# PREFACE



This clan details the descendants of George and Ann (or Anna) nee Rainsford of Turton, and in particular of his son John Warburton (1708-1786).

There is an older Warburton family at Turton in the 17th century, and some contemporary families at Turton in 19th century censuses. However these have not been linked together. One problem is the family's frequent use of Walmsley Unitarian Chapel whose records are incomplete.

The bulk of the clan is based on input from Ken Warburton and features his grandfather Fred Warburton, a professional footballer. Ken's story of Fred's life and career, **Rolling Your Own Life**, featured in issue 2 of **The Button Files**.

**1. Warburton.**

The father of George and John is unknown. Nor is it known how, or if George and John are related to Thomas Warburton of the Old Turton Family, who died in 1674. The two families use similar names. John, James and Thomas are used in both. Robert is also repeated in the 19th century. George is not found in Thomas's known family however.

If George's son was born in 1708 his own birth would be circa 1680 making him roughly contemporary with Thomas's grandchildren, thus ruling out descent from one of them. A common ancestor is therefore likely to be at least a generation before Thomas.

**2. John Warburton** (<sup>1</sup>). John died in Turton, Lancashire, in 1738.

John signed a will on 19th June 1738 which was proved on June 18th 1739. John's inventory was dated June 23rd 1738. It was valued at £60 17s 2d and included farm animals and equipment. Nephew John was one of the assessors.

His will left everything to his wife Mary for her life, and thereafter to John Warburton, son of George. It is not stated but George is presumed to be John's brother. The estate included a messuage called Horragees (sic) held by lease from Samuel Cheatham. There were small bequests (20 shillings) to Anne wife of Tho. Halliwell (this was actually £20), Izabell wife of William Kerkom, and James, Tho., and John Wadikar. These are assumed to be 2 married daughters and 3 grandchildren.

John married **Mary**.

They had the following children:

i. **Ann Warburton**.

Ann married **Thomas Halliwell**.

ii. **Izabell Warburton**.

Izabell married **William Kerkom**.

iii. **Miss Warburton**.

Miss Warburton married **Mr Wadikar**. Three children, presumed grandchildren, James, Thomas, and John, were left a bequest in John Warburton's will.

**3. George Warburton** (<sup>1</sup>).

On 26 Oct 1708 George married **Ann Rainford** in Bolton, St Peter, Lancashire.

They had the following children:

ii. **Margaret Warburton**. Margaret was born in Turton, Lancashire, in 1713. She was christened in Bolton, St Peter, Lancashire, on 8 Nov 1713.

Margret (sic) was the daughter of George and Anna of Turton on her baptism record.

**4. John Warburton** (*George<sup>2</sup>, <sup>1</sup>*). John was born in Turton, Lancashire, in 1708. He was christened in Bolton, St Peter, Lancashire, on 25 Dec 1708. John died in Turton, Lancashire, in 1786. He was buried in Walmsley Unitarian Chapel (aka Walmsley Meeting House), Bolton, Lancashire, on 9 Jan 1786.

John was the son of George and Anna of Turton on his baptism record. John's burial record gives his age at death as 78.

John's will was signed on 1st May 1785 and proved on 8th May 1788. It describes several properties, Horridges (leasehold), Thirkhams in Darwen, and The Stones (freehold, and including a school and other appurtenances). His wife Elizabeth received Horridges for the rest of the lease, plus the rents from Thirkhams, and interest from £200 invested. There is also mention of a share in an 'Engine'. Son George received The Stones, and son James received Thirkhams after 12 years. There are also bequests to the children of son John (presumably deceased) and four unnamed daughters.

Michael Wood's tree on Ancestry includes George (1750) and James (1760) but does not link them. Both are also included in Family Search pedigree files. However there are other IGI files which identify 7 children of John Warburton and Elizabeth Halliwell, and although the dates are obviously estimates they are based on John and Elizabeth's marriage date, and correspond with the children described in the will.

It seems that sons George and James both married an Ann Kay. There are separate dates on IGI for the marriages, and both James and George's children's baptisms name their mother as Ann Kay. This precludes George (1750) from being James's brother as he is said to have married a Jenny. Also George and Jenny's, son George was baptised, at Deane which is in south Bolton whereas Turton is north of Bolton.

On 10 Feb 1741 when John was 33, he married **Elizabeth Halliwell** in Bolton, Lancashire. Elizabeth was born abt 1717. Elizabeth died in Turton, Lancashire, on 23 Sep 1796. She was buried in Walmsley Unitarian Chapel (aka Walmsley Meeting House), Bolton, Lancashire.

Elizabeth's will, proven in 1796, is in the Lancashire Wills index but the actual will has been misplaced. Her burial record gives her age at death as 79.

They had the following children:

- i. **John Warburton**. John was born in Turton, Lancashire, abt 1744. John died in Turton, Lancashire, on 16 Aug 1775. He was buried in Walmsley Unitarian Chapel (aka Walmsley Meeting House), Bolton, Lancashire.

John had unnamed children who received bequests in their grandfather's will. He was buried in the grave subsequently occupied by his parents, at the age of 31.

**5. George Warburton** (*John*<sup>3</sup>, *George*<sup>2</sup>, <sup>1</sup>). George was born in Turton, Lancashire, abt 1746. George died on 9 Sep 1828. He was buried in Walmsley Unitarian Chapel (aka Walmsley Meeting House), Bolton, Lancashire.

George's baptism cannot be found on Family Search or on Lancashire Parishes On-line at Turton. However his approximate date of birth can be determined from his age of 82 on his burial record.

On 4 Nov 1772 when George was 26, he married **Ann Kay** in Bolton, Lancashire. Ann was born in Bolton, Lancashire, abt 1751. Ann died on 19 Sep 1825. She was buried in Walmsley Unitarian Chapel (aka Walmsley Meeting House), Bolton, Lancashire.

Ann was buried with her husband and three of her children, at age 74.

They had the following children:

- i. **John Warburton**. John was born abt 1773. John died in Walmsley Unitarian Chapel (aka Walmsley Meeting House), Bolton, Lancashire, on 17 Dec 1801.

John is known from his burial, aged 28.

- 7 ii. **George Warburton** (~1775-1833)
- iii. **Betty Warburton**. Betty was born abt 1776. Betty died on 3 Mar 1821. She was buried in Walmsley Unitarian Chapel (aka Walmsley Meeting House), Bolton, Lancashire.

Betty is known from her burial, aged 45.

- 8 iv. **Thomas Warburton** (1785-1836)
- v. **Samuel Warburton**. Samuel was born abt 1793. Samuel died on 13 Dec 1795. He was buried in Walmsley Unitarian Chapel (aka Walmsley Meeting House), Bolton, Lancashire.

Samuel is known from his burial, aged 2.

**6. James Warburton** (*John*<sup>3</sup>, *George*<sup>2</sup>, <sup>1</sup>). James was born in Turton, Lancashire, abt 1757. James died on 24 Aug 1813. He was buried in Walmsley Unitarian Chapel (aka Walmsley Meeting House), Bolton, Lancashire.

James is known from several references in Family Search Pedigree files, and Ancestry trees. However his baptism cannot be found on Family Search or on Lancashire Parishes On-line at Turton.

A burial record at Walmsley Unitarian Chapel (aka Walmsley Meeting House) is taken to be James as it is the only James of about the right age, as are children Betty and Samuel who are buried

with him. Also his wife's name is Annie, though this is the only place she is called Annie and not Ann. His age at death is 56. The burial records include two younger children whose baptisms have not been found, as after about 1793 Walmsley Meeting House baptisms are not on Lancashire Parishes Online.

James is living at Orrell's, Turton at the time of John's baptism, and at Horridge's, Turton for all other known baptisms, thus identifying him as the son of John.

On 9 Oct 1782 when James was 25, he married **Ann(ie) Kay** in Turton, Lancashire. Ann(ie) was born in Turton, Lancashire, abt 1761. Ann(ie) died on 28 May 1841. She was buried in Walmsley Unitarian Chapel (aka Walmsley Meeting House), Bolton, Lancashire.

Annie was 80 on her burial record.

They had the following children:

  - ii. **Betty Warburton**. Betty was born in Turton, Lancashire, in 1784. She was christened in Walmsley Unitarian Chapel (aka Walmsley Meeting House), Bolton, Lancashire, on 19 Aug 1784. Betty died on 24 Jul 1861. She was buried in Walmsley Unitarian Chapel (aka Walmsley Meeting House), Bolton, Lancashire.  
  
Betty and her husband were buried with her parents. She was 76 at death.  
  
Betty married **Thomas Kershaw**. Thomas was born abt 1771. Thomas died on 18 Jul 1843. He was buried in Walmsley Unitarian Chapel (aka Walmsley Meeting House), Bolton, Lancashire.  
  
Thomas was 72 at death.
  - iii. **Thomas Warburton**. Thomas was born in Turton, Lancashire, in 1785. He was christened in Walmsley Unitarian Chapel (aka Walmsley Meeting House), Bolton, Lancashire, on 15 May 1785. Thomas died bef 1794.  
  
Thomas was baptised the son of George and Ann of Stones, Turton. He must have died by 1794 when a second Thomas was baptised.
  - iv. **Elizabeth Warburton**. Elizabeth was born in Turton, Lancashire, on 21 Mar 1787. She was christened in Walmsley Unitarian Chapel (aka Walmsley Meeting House), Bolton, Lancashire, on 17 Apr 1787.
  - v. **Samuel Warburton**. Samuel was born in Turton, Lancashire, on 15 Dec 1789. He was christened in Walmsley Unitarian Chapel (aka Walmsley Meeting House), Bolton, Lancashire, on 12 Feb 1790. Samuel died on 16 Dec 1814. He was buried in Walmsley Unitarian Chapel (aka Walmsley Meeting House), Bolton, Lancashire.

Samuel's age at death is given as 26, though he would be just 25.

- vi. **Ann Warburton**. Ann was born in Turton, Lancashire, on 26 Jan 1793. She was christened in Walmsley Unitarian Chapel (aka Walmsley Meeting House), Bolton, Lancashire, on 2 May 1793.
- vii. **Thomas Warburton**. Thomas was born abt 1794. Thomas died on 15 Jun 1835. He was buried in Walmsley Unitarian Chapel (aka Walmsley Meeting House), Bolton, Lancashire.

Thomas is only known from his burial, with his parents, aged 41.

- viii. **Mary Warburton**. Mary was born abt 1797. Mary died on 19 Jun 1813. She was buried in Walmsley Unitarian Chapel (aka Walmsley Meeting House), Bolton, Lancashire.

Mary is only known from her burial, aged 16 with her parents.

7. **George Warburton** (*George<sup>4</sup>, John<sup>3</sup>, George<sup>2</sup>, <sup>1</sup>*). George was born abt 1775. George died in 1833. He was buried in Walmsley Unitarian Chapel (aka Walmsley Meeting House), Bolton, Lancashire, on 20 Sep 1833.

George is presumed to be the son of George because his address for the baptism of his children is the Old School, Turton and a school was included in Stones, which George the elder inherited. George died aged 58.

On 10 Nov 1802 when George was 27, he married **Hannah Crook** in Bolton, St Peter, Lancashire. George was a weaver, and both were 'of this parish'. Hannah was born in Turton, Lancashire, on 8 Feb 1783. She was christened in Walmsley Unitarian Chapel (aka Walmsley Meeting House), Bolton, Lancashire, on 6 Apr 1786. Hannah died in 1862. She was buried in Walmsley Unitarian Chapel (aka Walmsley Meeting House), Bolton, Lancashire, on 25 Jul 1862.

Hannah was the daughter of Robert Crook and Jane Halliwell. Her death was registered in 3q 1862 Bolton 8c 129, aged 78, sub-district Turton (LancashireBMD).

They had the following children:

- i. **Jane Warburton**. Jane was born on 28 Nov 1812. She was christened in Walmsley Unitarian Chapel (aka Walmsley Meeting House), Bolton, Lancashire, on 3 Jan 1813.
- ii. **George Warburton**. George was born in Aug 1815. He was christened in Walmsley Unitarian Chapel (aka Walmsley Meeting House), Bolton, Lancashire, on 8 Oct 1815. George died in 1845. He was buried in Walmsley Unitarian Chapel (aka Walmsley Meeting House), Bolton, Lancashire, on 18 Oct 1845.
- iii. **Betty Warburton**. Betty was born on 22 Feb 1828. She was christened in Walmsley Unitarian Chapel (aka Walmsley Meeting House), Bolton, Lancashire, on 4 May 1828.

8. **Thomas Warburton** (*George<sup>4</sup>, John<sup>3</sup>, George<sup>2</sup>, <sup>1</sup>*). Thomas was born in Turton, Lancashire, in 1785. He was christened in Walmsley Unitarian Chapel (aka Walmsley Meeting House), Bolton, Lancashire, on 15 May 1785. Thomas died on 20 Mar 1836. He was buried in Walmsley Unitarian Chapel (aka Walmsley Meeting House), Bolton, Lancashire.

Thomas's parents are called George and Ann (Kay) on Family Search and Lancashire Parishes On-line. The baptism is only 9 months after James and Ann's daughter Betty's and George's abode is different to James and Ann's, being given as Stones. Stones identifies George as the son of John.

Thomas is aged 50 on his burial record which ties in with his date of birth.

Thomas first married **Betty**. Betty was born abt 1789. Betty died on 9 Jun 1817. She was buried in Walmsley Unitarian Chapel (aka Walmsley Meeting House), Bolton, Lancashire.

Betty is known from her burial with Thomas.

Thomas second married **Ann**. Ann was born abt 1790. Ann died on 15 Mar 1836. She was buried in Walmsley Unitarian Chapel (aka Walmsley Meeting House), Bolton, Lancashire.

Ann is known from her burial, aged 46, with Thomas.

They had one child:

- i. **John Warburton**. John was born abt 1821. John died on 28 May 1835. He was buried in Walmsley Unitarian Chapel (aka Walmsley Meeting House), Bolton, Lancashire.

John is known from his burial, aged 14.

9. **Samuel Warburton** (*George<sup>4</sup>, John<sup>3</sup>, George<sup>2</sup>, <sup>1</sup>*). He was christened abt 1796.

Samuel is presumed to be the son of George because his address for the baptism of his children is the Old School, Turton and a school was included in Stones, which George inherited.

On 16 Jan 1820 Samuel married **Rachel Wood** in Bolton, Lancashire. Rachel was born abt 1800. Rachel died in Turton, Lancashire, in 1879.

Rachel's death was probably that registered in 1879 at Bolton aged 79, sub-district Turton. It is shown on LancashireBMD, but isn't present on [gro.gov](http://gro.gov), or FreeBMD.

They had the following children:

- i. **Ann Warburton**. Ann was born on 19 Aug 1820. She was christened in Walmsley Unitarian Chapel (aka Walmsley Meeting House), Bolton, Lancashire, on 25 May 1830.
- ii. **George Warburton**. George was born on 7 Nov 1822. He was christened in Walmsley Unitarian Chapel (aka Walmsley Meeting House), Bolton, Lancashire, on 25 May 1830.
- iii. **Betty Warburton**. Betty was born on 4 Oct 1825. She was christened in Walmsley Unitarian Chapel (aka Walmsley Meeting House), Bolton, Lancashire, on 25 May 1830.
- iv. **William Warburton**. William was born on 3 Feb 1828. He was christened in Walmsley Unitarian Chapel (aka Walmsley Meeting House), Bolton, Lancashire, on 25 May 1830.
- v. **Samuel Warburton**. Samuel was born on 7 Jan 1830. He was christened in Walmsley Unitarian Chapel (aka Walmsley Meeting House), Bolton, Lancashire, on 25 May 1830. Samuel died in Turton, Lancashire, in 1884.

Samuel's death was probably that registered in 1884 at Bolton aged 54, sub-district Turton. It is shown on LancashireBMD, but isn't present on [gro.gov](http://gro.gov), or FreeBMD. He was still unmarried 3 years before his death.

**10. John Warburton** (*James<sup>4</sup>, John<sup>3</sup>, George<sup>2</sup>, 1). John was born in Turton, Lancashire, on 8 Feb 1783. He was christened in Walmsley Unitarian Chapel (aka Walmsley Meeting House), Bolton, Lancashire, on 6 Apr 1783. John died in Turton, Lancashire, on 7 Sep 1829. He was buried in Walmsley Unitarian Chapel (aka Walmsley Meeting House), Bolton, Lancashire, on 11 Sep 1829.*

John's abode was Horridges' Turton on the parish record of his baptism, and Orridges, Turton on his burial. Horridge Fold exits today in Egerton, adjacent to Turton Golf Club.

John lived at Turton, with a short period at Darwen suggested by the place of birth for sons James and John. Baptisms for children born before 1811 are missing and this is probably because records of baptisms at Walmsley Unitarian Chapel are missing before that date.

John and Ann were living at Sough Bridge at the time of John junior's baptism, and at Cooper's, Turton at the time of Mary's baptism. John's age at death is given as 47, but should be 46.

On 30 May 1806 when John was 23, he married **Ann Crook** in Bolton, Lancashire. John was a carter, and both were 'of the parish'. Both signed their own name. Ann was born abt 1788. Ann died in Turton, Lancashire, on 31 Dec 1813. She was buried in Walmsley Unitarian Chapel (aka Walmsley Meeting House), Bolton, Lancashire.

It is likely Ann died of complications following the birth of daughter Mary. Details of her burial are

believed to be on [deceasedonline.com](http://deceasedonline.com).

They had the following children:

- 11 i. **Peter Warburton** (~1807-1873)
- ii. **Ann Warburton**. Ann was born in Turton, Lancashire, on 21 Jun 1808. Ann died in Turton, Lancashire, in 1850.

Ann's baptism isn't recorded on Family Search, or Lancashire Parishes On-line. She is only known from an IGI Pedigree Resource file.

- 12 iii. **James Warburton** (~1810-1864)
- 13 iv. **John Warburton** (1812-1867)
- v. **Mary Warburton**. Mary was born in Turton, Lancashire, on 3 Dec 1813. She was christened in Walmsley Unitarian Chapel (aka Walmsley Meeting House), Bolton, Lancashire, on 6 Feb 1814. Mary died in Turton, Lancashire, in 1874.

**11. Peter Warburton** (*John<sup>5</sup>, James<sup>4</sup>, John<sup>3</sup>, George<sup>2</sup>, <sup>1</sup>*). Peter was born in Turton, Lancashire, abt 1807. ■ Census for Turton, Lancashire, in 1841. Peter (30) is a stone quarryman living at Higher Stones with Charlotte (30), Ann (6), Mary (4), and Peter (5 mths). He is living at the home of William Yates (45) a weaver, Hannah Yates (50) a weaver, Yates Yates (20) a stone quarryman, Benjamin Yates (15) a stone quarryman, Elizabeth Yates (14) a cotton cleaner. Also present are Peter Crook (25) a stone quarryman, and Richard Openshaw (30) a carter. ■ Census for Halliwell, Lancashire, in 1851. Peter (42) is a quarryman living at New Road with Charlotte (39), Ann (15) a cotton factory hand, Mary (13), a cotton factory hand, Betsy (7), Alice (5), James (2), and 2 lodgers. ■ Census for Turton, Lancashire, in 1871. Peter (66) is a stone mason living alone in Cox Green. Peter died in Turton, Lancashire, on 26 Mar 1873. He was buried in Farnworth, St John, Lancashire, on 27 Mar 1873.

Peter's identification as a son of John and Ann (nee Crook) is circumstantial. His age in censuses is variable, but his age at death suggests he was born around 1807, and his place of birth is consistently given as Turton. He would therefore be John and Ann's eldest son, born before they moved to Darwen.

The evidence for Peter being the son of John and Ann includes:

1. The name Peter appears frequently in the Crook family, including the Peter Crook living at the same address as Peter in the 1841 census.
2. James and John are confirmed sons of John and Ann, John by his baptism record, and James because he records his father as John, albeit a labourer.
3. All three brothers (Peter, James, and John) named sons Peter.
4. All three brothers were quarrymen/stone masons, as was their father. At times they lived in close proximity in Turton.
5. Peter's probable date of birth falls conveniently close to the marriage of his parents.
6. His death was registered by Jane, the widow of brother John, who was also present at the death.

Only one marriage, that of Ann's, has been found on the Lancashire On-Line Parish Clerk site where the father of the bride or groom is Peter, a quarryman. The others were most likely at a non-conformist church and registered as Bolton Register Office or Registrar Attended.

Peter's death was registered in 1q 1872 Bolton 8c 213, aged 65. He died of smallpox at Cox Green, Turton, though his death registration refers to Turton Workhouse. At this time Bolton Workhouse, formerly in Turton, had moved to Farnworth, so maybe he was kept at home in

isolation because of his disease, though he was under the auspices of the workhouse.

On 6 Sep 1830 when Peter was 23, he married **Charlotte Holt** in Bolton, St Peter, Lancashire. Both are “of this parish”. It seems Peter and Charlotte were living separately by 1861 as they appear separately in censuses thereafter. Charlotte was born in Bolton, Lancashire, on 8 Oct 1809. ■ Census for Over Darwen, Lancashire, in 1861. Charlotte (50) is a laundress and married head of the family living at 15 Elersley with Ann (24) a cotton winder, Betsey (18) a cotton winder, and Alice (15) a power loom weaver. Husband Peter, and son James have not been found on the census. Alice’s age looks like 25, but should be 15 and she follows her older sisters. ■ Census for Turton, Lancashire, in 1871. Charlotte (61) is living at 209 Blackburn Road with Alice (25) a cotton winder, James (22) a quarryman, and Thomas Scholes and his family. Charlotte died in Newark, New Jersey, on 22 Mar 1878.

Charlotte accompanied her son James to the USA and appears on Directories for Newark, New Jersey as the widow of Peter Warburton, living at 71 High (a house), in 1875,6 and 7.

Her death was recorded as follows: Date 22nd March 1878. Place Newark, Essex, New Jersey. Age 68 yrs 5 mths 14 days (gives a birth date of 8th October 1809). parents Robert and Mary Holt,

They had the following children:

- i. **John Warburton**. John was born in Turton, Lancashire, in 1834. He was christened in Walmsley Unitarian Chapel (aka Walmsley Meeting House), Bolton, Lancashire, on 13 Apr 1834. John died in 1834. He was buried in Walmsley Unitarian Chapel (aka Walmsley Meeting House), Bolton, Lancashire, on 13 Apr 1834.
- ii. **Ann Warburton**. Ann was born in Turton, Lancashire, abt 1835.

Ann is only known from census entries. Her baptism record has not been found.

There are numerous marriages of a Mary at Bolton but she has not been explored further.

- iv. **Peter Warburton**. Peter was born in Turton, Lancashire, in 1839. He was christened in Walmsley Unitarian Chapel (aka Walmsley Meeting House), Bolton, Lancashire, on 22 Dec 1839. Peter died in Turton, Lancashire, in 1840.

Peter’s birth was registered in 4q 1839 Bolton 21 177, mother’s maiden name Holt. He presumably died before the second Peter was born in 1841. LancashireBMD

The only marriage of a Betsey (not Betsy) at Bolton was to John Haworth in 1865, Bolton registrar or Registrar attended. Betsey has not been explored further.

- vii. **Alice Warburton**. Alice was born in Halliwell, Lancashire, in 1846. She was christened in Walmsley Unitarian Chapel (aka Walmsley Meeting House), Bolton, Lancashire, on 15 Feb 1846.

Alice's's birth was registered in 1q 1846 Bolton 21 183, mother's maiden name Holt. LancashireBMD has the sub-district as Halliwell.

There are several possible marriages at Bolton for Alice but she has not been explored further.

- x. **Eliza Warburton**. Eliza was born in Sharples, Lancashire, in 1856. She was christened in Astley Bridge, St Paul, Lancashire, on 15 Oct 1857. Eliza died in 1858. She was buried in Astley Bridge, St Paul, Lancashire, in Oct 1858.

James (41) is a stone quarryman living at Cox Green with Sarah (34), John (12) a cotton piecer, James (8), Anne (6), Betty (3), and Peter (1). ■ Census for Turton, Lancashire, in 1861. James (51) is a stone quarrier living at Old Globe with Sarah (47), John (21) a cotton bleacher, James (17) a cotton bleacher, Ann (15) a factory worker, Betty (13) a factory worker, Peter (11) a factory worker, Thomas (8) a factory worker, Robert (7), Mary (4), and Eliza (2). James died in Turton, Lancashire, in 1864.

James is missing from the 1871 census so is probably the James whose death was registered in 4q 1864 Bolton 8c 173, aged 54. LancashireBMD has the sub-district as Turton.

On 1 Jan 1838 when James was 28, he married **Sarah Robinson** in Bolton, St Peter, Lancashire. Both are from Turton, and of full age. James is a labourer, father John, a labourer. Sarah's father is Thomas, a labourer. Sarah was born in Turton, Lancashire, abt 1815. ■ Census for Turton, Lancashire, in 1871. Sarah (52) is a widow living in Egerton with John (31) a labourer, Peter (21), Thomas (19), Robert (17), and Mary (14) cotton operatives, Eliza (12), Walter (7), and grandsons James (8) and Robert (6). ■ Census for Turton, Lancashire, in 1881. Sarah (64) is a widow living at 16 Water Street with Thomas (29) occupation illegible, Robert (27) awarehouseman, Mary (24) a reeler, Eliza (22) a doubler, Walter (17) a piecer in a cotton mill, and grandsons James (18) and Robert (16) piecers in a cotton mill. Sarah died in Turton, Lancashire, in 1889.

Sarah's age in censuses is variable. She is missing in 1891 so her death registration is probably that in 2q 1889 Bolton 8c 218, aged 69, sub-district Turton (LancashireBMD). The age is at the bottom of her census range.

Betty is missing from the 1871 and subsequent censuses, at least under her maiden name. There are a couple of possible marriages registered in 1867/8, but those couples have not been found in the 1871 census.

- vi. **Peter Warburton**. Peter was born in Turton, Lancashire, in 1849. Peter died in Turton, Lancashire, in 1921.

Peter's birth was registered in 2q 1849 Bolton 21 228, mother's maiden name Robinson. His death was registered in 4q 1921 Bolton 8c 480, aged 72. LancashireBMD has the sub-district as Turton. Although Peter and Jane haven't been found in the 1911 census, Peter's death was probably that registered in 4q 1921 Bolton 8c 480, aged 72, sub-district Turton (LancashireBMD).

Robert (46) is a single cotton cloth dyer living at 16 Water Street with, Walter A (36) a cotton cloth finisher, and nephew Robert (34) a bobbin polisher. Robert died in 1902.

Robert's birth was registered in 2q 1853 Bolton 8c 215, mother's maiden name Robinson. He is not present in the 1911 census so is probably the Robert whose death was registered in 1q 1902 Bolton 8c 251, aged 48, sub-district Turton. (LancashireBMD).

- ix. **Mary Warburton**. Mary was born in Turton, Lancashire, in 1856. Mary died in Turton, Lancashire, in 1901.

Mary's birth was registered in 3q 1856 Bolton 8c 208, mother's maiden name Robinson. She was still a spinster when her sister Eliza married in 1888, but is not present in the 1901 census, She is probably the Mary whose death was registered in 1q 1901 Bolton 8c 250, aged 44, sub-district Turton (LancashireBMD).

John (25) is a labourer living in Dunscair Lane with Jane (25), Thomas (3), Peter (2), Mary Taylor (40) a cotton reeler, and Ann Taylor (15) a cotton reeler. ■ Census for Holcombe, Lancashire, in 1851. John (39) is a quarryman living with Jane (35), Thomas (13) a labourer, Peter (12) a labourer, Ann (6), Betty (4), and Joseph (1). ■ Census for Turton, Lancashire, in 1861. John (49) is a stone quarrier living in Hardmans with Jane (46), Peter (21) a stone mason, Ann (16) a cotton lapper, Betty (14) a cotton reeler, Joseph (11) a cotton winder, Jane (9), John (4), and Samuel (1). Also present are mother-in-law Jane Taylor (78) who is blind, and sister-in-law Ellen Taylor (37) formally a cotton weaver. John died in Turton, Lancashire, in 1867.

John's parents were from Sough Bridge on his baptism. Family Search has the birth of a John on 14 March 1802 but this is probably an incorrect transcription of this John's birth.

John's death was registered in 4q 1867 Bolton 8c 202, aged 55, sub-district Turton (LancashireBMD).

On 29 Jun 1836 when John was 24, he married **Jane Taylor** in Bolton, St Peter, Lancashire. Both were "of this parish". Jane was born in Longworth, Lancashire, abt 1815. ■ Census for Turton, Lancashire, in 1871. Jane (55) is a widow living at Cox Green with Eliz (26) a packer?, Betty (24) a cotton weaver, Joseph (21) occupation unclear, John (19) a cotton weaver, Samuel (11), and Ellen Taylor (41) a servant. Jane died in Turton, Lancashire, in 1874.

Jane's death is probably that registered in 4q 1874 Bolton 8c 242, aged 59, sub-district Turton (LancashireBMD).

Peter has not been investigated fully, though his death was probably that registered in 1q 1890 Bolton 8c 293, aged 54, sub-district Turton (LancashireBMD).

On 8 Aug 1863 when Peter was 24, he first married **Phoebe Quinn** in Walmsley, Christ Church, Lancashire. Peter was a mason from Wamsley, father John, a quarryman. Phebe was from Walmsley, father Hugh, a tailor. The marriage was registered in 3q 1863 Bolton 8c 341. Censuses show they had 3 daughters, though not all registrations can be found. Phoebe was born abt 1841. Phoebe died in Turton, Lancashire, in 1876.

Phoebe's death was registered in 2q 1876 Bolton 8c 194, aged 35, sub-district Turton (LancashireBMD).

On 17 Jun 1878 when Peter was 39, he second married **Ann Knowles** in Walmsley, Christ Church, Lancashire. Peter (38) was a widowed stone mason from Walmsley, father John a deceased quarryman. Ann was a widow from Walmsley, father George Westman, a deceased gardener. Joseph Warburton was a witness. The marriage was registered in 2q 1878 Bolton8c 432. Ann was born in Ireland abt 1842.

- iii. **James Warburton**. James was born in Turton, Lancashire, in 1842. James died in Turton, Lancashire, in 1847.

James's birth was registered in 1842 at Bolton but isn't shown on FreeBMD or [gro.gov](http://gro.gov). Joseph's birth was registered in 3q 1849 Bury 21 327, mother's maiden name Taylor, sub-district Walmersley (LancashireBMD). The family were recorded at Holcombe in the 1851 census.

He is probably the Joseph whose death was registered in 4q 1902 Bolton 8c 283, aged 53, sub-district Turton (LancashireBMD).

Joseph and Ellen have a son and daughter in censuses but have not been fully documented.

On 11 Aug 1883 when Joseph was 34, he married **Ellen Berry** in Walmsley, Christ Church, Lancashire. Joseph (33) was a quarryman from Walmsley, father John, a deceased quarryman. Ellen (32) was from Walmsley, father Joseph, a deceased quarryman. John Warburton was a witness. The marriage was registered in 3q 1883 Bolton 8c 462. Ellen was born abt 1851. Ellen died in Turton, Lancashire, in 1900.

Ellen's death was probably that registered in 3q 1900 Bolton 8c 278, aged 49, sub-district Turton, (LancashireBMD).

- vii. **Jane Warburton**. Jane was born in Holcombe, Lancashire, in 1852. Jane died in Turton, Lancashire, in 1869.

Jane's birth was registered in 2q 1852 Bury 8c 377, mother's maiden name Taylor, sub-district Turton (LancashireBMD). The family were at Holcombe in the 1851

Eleanor (21) was cloth straightener from 1 Chapel Street, father Ralph, a bleacher. The marriage was registered in 3q 1881 Blackburn 8e 585. Eleanor was born in Stockport, Cheshire, abt 1861.

- x. **Samuel Warburton**. Samuel was born in Turton, Lancashire, abt 1859. Samuel died in Turton, Lancashire, in 1911.

Samuel's birth registration is not shown on on-line resources, and he is only known from census entries.

His death was probably that registered in 3q 1911 Bolton 8c 639, aged 51, sub-district Turton (LancashireBMD).

He and Mary Ann had 7 children, 5 still living in 1911 (3 sons and 2 daughters), but the family has not been fully documented.

In 1883 when Samuel was 24, he married **Mary Ann Mayoh** in Bolton Register Office or Registrar Attended. The marriage was registered in 2q 1883 Bolton 8c 477. Mary Ann was born in Turton, Lancashire, abt 1849.

James (32) is a stone mason lodging in Salisbury Road with George James and his family. ■ Census for Turton, Lancashire, in 1891. James (42) is a stone mason living at 21 Bedford Street, Egerton with Betsy (44), Mary A (15, should be Margaret) a doubler in a cotton mill, Joseph (14) at bleach works, Charlotte (12) a cotton powerloom weaver's tenter, Fred (10) a piecer in a spinning room, Walter (8), Herbert (6), and Mary J (4). ■ Census for Sharples, Lancashire, in 1901. James (52) is a stone mason living at 29 Park View with Betsy (54), Margaret (25) a worker in a cotton and thread mill, Joseph (24) a doubling overlooker, Charlotte (22) a cotton weaver, Fred (20) a cotton piecer, Walter (18) a cotton piecer, Herbert (16) a worker (exact job illegible) in a cotton mill, and Mary J (14) a cotton weaver. James died in Bromley Cross, Lancashire, on 2 Mar 1911. He was buried in Walmsley, Christ Church, Lancashire, on 6 Mar 1911.

James's birth registration has not been found. His death was registered in 1q 1911 Bolton 8c 301, aged 62, sub-district Turton (LancashireBMD).

James left for the USA after the 1871 census. His mother and future wife also made the journey. The manifest for SS Algeria sailing on April 18th 1871, and arriving in New York on May 1st shows James (23) a mechanic travelling in steerage, and Eliza Moore (25) traveling in a cabin. This is probably James and Betsy. Mother Charlotte is not recorded in the USA until 1875. It is possible James went to work on the rebuilding of St Patrick's Cathedral in New York.

James and Betsy returned to England in time for the baptism of their second child Mary on September 25th 1875. James's mother remained in New Jersey until her death in 1878.

Abt 1872 when James was 24, he married **Betsy More** in unknown. Details of James and Betsy's marriage have not been found so they presumably married between leaving for the USA on April 18th 1871, and the birth of their first child in 1873. Betsy was born in Bolton, Lancashire, in 1847. She was christened in Bolton, St Peter, Lancashire, on 22 Aug 1847. ■ Census for Bolton, Lancashire, in 1881. Betsy (34) is living at 5 Church Street, Astley Bridge (next door to her parents) with James (8), Margaret A (6), Joseph (4), Charlotte (2), and Fred (9 mths). Husband James is working in Wiltshire. ■ Census for Turton, Lancashire, in 1911. Betsy (64) is living at 145 Darwen Road, Bromley Cross (6 rooms) with Herbert (26) a jobber in a doubling mill, and Betsy Moore Warburton (6) who was born in Scotland and is a New Lanark resident. Betsy died in Nov 1929. She was buried in Walmsley, Christ Church, Lancashire.

Betsy's parents were John and Margaret nee Brewer. John was a carter from Great Bolton on her baptism record. Her birth was registered in 1q 1847 Bolton 21 129. Her death was registered in 4q 1926 Bolton 8c 381, aged 79.

Margaret (30) was from Walmsley, father James, a stonemason. One son was registered at Bolton with a mother's maiden name of Warburton. Joseph was born abt 1875. Joseph died in Oct 1943.

There are a number of death registrations for a Joseph Rigby of roughly the correct age. However only one is at Bolton (Oct 1943 Bolton 8c 406, aged 69), so this is probably him.

- iii. **Joseph Warburton**. Joseph was born in Elton, Bury, Lancashire, on 4 Sep 1876. ■ Census for Swinton, Lancashire, in 1911. Joseph (34) is a cotton mill foreman living at 6 Cemetery Road (5 rooms) with Mary Jane (32), Agnes (5), Mary Jane (4), Jessie (1), and Mrs Lyall (69) a widowed visitor born in New Lanark, Scotland and presumed to be Mary Jane's mother. Joseph and Mary Jane had been married 7 years and had 4 children, all living. Their eldest 2 daughters were born in New Lanark, but Jessie was born in Swinton and registered at Barton upon Irwell, mother's maiden name Lyall. Their fourth child, Betsy Moore is staying with Joseph's parents. Joseph died in Blackpool, Lancashire, on 13 Mar 1934. He was buried in Walmsley, Christ Church, Lancashire.

Joseph's birth was registered in 4q 1876 Bury 8c 544, mother's maiden name Moore. His death was registered in 1q 1934 Fylde 8e 880, aged 57.

Joseph and his family haven't been documented fully.

Abt 1903 when Joseph was 26, he married **Mary Jane Lyall** in Scotland. The marriage registration is not on FreeBMD so is assumed to have occurred in Scotland. In addition to the 4 daughters in the 1911 census, a son (James) and two daughters were registered at Skipton with a mother's maiden name of Lyall. There

is no other Warburton-Lyall marriage on FreeBMD in that period. Mary Jane was born in Aberdeen, Scotland, on 16 Dec 1878. ■ Census for Stockport, Cheshire, in 1939. A widowed Mary J is living at 4 Woodlands Drive, Stockport with 2 others including James born 18th February 1918. This James matches the James registered at Skipton, mother's maiden name Lyall.

- iv. **Charlotte Warburton**. Charlotte was born in Sharples, Lancashire, in 1878. She was christened in Astley Bridge, St Paul, Lancashire, on 6 Oct 1878.

Charlotte's birth was registered in 4q 1878 Bolton 8c 375, mother's maiden name Moore. Her death registration has not been identified.

On 2 Jan 1904 when Charlotte was 26, she married **Robert Crompton Lee** in Walmsley, Christ Church, Lancashire. Charlotte (25) was from Walmsley, father James, a stonemason. Robert (23) was a stripper from Astley Bridge, father Thomas, deceased overlooker. Witnesses were Joseph Warburton and Margaret Alice Lee Robert and Charlotte had a son in the 1911 census, and another child (believed to be a daughter Nora) who had died. No other children with a mother's maiden name of Warburton were registered in the Bolton area. Robert Crompton was born abt 1880. Robert Crompton died in 1957.

Robert's death was registered in 4q 1957 Farnworth 10c 245, aged 77.

- 17 v. **Fred Warburton** (1880-1948)  
vi. **Walter Warburton**. Walter was born in Bolton, Lancashire, in 1882. Walter died in Bromley Cross, Lancashire, in 1943. He was buried in Walmsley, Christ Church, Lancashire, on 1 Sep 1943.

Walter's birth was registered in 4q 1882 Bolton 8c 372, mother's maiden name Moore. His death was registered in 3q 1943 Horwich 8c 290, aged 60.

Walter has not been fully documented.

On 17 Aug 1907 when Walter was 25, he married **Sophia Brandwood** in Astley Bridge, St Paul, Lancashire. Walter (24) was a spinner from 38 Hamilton Street, father James, a stonemason. Sophia (24) was from 23 Coop Street, father Joseph, a wood machinist. Witnesses were Mary Jane Warburton and JW Brandwood. Walter had a daughter in the 1911 census, and a further son and daughter were registered at Bolton with mother's maiden name Brandwood. Sophia was born abt 1884.

- 18 vii. **Herbert Warburton** (1884-1940)  
viii. **Mary Jane Warburton**. Mary Jane was born in Bolton, Lancashire, in 1886. Mary Jane died in Heywood, Lancashire, on 15 Jan 1956. She was buried in Walmsley, Christ Church, Lancashire, on 20 Jan 1956.

Mary's birth was registered in 3q 1886 Bolton 8c 383, mother's maiden name Moore.

Her subsequent life is uncertain and has not been explored fully. She possibly married Thomas Holt at Walmersley, Bury in 1929, as Mary Holt's date of birth in the 1939 Register (22nd May 1886) just fits with registration in the 3rd quarter (6 weeks was allowed legally).

**15. John Warburton** (*James<sup>6</sup>, John<sup>5</sup>, James<sup>4</sup>, John<sup>3</sup>, George<sup>2</sup>, <sup>1</sup>*). John was born in Turton, Lancashire, in 1839. He was christened in Bolton, St Peter, Lancashire, on 21 Jul 1839. John died in Sharples, Lancashire, in 1895.

John's birth was registered in 1839 at Bolton but isn't shown on FreeBMD or [gro.gov](http://gro.gov). It is on LancashireBMD which records mother's maiden name as Robinson and the sub-district as Turton. His father is a mason on his baptism record.

He hasn't been found in the 1901 census so he is probably the John whose death was registered in 2q 1895 Bolton 8c 253, aged 55, sub-district Sharples (LancashireBMD).

John and his family have not been fully explored and documented. Only two of his 6 sons from his second marriage have appeared in censuses.

On 4 May 1862 when John was 23, he first married **Elizabeth Lever** in Walmsley, Christ Church, Lancashire. John was a labourer from Walmsley, father James a quarryman. Elizabeth was from Walmsley, father Thomas, a labourer. Witnesses were James Warburton and Mary Lever. Elizabeth was born abt 1840. Elizabeth died in Sharples, Lancashire, in 1866.

Elizabeth isn't present in the 1871 census when John and his two sons are living with his mother (claiming to be unmarried). Her death is likely to be that registered in 2q 1866 Bolton 8c 207, aged 26. LancashireBMD has the sub-district as Sharples, where her second son was born.

They had the following children:

- i. **James Warburton**. James was born in Turton, Lancashire, in 1862. ■ Census for Turton, Lancashire, in 1901. James (34) is a cotton dyer living at 10 Water Street with Margaret (30).

James's birth was registered in 3q 1862 Bolton 8c 259, mother's maiden name Lever, sub-district Turton (LancashireBMD). He and his family have not been documented fully.

In 1892 when James was 30, he married **Margaret Annie Lee** in Bolton Register Office or Registrar Attended. The marriage was registered in 2q 1892 Bolton 8c 624. By the 1911 census James and Margaret had had 6 children, 4 ( a son and three daughters) still living. Margaret Annie was born in Bolton, Lancashire, abt 1870.

- ii. **Robert Warburton**. Robert was born in Sharples, Lancashire, in 1864.

Robert's birth was registered in 3q 1864 Bolton 8c 267, mother's maiden name Lever, sub-district Turton (LancashireBMD). He has not been investigated further.

On 9 Apr 1873 when John was 34, he second married **Mary Ellen Hood** in Bolton, St Peter, Lancashire. John (31) was a widowed miner from Turton, father James, quarryman deceased. Ten children were registered with a mother's maiden name of Hood at Sharples (6 boys and 4 girls). Mary Ellen was born in Turton, Lancashire, abt 1850.

**16. James Warburton** (*James<sup>6</sup>, John<sup>5</sup>, James<sup>4</sup>, John<sup>3</sup>, George<sup>2</sup>, <sup>1</sup>*). James was born in Turton, Lancashire, in 1843.

James's birth was registered in 1843 at Bolton but isn't shown on FreeBMD or [gro.gov](http://gro.gov). It is on LancashireBMD which records mother's maiden name as Robinson and the sub-district as Turton.

James has not been fully documented but in 1911 he was living with his married daughter Lilly Booth and he reported having been married 23 years, and having had 4 children, 2 living (Polly and Lilly).

On 13 Jun 1867 when James was 24, he married **Grace Thomasson** in Walmsley, Christ Church, Lancashire. James was a crofter from Walmsley, father James, quarryman. Grace was from Walmsley, father Thomas, a carter. Betty Warburton was a witness. Grace was born in Turton, Lancashire, abt 1844. Grace died in Turton, Lancashire, in 1892.

Grace's death was registered in 1q 1892 Bolton 8c 302, aged 47, sub-district Turton (LancashireBMD).

They had the following children:

- i. **Polly Warburton**. Polly was born in Turton, Lancashire, in 1870.

Polly's birth was registered in 3q 1870 Bolton 8c 284, mother's maiden name Thomasson.

In 1894 when Polly was 24, she married **Emmanuel Wild** in Bolton Register Office or Registrar Attended. The marriage was registered in 1q 1894 Bolton 8c 579. Polly and Emmanuel had one daughter who was present in the 1911 census. Emmanuel was born in Darwen, Lancashire, abt 1870.

- ii. **Lilly Warburton**. Lilly was born in Turton, Lancashire, in 1872.

In 1901 when Lilly was 29, she married **Charles Booth** in Bolton Register Office or Registrar Attended. The marriage was registered in 1q 1901 Bolton 8c 616. Lilly and Charles had a son and 2 daughters in the 1911 census. Charles was born in Bromley Cross, Lancashire, abt 1877.

- iii. **Rupert Warburton**. Rupert was born in Turton, Lancashire, in 1874. Rupert died in Turton, Lancashire, in 1908.

Rupert's birth was registered in 2q 1874 Bolton 8c 361, mother's maiden name Thomasson. His death was registered in 1q 1908 Bolton 8c 305 aged 34, sub-district Turton (LancashireBMD).

In 1899 when Rupert was 25, he married **Elizabeth Gardner** in Bolton Register Office or Registrar Attended. The marriage was registered in 2q 1899 Bolton 8c 753. No children were registered with a mother's maiden name of Gardner before Rupert's death. Elizabeth was born in Turton, Lancashire, abt 1876.

- iv. **Alfred Warburton**. Alfred was born in Turton, Lancashire, in 1876. Alfred died in Turton, Lancashire, in 1878.

Alfred's birth was registered in 2q 1876 Bolton 8c 384, mother's maiden name Thomasson. His death was registered in 2q 1878 Bolton 8c 185, aged 1, sub-district Turton (LancashireBMD).

Fred was born in Sharples, Lancashire, on 8 Aug 1880. He was christened in Astley Bridge, St Paul, Lancashire, on 12 Sep 1880. ■ Census for Morecambe, Lancashire, in 1939. Fred is an unemployed football trainer living at 11A Downes Grove with Pauline, Edith, Henry a silk worker (sizer), Fred a silk worker, Pauline a tailoress, May a silk worker (jet examiner), Joseph an apprentice painter and decorator, Mary E, and one other whose record is closed (presumably Margaret). Fred died in Morecambe, Lancashire, on 29 Nov 1948. He was buried in Morecambe, Lancashire.

Fred's birth was registered in 3q 1880 Bolton 8c 362, mother's maiden name Moore. His death was registered in 4q 1948 Lancaster 10c 574, aged 68.

Fred was a professional footballer. His story, **Rolling You Own Life**, was written by his grandson Ken Warburton and published in issue 2 of **The Button Files**, the newsletter of the Warburton One-Name Study (<https://warburton.one-name.net/newsletters/Newsletter2.pdf>)

On 24 Jun 1908 when Fred was 27, he married **Pauline Walker** in Bolton, St George, Lancashire. Fred (28) was a builder of 39 Kent Street, father James, a stone mason. Pauline (26) was a tenter of 39 Kent Street, father Henry, a bill poster. Herbert Warburton and May Walker were witnesses. The marriage was registered in 2q 1908 Bolton 8c 818. Pauline was born in Warwick, Warwickshire, on 8 Apr 1882. Pauline died in Morecambe, Lancashire, in Jul 1970.

Paulines's birth was registered in 2q 1882 Warwick 6d 612 mother's maiden name Prestage. Her death was registered in July 1970 Lancaster 10c 1298, aged 88.

They had the following children:

- i. **James Warburton**. James was born in Plymouth, Devon, in 1908. James died in Lancaster, Lancashire, in 1981.

James's birth was registered in 1q 1909 Devonport 5b 281, mother's maiden name Walker. His death was registered in Oct 1981 Lancaster 40 1754, aged 76.

No entry has been found for him in the 1939 Register, and there is no marriage at or near Lancaster.

In 1944 when Edith was 33, she married **Stanley Bradshaw** in Morecambe, Holy Trinity, Lancashire. The marriage was registered in 3q 1944 Lancaster 8e 1588. A son and a daughter were registered at Lancaster and Fylde with a mother's maiden name of Warburton.

There is no death registration for Stanley at Lancaster so it isn't possible to identify which Stanley Bradshaw death registration is his.

- iii. **Henry Warburton**. Henry was born in Utrecht, Holland, on 16 Mar 1912. Henry died in Morecambe, Lancashire, in 1997.

Henry's death was registered in Jan 1997 Lancaster C52B 5871C entry 226, aged 84.

In 1942 when Henry was 29, he married **Violet Vernon** in Morecambe, Holy Trinity, Lancashire. The marriage was registered in 2q 1942 Lancaster 8e 2006. One son was registered at Lancaster with a mother's maiden name of Vernon. Violet was born on 17 Mar 1907. Violet died in Sep 1988.

Violet's death was registered in Sept 1988 Lancaster 40 1448, aged 81.

- iv. **Fred Warburton**. Fred was born in The Hague, Holland, on 11 Aug 1913. Fred died in Morecambe, Lancashire, in 1998.

Fred's death was registered in Jan 1999 Lancaster C54B 5871C entry 211 aged 84.

In 1948 when Fred was 34, he married **Frances Murray** in Lancaster Register Office or Registrar Attended. The marriage was registered in 3q 1948 Lancaster 10c 1626. No children were registered at or near Lancaster with a mother's maiden

name of Murray (or Rushton). Frances was born on 27 Dec 1912. Frances died in Jan 1978.

In 1939 when George Albert was 23, he married **Freda Taylor** in Sandylands, St John, Lancashire. The marriage was registered in 3q 1939 Lancaster 8e 2379. Numerous children were registered with a mother's maiden name of Taylor, in a variety of locations, but none in Lancaster. Freda was born on 17 May 1917. Freda died in 1999.

Freda's death was registered in July 1999 Lancaster C3C 5872C entry 197, aged 82.

- vi. **Pauline Warburton**. Pauline was born in The Hague, Holland, on 12 Mar 1917. Pauline died in Lancaster, Lancashire, in 2002.

Pauline's death was registered in Oct 2002 Lancaster C10B 5872C entry 17, aged 85.

On 22 Nov 1948 when Pauline was 31, she married **William Eric Walsh** in Morecambe, Holy Trinity, Lancashire. The marriage was registered in 4q 1948 Lancaster 10c 1104. There are no children registered with a mother's maiden name of Warburton.

- vii. **Margaret Ann Warburton**. Margaret Ann was born in The Hague, Holland, on 10 Sep 1920. Margaret Ann died in Barrow in Furness, Cumbria, on 27 Aug 2011.

Margaret's date of birth is impossibly close to her sister May so was probably the year before, but it can't be checked because her death registration is too late for inclusion on on-line sites, and her entry on the 1939 register is still closed.

In 1948 when Margaret Ann was 27, she married **Morris Holmes Pickup** in Morecambe, Holy Trinity, Lancashire. The marriage was registered in 1q 1948 Lancaster 10c 1245. Three daughters were registered at Lancaster and Barrow in Furness, with mother's maiden name Warburton. Morris Holmes was born on 2 Jul 1918. Morris Holmes died in Jul 1989.

In 1945 when May was 24, she married **Stanley Ross Albon** in Lancaster Register Office or Registrar Attended. The marriage was registered in 2q 1945 Lancaster 8e 1878. A son and a daughter were registered at Lancaster with mother's maiden name Warburton. Stanley Ross was born abt 1912. Stanley Ross died in Oct 1965.

Stanley's death was registered in Oct 1965 Lancaster 10c 630, aged 53.

- ix. **Joseph Warburton**. Joseph was born in The Hague, Holland, on 14 Jan 1922. Joseph died in Paignton, Devon, on 14 May 2001. He was buried in Torquay, Devon, on 23 May 2001.

Joseph's death was registered in May 2001 Torbay C41A 4221C entry 125, aged 79.

In 1946 when Joseph was 23, he married **Elizabeth Joyce Walker** in Morecambe, Holy Trinity, Lancashire. The marriage was registered in 2q 1946 Lancaster 8e 1890. Two sons and a daughter were registered at Lancaster with mother's maiden name Walker. Elizabeth Joyce was born on 5 Nov 1921. Elizabeth Joyce died in Mar 1998.

Elizabeth's death was registered in March 1998 Lancaster C55B 5871C entry 52, aged 76.

- x. **Mary Emma Warburton**. Mary Emma was born in The Hague, Holland, on 13 Aug 1925. Mary Emma died in Preston, Lancashire, in Apr 2002.

Mary's death was registered in April 2002 Preston and South Ribble B58C 5881B entry 116, aged 76.

On 18 Sep 1950 when Mary Emma was 25, she married **Varley** in Morecambe, Holy Trinity, Lancashire. The marriage was registered in 3q 1950 Lancaster 10c 1495. A daughter and a son were registered at Lancaster with a mother's maiden name of Warburton.

**18. Herbert Warburton** (*James<sup>7</sup>, Peter<sup>6</sup>, John<sup>5</sup>, James<sup>4</sup>, John<sup>3</sup>, George<sup>2</sup>, <sup>1</sup>*). Herbert was born in Bolton, Lancashire, on 21 Jun 1884. ■ Census for Nelson, Lancashire, in 1939. Herbert is an incapacitated slater's labourer living at 158 Baker House Road with Jesse, Robert a cotton manufacturer's clerk, and William Dean (Jesse's father) a general labourer on private means.

Herbert died in Nelson, Lancashire, in 1940. He was buried in Walmsley, Christ Church, Lancashire, on 20 Jun 1940.

Herbert's birth was registered in 3q 1884 Bolton 8c 385, mother's maiden name Moore. His death was registered in 2q 1940 Nelson 8e 520, aged 55.

Herbert's family have not been fully documented.

On 30 Aug 1913 when Herbert was 29, he married **Jesse Dean** in Walmsley, Christ Church, Lancashire. Herbert (29) was an assistant overlooker of 145 Darwen Road, Bromley Cross, father James, a deceased stonemason. Jesse (24) was from 97 Hough Lane, Eagley, father William, a labourer. Witness was Walter Warburton. Two sons were registered at Stockport, mother's maiden name Dean, one of whom is present in the 1939 Register. Jesse was born on 9 May 1889.

Jesse's death registration has not been identified. She may have remarried.

John's birth was registered in 2q 1917 Stockport 8a 42, mother's maiden name Dean.
