



# PREFACE



A Warburton family occupied Pool Bank farm in Bowdon in the 16th and 17th centuries. The earliest known ancestor is John Warburton who died before 1592, when his widow Jane died and left a will. The family later moved to Timperley.

This tree is based on input from Robert Warburton of Timperley.

## First Generation

---

1. **John Warburton**. John was born bef 1550. John died bef 1592.

This tree is based on input from Robert Egerton Warburton (Bob) of Timperley. He states that John was alive in 1561, but I don't know the source. As his son George was an executor of his widow's will, and so must have been 21 in 1592, John must have been born before 1550.

The family farmed at Poole Bank Farm in Bowdon.

John married **Jane**. Jane died in Bowdon, Cheshire, in 1592.

Bob, and Norman Warburton refer to Jane as Joan, but her will is listed under Jane by Cheshire Wills, and this is my reading of the name. Her children are determined from her will. Apart from George nothing further is known of them.

They had the following children:

## **Second Generation**

---

**2. George Warburton** (John<sup>1</sup>). George was born in Bowdon, Cheshire, bef 1571. George died aft 1625.

George is mentioned in the Subsidy Roll of 1593 and Rental of 1625 (Stamford Estate papers), though in the later case the rent is paid by the wife of George.

### **Third Generation**

#### **3. John Warburton** (George<sup>2</sup>, John<sup>1</sup>).

Bob has John as the son of George, and likely father of George born 1610. The only evidence of him seems to be the marriage to Ann in Feb 1610, though I am unaware of the source for this wedding as it isn't recorded at Bowdon. It is possible the second George was the direct son of the first.

In Feb 1610 John married **Ann Arstall**.

They had one child:

## Fourth Generation

---

**4. George Warburton** (John<sup>3</sup>, George<sup>2</sup>, John<sup>1</sup>). George was born in Bowdon, Cheshire, abt 1610. George died in Bowdon, Cheshire, in 1655. He was buried in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 24 Apr 1655.

On 7 Dec 1632 when George was 22, he married **Elizabeth Arstall** in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire. Elizabeth was born in Bowdon, Cheshire, abt 1610. Elizabeth died in Bowdon, Cheshire, in 1686. She was buried in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 19 Jan 1686.

Elizabeth left a will dated January 10th 1686 (modern date) in which she left her children small bequests. She made her son William executor but he renounced the role on October 4th 1687. Her inventory was valued at £26 8s.

They had the following children:

- i. **George Warburton** (1633-1688)
  - ii. **Jane Warburton**. Jane was born in Bowdon, Cheshire, in 1636. She was christened in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 14 Apr 1636. Jane died bef 1686.

Jane is not mentioned in her mother's will so probably died beforehand.

- iii. **Thomas Warburton** (1640-1697)
  - iv. **Margaret Warburton**. Margaret was born in Bowdon, Cheshire, in 1640. She was christened in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 14 Feb 1640.

Margaret was Thomas's twin. She is not mentioned in her mother's will so probably died beforehand.

- v. **William Warburton**. William was born aft 1640. William died in Bowdon, Cheshire, on 12 Jan 1710. He was buried in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 18 Jan 1710.

William is only known from his mother's will where he was named executor, but named after George and Thomas in the list of bequests. However Jill Groves believes he may have inherited Pool Bank Farm on the death of his brother George. Only one burial of a William of Bowdon is recorded in the appropriate timescale, but there is no direct evidence it is this William.

- vi. **Anne Warburton**. Anne was born in Bowdon, Cheshire, in 1650. She was christened in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 31 Mar 1650.

Anne married **Richard Clarke**.



- vii. **Sibbile Warburton**. Sibbile died in 1686. She was buried in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 24 Sep 1686.

Sibbile is known from her mother's will. She appears to have died a spinster and intestate. Administration was granted to her brother Thomas, and sister Ann Clarke. Her inventory was valued at £6 7s 10d.

## Fifth Generation

---

**5. George Warburton** (George<sup>4</sup>, John<sup>3</sup>, George<sup>2</sup>, John<sup>1</sup>). George was born in Bowdon, Cheshire, in 1633. He was christened in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 6 Nov 1633. George died in Bowdon, Cheshire, in 1688. He was buried in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire.

There is no record of George's marriage. Bob believes his wife's name might be Elizabeth, and that the wedding was circa 1660, which fits with the baptism of their first child. In addition to the children below, George had 2 unnamed infants buried at Bowdon, on April 9th 1681, and April 26 1682.

Abt 1660 when George was 27, he married **Elizabeth**.

They had the following children:

- 7 i. **John Warburton** (1661-1728)
- ii. **Elizabeth Warburton**. Elizabeth was born in Bowdon, Cheshire, in 1667. She was christened in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 5 Nov 1667.

My Bowdon records show this Elizabeth as the daughter of George of Partington. The most likely possible marriage for Elizabeth at Bowdon is to George Renshaw in 1694.

- iii. **Anne Warburton**. Anne was born in Bowdon, Cheshire, in 1669. She was christened on 31 Mar 1669.

Ann is only known from Bob. There is no baptism in the Bowdon record, or on FamilySearch (could she be at Warburton like brother John?).

- iv. **Rebecca Warburton**. Rebecca was born in Bowdon, Cheshire, in 1673. She was christened in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 13 Mar 1673.

On 17 Dec 1700 when Rebecca was 27, she married **Nathan Johnson** in Bowdon, Cheshire. Nathan was born in Bowdon, Cheshire, abt 1670.

- v. **Deborah Warburton**. Deborah was born in Bowdon, Cheshire, on 9 Nov 1676. She was christened in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 2 Feb 1677.

Deborah's birth date is from Bob, source unknown. The baptism is of the daughter of George of Bowdon. She possibly married Samuel Hackerley in 1700. The Bowdon parish register records they were both from Altrincham and married at Chester "as they say". There is no other likely marriage at Bowdon.

- vi. **Sybil Warburton**. Sybil was born in Bowdon, Cheshire, on 12 Apr 1680. Sybil

died in 1681. She was buried in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 20 Apr 1681.

Sybil's birth date is from Bob. There is no baptism in the Bowdon record (could she be at Warburton like brother John?).

- vii. **George Warburton**. George was born in Bowdon, Cheshire, in 1683. He was christened in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 3 Aug 1683. George died in Bowdon, Cheshire, in 1684. He was buried in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 27 May 1684.
- viii. **George Warburton**. George was born in Bowdon, Cheshire, in 1686. He was christened in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 25 May 1686. George died in Bowdon, Cheshire, in 1686. He was buried in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 21 Dec 1687.

**6. Thomas Warburton** (George<sup>4</sup>, John<sup>3</sup>, George<sup>2</sup>, John<sup>1</sup>). Thomas was born in Bowdon, Cheshire, in 1640. He was christened in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 14 Feb 1640. Thomas died in Bowdon, Cheshire, on 20 May 1697. He was buried on 23 May 1697.

Thomas was a wheelwright.

The deaths of Thomas and his wife Mary in quick succession left their children in financial difficulties, not helped by the apparent treachery of John Jackson, their father's administrator. This resulted in various suites and judgements in 1699 which are documented, along with Thomas's accounts, in Bowdon Wills Part 3 by Jill Groves and Pat Higginbotham.

On 5 Jun 1668 when Thomas was 28, he married **Mary Aldcroft** in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire. Mary was born in Baguley, Cheshire, abt 1645. Mary died in Bowdon, Cheshire, on 25 Apr 1697. She was buried in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 29 Apr 1697.

They had the following children:

- i. **John Warburton**. John was born in Bowdon, Cheshire, in 1668. He was christened in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 12 Sep 1668. John died in Bowdon, Cheshire, in 1668. He was buried in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 20 Sep 1668.
- ii. **Aldcroft Warburton**. Aldcroft was born in Bowdon, Cheshire, in 1672. He was christened in Rostherne, St Mary, Cheshire, on 9 Apr 1672.

Aldcroft's declared age of 23 in the hearings of 1699 would give him a birth date circa 1676. There is no further evidence of him at Bowdon after the hearings and suites of 1699.

On 26 Nov 1704 when Aldcroft was 32, he married **Margaret Gaskell**. A marriage license exists, but there is no parish record of the actual wedding, nor of any children. Margaret was born in Warrington, Lancashire.

- iii. **Elizabeth Warburton**. Elizabeth was born abt 1674. She was christened in Rostherne, St Mary, Cheshire, on 19 Mar 1674.

Elizabeth is only known from the hearings relating to her father's accounts. She was also named in a suite re her father's estate in 1700.

- iv. **Rachel Warburton**. Rachel was born abt 1679. She was christened in Rostherne, St Mary, Cheshire, on 31 Oct 1679.

On 5 Feb 1701 when Rachel was 22, she married **Henry Powell** in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire. Henry and Rachel had three sons and three daughters. Their grandson Henry Daniel married Pheobe Bancroft, daughter of Mary Warburton and John Bancroft of the Hale Barns Clan, and a descendant of theirs is Paul Cynsye, my contact. Henry died in 1727. He was buried in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 1 Sep 1727.

- v. **Sibbill Warburton**. Sibbill was born in 1681. She was christened in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 10 Jul 1681. Sibbill died in 1683. She was buried in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 9 Jul 1683.

Sibbill is only known from her burial as the daughter of Thomas of Bowdon.

- vi. **Mary Warburton**. Mary was born in 1685. She was christened in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 2 Jan 1686.

Mary is mentioned in the hearings of 1699.

## Sixth Generation

---

**7. John Warburton** (George<sup>5</sup>, George<sup>4</sup>, John<sup>3</sup>, George<sup>2</sup>, John<sup>1</sup>). John was born in Bowdon, Cheshire, in 1661. He was christened in Warburton, St Werberg, Cheshire, on 9 Sep 1661. John died in Timperley, Cheshire, on 23 Dec 1728. He was buried in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 26 Dec 1728.

John's monumental inscription is recorded on the Owen manuscript (grave 1337) but is not on the Bowdon archevist's current grave list. John was buried with his son and daughter-in-law, and was described as a Yeoman in his 66th year (actually ?6th year but 66 fits well). According to his burial record he was buried in linen.

On 25 Dec 1699 when John was 38, he married **Margaret Royle** in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire. Margaret was born in Hale, Cheshire, abt 1680. She was christened in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 22 Sep 1680.

Margaret was from Well Green in Hale. Her burial is not recorded at Bowdon, though it is possible she remarried.

They had the following children:

- 8 i. **George Warburton** (1702-1779)
- ii. **Thomas Warburton**. Thomas was born in Timperley, Cheshire, on 8 Mar 1704. He was christened in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 18 Mar 1704. Thomas died in Timperley, Cheshire, on 27 Apr 1776. He was buried in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 2 May 1776.

Thomas died aged 70 and is buried in grave 78 with his nephew William. There is no evidence of a marriage at Bowdon.

- iii. **William Warburton**. William was born in Timperley, Cheshire, abt 1708.

William is only known of through Bob. His baptism isn't recorded at Bowdon, or on FamilySearch.

## Seventh Generation

---

**8. George Warburton** (John<sup>6</sup>, George<sup>5</sup>, George<sup>4</sup>, John<sup>3</sup>, George<sup>2</sup>, John<sup>1</sup>). George was born in Timperley, Cheshire, in 1702. He was christened in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 20 Sep 1702. George died in Timperley, Cheshire, on 15 May 1779. He was buried in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 18 May 1779.

George was a yeoman farmer. The baptisms of his children, and of some of his grandchildren, are not recorded at Bowdon, or on FamilySearch. However some of his grandchildren's baptisms are recorded at Hale Chapel, suggesting this was a Presbyterian family. There is no record of Baptisms at Hale Chapel between its foundation in 1723, and 1752. The unrecorded baptisms probably took place there during this time, or were possibly performed in the home.

His monumental inscription is recorded on the Owen manuscript (grave 1337) but is not on the Bowdon archevist's current grave list. George was buried with his father and wife, and his age was given as 78.

On 6 Feb 1728 when George was 26, he married **Anne Johnson** in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire. Anne was born in Hale, Cheshire, abt 1700. She was buried in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 20 Aug 1766.

Anne's monumental inscription is recorded on the Owen manuscript (grave 1337) but is not on the Bowdon archevist's current grave list. Ann was buried with her husband and father-in-law, and her age was given as 66.

They had the following children:

- 9 i. **Thomas Warburton** (~1728-1817)
- 10 ii. **John Warburton** (1729-1802)
- iii. **Margaret Warburton**. Margaret was born in Timperley, Cheshire, in 1740. Margaret died in 1812. She was buried in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 18 Sep 1812.

Margaret was born at Green Lane Farm. She died a widow.

On 2 May 1760 when Margaret was 20, she married **John Chorlton** in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire. John is described as a husbandman. Margaret's brother Thomas is a witness. They had 2 sons, Richard and Warburton. John was born in Timperley, Cheshire, in 1737. He was christened in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 17 Aug 1737. John died bef 1812.

- iv. **George Warburton**. George was born in Timperley, Cheshire, abt 1742. George died in Timperley, Cheshire, on 29 May 1798. He was buried in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 31 May 1798.

George is buried in grave 482 with his wife Sarah, aged 55. He is described as a yeoman on his burial record.

On 7 Nov 1762 when George was 20, he married **Sarah Priestner** in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire. Sarah was born in 1739. She was christened in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 19 Aug 1739. Sarah died in Timperley, Cheshire, on 14 Dec 1795. She was buried in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 17 Dec 1795.

Sarah is buried in grave 482, aged 55, with her husband.

- v. **William Warburton**. William was born in Timperley, Cheshire, in 1746. William died in Timperley, Cheshire, on 10 Mar 1764. He was buried in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 13 Mar 1764.

William was born at Green Lane Farm. He was buried in grave 78 aged 17 years 9 months with his uncle Thomas.

## **Eighth Generation**

---

**9. Thomas Warburton** (George<sup>7</sup>, John<sup>6</sup>, George<sup>5</sup>, George<sup>4</sup>, John<sup>3</sup>, George<sup>2</sup>, John<sup>1</sup>).

Thomas was born in Timperley, Cheshire, abt 1728. Thomas died in Hale, Cheshire, in 1817. He was buried in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 12 Mar 1817.

The baptisms of Thomas's children are not recorded at Bowdon, or on FamilySearch; details are provided by Bob.

The burial of Thomas of Hale aged 88 fits with the details provided by Bob.

On 28 Apr 1755 when Thomas was 27, he married **Anne Armstrong** in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire. Anne was born in Bowdon, Cheshire, abt 1735. Anne died in Hale, Cheshire, in 1812. She was buried in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 24 Feb 1812.

Anne the wife of Thomas of Hale was buried in 1812 aged 77, giving her a birth date of circa 1735.

They had the following children:

- i. **John Warburton**. John was born in Timperley, Cheshire, in 1756. John died in Timperley, Cheshire, in 1826. He was buried in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 13 Aug 1826.

John of Timperley buried in 1828 aged 70 is the correct age to be this John.

- ii. **Anne Warburton**. Anne was born in Timperley, Cheshire, in 1758.

On 15 May 1792 when Anne was 34, she married **John Brundrett** in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire. John is identified as Anne's husband by Bob, though on the marriage record she is called Peggy. John was born in Timperley, Cheshire, in 1755.

**10. John Warburton** (George<sup>7</sup>, John<sup>6</sup>, George<sup>5</sup>, George<sup>4</sup>, John<sup>3</sup>, George<sup>2</sup>, John<sup>1</sup>). John was born in Timperley, Cheshire, in 1729. John died in Timperley, Cheshire, on 19 Dec 1802. He was buried in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 22 Dec 1802.

John is described as a yeoman on his burial record which gives his age as 72. However he is buried in grave 434 which gives his age as 73. He is buried with wife Jane, son John, and John's wife Ellen.

On 18 Mar 1760 when John was 31, he married **Jane Cowther** in Bowdon, Cheshire. Jane was born in Stretford, Lancashire, in 1732. She was christened in Stretford, Lancashire, on



30 Apr 1732. Jane died in Timperley, Cheshire, on 2 Nov 1806. She was buried in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 5 Nov 1806.

Jane is buried in grave 434 with husband John, son John, and John's wife Ellen.

They had the following children:

- 11**
- i. **William Warburton** (1761-1814)
  - ii. **Hannah Warburton**. Hannah was born in Timperley, Cheshire, in 1763. Hannah died in 1839.

Hannah was born at Green Lane Farm. Her baptism isn't recorded.

On 27 Dec 1785 when Hannah was 22, she married **James Hardey** in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire. William was a witness. Hannah and James had 5 sons. James was born abt 1760.

- iii. **Mary Warburton**. Mary was born in Timperley, Cheshire, in 1765.

Mary was born at Green Lane Farm. Her baptism is not recorded.

On 27 Dec 1787 when Mary was 22, she married **Thomas Howarth** in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire. John was a witness. Thomas was born abt 1760.

- iv. **Ann Warburton**. Ann was born in Bowdon, Cheshire, in 1765. She was christened in Hale Chapel, Cheshire, on 15 Jan 1766.

## **Ninth Generation**

---

**11. William Warburton** (John<sup>8</sup>, George<sup>7</sup>, John<sup>6</sup>, George<sup>5</sup>, George<sup>4</sup>, John<sup>3</sup>, George<sup>2</sup>, John<sup>1</sup>). William was born in Bowdon, Cheshire, in 1761. He was christened in Hale Chapel, Cheshire, on 5 Feb 1761. William died in Bowdon, Cheshire, on 26 Sep 1814. He was buried in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 28 Sep 1814.

William was a farmer and salt carrier. He was buried in grave 435 with his wife, and daughter Martha Mellor, aged 53.

On 3 Feb 1785 when William was 24, he married **Martha Worthington** in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire. William's brother John was a witness. Martha was born in Ringway, Cheshire, in 1763. She was christened in Ringway Chapel, Cheshire, on 10 Dec 1763. Martha died in Bowdon, Cheshire, on 9 Nov 1819. She was buried in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 12 Nov 1819.

Martha's baptism is recorded at Ringway Chapel on December 10th, and at Bowdon on December 18th. It is possible one of the dates is incorrectly transcribed and the Bowdon entry is merely a copy of the baptism at Ringway. She was buried in grave 435 with her husband, and her daughter Martha Mellor, aged 57.

They had the following children:

- 13**
- i. **John Warburton** (1787-1865)
  - ii. **Ellen Warburton**. Ellen was born in Bowdon, Cheshire, on 23 Jun 1789. She was christened in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 19 Jul 1789.

On 29 Jan 1821 when Ellen was 31, she married **Frederick L'Oste Probard** in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire. Witnesses were Martha and William Warburton, Ellen's brother and sister.

Frederick was a surgeon from Arden parish.

- iii. **Martha Warburton**. Martha was born in Bowdon, Cheshire, on 8 Jul 1802. She was christened in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 8 Aug 1802. Martha died on 31 Aug 1862. She was buried in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire.

Martha was buried in grave 435 with her parents.

On 28 Oct 1830 when Martha was 28, she married **John Whitaker Mellor** in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire. John was from Manchester at the time of his wedding. Martha's brother John was a witness.

- iv. **William Warburton**. William was born in Bowdon, Cheshire, on 4 Sep 1795. He was christened in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 23 Sep 1795. ■ Census for St, Anns, Manchester, Lancashire, in 1861. William (65) is a retired grocer living at a milliner's shop in St Anns Place with Betsey (63), Margaret (30), Mary (28), Jane (26) and Ellen (24), all milliners (including Betsey). William died in Manchester, Lancashire, on 25 May 1861. He was buried in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 29 May 1861.

William leased Bowdon Hall from around 1822. He is described as a farmer of Bowdon Hall on 4 of his children's baptisms, beginning in January 1823. However he later moved to Manchester and became a grocer, whilst his wife and 4 youngest daughters became milliners. The move was probably before 1851, explaining his absence from the 1851 census, copies of which are lost for much of Manchester. The deaths of all his 3 sons at a young age may have precipitated the move.

His death was registered in 2q 1861 Manchester 8d 151, and he was buried in grave 1138, aged 65.

On 2 Feb 1820 when William was 24, he married **Betsy Warburton** in Bowdon,

St Mary, Cheshire. A witness was E Warburton. Betsy was born in Bowdon, Cheshire, on 4 Mar 1799. She was christened in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 31 Mar 1799. ■ Census for Bowdon, Cheshire, in 1841. Betsey (40) is a farmer in Bowdon living with William (18), Martha (15), John (13), Margaret (11), Mary (7), Jane (6), and Ellen (4). Husband William is not at home. Betsy died in Manchester, Lancashire, on 20 Nov 1870. She was buried in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 24 Nov 1870.

Betsey was the grand daughter of William, Schoolmaster of Bowdon. Her family is described in the Josiah of Bowdon clan.

Betsy was baptised as Betty. She is referred to as Elizabeth on 4 of her children's baptisms, and as Betsey, Betty, and Betsy on others. The 4 references to Elizabeth coincide with the 4 where William is of Bowdon Hall.

Betsy's death was registered in 4q 1870 Manchester 8d 247, aged 71. She was buried in grave 1138 which gives her date of birth and so confirms her parentage.

- v. **Isaac Warburton**. Isaac was born in Bowdon, Cheshire, on 29 Apr 1807. He was christened in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 31 May 1807. ■ Census for Manchester, Lancashire, in 1841. Isaac (30) is a grocer living at 77 Oldham Street with 8 others, including his nephew Peter Warburton (15) a grocer's apprentice. ■ Census for Cheetham, Manchester, Lancashire, in 1861. Isaac (53) is a retired grocer living at 13 Smedley Lane with Susan (46), sister, Martha Mellor (58) a widow, her daughter Mary (22) and nephew Edward Fox (9), plus 2 servants. ■ Census for Cheetham, Manchester, Lancashire, in 1871. Isaac (63) is a retired grocer living in Smedley Lane with Susanna (58), nephew Edward Tallis, an architectural pupil, and 2 servants. ■ Census for Cheetham, Manchester, Lancashire, in 1881. Isaac (73) is an annuitant living at 13 Smedley Lane with Susanna (68), and 2 servants. Isaac died in Cheetham, Manchester, Lancashire, in 1886.

Isaac cannot be found in the 1851 census (much of the Manchester record has been lost), but since there are no children at home in 1861 after 15 years of marriage, it is unlikely he had children by Susannah. However as he was 39 when he married it is possible he had an earlier marriage, but no evidence of this has yet been found.

Isaac's death was registered in 3q 1886 Prestwich 8d 284, aged 79.

In 1846 when Isaac was 38, he married **Susannah Fox** in Hawarden, St Deniol, Flintshire. The marriage was registered in 1q 1846 Great Boughton 19 63. Susannah was born in Hawarden, Flintshire, abt 1812. Susannah died in Cheetham, Manchester, Lancashire, in 1884.

Susannah's death was registered in 2q 1884 Prestwich 8d 259, aged 72.

**12. John Warburton** (John<sup>8</sup>, George<sup>7</sup>, John<sup>6</sup>, George<sup>5</sup>, George<sup>4</sup>, John<sup>3</sup>, George<sup>2</sup>, John<sup>1</sup>). John was born in Bowdon, Cheshire, in 1772. He was christened in Hale Chapel, Cheshire, on 29 Jun 1772. ■ Census for Timperley, Cheshire, in 1841. John (70) is a farmer living with Ellen (50), William (21), George (17), Ellen (15), Charles (8), and Sarah (6). John died in Timperley, Cheshire, on 4 Oct 1844. He was buried in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 9 Oct 1844.

John was buried in grave 434, aged 72.

Bef 1807 when John was 35, he first married **Unknown**. John's first marriage is reported by Bob, but there is no marriage at Bowdon that fits, and no baptism can be found at Bowdon or Hale, or in FamilySearch for Mary Ann.

They had one child:

- i. **Mary Ann Warburton**. Mary Ann was born in Timperley, Cheshire, abt 1807.

Mary Ann and John's first marriage is reported by Bob, but there is no marriage at Bowdon that fits, and no baptism can be found at Bowdon or Hale, or in FamilySearch for Mary Ann.

On 19 Jul 1810 when John was 38, he second married **Ellen Taylor** in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire. Ellen was born in Hale, Cheshire, abt 1792. Ellen died in Timperley, Cheshire, on 14 Mar 1842. She was buried in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 20 Mar 1842.

Ellen's place of birth is from Bob, but the nearest baptism on FamilySearch is in Rostherne in 1791. She was buried in grave 434, aged 50.

Sarah's baptism isn't known and she is only known from her presence in the 1841 census. She is also possibly the Sarah, aged 18, born Timperley, who is a draper's assistant in Hyde in the 1851 census.

In 1856 when Sarah was 21, she married **Joseph Howard** in Stockport, St Mary, Cheshire. The marriage was registered in 1q 1856 Stockport 8a 90. Joseph died bef 1881.

John (63) is a farmer of 60 acres employing 4 labourers living in Bowdon Village with Ellen (56), John (29) a corn dealer, Robert (27) a corn dealer, Henry (25) a cheese dealer, Edmund (23) a tea dealer, Septimus (21) a tea dealer, Helen (19), and 3 servants. ■ Census for Bowdon, Cheshire, in 1861. John (73) is a farmer of 70 acres employing 5 men living in Church Vale with Ellen (66), Robert (37), and Henry (35) both corn and provisions merchants, Edmund (33), and Septimus (31) both tea merchants, Isaac (24) a salesman, and 2 servants. John died in Bowdon, Cheshire, on 8 May 1865. He was buried in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 13 May 1865.

John was a salt carrier. His death was registered in 2q 1865 Altrincham 8a 104, aged 77. He was buried in grave 2002.

On 8 Jan 1818 when John was 31, he married **Ellen Alsope** in Hartington, Derbyshire. Ellen was born in Hartington, Derbyshire, on 24 Jun 1794. She was christened in Hartington, Derbyshire, on 27 Jul 1794. Ellen died in Bowdon, Cheshire, on 12 Jan 1867. She was buried in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 16 Jan 1867.

Ellen gives her place of birth as Hartington, Derbyshire on the 1851 census. There are baptism records for Ellen at both Hartington and Hope in Derbyshire, same date, same parents. However Hartington and Hope are not near each other.

She was buried in grave 2002, aged 72.

Robert lived at Bowdon Hall which was inherited by his wife Jane. He had no children. He was buried in grave 3674, aged 64.

On 10 Jul 1869 when Robert was 45, he married **Jane Edwards** in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire. Jane was born in Anglesey, Wales, in 1830. Jane died in Bowdon, Cheshire, on 7 Jan 1904. She was buried in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 9 Jan 1904.

Jane was buried in grave 3674, aged 74.

Edmund's father is John, corn merchant, Elizabeth's father is William, an engineer. Witnesses were Septimus Warburton and Loura Betsy Richmond. Elizabeth was born in Manchester, Lancashire, in 1841. Elizabeth died in



Hesketh Park Hydro, Southport, Lancashire, on 11 May 1927. She was buried in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 14 May 1927.

Elizabeth was buried in grave 2002, aged 86.

- vii. **Septimus Warburton**. Septimus was born in Bowdon, Cheshire, on 13 Mar 1830. He was christened in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 9 Apr 1830. Septimus died in Bowdon, Cheshire, on 6 Nov 1868. He was buried in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 11 Nov 1868.

Septimus was buried in grave 2002, aged 38.

- viii. **Ellen Alsop Warburton**. Ellen Alsop was born in Bowdon, Cheshire, on 8 Feb 1832. She was christened in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 20 Apr 1832.

On 27 Jun 1857 when Ellen Alsop was 25, she married **Edward Starkey** in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire. The marriage was registered in 3q 1857 Altrincham 8a 199. Edward was born in Bowdon, Cheshire, in 1832.

- ix. **Isaac Worthington Warburton**. Isaac Worthington was born in Bowdon, Cheshire, in 1837. He was christened in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 26 Jul 1837. Isaac Worthington died in Bowdon, Cheshire, on 20 Nov 1868. He was buried in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 23 Nov 1868.

Isaac was buried in grave 2002, aged 31.

**14. John Warburton** (John<sup>9</sup>, John<sup>8</sup>, George<sup>7</sup>, John<sup>6</sup>, George<sup>5</sup>, George<sup>4</sup>, John<sup>3</sup>, George<sup>2</sup>, John<sup>1</sup>). John was born in Timperley, Cheshire, on 18 Apr 1814. He was christened in Hale Chapel, Cheshire, on 18 Jun 1814. ■ Census for Hyde, Cheshire, in 1851. John (36) is a farmer of 50 acres employing 4 men living at Hyde Hall Farm with Elizabeth (37), Matilda (10), Sarah Ann (6), John (2), and a lodger. ■ Census for Hyde, Cheshire, in 1861. John (47) is a farmer living at Hyde Hall with Elizabeth (48), Matilda (20), Sarah Ann (15), John (11), and Alfred (8). ■ Census for Denton, Lancashire, in 1871. John (58) is a retired farmer living in Manchester Road with Eliza (60), John (21) a hatter, Alfred (18) a goods clerk (railway), and a servant. John died in Denton, Lancashire, in 1874.

John cannot be found in the 1881 census and so is probably the John whose death was registered in 4q 1875 Ashton under Lyne 8d 396, aged 59.

John married **Elizabeth**. Elizabeth was born in Hattersley, Cheshire, abt 1813. Elizabeth died in Denton, Lancashire, in 1877.

Elizabeth's maiden name has not been determined. Neither a marriage registration nor parish record can be found that fits.

Her death is probably that recorded in 2q 1877 Ashton under Lyne 8d 426.

They had the following children:

- i. **Matilda Warburton**. Matilda was born in Hattersley, Cheshire, in 1841.

Matilda's birth was registered in 1q 1841 Ashton under Lyne 20 123.

- ii. **Sarah Ann Warburton**. Sarah Ann was born in Hyde, Cheshire, in 1844. She was christened in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 21 Sep 1845.

Sarah's birth was probably that registered in 4q 1844 Stockport 19 289.

- iii. **John Warburton**. John was born in Hyde, Cheshire, on 25 May 1849. He was christened in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 11 Nov 1849.

There are several birth registrations for John at Stockport which might fit. He has not been found in censuses after 1871, though there is no death registration that is an obvious fit.

- iv. **Alfred Warburton**. Alfred was born in Hyde, Cheshire, in 1852. He was christened in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 11 Jul 1852. ■ Census for Denton, Lancashire, in 1881. Alfred (29) is a carter living at 166 Manchester Road with his widowed sister Sarah Howard (46), and her family. In fact Sarah would appear to be Alfred's aunt.

Alfred's birth was registered in 2q 1852 Stockport 8a 25. He has not been found in censuses after 1881, and a death was registered in 2q 1888 Ashton under Lyne 8d 373, but the age of 34 is slightly too young.

William was born in Timperley, Cheshire, in 1817. He was christened in Hale Chapel, Cheshire, on 10 Jan 1818. ■ Census for Timperley, Cheshire, in 1851. William (32) is a cattle dealer living with his brother Thomas and his family. ■ Census for Timperley, Cheshire, in 1861. William (43) is a cattle dealer living in Wood Lane with Elizabeth (34), William Andrew (2), and 2 lodgers (Mr and Mrs Tipping). ■ Census for Birmingham, Warwickshire, in 1871. William (52) is a pork butcher living at 21 Bristol Street with Elizabeth (43), William Andrew (12), and a servant. ■ Census for Birmingham, Warwickshire, in 1881. William (68) is a pork butcher living at 21 Bristol Street with Elizabeth (53), William Andrew (22), and Mary Corfe (78), described as mother, formerley a butcher's wife. Elizabeth and

William Andrew are also pork butchers, and William is described as deaf.

William was a cattle dealer, and later a pork butcher. He cannot be found in censuses after 1881 but there is no death registration at Birmingham that fits. There is one at Altrincham in 1894, aged 76, but it is only supposition he returned to the Timperley area.

On 11 Nov 1857 when William was 40, he married **Elizabeth Corfe** in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire. Both bride and groom's fathers were named John. The marriage was registered in 4q 1857 Altrincham 8a 214. Elizabeth was born in Hampton in Arden, Warwickshire, abt 1827. Elizabeth died in Birmingham, Warwickshire, in 1888.

Elizabeth's death was registered in 3q 1888 Birmingham 6d 30, aged 60.

They had one child:

- i. **Willian Andrew Warburton**. Willian Andrew was born in Timperley, Cheshire, on 4 Apr 1859. He was christened in Timperley, Cheshire, on 25 Sep 1859. Willian Andrew died in Birmingham, Warwickshire, in 1884.

William's birth was registered in 2q 1859 Altrincham 8a 165. The Bishop's Transcripts (transcription) gives his baptism on April 4th, but this is taken to be his birth date as the parish record has September 25th for his baptism. His death was registered in 3q 1884 Birmingham 6d 52, aged 25.

Thomas (30) is a farmer of 12 acres living with Martha (28), George Harry (5), John (3), Thomas (8 mths), and brother William (32). ■ Census for Timperley, Cheshire, in 1861. Thomas (40) is a farmer of 12 acres living in Green Lane with Martha (39), George Harry (15), John (13), Thomas (11), Charles (7), James (4), and William (2). ■ Census for Timperley, Cheshire, in 1871. Thomas (50) is a farmer of 12 acres living in Green Lane with Martha (48), Charles (17), William (12), and Septimus (7). ■ Census for Timperley, Cheshire, in 1881. Thomas (60) is a farmer of 25 acres living in Green Lane with Martha (59), Charles (27), William (22), and Septimus (17). ■ Census for Timperley, Cheshire, in 1891. Thomas (70) is a farmer living in Green Lane with Marthea (68), Charles (37), William (31), and granddaughter Isabella (13). Thomas died in Timperley, Cheshire, on 2 Nov 1900. He was buried in Timperley, Christ Church, Cheshire.

The baptism at Hale Chapel records the name as George. He is still George in the 1841

census, but Thomas at his wedding and in subsequent census entries, Why the name was subsequently changed is unknown. He is buried in grave D9, aged 80.

On 19 Oct 1844 when Thomas was 24, he married **Martha Garner** in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire. Martha was born in Frodsham, Cheshire, in 1822. She was christened in Frodsham, Cheshire, on 17 Nov 1822. Martha died in Timperley, Cheshire, on 6 Aug 1902. She was buried in Timperley, Christ Church, Cheshire.

Martha's death was registered in 3q 1902 Bucklow 8a 106, aged 80. She is buried in grave D9.

They had the following children:

- i. **George Harry Warburton**. George Harry was born in Timperley, Cheshire, in 1845. He was christened in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 16 Nov 1845. ■ Census for Hale, Cheshire, in 1871. George Harry (25) is a farm labourer at Hale Moss on the farm of John Davenport. ■ Census for Timperley, Cheshire, in 1881. George H (34) is an agricultural labourer living in Wood Lane with Mary A (28). ■ Census for Timperley, Cheshire, in 1891. George H (45) is an agricultural labourer living in Wood Lane with Mary A (39). ■ Census for Timperley, Cheshire, in 1901. George H (55) is a widowed farmer's son living in Wood Lane with nephew James (21) a market gardener's labourer. ■ Census for Timperley, Cheshire, in 1911. George Harry (65) is a widowed farmer living at Green Lane farm with single brother William (51). George Harry died in Timperley, Cheshire, on 3 May 1915. He was buried in Timperley, Christ Church, Cheshire.

George's birth was registered in 4q 1845 Altrincham 19 5. He is buried in grave D10 aged 69.

In 1869 when George Harry was 24, he married **Mary Ann Burgess** in Altrincham, Cheshire. It was a civil marriage registered in 3q 1869 Altrincham 8a 275. Mary Ann was born in Hale, Cheshire, in 1852. Mary Ann died in Timperley, Cheshire, on 1 Jun 1898. She was buried in Timperley, Christ Church, Cheshire.

Mary Ann's birth was registered in 4q 1852 Altrincham 8a 147. Her death was registered in 2q 1898 Altrincham 8a 120, aged 45. She is buried in grave D10.

In 1878 when Thomas was 28, he married **Alice Hartley**. The marriage was registered in 3q 1878 Altrincham 8a 287. Alice was born in Sale, Cheshire, abt 1853.

- iv. **Charles Warburton**. Charles was born in Timperley, Cheshire, in 1853. He was christened in Timperley, Cheshire, on 27 Nov 1853. Charles died in Timperley, Cheshire, on 18 Sep 1905. He was buried in Timperley, Christ Church, Cheshire.

Charles's birth was registered in 3q 1853 Altrincham 8a 148. He never married. He is buried in grave B62.

He was buried in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 7 Apr 1862.

William's death was registered in 2q 1862 Altrincham 8a 123. He was buried in grave 2003, aged 43.

On 7 Jun 1843 when William was 24, he married **Catherine Roylance** in Manchester Cathedral, Lancashire. Catherine was born in Manchester, Lancashire, in 1820. She was christened in Manchester Cathedral, Lancashire, on 3 Aug 1820. Catherine died in Bowdon, Cheshire, on 30 Nov 1874. She was buried in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 4 Dec 1874.

Catherine's baptism isn't certain but it is the only one recorded on FamilySearch. She was buried in grave 2003, aged 54.

They had the following children:

- i. **John Warburton**. John was born in Manchester, Lancashire, abt 1844. John died in Bowdon, Cheshire, on 13 Jan 1897. He was buried in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 16 Jan 1898.

John was still single in the 1891 census. His death was registered in 1q 1897 Altrincham 8a 131 age 51. He was buried in grave 2003.

- ii. **William Warburton**. William was born in Manchester, Lancashire, abt 1846.

William was a solicitor and appears in censuses up to 1911 when he is in Windermere. He and Mary had no children.

Richard was a factory owner. He was living at Belmont, Bowdon at the time of his death, and was buried in grave 2104-5-6, aged 59.

On 31 Dec 1879 when Henry was 22, he married **Mary Dunham** in Queensland, Australia. Mary was born in Roma, Queensland, Australia, in 1862.

- ii. **Helen Whittingham Warburton**. Helen Whittingham was born in Bowdon, Cheshire, on 19 Aug 1849. She was christened in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 15 Sep 1849. Helen Whittingham died in Bowdon, Cheshire, on 10 Jun 1850. She was buried in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 12 Jun 1850.

Kenneth was a solicitor in Bowdon at the time of his marriage. His father was William MacKenzie, a Gentleman.

Henry was born at Vale Farm. He was buried in grave 2107, aged 48.

In 1866 when Henry was 40, he married **Mary Ann Moxon**. The most likely marriage registration is in 1q 1866 Glanford Brigg (Lincolnshire) 7a 836. Mary Ann was born in Hull, Yorkshire, in 1837. Mary Ann died in Bowdon, Cheshire, on 17 Mar 1902. She was buried in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire, on 19 Mar 1902.

Mary's maiden name is uncertain but is taken from the most likely marriage registration based on her place of birth. She was buried in grave 2107, aged 65.



They had the following children:

- i. **Harry Allsop Warburton**. Harry Allsop was born in Manchester, Lancashire, in 1867.

Harry's birth was registered in 1q 1867 Manchester 8d 329. He cannot be found in censuses after 1871 but there is no obvious death registration either.

John (33) is a general carrier living in Sugar Lane with Eleanor (30), John T (4), Isabella (3), James (2), and Martha E (4 wks). ■ Census for Timperley, Cheshire, in 1891. John (43) is a market gardener living in Wood Lane with Helena (Eleanor 40), Alice M (19), John T (14), James (12), Martha E (10), Ethell (7), Beatrice E (6), Florence M (2), Isabella Sharp (36) a visitor, and a boarder. ■ Census for Timperley, Cheshire, in 1901. John (53) is a market gardener living in Wood Lane with Annie (25), Ethell (17), Beatrice E (16), Florence M (12), Harold (1) and step daughter Amy Abram (4). ■ Census for Timperley, Cheshire, in 1911. John (63) is a market gardener living in Wood Lane with Annie (38), Beatrice (25), Harold (11), Percy (9), nephew Randolf (17) a driver on farm, and step daughter Amy Abram (14) a confectioner. John and Annie have been married 12 years and had 3 children, 2 still living. John died in Timperley, Cheshire, on 22 Mar 1927. He was buried in Timperley, Christ Church, Cheshire.

John's birth registration has not been found at Altrincham. He is buried in grave D9, aged 79.

In 1871 when John was 23, he first married **Eleanor Sharpe** in Cheetham, St Mark, Manchester, Lancashire. The marriage was registered in 4q 1871 Manchester 8d 151. John and Eleanor had four infant children buried at Timperley, Christ Church in grave A24. Eleanor was born in Chorlton On Medlock, Manchester, in 1850. ■ Census for Chorlton on Medlock, Lancashire, in 1871. Eleanor (20) is living at home with widowed mother Isabella, and 4 sisters including Isabella (16). Eleanor died in Altrincham, Cheshire, in 1896.

Eleanor's death was registered in 2q 1896 Altrincham 8a 125, aged 44.

They had the following children:

- i. **Alice Maud Warburton**. Alice Maud was born in Cheetham, Manchester, Lancashire, in 1872.

Alice's birth was registered in 4q 1872 Manchester 8d 377. She is possibly the 8 year old niece staying with Thomas and Mary Mitchell in Oswestry, Shropshire in the 1881 census.

- v. **Martha Ellen Warburton**. Martha Ellen was born in Timperley, Cheshire, on 26 Mar 1881. Martha Ellen died in Moosomin, Union Hospital, Saskatchewan, on 12 Mar 1968. She was buried in Rocanville, Webster Union Cemetery, Saskatchewan.

Martha's birth was registered in 1q 1881 Altrincham 8a 175, mother's maiden name Sharpe. She was born a week before the 1881 census though her age is given as 4 weeks (or maybe months). She was known as Mattie.

Mattie, son William, and sister Ethel departed Liverpool on July 16th 1910 on the White Star ship Dominion, bound for Montreal. They arrived in Quebec on July 25th, where Ethel was recorded as travelling to her sister in Rocanville.

In 1907 when Martha Ellen was 25, she first married **William Henry Bell**. The marriage was registered in 2q 1907 Bucklow 8a 383. William and Martha had a son who travelled with Martha to Canada. William Henry was born in Baguley, Cheshire, abt 1882. William Henry died in Altrincham, Cheshire, in 1908.

William's parents were William Bell and Mary Ellen nee Coombs. His death was registered in 2q 1908 Bucklow 8a 104, aged 26, sub-district Altrincham (CheshireBMD).

On 21 Dec 1912 when Martha Ellen was 31, she second married **Charles John Jopp** in Welwyn, Saskatchewan. Charles and Mattie has 2 sons. Charles John was born in Grey County, Ontario, on 7 Jul 1882. Charles John died in Moosomin, Union Hospital, Saskatchewan, on 23 Feb 1928. He was buried in Moosomin, South Cemetery, Saskatchewan, on 24 Feb 1928.

Charles's parents were John Cowle Jopp and Elizabeth Ellen nee Edge.

- vi. **Ethel Warburton**. Ethel was born in Timperley, Cheshire, on 4 Aug 1883. Ethel died in Moosomin, Union Hospital, Saskatchewan, on 5 Dec 1974. She was buried in Moosomin, Sunset Memorial Gardens, Saskatchewan, on 9 Dec 1974.

Ethel's birth was registered in 3q 1883 Altrincham 8a 164, mother's maiden name Sharpe. Although her birth was registered as Ethel, she was known as Ethel Maude (Ettie) in Canada.

On 1 Jan 1911 when Ethel was 27, she married **William James Christie** in Welwyn, Saskatchewan. William and Ettie married at the home of John Swanton. They had a son and a daughter. William James was born in Dunnottar, Stonehaven, Kincardineshire, on 23 Nov 1887. William James died in Moosomin, Eastern Saskatchewan Nursing Home, Saskatchewan, on 5 Oct 1970. He was buried in Moosomin, Sunset Memorial Gardens, Saskatchewan, on 7 Oct 1970.

William's parents were Alexander and Jessie Christie.

- vii. **Beatrice Emma Warburton**. Beatrice Emma was born in Timperley, Cheshire, in 1884.

Beatrice's birth was registered in 4q 1884 Altrincham 8a 187.

In 1899 when John was 51, he second married **Sarah Ann Abram**. The marriage was registered in 2q 1899 Bucklow 8a 373. Sarah Ann was born in Runcorn, Cheshire, in 1875.

Sarah Ann's birth was registered in 2q 1875 Runcorn 8a 235, mother's maiden name Ravenscroft. She was known as Annie. When she married John she already had a daughter Amy by John's younger brother William.

They had the following children:

- i. **Harold Warburton**. Harold was born in Timperley, Cheshire, in 1900.

Harold's birth was registered in 1q 1900 Bucklow 8a 169.

- ii. **Percy Warburton**. Percy was born in Timperley, Cheshire, in 1902.

Percy's birth was registered in 2q 1902 Bucklow 8a 180.

James (34) is an engine driver railway, living at 42 Manor Road with Harriet (31), Arthur (9), Albert (7), Thomas (6), James (3), Charles (1), and Frank (2 months). ■ Census for Altrincham, Cheshire, in 1901. James (44) is a railway engine driver living at 38 Charles Road with Harriet (42), James (13), Charles (11), Frank (10), Alice (8), Randolph (7), and Muriel (5). ■ Census for Dunham Massey, Cheshire, in 1911. James (54) is an electrical labourer living at White Cottage, Oldfield Lane with Harriet (52), Charles (21) a groom, Alice (18) a clerk, Harriet (15) a servant, and 3 visitors. James and Harriet have been married 24 years and had 10 children, 6 still living.

James's birth was registered in 3q 1856 Altrincham 8a 165, mother's maiden name Garner.

In the 1911 census James and Harriet have had 10 children, 6 still living. Of the 8 known children 6 are to be found in the census, leaving the 2 Johns who are known to have died young, and 2 others unknown.

On 2 Jun 1880 when James was 24, he first married **Mary Lyons** in Plemstall, St Peter, Mickle Trafford, Cheshire. The marriage was registered in 2q 1880 Chester 8a 511. The FamilySearch Record Pilot states that James father was Thomas Warburton. Mary was born in Hoole, Chester, Cheshire, abt 1856. Mary died in Stretford, Lancashire, in 1886.

Mary's death was registered in 1q 1886 Barton upon Irwell 8c 468, aged 29.

Thomas's birth was probably that registered in 4q 1884 Barton upon Irwell 8c 622. He was single, working as a stud groom in Lymm in 1911.

Randolph's birth was registered in 1q 1894 Altrincham 8a 196. They had one child:

- i. **Amy Warburton**. Amy was born in Timperley, Cheshire, in 1896.

Amy's birth was registered in 4q 1896 Altrincham 8a 212. as Amy Abrams. No mother's maiden name is given on the GRO index database, or on CheshireBMD.

It is known from Amy's daughter that her father was William Warburton. When her mother then married William's brother John, she became John's stepdaughter.

Sarah was born in Timperley, Cheshire, in 1863. ■ Census for Altrincham, Cheshire, in 1911. Sarah (47) is assisting her second husband George Needham (41) a publican, and living at 42 Victoria Road with Thomas (26) a fitter, William (24) a butcher, Hardy (22) a butcher, Mabel Constance (19) a domestic servant, Reginald (17) a printer, letterpress, and Alfred (15) a butcher. Sarah died in Old Roebuck Inn, Altrincham, in 1936.
