PREFACE

The Radcliffe clan was originally documented alongside the Haslingden clan, to which it is connected by marriage. The Utah branch of the Haslingden clan descended from this link.

The clan descends from William Warburton who was born around 1718 in Radcliffe, and includes a branch established in Trowbridge, Wiltshire by John Warburton (1776-1857) a popular preacher.

DNA also indicates the two clans have a common ancestor.

The Radcliffe tree includes input from David Clifford Warburton, Julia Frances, and Rosie Warburton.

First Generation

1. William Warburton. William was born in Radcliffe, Lancashire, abt 1718. William died in 1777. He was buried in Radcliffe, St Mary, Lancashire, on 13 Feb 1777.

An IGI Ancestry file shows William as the son of John Warburton and Esther Walker who married on 7th May 1700 at Radcliffe, St Mary. An earlier version of this file showed John was baptised in 1669 the son of Robert and Jane nee Taylor who married in Bury on 1st October 1664. However these details are no longer present.

Also William's baptism isn't in on-line parish records at Radcliffe, or elsewhere in Lancashire between 1700 and 1735 with a father named John. There is a baptism at Radcliffe on 4th May 1718, father William, and this is the only one that fits with the marriage to Margaret Barlow in 1749.

The children were all baptised at Radcliffe, the children of William and Margaret, starting after William's marriage date. William is described as a husbandman on their baptisms.

On 28 Mar 1749 when William was 31, he married **Margaret Barlow** in Radcliffe, St Mary, Lancashire. William is a husbandman and both are from Radcliffe. Margaret was born in Radcliffe, Lancashire, abt 1725. She was buried in Radcliffe, St Mary, Lancashire, on 13 Feb 1777.

They had the following children:

 - ii. **Mary Warburton.** Mary was born in Radcliffe, Lancashire, in 1751. She was christened in Radcliffe, St Mary, Lancashire, on 1 Sep 1751.
 - iii. **James Warburton.** James was born in Radcliffe, Lancashire, in 1753. He was christened in Radcliffe, St Mary, Lancashire, on 29 Jul 1753.

James has not been explored.
 - iv. **Anne Warburton.** Anne was born in Radcliffe, Lancashire, in 1754. She was christened in Radcliffe, St Mary, Lancashire, on 23 Dec 1754.
 - v. **Alice Warburton.** Alice was born in Radcliffe, Lancashire, in 1757. She was christened in Radcliffe, St Mary, Lancashire, on 14 Aug 1757.
 - vi. **Margaret Warburton.** Margaret was born in Radcliffe, Lancashire, in 1759. She was christened in Radcliffe, St Mary, Lancashire, on 30 Dec 1759.

 - vii. **William Warburton** (1762-1837)
 - viii. **Hester Warburton.** Hester was born in Radcliffe, Lancashire, in 1765. She was christened in Radcliffe, St Mary, Lancashire, on 5 May 1765.
 - ix. **John Warburton.** John was born in Radcliffe, Lancashire, in 1769. He was christened in Radcliffe, St Mary, Lancashire, on 3 Dec 1769.

John has not been explored.

2. **George Warburton** (*William*¹). George was born in Radcliffe, Lancashire, in 1749. He was christened in Radcliffe, St Mary, Lancashire, on 31 Dec 1749.

George son of William is the best fit for the husband of Esther Sligoe based on his age, and the proximity of Radcliffe and Whitefield. All other Georges born at that time were baptised at Bury, or further afield.

On 14 Jul 1772 when George was 23, he married **Esther Sligoe** in Prestwich, St Mary, Lancashire. Both George and Esther were from Whitefield.

Esther's baptism has not been found.

They had the following children:

- i. **Sarah Warburton**. Sarah was born in Whitefield, Lancashire, in 1772. She was christened in Prestwich, St Mary, Lancashire, on 20 Dec 1772.
- ii. **Ralph Warburton**. Ralph was born in Whitefield, Lancashire, in 1774. He was christened in Prestwich, St Mary, Lancashire, on 11 Dec 1774. Ralph died in Whitefield, Lancashire, in 1776. He was buried in Prestwich, St Mary, Lancashire, on 4 Feb 1776.
- 4 iii. **John Warburton** (1776-1857)
- iv. **Peggy Warburton**. Peggy was born in Whitefield, Lancashire, in 1778. She was christened in Prestwich, St Mary, Lancashire, on 5 Jul 1778.

Peggy's marriage has not been found, but she was a widow called Peggy Pitfield in the 1851 census, living with a daughter, and brother William.

Peggy married **Pitfield**.

- 5 v. **Ralph Warburton** (1780-1848)
- vi. **William Warburton**. William was born in Kersall, Lancashire, in 1782. He was christened in Prestwich, St Mary, Lancashire, on 25 Dec 1782. William died in Kersall, Lancashire, in 1783. He was buried in Prestwich, Lancashire, on 5 Sep 1783.
- vii. **William Warburton**. William was born in Kersall, Lancashire, in 1784. He was christened in Prestwich, St Mary, Lancashire, on 8 Aug 1784. ■ Census for Pilkington, Lancashire, in 1841. William (55) is a cotton weaver living at Chapelfield with Ann (65), and Mary Hough (40). William's relationship with Ann is uncertain. ■ Census for Pilkington, Lancashire, in 1851. William (66) is a widowed hand loom weaver living in Whitefield with his widowed sister Peggy Pitfield (74) who is receiving parish relief, and her unmarried daughter Leah Pitfield (46) a hand loom weaver. William died in Pilkington, Lancashire, in 1863.

Second Generation

William is probably the William whose death was registered in 3q 1863 Bury 8c 286, aged 79, sub district Pilkington. (LancashireBMD).

He has not been investigated beyond the two census entries so it is not known who his wife was, or if he had children.

3. William Warburton (*William*¹). William was born in Radcliffe, Lancashire, in 1762. He was christened in Radcliffe, St Mary, Lancashire, on 6 Jul 1762. William died on 3 Feb 1837.

IGI submissions have both the 24th June and 6th July as baptism dates, but the parish register confirms the latter.

Seven children are named in an IGI submission. Eight baptisms and two burials have been found in the parish records. On all of these bar one William is a Whitster, but on Sally's baptism he is a weaver. One burial, the first Samuel, has no matching baptism.

As details from Richard's descendant David Clifford Warburton give his place of birth as Whitefield it is assumed all the children were born there, though in fact Whitefield was part of Pilkington and in Prestwich parish. The Radcliffe parish records don't give abode.

Abt 1780 when William was 18, he married **Mary Pollett**. William's marriage to Mary Pollett is only known from IGI submissions, and their grandson Joseph's submission to the Genealogical Society of Utah, in which he gets his own father's date of birth wrong. Mary was born in Radcliffe, Lancashire, on 12 Dec 1756. Mary died on 27 Apr 1841.

Mary was the daughter of Thomas and Elizabeth Pollett.

They had the following children:

- i. **Richard Warburton** (1785-)
 - ii. **John Warburton**. John was born in Whitefield, Lancashire, on 6 Feb 1786. He was christened in Radcliffe, St Mary, Lancashire, on 8 Mar 1786.

John has not been studied further but he doesn't appear to be present in the 1851 census.

- iii. **Samuel Warburton**. Samuel was born in Whitefield, Lancashire, abt 1788. Samuel died on 3 Jan 1795. He was buried in Radcliffe, St Mary, Lancashire, on 4 Jan 1795.

Samuel's baptism hasn't been found in parish records, and the date is from the IGI submission.

- iv. **Betty Warburton**. Betty was born in Whitefield, Lancashire, on 19 Apr 1789. She was christened in Radcliffe, St Mary, Lancashire, on 27 Apr 1789. Betty died in Whitefield, Lancashire, on 28 Jan 1795. She was buried in Radcliffe, St Mary, Lancashire, on 30 Jan 1795.

Betty is not mentioned in the IGI submission. She died a month after her brother Samuel, possibly of the same cause.

- v. **Sarah Warburton**. Sarah was born in Whitefield, Lancashire, on 30 Aug 1790. She was christened in Radcliffe, St Mary, Lancashire, on 12 Sep 1790. Sarah died in Pilkington, Lancashire, on 25 Dec 1850.

Eva Proctor's history says Sarah was a widow when she married James Warburton. However her son Joseph, in his submission to the Genealogical Society of Utah, says she was born a Warburton, and IGI has her pedigree.

Joseph's submission to the Genealogical Society of Utah gives her birth date as August 30th 1780. However this is dubious because she would be over 50 when Joseph was born, and her father would be only 18 when she was born. The IGI submission has the same date but in 1790. There is a corresponding baptism record for Sally, which is an alternative for Sarah, but it gives her date of birth as September 1st.

Sarah's date of death is from Eva Proctor. Her death registration is in 4q 1850 Bury 21 227, age 61.

On 26 Feb 1810 when Sarah was 19, she married **James Warburton** in Prestwich, St Mary, Lancashire. James was born in Haslingden, Lancashire, on 18 Apr 1784. He was christened in Haslingden, St James, Lancashire, on 30 May 1784. ■
Census for Pilkington, Lancashire, in 1841. Jas (50) is a bleacher living in Peel St

with Sally (50), E (26) a bleacher, John (20) a bleacher, Betty (15), Joseph (10), and John (5). Note although E(dward), John and Joseph fit well with James and Sarah's children, Betty and the second John do not fit. John is probably a grandson (i.e. son of William). Betty is more problematical as James and Sarah's daughter Elizabeth died aged 1 month in 1827. Possibly they had a second daughter whose baptism has yet to be found. In the 1851 census Betty is a year younger than Elizabeth would have been. ■ Census for Pilkington, Lancashire, in 1851. James (74) is a widowed cotton carder living in Stand Lane with Joseph (20) a dyer, and Betty (22) a spinner, plus 3 lodgers. Although James's age is high the rest seems to fit. James died in Pilkington, Lancashire, on 19 Apr 1851.

The 1841 and 1851 census entries seem to fit based on the presence of his children, and indicate James lived until after 1851, though they are not without contradictions. The 1851 census entry gives his date and place of birth as circa 1777 in Pilkington, Lancashire. His 1841 entry would suggest he was 10 years younger.

However his son Joseph, in his submission to the Genealogical Society of Utah, says his father was born on April 18th 1784, in Haslingden. This date fits with the baptism date of James son of Henry Warburton and Alice Thredfield of Haslingden.

His probable death registration is 2q 1851 Bury 21 239, age 70, sub-district Pilkington (LancashireBMD). This is the only James registered in that quarter.

The descendants of James and Sarah are detailed in the Haslingden Clan.

- vi. **George Warburton**. George was born in Whitefield, Lancashire, on 4 Jul 1792. He was christened in Radcliffe, St Mary, Lancashire, on 5 Aug 1792.

George has not been investigated further but there is a pauper of the right age, born in Radcliffe, in the 1851 census.

- vii. **Samuel Warburton**. Samuel was born in Whitefield, Lancashire, on 11 Dec 1795. He was christened in Radcliffe, St Mary, Lancashire, on 3 Jan 1796.

Samuel was born the same year as the first Samuel was buried. He hasn't been explored further but there is a Samuel of the right age, born in Pilkington, in the 1851 census.

- viii. **Peter Warburton**. Peter was born in Whitefield, Lancashire, on 5 Jan 1798. He was christened in Radcliffe, St Mary, Lancashire, on 25 Feb 1798.

Peter has not been investigated further but there is a Peter of the right age, born in Radcliffe with his family in the 1851 census.

- ix. **David Warburton**. David was born in Whitefield, Lancashire, in 1800. He was

christened in Radcliffe, St Mary, Lancashire, on 26 Oct 1800.

The on-line image of David's baptism is indistinct but the date is recorded on FamilySearch. David has not been investigated further but there is a David of the right age, born in Lancashire, living in Middlesex in the 1851 census who might be him.

Third Generation

4. John Warburton (*George², William¹*). John was born in Whitefield, Lancashire, in 1776. He was christened in Prestwich, St Mary, Lancashire, on 24 Nov 1776. ■ Census for Trowbridge, Wiltshire, in 1851. John (74) is baptist minister of Zion Chapel, living with Lydia (74), and unmarried daughters Rachel (44) and Ruth (37). John died in Trowbridge, Wiltshire, in 1857. He was buried in Trowbridge Cemetery, Wiltshire, on 2 Apr 1857.

In the 1851 census John is aged 74 and born in Pilkington. The son of George and Esther of Whitefield is an exact match on age and Whitefield is part of the township of Pilkington, in the parish of Prestwich.

John moved to Trowbridge around 1800. In 1813 41 people seceded from the Back Street Baptist chapel because they disapproved of the doctrines of the new minister, and subsequently built the Zion Chapel. Their first permanent pastor was John Warburton, a Lancashire weaver. He was a very popular preacher, wrote a Christian classic (*The Mercies of a Covenant God*) and was one of the 3 founders of the Gospel Standard Baptist Churches. He remained their preacher until his death in 1857.

John's death was registered in 2q 1857 Melksham 5a 75, aged 80. His age is confirmed by the Wiltshire Memorial Inscription Index.

On 29 Dec 1795 when John was 19, he married **Lydia Sandford** in Prestwich, Lancashire. Lydia was born in Radcliffe, Lancashire, abt 1777. Lydia died in Trowbridge, Wiltshire, in 1862. She was buried in Trowbridge Cemetery, Wiltshire, on 21 May 1862.

Lydia was the wife of John, aged 85, in the Wiltshire Memorial Inscription Index.

They had the following children:

iii. **Elizabeth Warburton**. Elizabeth was born in Trowbridge, Wiltshire, on 20 Nov 1801. She was christened in Trowbridge, Baptist Ministry, Wiltshire, on 20 Nov 1801.

On 13 Jan 1825 when Elizabeth was 23, she married **John Hayward** in Trowbridge, St James, Wiltshire.

iv. **Leah Warburton**. Leah was born in Trowbridge, Wiltshire, on 16 Apr 1804. She was christened in Trowbridge, Baptist Ministry, Wiltshire, in 1804.

On 26 Mar 1823 when Leah was 18, she married **Isaac Moore** in Trowbridge, St James, Wiltshire.

v. **Rachel Warburton**. Rachel was born in Pilkington, Lancashire, on 16 Jun 1806. She was christened in Trowbridge, Baptist Ministry, Wiltshire, in 1806.

9 vi. **Gideon Warburton** (1808-1879)

vii. **Manoah Warburton**. Manoah was born on 23 Jan 1811. He was christened in Trowbridge, Baptist Ministry, Wiltshire, in 1811. Manoah died in Trowbridge, Wiltshire, in 1839.

Manoah's death was registered in 4q 1839 Melksham 8 236, aged 28 (Wiltshire BMD).

On 26 Apr 1835 when Manoah was 24, he married **Susannah Belson** in St Pancras, Old Church, Middlesex.

viii. **Ruth Warburton**. Ruth was born in Rochdale, Lancashire, on 27 Oct 1813. She was christened in Trowbridge, Baptist Ministry, Wiltshire, in 1813.

10 ix. **John Warburton** (1815-1892)

x. **Rhoda Warburton**. Rhoda was born in Jul 1817. She was christened in Trowbridge, Baptist Ministry, Wiltshire, in 1817. Rhoda died in 1820. She was buried in Trowbridge, Baptist Ministry, Wiltshire, in 1820.

5. Ralph Warburton (*George*², *William*¹). Ralph was born in Whitefield, Lancashire, in 1780. He was christened in Prestwich, St Mary, Lancashire, on 27 Aug 1780. ■ Census for Whitefield, Lancashire, in 1841. Ralph (60) is a hand weaver living in Whitefield with Alice (60), James (32), Alice (20), Sarah (18). Ralph died in Whitefield, Lancashire, in 1848. He was buried in Stand, All Saints, Lancashire, on 10 Dec 1848.

The exact extent of Ralph's family is unknown. Three presumed children are present in the 1841 census, and there is a baptism record at Stand Lane Presbyterian Chapel for twins Betty and Simeon, in which Ralph is a weaver from Whitebrook, suggesting their other children also had

Presbyterian baptisms, but they were unrecorded.

Nothing further has been found about the children.

Ralph was buried aged 67 years. His death was registered in 4q 1848 Bury 21 201, aged 67, sub-district Pilkington (LancashireBMD).

On 11 Oct 1801 when Ralph was 21, he married **Alice Astley** in Prestwich, St Mary, Lancashire. Alice and Ralph were both from Whitefield.

They had the following children:

- i. **James Warburton**. James was born in Whitefield, Lancashire, abt 1809.

James has not been identified in censuses after 1841.

- ii. **Betty Warburton**. Betty was born in Whitefield, Lancashire, on 21 Jun 1815. She was christened in Radcliffe, Stand Lane Chapel, Lancashire, on 23 Jun 1815.
- iii. **Simeon Warburton**. Simeon was born in Whitefield, Lancashire, on 21 Jun 1815. He was christened in Radcliffe, Stand Lane Chapel, Lancashire, on 23 Jun 1815.

Simeon has not been found in censuses.

- iv. **Alice Warburton**. Alice was born in Whitefield, Lancashire, abt 1821.
- v. **Sarah Warburton**. Sarah was born in Whitefield, Lancashire, abt 1823.

6. Richard Warburton (*William², William¹*). Richard was born in Whitefield, Lancashire, on 16 Feb 1785. He was christened in Radcliffe, St Mary, Lancashire, on 27 Feb 1785. ■ Census for Kearsley, Lancashire, in 1841. Richard (55) is a labourer living in Hulbert Square with Mary (40), James (15) a crofter, Margaret (3) and Samuel (3 months).

Richard was only known from the IGI submission, until I made contact with his descendant David Clifford Warburton, who provided details of his descent, which I have expanded. In addition I was given details of Richard's eldest son James's descendants by Julia Francis.

His date of death is unknown. It was before 1861 when Mary is a widow, and probably before 1851 when Mary and 2 of her children are living in Derbyshire, although she is described as married.

On 1 Jan 1806 when Richard was 20, he first married **Esther Bennett** in Radcliffe, St Mary, Lancashire. Richard was a whister, and both were 'of this parish'. Esther was born abt 1785. Esther died in Kearsley, Lancashire, in 1834. She was buried in Radcliffe, St Mary, Lancashire, on 16 Feb 1834.

Third Generation

They had the following children:

- i. **Hannah Warburton**. Hannah was born on 18 Aug 1808. She was christened in Radcliffe, St Mary, Lancashire, on 25 Sep 1808.

Father's occupation on Hannah's baptism record is whitster (bleacher).

- ii. **John Warburton**. John was born on 1 Dec 1810. He was christened in Radcliffe, St Mary, Lancashire, on 13 Jan 1811. John died on 4 May 1812. He was buried in Radcliffe, St Mary, Lancashire, on 7 May 1812.

Father's occupation on John's baptism and burial records is whitster (bleacher).

- iii. **Betty Warburton**. Betty was born in Radcliffe, Lancashire, on 4 Jan 1814. She was christened in Radcliffe, St Mary, Lancashire, on 20 Feb 1814.

Father's occupation on Betty's baptism record is whitster (bleacher).

- 11 iv. **Joseph Warburton** (1816-)
- v. **Thomas Warburton**. Thomas was born in Kearsley, Lancashire, on 6 Aug 1818. He was christened in Radcliffe, St Mary, Lancashire, on 20 Sep 1818.

Father's occupation on Thomas's baptism record is whitster (bleacher).

Thomas has not been found in any census but there is no obvious death registration either.

- vi. **Mary Warburton**. Mary was born in Ringley, Lancashire, on 1 Dec 1820. She was christened in Radcliffe, St Mary, Lancashire, on 28 Jan 1821.

Father's occupation on Mary's baptism record is whitster (bleacher).

- vii. **Peter Warburton**. Peter was born in Kearsley, Lancashire, on 31 Jan 1823. He was christened in Radcliffe, St Mary, Lancashire, on 30 Mar 1823. Peter died in Kearsley, Lancashire, in May 1829. He was buried in Radcliffe, St Mary, Lancashire, on 24 May 1829.

Father's occupation on Peter's baptism record is crofter (a bleacher of cloth).

- 12 viii. **James Warburton** (1826-1879)

On 9 Oct 1836 when Richard was 51, he second married **Mary Openshaw** in Eccles, St Mary the Virgin, Lancashire. Mary was born in 1802. She was christened in Little Lever, St Matthew, Lancashire, on 18 Apr 1802. ■ Census for Simmondley, Derbyshire, in 1851. Mary Warbuton (Warlutton in Ancestry) aged 50 is a paper sorter, described as married, and lodging in Charlestown with Thomas Clarke, together with Samuel (10) a wool tenter, and Sarah (7). ■ Census for Farnworth, Lancashire, in 1861. Mary Warbuton (Warbritton in Ancestry) aged 58 is a widow living in King Street with Samuel (20) a cotton worker (stripper and grinder), and Sarah A (15) a cotton worker (rover).

Third Generation

Mary's parents were John and Mary who were living next door to Mary in the 1841 census. John was a paper maker and this may explain Mary's stepson James's change of occupation.

They had the following children:

- i. **Margaret Warburton**. Margaret was born in Kearsley, Lancashire, in 1838. She was christened in Ringley, St Saviour, Lancashire, on 25 Mar 1838.

Margaret's birth was registered in 1q 1838 Bolton 21 153, mother's maiden name Openshaw. Her father's occupation on her baptism record is bleacher.

- ii. **Samuel Warburton** (1841-1907)
- iii. **Sarah Ellen Warburton**. Sarah Ellen was born in Kearsley, Lancashire, in 1845. She was christened in Ringley, St Saviour, Lancashire, on 5 Jul 1845.

Sarah's birth was registered in 3q 1845 Bolton 21 160, mother's maiden name Openshaw. Her father's occupation on her baptism record is labourer.

Fourth Generation

7. William Warburton (*John³, George², William¹*). William was born in Pilkington, Lancashire, in 1796. He was christened in Radcliffe, St Mary, Lancashire, on 21 Feb 1796. ■ Census for Rochdale, Lancashire, in 1841. William (45) is a power loom weaver living at Tong End with Hannah (40), Lydia (16) and Sarah (13) both power loom weavers, and Sarah Howarth (3). ■ Census for Spotland, Lancashire, in 1851. William (55) is a power weaver living at Whitworth with Hannah (52), Lydia (25) an unmarried power weaver, and three grandchildren Roda (2), Alice (1 mth), and John (5). ■ Census for Wardleworth, Lancashire, in 1861. William (64) is a widowed power loom weaver living with his married daughter Hannah Smith (36) a power loom weaver, in Alma Street. Also present is Hannah's nephew John Warburton (15) a warehouseman. William died in Rochdale, Lancashire, in 1864.

William is identified as the son of John and Lydia because of his age, and the naming of his daughter Lydia. His death was registered in 1q 1864 Rochdale 8e 53, aged 68, district Wardleworth (Lancashire BMD).

William and Hannah had their four children baptised together at Hope chapel. The record shows them living in Mountpleasant, Wardleworth. William is a weaver. Hannah's maiden name is Tweedale (sic). Samuel's date of birth is given as December 1830 although the baptism was on October 8th.

The identities of the 3 grandchildren in the 1851 census have not been determined as no consistent records have been found. There is no registration of a Roda, but there is an Amanda at the right time and place. Both she and Alice have mother's maiden name Warburton so they may be illegitimate daughters of Lydia or Sarah. The closest John has a mother's maiden name of Chadwick, but there is no matching marriage to a son of William.

On 30 Jul 1815 when William was 19, he married **Hannah Tweedall** in Middleton, St Leonard, Lancashire. William was a weaver. Hannah was born in Wardleworth, Lancashire, abt 1797. Hannah died in Rochdale, Lancashire, in 1859.

Hannah's death was registered in 3q 1859 Rochdale 8e 29, aged 61, district Wardleworth (Lancashire BMD).

Fourth Generation

They had the following children:

- i. **Hannah Warburton**. Hannah was born in Wardleworth, Lancashire, on 11 Jan 1824. She was christened in Rochdale, Hope Chapel, Lancashire, on 8 Oct 1830.

On 4 Jun 1843 when Hannah was 19, she married **David Smith** in Rochdale, St Chad, Lancashire. David and Hannah were minors residing in Spotland, fathers James Smith and William Warburton, both weavers.

- ii. **Lydia Warburton**. Lydia was born in Wardleworth, Lancashire, on 30 Jan 1826. She was christened in Rochdale, Lancashire, on 6 Mar 1826. She was christened in Rochdale, Hope Chapel, Lancashire, on 8 Oct 1830.

Lydia was probably baptised twice. There is a baptism in Rochdale shortly after her birth though her mother's name is Ann. She and her three siblings were then baptised in Hope Chapel (Peculiar baptist) in 1830.

- iii. **Sarah Warburton**. Sarah was born in Wardleworth, Lancashire, on 12 May 1828. She was christened in Rochdale, Hope Chapel, Lancashire, on 8 Oct 1830.
- iv. **Samuel Warburton**. Samuel was born in Wardleworth, Lancashire, on 13 Dec 1830. He was christened in Rochdale, Hope Chapel, Lancashire, on 8 Oct 1830.

The Hope chapel record lists Samuel as being baptised 2 months before his birth. Quite what this means is unclear. He doesn't appear in any censuses but no death record has been found.

8. James Warburton (*John³, George², William¹*). James was born in Pilkington, Lancashire, on 10 Aug 1800. He was christened in Trowbridge, Baptist Ministry, Wiltshire, in 1800. ■ Census for Trowbridge, Wiltshire, in 1841. James (40) is a weaver living in Shails Lane with Martha (45), James (17), and John Milgrove (3). ■ Census for Trowbridge, Wiltshire, in 1851. James (48) is a cloth weaver living in Shails Lane with Martha (56) and grandsons John (13), and Frederick (11). ■ Census for Trowbridge, Wiltshire, in 1861. James (62) is a trolley weaver living in the High Street with Martha (67) a winder. ■ Census for Trowbridge, Wiltshire, in 1871. James (72) is a widowed annuitant living alone in Shails Lane (but close to grandson John and his family). James died in Trowbridge, Wiltshire, in 1874.

James is assumed to have been born in Pilkington because he was not born in Wiltshire on the 1841 census. His death was registered in 4q 1874 Melksham 5a 77, aged 75.

On 28 Mar 1819 when James was 18, he married **Martha Edwards** in Trowbridge, St James, Wiltshire. Martha was born abt 1795. Martha died in Trowbridge, Wiltshire, in 1868.

Martha's death was registered in 2q 1868 Melksham 5a 72, aged 74.

9. Gideon Warburton (*John³, George², William¹*). Gideon was born in Rochdale, Lancashire, on 14 Sep 1808. Gideon (42) is an ironmonger's clerk living at 1 Anns Terrace with Ann Ellis (42), Henry Gideon (19) a pianoforte tuner, and neice Eliza Flemming (8). ■ Census for St Pancras, Middlesex, in 1861. Gideon (51) is a traveller in metals living at 3 Northampton Cottage with Ann E (52), and lodger Adolphus White (30) a professor of music. ■ Census for St Pancras, Middlesex, in 1871. Gideon (62) is a commercial traveller in hardware living at 56 Albert Street with Ann E (62). Gideon died in St Pancras, Middlesex, in 1879.

Gideon's death was registered in 1q 1879 Islington 1b 289, aged 70.

On 3 Sep 1829 when Gideon was 20, he married **Ann Ellis Wigley** in Westminster, St Marylebone, Middlesex.

They had one child:

10. John Warburton (*John³, George², William¹*). John was born in Trowbridge, Wiltshire, on 4 Aug 1815. He was christened in Trowbridge, Baptist Ministry, Wiltshire, in 1815. ■ Census for Southill, Bedfordshire, in 1851. John (35) is a baptist minister living in Chapel House with Emma (33), John (10), Lydia (7), Ebenezer (5), and Manoah (2). ■ Census for Southill, Bedfordshire, in 1861. John (45) is a baptist minister living with Emma (43), Lydia (17) a dressmaker, Ebenezer (15) a miller (apprentice?), Manoah (12), Phineas (8), Ruth (6), Elizabeth (1), and visitor Henry Mitchell (47). ■ Census for Southill, Bedfordshire, in 1871. John (55) is a baptist minister living in the Baptist Minister's House with Emma (53), Manoah (22) a grocer, Phineas (18) a schoolmaster, Ruth (15), Elizabeth (11), and a servant. John died in 1892.

John's death was registered in 1q 1892 Biggleswade 3b 295, aged 76.

In 1838 when John was 22, he married **Emma Rudman** in Trowbridge, St James, Wiltshire. The marriage was registered in 3q 1838 Melksham 8 452.

Fourth Generation

They had the following children:

- i. **John Warburton**. John was born in City of London, in 1840.

John's birth was registered in 2q 1840 East London 2 208, mother's maiden name Rudman.

John appears in censuses as a Solicitor with a wife, Mary, 2 daughters and a son. He has yet to be explored in detail.

- ii. **Lydia Warburton**. Lydia was born in City of London, in 1843.

Lydia's birth was registered in 3q 1843 St Marylebone 1 149, mother's maiden name Rudman.

- iii. **Ebenezer Warburton**. Ebenezer was born in Southill, Bedfordshire, in 1846.

Ebenezer's birth was registered in 1q 1846 Biggleswade 6 55, mother's maiden name Rudman.

Ebenezer appears in all censuses to 1911 where he is a miller and farmer in Southill having been married to Harriet Elizabeth for 41 years and had 11 children, 8 still living. He has yet to be explored in detail.

- iv. **William Warburton**. William was born in Southill, Bedfordshire, in 1848. William died in Southill, Bedfordshire, in 1848.

William's birth and death were registered in 1q 1848 Biggleswade 6 59, and 6 57, mother's maiden name Rudman.

- v. **Manoah Warburton**. Manoah was born in Southill, Bedfordshire, in 1849. Manoah died in 1938.

Manoah's birth was registered in 1q 1849 Biggleswade 6 60, mother's maiden name Rudman. His death was registered in 4q 1938 Biggleswade 3b 347, aged 89.

In the 1911 census Manoah is a grocer in Kent having been married to Jane Eliza for 31 years, but had no children. He has not been explored further.

On 17 Jul 1879 when Manoah was 30, he married **Jane Eliza Turner** in Henlow, Bedfordshire.

- vi. **Phineas Warburton**. Phineas was born in Southill, Bedfordshire, in 1852.

Phineas's birth was registered in 3q 1852 Biggleswade 3b 315, mother's maiden name Rudman.

In the 1911 census Phineas is a schoolmaster who has been married to Carrie Axford for 19 years and had one son, John Axford aged 18. Phineas and Carrie were recorded in the New York census in 1892. Carrie is American and John was

born in America. Phineas has yet to be documented further.

Ruth's birth was registered in 1q 1855 Biggleswade 3b 339, mother's maiden name Rudman.

Elizabeth's birth was registered in 4q 1859 Biggleswade 3b 345, mother's maiden name Rudman.

11. Joseph Warburton (*Richard*³, *William*², *William*¹). Joseph was born in Radcliffe, Lancashire, on 16 Mar 1816. He was christened in Radcliffe, St Mary, Lancashire, on 5 May 1816. ■ Census for Manchester, Lancashire, in 1841. Joseph (25) is a bleacher living in Back Drinkwater Street with Mary (20) a rag cutter, and Jane (3). ■ Census for Whitfield, Glossop, Derbyshire, in 1851. Joseph (35) is a farmer of 35 acres living at Whitfield Leach with Mary (30), Jane (13), Henry (7), Enoch (4), Samuel (2), and Eliza (3 mths).

Father's occupation on Joseph's baptism record is whitster (bleacher).

None of the family can be found in the 1861 or subsequent censuses so they possibly emigrated.

On 30 Oct 1836 when Joseph was 20, he married **Mary Chadderton** in Eccles, St Mary the Virgin, Lancashire. Mary was born in Harpurhey, Lancashire, in 1820. She was christened in Manchester Cathedral, Lancashire, on 24 Dec 1820.

Mary was the daughter of Jonathan Chadderton of Manchester, a paper maker. Harpurhey is just north of Manchester.

Mary is the most likely candidate for the Mary who married Joseph because she is the correct age, from roughly the right place, and married in the same church used by Joseph's father for his marriage to Mary Openshaw three weeks earlier.

Jane's birth was registered in 1q 1838 Manchester 20 354, mother's maiden name Chadderton.

Samuel's birth was registered in 2q 1847 Hayfield 19 617, mother's maiden name Chatterton (sic). He has not been investigated further.

- iv. **Enoch Warburton**. Enoch was born in Glossop, Derbyshire, in 1849.

Enoch's birth was registered in 2q 1849 Hayfield 19 617, mother's maiden name Chadderton. The 1851 census has him aged 4 and born in Smedley, Manchester so Enoch and Samuel's ages were probably mixed up. He has not been investigated further.

- v. **Eliza Warburton**. Eliza was born in Glossop, Derbyshire, in 1851.

Eliza's birth was registered in 1q 1851 Hayfield 19 617, mother's maiden name Chatterton (sic).

12. James Warburton (*Richard*³, *William*², *William*¹). James was born in Kearsley, Lancashire, on 9 Aug 1826. He was christened in Ringley, St Saviour, Lancashire, on 10 Aug 1826. ■ Census for Kearsley, Lancashire, in 1851. James (24) is a bleacher living at Black Forest Green (Crompton Houses) with Alice (24) and Robert (1). ■ Census for Alton, Staffordshire, in 1861. James (33) is a paper maker living at Bottom of Bank with Mary (27), Robert (11), Thomas (6), Maria Ann (4), Mary Ester (2), and Joseph (11 mths). ■ Census for Sutton Courtenay, Berkshire, in 1871. James (43) is a paper maker living with Mary (37), Thomas (16) employed at paperworks, Maria A (14), Mary E (12), Elizabeth (8), Hannah (6), Joseph (4), James (3), and William H (1). James died in Sutton Courtenay, Berkshire, on 19 May 1879.

James was baptised twice, once at Ringley the day after he was born (father's occupation described as labourer), and again at St Mary, Radcliffe, on 23rd February 1834, aged 7. This was shortly after his mother's death. On this occasion his father was described as a crofter (a bleacher of cloth). Possibly the first baptism was rushed because he was considered sickly, but having survived, his father was minded to have him done properly after his mother's death.

James's death was registered in 2q 1879 Abingdon 2c 203, aged 51.

On 26 Aug 1849 when James was 23, he first married **Alice Reason** in Deane, St Mary, Bolton,

Lancashire. James was a crofter from Halliwell, father Richard, a husbandman. Alice was from Halliwell, father George, a weaver. The marriage was registered in 3q 1849 Bolton 21 118. Alice was born in Halliwell, Lancashire, abt 1827. Alice died in 1852.

Alice's death was registered in 2q 1852 Bolton 8c 110, age 26, sub-district Farnworth (Lancashire BMD).

They had one child:

- i. **Robert T Warburton**. Robert T was born in Kearsley, Lancashire, in 1850. ■ Census for Radcliffe, Lancashire, in 1881. Robert (33) is a paper mill worker living at 23 Eton Hill, with Dinah (35), and Carrie (13). ■ Census for North Manchester, Lancashire, in 1901. Robert (53) is a weaving shed labourer living with Robert and Caroline Ashworth (33) at 95 Stuart Street. Dinah (55) a housekeeper, is also there. Robert Ashworth is a loom underlooker and Caroline is a weaver. ■ Census for North Manchester, Lancashire, in 1911. Robert T (63) is living with Robert and Caroline Ashworth (43) at 151 Stuart Street, Clayton. Dinah (65) is also there. They have been married 40 years and had 2 children, one still living (presumably Caroline though she wasn't a child of the marriage). Robert Ashworth is a check weaving overlooker and Caroline is a check weaver. They have been married 23 years and had 6 children, 4 still living. Robert T died in 1915.

Robert's birth was registered 1q 1850 Bolton 21 169, mother's maiden name Reason. His death is probably that registered in 1q 1915 Prestwich 8d 517, aged 67. He seems to have added 2 years to his age in all censuses and at his death.

In 1870 when Robert T was 20, he married **Dinah Crompton** in Bury Register Office (or Registrar Attended). The marriage was registered in 3q 1870 Bury 8c 561. Dinah was born in Chapel Field, Radcliffe, Lancashire, abt 1855. Dinah died in North Manchester, Lancashire, in 1911.

Dinah had a daughter Caroline prior to her marriage to Robert. Caroline is referred to as Warburton in the 1881 census but married as Caroline Warburton Crompton.

Dinah's death was registered in 3q 1911 Prestwich 8d 638, aged 65.

In 1854 when James was 27, he second married **Mary Hester Kitchen** in Durham. Mary Hester was born in Durham in 1835. ■ Census for Reading, Berkshire, in 1881. Mary (46) is a fancy shopkeeper living at 107 Friar Street with James (13), Wm Hry (11) a shop boy, Richard G (9), Florence J (7), Charles O (5), and John B (2). Mary Hester died in Reading, Berkshire, in 1888.

Mary's death registration has not been found.

- iii. **Mary Ester Warburton**. Mary Ester was born in Hope, Flintshire, in 1858. Mary Ester died in Jun 1936.
- Mary's birth was registered in 3q 1858 Wrexham 11b 276, mother's maiden name Kitchen. No marriage or death registration has been found, so the source for her date of death is unknown.
- iv. **Elizabeth Warburton**. Elizabeth was born in Barnsley, Yorkshire, in 1862.
- Elizabeth's birth was registered in 2q 1862 Barnsley 9c 137, mother's maiden name Kilson (sic). She was already a widow by 1901 and had probably remarried by the 1911 census. She has not been investigated further.

John's birth was registered in 3q 1878 Abingdon 2c 315, mother's maiden name Kitchen. His death was registered in 4q 1946 Wellingborough 3b 595, aged 68. No marriage registration has been found, and he has not been found in the 1901 or 1911 censuses.

13. Samuel Warburton (*Richard*³, *William*², *William*¹). Samuel was born in Kearsley, Lancashire, on 25 Mar 1841. He was christened in Ringley, St Saviour, Lancashire, on 29 Mar 1841. ■ Census for Lostock, Lancashire, in 1881. Samuel (40) is a carder - cotton factory, living in Chew Moor Village with Elizabeth (29) a frametender, and Mary (5 mths). ■ Census for Westhoughton, Lancashire, in 1891. Samuel (50) is a widowed cotton carder living at 302 Church Street with Mary (10), Samuel (8), Percy (7), and Sarah (6). ■ Census for Walton Le Dale, Lancashire, in 1901. Samuel (60) is a retired overlooker of the cotton card room living at Knights Cottage with second wife Sarah (46), Mary (20) a cotton cardroom hand, Samuel (18) a cotton spinner, Percy (17), and Sarah (15) both cardroom hands. Also present are mother-in-law Ann Greenatch (Greenhalgh?) aged 85, and relation Ann Hunsworth (Unsworth?), aged 2. Samuel died on 6 Feb 1907.

Samuel's birth was registered in 2q 1841 Bolton 21 145, mother's maiden name Openshaw. His father's occupation on his baptism record is crofter (a bleacher of cloth).

In 1879 when Samuel was 37, he first married **Elizabeth Winward** in Westhoughton, St John, Lancashire. The marriage was registered in 3q 1879 Bolton 8c 406. Elizabeth was born in Chew Moor, Lostock, Lancashire, on 16 May 1852. Elizabeth died in Chew Moor, Lostock, Lancashire, on 11 Mar 1889.

With the exception of Percy, Samuel and Elizabeth's children were registered with their mother's maiden name as Bullough. There is no evidence of a previous Bullough-Winward marriage. One explanation is that Elizabeth was illegitimate and used both her mother's and father's names at various times.

Richard's birth was registered in 3q 1886 Bolton 8c 366, mother's maiden name Bullough, sub-district Horwich (LancashireBMD). His death was registered in 1q 1888 Bolton 8c 240, aged 1, sub-district Horwich (LancashireBMD)

On 14 Feb 1893 when Samuel was 51, he second married **Sarah Unsworth** in Bradshawgate Wesleyan Church, Bolton, Lancashire. Samuel (51) was a widowed cotton carder from Westhoughton, father Richard, a crofter. Sarah (39) was a housekeeper from Westhoughton, father John, a collier. The marriages was registered in 1q 1893 Bolton 8c 543. Sarah was born in Westhoughton, Lancashire, abt 1853.

He was christened in Trowbridge, Baptist Ministry, Wiltshire. ■ Census for Trowbridge, Wiltshire, in 1851. John (35) is a cloth weaver living in Shails Lane with Elizabeth (34) a yarn winder, Rhoda (6), Ellen (4), Emma (2), and Manoah (5 mths). ■ Census for Trowbridge, Wiltshire, in 1861. John (46) is a weaver living in the High Street with Elizabeth (43) a charwoman, Emma (12), Manoah (10), George (8), Alma (6), Fred (2), and Frank (2 mths). ■ Census for Trowbridge, Wiltshire, in 1871. John (50) is a labourer living in the Shails Lane with Elizabeth (53) a charwoman, Manoah (20), and George (17) cloth walkers?, Alma (15) a servant, Fred (12), and Frank (11), plus a boarder. ■ Census for Trowbridge, Wiltshire, in 1881. John (61) is a cloth yarner living 49 Shails Lane with Elizabeth (64) a charwoman, Frank (20) a carpenter, and grandson James (5). ■ Census for Trowbridge, Wiltshire, in 1891. John (72) is a general labourer living at 50 Shails Lane with Elizabeth (75). John died in Trowbridge, Wiltshire, in 1899. He was buried in Trowbridge Cemetery, Wiltshire, on 5 Dec 1899.

John is recognised as the father of the John and Frederick who were grandsons of his parents in the 1851 census because John Jr used the name Millgrove for the middle name of 2 of his daughters, and for his own on his marriage record. This would also suggest that Elizabeth was the mother of John and Frederick although they were born long before her marriage.

John's death was registered in 4q 1899 Melksham 5a 80, aged 77. He is the husband of Elizabeth, aged 77, in the Wiltshire Memorial Inscription Index.

In 1844 when John was 24, he married **Elizabeth Millgrove** in Trowbridge, Holy Trinity, Wiltshire. The marriage was registered in 2q 1844. Elizabeth was born abt 1819. Elizabeth died in Trowbridge, Wiltshire, in 1894. She was buried in Trowbridge Cemetery, Wiltshire, on 26 Oct 1894.

Elizabeth's death was registered in 4q 1894 Melksham 5a 66, aged 75. She is the wife of John, aged 75, in the Wiltshire Memorial Inscription Index.

John (33) is a dyer living in Shails Lane with Jane (30) a cloth worker, Emily (13) a housemaid, Fanny (11) a housemaid, Clara (9), William (7), Sidney (5), Charles (3), and Rosina (1). ■ Census for North Kingstown, Rhode Island, on 14 Jun 1880. John (43) is a dyer in a woollen mill living with Jane (39) keeping house, Emily (22), Clara (18), William (17), Sidney (16), and Mary G (14) all working in the woollen mill, Charles (12), Rosina (10), and John H (7). ■ Census for North Kingstown, Rhode Island, on 19 Jun 1900. John (63) is a mill labourer living with Jane (60), and William (37) a spinner. John and Jane have been married for 43 years and had 9 children, 8 still living (this ignores George who died in infancy in Trobridge). They live in their own house. John died in North Kingstown, Rhode Island, on 11 Jul 1906. He was buried in Elm Grove Cemetary, Rhode Island.

John is living with his grandfather, as John Milgrove in the 1841 census, and as John Warburton, along with brother Frederick, in the 1851 census.

His birth was registered as John William Milgrove in 1q 1838 Melksham 8 372. No mother's maiden name is given on gro.gov. He used the name Millgrove as a middle name for two of his daughters and for himself on his marriage record, where his father was named John. On his grave reference on Find A Grave he is called John Henry. His parents are named John and Elizabeth. All details of his children in Rhode Island are from Find A Grave.

John and his family emigrated to Rhode island. His naturalisation papers state he arrived in New York on June 9th 1873 having been born in Trowbridge in 1837, and was naturalised in May 1885. John had arrived on the **City of Montreal** with William (11), Fanny (9), Sydney (7), and Mary (6). The arrival of the rest of the family has not been found but they are all present in the 1880 census.

On his grave his date of birth is February 21st 1837, and in the 1900 Federal census his birth date is Febuary 1837. However his birth was registered in the first quarter of 1838 so he is presumed to be mistaken about the date.

On 9 Apr 1857 when John was 19, he married **Jane Gerrish** in Trowbridge, St James, Wiltshire. John is named John Milgrove Warburton, father John. Jane's father is James Gerrish. The marriage was registered in 2q 1857 Melksham 5a 205 and John is called John Warburton Milgrove. Jane was born in Trowbridge, Wiltshire, on 1 Jan 1840. Jane died in North Kingstown, Rhode Island, on 14 Jan 1902. She was buried in Elm Grove Cemetary, Rhode Island.

Sixth Generation

They had the following children:

- i. **Emily Warburton**. Emily was born in Trowbridge, Wiltshire, in 1857. Emily died in 1936. She was buried in Elm Grove Cemetary, Rhode Island.

Emily's birth registration has not been found online.

Aft 1887 when Emily was 30, she married **James Burrill Arnold**. Emily was James's second wife. His first wife died in 1887. There is no evidence that James and Emily had children. James Burrill was born in Exeter, Rhode Island, in Aug 1824. James Burrill died in North Kingstown, Rhode Island, on 5 Mar 1902. He was buried in Elm Grove Cemetary, Rhode Island.

- ii. **Fanny Millgrove Warburton**. Fanny Millgrove was born in Trowbridge, Wiltshire, in 1859. Fanny Millgrove died in North Kingstown, Rhode Island, on 2 Sep 1912. She was buried in Elm Grove Cemetary, Rhode Island.

Fanny's birth was registered in 4q 1859 Melksham 5a 110, mother's maiden name Gerrish.

On 22 May 1880 when Fanny Millgrove was 21, she married **William James Boyce** in North Kingstown, Rhode Island. Fanny and William had a son and a daughter. William James was born in 1861. William James died in 1922.

- iii. **Clara Millgrove Warburton**. Clara Millgrove was born in Trowbridge, Wiltshire, in Aug 1861. Clara Millgrove died in Peace Dale, Rhode Island, on 28 Jan 1927. She was buried in Riverside Cemetery, Rhode Island.

Clara's birth was registered in 4q 1861 Melksham 5a 95, mother's maiden name Gerrish.

On 3 Oct 1881 when Clara Millgrove was 20, she married **George Burnside Gavitt** in South Kingstown, Rhode Island. Clara and George had 3 boys and 3 girls.

George Burnside was born in South Kingstown, Rhode Island, in May 1862. George Burnside died in Peace Dale, Rhode Island, on 3 Mar 1944.

- iv. **William Warburton**. William was born in Trowbridge, Wiltshire, on 17 Feb 1863. William died on 18 May 1933. He was buried in Elm Grove Cemetary, Rhode Island.

William's birth was registered in 1q 1863 Melksham 5a 128, mother's maiden name Gerrish. He never married.

- v. **Sydney Warburton**. Sydney was born in Trowbridge, Wiltshire, on 19 Aug 1864. Sydney died on 23 Nov 1914. He was buried in Elm Grove Cemetary, Rhode Island.

Sidney's birth was registered in 3q 1864 Melksham 5a 113, mother's maiden name Gerrish.

Sixth Generation

On 9 Feb 1903 when Sydney was 38, he married **Margaret E Gorton**. It isn't known if Sydney and Margaret had children.

- vi. **Mary Jane Warburton**. Mary Jane was born in Trowbridge, Wiltshire, in 1866.

Mary's birth was registered in 2q 1866 Melksham 5a 112, mother's maiden name Gerrish. Nothing is known of her life in Rhode Island.

- vii. **Charles Warburton**. Charles was born in Trowbridge, Wiltshire, in 1867. Charles died in 1900. He was buried in Elm Grove Cemetary, Rhode Island.

Charles's birth registration has not been found online.

Charles married **Marion K**. The date of the marriage, or if Charles and Marion had children, is unknown. Marion K was born in 1867. Marion K died in 1935. She was buried in Elm Grove Cemetary, Rhode Island.

- viii. **Rosina Warburton**. Rosina was born in Trowbridge, Wiltshire, on 20 Aug 1869. Rosina died in Hope Valley, Rhode Island, in 1953. She was buried in Elm Grove Cemetary, Rhode Island.

Rosina's birth was registered in 3q 1869 Melksham 5a 118, mother's maiden name Gerrish. By the time of her burial her name was rendered as Roseina.

Rosina married **Alvin T Phillips**. Alvin and Rosina had 2 sons and a daughter, but the date of their marriage is unknown. Alvin T was born in Rhode Island, on 20 Jun 1867. Alvin T died in 1932. He was buried in Elm Grove Cemetary, Rhode Island.

- ix. **George Warburton**. George was born in Trowbridge, Wiltshire, in 1871.

George's birth was registered in 3q 1871 Melksham 5a 118, mother's maiden name Gerrish. His death was registered in 2q 1871 Melksham 5a 72, aged 0.

- 30 x. **John Henry Warburton** (1872-1933)

24. **Alma Warburton** (*John⁵, James⁴, John³, George², William¹*). Alma was born in Trowbridge, Wiltshire, in 1855.

Alma's birth was registered in 3q 1855 Melksham 5a 109, mother's maiden name Millgrove.

Alma first had a relationship with **unknown father**.

They had one child:

- 31 i. **James Frederick Warburton** (1875-1958)

In 1887 when Alma was 32, she second married **William Wright** in Trowbridge, Wiltshire. The marriage was registered in 2q 1887 Melksham 5a 216.

25. **Herbert Warburton** (*Henry Gideon⁵, Gideon⁴, John³, George², William¹*). Herbert was born in

Camden Town, Middlesex, in 1868. ■ Census for Muswell Hill, Middlesex, in 1911. Herbert (42) is a printer (letterpress) living in an 8 room house at 3 Woodside Villas, Tenterdown, Muswell Hill with Edith Mary (42), Alan Glyde (13), Emily Mary Gregory (65), and a servant. Herbert and Edith had been married 14 years and had one child, still living.

Herbert's birth was registered in 4q 1868 Pancras 1b 129, mother's maiden name Grey. His death registration hasn't been found.

In 1896 when Herbert was 28, he married **Edith Mary Gregory**. The marriage was registered in 3q 1896 Pancras 1b 333. No further children were registered in the London area with mother's maiden name Gregory after the 1911 census. Edith Mary was born in Kentish Town, London, abt 1868.

They had one child:

- 32 i. **Alan Glyde Warburton** (1897-1967)

26. Thomas James Warburton (*Thomas Ernest⁵, James⁴, Richard³, William², William¹*). Thomas James was born in Sutton Courtenay, Berkshire, in 1878. ■ Census for Oxford, Oxfordshire, in 1911. Thomas (32) is a general merchant living at 25 Parker Street with Louisa (33), Charles (12), Olive (7), Thomas (1) and a servant. Thomas and Louisa have been married 12 years and had 4 children, 3 still living. This seems to be a white lie to explain Charles's age as they only married in 1903. Thomas James died in 1928.

Thomas's birth was registered in 2q 1878 Abingdon 2c 295, mother's maiden name Brice. His death was registered in 1q 1928 Headington 3a 1363, aged 49.

In 1903 when Thomas James was 25, he married **Louisa Laura Hounslow**. The marriage was registered in 3q 1903 Abingdon 2c 637. Louisa Laura was born in Oxford, Oxfordshire, in Jan 1878. Louisa Laura died in 1958.

Louisa's birth was registered in 1q 1878 Oxford 3a 706. She was living at St Ebbe, Oxford in 1881, and with her widowed mother at St Aldate, Oxford in 1901. Her death was registered in 2q 1958 Oxford 6b 907, aged 80.

In 1909 when Ernest was 25, he married **Caroline May Aldridge**. The marriage was registered in 2q 1909 Oxford 3a 1949. Caroline May died in Oxford, Oxfordshire, in 1970. Caroline May was born in St Thomas, Oxford, Oxfordshire, in May 1885.

They had the following children:

- i. **Rita May Warburton**. Rita May died in Nov 1984. Rita May was born in Reading, Berkshire, in 1910.

Rita's birth was registered in 2q 1910 Reading 2c 355, mother's maiden name Aldridge.

Barbara's birth was registered in 4q 1915 Oxford 3a 1800, mother's maiden name Milsted. Her death was registered in 2q 1979 Abingdon 20 2030, aged 63.

In 1938 when Barbara Joan (Geda) was 22, she married **Humphrey S J Ansell** in Oxfordshire. The marriage was registered in 2q 1938 Abingdon 2c 937a. Two boys and a girl were registered at Oxford with a mother's maiden name of Warburton between 1942 and 1949.

29. Arthur Lionel Warburton (*Thomas Ernest⁵, James⁴, Richard³, William², William¹*). Arthur Lionel was born in Oct 1898. Arthur Lionel died in Oxford, Oxfordshire, on 8 Sep 1952.

Arthur's birth was registered in 4q 1898 Oxford 3a 861, mother's maiden name Brice. His death was registered in 3q 1952 Oxford 6b 714, aged 53.

On 30 Apr 1936 when Arthur Lionel was 37, he married **Mollie Maureen Chandler** in Berkshire. The marriage was registered in 2q 1936 Reading 2c 1035. Arthur and Mollie also had a second son, who in turn had three sons. Mollie Maureen was born in Reading, Berkshire, on 26 Oct 1905. Mollie Maureen died in Michael Sobell House, Oxford, Oxfordshire, 14th December 1978.

Sixth Generation

They had the following children:

- i. **Helen Jill Maureen Warburton**. Helen Jill Maureen was born in Reading, Berkshire, in 1937. Helen Jill Maureen died in Cumnor, Oxford, in 1993.

Helen's birth was registered in 1q 1937 Reading 2c 507, mother's maiden name Chandler. Neither her marriage, nor her death registrations have been found.

In 1960 when Helen Jill Maureen was 23, she married **Mr Francis**. A boy and a girl were registered at Portsmouth/Gosport in 1961/3.

- ii. **William Clayton Warburton**. William Clayton was born in Oxford, Oxfordshire, in Jun 1943. William Clayton died in North Hinksey, Oxfordshire, in 2011.

William's birth was registered in 3q 1943 Oxford 3a 2594, mother's maiden name Chandler.

In 1966 when William Clayton was 22, he married **Margaret Elizabeth Mary Turnbull** in Oxford, Oxfordshire. The marriage was registered in 3q 1966 Oxford 6b 2633. William and Margaret had 2 sons and a daughter. Margaret Elizabeth Mary died in North Hinksey, Oxfordshire, in 2011.

John H (27) is a piano tuner living in a rented house with Sarah (32) a weaver, and Earl (5). John and Sarah have been married 5 years and had one child. As Sarah's date of birth matches that of Laura on her grave stone it is assumed Sarah and Laura are the same person and Sarah was entered in error. John Henry died on 30 Oct 1933. He was buried in Elm Grove Cemetary, Rhode Island.

John's birth was registered in 1q 1873 Melksham 5a 124, mother's maiden name Gerrish.

John Henry married **Laura A Huling**. Laura A was born on 2 Oct 1867. Laura A died on 16 Oct 1959. She was buried in Elm Grove Cemetary, Rhode Island.

They had one child:

- i. **Earl James Warburton**. Earl James was born in North Kingstown, Rhode Island, on 30 Apr 1895. Earl James died on 4 Feb 1986. He was buried in Elm Grove Cemetary, Rhode Island.

It is noted on Find A Grave that he was divorced according to the 1930 census, but his spouse's name is unknown.

31. James Frederick Warburton (*Alma⁶, John⁵, James⁴, John³, George², William¹*). James Frederick was born in Trowbridge, Wiltshire, in 1875. ■ Census for Trowbridge, Wiltshire, in 1901. James (25) is a carpenter living at 26 Mount Pleasant with his mother Alma Wright (44) a laundress. ■ Census for Trowbridge, Wiltshire, in 1911. James (34) is a carpenter builder living at 24 Ashton Street with Beatrice Florence (29), Florence Evelyn (3) and Beatrice May (18 mths). James and Beatrice have been married 3 years and had 2 children. James Frederick died in Trowbridge, Wiltshire, in 1958.

James's birth was registered in 4q 1875 Melksham 5a 120. His mother's maiden name isn't shown on gro.gov. His death was registered in 3q 1958 Trowbridge 7c 463, aged 82.

In 1907 when James Frederick was 32, he married **Beatrice Florence Evers** in Trowbridge, Wiltshire. The marriage was registered in 2q 1907 Melksham 5a 236. Beatrice Florence was born in North Bradley, Wiltshire, in 1882. Beatrice Florence died in Trowbridge, Wiltshire, in 1963.

Beatrice's birth was registered in 1q 1882 Westbury 5a 136. Her death was registered in 2q 1963 Trowbridge 7c 595, aged 81.

David's birth was registered in 1q 1928 Barnet 3a 705, mother's maiden name Daman (sic).

His death was notified in The Stirling Observer 15 Jan 2016:

WARBURTON - DAVID JOHN, who has lived in Doune since 1969, died in his sleep on the 12th of January 2016, aged 88. He was never a man who placed emphasis on ceremony and bearing that in mind his family have decided not to hold a funeral service. He will, of course, be much missed by his wife Jean, his daughters, his son and four grandchildren.
