# PREFACE



This tree combines three families which are linked on the basis of specific assumptions.

The families are:

1. The ancestors of Warburtons Bakers of Bolton, starting from Henry born in 1805.
- 2 The descendant of James, born in 1800 in Walmersley.
3. The descendants of Peter and Elizabeth Heap.

The first two families are linked by the assumption that 4 children of Thomas and Sarah of Walmersley, baptised at Holcombe between 1800 and 1804, are part of the same family as 4 children of Thomas and Sarah of Edenfield, baptised at Edenfield Chapel between 1805 and 1809.

The identification of Thomas, the father of the above children with the son of Peter and Elizabeth nee Heap is based on the assumption that he is the Thomas whose burial was recorded at Holcombe in 1810.

The assumptions are expanded on in the tree.

## First Generation

### 1. Peter Warburton.

This tree combines three families which are linked on the basis of specific assumptions.

The families are:

1. The ancestors of Warburtons Bakers of Bolton, starting from Henry born in 1805.
2. The descendant of James, born in 1800 in Walmersley.
3. The descendants of Peter and Elizabeth Heap.

The first two families are linked by the assumption that 4 children of Thomas and Sarah of Walmersley, baptised at Holcombe between 1800 and 1804, are part of the same family as 4 children of Thomas and Sarah of Edenfield, baptised at Edenfield Chapel between 1805 and 1809. Furthermore the Henry born in 1805 is the same Henry whose son Thomas founded the bakery business in Bolton. The facts and issues behind these assumptions are discussed in my paper **Thomas and Sarah Families** on the **Papers** page of my website ([warburton.one-name.net](http://warburton.one-name.net)).

The identification of Thomas, the father of the above children with the son of Peter and Elizabeth nee Heap is based on the assumption that he is the Thomas whose burial was recorded at Holcombe in 1810. This in turn rests on the assumption that the Sarah Jackson who is living with James in the 1841 census is his mother, being the same person as the Sally Warburton, widow, who married James Jackson in 1818. This is despite the fact that James married Peggy Jackson so the Sarah living with him could be her relative, though she is not her mother who was named Mary.

If Sarah was a widow in 1818, Thomas must have died between 1809 and 1818, and only 2 burials of a Thomas are recorded locally in that period. Both are a bit older than Sarah. Sarah Jackson's age at death gives a birth circa 1776/7, whereas the son of Peter and Elizabeth was born in 1755, and a Thomas who was buried in 1813 aged 67 would have been born circa 1746.

The burial in 1810 is the best fit because the age gap is smaller, and the date is closer to birth of Sarah's last child, and so explains why Sarah stopped having children in her early 30s. Thomas's abode Heartsough Mill in the Holcombe register. There is no known Heartsough Mill, but there is a Hardsough Lane in Edenfield. Hardsough Mill was built on Hardsough Lane in 1871, and there may have been an earlier mill in the area. It would seem probable that Heartsough is a misspelling of Hardsough and this fits with Thomas's abode on the baptisms of his last four children.

The burial is also recorded in the Bury parish records, as Holcombe was a chapel of ease for Bury Bury St Mary until 1866. This gives Thomas's abode as Elton, but this is probably a misunderstanding of the location of Hardsough Mill.

No records have been uncovered describing an alternative life for Thomas.

The family of Peter and Elizabeth nee Heap shares characteristics with the Edenfield clan as it is from a similar area, and includes the name Peter, but no actual connection has been identified. I discussed the relationship of the name Peter to the Edenfield clan and area in my paper **Edenfield Clan and Related Peters** on the **Papers** page of my website ([warburton.one-name.net](http://warburton.one-name.net)).

Their children's baptisms refer to Newhall, Balladen and Carrhead. New Hall Hey, Balladen Brook, and modern day Carr Head farm are features close to each other to the south of Rawtenstall, and probably refer to a single abode.

On 7 May 1754 Peter married **Elizabeth Heap** in Bury, St Mary, Lancashire.

They had the following children:

  - ii. **Mary Warburton**. Mary was born in Rawtenstall, Lancashire, in 1757. She was christened in Holcombe, St Emmanuel, Lancashire, on 11 Feb 1757.  
  
Mary's parents are from Newhall on her baptism record.
  - iii. **John Warburton**. John was born in Rawtenstall, Lancashire, in 1759. He was christened in Newchurch, St Nicholas, Lancashire, on 17 Jun 1759.  
  
John's parents are from Newhall on his baptism record.
  - iv. **Ann Warburton**. Ann was born in Rawtenstall, Lancashire, abt 1760. Ann died on 7 May 1761. She was buried in Holcombe, St Emmanuel, Lancashire, on 7 May 1761.  
  
Ann is only known from her burial as the child of Peeter.

  - v. **Peter Warburton** (1761-1849)
  - vi. **Genney Warburton**. Genney was born in Rawtenstall, Lancashire, abt 1764. Genney died in Rawtenstall, Lancashire, on 14 Aug 1764. She was buried in Holcombe, St Emmanuel, Lancashire, on 16 Aug 1764.  
  
Genney is only known from her burial as the child of Peeter.
  - vii. **James Warburton**. James was born in Rawtenstall, Lancashire, in 1765. He was christened in Newchurch, St Nicholas, Lancashire, on 5 Aug 1765.  
  
James's parents are from Carrheadl on his baptism record. His mother is named as Betty. It is Elizabeth on all other baptisms except Thomas, who was baptised before mother's name was recorded.
  - viii. **Henery Warburton**. Henery was born in Rawtenstall, Lancashire, abt 1767. Henery died in Rawtenstall, Lancashire, in 1767. He was buried in Holcombe, St Emmanuel, Lancashire, on 7 Dec 1767.

Henery is only known from his burial as the child of Peeter.

- ix. **Peggy Warburton**. Peggy was born in Rawtenstall, Lancashire, in 1768. She was christened in Newchurch, St Nicholas, Lancashire, on 9 Oct 1768.

Peggy's parents are from Balladen on her baptism record.

- x. **Betty Warburton**. Betty was born in Rawtenstall, Lancashire, in 1773. She was christened in Newchurch, St Nicholas, Lancashire, on 19 Dec 1773.

Betty's parents are from Balladen on her baptism record.

**2. Thomas Warburton** (*Peter*<sup>1</sup>). Thomas was born in Rawtenstall, Lancashire, on 1 Mar 1755. He was christened in Edenfield Chapel, Lancashire, on 16 Mar 1755. Thomas died in Edenfield, Lancashire, on 30 Jul 1810. He was buried in Holcombe, St Emmanuel, Lancashire, on 30 Jul 1810.

Thomas is the son of Peter of Balladen on his baptism record. His burial record at Holcombe says he is from Heartsough Mill, aged 55. The Bury, St Mary parish register gives his abode as Elton, so it is assumed Heartsough Mill was in Elton.

Thomas's occupation is not mentioned on the 4 baptisms at Holcombe, but on his son James's second marriage he is named as Thomas, a carder. He is also a carder on the baptisms of Thommy (Fanny), and George, but on Henry's he is a spinner and on Susannah's he is an engineer. These might be errors, or evidence of attempts to better himself, with his attempt to become a spinner failing so he reverted to carder.

Thoas is aged 55 from Heartsough Mill on his baptism record at Holcombe. This was probably a reference to Hardsough Mill which used to exist on Hardsough Lane in Edenfield.

There are no known alternative family records for the son of Peter and Elizabeth.

On 18 May 1797 when Thomas was 42, he married **Sarah Handley** in Manchester Cathedral, Lancashire. The identification of Sarah as Sarah Handley is speculative. The death of Sarah Jackson in 1846, aged 69 limits the possible dates for her marriage to 1795-9., and the marriage of Thomas and Sarah Handley at Manchester Cathedral is the best fit. The only other recorded marriages are one in Wiltshire, and the marriage of Thomas and Sally Isherwood which is discounted as that Thomas died in 1805. There could however be an unrecorded marriage. Sarah was born abt 1777. Sarah died in Bury, Lancashire, in 1846.

A Sarah Jackson, aged 60, is living with her son James in the 1841 census. As James's wife Peggy is also a Jackson, this could be a relative of hers. However her mother was Mary, so Sarah may be the Sally Warburton, widow, who married James Jackson in 1818.

If Sarah was Sarah Handley she was probably born outside Lancashire as all recorded Sarah Handly baptisms circa 1776/7 were outside Lancashire.

Sarah's death was registered in 2q 1846 Bury 21 198, aged 69.



They had the following children:

- i. **James Warburton** (1800-1886)
  - ii. **Jane Warburton**. Jane was born in Walmersley, Lancashire, on 30 Jul 1801. She was christened in Holcombe, St Emmanuel, Lancashire, on 12 Sep 1801.
  - iii. **Sarah Warburton**. Sarah was born in Walmersley, Lancashire, on 13 Sep 1802. She was christened in Holcombe, St Emmanuel, Lancashire, on 13 Nov 1802.
  - iv. **Thomas Warburton**. Thomas was born in Walmersley, Lancashire, on 28 Dec 1803. He was christened in Holcombe, St Emmanuel, Lancashire, on 14 Feb 1804.

- v. **Henry Warburton** (1805-1853)
  - vi. **Fanny Warburton**. Fanny was born in Edenfield, Lancashire, on 8 Feb 1807. She was christened in Edenfield Chapel, Lancashire, on 17 Mar 1807. Fanny died in Edenfield, Lancashire, on 13 Jan 1809. She was buried in Holcombe, St Emmanuel, Lancashire, on 15 Jan 1809.

Fanny was baptised as a boy called Thommy, and buried as a girl called Phanny, aged 2. It seems most likely the records refer to the same child, and the baptism record is in error.

- vii. **George Warburton**. George was born in Edenfield, Lancashire, on 11 Dec 1807. He was christened in Edenfield Chapel, Lancashire, on 10 Mar 1808.
- viii. **Susannah Warburton**. Susannah was born in Edenfield, Lancashire, on 4 May 1809. She was christened in Edenfield Chapel, Lancashire, on 23 Jul 1809.

3. **Peter Warburton** (*Peter*<sup>1</sup>). Peter was born in Rawtenstall, Lancashire, in 1761. He was christened in Newchurch, St Nicholas, Lancashire, on 6 Sep 1761. ■ Census for Holcombe, Lancashire, in 1841. Peter (79) is a server living at Tanners with the Morris family, and Nancy Warburton (15) a weaver. Nancy is probably Peter's granddaughter, daughter of his son James. Peter died in 1849. He was buried in Holcombe, St Emmanuel, Lancashire, on 2 Oct 1849.

Peter's parents are from Balladen on his baptism record. He was from Tanners, aged 88 on his burial record. His death was registered in 3q 1849 Bury 21 208, aged 88.

The identification of Peter as the son of Peter and Elizabeth is based on his age at death which fits his baptism record. Also the presumed granddaughter Nancy who is living with him and the Morris family at Tanners in 1841 is a good fit for the daughter of his son James, and the witness Thomas at his wedding matches the elder brother Thomas in the family of Peter and Elizabeth nee Heap.

On 5 Jun 1783 when Peter was 22, he married **Alice Haslem** in Bury, St Mary, Lancashire. Peter was a weaver. Thomas Warburton was a witness. Alice was born abt 1767. Alice died in Walmersley, Lancashire, on 15 May 1792. She was buried in Holcombe, St Emmanuel, Lancashire, on 17 May 1792.

Alice was the wife of Peter, in her 25th year on her burial record. This seems a little young given her marriage date. She was buried the same day her youngest child was baptised.

They had the following children:

- i. **John Warburton**. John was born in Holcombe, Lancashire, on 29 Oct 1784. He was christened in Holcombe, St Emmanuel, Lancashire, on 20 Nov 1784.
- ii. **Betty Warburton**. Betty was born in Edenfield, Lancashire, on 10 Feb 1786. She was christened in Edenfield Chapel, Lancashire, on 5 Mar 1786.
- iii. **Rachel Warburton**. Rachel was born in Walmersley, Lancashire, on 31 Mar 1788. She was christened in Holcombe, St Emmanuel, Lancashire, on 26 Apr 1788.

Rachel's parents are from Gollinrod on her baptism record. This is in Walmersley.

7 iv. **James Warburton** (1789-)

- v. **Alice Warburton**. Alice was born in Walmersley, Lancashire, on 11 Mar 1792. She was christened in Holcombe, St Emmanuel, Lancashire, on 17 Mar 1792.

4. **Henry Warburton** (*Peter*<sup>1</sup>). Henry was born in Ramsbottom, Lancashire, in 1778. He was christened in Holcombe, St Emmanuel, Lancashire, on 8 Aug 1778. ■ Census for Holcombe, Lancashire, in 1841. Henry (60) is a joiner living in Ramsbottom Lane with Martha (55), John (20) a cotton spinner, Thomas (20) a cotton spinner, and Martha (15) a cotton weaver. ■ Census for Ramsbottom, Lancashire, in 1851. Henry (72) is a carpenter living at 100 Ramsbottom Lane with Martha (68), John (32) a cotton spinner, and Henry (25) a power loom weaver. Henry died in Ramsbottom, Lancashire, in 1855. He was buried in Holcombe, St Emmanuel, Lancashire, on 11 Feb 1855.

Henry's father is a farmer from Ramsbottom on his baptism record. His mother is Elizabeth, formerly Heap. He was living in Bolton Street when he died. His death was registered in 1q 1855 Bury 8c 240, age 76.

On 13 Jun 1802 when Henry was 24, he married **Martha Leach** in Bury, St Mary, Lancashire. Henry was a husbandman. Martha was born in Bury, Lancashire, abt 1783. Martha died in Bury, Lancashire, in 1858.

Martha, like the rest of the family, gave her place of birth as Bury in the 1851 census. However this seems to a general definition that doesn't preclude specific locations in the Ramsbottom area. Her death was registered in 1q 1858 Bury 8c 242, aged 74.

They had the following children:

- i. **Peter Warburton**. Peter was born in Ramsbottom, Lancashire, on 20 Dec 1802. He was christened in Holcombe, St Emmanuel, Lancashire, on 8 Jan 1803. Peter died in Ramsbottom, Lancashire, in 1804. He was buried in Holcombe, St Emmanuel, Lancashire, on 30 Mar 1804.

Peter was buried the son of Henry and Matty of Ramsbottom Lane, aged 2.

- 8 ii. **James Warburton** (1804-)
- iii. **Betty Warburton**. Betty was born in Ramsbottom, Lancashire, on 23 Oct 1806. She was christened in Holcombe, St Emmanuel, Lancashire, on 15 Nov 1806. Betty died in Ramsbottom, Lancashire, on 11 Feb 1808. She was buried in Holcombe, St Emmanuel, Lancashire, on 13 Feb 1808.

Betty was buried the daughter of Henry and Martha of Ramsbottom Lane, aged 2.

- iv. **Elizabeth Warburton**. Elizabeth was born in Ramsbottom, Lancashire, on 2 Jan 1809. She was christened in Holcombe, St Emmanuel, Lancashire, on 28 Jan 1809.
- v. **Charles Warburton**. Charles was born in Ramsbottom, Lancashire, on 4 Jan 1811. He was christened in Holcombe, St Emmanuel, Lancashire, on 26 Jan 1811. Charles died in Ramsbottom, Lancashire, on 10 Nov 1811. He was buried in Holcombe, St Emmanuel, Lancashire, on 13 Nov 1811.

Charles was buried the infant son of Henry and Martha.

- vi. **Mary Warburton**. Mary was born in Ramsbottom, Lancashire, on 13 Sep 1812. She was christened in Holcombe, St Emmanuel, Lancashire, on 4 Oct 1812.
- vii. **Eliza Warburton**. Eliza was born in Ramsbottom, Lancashire, on 14 Aug 1814. She was christened in Holcombe, St Emmanuel, Lancashire, on 4 Sep 1814.

Eliza was the daughter of Henry, a carpenter of Ramsbottom Lane, and Martha.

- viii. **Sarah Warburton**. Sarah was born in Ramsbottom, Lancashire, on 21 Jan 1817. She was christened in Holcombe, St Emmanuel, Lancashire, on 19 Feb 1817.

Sarah was the daughter of Henry, a carpenter of Stubbins Lane, and Martha.

- ix. **John Warburton**. John was born in Ramsbottom, Lancashire, on 16 Oct 1818. He was christened in Holcombe, St Emmanuel, Lancashire, on 8 Nov 1818.

John was the son of Henry, a carpenter of Ramsbottom, and Martha.

- 9 x. **Thomas Warburton** (1821-1851)
- xi. **Margaret Warburton**. Margaret was born in Ramsbottom, Lancashire, on 7 Mar 1823. She was christened in Holcombe, St Emmanuel, Lancashire, on 6 Apr 1823.

Margaret was the daughter of Henry, a carpenter of Ramsbottom Lane, and Mally.

- xii. **Henry Warburton**. Henry was born in Ramsbottom, Lancashire, on 18 Mar 1826. He was christened in Holcombe, St Emmanuel, Lancashire, on 9 Apr 1826.

Henry was the son of Henry, a carpenter of Ramsbottom, and Martha.

### Third Generation

**5. James Warburton** (*Thomas<sup>2</sup>, Peter<sup>1</sup>*). James was born in Walmersley, Lancashire, on 29 Apr 1800. He was christened in Holcombe, St Emmanuel, Lancashire, on 7 Jun 1800. ■ Census for Bury, Lancashire, in 1841. James (40) is a woollen spinner living at Huntley Brook with Sarah (15) a warper, Thomas (14) a warper, Joshua (12) a warper, James (9), John (7), Daniel (3), and Sarah Jackson (60), probably James's mother. Peggy's mother was Mary. ■ Census for Bury, Lancashire, in 1851. James (50) is a woollen spinner living in Bamford Road with Ann (44), Joshua (22) a woollen spinner, James (19) a woollen feeder, John (17) a woollen warper, and Daniel (13) a woollen piecer. ■ Census for Bury, Lancashire, in 1861. James (60) is a woollen spinner living at 67 Huntley Brook with Ann (54), Thomas (33) a woollen weaver, and grandson James (9). ■ Census for Bury, Lancashire, in 1871. James (70) is a woollen dresser living at 67 Huntley Brook with Ann (64), and grandson James (19) a commercial clerk. ■ Census for Bury, Lancashire, in 1881. James (80) a retired woollen spinner, and his wife Ann (74), are grandparents living at 245 Rochdale Road, the home of James (29) a clerk at a paper manufacturer, and his wife Elizabeth (34). James died in Bury, Lancashire, on 9 Jun 1886.

James died of Bronchitis at 245 Rochdale Road, Bury North. His grandson, James Warburton, was present at the death. James was living at the same address.

On 26 Aug 1822 when James was 22, he first married **Peggy Jackson** in Bury, St Mary, Lancashire. Peggy was born in Holcombe, Lancashire, on 12 Jun 1805. She was christened in Holcombe, St Emmanuel, Lancashire, on 27 Jul 1805. Peggy died in Huntley's Brook, Bury, Lancashire, on 24 Dec 1838.

Peggy was the daughter of Daniel Jackson & Mary.

The death certificate for Peggy indicates that she died whilst giving birth to Daniel Jackson Warburton. Neither a birth registration nor a baptismal record for Daniel has so far been found.

They had the following children:

- i. **Betty Warburton**. Betty was born in Bury, Lancashire, on 23 Apr 1823. She was christened in Bury, St Mary, Lancashire, on 15 Jun 1823. Betty died in Bury, Lancashire, in 1831. She was buried in Bury, St Mary, Lancashire, on 4 May 1831.

Betty's father was a woollen spinner from Huntley Brook on her baptism record. She was buried the daughter of James and Peggy of Bury, aged 8.

- ii. **Sarah Warburton**. Sarah was born in Bury, Lancashire, on 15 Aug 1825. She was christened in Bury, St Mary, Lancashire, on 25 Aug 1825.

Sarah's father was a spinner from Huntley Brook on her baptism record.

- v. **Daniel Warburton**. Daniel was born in Bury, Lancashire, on 9 Aug 1830. He was christened in Bury, St Mary, Lancashire, on 11 Aug 1830. Daniel died in Bury, Lancashire, on 12 Aug 1830. He was buried in Bury, St Mary, Lancashire, on 13 Aug 1830.

Daniel's father was a spinner from Huntley Brook on his baptism record. He was buried the son of James and Peggy of Huntley, aged 3 days.

- 14 viii. **Daniel Warburton** (~1838-1901)

On 24 Aug 1845 when James was 45, he second married **Ann Foster** in Bury, St Mary, Lancashire. Ann was born in Bury, Lancashire, abt 1806. Ann died in Bury, Lancashire, in 1883.

Ann's death was registered in 1q 1883 Bury 8c 357, aged 76, sub district Bury North (LancashireBMD).

**6. Henry Warburton** (*Thomas<sup>2</sup>, Peter<sup>1</sup>*). Henry was born in Walmersley, Lancashire, on 26 Jun 1805. He was christened in Edenfield Chapel, Lancashire, on 11 Aug 1805. ■ Census for Walmersley, Lancashire, in 1841. Henry Warbutton (36) is a cotton carder living at Deeply Hill (parish of Bury) with Ann (25), Amelia (11), George (9), Betty (7), Margaret (6), Thomas (4), Mary (2), and James (6 months). ■ Census for Bolton, Lancashire, in 1851. Henry Warbutton (transcribed by Ancestry as Warhelton), aged 46, is a cotton spinner living at 11 Lower Mill Hall with Ann (44), George (19) a cotton spinner, Betty (17), Margaret (16), Thomas (14), and Mary (12) all piecers, Ann (8), Henry (6), Peter (4), and Sarah (1). Henry died in Bolton, Lancashire, in 1853. He was buried in Holcombe, St Emmanuel, Lancashire, on 22 May 1853.

Henry and his descendants are based on a Family Tree published in a booklet called "125 Years" by Warburtons Bakers. It has been extended with information from censuses, registrations and parish records found in on-line sources.

The baptism record at Edenfield Chapel is the only one close to his birth date, and likely place of birth, and there is no evidence of a second Henry to account for this baptism. On balance it is most likely that this is the same Henry. However there are a couple of issues. Firstly in the 1851 census his age is 46, and place of birth Walmsly. This would put his birth between April 1804 and March 1805. His age at death is consistent with this. However the Henry at Edenfield wasn't born until July.

Secondly the baptism gives the family abode as Edenfield. The place of birth on the 1851 census is probably meant to be Walmsley in Bolton. However he married a girl from Holcombe, which is close to Walmersley, near Bury, and he spent his early married life there, being recorded as living there in the 1841 census. Also he was buried in Holcombe Chapelry. In the 1851 census, when the family were living in Bolton, he most probably stated his place of birth as Walmersley, but the census enumerator confused this with Walmsley near Bolton

As Henry was the first of the four children of Thomas and Sarah of Edenfield, directly preceded by the 4 children from Walmersley, his stated place of birth in 1851 is a link between the two halves of the family.

The family now has a Thomas and a Thommy, but the burial of a daughter Phanny 2 years later, aged 2, suggests that Thommy is an error.

Henry's death was registered in 2q 1853 Bolton 8c 174, aged 48. According to FamilySearch he was living at Lower Mile Hill, Bolton at the time of his death. This is probably a poor transcription of Lower Mill Hall.

Baptisams can only be found for 2 of Henry's children.

Many of his descendants are recorded as marrying at Bolton Registry Office, or Registrar Attending. This probably reflects the fact the family were Methodists, and the weddings were Methodist marriages.

On 23 Dec 1827 when Henry was 22, he married **Ann Hamer** in Bury, St Mary, Lancashire. Ann was born in Holcombe, Lancashire, in 1812. She was christened in Bury, St Mary, Lancashire, on 25 Dec 1812. ■ Census for Bolton, Lancashire, in 1861. Ann Warbuton (48) is a widow living at 16 Higher Terrace with George (29) a cotton spinner, Betty (27) a cotton drawer, Margaret (26) a cotton picker of yarn, Mary (22) a worker in cotton mill, Ann (18) a frame tenter, Henry (16) a card grinder, Peter (14) a cotton mule piecer, Sarah (12) a cotton bark tenter, Amelia (9), John (7), and Emma (2). ■ Census for Bolton, Lancashire, in 1871. Ann is living with son Henry. Ann died in Bolton,

Lancashire, in 1879.

The FamilySearch records site has baptism records for Bury, St Mary, and for Walmersley. The latter may simply reflect her abode. On censuses she refers to her place of birth as Holcombe, or Tottington which is adjacent to Walmersley. Her death was registered in 3q 1879 Bolton 8c 178, aged 66.

They had the following children:

Betty's death was registered in 4q 1902 Bolton 9c 288, aged 69.

In 1867 when Betty was 34, she married **Ralph Tonge** in Bolton Register Office, or Registrar attended. The marriage was registered in 4q 1867 Bolton 8c 485. Ralph was born in Horwich, Lancashire, abt 1828. ■ Census for Bolton, Lancashire, in 1881. Ralph (52) is a grocer living at 2 Rhyl Street with Betty (47), one son and 2 daughters, and Emma Warburton (23) a cotton mill hand. ■ Census for Bolton, Lancashire, in 1891. Ralph (62) is a grocer living at 2 Rhyl Street with Betty (57), one son and 2 daughters, and Emma Warburton (33) a cotton frame tenter. Ralph died in Bolton, Lancashire, in 1893.

Ralph's death is probably that registered in 2q 1893 Bolton 8c 302. His age at 62 is a little low but it is the only one at Bolton before 1902 when Betty is a widow.

- iv. **Margaret Warburton**. Margaret was born in Holcombe, Lancashire, in 1835. She was christened in Holcombe, St Emmanuel, Lancashire, on 26 Jul 1835. Margaret died in Bolton, Lancashire, in 1870.

Margaret has not been found in the 1870 census, nor in Bolton marriages before 1871. She is possibly the Margaret whose death was registered in 1q 1870 Bolton 8c 262, aged 35.

- v. **Thomas Warburton**. Thomas was born in Holcombe, Lancashire, in 1837. ■ Census for Tonge, Bolton, Lancashire, in 1861. Thomas (24) is a cotton spinner living in Back Tonge view with Ellen (23). ■ Census for Bolton, Lancashire, in 1881. Thomas (43) is a grocer and baker living at 125 Blackburn Road with Ellen (42). ■ Census for Tonge,



Bolton, Lancashire, in 1891. Thomas (54) is living on own means at 239 Tonge Moor Road with Ellen (53). ■ Census for Tonge, Bolton, Lancashire, in 1901. Thomas (64) is a retired baker living on own means at 239 Tonge Moor Road with Ellen (63). Thomas died in Bolton, Lancashire, in 1909.

Thomas's baptism is not recorded in on-line resources. His birth might be that registered in 3q 1837 Bury 21 197. His death was registered in 3q 1909 Bolton 8c 227, aged 72.

On 3 Apr 1859 when Thomas was 22, he married **Ellen Platt** in Bolton Register Office, or Registrar attended. The marriage was registered in 2q 1859 Bolton 8c 381. Ellen was born abt 1838.

Ellen was the daughter of Edward Platt.

- vi. **Mary Warburton**. Mary was born in Holcombe, Lancashire, abt 1838. Mary died aft 1901.

There are several possible birth registrations at Bury for Mary. There is no exact death registration for Mary Bromley in Bolton.

In 1864 when Mary was 26, she married **Walter Bromley** in Bolton Register Office, or Registrar attended. This is Mary's probable marriage based on her age and place of birth. It was registered in 2q 1864 Bolton 8c 422. Walter was born in Bolton, Lancashire, abt 1841.

- vii. **James Warburton**. James was born in Holcombe, Lancashire, abt 1840. James died bef 1851.

James's birth was probably that registered in 1q 1841 Bury 21 265. He doesn't appear in subsequent censuses or the Warburtons Family Tree and so probably died young.

- viii. **Ann Warburton**. Ann was born in Birtle, Lancashire, in 1842. Ann died in Bolton, Lancashire, in 1901.

Ann's birth was registered in 2q 1842 Bury 21 290. Her death, assuming she married Daniel Walker, was possibly that registered in 2q 1901 Bolton, 8c 282, aged 58.

In 1862 when Ann was 20, she married **Daniel Walker** in Bolton Register Office, or Registrar attended. This is Ann's probable marriage based on her age and place of birth. It was registered in 2q 1862 Bolton 8c 362. Daniel was born in Tootil Bridge, Lancashire, abt 1841.

In 1877 when Sarah was 28, she married **John Tonge** in Bolton Register Office, or Registrar attended. This is Sarah's probable marriage based on her age and place of birth. It was registered in 2q 1877 Bolton 8c 497. John was born in Egerton, Lancashire, abt 1854.

- xii. **Amelia Warburton**. Amelia was born in Bolton, Lancashire, in 1852.

Amelia's birth was registered in 1q 1852 Bolton 8c 241.

In 1877 when Amelia was 25, she married **William Holt** in Bolton Register Office, or Registrar attended. William was born in Bolton, Lancashire, abt 1851. ■ Census for Bolton, Lancashire, in 1911. William (60), and Amelia (59) are living at 24 Horsa Street. With them is Emma Warburton (52) a single charwoman. Amelia and William have been married 33 years but had no children.

Emma's birth was registered in 3q 1858 Bolton 8c 222. This is 5 years after her father's death, though she is recorded as a daughter of Ann in the 1861 census, and always as sister or sister-in-law to whichever sibling's family she is living with in subsequent censuses. She would appear to be illegitimate, though it possible she is Ann's granddaughter rather than daughter.

Her death was registered in 1q 1919 Bolton 8c 733, aged 60.

James's parents are from Gollinrod on his baptism record. This is in Walmersley.

On 10 Oct 1816 when James was 26, he married **Margaret (Peggy) Rothwell** in Bolton, St Peter, Lancashire. James was a weaver, both were 'of this parish', and Samuel Warburton (relationship unknown) was a witness.

They had the following children:

- i. **Ann Warburton**. Ann was born in Harwood, Lancashire, on 9 Jan 1818. She was christened in Tottington, St Anne, Lancashire, on 11 Apr 1818.
- ii. **Betty Warburton**. Betty was born in Harwood, Lancashire, on 17 Sep 1819. She was christened in Tottington, St Anne, Lancashire, on 29 Jan 1820.
- iii. **Nancy Warburton**. Nancy was born in Tottington, Lancashire, on 8 Sep 1821. She was christened in Tottington, St Anne, Lancashire, on 9 Jan 1822.

Nancy's parents were from Birch Hey on her baptism record. There is a modern day Birch Hey farm on Turton Road, Tottington.

- iv. **Peggy Warburton**. Peggy was born in Tottington, Lancashire, on 22 May 1823. She was christened in Holcombe, St Emmanuel, Lancashire, on 8 Nov 1823.

Peggy's parents were from Birchhey on her baptism record.

**8. James Warburton** (*Henry<sup>2</sup>, Peter<sup>1</sup>*). James was born in Ramsbottom, Lancashire, on 20 Sep 1804. He was christened in Holcombe, St Emmanuel, Lancashire, on 20 Oct 1804. ■ Census for Ramsbottom, Lancashire, in 1841. James (35) is a cotton spinner living in Ramsbottom Lane with Betty (30), Charles (10), Thomas (8), Sarah (6), and Jenny (1).

James and his family are not obvious in records beyond 1841, but haven't been studied in detail.

On 21 Mar 1830 when James was 25, he married **Betty Holroyd** in Bury, St Mary, Lancashire. James was a spinner, both were 'of this parish'.

They had the following children:

- i. **Charles Warburton**. Charles was born in Ramsbottom, Lancashire, on 30 Aug 1831. He was christened in Edenfield Chapel, Lancashire, on 25 Sep 1831.

He was christened in Holcombe, St Emmanuel, Lancashire, on 2 Mar 1821. ■ Census for Baxenden, Lancashire, in 1851. Thomas (30) is a block printer living in Wilson's Row with Jane (29), Betsey (9) a teaser, John (8) a teaser, James (6), and William (5), Henry (3), and Margaret (11 months). Thomas died in Baxenden, Lancashire, in 1851.

Thomas was the son of Henry, a carpenter of Ramsbottom Lane, and Martha. His death was registered in 4q 1851 Haslingden 21 342, aged 30.

On 5 Mar 1842 when Thomas was 21, he married **Jane Hurst** in Bury, St Mary, Lancashire. Thomas was a twister of cotton from Bury father Henry, a joiner. Jane was from Bury, father James a blacksmith. Both were 'of full age'. Jane was born in Ramsbottom, Lancashire, abt 1821. ■ Census for New Accrington, Lancashire, in 1861. Jane (39) is living at 12 Mill Street with her second husband, Nicholas Roche (47) a stone mason, whom she married in 1853. Also present are a stepson, her four children by Nicholas, and Betsy Warburton (19) a cotton power loom weaver, John (18) a coal miner, James (16) a coal miner, William (14) a drawer in a coal mine, and Margaret (10).

They had the following children:

John's birth was registered in 1q 1843 Bury 21 302, mother's maiden name Hurst.

Son James is with his grandfather at 67 Huntley Brook, Bury. ■ Census for Bury, Lancashire, in 1881. Thomas (54) is a paper mill hand living at Fern Grove Mill Cottages with Margaret (49), and Mary (19) both cotton weavers. ■ Census for Bury, Lancashire, in 1891. Thomas (64) is a labourer in a paper mill living at Fern Bank, Rochdale Old Road with Margaret (60), and Mary B (29) a cotton weaver. Son Joshua (36) a County Court Bailiff and his family are a separate household at the same address. Thomas died in Bury, Lancashire, in 1898.

Thomas's father was a woollen spinner from Huntley Brook on his baptism record. His death was registered in 1q 1898 Bury 8c 354, aged 70.

On 19 Jan 1851 when Thomas was 23, he first married **Sarah Livesey** in Prestwich, St Mary, Lancashire. Thomas (23) was a weaver from Bury, father James, a spinner. Sarah (22) was from Prestwich, father Benjamin, a weaver. Sarah was born in Prestwich, Lancashire, abt 1828. Sarah died in Bury, Lancashire, in 1851. She was buried in Bury, St Paul, Lancashire, on 23 Nov 1851.

Sarah's death was registered in 4q 1851 Bury 21 220, aged 23.

In 1880 when James was 28, he married **Elizabeth Nightingale** in Bury, Lancashire. Elizabeth was born in Nuttall, Ramsbottom, Lancashire, in 1846.

On 2 Oct 1853 when Thomas was 26, he second married **Margaret Bentley** in Bury, St Mary, Lancashire. Thomas (26) was a widowed weaver from Bury, father James, a spinner. Margaret (22) was from Elton father Joshua, a labourer. Margaret was born in Elton, Lancashire, abt 1831. ■ Census for Elton, Lancashire, in 1861. Margaret (29) an assistant warper, and her son Joshua (6) are living with her mother and three sisters at 27 Woodhill Street. Although Margaret is described as married she is listed as a Bentley. ■ Census for Bury, Lancashire, in 1871. Margt (39) is a married cotton weaver living at 5 Sandhole with Joshua (16) a cotton piecer, and Mary (9). Margaret died in 1891.

Margaret's death was probably that registered in 3q 1891 Bury 8c 341, aged 60

Joshua (52) is a house painter living at 23 Bridgman Street, with Ann S (51). ■ Census for Farnworth, Lancashire, in 1891. Joshua (62) is a general labourer living at 86 Park Street with Ann S (61). ■ Census for Farnworth, Lancashire, in 1901. Joshua (72) is a widowed labourer at a tin plate works living with daughter Sarah Morgan (42), her husband William (45) and their children at 12 Lark Hill. ■ Census for Farnworth, Lancashire, in 1911. Joshua (82) is a retired labourer lodging with John and Hannah Crompton at 216 Piggot Street (5 rooms). Joshua died in Bolton, Lancashire, in 1911.

Joshua's father was a spinner from Huntley Brook on his baptism record. His death was registered in 2q 1911 Bolton 8c 185, aged 82.

On 31 Dec 1854 when Joshua was 26, he married **Ann Smith Haworth** in Bury, St Mary, Lancashire. Joshua (25) was a spinner from Bury, father James, a spinner. Ann (25) was from Bury, father John, a tanner and brazier. The marriage was registered in 4q 1854 Bury 8c 530. Ann Smith was born in Bury, Lancashire, in 1830.

They had one child:

- i. **Sarah Jane Warburton**. Sarah Jane was born in Bury, Lancashire, in 1860.

Sarah's birth was registered in 3q 1859 Bury 8c 395, mother's maiden name Howorth.

In 1879 when Sarah Jane was 19, she married **William Morgan**. William and Sarah had 6 sons and a daughter. William was born in Bolton, Lancashire, in 1857.

The 1901 Census gives William's occupation as Insurance Agent.

James (39) is a calico dresser living at 1 Baptist Place with Mary (35), widowed mother-in-law Ann Ramsbottom (71), Joseph H (14) a back tenter in cotton mill, Daniel (12) a back tenter, Margaret (10) a cotton weaver, and Frederic (4). ■ Census for Bury, Lancashire, in 1881. James (49) is a carder in woollen mill living at 10 Haslem Street with Mary (45), George (9), and mother-in-law Ann Ramsbottom (81). ■ Census for Bury, Lancashire, in 1891. James (59) is a woollier living at 10 Haslem Street with Mary (55), and George (19) a hat lining printer. James died in Bury, Lancashire, in 1915.

James's father was a spinner from Huntley on his baptism record. His death was registered in 1q 1915 Bury 8c 775, aged 83.

On 21 Mar 1855 when James was 23, he first married **Mary Eccles** in Bury, St Mary, Lancashire. James (23) was a spinner from Bury, father James, a spinner. Mary (20) was from Bury, father James, a shoe maker. The marriage was registered in 1q 1855 Bury 8c 336. Mary was born in Bury, Lancashire, abt 1834. Mary died in Bury, Lancashire, in 1868.

Mary's death was registered in 4q 1868 Bury 8c 301, aged 34.

John (47) is a woollen weaver living at 51 Deal Street with Alice (48), George E (21) a warehouseman, Rachel A (19) a cotton weaver, James H (15) a clage iron puncher, Daniel J (10) half time cotton mill, John H (8), and Sarah A (5). ■ Census for Bury, Lancashire, in 1891. John (57) is a woollen warper living at 51 Deal Street with Alice (58), Rachael A (29) a cotton weaver, Daniel J (20) a joiner's apprentice, John H (18) a woollen warper, and Sarah A (15) a cotton weaver. John died in Bury, Lancashire, in 1895.

John's father was a spinner from Huntley Brook, Bury on his baptism record. His mother is described as 'formerly Jackson'. His death was registered in 1q 1895 Bury 8c 403, aged 61.

On 2 May 1858 when John was 24, he married **Alice Rothwell** in Bury, St Paul, Lancashire. John (24) was a labourer from Greenacres Moor, Oldham, father James a spinner. Alice (25) was from Bury, father Thomas, a gardener. The marriage was registered in 2q 1858 Bury 8c 407. Alice was born in Birtle cum Barnford, Lancashire, in 1833. ■ Census for Bury, Lancashire, in 1901. Alice (68)



is a widow living at 58 Myrtle Street with John H (29) a woollen warper. Alice died in Bury, Lancashire, in 1907.

Daniel (33) is a waggon maker living at 40 Wood Street with Elizabeth (34), George (10), Thomas (8), Mary E (4), and Emma (3). ■ Census for Gorton, Manchester, Lancashire, in 1881. Daniel (43) is a joiner living at 40 Church Lane with Elizabeth (44), George (20) a railway waggon maker, Thomas (18) a joiner, Mary E (14) a cotton weaver, and Emma (13). ■ Census for Gorton, Manchester, Lancashire, in 1891. Daniel (53) is a joiner and railway waggon maker living at 16 Haddon Street with Elizabeth (54), Mary E (24) a cotton weaver, and Emma (23) a cotton weaver. ■ Census for Gorton, Manchester, Lancashire, in 1901. George (59) is living off his own means at 278 Blackburn Road with Mary (59), Margaret A (21) a roller (boverer?) in a mill, and George (18) a machinist in a foundry. George died in 1892.

On 10 Dec 1861 when George was 29, he married **Mary Wood** in Bolton, St John, Lancashire. The marriage was registered in 3q 1861 Bolton 8c 271. Mary was born in Bolton, Lancashire, abt 1832.

The fact the eldest son George was with his grandparents in 1881 supports the fact he left before then. In 1901 his wife and family are back in Bolton, but Henry is still absent. A death registered in 2q 1903 Bolton 8c 259, aged 58, may be him.

In 1864 when Henry was 20, he married **Margaret Knowles** in Bolton Register Office, or Registrar

attended. The marriage was registered in 4q 1864 Bolton 8c 393. Margaret was born in Bolton, Lancashire, in 1845. ■ Census for Bolton, Lancashire, in 1901. Margaret (56) is living at 78 Charles Rupert Street with Harry (24) a piecer in a cotton mill, James (18) a cabinet maker's apprentice, Emma (16) a niddle setter in a cotton mill, Frank (12), Edward (9), and Alice (6). Margaret is described as a wife, and married. Margaret died in Bolton, Lancashire, in 1908.

Margaret's birth is probably one of two registered at Bolton in 1q 1845 (21 114, and 21 195). She has not been found in the 1911 census so she is probably the Margaret whose death was registered in 4q 1908 Bolton 8c 291, aged 63.

1847. ■ Census for Reddish, Stockport, Cheshire, in 1871. Peter (24) is a cotton spinner living at 11 Manchester Street with Elizabeth (24), and Mary A (3). ■ Census for Bolton, Lancashire, in 1881. Peter (34) is a cotton spinner living at 709 Waterloo Street, Little Bolton with Elizabeth (34), Amelia (7), Thomas (3), and Mary Elizabeth (1). ■ Census for Radcliffe, Lancashire, in 1891. Peter (44) is a cotton spinner overlooker living at 264 Ainsworth Road with Elizabeth (34), Amelia (17) a cotton winder, Sarah (15) a cotton winder, Thomas (13) a cotton piecer, William (9), and Annie (7). Peter died on 13 Oct 1897.

Peter's birth was registered in 1q 1847 Bury 21 291, mother's maiden name Hamer. His death was registered in 4q 1897 Bolton 8c 327, aged 50.

In 1866 when Peter was 19, he married **Elizabeth Hensor** in Bolton, Christ Church, Lancashire. The marriage was registered in 4q 1866 Bolton 8c 322 (indexed as Warbutton and Henson). Elizabeth was born in Bolton, Lancashire, in 1846. ■ Census for Bolton, Lancashire, in 1901. Elizabeth (54) is a widow living at 11 Augustus Street with Thomas (23) a machine minder, cotton spinning mill, William (19) a worker, cotton spinning mill, Sarah (25) a machine minder, cotton mill, and Annie (17) a domestic servant. ■ Census for Bolton, Lancashire, in 1911. Elizabeth (64) is a widow living at 11 Augusta Street (5 rooms) with Annie (27) a cotton spinning minder. Elizabeth said she was married 44 years and had 10 children, 5 still living. Elizabeth died in Bolton, Lancashire, in 1920.

Elizabeth's birth was registered as Elizabeth Rostron in 4q 1846 Bolton 21 112, mother's maiden name Rostron (on LancashireBMD, not given on [gro.gov](http://gro.gov)). In 1854 Mary Rostron married William Hensor (transcribed as Henson on FreeBMD and LancashireBMD). In 1861 Elizabeth Hensor (15), born in Bolton, is a cotton piecer living with parents William and Mary. This explains her variable maiden name on the registrations of her children (she used each name 5 times).

On the 1911 census she claims to have been married 44 years, which is the time since her marriage though she had been a widow for over 13 years. She also had 10 children, 5 living, thus claiming all of Peter's children.

John (48) is a baker living at 2 Angle Street with Ann (46), Annie (18), and Joseph (10). ■ Census for Bolton, Lancashire, in 1911. John (57) is a baker living at 2 Angle Street with Ann (56), and Joseph (20) a turner. John and Ann have been married 34 years and had 2 children, both living. John died in Bolton, Lancashire, in 1918.

John's birth is probably that registered in 3q 1853 8c 223. His death is probably that registered in 4q 1918 Bolton 8c 674, aged 65.

He was christened in Elton, All saints, Lancashire, on 2 Nov 1856. ■ Census for Bury, Lancashire, in 1881. Joshua (26) a cotton mule spinner, Martha A (22), and Mary K (1) are living with Martha's parents Edward and Betty Kershaw at 4 Wood Street. ■ Census for Bury, Lancashire, in 1891. Joshua (36) is a County Court Bailiff living at 114 Fern Bank, Rochdale Old Road with Martha A (32), Mary A (11), and Stanley (3). His father is living in a separate household at the same address. ■ Census for Bury, Lancashire, in 1901. Joshua (46) is a County Court Bailiff living at 37 Hanson Street with Martha A (42), Mary K (21) an Elementary School teacher, and Stanley (13). ■ Census for Bury, Lancashire, in 1911. Joshua (56) is a County Court Bailiff living at 37 Hanson Street (6 rooms) with Martha Ann (52), Mary May (30) an Elementary School assistant mistress, and Stanley (23) a railway clerk. Joshua and Martha had been married 32 years and had 2 children, both living. Joshua died in Bury, Lancashire, in 1933.

Joshua's birth was registered in 4q 1854 Bury 8c 347, mother's maiden name Bentley. His death was registered in 2q 1933, Bury 8c 459, aged 78.

The following story is from Peter Jones, great nephew of Ellen (Nellie) Walker, Joshua's daughter-in-law.

*Joshua joined Chesham Unitarian Chapel and became one of its superintendents. This began a long link between the family and the Unitarians in Bury. Being a non-conformist church, marriages could only take place with the registrar in attendance, hence the references in marriage records to "registrar attendance". The Bury chapels maintained a Unitarian graveyard at Holebottom, Bury, near Huntley Brook, and Joshua along with many of the family were either buried there or their ashes were scattered there.*

In 1879 when Joshua was 24, he married **Martha Ann Kershaw** in Bury Register Office, or Registrar Attended, Lancashire. The marriage was registered in 1q 1879 Bury 8c 541. Martha Ann was born in Bury, Lancashire, on 18 Jan 1859. Martha Ann died in Bury, Lancashire, in 1940.

Martha's death was registered in 2q 1940 Bury 8c 858, aged 81.

They had the following children:

- i. **Mary Kay Warburton**. Mary Kay was born in Bury, Lancashire, on 17 Jul 1879. She was christened in Bury, St Paul, Lancashire, on 10 Sep 1879. ■ Census for Bury, Lancashire, in 1939. Mary is living at 146 Chesham Road with her incapacitated mother. Mary Kay died in Bury, Lancashire, in 1963.

Mary's birth was registered in 3q 1879 Bury 8c 528, mother's maiden name Kershaw. Her death was registered in 3q 1963 Bury 10b 636, aged 83.

Mary was a school teacher and never married.

The following story is from Peter Jones, great nephew of Ellen (Nellie) Walker, wife of Stanley Warburton.

*I have few memories of her (she died when I was 4), but I do recall going into her house with my father a week after her death. She was a schoolteacher (a popular profession in the family). The house was full of "antique" furniture; sadly, Mary had been sold rather a lot of supposedly good quality furniture and other items, most of which were of no value. Her favourite armchair had very tall wings to it and she had said that my mother (her brother's niece) could have it. I helped dad carry it out, holding on to one of the wings which immediately fell off to reveal a much smaller chair underneath this wooden framework!*

Joseph Henry (54) was a hat lining printer at a felt hat manufacturer living at 188 Fairfield (6 rooms) with Mary Ellen (55), Alfred (26) a hat lining printer, Joseph (21) a house painter, widowed father James (79) an old age pensioner, and daughter Clara Taylor (32) a calico weaver, her husband Benjamin (33) a shoemaker, and her daughter Jessie (1). Joseph and Mary had been married 34 years and had 5 children, 4 still living. Benjamin and Clara had been married 3 years and had 1 child.

Joseph's birth was registered in 4q 1856 Bury 8c 355, mother's maiden name Eccles.

In 1878 when Joseph Henry was 22, he married **Mary Ellen Marsden** in Bury Register Office, or Registrar Attended, Lancashire. The marriage was registered in 2q 1878 Bury 8c 621. Mary Ellen was born in Blackburn, Lancashire, abt 1855.

They had the following children:

- i. **Clara Warburton**. Clara was born in Bury, Lancashire, on 4 Jan 1879. ■ Census for Bury, Lancashire, in 1939. Clara and her husband Benjamin, an incapacitated boat repairer are living with their daughter Jessie and her husband William Crawshaw, a mechanical engineer/draughtsman on paper making machinery. Clara died in Bury, Lancashire, in 1962.

Clara's birth was registered in 1q 1879 Bury 8c 575, mother's maiden name Marsden. Her death was registered in 1q 1962 Bury 10b 1085, aged 83.

In 1907 when Clara was 27, she married **Benjamin Taylor** in Bury Register Office, or Registrar Attended, Lancashire. The marriage was registered in 2q 1907 Bury 8c 1004. Jessie, who appears in the 1911 census, was the only child registered at Bury with mother's maiden name Warburton. Benjamin was born in Bury, Lancashire, on 1 Dec 1878. Benjamin died in Bury, Lancashire, in 1940.

Benjamin's death was registered in 1q 1940 Bury 8c 1260, aged 61.

James's birth was registered in 3q 1881 Bury 8c 541, mother's maiden name Marsden. As he is missing from the 1911 census and the 1939 Register he is possibly the James whose death was registered in 1q 1909 Bury 8c 392, aged 28.

- iv. **Joseph Warburton**. Joseph was born in Bury, Lancashire, on 17 Jul 1889. ■ Census for Bury, Lancashire, in 1939. Joseph is a house painter and decorator living at 162 Tottington Road with Ethel and one other person whose record is closed. Joseph died in Bury, Lancashire, in 1969.

Joseph's birth was registered in 3q 1889 Bury 8c 572, mother's maiden name Marsden. His death was registered in 4q 1969 Bury 10b 2172, aged 80.

In 1918 when Joseph was 28, he married **Ethel Taylor** in Bury Register Office, or Registrar Attended, Lancashire. The marriage was registered in 2q 1918 Bury 8c 894. There were several Warburton-Taylor marriages registered at Bury, and many children registered with mother's maiden name Taylor, so it is not possible to determine from the Register Index alone, which one is their child with a closed record in the 1939 Register, or if they had others. Ethel was born on 6 Mar 1893. Ethel died in Bury, Lancashire, in 1967.

Ethel's death was registered in 2q 1967 Bury 10b 744, aged 74.

**21. Daniel Warburton** (*James<sup>4</sup>, James<sup>3</sup>, Thomas<sup>2</sup>, Peter<sup>1</sup>*). Daniel was born in Bury, Lancashire, in 1858. ■ Census for Accrington, Lancashire, in 1881. Daniel (22) is a mechanic in an iron works living at 9 Holland Street with Nancy (21), Mary (2), and Harry (12 weeks). ■ Census for Accrington, Lancashire, in 1891. Daniel (32) is an iron turner living at 95 Richmond Road with Nancy (31), Mary (11), Harry (10), Sarah (5), and Wilfred (5 months). ■ Census for Rochdale, Lancashire, in 1901. Daniel (42) is an iron turner living at 43 Partington Street with Nancy (41), Mary (21) a dressmaker, Harry (20) a draughtsman, Wilfred (9), Rhoda (7), and Clara (4). ■ Census for Bury, Lancashire, in 1911. Daniel (52) is an iron turner at a textile machinery works living at 7 Maxwell Street (6 rooms) with Nancy (51), Mary (31) a dress maker, Wilfred (20) a textile machine fitter, Rhoda (17) a cotton weaver, and Clara (14) a cotton weaver. Daniel and Nancy had been married 32 years and had 10 children, 5 still living. Daniel died in 1919.

Daniel's birth was registered in 2q 1858 Bury 8c 408, mother's maiden name Eccles. His death was registered in 1q 1919 Bury 8c 849, aged 60.

In 1879 when Daniel was 21, he married **Nancy Smith** in Bury Register Office, or Registrar Attended, Lancashire. The marriage was registered in 1q 1879 Bury 8c 543. Nancy was born in Rochdale, Lancashire, abt 1859. Nancy died in Bury, Lancashire, in 1942.

Nancy's death is probably that registered in 3q 1942 Bury 8c 381, aged 82.

They had the following children:

- i. **Mary Warburton**. Mary was born in Birtle, Bury, Lancashire, in 1879.

Mary's birth was registered in 2q 1879 Bury 8c 508, mother's maiden name Smith.

Minnie's birth was registered in 3q 1883 Haslingden 8e 162, mother's maiden name Smith. Her death was registered in 3q 1883 Haslingden 8e 97, aged 0.

- v. **Sarah Warburton**. Sarah was born in Accrington, Lancashire, in 1885. Sarah died in Accrington, Lancashire, in 1896.

Sarah's birth was registered in 3q 1885 Haslingden 8e 147, mother's maiden name Smith. Her death was registered in 2q 1896 Haslingden 8e 108, aged 10.

- vi. **Daniel Warburton**. Daniel was born in Accrington, Lancashire, in 1888. Daniel died in Accrington, Lancashire, in 1888.

Daniel's birth was registered in 31q 1888 Haslingden 8e 165, mother's maiden name Smith. His death was registered in 4q 1888 Haslingden 8e 122, aged 0.

- vii. **Fred Warburton**. Fred was born in Accrington, Lancashire, in 1889. Fred died in Accrington, Lancashire, in 1889.

Fred's birth was registered in 3q 1889 Haslingden 8e 157, mother's maiden name Smith. His death was registered in 3q 1889 Haslingden 8e 100, aged 0.

- ix. **Rhoda Warburton**. Rhoda was born in Accrington, Lancashire, in 1893.

Clara's birth was registered in 2q 1896 Haslingden 8e 140, mother's maiden name Smith.

22. **George Ramsbottom Warburton** (*James<sup>4</sup>, James<sup>3</sup>, Thomas<sup>2</sup>, Peter<sup>1</sup>*). George Ramsbottom was born in Bury, Lancashire, in 1871. ■ Census for Bury, Lancashire, in 1901. George (29) is a

chartered accountant's clerk living at 39 Garston Street, with Rhoda (31), and Rhoda Mary (1).

George's birth was registered in 4q 1871 Bury 8c 455, mother's maiden name Ramsbottom.

George's occupation in the 1901 census is a major change from 1891, but there is no George of a similar age from Bury in the 1881 and 1891 censuses to contradict the entry being for this George. The family are missing from the 1911 census and no matching death registrations have been found so it is possible the family emigrated.

In 1897 when George Ramsbottom was 26, he married **Rhoda Healey** in Bolton Register Office, or Registrar Attended, Lancashire. The marriage was registered in 1q 1897 Bolton 8c 590. Rhoda was born in Bury, Lancashire, abt 1869.

They had one child:

- i. **Rhoda Mary Warburton**. Rhoda Mary was born in Bury, Lancashire, in 1899.

Rhoda's birth was registered in 2q 1899 Lancaster 8e 793, mother's maiden name Healey.

**23. Daniel Jackson Warburton** (*John<sup>4</sup>, James<sup>3</sup>, Thomas<sup>2</sup>, Peter<sup>1</sup>*). Daniel Jackson was born in Bury, Lancashire, in 1870. ■ Census for Elton, Lancashire, in 1901. Daniel (30) is a foreman joiner living at 221 Tottington Road with Harriett (29), and Alice (1). Daniel Jackson died in Ancoats, Manchester, Lancashire, on 23 Oct 1949.

Daniel's birth was registered in 2q 1870 Bury 8c 481, mother's maiden name Rothwell. His death was registered in 4a 1949 Bury 10b 768, aged 79. Daniel died in The Fairfield General Hospital, Bury. He lived at 17 Harrison Street, Ancoats at the time of his death, and probate was granted to Alice Stranaghan and Annie Jones, married women, His effects were valued at £1879 15s 6d.

In 1898 when Daniel Jackson was 28, he married **Harriett Overfield** in Bury Register Office, or Registrar Attended, Lancashire. The marriage was registered in 1q 1898 Bury 8c 737. Harriett was born in Dudley, Worcestershire, abt 1871. Harriett died in Salford, Lancashire, in 1930.

Harriett's birth registration has not been found. Her death is probably that registered in 2q 1930 Salford 8d 337, aged 58. Other registrations that match her date of birth have a middle initial not present in known records of Harriett.

They had the following children:

- i. **Alice Warburton**. Alice was born in 1898.

Alice's birth was registered in 4q 1898 Bury 8c 605, mother's maiden name Overfield.

In 1920 when Alice was 22, she married **Harold Stranaghan** in Salford, Christ Church, Lancashire. The marriage was registered in 3q 1920 Salford 8d 185. One son was registered at Salford, mother's maiden name Warburton.

- ii. **Edna Warburton**. Edna was born in Bury, Lancashire, in 1902.

Edna's birth was registered in 3q 1902 Bury 8c 597, mother's maiden name Overfield.

- iii. **Annie Warburton**. Annie was born in Bury, Lancashire, in 1905.

Annie's birth was registered in 3q 1905 Bury 8c 582, mother's maiden name Overfield. As Annie is probably the Annie Jones who received probate on her father's will she married either William E Jones at Wrexham in 1933, or Arthur Jones at Salford in 1946.

- iv. **James Warburton**. James was born in Bury, Lancashire, in 1908. James died in Bury, Lancashire, in 1913.

James's birth was registered in 3q 1908 Bury 8c 555, mother's maiden name Overfield. James has not been found in the 1939 Register so is probably the James whose death was registered in 3q 1913 Bury 8c 709, aged 4.

**24. John Herbert Warburton** (*John*<sup>4</sup>, *James*<sup>3</sup>, *Thomas*<sup>2</sup>, *Peter*<sup>1</sup>). John Herbert was born in Bury, Lancashire, in 1872. ■ Census for Bury, Lancashire, in 1911. John (38) is a woollen warper living at 17 Fir Street (4 rooms) with Mary Jane (39), Mary (8), John (5), Geoffrey (4 months), and father-in-law Henry Kenyon (69) a widowed corporation labourer. John and Mary had been married 10 years and had 3 children, all living. ■ Census for Bury, Lancashire, in 1939. John is a retired woollen warper living at 17 Fir Street with Mary J, Margaret (later Fletcher) a master tailoress, and Annie (later Coleman) a confectioner. John Herbert died in Bury, Lancashire, in 1953.

John's birth was registered in 3q 1872 Bury 8c 464, mother's maiden name Rothwell. His death was registered in 4q 1953 Bury 10b 689, aged 81.

On 18 May 1901 when John Herbert was 29, he married **Mary Jane Kenyon** in Bury, St Paul, Lancashire. John Herbert (28) was a warper from 58 Myrtle Street, father John, a warper, deceased. Mary Jane (29) was a felter from 11 Fir Street, father Henry, an overlooker. The marriage was registered in 2q 1901 Bury 8c 925. Mary Jane was born abt 1871.

They had the following children:

- i. **Mary Warburton**. Mary was born in Bury, Lancashire, in 1903.

Mary's birth was registered in 1q 1903 Bury 8c 593, mother's maiden name Kenyon.

- ii. **John Warburton**. John was born in Bury, Lancashire, in 1905.

John's birth was registered in 3q 1905 Bury 8c 543, mother's maiden name Kenyon. In the 1939 Register there are 2 John's born in 1905 who could have been registered in the third quarter. Both are married but not yet with children. Based on the church used for their marriage the most likely was born on May 23rd, married Edna May Spencer at Bury, St Paul in 1937, and died in August 2003.

- iii. **Geoffrey Warburton**. Geoffrey was born in Bury, Lancashire, in 1910.

Geoffrey's birth was registered in 4q 1910 Bury 8c 520, mother's maiden name Kenyon. Geoffrey cannot be found in the 1939 Register, but there is no matching death registration.

Margaret's birth was registered in 4q 1912 Bury 8c 1004, mother's maiden name Kenyon.

In 1940 when Margaret was 27, she married **Samuel John Fletcher** in Bury, St Paul, Lancashire. The marriage was registered in 2q 1940 Bury 8c 1449. A boy was registered at Bury in 1948.

- v. **Annie Warburton**. Annie was born in Bury, Lancashire, on 1 Apr 1916.

Annie's birth was registered in 2q 1916 Bury 8c 850, mother's maiden name Kenyon.

In 1942 when Annie was 25, she married **Edgar Coleman** in Bury, St Paul, Lancashire. The marriage was registered in 2q 1942 Bury 8c 1297. A girl and a boy were registered in Heywood.

**25. George Warburton** (*Daniel<sup>4</sup>, James<sup>3</sup>, Thomas<sup>2</sup>, Peter<sup>1</sup>*). George was born in Gorton, Manchester, Lancashire, in 1861. ■ Census for Cheadle, Cheshire, in 1891. George (30) is a railway waggon inspector living at 3 Morley Street with Annie Pearson (29), Elizabeth Eleanor (4), Mary Emma (3), and Sarah Alice (10 months). ■ Census for Gorton, Manchester, Lancashire, in 1901. George (40) is a waggon maker for the railways living at 5 Lord Street with Annie Pearson (39), Mary Emma (13) a corset maker, Martha Annie (7), Georgina (5), and Daniel Mellor (2). ■ Census for Gorton, Manchester, Lancashire, in 1911. George (50) is a waggon maker for the railways living at 7 Reddish Lane (5 rooms) with Annie Pearson (49), Martha Annie (17) a cotton weaver, Georgina (15) a machinist (shirt maker), Daniel Mellor (12), and widowed father-in-law



Thomas Hasbaur (70). George and Annie had been married 27 years and had 6 children, 4 living. George died in 1930.

George's birth was registered in 1q 1861 Chorlton 8c 507, mother's maiden name Topham. His death was registered in 4q 1930 Manchester South 8d 132, aged 69.

On 30 Jun 1883 when George was 22, he married **Anne Pearson Meller** in Gorton, St Thomas (aka St James), Lancashire. George (22) was a wagon maker from Gorton, father Daniel. a wagon maker. Anne (21) was from Gorton, father Tommy, a baker. Mary Warburton was a witness. The marriage was registered in 3q 1883 Chorlton 8c 881. Anne Pearson was born in Huddersfield, Yorkshire, in 1862.

They had the following children:

- i. **Elizabeth Eleanor Warburton**. Elizabeth Eleanor was born in Stockport, Cheshire, in 1886. Elizabeth Eleanor died in Chorlton, Manchester, Lancashire, in 1893.

Elizabeth's birth was registered in 2q 1886 Stockport 8a 49, mother's maiden name Meller. Her death was registered in 1q 1893 Chorlton 8c 516, aged 6.

- ii. **Mary Emma Warburton**. Mary Emma was born in Stockport, Cheshire, in 1888.

Mary's birth was registered in 4q 1887 Stockport 8a 57, mother's maiden name Meller.

- iii. **Sarah Alice Warburton**. Sarah Alice was born in Stockport, Cheshire, in 1890. Sarah Alice died in Stockport, Cheshire, in 1891.

Sarah's birth was registered in 3q 1890 Stockport 8a 51, mother's maiden name Meller. Her death was registered in 3q 1891 Chorlton 8c 470, aged 1.

- iv. **Martha Anne Warburton**. Martha Anne was born in Gorton, Manchester, Lancashire, in 1893. Martha Anne died in Manchester, Lancashire, in 1929.

Martha's birth was registered in 4q 1883 Chorlton 8c 757, mother's maiden name Meller. Her death was registered in 3q 1929 Manchester South 8d 137, aged 35.

In 1916 when Martha Anne was 23, she married **Simeon Griffiths** in Chorlton, Manchester, Lancashire. The marriage was registered in 3q 1916 Chorlton 8c 1323. Simeon and Martha had a son and daughter. Simeon was born in Gorton, Manchester, Lancashire, in 1895.

- v. **Georgina Warburton**. Georgina was born in Gorton, Manchester, Lancashire, on 13 Sep 1896. Georgina died in Hurstville, NSW, on 11 Jul 1981.

Georgina's birth was registered in 4q 1895 Chorlton 8c 716, mother's maiden name Meller.

On 20 May 1918 when Georgina was 21, she married **Arthur Wallis** in Gorton, St Philip, Lancashire. The marriage was registered in 2q 1918 Chorlton 8c 1196. Arthur and Georgina had two daughters, and several grandchildren, including my contact Virginia Nightingale. Arthur was born in Castleton, Bury, Lancashire, on 19 Mar 1897. Arthur died in Hurstville, NSW, on 22 Jul 1954.

Arthur (24) a married, fitter, Georgina (25) his wife, and daughter Jean departed from London on 25 May 1921 for Sydney, Australia. . They sailed on the BELTANA, captained by Capt B Cornwall-Jones. There were 939 passengers.

- vi. **Daniel Meller Warburton**. Daniel Meller was born in Gorton, Manchester, Lancashire, in 1899. Daniel Meller died in Baguley, Cheshire, on 26 Aug 1965.

Daniel's birth was registered in 1q 1899 Chorlton 8c 818, mother's maiden name Meller. His death was registered in 3q 1965 Manchester 10e 137, aged 65. Probate for Daniel Warburton otherwise Daniel Mellor of 38 Hornbeam Road, Levenshulme, Manchester, who died at Baguley Hospital, Manchester Administration, was granted to the solicitor for the affairs of the Duchy of Lancaster. His effects were valued at £1871.

In 1918 when Daniel Meller was 19, he first married **Frances Cain** in Gorton, St Philip, Lancashire. The marriage was registered in 2q 1918 Chorlton 8c 1193. No children were registered with mother's maiden name Cain.

In 1943 when Daniel Meller was 44, he second married **Emma McKenna** in Manchester Register Office, or Registrar Attended, Lancashire. The marriage was registered in 4q 1943 Manchester 8d 544.

Emma was previously Emma Holton. No children were registered with mother's maiden name of either McKenna or Holton.

In 1957 when Daniel Meller was 58, he third married **Eva Alice Quin** in Manchester Register Office, or Registrar Attended, Lancashire. The marriage was registered in 1q 1957 Manchester 10e 843.

**26. Thomas Warburton** (*Daniel<sup>4</sup>, James<sup>3</sup>, Thomas<sup>2</sup>, Peter<sup>1</sup>*). Thomas was born in Gorton, Manchester, Lancashire, in 1863. ■ Census for Gorton, Manchester, Lancashire, in 1901. Thomas (38) is a joiner and builder living at 1 Melbourne Street with Maria (37), Thomas E (6), and Alfred W (3). ■ Census for Ardwick, Manchester, Lancashire, in 1911. Thomas (48) is a joiner and cottage builder living at 57 Beech Street with Maria (47), Thomas Edward (16) an apprentice to a pharmaceutical chemist, Alfred Nelson (13), and Stanley (8). Thomas and Maria had been married 18 years and had 4 children, 3 still living.

Thomas's birth was registered in 2q 1863 Chorlton 8c 530, mother's maiden name Topham.

Abt 1891 when Thomas was 28, he married **Maria Nielson**. The date is based in time married in the 1911 census. No registration has been found so it possibly took place abroad. Maria was born in Sweden abt 1864.

Maria was Swedish.

They had the following children:

- i. **Thomas Edward Warburton**. Thomas Edward was born in Gorton, Manchester, Lancashire, in 1895. ■ Census for Manchester, Lancashire, on 16 Mar 1939. Thos E is a pharmacist living at 46 Denison Road with Florence Garside, a home maker, and 9 other individuals in various occupations. It would appear the premisis is a lodging house. Thomas and Florence are both married, and 'Warburton' has been added to Florence's entry.

Thomas's birth was registered in 2q 1895 Chorlton 8c 778, mother's maiden name Nelson.

In 1938 when Thomas Edward was 43, he married **Florence Garside** in Manchester South Register Office, or Registrar Attended, Lancashire. The marriage was registered in 4q 1938 Manchester South 8d 403. No children were registered with mother's maiden name Garside. Florence was born on 30 Aug 1895.

- ii. **Alfred Nelson Warburton**. Alfred Nelson was born in Gorton, Manchester, Lancashire, in 1897.

Alfred's birth was registered in 3q 1897 Chorlton 8c 804, mother's maiden name Nelson. He and his family have not been found in the 1939 Register and no matching death registration has been found for Alfred.

In 1924 when Alfred Nelson was 27, he married **Elizabeth Roberts** in Chorlton-on-Medlock Register Office, or Registrar Attended. The marriage was registered in 1q 1924 Chorlton 8c 1130. Two boys were registered in South Manchester with mother's maiden name Roberts (1926 and 1932).

- iii. **James Warburton**. James<sup>3</sup> was born in Gorton, Manchester, Lancashire, in 1899. James died in Gorton, Manchester, Lancashire, in 1900.

James's birth was registered in 3q 1899 Chorlton 8c 8060, mother's maiden name Nelson. His death was registered in 1q 1900 Chorlton 8c 657, aged 0.

Henry (26) is a master baker living at 125 Blackburn Road with Rachel (27). ■ Census for Bolton, Lancashire, in 1901. Henry (36) is a master baker living at 22 Blackbanck Street with Rachel (37), George (9), Nellie (8), Harry (4), William (4), and James (2). ■ Census for Bolton, Lancashire, in 1911. Henry (46) is a master bread baker and employer living at North House, Blackburn Road with Rachel (47), George (19) a clerk in the Bakery, Nellie (18) who assists in house duties, Harry (14), and William (14) both at school, and a servant. Henry and Rachel have been married 23 years and had 5 children, 4 still living. Henry died in Bolton, Lancashire, on 5 Sep 1936.

Henry's birth was registered in 1q 1865 Bolton 8c 307. His death was registered in 3q 1936 Bolton 8c 282, aged 71.

On 12 Sep 1888 when Henry was 23, he married **Rachel Smethurst** in Bolton Register Office, or Registrar attended. The marriage was registered in 3q 1888 Bolton 8c 584. Rachel was born in Bolton, Lancashire, in 1864. She was christened in Bolton, Lancashire, on 6 Mar 1864. Rachel died in Bolton, Lancashire, in 1942.

Rachel's parents were William and Margaret Smethurst. Her birth was registered in 1q 1864 Bolton 8c 303, and her death was probably that registered in 2q 1942 Bolton 8c 369, aged 78.

They had the following children:

- i. **George Warburton**. George was born in Bolton, Lancashire, on 19 Apr 1891. He was christened in Bolton, Higher Bridge St. Primitive Methodist Chapel, Lancashire, on 24 May 1891. George died in Cleveland, Ohio, in 1948.

George's birth was registered in 2q 1891 Bolton 8c 502.

On 15 Sep 1915 when George was 24, he first married **May Jones** in Bolton, Higher Bridge St. Primitive Methodist Chapel, Lancashire. Two girl's births were registered at Bolton in the 1920s, mother's maiden name Jones which may be the daughters of George and May. May was born in Bolton, Lancashire, in 1890. May died in 1937.

May was the daughter of Daniel Jones. Her birth is probably that registered in 2q 1890 Bolton 8c 493.

Abt 1940 when George was 48, he second married **Marjorie Hilkert**. George met Marjorie whilst serving as Vice Consul in Cleveland, Ohio. They had one son, William George who lived there with his mother after George's death. William served in the US Navy at Holy Loch in the late 1960s and early 1970s, and married in Scotland. He has 2 sons and 2 grandsons. Marjorie was born in USA. Marjorie died in Cleveland, Ohio, in Nov 1999.

- ii. **Nellie Warburton**. Nellie was born in Bolton, Lancashire, on 7 Feb 1893. She was christened in Bolton, Higher Bridge St. Primitive Methodist Chapel, Lancashire, on 12 Mar 1893. Nellie died in 1973.

Nellie's birth was registered in 1q 1893 Bolton 8c 508.

On 27 Mar 1918 when Nellie was 25, she married **Joseph Prestwich Warwick** in Bolton, Higher Bridge St. Primitive Methodist Chapel, Lancashire. Nellie and Joe had 4 children. Joseph Prestwich was born in 1893.

Joseph was the son of Francis Warwick.

**28. Thomas Warburton** (*George<sup>4</sup>, Henry<sup>3</sup>, Thomas<sup>2</sup>, Peter<sup>1</sup>*). Thomas was born in Bolton, Lancashire, in 1867. He was christened in Bolton, Lancashire, on 24 Nov 1867. ■ Census for

Bolton, Lancashire, in 1891. Thomas (23) is a cotton machinery fitter living at 28 Keswick Street with Emma (21). ■ Census for Bolton, Lancashire, in 1901. Thomas (33) is a cotton machinery fitter living at 313 Blackburn Road with Emma (31), and Harry (8). ■ Census for Bolton, Lancashire, in 1911. Thomas (43) is a fruiterer and fish dealer living at 271 Derby Road with Harry (18) also a fruiterer and fish dealer, Thomas (4), and a servant.

Thomas's birth was registered in 4q 1867 Bolton 8c 287. The identity of Thomas's wife was changed following contact from Lindsay Garmston-Trump.

In 1890 when Thomas was 23, he married **Emma Openshaw** in Bolton Register Office, or Registrar attended. The marriage was registered in 3q 1890 Bolton 8c 616. FamilySearch records Thomas's father as George, and Emma's as James. Emma was born in Astley Bridge, Lancashire, in 1869. Emma died in Bolton, Lancashire, bef 1911.

Emma's birth was registered in 2q 1869 Bolton 8c 305. Her death registration has not been found on FreeBMD, but Thomas was a widower in the 1911 census. As her son Thomas was 4 in 1911 she died between 1906 and 1911.

They had the following children:

- i. **Harry Warburton**. Harry was born in Bolton, Lancashire, abt 1892. Harry died in 1970.

The births of 2 Harry's were registered at Bolton, one in 3q 1892 Bolton 8c 383, the other in 1q 1893 Bolton 8c 495. He is probably the Harry whose death was registered in 2q 1970 Bolton 10b 1582, aged 77.

- ii. **Thomas Warburton**. Thomas was born in Bolton, Lancashire, on 6 Apr 1906. Thomas died in May 1985.

Thomas's birth was registered in 2q 1906 Bolton 8c 485. His death is probably that registered in May 1985 Bolton 38 34.

**29. George Warburton** (*George<sup>4</sup>, Henry<sup>3</sup>, Thomas<sup>2</sup>, Peter<sup>1</sup>*). George was born in Bolton, Lancashire, in 1873. He was christened in Bolton, Lancashire, on 6 Apr 1873. ■ Census for Bolton, Lancashire, in 1901. George (28) is a greengrocer living at 125 Blackburn Road with Martha A (28), Lily (5), and Emma (3). ■ Census for Bolton, Lancashire, in 1911. George (38) is a greengrocer living at 16 Blackburn Road with Martha Alice (37) who is assisting in the business, Lily (15) working in a cardroom, Emma (13) a cotton weaver, Thomas (8), and Walter (4). George and Martha have been married 16 years and had 5 children, 4 still living.

George's birth was registered in 1q 1873 Bolton 8c 373.

On 27 Mar 1895 when George was 22, he married **Martha Alice Bentley** in Bolton Register Office,

or Registrar attended. The marriage was registered in 1q 1895 Bolton 8c 537. Martha Alice was born in Bolton, Lancashire, in 1874.

Martha was the daughter of John Bentley.

They had the following children:

- i. **Lily Warburton**. Lily was born in Bolton, Lancashire, in 1895.

Lily's birth was registered in either 4q 1895 Bolton 8c 444, or 1q 1896 Bolton 8c 486.

- ii. **Emma Warburton**. Emma was born in Bolton, Lancashire, in 1897.

Emma's birth was registered in 3q 1897 Bolton 8c 461.

- iii. **Thomas Warburton**. Thomas was born in Bolton, Lancashire, in 1902.

George (20) is an apprentice millwright living at 32 Keswick Road with sister Margaret A (19), brother Harry (14) a piecer, and a lodger Rachel Pendlebury (25). ■ Census for Bolton, Lancashire, in 1901. George (30) is a millwright living at 64 Lena Road with Alice A (31), and Beatrice (6). ■ Census for Bolton, Lancashire, in 1911. George (40) is an iron founder living at 82 Ashworth Lane with Alice Ann (41), and Beatrice (16) a dressmaker. George and Alice have been married 19 years and had 2 children, one still living.

George's birth was registered in 2q 1870 Bolton 8c 334.

In 1891 when George was 21, he married **Alice Ann Worsley** in Bolton Register Office, or Registrar attended. The marriage was registered in 4q 1891 Bolton 8c 598. Alice Ann was born in Bolton, Lancashire, abt 1869.

They had one child:

- i. **Beatrice Warburton**. Beatrice was born in Bolton, Lancashire, in 1894.

Beatrice's birth was registered in 3q 1894 Bolton 8c 429.

**31. Harry Warburton** (*Henry<sup>4</sup>, Henry<sup>3</sup>, Thomas<sup>2</sup>, Peter<sup>1</sup>*). Harry was born in Bolton, Lancashire, in 1876. ■ Census for Bolton, Lancashire, in 1911. Harry (35) is a minder in a cotton mill living at 42

Charles Rupert Street with Martha Ann (29), Henry (6), and Martha (4). Harry and Martha have been married 8 years and had 2 children, both living.

Harry's birth was registered in 2q 1876 Bolton 8c 411.

In 1903 when Harry was 27, he married **Martha Ann Gilmore** in Bolton Register Office, or Registrar attended. The marriage was registered in 2q 1903 Bolton 8c 757. Martha Ann was born in Manchester, Lancashire, in 1882.

Martha's birth was registered in 2q 1882 Prestwich 8d 350.

They had the following children:

- i. **Henry Warburton**. Henry was born in Bolton, Lancashire, in 1905.

Henry's birth is one of 2 registered in 3q 1905 Bolton 8c 449 or 476.

- ii. **Martha Warburton**. Martha was born in Bolton, Lancashire, in 1907.

Martha's birth was registered in 2q 1907 Bolton 8c 485.

- iii. **Ada Warburton**. Ada was born in Bolton, Lancashire, in 1912.

Ada's birth was registered in 1q 1912 Bolton 8c 912.

- iv. **Ruby Warburton**. Ruby was born in Bolton, Lancashire, in 1915.

Ruby's birth was registered in 2q 1915 Bolton 8c 848.

**32. Thomas Warburton** (*Peter<sup>4</sup>, Henry<sup>3</sup>, Thomas<sup>2</sup>, Peter<sup>1</sup>*). Thomas was born in Reddish, Stockport, Cheshire, on 4 Aug 1877. ■ Census for Bolton, Lancashire, in 1911. Thomas (33) is a cotton operative living at 27 St Bartolomew Street (5 rooms) with Mary Jane (35), and Gladys (1). Thomas and Mary Jane had been married 2 years and had one child who is still living. ■ Census for Bolton, Lancashire, in 1939. Thomas is a rayon fibre spinner living at 27 St Bartolomew Street with Mary Jane unpaid domestic duties, and Gladys an army machinist. Thomas died in Bolton, Lancashire, on 11 Mar 1953.

Thomas's birth was registered in 3q 1877 Stockport 8a 43, mother's maiden name Rostron. His death was registered in 1q 1953 Bolton 10b 684, aged 75. He died at 27 St. Bartholomew Street.

In 1908 when Thomas was 30, he married **Mary Jane Edge** in Bolton Register Office, or Registrar attended. The marriage was registered in 2q 1908 Bolton 8c 833. Mary Jane was born in Bolton, Lancashire, on 25 May 1875. Mary Jane died in Bolton, Lancashire, on 5 Feb 1951.

Mary Jane's birth was registered in 3q 1875 Bolton 8c 429. Her death was registered in 1q 1951 Bolton 10b 990, aged 75.

■ Census for Bolton, Lancashire, in 1911. William (29) is a self actor minder (cotton spinning) living at 205 Rishton Lane (6 rooms), with Sarah Jane (28). They had been married one year. ■ Census for Bolton, Lancashire, in 1939. William (is a musician (violinist) living at 205 Rishton Lane, with Sarah Jane, and Millicent a laundry head washer. William died in Farnworth, Lancashire, in 1944.

William's birth was registered in 1q 1882 Bolton 8c 397, mother's maiden name Hensor. His death was registered in 2q 1944 Farnworth 8c 355, aged 62.

In 1910 when William was 28, he married **Sarah Jane Higham** in Bolton Register Office, or Registrar attended. The marriage was registered in 1q 1910 Bolton 8c 704. Sarah Jane was born in Bolton, Lancashire, on 20 Jul 1882. Sarah Jane died in Farnworth, Lancashire, on 10 Sep 1976.

Sarah's death was registered in 3q 1976 Bolton 38 56, giving her date of birth.

They had the following children:

- i. **Millicent Warburton**. Millicent was born in Bolton, Lancashire, on 6 Feb 1922. Millicent died in Farnworth, Lancashire, on 12 Mar 1984.

George's birth was registered in 2q 1912 Bolton 8c 919, mother's maiden name Higham. His death was registered in June 1995 Scunthorpe C34B 5541C 9, giving his date of birth.

On 16 Jul 1938 when George was 26, he married **Ellen Richards** in Bolton, Victoria Methodist, Lancashire. George and Ellen had two sons. Ellen was born in Bolton, Lancashire, on 12 Jul 1907. Ellen died in Scunthorpe, Lincolnshire, in Jan 1996.

Ellen's death was registered in January 1996 Scunthorpe B38B 5541B 231, giving her date of birth.

**34. Joseph Warburton** (*John<sup>4</sup>, Henry<sup>3</sup>, Thomas<sup>2</sup>, Peter<sup>1</sup>*). Joseph was born in Bolton, Lancashire, in 1890. Joseph died on 15 May 1943.

Joseph's birth was registered in 2q 1890 Bolton 8c 449, mother's maiden name Warwick. His death was registered in 2q 1943 Horwich 8c 339, aged 52.

On 5 Jul 1916 when Joseph was 26, he married **Florence Ramsden** in Harwood Primitive Methodist Chapel, Lancashire. The marriage was registered in 3q 1916 Bolton 8c 809. Florence was born on 6 May 1891. Florence died on 14 May 1973.

Florence's death was registered in 2q 1973 Cardiff 8b 544.

They had the following children:

- i. **Geoffrey Warburton**. Geoffrey was born on 16 Apr 1924. Geoffrey died on 11 Dec 1982.

Geoffrey's birth was registered in 2q 1924 Bolton 8c 746, mother's maiden name Ramsden. His death was registered in 4q 1982 Brecknock (Powys) 26 43.

In 1948 when Geoffrey was 23, he married **Winnie Platt** in Harwood Primitive Methodist Chapel, Lancashire. The marriage was registered in 3q 1948 Horwich 10c 1305. Two children were registered in South ales including my contact Martin who has 2 sons, and a grandson. Winnie was born on 24 Dec 1925. Winnie died on 13 Jan 1977.

Winnie's birth was registered in 1q 1926 Bolton 8c 698, mother's maiden name Smith. Her death was registered in 1q 1977 South Glamorgan 28 1884.

- ii. **Renie Warburton**. Renie was born in 1920. Renie died in Switzerland on 30 Sep 2002.

Renie's birth was registered in 1q 1920 Bolton 8c 963, mother's maiden name Ramsden.

**Renie Adams** (née Warburton) was one of the first WAAF Radar Instructors at the training school set up by Jack Ratcliffe in Forres School in Swanage in 1941. She married John Adams in 1943 who later became the Chief Scientist for Civil work in the Ministry of Technology and subsequently was Director of CERN in Geneva.

Norman Blackburne, Purbeck Radar Site:

Renie, Lady Adams, who died on 30 September 2002 was the widow of Sir John Adams, a former Staff Member and Director-General of CERN. As a beneficiary of the CERN Pension Fund, she was a member of GAC and took an interest in its affairs. In 1998, Renie was elected as one of the Auditors of our Association, but was unable to take up this appointment because of ill health.

In 1974, she founded the CERN Women's Club, which, in addition to its normal club activities, has since helped many newcomers' wives to settle into the Geneva area. She played an important role in supporting her husband in his contacts with CERN personnel at all levels, with the CERN Council and its committees, as well as with visiting dignitaries from all parts of the world.

Renie was interested in everything around her and was always ready to help her friends and family alike. Her warm personality and easy manner will be missed by all

those who knew her.

In 1943 when Renie was 23, she married **Sir John Adams** in Harwood Primitive Methodist Chapel, Lancashire. The marriage was registered in 1q 1943 Horwich 8c 657.

Sir John was a Director General of CERN in Switzerland.

**35. Stanley Warburton** (*Joshua<sup>5</sup>, Thomas<sup>4</sup>, James<sup>3</sup>, Thomas<sup>2</sup>, Peter<sup>1</sup>*). Stanley was born in Bury, Lancashire, on 16 Aug 1887. ■ Census for Bury, Lancashire, in 1939. Stanley is a railway clerk living at 132 Chesham Road with Ellen, Winifred M an infant school teacher, and Walter J Bushrod a retired minister, and Lucy Bushrod. Stanley died in Bury, Lancashire, in 1973.

Stanley's birth was registered in 3q 1887 Bury 8c 558, mother's maiden name Kershaw. His death was registered in 4q 1973 Bury 10b 2281, aged 86.

The following story is from Peter Jones, great nephew of Stanley and Nellie.

*Rev Bushrod, referred to in the 1939 Register, was the minister of Chesham Unitarian Chapel in Bury from 1925 to 1936. He was visiting Stanley and Nellie from his home in Southampton when the 1939 record was created.*

*Stanley died watching "The Generation Game", a well-known Saturday evening game show hosted by Bruce Forsyth. He was roaring with laughter at one of Bruce's jokes, when he suddenly tipped forward in his armchair so literally died laughing!*

In 1917 when Stanley was 29, he married **Ellen Walker** in Chesham Unitarian Church (Registrar Attended), Lancashire. The marriage was registered in 2q 1917 Bury 8c 918. Winifred is the only child registered at Bury with mother's maiden name Walker, following the marriage. Ellen was born in Bury, Lancashire, on 27 Apr 1891. Ellen died in Bury, Lancashire, in 1975.

Ellen's death was registered in 2q 1975 Bury 38 597, aged 84. She was known as Nellie.

The following story is from Peter Jones, Nellie's great nephew.

*Nellie was the youngest of three children of James and Sarah Walker. She qualified as a schoolteacher and taught at Buckhurst School, a small school up on the Lancashire moors to the north of Chesham, about an hour's walk from her home. She was said to be a fine mathematician.*

*Stanley and Nellie never sold any of the houses they lived in in Chesham, Bury. On his death, he owned four properties, all within a hundred yards of each other. He often told the story that Nellie on more than one occasion sent a message down to the Railway Offices to say that she'd bought a new house, and would he move the coal round to it when he came home from work. They lived for a while at 134 Chesham Road, then the larger house next door came on the market, so Nellie bought it, and moved in the same day, and Stanley moved the coal from one cellar to the other that evening!*

*Nellie suffered a series of strokes in the two years before she died. Sadly, these affected her speech*

*badly, but she would watch me from her chair in the kitchen playing board games with her daughter Mary. If ever we made a mistake adding up scores, she would immediately call out the correct number.*

*A final stroke shortly before she died left her unable to speak English, but she had oddly retained some fluency in French, much to the surprise of John Allerton, the Minister of Bury Unitarian Church who was visiting her.*

*Richmal Crompton, the author of the Just William stories, spent her early years higher up Chesham Road and knew Stanley, Nellie and her brother Samuel (my grandfather). In one Just William story, Crompton relates how after William and his gang, the Outlaws, won a scrap, they marched triumphantly up the road followed by William's dog, cat and bantam hen. My grandfather always believed that Crompton based this episode on his own dog, cat and bantam hen that used to always support each other in fights with other local animals.*

They had one child:

- i. **Winifred Mary Warburton**. Winifred Mary was born in Bury, Lancashire, on 22 Sep 1919. Winifred Mary died in Bury, Lancashire, on 8 Jun 2012. She was buried in Bury Unitarian Church, Lancashire.

Mary's birth was registered in 4q 1919 Bury 8c 1022, mother's maiden name Walker. She never married. The following story is from Peter Jones (her cousin).

*Mary was my first cousin once removed, though I called her Auntie.*

*Mary trained as a nursery school teacher at Gypsy Hill College in London; her last post was as Headmistress at Millbank Nursery School in Heywood, Lancashire.*

*Several articles about her and her school appeared in the Heywood Advertiser in the 1960s.*

*Mary never married; she and two other spinster teachers used to holiday together all over Europe, often visiting places rarely frequently by English tourists, and enjoying particularly going to skiing resorts in the summer. They made a formidable trio. One of them, Lenora Shaw, drove a 1940s Austin 10 round Bury until the early 1990s when she was at least 80.*

*It was Mary who first whetted my appetite for researching the family tree. At my wedding, I commented that I came from a very small family - there were only three relatives there. Mary immediately found a sheet of paper and wrote out a family tree to demonstrate that there were actually a lot of members of the family, but I just didn't know them!*

**36. Alfred Warburton** (Joseph Henry<sup>5</sup>, James<sup>4</sup>, James<sup>3</sup>, Thomas<sup>2</sup>, Peter<sup>1</sup>). Alfred was born in Bury,

Lancashire, on 15 Oct 1884. ■ Census for Bury, Lancashire, in 1939. Alfred is a hatter and presser (hot work) living at 9 Oram Street with Emma and two persons whose records are closed. Alfred died in Bury, Lancashire, in 1949.

Alfred's birth was registered in 4q 1884 Bury 8c 552, mother's maiden name Marsden. His death was registered in 1q 1949 Bury 10b 980, aged 64.

In 1919 when Alfred was 34, he married **Emma Dodd** in Bury Register Office, or Registrar Attended, Lancashire. The marriage was registered in 3q 1919 Bury 8c 1407. Emma was born on 25 May 1885. Emma died in 1959.

Emma's death is probably that registered in 3q 1959 Haslingden 10c 297, aged 74 as it is the correct age and close geographically.

They had the following children:

- i. **Alan Warburton**. Alan was born in Bury, Lancashire, on 5 Jun 1921. Alan died in Bury, Lancashire, in 1997.

Alan's birth was registered in 2q 1921 Bury 8c 1030, mother's maiden name Dodd. His death was registered in October 1997, Bury C51B 31C 39, aged 76. No marriage has been found for Alan at Bury.

- ii. **James Warburton**. James was born in Bury, Lancashire, on 27 Apr 1926. James died in Bury, Lancashire, in 1994.

James's birth was registered in 2q 1926 Bury 8c 772, mother's maiden name Dodd. His death was registered in July 1994 Bury C43B 31C 268, aged 68. No marriage has been found for James at Bury.

**37. Harry Warburton** (*Daniel*<sup>5</sup>, *James*<sup>4</sup>, *James*<sup>3</sup>, *Thomas*<sup>2</sup>, *Peter*<sup>1</sup>). Harry was born in Bury, Lancashire, on 8 Jan 1881. ■ Census for Heywood, Lancashire, in 1911. Harry (30) is a textile machinery draughtsman in an iron works, living at 31 Wilton Street (5 rooms) with Martha (23) and James (3 months). Harry and Martha had been married i year and had one child. ■ Census for Rochdale, Lancashire, in 1939. Harry is an engineering draughtsman living at 46 Meadway with Martha, James an insurance audit clerk, and Stanley an engineering draughtsman. Harry died in Rochdale, Lancashire, in 1961.

Harry's birth was registered in 1q 1881 Bury 8c 548, mother's maiden name Smith. His death was registered in 3q 1961 Littleborough 10d 76, aged 80.

Harry married **Martha Wolstenholme**. Martha was born in Heywood, Lancashire, on 29 Oct 1887. Martha died in Rochdale, Lancashire, in 1961.

Martha's death was registered in 4q 1961 Rochdale 10f 426, aged 74.

They had the following children:

- i. **James Warburton**. James was born in Heywood, Lancashire, on 19 Dec 1910. James died in Luton, bedfordshire, in 1994.

James's birth was registered in 1q 1911 Bury 8c 531, mother's maiden name Wolstenholme. His death was registered in April 1994 Luton C44F 3151C 234, aged 83.

- ii. **Stanley Warburton**. Stanley was born on 19 Mar 1919.

Stanley's birth was registered in 1q 1919 Bury 8c 675, mother's maiden name Wolstenholme. There is no death registration in England and Wales that matches his date of birth in the 1939 Register.

**38. Wilfred Warburton** (*Daniel<sup>5</sup>, James<sup>4</sup>, James<sup>3</sup>, Thomas<sup>2</sup>, Peter<sup>1</sup>*). Wilfred was born in Accrington, Lancashire, on 8 Oct 1890. ■ Census for Bury, Lancashire, in 1939. Wilfred is a shop keeper, owner of drapers business living at 18 Eastham Avenue with Bertha, frank a laboratory assistant dyeing and finishing, and a person whose record is closed. Wilfred died in Bury, Lancashire, in 1956.

Wilfred's birth was registered as Wilfrid in 4q 1890 Haslingden 8e 141, mother's maiden name Smith. His death was registered in 1q 1956 Bury 10b 1017, aged 65.

In 1918 when Wilfred was 27, he married **Bertha Heap** in Bury Register Office, or Registrar Attended, Lancashire. The marriage was registered in 2q 1918 Bury 8c 896'. Bertha was born on 21 Oct 1891. Bertha died in Bury, Lancashire, in 1972.

Bertha's death was registered in 4q 1962 Bury 10b 810, aged 71.

They had the following children:

- i. **Frank Warburton**. Frank was born on 26 May 1921. Frank died in 1981.

Frank's birth was registered in 2q 1921 Bury 8c 1030, mother's maiden name Heap. His death was registered in 1q 1981 Preston and South Ribble 40 2139, aged 59.

- ii. **Fred Warburton**. Fred was born in Bury, Lancashire, in 1923.

Census for Manchester, Lancashire, in 1939. Stanley is a rent collector living at 57 Haworth Road with Clarice, May E, a single, retired cotton spinner born in 1860 (29th June) who has not been identified. There are also 2 closed records that are probably 2 of Stanley's children.

Stanley's birth was registered in 4q 1902 Chorlton 8c 780, mother's maiden name Nelson. His death was probably registered in 2q 1977 Manchester 38 958, aged 74. However there is a discrepancy between his date of birth on the 1939 Register, (Sept. 11th) and his death registration (Sept 22nd), though there is no other Stanley in the 1939 Register born in 1902.

In 1923 when Stanley was 20, he married **Clarice Mills** in Middlesborough, Yorkshire. The marriage was registered in 4q 1923 Middlesborough 9d 1329. In addition to Daniel 2 daughters were registered, one in Middlesborough, and one in Manchester. Clarice was born in Manchester, Lancashire, on 25 Jul 1901.

Clarice's birth was registered in 3q 1901 Chorlton 8c 812, mother's maiden name Slater. Her death was registered in 3q 1973 Manchester 10e 484, aged 72.

- i. **Daniel Warburton**. Daniel was born in Manchester, Lancashire, in 1926. Daniel died in Manchester, Lancashire, in 1926.

Daniel's birth was registered in 1q 1926 Manchester South 8d 143, mother's maiden name Mills. His death was registered in iq 1926 Manchester South 8d 146, aged 0.

**40. Harry Warburton** (*Henry<sup>5</sup>, George<sup>4</sup>, Henry<sup>3</sup>, Thomas<sup>2</sup>, Peter<sup>1</sup>*). Harry was born in Bolton, Lancashire, on 27 Nov 1896. He was christened in Bolton, Higher Bridge St. Primitive Methodist Chapel, Lancashire, on 27 Dec 1896. Harry died in 1966.

Harry and William were twins. Harry was christened at Bridge Street Chapel, a Primitive Methodist Church. His birth registration is not listed on FreeBMD.

In 1921 when Harry was 24, he married **Hilda Morris** in Bolton, St Paul, Lancashire. The marriage was registered in 3q 1921 Bolton 8c 677.

Several Hilda Morris births are registered at Bolton around 1900.

They had the following children:

- i. **Harold Derrick Warburton**. Harold Derrick was born in Bolton, Lancashire, in 1924.

Derrick's birth was registered in 1q 1924 Bolton 8c 741.

In 1949 when Harold Derrick was 25, he married **Joyce Booth** in Bolton, St Philip, Lancashire. Derrick and Joyce have a daughter who gave them 2 granddaughters, and a son who gave them 3 grandsons and a granddaughter.

- ii. **George Warburton**. George was born in Bolton, Lancashire, in 1927.

George's birth was registered in 2q 1927 Bolton 8c 629.

George married **Maureen**. George and Maureen had a son and 2 granddaughters.

- iii. **Henry Warburton**. Henry was born in Bolton, Lancashire, in 1930.

Henry's birth was registered in 4q 1930 Bolton 8c 463.

Henry first married **Julie**. Henry and Julie had 2 daughters and 3 grandchildren. Julie died in 1984.
