# PREFACE

The Warburtons of Edenfield first appear in the Halmote Records of Tottington Manor in the early 16th century although there is an earlier mention of a probable ancestor on a rental from 1442. A paper called **Warburton References in the Halmote Records of Tottington Manor** can be found on the **Pages** page of the website.

The tree is based on an original tree provided by Anthony Carter, with additional input from Nicolas Blackhurst, and David Hardman. It has been considerably extended by my own research and information on additional lines from Robert Warburton, Colin Warburton, and Sharron Newhouse.

A paper called **Edenfield Clan and Related Peters** can be found on the **Papers** page of the website.

There are two matching DNA Profiles from the clan, including a BigY result. There are several other matches from clans with origins in the area which together form **The Lancashire Group**. It is likely these other clans are branches of the Edenfield clan though the exact links have yet to be found.

## First Generation

---

1. **Thomas Warburton**. Thomas was born abt 1490. Thomas died aft 1559.

This report is based on a tree provided by Anthony Carter, with additional information from Nicolas Blackhurst (The Original Tree).

I have done original research based on:

1. The Halmote Court of Tottington Manor records.
2. The parish records of Edenfield, Holcombe, Newchurch-in-Rosendale, and early records from Bury, St Mary.
3. A study of local Peters, and of Thomas and Sarah families in the early 19th century.
4. Censuses and BMD indices.

The earliest mention of a Warburton in the Tottington Manor records is to a Thomas Warburton in a list of tenants in 1442. This would be an ancestor of this Thomas.

There are several references to Thomas in the Halmote Records of Tottington Manor, which included Stubbins and Edenfield. The earliest was in 1513, and the last in 1559. He was a constable in 1515 suggesting he was already a mature adult born not later than 1490.

The references indicate he was an important person in the manor as he often acted as a trustee in land dealings. He was also twice sued by the vicar of Holcombe Chapel for his wages. He was latterly referred to as a Gentleman.

In 1515 there is record of prospecting for a road from Holcombe to Durden, with part of the route being the route to Thomas's house. Durden is probably Dearden and there is Dearden Brook, Dearden Moor and Dearden Clough in Edenfield, and Deardengate in Haslingden. A road from Holcombe to Edenfield must pass close to Stubbins, which is south-west of Edenfield. Therefore it is likely the reference to Thomas's house is a reference to Stubbins Hall.

Stubbins Hall is directly mentioned in 1559 when use of it is being granted to his wife Alice. Five years earlier his recently widowed new wife is referred to as Agnes. It would appear neither Agnes nor Alice was the mother of his children.

In 1540 Thomas was first referred to as of Little Clegg in Butterworth indicating he had holdings outside the manor, and lived in Butterworth. However this is clearly the same Thomas as there are references to his son Francis in 1533, 1556 and 1559.

A George Warburton mentioned in 1526 and several subsequent entries is probably a brother of Thomas.

Thomas first married **Unknown**.

They had one child:

- 2 i. **Francis Warburton** (~1510-<1559)

Abt 1554 when Thomas was 64, he second married **Agnes Rothwell**. Agnes died bef 1559.

Agness was the widow of Peter Rothwell.

Bef 1559 when Thomas was 69, he third married **Alice**.

## Second Generation

---

2. **Francis Warburton** (*Thomas*<sup>1</sup>). Francis was born abt 1510. Francis died bef 1559.

The first reference to Francis in the Tottington Halmote records is in 1533 when he is granted use of land. He must already be an adult by this time so his birth can be no later than 1512. He is mentioned as a trustee in 1556, but is deceased by 1559.

Francis married **Ann**.

Ann is known from a reference to her as the widow of Frances in the 1559 entry in the Halmote Records.

They had one child:

- 3 i. **Thomas Warburton** (~1538-)

## Third Generation

---

3. **Thomas Warburton** (*Francis<sup>2</sup>, Thomas<sup>1</sup>*). Thomas was born in Stubbins Hall, Edenfield, Lancashire, abt 1538.

Thomas is granted use of land in 1559, suggesting he was already an adult. He is said to have died in 1634 but this would mean he was in his mid-90s. It also means he would be 45 when his heir Francis was born.

A footnote to the British History Online entry for Butterworth says “Thomas Warburton the elder, Ellen his wife, and Thomas his son, made settlements of an estate in Butterworth in 1558; Thomas Warburton, who died in 1634 at Stubbins, held messuages in Little Clegg, Hollinworth, and Butterworth”.

Although Thomas’s grandfather was resident at Little Clegg in 1559, Thomas the elder must refer to this Thomas, his grandson, if his death in 1634 is conceivable. A wife called Ellen also doesn’t fit his grandfather given two other wives are referenced at Tottington in the same five year period.

Even so the birth of an heir at age 45 and a death in his 90s seems unlikely. It is more likely it was the son of this Thomas who was the father of Francis and who died in 1634.

Thomas married **Ellen**.

They had one child:

- 4 i. **Thomas Warburton** (<1558-1634)

## Fourth Generation

---

**4. Thomas Warburton** (*Thomas<sup>3</sup>, Francis<sup>2</sup>, Thomas<sup>1</sup>*). Thomas was born bef 1558. Thomas died in Stubbins Hall, Edenfield, Lancashire, in 1634. He was buried in Bury, St Mary, Lancashire, on 15 Jun 1634.

Because Thomas's father was an adult in 1538 it is unlikely he lived until 1634, so that burial is believed to refer to this Thomas.

Child:

- 5**      i. **Francis Warburton** (1583-1649)



## Fifth Generation

---

5. **Francis Warburton** (*Thomas<sup>4</sup>, Thomas<sup>3</sup>, Francis<sup>2</sup>, Thomas<sup>1</sup>*). Francis was born in 1583. Francis died in Stubbins Hall, Edenfield, Lancashire, on 18 Apr 1649. He was buried in Bury, St Mary, Lancashire, on 20 Apr 1649.

Francis was described as a gentleman.

The parish registers show baptisms for 6 of his children, but not his heir John, or a daughter Margaret who married Thomas Browne (source unknown). There are also burials suggesting other children whose baptism wasn't recorded. These are Kateren (buried 17th June 1604 and so Francis's first born), Ann (buried 5th March 1620), and an earlier Margaret (buried 7th March 1620). Also a child of Francis was buried on 10th September 1636, but this could belong to a later Francis.

On 14 Jul 1603 when Francis was 20, he married **Margaret Rawstone** in Bury, St Mary, Lancashire. Margaret died in 1649.

They had the following children:

- i. **Alice Warburton**. Alice was born in 1604. She was christened in Bury, St Mary, Lancashire, on 11 Nov 1604.
- ii. **Elizabeth Warburton**. Elizabeth was born in 1607. She was christened in Bury, St Mary, Lancashire, on 12 Jun 1607.
- iii. **Katharine Warburton**. Katharine was born in 1610. She was christened in Bury, St Mary, Lancashire, on 17 Jun 1610.
- iv. **Marie Warburton**. Marie was born in Stubbins Hall, Edenfield, Lancashire, in 1613. She was christened in Bury, St Mary, Lancashire, on 11 Apr 1613.
- v. **Susan Warburton**. Susan was born in Stubbins Hall, Edenfield, Lancashire, in 1614. She was christened in Bury, St Mary, Lancashire, on 17 Sep 1614. Susan died in 1639. She was buried in Bury, St Mary, Lancashire, on 12 Jun 1639.

The name on this parish entry is very indistinct. It is transcribed as Susan on FamilySearch, and John on Ancestry. It does seem to say 'd of Francis', implying a daughter, and the first letter looks like an S. The later burial of a Susan would seem to confirm the name.

- vi. **Thomas Warburton**. Thomas was born in 1617. He was christened in Bury, St Mary, Lancashire, on 12 Oct 1617. Thomas died aft 1651.

Thomas would have appeared to have died young as his brother John inherited Stubbins Hall and was living there in 1656.

Thomas married **Alice**. Alice died aft 1651.

- 6 vii. **John Warburton** (1621-1693)
- viii. **Margaret Warburton**.

Margaret married **Thomas Browne**.

Thomas Browne was a gentleman.

## Sixth Generation

---

**6. John Warburton** (*Francis<sup>5</sup>, Thomas<sup>4</sup>, Thomas<sup>3</sup>, Francis<sup>2</sup>, Thomas<sup>1</sup>*). John was born in Stubbins Hall, Edenfield, Lancashire, in 1621. John died on 10 Jun 1693. He was buried in Bury, St Mary, Lancashire, on 11 Jun 1693.

John went to Bolton School, and entered St. Johns College, Cambridge in 1639, aged 17 and graduated. He was an MA in 1664, and a minister on the Holcombe/Edenfield circuit 1667-91.

He inherited Stubbins Hall, but sold it in 1666. A Rental from 1662 shows John of Stubbings was paying £2 0s 7 1/2d ancient rent plus £1 17s 11 1/2d for commons, encroachments, new improvements and Alden rents. This was the third highest rent in the Tottington Manor. He was also the first name on the list of homagers of the court who swore an oath to the validity of the Return.

John married **Katherine Ramsbotham**. Katherine was born in 1637. Katherine died on 7 Feb 1687. She was buried in Bury, St Mary, Lancashire, on 9 Feb 1687.

Katherine was the daughter Peter Ramsbotham. She was described as the wife of Mr John Warburton on her burial record.

They had the following children:

- i. **John Warburton**. John was born in Stubbins Hall, Edenfield, Lancashire, in 1656. He was christened in Bury, St Mary, Lancashire, on 2 Nov 1656.

On 28 Feb 1681 when John was 25, he married **Ellen Farnsworth** in Bury, St Mary, Lancashire.

- ii. **Thomas Warburton**. Thomas was born in 1658. Thomas died on 12 Dec 1675. He was buried in Bury, St Mary, Lancashire, on 14 Dec 1675.

The burial record is identified as belonging to this Thomas because he is described as the son of Mr John.

- 7 iii. **Peter Warburton** (1665-1737)

## Seventh Generation

---

**7. Peter Warburton** (*John<sup>6</sup>, Francis<sup>5</sup>, Thomas<sup>4</sup>, Thomas<sup>3</sup>, Francis<sup>2</sup>, Thomas<sup>1</sup>*). Peter was born in Ramsbottom, Lancashire, on 26 Aug 1665. He was christened in Bury, St Mary, Lancashire, on 5 Sep 1665. Peter died in Stubbins Lane, Edenfield, Lancashire, on 24 Feb 1737. He was buried in Holcombe, St Emmanuel, Lancashire, on 26 Feb 1737.

On The Original Tree Peter is described as a clothier, and also a son and heir in 1713. However the reference for these comments is unknown, and as his father had died before 1713 these comments may relate to a different Peter.

On 30 May 1693 when Peter was 27, he married **Mary Holding** in Manchester, Lancashire. Mary was born in 1668. Mary died in Shuttleworth, Lancashire, on 6 Dec 1750. She was buried in Holcombe, St Emmanuel, Lancashire, on 8 Dec 1750.

They had the following children:

- 8**            i. **John Warburton** (1693-1754)
- 9**            ii. **Thomas Warburton** (1703-1763)

## Eighth Generation

---

**8. John Warburton** (*Peter<sup>7</sup>, John<sup>6</sup>, Francis<sup>5</sup>, Thomas<sup>4</sup>, Thomas<sup>3</sup>, Francis<sup>2</sup>, Thomas<sup>1</sup>*). John was born in 1693. John died in Edenfield, Lancashire, on 27 Apr 1754. He was buried in Holcombe, St Emmanuel, Lancashire, on 28 Apr 1754.

On 1 Mar 1721 when John was 28, he married **Anne Ormerod** in Newchurch-in-Rossendale, Lancashire. This would seem to be a good fit for son Peter, and two later baptisms at Edenfield. Anne was born in 1697. Anne died in Holcombe, Lancashire, on 23 Apr 1750.

They had one child:

- i. **Peter Warburton**. Peter was born in 1722. Peter died in Holcombe, Lancashire, on 7 Feb 1757. He was buried in Holcombe, St Emmanuel, Lancashire, on 8 Feb 1757.

Peter's birth is given in The Original Tree as 1720. It is not certain how accurate this date is but it is fairly close to the nearest recorded John and Ann marriage, and Peter's parents are given as John and Anne.

There are two marriages at Bury, and four children of Peter baptised at Edenfield between 1751, and 1757 when Peter died, and his cousin Peter married Elizabeth Wolstenholme. It is possible the 1751 marriage to Anne Booth, and at least a couple of the children belong to this Peter, but there is no specific evidence.

**9. Thomas Warburton** (*Peter<sup>7</sup>, John<sup>6</sup>, Francis<sup>5</sup>, Thomas<sup>4</sup>, Thomas<sup>3</sup>, Francis<sup>2</sup>, Thomas<sup>1</sup>*). Thomas was born in 1703. Thomas died in Hencock, Edenfield, Lancashire, on 17 Oct 1763. He was buried in Holcombe, St Emmanuel, Lancashire, on 19 Oct 1763.

On 26 Nov 1730 when Thomas was 27, he married **Martha Emit** in Bury, St Mary, Lancashire. Martha was born in 1698. Martha died in Hencock, Edensfield, Lancashire, in Jul 1774. She was buried in Holcombe, St Emmanuel, Lancashire, on 23 Jul 1774.

Martha is merely a widow from Hencock on her burial record.

They had the following children:

- 10**
  - i. **Peter Warburton** (1733-1814)
  - ii. **Elizabeth Warburton**. Elizabeth was born in Edenfield, Lancashire, on 4 May 1735. She was christened in Edenfield Chapel, Lancashire, on 18 May 1735.

On 11 Jan 1757 when Elizabeth was 21, she married **James Haworth**.

- iii. **Alice Warburton**. Alice was born in Edenfield, Lancashire, on 21 Feb 1738. She was christened in Edenfield Chapel, Lancashire, on 5 Mar 1738.
- iv. **Ann Warburton**. Ann was born in Edenfield, Lancashire, on 3 Jul 1741. She was christened in Edenfield Chapel, Lancashire, on 12 Jul 1741.
- v. **John Warburton**.

John is only known from The Original Tree, where he is described as a carpenter.

John married **Betty**. Betty was born in 1746. Betty died on 19 Sep 1821.

## Ninth Generation

---

**10. Peter Warburton** (*Thomas<sup>8</sup>, Peter<sup>7</sup>, John<sup>6</sup>, Francis<sup>5</sup>, Thomas<sup>4</sup>, Thomas<sup>3</sup>, Francis<sup>2</sup>, Thomas<sup>1</sup>*). Peter was born in Hencock, Edenfield, Lancashire, on 1 Feb 1733. He was christened in Edenfield Chapel, Lancashire, on 11 Feb 1733. Peter died in Edenfield, Lancashire, in 1814. He was buried in Holcombe, St Emmanuel, Lancashire, on 16 May 1814.

Peter died aged 81.

On 27 Dec 1757 when Peter was 24, he married **Elizabeth Wolstenholme** in Bury, St Mary, Lancashire. Elizabeth was born in Bury, Lancashire, abt 1729. She was christened in Bury, St Mary, Lancashire, on 4 Jan 1730. Elizabeth died in Edenfield, Lancashire, on 12 Dec 1809. She was buried in Holcombe, St Emmanuel, Lancashire, on 15 Dec 1809.

Elizabeth was the daughter of Lawrence Wolstanholme. She was buried as the wife of Peter, aged 83.

They had the following children:

- 11
  - i. **John Warburton** (1759-1837)
  - ii. **Martha Warburton**. Martha was born in Hencock, Edenfield, Lancashire, in 1760. She was christened in Edenfield Chapel, Lancashire, on 29 Nov 1760.
- 12
  - iii. **Thomas Edmund Warburton** (~1763-1805)
  - iv. **Peter Warburton**. Peter was born in Hencock, Edenfield, Lancashire, in 1765. He was christened in Edenfield Chapel, Lancashire, on 27 Oct 1765. Peter died in 1767. He was buried in Holcombe, St Emmanuel, Lancashire, on 19 Oct 1767.

A second Peter was buried on December 1st 1769. There is no comment on either burial so either could refer to this Peter. However as a second Peter was born in 1771 it seems certain that one of the burials was of this Peter.

- v. **James Warburton**. James was born in 1765. James died on 10 Mar 1823.

James was employed by John Kay for 40 years. His baptism doesn't appear at Edenfield Chapel, but there is a James son of Peter and Betty of Carrhead baptised at Newchurch, St Nicholas on Aug 5th 1765.

- vi. **Mary Warburton**. Mary was born in Hencock, Edenfield, Lancashire, in Nov 1768. She was christened in Edenfield Chapel, Lancashire, on 20 Nov 1768.
- vii. **Peter Warburton**. Peter was born in Hencock, Edenfield, Lancashire, in Mar 1771. He was christened in Edenfield Chapel, Lancashire, on 29 Mar 1771.

There are no further records that can be linked to this Peter.

- viii. **Betty Warburton**. Betty was born in Hencock, Edenfield, Lancashire, in Jan 1774. She was christened in Edenfield Chapel, Lancashire, on 26 Jan 1774.

## Tenth Generation

---

**11. John Warburton** (*Peter<sup>9</sup>, Thomas<sup>8</sup>, Peter<sup>7</sup>, John<sup>6</sup>, Francis<sup>5</sup>, Thomas<sup>4</sup>, Thomas<sup>3</sup>, Francis<sup>2</sup>, Thomas<sup>1</sup>*). John was born in Henscock, Edenfield, Lancashire, in 1759. He was christened in Edenfield Chapel, Lancashire, on 11 Mar 1759. John died in Ramsbottom, Lancashire, in 1837. He was buried in Holcombe, St Emmanuel, Lancashire, on 16 Mar 1837.

The baptisms of John and Agnes's early children show an abode of Edenfield, and the later ones show Ramsbottom. Also in 1791 they switched from Edenfield Chapel to St Emmanuel in Holcombe for their baptisms. Shortly after this switch the baptisms of James and Anne have Stake and Modeleys as the abode. The only known reference is that Moor Road south of Helmshore was formerly known as Stake Lane, but it is more likely these abodes relate to Ramsbottom because of the change in church.

John was buried aged 77.

On 28 Jul 1781 when John was 22, he married **Agnes Nuttall** in Bury, St Mary, Lancashire. Agnes is called Annes on the parish register but it is the only marriage that provides a good fit for the arrival of their children. Agnes was born abt 1751. Agnes died in Ramsbottom, Lancashire, in Jan 1820. She was buried in Holcombe, St Emmanuel, Lancashire, on 9 Jan 1820.

Agnes was buried aged 68. Her abode is given as Carr.

They had the following children:

- i. **Betty Warburton**. Betty was born in Edenfield, Lancashire, on 8 Oct 1781. She was christened in Edenfield Chapel, Lancashire, on 4 Nov 1781.
- 13** ii. **Peter Warburton** (1783-1837)
- 14** iii. **John Warburton** (1784-1848)
- iv. **Peggy Warburton**. Peggy was born in Edenfield, Lancashire, on 11 Aug 1786. She was christened in Edenfield Chapel, Lancashire, on 27 Aug 1786.
- 15** v. **Thomas Edmund Warburton** (1788-)
- 16** vi. **Abraham Warburton** (1790-1861)
- vii. **Robert Warburton**. Robert was born in Edenfield, Lancashire, on 15 May 1791. He was christened in Holcombe, St Emmanuel, Lancashire, on 13 Jun 1791.

Robert's history is uncertain. The only records relate to a marriage at Haslingden to Ann Booth, and an associated family and grave. Although the age at death is a near fit, the marriage was "with consent of guardians" so this is more likely to be the family of an illegitimate Robert born at the same time. No other matching records have been found.
- 17** viii. **James Warburton** (1792-1858)
- ix. **Anne Warburton**. Anne was born in Edenfield, Lancashire, on 17 Dec 1794. She was christened in Holcombe, St Emmanuel, Lancashire, on 2 Mar 1795. Anne died in Ramsbottom, Lancashire, in 1797. She was buried in Holcombe, St Emmanuel, Lancashire, on 30 Oct 1797.

Anne's abode was Modeleys on her baptism, and Ramsbottom on her burial, where she was an infant named Ann, raising the possibility there was an Anne and an Ann who both died young.
- x. **Alice Warburton**. Alice was born in Ramsbottom, Lancashire, on 31 Oct 1796. She was christened in Holcombe, St Emmanuel, Lancashire, on 15 Jan 1797. Alice died in Ramsbottom, Lancashire, on 11 Mar 1798. She was buried on 13 Mar 1798.

Alice was buried aged 1.

18 xi. **William Warburton** (1799-1859)

**12. Thomas Edmund Warburton** (*Peter<sup>9</sup>, Thomas<sup>8</sup>, Peter<sup>7</sup>, John<sup>6</sup>, Francis<sup>5</sup>, Thomas<sup>4</sup>, Thomas<sup>3</sup>, Francis<sup>2</sup>, Thomas<sup>1</sup>*). Thomas Edmund was born in Hencock, Edenfield, Lancashire, abt 1763. He was christened in Edenfield Chapel, Lancashire, on 9 Jan 1763. Thomas Edmund died in Edenfield, Lancashire, on 27 Feb 1805. He was buried in Holcombe, St Emmanuel, Lancashire, on 2 Mar 1805.

Thomas's abode is given as Carr, and later Hall Carr, on parish records from 1788 onwards. This is assumed to be Hall Carr in Newchurch, as the records are from St Nicholas, Newchurch after 1792.

The burial of Thomas, aged 42, of Edenfield is a good fit for this Thomas. It implies he moved again sometime after 1798. Because there is no other local Thomas and Sarah marriage before 1803, he is still relatively young, and has clearly moved from Hall Carr, he is assumed to be the father of four children born in Walmersley between 1800 and 1803. However this is despite the mother being called Sarah when she is Sally in all other references, and the possibility that these, and four subsequent children from Edenfield could be the family of a Thomas and Sarah who moved into the area and whose marriage is unknown. A paper **Thomas and Sarah Marriages** on The Warburton Website gives the available evidence.

On 24 Jul 1781 when Thomas Edmund was 18, he first married **Millicent Turner** in Bury, St Mary, Lancashire. Millicent was born in Holcombe, Lancashire, in 1762. She was christened in Holcombe, St Emmanuel, Lancashire, on 17 Jul 1762. Millicent died in Newchurch-in-Rossendale, Lancashire, on 15 Apr 1794. She was buried in Holcombe, St Emmanuel, Lancashire, on 17 Apr 1794.

Millicent died in her 33rd year. Her abode on her burial record was Hall Carr.

They had the following children:

- i. **Ann Warburton**. Ann was born in Ramsbottom, Lancashire, on 12 Nov 1781. She was christened in Holcombe, St Emmanuel, Lancashire, on 8 Dec 1881.
- 19 ii. **Peter Warburton** (1784-1854)
- iii. **Betty Warburton**. Betty was born in Newchurch-in-Rossendale, Lancashire, on 5 May 1788. She was christened in Bury, St Mary, Lancashire, on 1 Jun 1788.

Peter is a dyer on his marriage, and a weaver on the last three baptisms.

On his burial his abode is Stubbins Lane which is not far from Gibbon Green his abode at the time of the baptism of his last child 15 years earlier. His age is given as 53, though he had probably just passed his 54th birthday when he died.

On 2 Sep 1805 when Peter was 22, he married **Mary Lowe** in Bury, St Mary, Lancashire. Mary was born abt 1784. Mary died in Ramsbottom, Lancashire, in 1843. She was buried in Holcombe, St Emmanuel, Lancashire, on 21 Oct 1843.

Mary's death was registered in 4q 1843 Bury 21 193, aged 59. She was from Ramsbottom on her burial.

St Emmanuel, Lancashire, on 2 Nov 1848.

John was aged 64 from Top Wood on his burial record, which is correct for the son of John and Agnes. He was living at Top Wood in the 1841 census, and his widow Ann is a farmer at Top Wood in the 1851 census with married daughter Ann, and Abraham. He was a weaver on several of his children's baptisms, but a carter on that of William.

On 13 Aug 1810 when John was 25, he married **Ann Ormerod** in Bury, St Mary, Lancashire. Ann was born in Rossendale, Lancashire, abt 1784. ■ Census for Tottington Lower End, Lancashire, in 1851. Ann (62) is a widowed farmer living at Topwood with Abraham (22) an engraver, daughter Ann Balshaw (40), her husband Samuel (40), and children Selina (14), John (12), Mary (10), and William (5). ■ Census for Tottington Lower End, Lancashire, in 1861. Ann (75) is a widowed farmer living at Top Wood with Abraham (35) an engraver to calico printer, daughter Ann Balshaw (52), her husband Samuel (53), and children Selina (24), John (23), Mary (20), and William (15). ■ Census for Tottington Lower End, Lancashire, in 1871. Ann (86) is living at Top Wood as mother-in-law to Samuel Balshaw (60), his wife Ann (58), and children Mary (30), and William (25), and son Abraham (46) a machine engraver. Ann died in Holcombe, Lancashire, in 1878.

Ann's death was registered in 4q 1878 Bury 8c 302, aged 94.

Thomas (50) and Sarah (50) are living with daughter Annis (25), her husband John Mills (30), and their 2 sons and a daughter. ■ Census for Tottington Lower End, Lancashire, in 1851. Thomas (62) is a servant man, born in Edenfield, living in Holcombe with Sally (65) born Haslingden.

The 1841 census entry is linked to Thomas and Sarah Heyes by the presence of Annis. Thomas's age and abode in the 1851 census exactly fit the birth of Thomas Edmund. The Edmund does not appear to have been used following his baptism.

There is no obvious burial or death registration for either Thomas or Sarah so their movements after 1851 are unknown.

On 22 Oct 1810 when Thomas Edmund was 22, he married **Sarah Heys** in Bury, St Mary, Lancashire. Thomas is a dyer. FamilySearch has the marriage also recorded at Walmersley. Sarah was born in Haslingden, Lancashire, in 1785. She was christened in Haslingden, St James, Lancashire, on 27 Feb 1785.

Sarah was called Sally on the baptisms of her three children, and also on the 1851 census. The Sarah baptised in Haslingden is the closest in age and place of birth to the details in the 1851 census (she would actually be 66). Her parents were Henry and Mary of Broadholden.

The abode on James's baptism is Stake.

The only Richmel baptism is that of Richmael Platt daughter of Jenny Platt and James Warburton. The baptism of Hannah Platt in 1828 also refers to Jenny Platt, and to James as the reputed father. Hannah is not present in the censuses but no burial has been found. No baptism has been found for Rosanna or Agnes/Alice (assuming the census references to Agnes and to Alice are to the same person). However as their ages fall between Richmael and Hannah it is likely they were the children on James and Jenny.

No record of James's marriage has been found. The only evidence of a wife is the presence of Jane in the 1841 census, and the fact James was a widower in 1851. It would seem James and Jenny never married and the reference to widower could just be cover for the fact he was living with two daughters.

Jenny or Jane's burial has not been found.

James was buried aged 65, of Carr Street, in grave 552.

He common-law married **Jenny Platt**.

Peter was a weaver on his first child John's baptism, and a carder on the others. Both Peter and John were living at Holden Mill in 1834/5 when Peter's last child, and John's first were both baptised at Ebenezer Chapel in Blackburn.

Peter was aged 69, from Iron Gate on his burial record.

Millicent died of acute pneumonia.

On 10 Aug 1848 when Millicent was 25, she married **John Butterworth** in Haslingden, Wesleyan Chapel, John of Syke Side, Lancashire. John and Millicent had six sons and three daughters. They lived at Tottington and Ramsbottom. John was born in Haslingden, Lancashire, on 25 May 1823. He was christened in Haslingden, King St Wesleyan Methodist, Lancashire, on 1 Jul 1823. John died in Bury, Lancashire, on 3 Apr 1909.

John was the son of James and Alice Butterworth. He was a cotton mill manager. He died of senile decay.

- v. **Susan Warburton**. Susan was born in Hardsough, Edenfield, Lancashire, on 5 Nov 1825. She was christened in Edenfield Chapel, Lancashire, on 15 Jan 1826. Susan died on 4 May 1841. She was buried in Edenfield Chapel, Lancashire, on 8 May 1841.
- vi. **Jane Warburton**. Jane was born in Edenfield, Lancashire, on 17 May 1828. She was christened in Edenfield Chapel, Lancashire, on 7 Sep 1828. Jane died aft 1891.

On 15 May 1851 when Jane was 22, she first married **Daniel Walmsley** in Haslingden, St James, Lancashire. Jane was from Waterfoot, Haslingden, father John, a manufacturer. Daniel was a millwright from Ramsbottom, father John, a lawyer. Witnesses were John and Betty Warburton. Daniel and Jane had a son. Daniel died in 1852. He was buried in Chorlton, All Saints, Lancashire, on 5 Apr 1852.

Daniel's death was registered in 2q 1852 Manchester 8d 96, aged 25. His son John was registered in Manchester, mother's maiden name Warburton, in the same year.

James (40) is a woollen spinner living in Huntley Brook with Sarah (15) a woollen warper, Thomas (14) a woollen warper, Joshua (12) a woollen piecer, James (9), John (7), Daniel (3), and Sarah Jackson (60). ■ Census for Bury, Lancashire, in 1851. James (50) is a woollen spinner living in Bamford Road with Ann (44), Joshua (22) a woollen spinner, James (19) a woollen feeder, John (17) a woollen warper, and Daniel (13) a woollen piecer. ■ Census for Bury, Lancashire, in 1861. James (60) is a woollen spinner living at 67 Huntley Brook with Ann (54), Thomas (33) a woollen weaver, and James (9). ■ Census for Bury, Lancashire, in 1871. James (70) is a woollen dresser living at 67 Huntley Brook with Ann (64), and grandson James (19) a commercial clerk - paper. ■ Census for Bury, Lancashire, in 1881. James (80) a retired woollen spinner, and wife Ann (74) are living with their grandson James and his wife Elizabeth at 245 Rochdale Road. James died in 1886.

James was a woollen spinner on the baptisms of his first five children. His death was registered in 2q 1886 Bury 8c 322, aged 86.

His children have not been explored further, though it would be useful if a male Warburton descendant could be found to get DNA verification of his parentage.

On 26 Aug 1822 when James was 22, he first married **Peggy Jackson** in Bury, St Mary, Lancashire. James is a woollen spinner, and both are of the parish. Peggy was born abt 1805. Peggy died in Huntley Brook, Bury, Lancashire, in 1838.

Peggy's last child was born in 1837, and she is absent from the 1841 census. James remarried in 1846. It is therefore likely her death was that registered in 4q 1838 Bury 21 164, aged 33.

On 3 Aug 1846 when James was 46, he second married **Ann Foster** in Bury, St Mary, Lancashire. James was a widower, and spinner of Bury, father Thomas, a carder. Ann was a spinster of Bury, father Ralph, a



dye. Ann was born in Bury, Lancashire, abt 1806.

In 1843 when James was 26, he married **Rebecca Dawbiggin** in Ainsworth, Christ Church, Lancashire. Rebecca was born abt 1822. Rebecca died in Ramsbottom, Lancashire, in 1904.

They had the following children:

- i. **John Warburton**. John was born in Holcombe, Lancashire, on 14 Oct 1843. He was christened in Holcombe, St Emmanuel, Lancashire, on 17 Dec 1843.

John's birth was registered in 4q 1843 Bury 21 290, mother's maiden name Dawbegin. John has not been explored further. His abode at birth was Cobbas Nab.

Peter (25) is a calico printer living at Top Wood with Maria (25), Alice (5), and three Melling girls, Sarah (30), Maria (20), and Mary (30). ■ Census for Tottington Lower End, Lancashire, in 1851. Peter (36) is a block printer (calico) living at 5 Nabbs with Maria (36), Alice (15) a power loom weaver, Thomas (7), John (5), Robert (3), and Joseph (6 mths). ■ Census for Tottington Lower End, Lancashire, in 1861. Peter (46) is a calico block printer living on the Holcombe and Bury Road with Maria (46) a dressmaker, Thomas (18) a powerloom cotton weaver, John (16), and Robert (13) factory workers, Joseph (11) employed at print works, Henry M (7), and Sarah (3). ■ Census for Lawrence, Essex, MA, in 1870. Peter (55) is worker in a woollen mill living with Maria (57), Joseph (19) a carpenter, Henry (16) a spooler,

and Sarah (12). His real estate is valued at \$250. ■ Census for Lawrence, Essex, MA, in 1880. Peter (66) is a widowed cotton mill worker living with Sarah (22) a cotton mill worker at 53 Mehuen Street. Peter died in Lawrence, Essex, MA, on 30 Dec 1898.

Peter died aged 83 yrs 9 mths and 22 days, an exact match for his date of birth. From John onwards the baptisms of his children have not been found. This indicates a change of venue, possibly to a nonconformist church.

Peter and his family emigrated to Massachusetts between 1861 and 1870. His descendants have not been explored in detail.

Jonathan (42) is a millwright living Bridge Street, Ramsbottom with Alice (39), Mary A (15) a cotton weaver, Sarah J (11), William (7), and Robert Hoyle (69) a widowed boarder (Alice's father). ■ Census for Tottington Lower End, Lancashire, in 1871. Jonathan (52) is a millwright living at 5 Stubbins Lane with Alice (49), Sarah Jane (21) a cotton weaver, and William (17) a druggist's apprentice. ■ Census for Tottington Lower End, Lancashire, in 1881. The abode on William's baptism is Top. His wife is a widow in the 1871 census so his death is probably that registered in 4q 1868 Bury 8c259, aged 45. Despite having 2 young sons buried in the same month in 1855 William had four other sons who reached maturity, but they have not been investigated further.

On 31 Aug 1846 when William was 23, he married **Mary Goreman** in Bury, St Mary, Lancashire. William is a jobber from Tottington, father Abraham, a printer. Mary is from Tottington, father John, a printer. Mary was born in Holcombe, Lancashire, abt 1825. ■ Census for Tottington Lower End, Lancashire, in 1871. Mary (45) is a widow living at 17 Spring Wood Street with Margaret (23) a cotton weaver, Jonathan (16) a cotton weaver, Alexander (13) employed at print works, Susannah (11) card room hand, Thomas (8), Albert (6), and Alice Jane (2). ■ Census for Tottington Lower End, Lancashire, in 1881. Mary (56) is a widowed housekeeper living at 9 Springwood Street with Susannah (21) a cotton weaver, Thomas (19) a cotton weaver, Albert J (16) a draper's assistant, Alice Jane (12), and a lodger. ■ Census for Tottington Lower End, Lancashire, in 1891. Mary (65) is a widow living on her own means at 9 Springwood Street with Alice Jane (22) a dressmaker and milliner, married daughter Susannah Blake (31) and her husband George (31) and 2 daughters. ■ Census for Ramsbottom, Lancashire, in 1901. Mary (76) is living at 87 Callendar Street with her son-in-law James Brogan (30) an engraver's sketch maker, and daughter Alice Jane Brogan (32) a dressmaker. Niece Kate Blake is also visiting. Mary is referred to as Gorman on her marriage, but as Goreman on the registration of all but the last of her children.

John (49) is a cotton rover living in Waterfoot with Mary (43), Henry (21) a mule spinner, William (16), and Alice (14) mule piecers, Maryann (11), Millicent (9), Thomas (7), John (6), Elizabeth (3), and Hannah (8 mths). John died in Haslingden, Lancashire, on 18 Jul 1869. He was buried in Haslingden, St James, Lancashire.

John's father is a weaver, and his mother's name is Anne (rather than Ann) on his baptism. However the relationship is confirmed because John was living at Holden Mill in 1835 when he married and had his first child baptised at Ebenezer Chapel, Blackburn, as was his father when his sister was baptised at the same chapel in 1834.

Arnold's birth was registered in 4q 1881 Haslingden 8e 141, mother's maiden name Barnes. His death was probably that registered in 3q 1949 Manchester 10e 123, aged 67.

In 1908 when Arnold was 26, he married **Betsy Greenwood** in Haslingden, Salem Chapel, Lancashire. The marriage was registered in 2q 1908 Haslingden 8e 317. Betsy was born in Haslingden, Lancashire, on 13 Nov 1882. Betsy died in Haslingden, Lancashire, in 1973.

Betsy's death was registered in 1q 1973 Haslingden 10c 1144, aged 90.

They had one child:

- i. **Leslie Warburton**. Leslie was born in Haslingden, Lancashire, on 30 Apr 1910. Leslie died in Gloucestershire in Feb 1984.

Leslie's birth was registered in 2q 1910 Haslingden 8e 114. His death was registered in Feb 1984 Gloucester 22 2045, aged 73.

John was a cotton weaver living at 299 Grane Rd. John Dean died in 1954. He was buried in Haslingden, Holden Cemetery, Lancashire, on 30 Mar 1954.

John was a widower living at 315 Grane Road in the 1939 Register and when he was buried aged 84.

In 1887 when John Dean was 17, he married **Nancy Britland** in Haslingden, St James, Lancashire. The marriage was registered in 2q 1887 Haslingden 8e 161. Nancy was born in Haslingden, Lancashire, in 1869. Nancy died aft 1901.

They had one child:

- i. **Annie Warburton**. Annie was born in 1888.

Annie's birth was registered in 1q 1888 Haslingden 8e 93 or 126.

Samuel (30) is a cotton weaver living at 7 Houghtons Road with Alice (31), Willie (9), Annie Mary (7), John Dean (3), Samuel (11 months), and a boarder and his child. Note Frances is staying with her grandparents John and Harriet Warburton. ■ Census for Haslingden, Lancashire, in 1911. Samuel Bradburn (40) is a tackler living at 16 Pleasant Street with Alice Maud (42), William (19) a card room hand, John Dean (a weaver), Hannah Mary (17) a weaver, Samuel (10), Harold (8), Thomas (6), and Albert (3). Samuel and Alice have been married for 24 years and had 8 children, all living. Samuel Bradburn died in 1939. He was buried in Padiham, St Leonard, Lancashire.

Samuel's date of birth is from the 1939 Register. His birth was registered in 4q 1870 Haslingden 8e 143.

Burnley Express - Saturday 30th December 1939: LATE MR. S. B. WARBURTON The internment took place in the Padiham Church Cemetery yesterday week of Mr. Samuel Bradburn Warburton of 68 Station Road, whose death occurred the previous Wednesday in his 70th year. Born at Haslingden, Mr. Warburton had resided in Padiham for 19 years, and for over 15 years had been employed at Messrs. Stuttard's Cobden Mill. He had been a prominent member of the Padiham Unity Club and the Overlookers' Club. He had also been connected with St. Leonard's Church. He leaves a widow, six sons and one daughter. The Rev. C. A. Parkinson offered prayers at the home and also officiated at the graveside. Floral tributes were

sent by:- His sorrowing wife; Harold, Ivy and children; Bill, Marguarette and children; Annie, Mary and Arthur; Jack, Maggie and children; Sam and Rosie; Tom, Edith and children; Albert, Victor and Harold; Mrs Baxendale and family; brother J. Warburton; Mr and Mrs Townsend; workpeople, Tuniam Shed, Cobden Mill; overlookers, Cobden Mill, Sabden; Albert, Lea and baby Josephine, Leslie; Padiham Overlookers' Association; members of United Irish league, Padiham.

In 1888 when Samuel Bradburn was 17, he married **Alice Maud Ellis** in Hyndburn Register Office or Registrar Attended, Lancashire. The marriage was registered in 1q 1888 Haslingden 8e 230. Alice Maud was born in Shrewsbury, Shropshire, in 1870.

Thomas and Mary had been married 9 years and had 3 children, all living. ■ Census for Haslingden, Lancashire, in 1939. Thomas is hand waste cotton weaver living at 275 Grane Road, Haslingden with Mary, and Harold. The other children have all left home. Thomas Eccles died in Haslingden, Lancashire, in 1944. He was buried in Haslingden, Holden Cemetery, Lancashire, on 9 Nov 1944.

Thomas's birth was registered in 2q 1874 Haslingden 8e 163, mother's maiden name Isherwood.

In addition to Thomas's 6 known children two other children were registered at Haslingden in 1919/20 with mother's maiden name Platt, but there was one other Warburton-Platt marriage by this time. As the two were born too close to be from the same family then either Leonard registered in 3q 1919 Haslingden 8e 137, or Una registered in 1q 1920 Haslingden 8e 185 are probably part of this family.

Thomas died at 275 Grane Road and was buried aged 70 in grave B680 with his parents, and two of his children.

Thomas and Alethea had been married 6 years and had 3 children, 2 still living.

In 1905 when Thomas was 23, he married **Alethea Bonaker Gale** in Westhampnett, Sussex. The marriage was registered in 2q 1905 Westhampnett 2b 794. Alethea Bonaker was born in Chaddington, Buckinghamshire, in 1884. Alethea Bonaker died in Horwich, Lancashire, in 1946.

Alethea's birth was registered in 2q 1884 Leighton Buzzard 3b 435. Her death was registered in 1q 1946 Horwich 8c 443, aged 62.

William is probably the Bill who sent a floral tribute at his father's funeral in December 1939 along with Margarett and children. As he is not with his wife Eleanor (Nellie) in the 1939 Register, and she is using her maiden name, it is possible they are separated and Margarett is his new lady.

Harold Warburton** (*Samuel Bradburn<sup>14</sup>, John<sup>13</sup>, Thomas<sup>12</sup>, John<sup>11</sup>, Thomas Edmund<sup>10</sup>, Peter<sup>9</sup>, Thomas<sup>8</sup>, Peter<sup>7</sup>, John<sup>6</sup>, Francis<sup>5</sup>, Thomas<sup>4</sup>, Thomas<sup>3</sup>, Francis<sup>2</sup>, Thomas<sup>1</sup>*). Harold was born in Haslingden, Lancashire, on 16 Nov 1902.

Harold's birth was registered in 4q 1902 Haslingden 8e 120. He is a motor driver in the 1939 Register. He and his family are living with his parents at 68 Station Road, Padiham.

In 1923 when Harold was 20, he married **Ivy Wilkinson** in Burnley Register Office or Registrar Attended, Lancashire. The marriage was registered in 2q 1923 Burnley 8e 530. Two sons and three daughters are registered at Burnley, district Padiham, between 1923 and 1934, Four are present in the 1939 Register, Iris and three closed records. Ivy was born on 7 Oct 1901.

Ivy is a cotton weaver on the 1939 register.

They had the following children:

- i. **Albert Warburton**. Albert was born in Padiham, Lancashire, in 1928. Albert died in Padiham, Lancashire, in Sep 1939. He was buried in Padiham Church cemetery, Lancashire, on 19 Sep 1939.

Albert's birth was registered in 4q 1928 Burnley 8e 267. He died when he fell through a factory roof. His death was registered in 3q 1939 Burnley 8e 196, aged 10.

Burnley Express 15th July 1939 SERIOUSLY INJURED As result of an accident which occurred about six o'clock last Sunday evening, Albert Warburton (10), of 68, Station-road, was taken Burnley Victoria Hoapital in a critical condition. As far as is known Warburton fell through the roof of the Padiham Chemical Works. His injuries included lacerated wound the top of the head and lacerated wound to the thigh. On inquiry at the Victoria Hospital yesterday the Express " was told that Warburton's condition was much the same."

Burnley Express 22nd July 1939: TRAGEDY VICTIM'S DEATH The funeral took place last Wednesday in the Church Cemetery of Master Albert Warburton (10), of 68, Station-road, who, reported in last Wednesday's " Express," died after crashing 16 feet through a skylight to a concrete floor. Mr. Hargreave, lay preacher of the Unitarian Circuit, officiated at the home, Padiham Unitarian Chapel and the graveside. There were many floral tributes.

- ii. **Iris Warburton**. Iris was born in Padiham, Lancashire, on 31 May 1930. Iris died in Blackpool, Lancashire, in Aug 1992.

On 5 Nov 1951 when Iris was 21, she married **Frederick Fairhurst** in Nelson Register Office or Registrar Attended, Lancashire. The marriage was registered in 4q 1951 Nelson 10e 965.

**55. Thomas Warburton** (*Samuel Bradburn<sup>14</sup>, John<sup>13</sup>, Thomas<sup>12</sup>, John<sup>11</sup>, Thomas Edmund<sup>10</sup>, Peter<sup>9</sup>, Thomas<sup>8</sup>, Peter<sup>7</sup>, John<sup>6</sup>, Francis<sup>5</sup>, Thomas<sup>4</sup>, Thomas<sup>3</sup>, Francis<sup>2</sup>, Thomas<sup>1</sup>*). Thomas was born in Haslingden, Lancashire, in 1905.

Tom's birth was registered in 2q 1905 Haslingden 8e 78 or 113 (2 were registered). He was called Thomas in the 1911 census, but Tom on his marriage. In the 1939 Register he is a gas worker living at 183 Newhouse Road, Blackpool with Edith, Thomas B, and one other child whose record is closed.

In 1923 when Thomas was 18, he married **Edith Ramsden** in Miles Platting, St Luke, Lancashire. The marriage was registered in 2q 1923 Prestwich 8d 544. Five children's births were registered with mother's maiden name Ramsden: Edith Joan in 4q 1923, and Doreen in 4q 1925 both at Padiham, Thomas Bradburn at Cheetham in 4q 1932, and Keith E in 1q 1938 and Harold in 4q 1944 at Blackpool. Edith was born on 23 Sep 1900. Edith died in Blackpool, Lancashire, in 1975.

Edith's death is probably that registered in 3q 1975 Blackpool and Fylde 40 0722, but the date of birth (26th August 1900) doesn't match that on the 1939 Register.

They had the following children:

- i. **Edith Joan Warburton**. Edith Joan was born in Padiham, Lancashire, on 8 Nov 1923.

Edith's birth was registered in 4q 1923 Burnley 8e 306. In the 1939 Register she is a confectioner assistant living at 68 Station Road, Padiham with her grandparents, and Uncle Harold and his family. Her record isn't closed implying she is no longer living but her death registration cannot be found under the name Mulberry.
