1. Thomas Warburton.

Thomas married **Sarah Dodd** on 20 Oct 1790 in Harthill, All Saints, Cheshire.

Children from this marriage were:

- 2 M i. **John Warburton** was born in 1791 in Broxton, Cheshire and died on 20 Mar 1791 in Harthill, All Saints, Cheshire.
- 3 M ii. **George Warburton** was born in 1793 in Broxton, Cheshire and died on 26 May 1793 in Harthill, All Saints, Cheshire.
- 4 M iii. **William Warburton** was born about 1795 in Broxton, Cheshire and died on 4 Feb 1795 in Harthill, All Saints, Cheshire.
- 5 M iv. **Thomas Warburton** was born in 1796 in Broxton, Cheshire and died on 15 Jan 1797 in Harthill, All Saints, Cheshire aged 1.
- 6 M v. **Samuel Warburton** was born in 1799 in Broxton, Cheshire and died on 26 Mar 1799 in Harthill, All Saints, Cheshire.
- 7 F vi. **Hannah Warburton** was born in 1801 in Broxton, Cheshire and died on 30 Aug 1801 in Harthill, All Saints, Cheshire.
- 8 M vii. **Peter Warburton** was born in 1804 in Broxton, Cheshire and was christened on 19 Aug 1804 in Harthill, All Saints, Cheshire.
- 9 F viii. **Elizabeth Warburton** was born in 1805 in Broxton, Cheshire and was christened on 5 Jan 1806 in Harthill, All Saints, Cheshire.
- 10 M ix. **James Warburton** was born in 1808 and was christened on 13 Nov 1808 in Harthill, All Saints, Cheshire.
- + 11 M x. **Joseph Warburton** was born in 1810 in Broxton, Cheshire, was christened on 30 Sep 1810 in Harthill, All Saints, Cheshire, and died in 1866 in Bickerton, Cheshire aged 56.

Second Generation (Children)

11. Joseph Warburton (*Thomas¹*) was born in 1810 in Broxton, Cheshire, was christened on 30 Sep 1810 in Harthill, All Saints, Cheshire, and died in 1866 in Bickerton, Cheshire aged 56.

General Notes: This Joseph is included to help separate him from Joseph son of John and Mary Tomlinson who also married a Jane.

His death is probably that registered in 2q 1866 Nantwich 8a 255, aged 55. This fits with the baptism at Harthill in September 1810.

IGI records only female baptisms at Malpas in this period. The births of the 2 sons are in an IGI Pedigree file, but only the year is quoted and details of the parents is dubious.

Noted events in his life were:

- He appeared on the census in 1841 in Bickerton, Cheshire. Joseph Warburton (30) is a slater living with Jane (25), Elizabeth (5), Emma (4), James (3), Mary (7 months), and Sarah (75).
- He appeared on the census in 1851 in Bickerton, Cheshire. Joseph (37) is a plasterer from Broxton, living in Harthill Lane, with Jane (37) of Bickerton, Elizabeth (16), Emma (14), James (12), Mary (9), Sarah (8), Jane (6) and Thomas (2).
- He appeared on the census in 1861 in Bickerton, Cheshire. Joseph (50) is a plasterer employing 4 men and 2 boys and living on Gallantry Bank with Jane (47), James (22) a plasterer, Mary (20) Thomas (12), Joseph (9), Ann (3), Hannah (2), father-in-law Thomas Roberts (82), and nephew Thomas Roberts (25).

Joseph married **Jane Roberts** on 2 Oct 1833 in Malpas, Cheshire. Jane was born about 1813 in Bickerton, Cheshire and died in 1885 aged about 72.

General Notes: After Joseph's death Jane married Charles Vickers at Chester, St. Oswald in 1868 (C BMD CE 15/6/82). Charles is dead by 1881, probably in 1875 aged 73, C BMD reference CAT/40/24. Her own death is probably that of Jane Vickers in 1885, age 72, C BMD reference CAT/53/27.

Descendants of Thomas Warburton

Noted events in her life were:

- She appeared on the census in 1871 in Bickerton, Cheshire. Jane Vickers (57) is living in Harthill Lane with James (32) a plasterer and slater, Thomas (22) a plasterer, Ann (14), and granddaughter Jane Abbot (5). Mr Vickers is not at home. Although James is described as unmarried he was married to Martha Mein by this time. She was living in Birkenhead.
- She appeared on the census in 1881 in Bickerton, Cheshire. Jane (67) is boarding with daughter Jane, her husband Thomas Nicklin and family at 36 Coombe Dale.

Children from this marriage were:

- 12 F i. **Elizabeth Warburton** was born about 1834 in Bickerton, Cheshire.
General Notes: There is an Elizabeth Anne baptised at Malpas on 6 Jan 1835. The date fits but her parents are described as Joseph and Ann. However there are no other children for Joseph and Ann on IGI.
- 13 F ii. **Emma Warburton** was born about 1836 in Tunstall, Staffordshire.
Emma married **John Lea** on 4 Feb 1859 in Malpas, St Oswald, Cheshire. John was born about 1836.
Marriage Notes: Emma 22, spinster of Bickerton, father Joseph, plasterer. John 22, plasterer of Bickerton, father William, schoolmaster. Witnesses Thomas Lea and Mary Warburton.
On the 1861 census John and Emma have 2 daughters Mary Ann (1) and Jane (3 months), but the family disappear from future censuses.
- + 14 M iii. **James Warburton** was born in 1838 in Bickerton, Cheshire and was christened on 24 Dec 1838 in Malpas, St Oswald, Cheshire.
- 15 F iv. **Mary Warburton** was born in 1840 in Bickerton, Cheshire and was christened on 1 Nov 1840 in Malpas, Cheshire.
- 16 F v. **Sarah Warburton** was born about 1842 in Bickerton, Cheshire and was christened on 6 Nov 1842 in Malpas, Cheshire.
General Notes: An 1871 census record shows her married to a Belton Deaner and living in Stoke-on-Trent. Brother Joseph (Warbinton) is staying. No marriage record has been found for a name resembling Belton Deaner.
- 17 F vi. **Jane Warburton** was born about 1844 in Bickerton, Cheshire and was christened on 14 Nov 1844 in Malpas, Cheshire.
Jane married **Thomas Nicklin** from 1871 to 1875 in Bickerton, Holy Trinity, Cheshire. Thomas was born about 1842 in Breamore, Hampshire.
Marriage Notes: Thomas and Jane's children were Thomas (b. 1873), James (b. 1876), Elizabeth (b. 1877), and Emma (b. 1878).
- + 18 M vii. **Thomas Warburton** was born in 1849 in Bickerton, Cheshire.
- 19 M viii. **Joseph Warburton** was born about 1851 in Bickerton, Cheshire.
General Notes: Joseph is missing from the censuses after 1871.
Noted events in his life were:
• He appeared on the census in 1871 in Stoke-On-Trent, Staffordshire. Joseph Warbinton (18) is a painter staying with sister Sarah (28) and brother-in-law Belton Deaner (sic).
- 20 F ix. **Ann Warburton** was born about 1857 in Bickerton, Cheshire.
- 21 F x. **Hannah Warburton** was born about 1858 in Bickerton, Cheshire.

Third Generation (Grandchildren)

14. James Warburton (*Joseph*², *Thomas*¹) was born in 1838 in Bickerton, Cheshire and was christened on 24 Dec 1838 in Malpas, St Oswald, Cheshire.

General Notes: Neither James nor his family appear in the 1901 census. Ada may have married by this time. No deaths are recorded on FreeBMD in Birmingham between 1891 and 1901, except for a Martha in 1899 who is five years too young.

Noted events in his life were:

- He appeared on the census in 1881 in Alpraham, Cheshire. James (48) is a plasterer lodging with Thomas Williams and family. He is described as married and of Bickerton (transcribed as Beckinton by Ancestry).

Descendants of Thomas Warburton

- He appeared on the census in 1891 in Birmingham, Warwickshire. James (52) a plasterer of Bickerton is living at 6 Summer Hill Drive with Martha (56), William and Mary Newall (Matha's daughter and son-in-law) and their son Frank. Also present is Thomas J Warburton (15) a metal turner born in Rock Ferry, Birkenhead, Cheshire. He is described as a grandson.

James married **Martha Mein** in 1868 in Liverpool, Lancashire. Martha was born about 1834 in Lydbrook, Gloucestershire.

Marriage Notes: Marriage reference 4q 1868 Liverpool 6b168.

General Notes: Martha was married before her marriage to James and had a number of children including David (b. circa 1849), Clara (b.c circa 1853), Martha M (b. circa 1857), Amelia Ellen (b. circa 1859), and May Ann (b.circa 1863).

Noted events in her life were:

- She appeared on the census in 1871 in Birkenhead, Cheshire. Martha (36), said to be from Ireland, is living at 1 Priory Street, with Ada J (2), and David, Ellen and May Ann Mein from her previous marriage.
- She appeared on the census in 1881 in Birmingham, Warwickshire. Martha (52) is living at 206 Bristol Street with Ada J (12), daughters Clara, Martha M, and Amelia E Mein from her previous marriage, and Tom J Mein her grandson (presumably son of David Mein). James is lodging in Alpraham, Cheshire.

Children from this marriage were:

- 22 F i. **Ada J Warburton** was born about 1868 in Birkenhead, Cheshire.
- 23 M ii. **Thomas J Warburton** was born about 1875 in Rock Ferry, Cheshire.

General Notes: Thomas is referred to as a grandson on the 1891 census, but this is impossible given his parents date of marriage, unless he is the son of one of Martha's grandsons from her first marriage misnamed. He does not appear in any other census.

18. Thomas Warburton (*Joseph*², *Thomas*¹) was born in 1849 in Bickerton, Cheshire.

Noted events in his life were:

- He appeared on the census in 1881 in Bunbury, Cheshire. Thomas (32) is a plasterer living with his in-laws William and Margaret Frodsham, their son Hugh, wife Annie (24), Jane (3), and Joseph (1).
- He appeared on the census in 1891 in Broxton, Cheshire. Thomas (42) is a plasterer living with Annie (34) William J (11), George (8), Thomas (6), and Harry (4).
- He appeared on the census in 1901 in Broxton, Cheshire. Thomas (51) a plasterer is living with Annie (43).

Thomas married **Anne Frodsham** in 1877 in Bunbury, St Boniface, Cheshire. Anne was born about 1857 in Bunbury, Cheshire.

Marriage Notes: Marriage reference C BMD Cheshire Central 111/3/26. The marriage registration index for 2q 1877 Nantwich has different references for Thomas (8a 437) and Anne (8a 457). Anne's is hand written in so it is probably Thomas's that is correct.

Children from this marriage were:

- 24 F i. **Jane Warburton** was born in 1877 in Bunbury, Cheshire.
General Notes: Jane's birth is probably that registered in 3q 1877 Nantwich 8a 368.
- + 25 M ii. **William Joseph Warburton** was born in 1879 in Tattenhall, Cheshire and was christened on 23 Sep 1879 in Tattenhall, St Alban, Cheshire.
- 26 M iii. **George Warburton** was born about 1882 in Tilston, Cheshire.
- 27 M iv. **Thomas Warburton** was born about 1884 in Broxton, Cheshire.
- 28 M v. **Harry Warburton** was born about 1886 in Broxton, Cheshire.

Fourth Generation (Great-Grandchildren)

25. William Joseph Warburton (*Thomas*³, *Joseph*², *Thomas*¹) was born in 1879 in Tattenhall, Cheshire and was christened on 23 Sep 1879 in Tattenhall, St Alban, Cheshire.

General Notes: Birth registration is probably that in 3q 1879 Chester 8a 385. His death registration is probably that in 1q 1910 Whitchurch 6a 494, aged 30.

William married **Jessie Allen** on 25 Dec 1905 in Malpas, St Oswald, Cheshire. Jessie was born on 6 Mar 1877 in Malpas, Cheshire, died on 3 Apr 1958 in Rockcroft, Ontario aged 81, and was buried on 5 Apr 1958 in Lakefield, Ontario.

Marriage Notes: The marriage was registered in 4q 1905 Whitchurch 6a 1475.

Descendants of Thomas Warburton

General Notes: Jessie's birth was registered in 1q 1877 Whitchurch 6a 803.

Information Jessie's life and family is provided by her granddaughter Eileen Hughes, and includes information from a tree prepared by her great granddaughter Karen Windover.

Jessie and her three children emigrated to Canada circa 1914 on the Mayflower. She married Albert Edward Allen on July 7th 1914 in Canada and had two further children.

Noted events in her life were:

- She appeared on the census in 1911 in Malpas, Cheshire. Jessie (34) is a widowed charwoman living at Oak Hill Cottages with her father Joseph (72) a widowed bricklayer, Albert Allen (11) Jessie's son from an earlier relationship, Marion (4), and Joseph (3). She says she was married 5 years and had 4 children, 3 still living.

Children from this marriage were:

- + 29 F i. **Marion Warburton** was born on 19 Jul 1906 in Malpas, Cheshire, died on 9 Mar 1964 in Peterborough, Ontario aged 57, and was buried on 11 Mar 1964 in Lakefield, Ontario.
- 30 M ii. **Thomas Joseph Allen Warburton** was born on 11 Apr 1908 in Malpas, Cheshire.

General Notes: The birth of Thomas Joseph A was registered in 2q 1908 Whitchurch 6a 706.

Thomas had five sons and two daughters, who provided 24 grandchildren, including 17 Warburtons (9 grandsons, and eight granddaughters).

Thomas married **Lila Nesbitt**.

Fifth Generation (Great Great-Grandchildren)

29. Marion Warburton (*William Joseph⁴, Thomas³, Joseph², Thomas¹*) was born on 19 Jul 1906 in Malpas, Cheshire, died on 9 Mar 1964 in Peterborough, Ontario aged 57, and was buried on 11 Mar 1964 in Lakefield, Ontario.

General Notes: Marion's birth was registered in 3q 1906 Whitchurch 6a 710.

Marion had six children. The first, the son of Clarion Windover, carried the name Warburton. She married George Hullah in 1927 and had a daughter. She then had four children by Julian Aldolphus Windover, including the father of Karen Windover.

Marion had a relationship with **Clarion Windover**. Marriage status: unmarried.

Their child was:

- 31 M i. **Vernon Bert Warburton** was born on 19 Mar 1926 in Rockcroft, Ontario and died on 20 Sep 2004 in Waterloo, Ontario aged 78.

General Notes: Vernon had one daughter.

Descendants of Samuel Warburton

First Generation

1. Samuel Warburton was born about 1806 in Clutton, Cheshire and died after 1881.

General Notes: The information on Samuel and his family comes mainly from the tree of Joyce Lawrence on Genes Reunited. She is descended from Sarah Warburton and John Aldersley. Further detail was provided by Kate Probyn.

The young grandchildren Emma and John who are with Samuel in 1851 are an enigma. They were born before any of his known children married and do not appear in subsequent censuses.

Noted events in his life were:

- He appeared on the census in 1841 in Duckington, Cheshire. Samuel (30) is an agricultural labourer living with Margaret (35), Mary (10), Sarah (8), Martha (6), Samuel (3) and Margaret (2).
- He appeared on the census in 1851 in Duckington, Cheshire. Samuel (44) is an agricultural labourer living with Margaret (50), Sarah (19), Margaret (12), William (8), and grandchildren Emma (2) and John (1).
- He appeared on the census in 1871 in Duckingfield. Samuel (65) is a widowed agricultural labourer born in Clutton living with Margaret (31), William (27) an agricultural labourer, and granddaughter Elizabeth A (1 month), Margaret's daughter. They are indexed as Warberton on Ancestry.
- He appeared on the census in 1881 in Duckington, Cheshire. Samuel (72) a widowed agricultural labourer born in Tilston, is living with daughter Margaret (40) and granddaughter Elizabeth (10), both born in Duckingfield. He is indexed by Ancestry as Saint Warberton.

Samuel married **Margaret Probin** on 15 May 1828 in Malpas, Cheshire. Margaret was born in 1798 in Duckington, Cheshire, was christened on 25 Mar 1798 in Malpas, St Oswald, Cheshire, and died in 1868 in Malpas, Cheshire aged 70.

General Notes: Margaret's parents were Uriah and Mary Probin. She was recorded as age 70 on her death certificate.

Children from this marriage were:

+ 2 M i. **John Warburton** was born in 1828 in Duckington, Cheshire, died on 5 May 1905 in Brown Knowle Methodist Church, Harthill aged 77, and was buried in 1905.

3 F ii. **Mary Warburton** was born in 1831 in Duckington, Cheshire.

Noted events in her life were:

- She appeared on the census in 1851 in Duckington, Cheshire. Mary (20) is a house servant on the farm of John Morris. Brother Samuel is an agricultural labourer.

Mary married **Thomas Carter** in 1853 in Malpas, St Oswald, Cheshire. Thomas was born in 1828 in Duckington, Cheshire.

Marriage Notes: Thomas and Mary's children were Martha (b. 1854), John (b. 1858), Thomas (b. 1866), Mary (b. 1869), and William (b. 1877).

Noted events in his life were:

- He appeared on the census in 1851 in Duckington, Cheshire. Mary (20) is a house servant on the farm of John Morris. Brother Samuel is an agricultural labourer.

4 F iii. **Sarah Warburton** was born in 1832 in Duckington, Cheshire, died on 23 Oct 1924 in Malpas, Cheshire aged 92, and was buried in 1924 in Brown Knowle Methodist Church, Harthill.

General Notes: In 1881 she is widowed, living next door but one to her father, Samuel Warburton.

Her Monumental Inscription, along with her husband and mother-in-law reads:

IN MEMORY OF MARY ALDERSEY
OF DUCKINGTON

Illustrated History of Pawtucket, Central Falls and Vicinity by Robert Grieve, 1897:

WARBURTON, Henry Ashton, descends from an old English Quaker family. His grandfather, Jacob Warburton, was born in Bury, Lancashire, England, July 2, 1782, was a hand loom weaver and came from a family of farmers. His grandmother, Sarah Ashton Warburton, was also born in Bury, April 9, 1784, and her family were farmers. His father was born in Bury, Feb. 8, 1806, and was well known as a successful manager of cotton mills; he was a distinguished member of the Society of Friends, came to the United States in 1852, and died in Lawrence, Mass., in 1879. His mother was Sarah Taylor, born in Barnsley, Derbyshire, England, July 20, 1808. Her amiability and gentleness of character endears her memory to her children. Her patience was often tried by her large family of twelve children, nine sons and three daughters.

Henry Ashton Warburton was born in the town of Hyde, Cheshire, England, Nov. 2, 1837, and is the sixth child of Peter and Sarah (Taylor) Warburton. He attended the public schools of his native town until he attained his eighth year, when he entered the cotton mill, and until his 10th year his time was equally divided between school and work. With the knowledge thus obtained he started in life at the tender age of 10 years. He came to this country with his father in 1852, secured employment as a piecer on hand spinning mules at Portsmouth, N. H., and availed himself of the local night school to enlarge his general knowledge. In 1853 he engaged in mule spinning in Lawrence, Mass., and operated a pair of spinning mules for seven years. He also worked at file-cutting by machinery at Ballardvale, Mass., then returned to Portsmouth, N. H., where he was assistant overseer in the Portsmouth steam mill, and was transferred to the thread department, where he obtained the knowledge which contributed to his final success.

He also worked in Newmarket, Exeter, N. H., was assistant overseer of the Hadley Thread Co., of Holyoke, Mass., and was overseer of the Warren Thread Co., of Worcester, Mass. In the latter city he engaged with William Ward of Portsmouth [sic], N. H., the owner of a distillery, of which he was induced to take charge, and though he remained over three years, testing all kinds of alcoholic liquors by taste and smell, he yet never drank a drop. He then returned to his old business in 1877, accepting a position as overseer of the winding room with William Warren of New York city, thread manufacturer. In 1880 he came to Pawtucket as overseer and then became superintendent of Stafford & Co.'s works. In company with James C. Roth in 1886 he purchased this company's thread department and organized the New England Thread Co., he being general manager. His vast experience in the manufacture of threads peculiarly fitted him to produce a superior article, which was soon observed by the trade, and although he had to contend with many obstacles he steadily

succeeded in establishing a lucrative business. In 1889 Mr. Roth died and he purchased his interest from the heirs, thus becoming sole proprietor. He employs over 100 hands and does a gross business of from \$135,000 to \$150,000 per annum in the manufacture of cotton thread, tapes and specialties, and the demand for his goods is so great that he experiences much difficulty in supplying his agents in New York, Chicago and Boston. In 11 years his business has increased four-fold.

In 1893 Mr. Warburton bought the Cooper mills, so called, corner Cottage and Saunders streets, and although his new quarters were thought to be ample for 10 years' growth, he finds that by the addition of \$3,000 worth of new machinery now ordered and promised by Jan. 1, 1897, nearly all the available space will be taken up.

In national and state affairs, Mr. Warburton is a Republican, but in local matters is guided entirely in his political actions by consideration of the city's best interests, regardless of party.

Sept. 8, 1862, he was married to Jane E. Critchley, daughter of William and Mary Critchley of Portsmouth, N. H., the result of this union being three children: Franklin E., b. in Portsmouth, N.
