# Descendants of Thomas Warburton

## First Generation

### 1. Thomas Warburton.

General Notes: This family is based on information provided by David Warburton.

The closest marriage in time and place is to Ann Walch on 30th March 1823 at Bolton, St Peters. This is 9 weeks before John was baptised. This is confirmed as correct as Ann's maiden name is given on the baptisms of her children which are in the Nonconformist Register RG4-8, and listed on Lancashire Parishes Online.

There is no obvious census record for Thomas, his wife Ann, or children John and Betty in 1841 or 1851. George and Ann are possibly those living with Thomas and Betty Simpson at Turton in 1841.

Thomas married **Ann Walsh** on 30 Mar 1823 in Bolton, St Peter, Lancashire.

Marriage Notes: Ann's name is spelt Walch in the register.

Children from this marriage were:

- 2 M i. **John Warburton** was born on 18 Apr 1823 in Holme's, Sharples, Lancashire and was christened on 8 Jun 1823 in Walmsley Presbyterian Chapel, Lancashire.
- + 3 M ii. **George Warburton** was born on 26 Jan 1826 in Holmes's, Sharples, Lancashire, was christened on 26 Mar 1826 in Walmsley Presbyterian Chapel, Lancashire, and died in 1910 in Bolton, Lancashire aged 84.
- 4 F iii. **Betty Warburton** was born on 5 Jun 1830 in Ferneysides, Little Lever, Bolton, Lancashire and was christened on 5 Aug 1830 in Walmsley Presbyterian Chapel, Lancashire.
- 5 F iv. **Ann Warburton** was born on 11 Jan 1833 in Ferneysides, Little Lever, Bolton, Lancashire and was christened on 17 Apr 1833 in Walmsley Presbyterian Chapel, Lancashire.

## Second Generation (Children)

**3. George Warburton** (*Thomas<sup>1</sup>*) was born on 26 Jan 1826 in Holmes's, Sharples, Lancashire, was christened on 26 Mar 1826 in Walmsley Presbyterian Chapel, Lancashire, and died in 1910 in Bolton, Lancashire aged 84.

General Notes: George's baptism is in the Nonconformist Register RG4-8. His death is probably that registered in 1q 1910 Bolton 8c 272, aged 83.

Noted events in his life were:

- He appeared on the census in 1841 in Turton, Lancashire. George (15) is possibly the George who is living with Thomas and Betty Simpson at (looks like) St Warburton's Houses together with Ann (8) who is the correct age for George's sister.
- He appeared on the census in 1851 in Hindley, Lancashire. George (25) is a butcher living in Chapel Green with Elizabeth (29), and Thomas B (4).
- He appeared on the census in 1861 in Hindley, Lancashire. George Warbutton (35) is a butcher and ginger beer manufacturuer living in Bridge Street with Elizabeth (38) a confectioner, Thomas (14), and Mary Redmeyne (10) a visitor.
- He appeared on the census in 1871 in Hindley, Lancashire. George (45) is a farmer of 6 acres living in Bridge Street with Elizabeth (48).
- He appeared on the census in 1881 in Bolton, Lancashire. George (55) is probably the widowed horse dealer living at 74 Kay Street.
- He appeared on the census in 1891 in Bolton, Lancashire. George (64) is a foreman in a brewery living at 18 Cannon Street with Mary (62), and a boarder.
- He appeared on the census in 1901 in Bolton, Lancashire. George (75) is a provisiions dealer living at 10 King Street, with Mary (72).

George married **Elizabeth Bland** on 23 Feb 1846 in Preston, St John, Lancashire. Elizabeth was born about 1821 in Sharples, Lancashire and died in 1878 aged about 57.

Marriage Notes: The marriage was registered in 1q 1846 Preston 21 466.

General Notes: Elizabeth's death is probably that registered in 4q 1878 Bolton 8c 257, aged 57

The child from this marriage was:

- + 6 M i. **Thomas Bland Warburton** was born on 5 Sep 1846 in Lancaster, Lancashire and died in 1924 in Hindley,

Lancashire aged 78.

George next married **Mary Harrison** on 20 Jun 1883 in Bolton, Holy Trinity, Lancashire. Mary was born about 1828 in Long Preston, Yorkshire.

Marriage Notes: The marriage was registered in 2q 1883 Bolton 8c 336.

General Notes: Mary's maiden name was Moorbys, father William. She was a widow when she married George.

## Third Generation (Grandchildren)

**6. Thomas Bland Warburton** (*George<sup>2</sup>, Thomas<sup>1</sup>*) was born on 5 Sep 1846 in Lancaster, Lancashire and died in 1924 in Hindley, Lancashire aged 78.

General Notes: Thomas is just Thomas on his birth registration but is sometimes Thomas Bland in censuses. He was born at 34 Bridge Lane, Lancaster. His father's occupation was butcher.

Several of Thomas's children's births were registered as Warbutton, others as Warburton. Of their 12 children, eleven are found in censuses. The 12th is presumed to be Thomas Bland Warburton, who died aged 2 in 1887, on the basis of his name and his registration district on LancashireBMD. In total four had died by the 1911 census. In addition to Thomas Bland, these are assumed to include eldest sons George and Thomas, as both names were reused. George only appears in the 1871 census and there is a death registration with the correct age and place. Similarly Thomas only appears in the 1881 census and there is a probable death registration, although the age is given as 12 when it should be 11. The fourth death is assumed to be Mary Ann as she is only found in the 1891 census and there is a death registration that fits. Of the other eight, six have been found in the 1911 census, but Elizabeth and George have yet to be identified.

Noted events in his life were:

- He appeared on the census in 1871 in Hindley, Lancashire. Thomas Bland (24) is a butcher living in Larner Street with Lucy (23), and George (6 months)
- He appeared on the census in 1881 in Hindley, Lancashire. Thomas Bland (34) is a master butcher living at 43 Chapel Green (house and shop) with Lucy (33), Thomas (8), Elizabeth (6), Lucy (4), John Charnock (3), and Ellen Mary (1).
- He appeared on the census in 1891 in Hindley, Lancashire. Thomas (44) is a butcher living at 3 Close Street with Lucy (43), Elizabeth (16), Lucy (14), John Charnock (13), Ellen Mary (11), Anne (9), Emily Florence (7), George (4), and Mary Ann (2).
- He appeared on the census in 1901 in Hindley, Lancashire. Thomas Bland (54) is a butcher/slaughterman living at 3 Close Street with Lucy (53), George (14) a cardboard box maker, and Alpheus Fred'k (9).
- He appeared on the census in 1911 in Hindley, Lancashire. Thomas Bland (64) is a dattler/underground labourer at a colliery and living at 3 Close Street, Castle Hill, with Lucy (63), daughter Lucy Partington (34) a weaver who has been married 11 years and had 3 children, Thomas Partington (11), and Fred Partington (5). Thomas and Lucy have been married 40 years and had 12 children, 8 still living.

Thomas married **Lucy Charnock** on 22 May 1870 in Hindley, Lancashire. Lucy was born on 26 Jun 1847 in Wigan, Lancashire, was christened on 25 Jul 1847 in Wigan, Lancashire, and died in 1917 in Rochdale, Lancashire aged 70.

Marriage Notes: The marriage was registered in 2q 1870 Wigan 8c 30.

General Notes: Lucy's death is probably that registered as Lucy Warbutton in 1q 1917 Rochdale 8e 5, aged 69 .

Children from this marriage were:

- 7 M i. **George Warburton** was born in 1870 in Hindley, Lancashire and died in 1877 in Hindley, Lancashire aged 7.  
General Notes: George's birth was registered in 3q 1870 Wigan 8c 87. His death was registered in 3q 1877 Wigan 8c 53, aged 6.
- 8 M ii. **Thomas Warburton** was born in 1872 in Hindley, Lancashire, died in 1883 in Hindley, Lancashire aged 11, and was buried on 27 Sep 1883.  
General Notes: Thomas's birth was registered in 2q 1872 Wigan 8c 83. His death was registered as Warbutton in 3q 1883 Wigan 8c 57, aged 12.
- 9 F iii. **Elizabeth Warburton** was born in 1874 in Hindley, Lancashire and died on 31 Dec 1921 aged 47.  
General Notes: Elizabeth's birth was registered in 2q 1874 Wigan 8c 85. Lizzie and Robert lived in Ladies Lane, Hindley and had one son, Cornelius who was killed in WW1. Lizzie never got over his death and died in 1921.  
Elizabeth married **Robert William Clarke**. Robert died on 31 Jan 1945.

# Descendants of Thomas Warburton

General Notes: Robert was a coal dealer.

- 10 F iv. **Lucy Warburton** was born in 1876 in Hindley, Lancashire and died on 13 Mar 1946 aged 70.

General Notes: Lucy's birth was registered in 2q 1876 Wigan 8c 100. She had a fourth child circa 1914-15, father unknown, presumably after Arthur went to America.

Noted events in her life were:

- She appeared on the census in 1911 in Hindley, Lancashire. Lucy (34) is a weaver, She and 2 sons are staying with her parents. She had been married for 11 years and had 3 children, all living.

Lucy married **Arthur Partington** in 1899 in Hindley, All Saints, Lancashire. Arthur died on 18 Feb 1921 in New Bedford, Massachusetts.

Marriage Notes: The marriage was registered in 3q 1899 Wigan 8c 46. Lucy and Arthur had three children, Thomas, Frederick and Edna.

General Notes: Arthur went to America with the intention his family would follow, but Lucy refused to go.

- + 11 M v. **John Charnock Warburton** was born in 1878 in Hindley, Lancashire.

- 12 F vi. **Ellen Mary Warburton** was born in 1879 in Hindley, Lancashire and was buried in Haigh, St David, Lancashire.

General Notes: Ellen's birth was registered in 3q 1879 Wigan 8c 93. She and her husband lived in Mawdsley for many years. She lived with brother George for a short time after her husband's death.

Noted events in her life were:

- She appeared on the census in 1901 in Lowton, Lancashire. Ellen M (21), and Ann (19) are servants to Ann Green, a widow, at Oaklands, 184 Newton Road.
- She appeared on the census in 1911 in Haigh, Wigan, Lancashire. John Peter Sharrock (26) a dairy farmer, and Ellen Mary Sharrock (30) are living at 35 Haigh Road. Also present is Ellen's brother Alpheus (19) a horseman (or houseman) on the farm. John and Ellen have been married 2 years and had no children.

Ellen married **John Peter Sharrock** in 1908 in Haigh, St David, Lancashire. John was born about 1884 and was buried in Haigh, St David, Lancashire.

Marriage Notes: The marriage was registered in 3q 1908 Wigan 8c 47.

General Notes: John died after being knocked down in the early 1960s outside his home Smithy Cottage, near Leyland.

- 13 F vii. **Ann Warburton** was born in 1881 in Hindley, Lancashire.

General Notes: Ann's birth was registered in 4q 1881 Wigan 8c 85.

Noted events in her life were:

- She appeared on the census in 1901 in Lowton, Lancashire. Ellen M (21), and Ann (19) are servants to Ann Green, a widow, at Oaklands, 184 Newton Road.
- She appeared on the census in 1911 in Lowton, Lancashire. Ann (29) and Gilbert Jones (25) a domestic gardener are living at 173 Church Lane, with 2 children. They had been married 6 years and had 2 children, both living.

Ann married **Gilbert Jones** in 1904 in Hindley, All Saints, Lancashire. Gilbert was born about 1885 in Lowton, Lancashire.

Marriage Notes: The marriage was registered in 4q 1904 Wigan 8c 38.

- 14 F viii. **Emily Florence Warburton** was born in 1883 in Hindley, Lancashire.

General Notes: Emily's birth was registered in 3q 1883 Wigan 8c 99.

Noted events in her life were:

- She appeared on the census in 1911 in Newhey, Rochdale, Lancashire. Frank (26) a joiner calico printing, and Emily Florence Roberts (24) are living at 4 Spring Hole, with their 2 children. They had been married 6 years and had 2 children, both living.

Emily married **Frank Roberts** in 1904 in Aspull, St Elizabeth, Lancashire.

Marriage Notes: The marriage was registered in 4q 1904 Wigan 8c 17.

- 15 M ix. **Thomas Bland Warburton** was born in 1885 in Hindley, Lancashire and died in 1887 in Hindley, Lancashire aged 2.

# Descendants of Thomas Warburton

General Notes: Thomas's birth was registered in 1q 1885 Wigan 8c 97. His death was registered in 3q 1887 Wigan 8c 49, aged 2.

- 16 M x. **George Warburton** was born in 1886 in Hindley, Lancashire.

General Notes: George's birth was registered in 3q 1886 Wigan 8c 86. He has not been found in the 1911 census but it is known from the family that he married and lived in the Blackburn area. He lived into the 1960s.

- 17 F xi. **Mary Ann Warburton** was born in 1888 in Hindley, Lancashire and died in 1894 in Hindley, Lancashire aged 6.

General Notes: Mary's birth was registered in 4q 1888 Wigan 8c 102. Her death was registered in 1q 1894 Wigan 8c 55, aged 5.

- 18 M xii. **Alpheus Frederick Warburton** was born in 1891 in Hindley, Lancashire and died on 7 Feb 1960 in Standish, Lancashire aged 69.

General Notes: Alpheus's birth was registered in 3q 1891 Wigan 8c 90 under the name Warbutton. He was living at Brooklands, Wigan Road, Standish at the time of his death. His grandson David is my contact.

Noted events in his life were:

- He appeared on the census in 1911 in Haigh, Wigan, Lancashire. Alpheus (19) is a horseman (or houseman) on the farm, living at 35 Haigh Road with brother-in-law John Peter Sharrock (26) a dairy farmer, and Ellen Mary Sharrock (30). John and Ellen have been married 2 years and had no children. Alpheus is transcribed as Alpheaus Frederick Warbrick on FindMyPast.

Alpheus married **Margaret Preston** in 1912 in Wigan, All Saints, Lancashire. Margaret was born about 1891 and died in Nov 1958 in Standish, Lancashire aged about 67.

Marriage Notes: The marriage was registered in 4q 1912 Wigan 8c 111.

General Notes: Margaret was living at Brooklands, Wigan Road, Standish at the time of her death.

## Fourth Generation (Great-Grandchildren)

11. **John Charnock Warburton** (*Thomas Bland*<sup>3</sup>, *George*<sup>2</sup>, *Thomas*<sup>1</sup>) was born in 1878 in Hindley, Lancashire.

General Notes: John's birth was registered in 1q 1878 Wigan 8c 116.

Several of John's children's births were registered as Warbutton, others as Warburton.

Noted events in his life were:

- He appeared on the census in 1901 in Hindley, Lancashire. John Charnock Warbutton (23) is a coal hewer (below) living at 248 Sandy Lane with Elizabeth (21), and John (5 months).
- He appeared on the census in 1911 in Hindley, Lancashire. John Charnock (33) is a coal miner (hewer) living at 13 Thomas Street, Hindley Green with Elizabeth (31), John (10), Lucy (9), Clara (7), and Isabella (2). John and Elizabeth have been married 11 years and had 4 children, all living.

John married **Elizabeth Hammond** in 1900 in Aspull, St Elizabeth, Lancashire. Elizabeth was born about 1879 in Aspull, Lancashire.

Marriage Notes: The marriage was registered in 1q 1900 Wigan 8c 13.

Children from this marriage were:

- 19 M i. **John Warburton** was born in 1900 in Hindley, Lancashire.

General Notes: John's birth was registered in 4q 1900 Wigan 8c 97.

- 20 F ii. **Lucy Warburton** was born in 1902 in Hindley, Lancashire.

General Notes: Lucy's birth was registered in 1q 1902 Wigan 8c 116.

- 21 F iii. **Clara Warburton** was born in 1903 in Hindley, Lancashire.

General Notes: Clara's birth was registered in 1q 1904 Wigan 8c 88, but she is listed under 1903 on LancashireBMD, suggesting she was born at the end of 1903, and registered the following year.

- 22 F iv. **Isabella Warburton** was born in 1908 in Hindley, Lancashire.

General Notes: Isabella's birth was registered in 1q 1909 Wigan 8c 81, but she is listed under 1908 on LancashireBMD, suggesting she was born at the end of 1908, and registered the following year.

- 23 M v. **William Warburton** was born in 1911 in Hindley, Lancashire.

## First Generation

### 1. James Warburton.

General Notes: This family is based on information provided by Robin Hunt. Robin's tree equates this James with the son of Thomas Warburton and Susan Barnes of Haslingden, who was baptised at Haslingden, St James on January 25th 1769.

However there are a number of Jameses born in Haslingden, Tottington, and Bury between 1755 and 1770 who could be this James, especially as he was already married and widowed before he married Ann, and so could be much older than 23, the age of the son of Thomas and Susan in 1792.

James is a weaver on his marriage record, a carter on John's baptism, and a machine maker, like son John on John's second wedding declaration.

James married **Ann Smith** on 23 Apr 1792 in Bury, St Mary, Lancashire. Ann was born in 1770 in Bury, Lancashire.

Children from this marriage were:

- 2 M i. **James Warburton** was born on 8 Jan 1794 and was christened on 16 Feb 1794 in Radcliffe, Stand Unitarian Chapel, Lancashire.

General Notes: James's parents are named James and Ann on his baptism.

- + 3 M ii. **John Warburton** was born on 27 Jul 1795 in Tottington, Lancashire, was christened on 4 Oct 1795 in Radcliffe, Stand Unitarian Chapel, Lancashire, and died on 18 May 1872 in Mountain Clayton, Bradford, Yorkshire aged 76.

## Second Generation (Children)

**3. John Warburton** (*James<sup>1</sup>*) was born on 27 Jul 1795 in Tottington, Lancashire, was christened on 4 Oct 1795 in Radcliffe, Stand Unitarian Chapel, Lancashire, and died on 18 May 1872 in Mountain Clayton, Bradford, Yorkshire aged 76.

General Notes: John's parents are named as James and Ann Smith on an IGI pedigree file.

John declared his father to be James, a machine maker, on his second marriage. He also declared his age on that marriage, and on 3 censuses, and it was also stated on his death certificate. If his age was accurate in all cases he was born between 3rd September 1793 and late March 1794. Finally his declared place of birth was Tottington on two censuses.

I can find no on-line record of a John son of James born in this timeframe at Tottington or elsewhere nearby, though this doesn't preclude an unrecorded nonconformist baptism. The nearest is the one documented for him as born 27th July 1795, and baptised on October 4th at Stand Unitarian Chapel, father James Warburton, a carter to Mr Potter. The chapel is which is in Whitefield, part of the Radcliffe parish. As this is a nonconformist baptism it is perhaps understandable that they may need to travel 6 miles to go to the church they want.

Another child, James was baptised in 1794, son of James and Ann, so although John's mother is not named on his baptism she is probably Ann. The chapel's baptism records do not give the parents abode so James and Ann can't be shown to have lived in Tottington.

John's death registration is in 2q 1872 Bradford 9b 138, aged 78. He was described as a mechanic and died of heart disease.

Noted events in his life were:

- He appeared on the census in 1841 in Hartwith cum Winsley, Yorkshire. John (48) is a mechanic living at New York with Mary (47), George (17) a mechanic, Jane (14) and Elizabeth (12) th[ro]stle spinners, Isaac (10), John (7), and Grace (4).
- He appeared on the census in 1851 in Hartwith cum Winsley, Yorkshire. John (57) is a machine maker foreman living at New York with Mary (56), Isaac (19) and John (16) machine maker apprentices, Grace (14), and granddaughter Mary Bromley (9).
- He appeared on the census in 1861 in Clayton, Yorkshire. John (67) is a worsted machine maker living at Patchetts with Nancy (66). This should presumably be Mary.
- He appeared on the census in 1871 in Bradford, Yorkshire. John (77) is a worsted machine maker living at Mountain with Elizabeth (61).

John married **Mary Crowder** on 7 Nov 1814 in Halifax, Yorkshire. Mary was born in 1794 in Rastrick, Yorkshire, was christened on 9 Apr 1794 in Radcliffe, St Mary, Lancashire, and died on 9 Mar 1869 in Mountain Clayton, Bradford, Yorkshire aged 75.

General Notes: Mary was a dissenting non-conformist. She died aged 75, wife of John a mechanic, of paralysis.

Children from this marriage were:

- 4 M i. **James Warburton** was born on 12 Jan 1815 in Brighouse, Yorkshire.  
General Notes: James has not been documented fully but he had a daughter with each wife, and is in censuses until at least 1871.  
James married **Elizabeth**.  
James next married **Susannah Waite** on 25 Aug 1849 in Hartwith Chapel, Yorkshire.  
Marriage Notes: James was of full age, a widower and mechanic of Hartwith, father John, a mechanic. Susannah was of full age, a spinster of Hartwith, father Joseph, a spinning master.
- 5 F ii. **Eliza Warburton** was born on 15 May 1817 in Bradford, Yorkshire and was christened on 4 Mar 1818 in Bradford, Horton Lane Independent Chapel, Yorkshire.
- 6 F iii. **Harriet Warburton** was born on 24 Feb 1819 in Bradford, Yorkshire.
- 7 F iv. **Ann Warburton** was born on 9 Apr 1822 in Bradford, Yorkshire.  
Ann married **Mark Bramley** on 4 Jul 1840 in Hartwith Chapel, Yorkshire. Mark was born in 1818.  
Marriage Notes: Both were of full age, Mark was a thread maker of Hartwith, father Henry a labourer. Ann was a spinster of Hartwith, father John, a mechanic.
- 8 M v. **George Warburton** was born in 1823 in Bradford, Yorkshire.  
General Notes: George has not been found in censuses after 1841.
- 9 F vi. **Elizabeth Warburton** was born in 1825 in Bradford, Yorkshire.
- 10 F vii. **Jane Warburton** was born in 1827 in Brighouse, Yorkshire.  
Jane married **John Wilkinson** on 24 Jul 1848 in Hartwith Chapel, Yorkshire. John was born in 1828 in Hartwith, Yorkshire and died in 1867 aged 39.  
Marriage Notes: Both were of full age. John was a tailor from Hartwith, father Peter, a tailor. Jane was from Hartwith, father John, a mechanic. John and Jane had six sons and five daughters.
- + 11 M viii. **Isaac Warburton** was born in 1831 in Hartwith, Yorkshire, was christened on 13 May 1831, died on 8 Oct 1917 in Rotherham, Yorkshire aged 86, and was buried in Moorgate.
- 12 M ix. **Joseph Warburton** was born in 1833 in Hartwith, Yorkshire.  
General Notes: Joseph probably died young as he doesn't appear in censuses.
- 13 M x. **John Warburton** was born in 1834 in Hartwith, Yorkshire and was christened in Dacre Providence Independant Chapel, Yorkshire.  
General Notes: John has not been found in censuses after 1851.
- 14 F xi. **Grace Warburton** was born in 1837 in Hartwith, Yorkshire.  
Grace married **William Benson** on 12 Nov 1853 in Skipton Register Office, Yorkshire.  
Marriage Notes: William was of full age, a manager in a flax mill, living in New York, Hartwith. Grace was a minor of Chancery Lane, Skipton, father John, a mechanic.

John next married **Elizabeth Skillington** on 2 Sep 1869 in Leeds, St Peter, Yorkshire. Elizabeth was born in 1808 in Winksley, Yorkshire and died in 1879 in Bradford, Yorkshire aged 71.

Marriage Notes: The marriage was registered in 3q 1869 Leeds 9b 597. John (75) was a widower and machine maker living in Hunslet Road, father James Warburton, machine maker. Elizabeth (59) was a widow living in Hunslet Road, father Thomas Hullah, a grocer.

## Third Generation (Grandchildren)

**11. Isaac Warburton** (*John*<sup>2</sup>, *James*<sup>1</sup>) was born in 1831 in Hartwith, Yorkshire, was christened on 13 May 1831, died on 8 Oct 1917 in Rotherham, Yorkshire aged 86, and was buried in Moorgate.

General Notes: Isaac's death was registered in 1917, a retired water meter maker aged 86, at South View, Wellgate, of cerebral softening.

Family stories:

Isaac was a "little mester" at Beaton Clark brass foundry. As such he had a work gang, and he received payment for the gang from the employer and then paid out the rest of the gang. He wasn't popular because he was thought to be receiving the lion's share.

He lived at Southview, Wellgate Mount, Rotherham. The house had a music room, a garden with nectarines growing up a wall, and a tennis court. The house no longer exists, the space currently being a car park.

Isaac did his own gardening, and was also a music teacher. He is recorded as the organist of Greesborough Church in 1879.

His wife Jemima was 9 years his senior.

Noted events in his life were:

- He appeared on the census in 1861 in Kimberworth, Yorkshire. Isaac (29) is a machinist living in Mary Street with Jemima (38), Kate L (6), and John Tho (3).
- He appeared on the census in 1871 in Rotherham, Yorkshire. Isaac (39) is a machinist water meter living at 35 Wellgate Mt., Wellgate with Jemima (50), Kate L (16), John T (13), and Mary A (11).
- He appeared on the census in 1881 in Rotherham, Yorkshire. Isaac (49) is a machinist (water meter) living at 35 Wellgate Mt. with Jemima (60), Mary A (21), nephew Alfred Wilkinson (22) a brass worker, and a servant.
- He appeared on the census in 1891 in Rotherham, Yorkshire. Isaac (59) is a machinist for water living at Wellgate Mount (South View) with granddaughter Clara J (9), and a servant.
- He appeared on the census in 1901 in Rotherham, Yorkshire. Isaac (69) is a widowed machinist of water meters in a Brass Works, living at 35 Wellgate Mount with daughter Kate L. Barlow (46) a widowed housekeeper, and her children Florence W (24), William E (23), and Ernest (21), and granddaughter Clara J Warburton (19).
- He appeared on the census in 1911 in Rotherham, Yorkshire. Isaac (79) is a widowed machinist in a brass manufacturer, living at 35 Wellgate Mount with daughter Kate Laurette Barlow (56) and her 3 children

Isaac married **Jemima Howden** on 31 Dec 1853 in Masbrough Independant Chapel, Yorkshire. Jemima was born in 1820, was christened on 19 Nov 1820 in Fishlake, Yorkshire, and died on 10 Oct 1891 in Rotherham, Yorkshire aged 71.

Marriage Notes: Isaac (23) was amechanic from Thornhill, Masborough, father John, a machine maker. Jemima (30) was a spinster from Doncaster Gate, Rotherham, father Thomas, a farm labourer.

General Notes: Jemima died at Wellgate Mount, aged 70, of cerebral paralysis, asthma, cardiac disease, dilatation, and albumisunia.

Children from this marriage were:

- 15 F i. **Kate Laurette Warburton** was born on 3 Sep 1854 in Masbrough, Yorkshire and died on 15 Aug 1936 in Sheffield, Yorkshire aged 81.
- General Notes: Kate was born at Thornhill, Masbrough, and the birth was registered on October 9th by her father who was described as a mechanic. She died at 689 Abbeydale Road, Sheffield, aged 81, of senile decay. She was the widow of John William Barlow, a gentleman's hosier.
- Family stories:
- Kate was a very mean person When her parents went on holiday leaving her in charge of the house she refused to use food from the full pantry and brother John Thomas had to buy himself pikelets which made him ill. When old she lived in lodgings and stored bits of crust in a drawer in case she became hungry.
- Kate married **John William Barlow** on 11 Apr 1876 in Eastwood, St Stephen, Yorkshire. John was born in 1851 in Oakham, Yorkshire and died on 20 May 1883 in Rotherham, Yorkshire aged 32.
- Marriage Notes: John (25) was a draper from Leicester, father John Dennis, a builder. Kate (21) was living in Eastwood, father Isaac, a machinist. Isaac and Mary Ann Warburton were witnesses. Kate and John had two sons and a daughter.
- + 16 M ii. **John Thomas Warburton** was born on 6 Feb 1858 in Masbrough, Yorkshire and died on 29 Sep 1947 in Rotherham, Yorkshire aged 89.
- 17 F iii. **Mary Ann Warburton** was born on 14 Oct 1859 in Masbrough, Yorkshire.
- General Notes: Mary was born in Mary Street. Her birth was registered October 21st by her father Isaac, a machinist. In the 1911 census her husband was described as a journalist and newspaper reporter.
- Mary married **Willis Brunt** on 14 May 1884 in Rotherham, All Saints, Yorkshire. Willis was born on 2 Jun 1857 in Rotherham, Yorkshire.

Marriage Notes: Willis (26) was a reporter from Altrincham, father Thomas a colliery deputy. Mary (24) was a spinster from Rotherham, father Isaac, a music teacher. Mary and Willis had three sons.

- 18 F iv. **Lizzie Howden Warburton** was born on 4 Oct 1861 in Masbrough, Yorkshire and died on 11 Sep 1863 in Masbrough, Yorkshire aged 1.

General Notes: Lizzie was born in Mary Street. her birth was registered on October 31st by her mother Jemima, formerly Howden. Her father was Isaac, a machinist. She died aged 33 months of hooping cough, and teething at 3 Mary Street. Her death was registered on September 12th by father Isaac.

## Fourth Generation (Great-Grandchildren)

**16. John Thomas Warburton** (*Isaac*<sup>3</sup>, *John*<sup>2</sup>, *James*<sup>1</sup>) was born on 6 Feb 1858 in Masbrough, Yorkshire and died on 29 Sep 1947 in Rotherham, Yorkshire aged 89.

General Notes: John was born in Mary Street Masbrough. His birth was registered by his mother Jemima on March 29th naming his father Isaac, a mechanic.

Family Stories:

John's father wanted him to be a lawyer but he was spoilt. He travelled by pony and was a weekly boarder at Roche Abbey School. He stayed at school until he was 18.

When he was first married he was living in Manchester with Walter Rogerson and his family. Daughter Clara was born in a pub. By the time Lizzie was born (1883) they had moved back to Sheffield, and then Rotherham.

John worked for Joseph Peck where people bought clothes 'on-tick' and paid weekly. He was suspected of either taking some money, or not keeping proper accounts. His father Isaac saved him from prison twice. He then worked as a rent and debt collector for Thompson and Wright. In later life he was allowed to go into the office whenever he liked but when he was 80 Mr Thompson came to his house to say he had to leave because he was chasing the girls.

He was 'a bit of a lad'. His wife was besotted by him. He was a gambler, and when his father left him £600 he drank and gambled it away saying "I'm not going to leave it to others to piss against the wall". He had lots of friends when he had money, but they disappeared when the money was gone.

He allowed his children to go about in rags. Daughter Anne was never given any money and had to ask her grandfather Isaac for money to buy boots for the children. He was also a moaner. He rented parts of his house to relations but sold it and turned them out on the street.

He then moved in with daughter Annie who hired a solicitor to witness he was living with her to prevent him taking her goods. He used to go with Annie's husband Frederick Bower to Bakewell Fair in Derbyshire and they always brought a present (a tray, basket or trinket) for Annie.

In the war he refused to go down to the air-raid shelter in the cellar, saying he would "die in his bed".

He died at 22 Oakwood Grove, Rotherham, aged 89, a retired accounts clerk, of cardiac muscle failure, cerebral thrombosis, and senility. The informant was daughter Annie Bower.

Noted events in his life were:

- He appeared on the census in 1881 in Chorlton-on-Medlock, Lancashire. Thos (23) is a manager living at 46 Rosamund Street East with the Rogerson family, along with Annie (30).
- He appeared on the census in 1891 in Rotherham, Yorkshire. John T (33) is a clerk living at 17 Frederick Street with Annie (32), Lizzie (8), Annie (5), Betsy (3), and Isaac (1).
- He appeared on the census in 1901 in Rotherham, Yorkshire. John T (43) is a commercial clerk living at 26 York Road with Annie (50), Lizzie (18), Annie (15), Betsy (13), and Isaac (11).
- He appeared on the census in 1911 in Rotherham, Yorkshire. John Thomas (53) is an Accounts clerk with an accountants living at 45 St. Ann's Road with Annie (60), and Isaac (21) a grocer's assistant. John and Annie had been married 30 years and had 5 children, all living.

John married **Annie Gillatt** on 8 Jan 1881 in Chorlton-on-Medlock, St Luke, Lancashire. Annie was born on 25 Dec 1847 in Eccleshall Bierlow, Yorkshire and died on 1 Mar 1917 in Rotherham, Yorkshire aged 69.

Marriage Notes: At the time of their marriage John and Ann were living in Rosamund Street East, with Walter Rogerson

and his family. John (23) was a clerk, father Isaac, a machinist. Annie (30) was a spinster father John, a brewer. Fanny Warburton was a witness.

General Notes: Annie was born at 260 Rockingham Street, Ecclesall Bierlow, father John, a carter, mother Ann, formerly Wheatman. The birth was registered on February 1st 1848 by her mother.

She attended Miss Lettall's school where she learned singing and dancing. She stayed at school until she was 18.

She died at 43 St Ann's Road, Rotherham, aged 65, wife of John Thomas, an accounts clerk, of bronchitis and endocarditis. The death was registered on March 2nd, by daughter Betsy Warburton.

Children from this marriage were:

- 19 F i. **Clara Jemima Warburton** was born on 13 Sep 1881 in Manchester, Lancashire and died on 18 Aug 1960 in Hastings, Sussex aged 78.

General Notes: Clara was born at 38 Seal Street, Manchester, father John Thomas, an office clerk, mother Annie formerly Gillatt. The birth was registered on October 24th by her mother Annie.

Family stories:

She went to live with her grandfather Isaac when her mother was struggling to run a pub and have another child. She was still with him in the 1891 and 1901 censuses. When she could have returned home Isaac said "Only if you want to break my heart".

She met husband Alf Watt at a theatre where they passed notes. St Stephen's church where they married was almost opposite the St Anne's Road house where she lived. Alf was a tall, thin, mean Scot. He took Clara to Gurock in Scotland to look after his aged parents until they died. He also would send her to the market at the last minute so she could buy cheap vegetables.

Alf was a top grade Civil Servant (in the Inland Revenue) and they went to live in Dorchester, and then Hastings. When he retired aged 45 he took on 2 or 3 private clients. When he died he left Clara their bungalow in Park View, Hastings for life, and a small sum of money administered through a solicitor. He wanted the bulk of his estate to go to his side of the family after her death, and it ultimately went to distant cousins in New Zealand.

She had a speech defect and was found dead in her bathroom. She died aged 78 at 12 Park View, Hastings, widow of Alfred James Watt, an income tax consultant, of cerebral thrombosis and hypertension. Her death was registered on August 18th by her sister Annie Bower of 49 Park View, Hastings.

Clara married **Alfred James Watt** on 15 Jan 1919 in Rotherham, St Stephens, Yorkshire. Alfred was born on 23 Jan 1883 in Sheffield, Yorkshire.

Marriage Notes: Alfred (26) was a civil servant of Leathercourt War Signal Station, St Margaret, Dover, father James, a joiner. Clara (37) was a spinster of 43 St Anne's Road, father John Thomas, an accountant.

- 20 F ii. **Lizzie Warburton** was born on 23 Jan 1883 in Sheffield, Yorkshire and died on 18 Aug 1920 in Harwarden, Flintshire aged 37.

General Notes: Lizzie was born at The Railway Hotel, Wicker, Sheffield, father John Thomas, mother Annie, formerly Gillatt, publican. The marriage was registered on March 5th by her father.

Family stories:

At one time Lizzie worked as a hospital nurse at night and carried a gun for protection.

First husband Walter was a forge or furnace man, and a whiskey drinker who died of pneumonia. A cure for pneumonia is to "get up to the crisis" with strong spirits but because Walter drank so much they had no effect.

Lizzie's mother-in-law didn't allow Lizzie any help with the birth of son Henry who weighed 14lbs. It was believed this triggered her cancer. Lizzie's second husband Sam brought up her children after she died, until they left High School.

She died age 37, wife of Samuel Weigh a foreman at Harwarden Bridge Ironworks, at Laburnam Cottage, Aston, Harwarden, Flintshire, of malignant disease of the uterus. The death was registered on August 19th by Samuel Weigh.

Lizzie married **Walter Ward** on 24 Dec 1903 in Kimberworth, Yorkshire. Walter was born on 7 Oct 1871 and

died in 1912 aged 41.

Marriage Notes: Walter (30) was a farmer from Kimberworth, father Henry, a turner. Lizzie (21) was from York Road, father John Thomas a bookkeeper. Walter and Lizzie had a son and daughter.

General Notes: Walter's death is probably that registered in 1q 1912 Rotherham 9c 900, aged 39.

Lizzie next married **Samuel Weigh** on 1 Nov 1919 in Sheffield, St Michael and All Saints, Yorkshire. Samuel was born about 1883 and died in 1950 in Harwarden, Flintshire aged about 67.

Marriage Notes: Samuel (35) was a steelworks foreman of 55 Firs Hill Road, father John, a miner. Lizzie (35) was a widow of 25 Burton Road, father John Thomas, an accountant.

General Notes: Samuel's death is probably that registered in 1q 1950 Harwarden 8a 590, aged 67.

- 21 F iii. **Annie Warburton** was born on 2 Jun 1885 in Eccleshall Bierlow, Yorkshire and died on 26 Mar 1980 in Worthing, West Sussex aged 94.

General Notes: Annie was born at 36 Thorndon Road, Sheffield, father John Thomas a commercial clerk, mother Annie, formerly Gillatt. The birth was registered on July 14th by her father.

Family stories:

Annie would like to have been a dressmaker but her father wouldn't pay the apprentice fee. She and sister Betsey went into service for some farmers in South Mimms, Hertfordshire. They then returned to Rotherham and worked at Horsfalls confectioners and restaurant in the High Street. When Annie was scolded for dropping a dozen diner plates she said, "if you are not satisfied I will go".

Annie later recalled that if you looked up at the ceiling at Horsfalls you could see rats tails hanging down from the many holes in it. It was said that High Street was built on rats, and when a large property was pulled down a swarm of rats ran up Wellgate and then divided, one lot going up Old Hill, and the other up Quarry Hill.

After she was married she would have liked a corner shop, and tried to borrow £110 from friends but was refused.

Annie died at 20 Reigate Road, Worthing, of abdominal aortic aneurysm and generalised arteriosclerosis. The death was registered on May 27th by her daughter Beatrice from Shropshire.

Annie married **Frederick Bower** on 30 Jul 1908 in Northfield, Rotherham, Yorkshire. Frederick was born on 25 Jun 1884 and died in 1967 in Hastings, Sussex aged 83.

Marriage Notes: Annie and Frederick had two daughters including the mother of Robin Hunt.

General Notes: Frederick's death is probably that registered in 2q 1967 Hastings 5h 364, aged 82.

- 22 F iv. **Betsy Warburton** was born on 11 Jan 1888 in Rotherham, Yorkshire and died on 31 Jan 1958 in York, Yorkshire aged 70.

General Notes: Betsy was born at 89 Eldon Road, Eastwood Vale, Rotherham, father John Thomas a commercial clerk, mother Annie, formerly Gillatt. The birth was registered on February 24th by her father.

Family Stories:

Betsy (aka) Betty had a boyfriend Holvey Greetham, a Guardsman, but he was wounded in the First World War and spent his days in a long wicker bath chair. During the war she did housekeeping jobs, and then went to work in the Post Office at St Bartholemew's, London. She came back pregnant and there was dark talk of the "back of the fire".

She met Willy Smart who owned a garage and two charabancs, one of which was called "The Gypsy Love". However he was married. He set her up in West Street with a shop and bakery.

When Willy's wife died he married Betty, with a "push" from his sisters and brother-in-law. Betty ran a cafe popular with local businessmen who came in for lunch. She was a good confectioner.

After living in Greasbrough they returned to Oxford Street, Rotherham. When Willy died he left her with a mortgage so she sold up and went to live with her sister Annie. She worked for Dr Coldray, and Elmhurst solicitors.

When she got the sack she went to Stratford on Avon and met Frank Grix who was in the army at the time. She married him and went to York, but never mentioned she was 20 years older than him. He was horrified to

read her birth certificate when she died.

She died of cancer and was seen in St James's Hospital, Leeds by a nephew who was doing his medical training there. She died in the County Hospital, York, aged 70 of Flat 1 Burton Stone Lane, York, wife of Francis Tomlinson Grix, a railway clerk, of carcinoma of breast with secondaries to lungs. The death was registered on February 1st by Francis.

Betsy married **John William Smart** on 23 Feb 1928 in Rotherham, Yorkshire. John was born in 1872 and died on 19 Feb 1936 in Rotherham, Yorkshire aged 64.

Marriage Notes: The marriage was registered in 1q 1928 Rotherham 9c 895.

General Notes: Francis's death was registered in 2q 1981 York 2 2634, aged 76.

23 M v. **Isaac Warburton** was born on 19 Jun 1889 in Rotherham, Yorkshire and died on 25 Jan 1963 in Rotherham, Yorkshire aged 73.

General Notes: Isaac was born at 17 Frederick Street, Rotherham son of John Thomas a book keeper, and Annie, formerly Gillatt. The birth was registered on August 19th by his father.

Family stories:

Isaac was named after his grandfather in the hope he would follow his character and fortune, but being an only son he was spoilt. In the 1911 census he is a grocer's assistant. He was apprenticed to the grocer Henry Gough.

He joined the Royal Engineers on August 17th 1916 and from October 1916 until December 1918 he served in France as a Permanent Linesman. When he enlisted he was living at 43 St. Anne's Road, and a steelworker at the Rotherham Forge and Rolling Mills.

He later worked at Smart's grocers, and at a motor shop. He also worked on a traction engine for the Work House as a fireman or on the footplate.

He lived for a while with sister Annie and Fred at St Anne's Road, but when they moved to a smaller house and couldn't accommodate him he went to a Mrs Dawson in Carlyle Street.

He had a few girl friends but never married. He liked to be called Ernest and was so called by all but his close family. He liked whiskey.

He died at Moorgate General Hospital, aged 73, a general labourer (retired) of 22 Wharncliffe Street, Rotherham,. He died of myocardial infarction and coronary thrombosis. The death was registered on January 30th by sister Annie. He was buried at Moorgate with his parents. Annie and Fred Bower paid for the funeral as he was without means and would have been buried in a pauper's grave otherwise.

Also Ann is using the name Warburton in the 1871 census though they are not living together. It is likely but uncertain that Ann's son Henry was also Paul's son though he reverted to his mother's name Tait after 1871.

Ann Tait originally married Robert Pope in 1859 so it is possible either Ann, Paul or both were married to others during their relationship. After Paul returned to Oldham, Ann had a child by Robert Porter.

Noted events in his life were:

- He appeared on the census in 1861 in Glasgow, Scotland. Paul (26) is a clogmaker lodging at 18 Saltmarket, Clyde.
- He appeared on the census in 1871 in Glasgow, Scotland. Paul (36) is a patient in City House Hospital, Parliamentary Road.
- He appeared on the census in 1891 in Oldham, Lancashire. Paul (59) is a clog maker lodging at 15 Spring Garden Street.

Paul married **Hannah Jones** on 12 Dec 1853 in Oldham, St Mary, Lancashire. Hannah was born in 1835.

Marriage Notes: Paul was aged 20, father Hiram, Hannah was also 20, father William. The marriage was registered in 4q 1853 Oldham 8d 1008.

Paul next married **Ann Tait**. Marriage status: common law. Ann was born in 1838 in Glasgow, Scotland and died in 1894 in Glasgow, Scotland aged 56.

General Notes: Ann was the daughter of Robert Tait and Ann nee Welsh. Robert was a soldier and is so described on Ann's marriage to Robert Poper. The family are present on the 1841 census in Halifax where Robert is serving in a Temporary Barracks. Ann, aged 5, is said to be born abroad, but in the 1881 census she was born in England.

By 1851 Ann is back in Glasgow with her widowed mother, though her age is now given as 10, and her place of birth is Ireland. She married Robert Pope in 1859, but reverted to her maiden name soon after, suggesting the marriage was unsuccessful. It is possible it was a Catholic marriage so Ann was not free to remarry until Robert died. Her sons Henry (possibly Paul's), and Robert Porter (son of Robert Porter) were both described as illegitimate. They both used the name Tait.
