1929. ■ Census for Handley, Cheshire, in 1891. John (23) of Harthill is a general servant to Harriet Beck (55) a widow. ■ Census for Handley, Cheshire, in 1901. John (33) of Harthill is a gardener and domestic labourer at Calvely Hall (head of household is James Blake). He is living in Tattenhall Road with Mary Speakman (33), also a servant.

Cheshire BMD birth reference TAT/11/34 (Tattenhall district). On the parish register his parents are Samuel, a labourer, and Eliza of Harthill.

He is of Harthill, aged 61, on his burial in the parish register. John and his sister Emil are buried in the grave next to their parents:

- ii. **Emily Warburton**. Emily was born in Harthill, Cheshire, in 1871. She was christened in Harthill, All Saints, Cheshire, on 18 Jun 1871. Emily died in Chowley, Cheshire, in 1923. She was buried in Coddington, St Mary the Virgin, Cheshire, on 14 Apr 1923. ■ Census for Broxton, Cheshire, in 1891. Emily (19) of Harthill is an under housemaid at Bolesworth Castle, where George Barbour is the head of household.

Cheshire BMD reference TAT/12/83 (Tattenhall district). On the parish register her parents are Samuel, a labourer, and Eliza of Harthill.

She is of Bowlesworth Lodge, Chowley, aged 51, on her burial in the parish register.

In 1914 when Emily was 43, she married **Joseph Hough** in Harthill, All Saints,

Cheshire.

4. **Margaret Warburton** (*Samuel*<sup>1</sup>). Margaret was born in Duckington, Cheshire, in 1839. ■  
Census for Duckington, Cheshire, in 1901. Margaret (59) is living with her daughter,  
Elizabeth Walker and her family.

Child:

- i. **Elizabeth Ann Warburton**. Elizabeth Ann was born in Duckington, Cheshire, in 1871. She was christened in Brown Knowle Methodist Church, Harthill, on 18 Mar 1871.

Probable birth registration is C BMD MAL/5/1. The Church register describes her as the daughter of Margaret Warburton, a Spinster of Duckington.

Elizabeth is living with her mother and grandfather on the 1881 census.

Elizabeth Ann married **Samuel Walker**. Samuel was born in Tattenhall, Cheshire, abt 1865.
