# Descendants of John Warburton

## First Generation

1. **John Warburton** was born about 1774 and died in 1844 in Bury, Lancashire aged about 70.

General Notes: John is assumed to be George's father because George names his first child Dinah, presumably after his mother. Wilson Warburton, born 1825 the son of Robert (probably John and Dinah's first child), is living with John and Betty in 1841, and with Betty, then widowed in 1851 as her grandson. However there is no Robert son of John and Betty recorded. If Wilson was named after Dinah Wilson then Betty is John's second wife.

John died between 1841 and 1851 and the only death recorded at Bury where the age at death fits John's census age is that registered in 1q 1844 Bury 21 207, aged 70. Based on his age at death John was born in 1773/4. There is no baptism at St Mary's, Bury that fits exactly, but there is one in 1772, son of John of Bury, one in 1774 son of Thomas of Tottington, and one in 1775 (born 27 Nov 1774) son of Robert of Elton. The last of these is possible as John called his first son Robert.

Noted events in his life were:

- He appeared on the census in 1841 in Bury, Lancashire. John (65) is a cotton weaver living in Back King Street with Betty (60), Wilson (15) a cotton weaver, and Thomas (20) a brass dresser.

John married **Dinah Wilson** on 10 Jul 1797 in Bury, St Mary, Lancashire. Dinah died on 10 May 1808 in Bury, Lancashire and was buried in Bury, St Mary, Lancashire.

Children from this marriage were:

- + 2 M i. **Robert Warburton** was born on 8 Feb 1800 in Bury, Lancashire and was christened on 23 Mar 1800 in Bury, St Mary, Lancashire.
- + 3 M ii. **George Warburton** was born on 10 Dec 1801 in Bury, Lancashire and was christened on 7 Feb 1802 in Bury, St Mary, Lancashire.
- 4 F iii. **Ann Warburton** was born on 21 Nov 1803 in Bury, Lancashire and was christened on 29 Jan 1804 in Bury, St Mary, Lancashire.
- 5 F iv. **Betty Warburton** was born on 2 Dec 1805 in Bury, Lancashire and was christened on 26 Jan 1806 in Bury, St Mary, Lancashire.

John next married **Betty**.

Noted events in her life were:

- She appeared on the census in 1851 in Bury, Lancashire. Betty (70) is a widow living in Back King Street with grandson Wilson (25) a cotton weaver.

The child from this marriage was:

- 6 M i. **Thomas Warburton** was born on 7 May 1822 in Bury, Lancashire and was christened on 25 Aug 1822 in Bury, St Mary, Lancashire.

## Second Generation (Children)

2. **Robert Warburton** (*John*<sup>1</sup>) was born on 8 Feb 1800 in Bury, Lancashire and was christened on 23 Mar 1800 in Bury, St Mary, Lancashire.

Robert married **Rachel Taylor** on 8 Nov 1824 in Bury, St Mary, Lancashire. Rachel was born about 1798, died in 1830 aged about 32, and was buried on 28 Jul 1830 in Heywood, Lancashire.

The child from this marriage was:

- 7 M i. **Wilson Warburton** was born in 1825 in Bury, Lancashire, was christened on 9 Oct 1825 in Bury, St Mary, Lancashire, and died in 1859 in Bury, Lancashire aged 34.

General Notes: Wilson's death was registered in 3q 1859 Bury 8c 221, aged 34.

3. **George Warburton** (*John*<sup>1</sup>) was born on 10 Dec 1801 in Bury, Lancashire and was christened on 7 Feb 1802 in Bury, St Mary, Lancashire.

General Notes: George was a weaver at the time of his marriage. It would seem that George and/or his wife died some time after William was born as there were no more children, and no evidence of them in the 1841 census.

Because there is no evidence to indicate George's age his birth and baptism are speculative, as they are based on the names Dinah (his daughter and presumed mother) and Wilson (his nephew and presumed mother).

# Descendants of John Warburton

George married **Betty Hutchinson** on 21 Jul 1823 in Bury, St Mary, Lancashire.

Children from this marriage were:

- 8 F i. **Dinah Warburton** was born on 4 Aug 1823 in Bury, Lancashire, was christened on 26 Oct 1823 in Bury, St Mary, Lancashire, and died on 27 Nov 1823 in Bury, Lancashire.
- + 9 M ii. **William Warburton** was born on 13 Mar 1825 in Bury, Lancashire, was christened on 14 Mar 1825 in Bury, St Mary, Lancashire, and died in 1892 in Bury, Lancashire aged 67.

## Third Generation (Grandchildren)

**9. William Warburton** (*George<sup>2</sup>, John<sup>1</sup>*) was born on 13 Mar 1825 in Bury, Lancashire, was christened on 14 Mar 1825 in Bury, St Mary, Lancashire, and died in 1892 in Bury, Lancashire aged 67.

General Notes: William's marriage record identifies his father as George. The only baptism at Bury is the son of George and Betty.

William's death is probably that registered in 1q 1892 Bury 8c 425, aged 65.

Noted events in his life were:

- He appeared on the census in 1851 in Bury, Lancashire. William (26) is a cotton weaver living in Back Eden Street with Sarah (26), Jonathan (4), Betty (2), and William Henry (4 months).
- He appeared on the census in 1861 in Bury, Lancashire. William (36) is a labourer at an iron foundry living at 2 Ormerod Street with Sarah (36), Jonathan (14) a mule piecer, Betty (12), William H (10), George T (8), Mary Ellen (6), Ralph (3), and Frederick (2 months).
- He appeared on the census in 1871 in Bury, Lancashire. William (47) is a watchman living at 5 Saleses with Sarah (47), Jonathan (24) a mule spinner, Betty (22) a rover in a card room, William Hy (20) a mule piecer, George Tho (17) a mule piecer, Mary Ellen (15) in a card room, Ralph (13) a mule piecer, Frederick (10) an imbecile, Elizabeth (7), Clara (3), and Ormerod (1).
- He appeared on the census in 1881 in Bury, Lancashire. William (54) is a watchman at an iron foundry living at 105 Rochdale Road with Sarah (55), Beth (32) a cotton rover, William (30) an iron founder, Mary Ellen (25) a cotton rover, Ralph (22) a cotton spinner, Elizabeth (16) a cotton weaver, Clara (13) a cotton weaver, and Ormerod (11).
- He appeared on the census in 1891 in Bury, Lancashire. William (65) is a watchman at an iron works living at 19 New Cedar Street with Sarah (65), William Hy (40) an iron moulder, Elizabeth (26) a cotton weaver, Clara (23) a cotton weaver, Ormerod (21) a frame fitter, and grandson Harry (4).

William married **Sarah Ashworth** on 1 Sep 1846 in Bury, St Mary, Lancashire. Sarah was born on 30 Dec 1825 in Padiham, Lancashire, was christened on 5 Feb 1826 in Padiham, Lancashire, and died in 1904 in Bury, Lancashire aged 79.

Marriage Notes: The marriage was registered in 3q 1846 Bury 21 197. William's father is named George on the parish register.

Noted events in her life were:

- She appeared on the census in 1901 in Bury, Lancashire. Sarah (75) is a widow living at 19 Cedar Street with Elizabeth (36) a cotton weaver, grandson Harry (14) an ironmonger's apprentice, and 3 boarders (the Hollins family). It is not known whose Harry's parents were, but as he seems to living permanently with Sarah and Elizabeth he is possibly Elizabeth's illegitimate son.

Children from this marriage were:

- 10 M i. **Jonathan Warburton** was born on 2 Nov 1846 in Bury, Lancashire and was christened on 25 Dec 1847 in Bury, St Mary, Lancashire.  
General Notes: Johathan's birth was registered in 4q 1846 Bury 21 [4]70.  
Jonathan married **Alice Jane Taylor** in 1873 in Bury, St Paul, Lancashire. Alice was born about 1851 in Bury, Lancashire.  
Marriage Notes: The marriage was registered in 3q 1873 Bury 8c 500. Jonathan and Alice had no children.
- 11 F ii. **Betty Warburton** was born on 5 Oct 1848 in Bury, Lancashire and was christened on 29 Apr 1848 in Bury, St Mary, Lancashire.  
General Notes: Betty's birth was registered in 4q 1848 Bury 21 248.
- + 12 M iii. **William Henry Warburton** was born on 2 Dec 1850 in Bury, Lancashire and was christened on 19 Jan 1851 in Bury, St Mary, Lancashire.

- + 13 M iv. **George Thomas Warburton** was born on 24 Jan 1853 in Bury, Lancashire, was christened on 16 Mar 1853 in Bury, St Mary, Lancashire, and died in 1901 in Bury, Lancashire aged 48.
- 14 F v. **Mary Ellen Warburton** was born on 31 Jul 1855 in Bury, Lancashire and was christened on 21 Dec 1856 in Bury, St Mary, Lancashire.  
General Notes: Mary Ellen's birth was registered in 3q 1855 Bury 8c 346. She was baptised as Mary Ann, but is Mary Ellen in censuses.
- 15 M vi. **Ralph Warburton** was born on 12 Apr 1858 in Bury, Lancashire, was christened on 2 May 1858 in Bury, St Mary, Lancashire, and died on 11 Jun 1927 in Rhode Island aged 69.  
General Notes: Ralph's birth was not registered. It doesn't appear on either FreeBMD or Lancashire BMD. His death record in Rhode Island records his parents, wife, and age of 69.  
Ralph married **Hannah M.**
- 16 M vii. **Frederick Warburton** was born on 4 Jan 1861 in Bury, Lancashire, was christened on 10 Nov 1861 in Bury, St Mary, Lancashire, and died in 1871 in Bury, Lancashire aged 10.  
General Notes: Frederick's birth was registered in 1q 1861 Bury 8c 384. As he is absent from censuses after 1871 his death was probably that registered in 1871 aged 10 (Lancashire BMD reference BS/24/25; the record isn't on FreeBMD - presumably transcription error).
- 17 F viii. **Elizabeth Warburton** was born in 1864 in Bury, Lancashire.  
General Notes: Elizabeth's birth was probably that registered in 3q 1864 Bury 8c 397.
- 18 F ix. **Clara Warburton** was born in 1867 in Bury, Lancashire.  
General Notes: Clara's birth was registered in 4q 1867 Bury 8c 412.
- + 19 M x. **Ormerod Warburton** was born in 1870 in Bury, Lancashire.

## Fourth Generation (Great-Grandchildren)

**12. William Henry Warburton** (*William*<sup>3</sup>, *George*<sup>2</sup>, *John*<sup>1</sup>) was born on 2 Dec 1850 in Bury, Lancashire and was christened on 19 Jan 1851 in Bury, St Mary, Lancashire.

General Notes: William's birth is possibly that registered in 4q 1850 Rochdale 21 742, as there is none that matches in Bury.

Noted events in his life were:

- He appeared on the census in 1901 in Bury, Lancashire. William Henry (50) is an iron moulder living at 29 Foundry Street with Margaret Ann (47), and Fred (3).
- He appeared on the census in 1911 in Bury, Lancashire. William Henry (60) is a plate moulder living at 79 Ingham Street with Margaret Ann (56), and Fred (13), an errand boy. William and Margaret have been married 15 year and had one child still living.

William married **Margaret Sowerby** in 1896 in Bury Register Office, Lancashire. Margaret was born about 1853 in Appleby, Westmoreland.

Marriage Notes: The marriage was registered in 3q 1896 Bury 8c 866.

The child from this marriage was:

- 20 M i. **Fred Warburton** was born in 1898 in Bury, Lancashire.

General Notes: Fred's birth was registered in 2q 1898 Bury 8c 575 (or possibly 626 as there are 2 Freds, but as this Fred was 3 in the 1901 census he must have been born at the end of the first quarter so the lower sequence number is most likely).

**13. George Thomas Warburton** (*William*<sup>3</sup>, *George*<sup>2</sup>, *John*<sup>1</sup>) was born on 24 Jan 1853 in Bury, Lancashire, was christened on 16 Mar 1853 in Bury, St Mary, Lancashire, and died in 1901 in Bury, Lancashire aged 48.

General Notes: Mostly known as Thomas his birth was registered in 1q 1853 Bury 8c 381. His death was registered in 4q 1901 Bury 8c 375, aged 48.

Noted events in his life were:

- He appeared on the census in 1881 in Bury, Lancashire. Thomas (28) is a cotton spinner living at 17 Deal Street with Dorothy (28), Frederick (7), Sarah Ann (5), Emily (2), Frank (2 months), and Charles Haslam (40) a visitor and unemployed engine fitter.



# Descendants of John Warburton

- He appeared on the census in 1891 in Bury, Lancashire. George Tho (38) is a cotton spinner living at 6 Tinline Street with Dorothy (38), Frederick (17) a cotton piecer, Sarah Ann (15) a cotton weaver, Emily (12), Frank (10), Walter (7), Ormerod (5), Edith Mary (3), and Richard H (4 months).
- He appeared on the census in 1901 in Bury, Lancashire. Thomas (48) is a cotton spinner living at 6 Tinline Street with Dorothy (48), Sarah Ann (25) a cotton weaver, Emily (22), Frank (20) a cotton back tenter, Walter (17) a grocer's assistant, Ormerod (15) a coal merchant's clerk, Edith Mary (13) a cotton weaver, Richard Harold (10), and Bertha (7).

George married **Dorothy Haslam** in 1873 in Bury, St Peter, Lancashire. Dorothy was born in 1852 in Liverpool, Lancashire and died in 1906 in Bury, Lancashire aged 54.

Marriage Notes: The marriage was registered in 3q 1873 Bury 8c 506.

Children from this marriage were:

- + 21 M i. **Frederick Warburton** was born in 1873 in Bury, Lancashire.
- 22 F ii. **Sarah Ann Warburton** was born about 1876 in Bury, Lancashire.  
General Notes: Sarah's birth was registered in 1q 1876 Bury 8c 574.
- 23 F iii. **Emily Warburton** was born in 1878 in Bury, Lancashire.  
General Notes: Emily's birth was registered in 3q 1878 Bury 8c 553.
- 24 M iv. **Frank Warburton** was born in 1881 in Bury, Lancashire.  
General Notes: Frank's birth was registered in 1q 1881 Bury 8c 559.  
Noted events in his life were:
  - He appeared on the census in 1911 in Heywood, Lancashire. Frank (30) is a back tenter, cotton mill cardroom living at 3 Lord Street, Heap Bridge. He and his brother Richard (20) is a bricklayer, and sister Bertha (17) no occupation, are boarding with Mrs Carman.
- 25 M v. **Walter Warburton** was born in 1883 in Bury, Lancashire and died in 1903 in Bury, Lancashire aged 20.  
General Notes: Walter's birth was registered in 4q 1883 Bury 8c 513. He is absent from the 1911 census so is probably the Walter whose death was registered in 2q 1903 Bury 8c 364, aged 19.
- 26 M vi. **Ormerod Warburton** was born in 1885 in Bury, Lancashire and died in 1909 in Bury, Lancashire aged 24.  
General Notes: Ormerod's birth was registered in 4q 1885 Bury 8c 536. His death was registered in 1q 1909 Bury 8c 407, aged 23.
- 27 F vii. **Edith Mary Warburton** was born about 1888 in Bury, Lancashire.  
General Notes: Edith's birth was registered in 1q 1888 Bury 8c 573.
- + 28 M viii. **Richard Harold Warburton** was born on 9 Nov 1890 in Bury, Lancashire and died in 1973 in Bury, Lancashire aged 83.
- 29 F ix. **Bertha Warburton** was born in 1893 in Bury, Lancashire.  
General Notes: Bertha's birth was registered in 3q 1893 Bury 8c 695.

## 19. Ormerod Warburton (*William*<sup>3</sup>, *George*<sup>2</sup>, *John*<sup>1</sup>) was born in 1870 in Bury, Lancashire.

General Notes: Ormerod's birth was registered in 1q 1870 Bury 8c 469.

Noted events in his life were:

- He appeared on the census in 1901 in Bury, Lancashire. Ormerod (31) is an engine machine fitter living at 40 Oxford Road with Margaret (31), Harry (3), and a boarder.
- He appeared on the census in 1911 in Bury, Lancashire. Ormerod (41) is a bleaching and finishing machine fitter living at 40 Oxford Road with Margaret (41), and Wilfred (3). Ormerod and Margaret have been married 18 years and had 2 children, one living.

Ormerod married **Margaret Sutcliffe**. Margaret was born about 1870 in Bury, Lancashire.

Children from this marriage were:

- 30 M i. **Harry Warburton** was born in 1897 in Bury, Lancashire and died in 1908 in Bury, Lancashire aged 11.  
General Notes: Harry's birth was registered in 4q 1897 Bury 8c 595, and his death was registered in 3q 1908 Bury 8c 340, aged 10.
- 31 M ii. **Wilfred Warburton** was born in 1907 in Bury, Lancashire.

General Notes: Wilfred's birth was registered in 4q 1907 Bury 8c 550.

## Fifth Generation (Great Great-Grandchildren)

**21. Frederick Warburton** (*George Thomas<sup>4</sup>, William<sup>3</sup>, George<sup>2</sup>, John<sup>1</sup>*) was born in 1873 in Bury, Lancashire.

General Notes: Frederick's birth was registered in 4q 1873 Bury 8c 479. Harry and Rachel had a third child, name unknown, who was not at home in the 1911 census.

Noted events in his life were:

- He appeared on the census in 1901 in Bury, Lancashire. Frederick (27) is a cotton spinner living at 61 St Paul Street with Rachel (28) a cotton weaver.
- He appeared on the census in 1911 in Bury, Lancashire. Frederick (37) is a beaterman's assistant (paper maker) living at 34 Gigg with Rachel (38), Alfred (6), and Harry (4). Frederick and Rachel have been married 11 years and had 3 children, all living.

Frederick married **Rachel Chadderton** in 1900 in Bury, St Paul, Lancashire. Rachel was born about 1872 in Bury, Lancashire.

Marriage Notes: The marriage was registered in 1q 1900 Bury 8c 609.

Children from this marriage were:

32 M i. **Alfred Warburton** was born in 1904 in Bury, Lancashire.

General Notes: Alfred's birth was registered in 2q 1904 Bury 8c 585.

33 M ii. **Harry Warburton** was born in 1907 in Bury, Lancashire.

General Notes: Harry's birth was registered in 2q 1907 Bury 8c 578.

Richard's children are identified by their mother's maiden name. There were 2 Warburton-Chadwick marriages in Bury in 1914. The other couple were Jonathon Warburton and Alice Chadwick, who both seemed to have lived into old age, and are therefore candidates for the children's parentage. The eldest child Richard Harold can be fairly certainly tied to Richard on the basis of his name. Stanley is certainly Richard's child as his birth certificate has been checked. It is considered most likely that the subsequent two children also belonged to Richard as 14 years seems a long time to go childless before starting a family, as would be the case if Betty or Maurice were Jonathon's children.

- He appeared on the census in 1911 in Heywood, Lancashire. Richard (20) is a bricklayer living at 3 Lord Street, Heap Bridge. He and his brother Frank (30) a back tenter, cotton mill cardroom, and sister Bertha (17) no occupation, are boarding with Mrs Carman.

Richard married **Betsy Chadwick** in 1914 in Bury, Lancashire. Betsy was born in 1892 in Bury, Lancashire and died in 1977 in Bury, Lancashire aged 85.

## First Generation

General Notes: The early Warburtons of Turton are pieced together from a few IGI entries and extant wills. Baptisms for St Annes, Turton are on Lancashire Parishes Online but there are no entries for 1728-69 (either because they were not recorded or have been lost). The church was rebuilt around 1770 so it is possible many if not all baptisms took place elsewhere, for example at Bolton, St. Peter whose records are, for the most part, not yet included on Lancashire Parishes On-line.

Thomas is only known from his will, signed in 1672 and proved in 1674. He also left an inventory valued at over £200 and dated 25th July 1674. His estate was split between his wife, Ellen, son James, and grandson James.

Son George received The Stones, and son James received Thirkhams after 12 years. There are also bequests to the children of son John (presumably deceased) and four unnamed daughters.

Michael Wood's tree on Ancestry includes George (1750) and James (1760) but does not link them. Both are also included in Family Search pedigree files. However there are other IGI files which identify 7 children of John Warburton and Elizabeth Halliwell, and although the dates are obviously estimates they are based on John and Elizabeth's marriage date, and correspond with the children described in the will.

It seems that sons George and James both married an Ann Kay. There are separate dates on IGI for the marriages, and both James and George's children's baptisms name their mother as Ann Kay. This precludes George (1750) from being James's brother as he is said to have married a Jenny. Also George and Jenny's son George was baptised, at Deane which is in south Bolton whereas Turton is north of Bolton.

Neither his baptism nor his first marriage have been found in parish records (not much of Holywell is online).

A good match for John's death is that registered in 1q 1886 West Derby 8b 306. aged 77.

There are three unusual family members present in censuses.

1. Grandson Albert, born about 1862 is present in 1871 and 1881, but there is no matching birth registration, and no entries in other censuses. There is however an Albert Parry, registered at Runcorn in 4q 1862 (8a 199), and baptised at Frodsham on November 23rd the son of Martha (father's name is crossed out). There are also later census entries for Albert Parry born at Netherton and living in Everton.

2. Martha is present in 1871, described as daughter but aged 59, born in Frodsham. This is probably Albert's mother Martha Parry (sometimes Perry), aged 29. A Martha Perry was baptised on January 3rd 1841 daughter of Elizabeth a spinster of Netherton, where Elizabeth's father lived. Martha would have been born 2 years after the death of Elizabeth's first husband. The birth was registered in 4q 1841 Runcorn 19 184. A Martha Parry/Perry born in Netherton can be found as a servant in the 1851 and 1861 censuses.

3. Joseph aged 66, born Holywell is described as father (logically John's, then aged 72). It is unclear whose father Joseph is. Elizabeth's father was John Prince, and John's father Joseph was already deceased when he married Elizabeth in 1845. There is no equivalent Joseph in other censuses, but there is a Joseph Perry/Parry of a similar age, from Flintshire in 1851, and Wales in 1861. Joseph is possibly a relation of Elizabeth's via her first marriage.

Noted events in his life were:

- He appeared on the census in 1851 in Frodsham, Cheshire. John (42) is a stonecutter, born in Ince, lodging with his father-in-law John Prince (70) in Netherton with Elizabeth (34), Sarah (6), Joseph (4), and Thomas (1).
- He appeared on the census in 1861 in Frodsham, Cheshire. John (45) is a stone quarrier, born in Wales, lodging with his father-in-law John Prince (80) in Netherton with Elizabeth (46) formerly a dairy maid, Sarah (15), Thomas (11), and John (8).
- He appeared on the census in 1871 in Everton, Liverpool, Lancashire. John (65) is a labourer at the docks, born in Holywell, Flintshire living at 56 Torr Street with Elizabeth (52), Joseph (26) a railway porter, John (19), Martha (? transcribed as a daughter aged 59) a laundress out of employment, and grandson Albert (8)
- He appeared on the census in 1881 in Everton, Liverpool, Lancashire. John (75) is a dock labourer, born in Wales living at 56 Torr Street with Elizabeth (63), John (29) a grocer, grandson Albert (18) a dock labourer, and Joseph (66) a dock labourer described as father born in Holywell.

John married **Elizabeth Prince** on 27 Dec 1845 in Frodsham, Cheshire. Elizabeth was born about 1816 and died in 1886 aged about 70.
