First Generation

1. Richard Warburton.

This tree has been compiled from a number of sources, some contradictory. These include:

1. A handwritten tree obtained from the late Virginia Warburton detailing the descendants of George Warburton of Aughrim, of whom her husband, Thomas Egerton Warburton, was one. It is in part based on **Burke's Landed Gentry of Great Britain and Ireland for 1852**.
2. A tree prepared for James Arthur Warburton of Prince Edward Island, Canada, by Conrad Swan, York Herald of Arms dated 1st July 1976, together with a memoir written by James Arthur.
3. **Burke's Colonial Gentry**; the entry for Henry Hume Warburton of Vancouver, British Columbia.
4. A tree submitted to www.islandregister.com (the island being Prince Edward Island) by Gary Carroll.
5. **The Royal Ark** website by Christopher Buyers, specifically the entry for the Durrani dynasty at: <http://www.royalark.net/Afghanistan/warburto.htm>.
6. **The Controller of Devils** by J D Martineau.

Richard's descendants claimed kinship with the Warburtons of Arley Hall, a link accepted at certain times by the family at Arley. However there is no known documented evidence of this link, and different explanations of it have been suggested. One is that Richard was descended from Peter Warburton, the ancestor of the Warburtons of Hefferston Grange, and his wife Alice Cooper, via Peter Warburton and Magdalen Molten.

However DNA evidence suggests that if there is a link it is not in the male line. Two descendants of Richard, by different sons, have matching haplotype J Y-chromosomes. This has not been found in any other Warburton group. Meanwhile evidence is growing that the Arley Hall family share a haplotype R1b-DF98 DNA profile with several other Warburton clans.

Richard was a merchant in Dublin. He was named in a Chancery Decree on the 8th February 1635 when he lent £8000 to King Charles I.

Richard married **Elizabeth L'Estrange**.

Elizabeth was the daughter of Thomas L'Estrange of Moystown, King's County.

First Generation

They had the following children:

John was of Dublin, and was MP for Belturbet.

2. Richard Warburton (*Richard*¹). Richard was born abt 1637. Richard died in Garryhinch, Queen's County, Ireland, in Feb 1717.

Richard was of Garryhinch, Queens County which was acquired before 1682. He was also granted Kilbrechan and other lands totalling 406 acres in the parish of Fennagh. He received the Barony of Forth, County Carlow, on the 9th October 1682.

He was Clerk of the Council to Henry Cromwell in 1654, and Clerk to the Irish House of Commons 1661; though at the tender age of 17 in 1654, could it be more likely his father held these posts? He was named in the will of his brother-in-law Henry L'Estrange of Moystown, dated 20th Jan 1665. He was High Sherrif of Carlow in 1675, and of King's County in 1691, and MP for Ballyshannon in 1697-9, and 1703-13.

Some sources consider Judith Sandes the mother of Richard's children. However the tree prepared by Conrad Swan, the York Herald of Arms, has a marriage date for Richard and Judith in 1686, after the births of Richard's children.

In Apr 1656 when Richard was 19, he married **Judith Sandes** in Dublin, St Michan, Ireland. This marriage date is based on the entry of banns as listed in the church records on www.irishgenealogy.ie. This contradicts a date from the tree prepared by the York Herald at Arms which has 1686.

Judith was the daughter of William Sandes of Dublin

Second Generation

They had the following children:

Elizabeth married **Frederick Trench**.

Frederick was from Garbally, and ancestor to the Earls of Clancarty.

3. **George Warburton** (*Richard*¹). George was born abt 1640. George died on 14 Nov 1709.

George was of Aughrim and Firmount, MP for Gowran, and Postmaster General for Ireland in 1702.

The tree of George's descendants is based on a handwritten tree provided by the late Virginia Warburton which was in turn based largely on **Burke's Landed Gentry of Great Britain and Ireland for 1852**.. The tree has few dates so these have and will be added from other sources where possible.

George married **Ann L'Estrange**.

Ann was from Moystown.

They had the following children:

- i. **Richard Warburton**. Richard died in Dublin, Ireland, in 1746.

Richard was of Aughrim and Firmount. His will dated 30th July 1744 left his estates to his brother John.

Richard married **Ann Castleton**.

Third Generation

4. Richard Warburton (*Richard², Richard¹*). Richard was born in King's County, Ireland, abt 1664. Richard died in Garryhinch, Queen's County, Ireland, in Jan 1715.

Richard was educated at Shinrone by Mr Archibald, and matriculated at Trinity College Dublin on 2nd July 1679, aged 15. He was High Sheriff of King's County in 1701, and MP for Portarlington 1692-3, 1695-9, 1703-13, and 1713-14.

In his will Richard decreed that if his son Richard had no heirs then George and his heirs should inherit.

On 9 Jan 1695 when Richard was 31, he married **Elizabeth Pigott**.

Elizabeth was the daughter of John Pigott of Kilkinny, County Limerick, and Gertrude Southwell.

They had the following children:

- i. **Richard Warburton**. Richard was born on 6 Dec 1696. Richard died in Nov 1771.

Richard inherited Garryhinch and other estates, but died unmarried leaving his estates to his brother Peter. He was a man of great learning who spent much of his time in London. However, because of the disputes that arose because he ignored his father's will and left Garryhinch to Peter, his memory was not esteemed by the family.

- ii. **John Warburton**.

John died unmarried.

- iv. **Peter Warburton**. Peter died on 29 Sep 1784.

Peter was left the estates at Garryhinch by his brother Richard, in contravention of his father's will which decreed that if Richard had no heirs then George and his heirs should inherit. Peter occupied Garryhinch paying a nominal rent to Richard. After Richard's death Peter was involved in a dispute with his nephew John, the rightful heir, but this was eventually settled and it was agreed that Garryhinch should revert to John if Peter died without heirs, which he did.

Gertrude is referred to as George in Burke's Colonial Gentry, though she is listed as a daughter.

Gertrude married **William Carden**.

William was from Lismore, Queen's County.

Jane married **George Pigott.**

George was from Knapton.

5. **Rev George Warburton** (*George², Richard¹*). George died in 1760.

George was Reverend George of Parsontown.

George married **Warren.**

George's wife was the daughter of Mr. Warren of Grangebegg esq.

George was of Dublin

George married **Jane Le Hunte**.

Jane was the daughter of George Le Hunte of Artramont, County Wexford.

They had one child:

8. William Warburton (*Richard³, Richard², Richard¹*).

William married **Barbara Robinson**.

Barbara was the daughter of William Robinson of Knebworth, Herts, who succeeded his cousin Lytton (formerly Strode), and assumed the name Lytton.

They had one child:

9. Rev Richard Warburton (*George³, George², Richard¹*).

Richard was living in Britania, Kings County in 1752. Interest in a 3 lives lease for 20 acres at Gortagavan, Co. Offaly was transferred to him on 9th October 1755 (Rooke papers).

In Apr 1752 Richard married **Anne Elliot**. A marriage settlement between Rev. Richard Warburton of Firbane, Co. Offaly, clerk and Ann Eliot, eldest daughter of Bartholomew Eliot, deceased, is in the Rooke papers, dated April 1752. Anne died aft 1778.

Anne was the daughter of Bartholomew Elliot of Mount Elliot in County Wexford. Burke gives a date of death of 1761, but the number of her children make this unlikely, unless some belong to a second wife.

In 1798 when Frances was 20, she married **Charles Coote Meredith** in Kildare. According to Irish Marriage License Bonds. Charles and Frances had 11 children. After Frances's death Charles remarried twice, and had 6 more children by the first of these. Charles Coote was born in Reary Valley, Queen's County, Ireland., in 1770. Charles Coote died in Prospect Hill, Dublin, Ireland, on 18 Mar 1852.

10. George Warburton (*John³, George², Richard¹*).

George was of Aughrim, and MP for Gaty.

George married **Trench**.

Miss Trench was the aunt of the 1st Earl of Clancarty.

They had the following children:

- i. **Richard Warburton.** Richard died in 1767.

Richard was a Captain of Foot.

- ii. **Mary Warburton.**

Mary married **John Burgh**.

John was an uncle of Lord Donne.

Fifth Generation

11. John Warburton (*George⁴, Richard³, Richard², Richard¹*). John died in 1806. He was buried in Emo, Coolbanagher Churchyard, Queen's County, Ireland.

John was, after some dispute, heir to his uncle Peter. Her served in the Army and was at the taking of Quebec under General Wolfe. He was MP for Queen's County 1779-94.

According to James Arthur Warburton there was a third son, older than Richard, who died young.

John married **Martha Benson**. She was buried in Emo, Coolbanagher Churchyard, Queen's County, Ireland.

Martha was the daughter of Richard Benson (York Herald), Bowes Benson (Burke's) or maybe Richard Bowes Benson.

They had the following children:

Martha married **William Augustus Le Hunte**. They had no children.

William was of Artramont.

12. Richard Warburton-Lytton (*William Warburton⁴, Richard³, Richard², Richard¹*). Richard was born in 1745. Richard died in 1810.

In 1768 when Richard was 23, he married **Elizabeth Jodrell**.

Elizabeth was the daughter of Paul Jodrell of Lewknor.

They had one child:

- i. **Elizabeth Barbara Warburton-Lytton**. Elizabeth Barbara was born in 1773.

Elizabeth was the only daughter and heiress.

In 1798 when Elizabeth Barbara was 25, she married **William Earle Bulwer**.

Elizabeth and William had children described in Burke's Peerage under Lytton, E.

William was of Wood Dalling and Heydon, Norfolk, and a Brigadier-General.

13. Bartholomew Boyd Warburton (*Richard⁴, George³, George², Richard¹*). Bartholomew Boyd was born in 1757. Bartholomew Boyd died in 1823. ■ Census for Crinkle, Birr, King's County, Ireland, in 1821. Bartholomew (64) Gentleman is living with Elizabeth (54), and 4 servants.

Fifth Generation

The case of Warburton vs. Loveland (1832), in 'New Reports of Cases Heard in the House of Lords: On Appeals and Writs of Error in the House of Lords ...', Vol 2 states: "... on the marriage of Elizabeth Batt with Bartholomew Boyd Warburton (she being then of full age,) by indenture of settlement dated the 24th of July, 1779 ... the death of Bartholomew Boyd Warburton, which happened in 1823."

In Jul 1779 when Bartholomew Boyd was 22, he married **Elizabeth Batt**. Elizabeth was born in 1767.

Elizabeth was the daughter of Benjamin Batt of Bally William, County Wexford.

They had the following children:

- 18 i. **Bartholomew Boyd Warburton** (1785-1860)
- 19 ii. **John Warburton** (~1788-1865)
- iii. **Anne Warburton**. Anne was born in Birr, King's County, Ireland, on 18 Jan 1799.
- iv. **Elizabeth Warburton**. Elizabeth was born in Birr, King's County, Ireland, on 2 Jul 1803. Elizabeth died on 11 Jun 1886. She was buried in Stillorgan, St Brigid, Dublin, Ireland.

On 21 Dec 1824 when Elizabeth was 21, she married **Henry Rook** in Dublin, St Mark, Ireland. A marriage settlement in the Rooke papers, is dated 11th December 1824 and mentions Major George Warburton of Castlegar, Co Galway. Elizabeth and Henry had 14 children. Henry was born in 1795. Henry died on 3 May 1866. He was buried in Stillorgan, St Brigid, Dublin, Ireland.

Henry was a solicitor, and the eldest son of Thomas and Elinor Ward of Wexford.

He is buried in grave D110 with his wife Elizabeth and three of their children. The inscription reads: 'Sacred to the memory of Henry Rooke Esq A.M. Who died the 3rd day of May 1866 aged 71 years Erected by his sorrowing widow Elizabeth Rooke who died on the 11th June 1886 aged 82 and was buried beneath also their son William Duffield Rooke who died Oct 23rd 1868 aged 52 years. Catherine Rooke his widow died 7th December 18?3 aged 85 Eleanor E Rooke daughter of Henry and Elizabeth Rooke died 19th March 1883.'

- v. **Henry Warburton**. Henry was born in Birr, King's County, Ireland, on 13 Apr 1807.

Henry married **Elizabeth Harvey**.

- 20 vi. **George Warburton** (-1845)
- vii. **Benjamin Warburton**. Benjamin died on 21 Nov 1828. He was buried in Stillorgan, St Brigid, Dublin, Ireland.

Benjamin was a captain in the Royal Navy.

Fifth Generation

He is buried in grave D108 with his wife Elizabeth, and sister Deborah Montgomery. The grave inscription reads: "Captain Benjamin Warburton of HM Royal Navy died 21st November 1828. Here also lieth the remains of his widow Elizabeth Warburton died February 1848 age ?. Deborah Montgomery Daughter of D B Warburton and Elizabeth Warburton relict of W Montgomery MD Died 21 June 1878."

Benjamin married **Elizabeth**. Elizabeth died in 1848. She was buried in Stillorgan, St Brigid, Dublin, Ireland.

- viii. **Samuel Warburton**. Samuel died in Birr, King's County, Ireland, on 25 Dec 1816. He was buried in Birr, St Brendan, King's County, Ireland.
- ix. **Deborah Warburton**. Deborah died on 21 Jun 1878. She was buried in Stillorgan, St Brigid, Dublin, Ireland.

In 1840 Deborah married **William Fetherstone H Montgomery M.D.**. A marriage settlement in the Rooke papers dated 21st December 1840 refers to William Fetherstone H. Montgomery of Dublin, M.D. and Deborah Warburton of Monkstown, Co.Dublin, and Bartholomew Warburton of Ballinasloe, Co. Galway.

14. **Rev John Warburton** (*Richard⁴, George³, George², Richard¹*).

John married **Elliot**.

They had the following children:

A William Warburton was buried May 4th 1801 at Birr, no age given.

Thomas married **Sarah**.

They had the following children:

- i. **Sarah Warburton**. Sarah was born in 1796. She was christened in Birr, St Brendan, King's County, Ireland, on 24 Mar 1796.
- ii. **Abraham Warburton**. Abraham was born in Birr, King's County, Ireland, in 1797. He was christened in Birr, St Brendan, King's County, Ireland, on 25 Nov 1797.

Sixth Generation

16. Richard Warburton (*John⁵, George⁴, Richard³, Richard², Richard¹*). Richard was born in 1778. Richard died in Garryhinch, Queen's County, Ireland, on 15 Jul 1853.

Richard inherited Garryhinch. He was a JP and Deputy Lieutenant. The PEI Island Register gives Richard the middle name of Benson.

On 15 May 1800 when Richard was 22, he married **Anne Kemmis**. Anne was born on 12 Oct 1775. Anne died in Nice, France, on 29 Aug 1852.

Anne was the daughter of Thomas Kemmis of Dublin. Her death was recorded in the Evening Mail of 8th September 1852 which referred to her as Anne, wife of Richard Warburton Esq., formerly of Garryhinch in the King's County.

They had the following children:

- i. **John Warburton**. John died in 1839. He was buried in Pere La Chaise Cemetery, Paris.

John died without issue. He was killed in a duel in Paris.

18. Bartholomew Boyd Warburton (*Bartholomew Boyd⁵, Richard⁴, George³, George², Richard¹*).

Bartholomew Boyd was born in 1785. ■ Census for Crinkle, Birr, King's County, Ireland, in 1821. Bartholomew (32) Gentleman is living with Anna (23), Bartholomew (1) and a nurse. Bartholomew Boyd died in Birr, King's County, Ireland, on 16 Dec 1860. He was buried in Stillorgan, St Brigid, Dublin, Ireland.

Bartholomew was buried in grave D134. The inscription reads: "Capt Barth Warburton Late of Birview in the Kings County Resident magistrate for 37 years died 16th December 1860 age 75 tears. Anna Lucinda, his wife died 8th January 1873 aged 85 years. Their only daughter Mildred Derorah Warburton died 16th September 1910 aged 85 years".

Bartholomew Boyd married **Anna Lucinda Bayly**. Anna Lucinda was born in 1787. Anna Lucinda died on 8 Jan 1873. She was buried in Stillorgan, St Brigid, Dublin, Ireland.

Anna was the daughter of Rev. E Bayly of Lamberton, County Wicklow.

Landed Estates Court, King's County: In the Matter of the Estate of Anna Lucinda Warburton, Widow, Edward Bayly Warburton, and Mildred Deborah Warburton, Spinster, Owners and Petitioners. To be sold before the Honourable Judge Longfield, on Tuesday, the 16th day of May 1865, at noon, at his Court, Inn's Quay, Dublin, in one Lot, The Estate and Demesne of Birrview, situate in the Parish of Birr, barony of Ballybritt and King's County, and that part of Birrview now

known as Grove Street, held under Lease for three lives, dated 30th of April, 1833, at the yearly rent of £48 12s. 8d. All the lives are in being. These Lands contain 117a. 0r. 30p. statute measure, and produce a net annual rental of £134 1s. 10d. Dated this 25th day of March, 1865." (**King's County Chronicle, 3 Apr 1865**).

They had the following children:

- i. **Batholomew Boyd Warburton**. Batholomew Boyd was born in Birr, King's County, Ireland, in 1821. He was christened in Birr, St Brendan, King's County, Ireland, on 2 Apr 1821.

Bartholomew's baptism record names his mother as Eliza Louisa. However as the 1821 census shows his father is already married to Anna this is probably a misunderstanding of Anna Lucinda by the parish clerk.

- ii. **Edward Bayly Warburton**. Edward Bayly was born in Birr, King's County, Ireland, in 1824. He was christened in Birr, St Brendan, King's County, Ireland, on 12 Sep 1824.

The Edinburgh Gazette' Jan 10, 1860 reported: "Dublin Castle, January 2, 1860. The Lord Lieutenant has been pleased to appoint Edward Bayly Warburton, Esq., to be a Resident Magistrate for the County of Westmeath".

On 15 Mar 1855 when Edward Bayly was 31, he married **Emily Howe** in Monkstown, Cork, Ireland.

Emily was the daughter of Randal Howe.

- iii. **Mildred Deborah Warburton**. Mildred Deborah was born in 1825. Mildred Deborah died on 16 Sep 1910. She was buried in Stillorgan, St Brigid, Dublin, Ireland.

19. John Warburton (*Bartholomew Boyd⁵, Richard⁴, George³, George², Richard¹*). John was born abt 1788. John died in Birr, King's County, Ireland, on 28 Oct 1865. He was buried in Birr, St Brendan, King's County, Ireland, on 30 Oct 1865.

John was a J.P. at Crinkle in **Slater's National Commercial Directory of Ireland**, entry for Birr, 1846.

The Griffith, Valuation of Tenements, Parish of Birr (undated) shows John had land and buildings in Ballinree of over 51 acres, valued at £50, and in Crinkle over 179 acres, valued at £247.

The Cork Examiner recorded his age at death as 78, but his burial, and civil death records say he was 77. He died of disease of the prostate. His date of death is variously reported as the 26th and 28th of October.

A will in the Rooke papers, dated 18th April 1825, shows his widow Anne was granted probate on 20th January 1846.

The Rooke papers also include a printed address to Major George Warburton [died 1845] from the members of the Clare Police establishment regarding his removal from the office of Chief Magistrate. Warburton's reply is addressed to a Major Miller.

On 6 Jul 1806 George married **Anna (Anne) Acton**. A marriage settlement dated 3rd July 1806 is in the Roole papers George is of Birriew, Co, Offaly and Anne's father is named as Thomas of Westaston, Co Wicklow. Anna (Anne) was born abt 1783. Anna (Anne) died in Iffley, Oxfordshire, in 1870.

Anna was the daughter of Thomas Acton of County Wexford. Her death was registered in 4q 1870 at Headington 4a 328, aged 86.

Whilst in Kabul he married Shah Jahan Begum, an Afghan princess, and niece of Dost Mahommed Khan, the Amir of Afghanistan. The Begum was previously married to Sardar Faiz Talab Khan, who is thought to have fled Kabul with the Amir when the British arrived.

By the time of the marriage the Begum's son Jan Dad Khan (1840-1919) had already been born and it was assumed he was the son of her first husband, but as the husband probably left Kabul a

year earlier, Jan Dad Khan was more likely Robert's son and it is said he recognised him as such in later life. Officially Robert adopted Jan Dad Khan, who became John Paul Warburton.

Robert was taken hostage at Kabul in 1841. The Begum, now pregnant with her second child, fled and was sheltered by her family. During the subsequent invasion of the Army of Retribution, Robert escaped in September 1842, and both he and the Begum were able to make their way back to India..

On 27 Oct 1841 when Robert was 29, he married **Shah Jahan Begum** in Kabul, Afghanistan. Shah Jahan was born abt 1813. Shah Jahan died abt 1866.

Elliot (41), a landholder, is living at 11 Rutland Gate, with Matilda J (31), George HPP (2), Piers E (1), and 4 servants. Bartholomew Elliot George died in At sea (off Land's End), on 4 Jan 1852.

He usually went by his middle name of Elliott. He matriculated at Queens' College, Cambridge on 8 December 1828. He graduated from Trinity College, Cambridge on 22 May 1833 with a Bachelor of Arts (B.A.). He graduated from Trinity College, Cambridge in 1837 with a Master of Arts (M.A.).

Elliott was a traveller, writer, and novelist, whose works included **The Crescent and the Cross**. He also edited **Hochelaga, Or, England in the New World** (which was written by his brother). He died with 141 others when RMA Amazon caught fire and sank 110 miles off the Scilly.

Biographies of Elliott can be found in Wikipedia (see <http://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/0>) and in the Dictionary of National Biography.

A grant of administration of his will, dated 16th May 1848, to Rev. Thomas Acton Warburton, is in the Rooke papers.

On 11 Jan 1848 when Bartholomew Elliot George was 38, he married **Matilda Jane Grove** in Piccadilly, St James, London. The marriage was registered in 1q 1848 at St James 1 84. Matilda Jane was born in Shenstone, Staffordshire, abt 1819. ■ Census for Clains, Worcestershire, in 1861. Matilda (41) a landholder, is remarried and living with her husband Henry Milman (39) a barrister, George (12) at Wellington College, Piers (11) a pupil of Rev. C Bedford Allesley, and 2

Thomas (57) is the Vicar of Iffley, living at the Vicarage with Alice (27), Acton (4), George (2), and 3 servants. ■ Census for Camberwell in 1881. Thomas A (67) is the Vicar at St John's Camberwell, living at 13 East Dulwich Road with Emily (37), and a servant. Sons Acton and George are boarding at Windsor, and Penge respectively. ■ Census for Dulwich in 1891. Thomas (77) is a clerk in holy orders living at Dulwich Wood Park with wife Emily A (47), Acton (24), and George (22), both students of theology, and 3 servants. Emily (56) is a widow living on her own means with Acton (34) a clergyman, and George (32) living on own means. They are lodging at 21 Brock Street a Lodging House run by Piety Ann Edwards (54). ■ Census for St Leonards on Sea, Hastings, Sussex, in 1911. Alice (66) on private means, and Acton (43) a clergyman and bachelor, are lodging with Miss J Murray (49) at 24 Warrior Square.

He was stationed at Montreal from 4 Sept. 1844 to 15 July 1845 and from 19 Dec. 1845 to 1 March 1847. He wrote **Hochelala or, England in the New World** (edited by brother Elliott) and **The Conquest of Canada** as a result of his experiences. He also served for six months in Corfu.

On 28 March 1857 he was elected to parliament by a large majority as an Independent Liberal for Harwich. On 23 October, "in a fit of temporary insanity" induced by pains of indigestion to which he was subject, he shot himself through the head.

The Rooke papers have two copies of probate granted on his will dated 3rd April 1854, to his brother Rev Thomas Acton Warburton on 19th November 1857.

On 1 Jun 1853 when George Drought was 36, he married **Hon. Elizabeth Augusta Bateman-Hanbury** in St. George, Hanover Square, London. Elizabeth Augusta was born on 16 Mar 1832. Elizabeth Augusta died on 29 May 1912.

Elizabeth was the daughter of the 1st Baron Bateman, and she was later Lady Northwick.

However as his mother's first husband had probably left Kabul a year before his birth it is likely Colonel Robert was his natural father and he is said to have acknowledged a likeness in later life.

John Paul went on to become a renowned detective and Chief of Police in the Punjab and on his death he received a Times Obituary entitled by his nickname of 'Button Sahib'. He received a grant of land in Gujranwala, Punjab, where there is now a town called Warburton. His exploits are described in **Controller of Devils** by G D Martineau, the son of John Paul's daughter, Selina.

John Paul died of injuries sustained in a fall from his horse.

His three children are known from **The Khyber Rifles** by Jules Stewart, though Marie Cecil and her marriage can be deduced from the inclusion of her son James Robert Birch in the Durrani Dynasty on the Royal Ark site. Frank and Hilda were probably born in India. Hilda married into an Irish family.

George's birth was registered in 4q 1848 at Barnstable 10 45.

George emigrated to New Zealand and lived in Palmerston North where he had five children. He returned to England in 1898 and stayed until 1903. He appeared in the 1901 census with his wife and four of his children.

The Rooke papers include 2 documents concerning George Hartoph Eliot Warburton's annuity of £200 charged on the lands of Mount Eliot in Co. Wexford.

His death registration has not been found.

George Hartoph Eliot married **Sophia Isabella Budd**. Sophia Isabella was born in Stoke, Devonshire, abt 1864.

They had the following children:

- i. **Charlotte Eliot Warburton**. Charlotte Eliot was born in Palmerston North, New Zealand, on 14 Mar 1883. Charlotte Eliot died in Palmerston North, New Zealand, on 17 Dec 1961.


