



PREFACE



The bulk of this clan are descendants of John Charles Warburton born in 1808 in Wilmslow, the illegitimate son of Alice Warburton. His descendants were mainly to be found in Macclesfield, and in Paterson, New Jersey. Alice's father, Peter Warburton has yet to be linked to a known clan.

First Generation

1. Peter Warburton. Peter was born in 1746. He was christened in Mobberley, St Wilfred, Cheshire, on 26 Feb 1746. Peter died in Hough, Wilmslow, Cheshire, on 28 Jul 1793.

Peter is probably the son of Peter Warburton and Ann Astle who were married at Mobberley St Wilfred on 1 Dec 1744. Peter is described as 'of Morley', and Alice 'of Dean Row'. Their son was baptised on 26 Feb 1746 in the same church but his father is described as 'of Fulshers (Fulshaw) Hall in the parish of Wilmslow'. Two further sons were baptised at Wilmslow, Thomas on 14 May 1748, and John on 22 March 1749.

The origins of Peter snr. are unclear. He does not belong to the established Mobberley families, where Peters occur but are accounted for. There are several Peters baptised at Rostherne, one in 1745, son of Thomas and Martha, who is another candidate for Peter jun., one in 1723, son of Peter and Hannah, and others in 1706, 1702, 1696 (Wilmslow), 1681, 1677, and 1640 (Wilmslow). Since names frequently run in families, and Peter was relatively uncommon at this time this run of Peters probably indicates a single extended family.

It is interesting that after the first daughter was baptised in Manchester the others were baptised at Dean Row Unitarian Chapel whilst the sons were baptised at Wilmslow Parish Church.

The death of a Peter was recorded at Wilmslow on the 28 July 1793. No age is given, but no other Peters of a suitable age are recorded in the next 50 years (Family Online which covers Wilmslow). The location of his death at Hough is uncertain.

On 21 Mar 1769 when Peter was 23, he married **Catherine Holt** in Wilmslow St Bartholomew, Cheshire. Wilmslow Parish Register: Peter Warburton and Catherine Holt by banns. Witnesses: John Holt and Thomas Antrobus. Catherine was born abt 1741. She was buried in Wilmslow St Bartholomew, Cheshire, on 25 Aug 1826.

IGI doesn't show a Catherine Holt born around Wilmslow, so she may have come from further afield. Two Catherines were buried at Wilmslow St Bartholomew. However the Catherine Warburton buried 12 Jan 1834 aged 85 fits with Katherine Hooley baptised 4 July 1749 at Mobberley, wife of William Warburton. Therefore the Catherine Warburton buried 25 Aug 1826 aged 85 may be her.

They had the following children:

- i. **Elizabeth Warburton**. Elizabeth was born in 1772. She was christened in Manchester, Saint Ann, Lancashire, England, on 22 Jul 1772.

It is unusual she was christened in Manchester, but her parent's names are fairly rare and the dates fit. An Elizabeth married William Stubbs at Wilmslow on Oct 20th or 22nd (IGI has entries for both dates).

- ii. **James Warburton**. James was born in 1774. He was christened in Wilmslow St Bartholomew, Cheshire, on 2 Oct 1774.
- iii. **Mary Warburton**. Mary was born on 24 Feb 1777. She was christened in Unitarian Chapel, Dean Row, Cheshire, on 8 Apr 1777.

2 iv. **Alice Warburton** (1779-1829)

- v. **John Warburton**. John was born in Wilmslow, Cheshire, England, in 1784. He was christened in Wilmslow St Bartholomew, Cheshire, on 18 Apr 1784. John died in Sutton, Macclesfield, Cheshire, on 8 Oct 1867. He was buried in Wilmslow St Bartholomew, Cheshire, on 13 Oct 1867.

Death certificate says John Warburton of Macclesfield aged 90, occupation Farm labourer, residing on St. Georges Street, Sutton, at time of death.

Informant John Warburton, of St. Georges Street. Died of Senile decay, asthenia certified. His age would appear to be exaggerated as he was about 83 years old.

- vi. **Thomas Warburton**. Thomas was born in 1788. He was christened in Wilmslow St Bartholomew, Cheshire, on 5 Oct 1788.

Second Generation

2. Alice Warburton (*Peter*¹). Alice was born in Hough, Wilmslow, Cheshire, on 20 Feb 1779. She was christened in Unitarian Chapel, Dean Row, Cheshire, England, on 23 Apr 1780. Alice signed a will on 16 Nov 1828. Her Will states that she died 27 May 1829, leaving an estate of under £200 to her "illegitimate" son John Warburton. Executors of her will were: John Grimshaw, and Joseph Stanfield Grimshaw of Audenshaw, Gentlemen. Audenshaw is near Ashton-under-Lyne, Lancashire, now part of Greater Manchester. Witnesses were Isaac Goodier and Eli ?(can't decipher). Probate was granted on 2 Jul 1829, stating her personal Estate was within the Diocese of Chester. Alice died on 27 May 1829. She was buried in Wilmslow, St. Bartholomew, Cheshire, on 31 May 1829.

The Wilmslow Parish Register of burials states: Alice Warburton of Hough, aged 45 yrs.

- 3 i. **John Charles Warburton** (1808-1878)

Third Generation

3. John Charles Warburton (*Alice², Peter¹*). John Charles was born in Wilmslow, Cheshire, England, on 16 Jun 1808. He was christened in Dean Row Unitarian Chapel, Wilmslow, Cheshire, on 24 Jun 1808. John Charles died in Sutton, Macclesfield, Cheshire, on 9 Jan 1878. ■ Census for Sutton, Macclesfield, Cheshire, in 1841. John (32) is a silk weaver living in St Georges Street with Mary (36) also a silk weaver, Ann (7), Alice (5), Henry (4), Maria (3), and Elizabeth (1). Also present are John Warburton (55), probably an Uncle, and Mary Albison (68), probably mother-in-law. ■ Census for Sutton, Macclesfield, Cheshire, in 1851. John (43) a silk weaver is living at 28 St Georges Street, with Mary (38), Ann (17), Alice (16), and Henry (16), all silk weavers, plus Maria (14), Elizabeth (11), Emma (9) and Harriet (7), all silk winders, and John (5), Maria (3), Emma (Hannah?) (1), and Thomas (? months). Also present is uncle John Warburton (75). ■ Census for Sutton, Macclesfield, Cheshire, in 1861. John (52) a silk weaver is living at 15 St. Georges Street, with Mary (48) housekeeper, Henry (24), and Maria (22), silk weavers, Elizabeth (21), Emma (19) and Harriet (17), silk winders, John (15) shoemaker, Mary (13), Hannah (11), and Thomas (10) silk winders, James (7) scholar, and uncle John Warburton (83) charman. ■ Census for Sutton, Macclesfield, Cheshire, in 1871. John (62) a widower and silk weaver is living at 15 St. Georges Street, with Maria (32), and John (25) also a widower, silk weavers, Mary (23), and Hannah Jane (11) silk workers, and James (17) silk weaver.

1878 Death Register for John Warburton: Died 9 January 1878, aged 69, silk weaver residing at 1 St Georges Place, of chronic bronchitis lasting 3 years. Informant Ann Brownridge daughter of 1 St Georges Place, Sutton.

On 22 Jul 1832 when John Charles was 24, he married **Mary Albinson**, daughter of **Joseph Albinson** & **Mary Bore**, in Manchester Cathedral. Manchester Cathedral Marriage Entry: 22 July 1832 John Warburton, Bachelor, Silk Weaver, and Mary Albinson, Spinster, both of this parish, by Banns, both signed with an X. Witnesses: Thomas Parry and Joseph Adshead. Mary was born in Wilmslow, Cheshire, England, abt 1812. Mary died in 1863.

They had the following children:

- i. **Anne Warburton**. Anne was born in Macclesfield, Cheshire, in 1834.

Daughter Anne Brownridge is listed as informant for death of father John Warburton.

On 16 May 1852 when Anne was 18, she married **William Brownridge**, son of **Robert Brownridge** & **Maria Worrall**, in Prestbury, St. Peter, Cheshire.

Marriage Registration: William Brownridge 21, bachelor, mechanic of Sutton. Father: Robert Brownridge mechanic. Ann Warburton 18, spinster of Sutton, father: John Warburton, weaver. Witnesses: John Warburton and Alice Warburton. William was born in Macclesfield, Cheshire, abt 1831. ■ Census for Sutton, Macclesfield, Cheshire, in 1881. William (49) is an engine fitter living at 1 St. Georges Place with Ann (47), Mary M (23) called Brownridge but described as married, and Alica A (18) silk weavers, Albert E (16), and Emma (14) silk piecers, Hannah J (12), Elizabeth (10), George (6), Chalotte (6), and John J Holden (9 months) grandson. John is presumably Mary's son. Alice and Albert were born in Lambeth, Surry. Emma, Hannah and Elizabeth were born in Yeovil, Somerset. George, Charlotte, and John were born in Macclesfield. ■ Census in 1891. William (59) is an engine fitter living at 1 St. Georges Place with Ann (56), plus Mary Holden (34) daughter, Emma (24), and Hannah (22) silk weavers, Albert E (26) locomotive stoker, Chalotte (17) cloth picker cotton, and John Thomas Holden (10) grandson.

- ii. **Alice Warburton**. Alice was born in Macclesfield, Cheshire, in 1835.

Alice was a witness at her sister Ann's wedding in 1852, but Alice was not found with her parents in the 1861 Census. However Alice Davenport (25) born in Sutton, a silk weaver is living with her husband Charles (27) a brewery carter in Barton Street Macclesfield.

In 1859 when Alice was 24, she married **Charles Davenport** in Prestbury, St. Peter, Cheshire. Charles was born in Longmoss, Cheshire, abt 1833.

Location of Longmoss is uncertain. Other censuses may be more specific.

- 4 iii. **Henry Warburton** (1836-1895)
- iv. **Maria Warburton**. Maria was born in Macclesfield, Cheshire, on 6 Sep 1838. Maria died aft 1891.

There is a discrepancy in Maria's age. When living with her father she was born in 1834. When living with husband she was born in 1839.

On 18 Aug 1877 when Maria was 38, she married **James Parkinson**, son of **Edward Parkinson**, in St. James Church, Macclesfield, Cheshire, England. Marriage Record: James Parkinson, full age, bachelor, joiner, resident in St Paul (Parish) Paddington-in-Pendleton, Salford, Lancashire, father Edward Parkinson, dyer. Maria Warburton, full age, spinster, resident in St James (Parish), Sutton, father John Warburton, silk weaver. Witnesses: Thomas White (bride's brother-in-law), and Hannah Jane Warburton (bride's sister). Maria and James's children were Arthur (b. 1861), Herbert (b. 1864), Alfred (b. 1869), Ruth (b. 1872), and Frank (b. 1879). James was born in Pendleton, Lancashire, in 1832. James died aft 1891. ■ Census for Pendleton in Salford, Lancashire, in 1881. James Parkinson (49) is a carpenter/joiner living at 14 Pimbletts Place with Maria (42) of Macclesfield, Arthur (20) plumber/glazer, Herbert (17) printer compositor, Alfred (12), Ruth (9), and Frank (2). ■ Census for Pendleton in Salford, Lancashire, in 1891. James Parkinson (59) is a carpenter/joiner living at 14 Pimbletts Place with Maria (52) of Macclesfield, and Frank (12).

- v. **Elizabeth Warburton**. Elizabeth was born in Sutton, Macclesfield, Cheshire, on 9 Apr 1840.

Birth Certificate: Elizabeth Warburton, born Sutton, parents John Warburton, weaver, St. Georges Street, Sutton, and Mary Warburton formerly Albinson.

On 25 Sep 1862 when Elizabeth was 22, she married **George Bradburne**, son of **James Bradburne** & **Maria**, in Prestbury, St. Peter, Cheshire. Prestbury, St. Peters, parish register: George Bradburne (25), bachelor, schoolmaster of Sutton, father James Bradburne, dyer. Elizabeth Warburton (22), spinster of Sutton, father James Warburton, weaver. Witnesses: John Warburton, and Maria Warburton. George and Elizabeth's children were Elizabeth Ann (b. 1867), Alice Emma (b. 1870), George H (b. 1876), and Ethel J (b. 1879). George was born in 1837. ■ Census for South Kyme, Lincoln, in 1881. George Bradburn (44) of Macclesfield is a schoolmaster living with Elizabeth (41) schoolmistress of Macclesfield, Elizabeth A (14), and Alice E (11), born Croxton Herrial, Leicester, George H (5) born Hough (on Hill), Lincoln, and Ethel J (2) born S. Kyme, Lincoln.

- vi. **Emma Warburton**. Emma was born in Sutton, Macclesfield, Cheshire, in 1842.

On 11 Jun 1865 when Emma was 23, she married **Charles Oldham** in Prestbury, St. Peter, Cheshire. Marriage record at Prestbury St Peters: Charles Oldham (23) bachelor, warehouseman of Macclesfield, father William Oldham, silk steward. Emma Warburton (23), spinster of Sutton, father John Warburton, weaver. Witnesses: John Warburton and Sarah Ann Oldham. Charles was born in Macclesfield, Cheshire, in 1842. ■ Census for Pendleton in Salford, Lancashire, in 1881. Charles Oldham (31), born Macclesfield, is a warehouseman living at 14 Albion Place, with Emma (39) also born in Macclesfield, and two boarders, Martha Hall and Mary Hall .

- vii. **Harriet Warburton**. Harriet was born in Sutton, Macclesfield, Cheshire, in 1844.

On 14 Sep 1862 when Harriet was 18, she married **Thomas White**, son of **Edward White**, in Prestbury, St. Peter, Cheshire. Marriage Record at Prestbury St Peter: Thomas White 22, bachelor, Staffman residing in Macclesfield, father Edward White, maker-up. Harriet Warburton 18, spinster residing in Sutton, father John Warburton weaver. By Banns by Stephen Lea Wilson. Witnesses: John Warburton and Emma Warburton. Harriet and Thomas's children were May (b. 1870), and Frank (b. 1872). Thomas was born in Macclesfield, Cheshire, in 1840. ■ Census for Sutton, Macclesfield, Cheshire, in 1881. Thomas (41) born Macclesfield, is a silk maker up living at 80 Peel Street with Harriet (37) silk weaver, May (11), and Frank (9).

Listed as a witness at the wedding of his brother-in-law James Warburton to Emma Clayton.

- 5 viii. **John Warburton** (1846-)

- ix. **Mary Warburton**. Mary was born in Sutton, Macclesfield, Cheshire, in 1849.

Still living with father in 1871, but not living with brother in 1881 at same address. Probably married between 1871-1881, Cheshire BMD shows 3 Marys marrying at Sutton or Macclesfield in that time.

- x. **Hannah Jane Warburton**. Hannah Jane was born in Sutton, Macclesfield, Cheshire, in 1851.

1880 Census of Paterson New Jersey: Hannah Jane Warburton is enumerated with her brother Henry Warburton and family. It is not known if she was just visiting, got married, etc.

4. Henry Warburton (*John Charles³, Alice², Peter¹*). Henry was born in Macclesfield, Cheshire, in 1836. ■ Census for Paterson, Passaic County, New Jersey, in 1870. Henry Warburton (33), a tape weaver is living with Ann (25) who keeps home, Thomas G (6), and John W (4). Also present is William Goodwin (59). All were born in England except John W who was born in New Jersey. ■ Census for Paterson, Passaic County, New Jersey, in 1880. Henry (43) works in a silk mill, and lives at 12 Seeley Street with Ann (45) who keeps house, Thomas (17), and John W (14) also at silk mill, and Charles (10) at school. Also present are Hannah J Warburton (29) sister, and William Goodwin (70) father-in-law. Henry signed a will in Jul 1894. Henry gave everything to his wife Ann. After her death everything would go to his three sons Thomas Warburton, John William Warburton, and Charles Henry Warburton. Witnesses: Sidney Farrar of 26 West Street, Paterson, and Maria Barlow of 14 Seeley Street, Paterson. Henry died in Paterson, Passaic County, New Jersey, on 4 Feb 1895. He was buried in Cedar Lawn Cemetery, Paterson, New Jersey, on 6 Feb 1895.

In Paterson, New Jersey Henry and family lived at 12 Seeley Street. Brother James lived at 14 Seeley. Henry was still at 12 Seeley in 1885 when Thomas Goodwin Warburton married, but he was at 14 Seeley at the time of his death. He died of Asthmatic Chronic bronchitis.

On 16 Nov 1862 when Henry was 26, he married **Anna Whittaker Goodwin**, daughter of **William Goodwin**, in Prestbury, St. Peter, Cheshire. Marriage Record: Henry Warburton 26, bachelor, weaver, residing at Sutton, father John Warburton, weaver. Ann Whittaker Goodwin 28, spinster, residing in Sutton, father William Goodwin, silk manager. By Banns by Stephen Lea Wilson. Witnesses: Henry Pickston and Mary Rockcliffe. Anna Whittaker was born in Cheshire in Sep 1833. Anna Whittaker died in Paterson, Passaic County, New Jersey, on 12 Jun 1915. She was buried in Cedar Lawn Cemetery, Paterson, New Jersey, on 14 Jun 1915. ■ Census for Paterson, Passaic County, New Jersey, in 1900. Ann (66) is a widow born in England in April 1833, living at 12 Seeley Street with her son Charles (27) a silk weaver born in New Jersey in November 1878. Ann is described as the landlord. At the same address is Samuel Hough of England. Apparently Samuel was widowed while living there in 1891. Another researcher (of the Hough line) says that he saw the house and that one family lived downstairs (Samuel Hough) while the Warburtons lived upstairs.

They had the following children:

- iii. **Charles Henry Warburton**. Charles Henry was born in New Jersey, in Nov 1869. Charles Henry died in Paterson, Passaic County, New Jersey, on 9 Jan 1939. He was buried in Cedar Lawn Cemetery, Paterson, New Jersey, on 12 Jan 1939.

The 1880 census states that Charles was born in New Jersey, and was aged 10. There is no birth registered in England.

At the time of his death Charles was living at No.1 Spruce Street, Paterson. He died of endocarditis. He was single, and aged about 68.

- iv. **Frederick Warburton**. Frederick was born in Paterson, Passaic County, New Jersey, in 1872. Frederick died in Paterson, Passaic County, New Jersey, on 2 Dec 1874.

Frederick Warburton died in 1874. Buried with Ralph Hunt, and Thomas Berry. Owner of the Lot was Jane Hunt who married Joseph Bentley. Later, after his death, others were buried there. In September 1883 he was moved to newly purchased Cemetery lot owned by Henry and Ann Warburton.

According to New Jersey State Archives, there is no record of Frederick's birth.

5. John Warburton (*John Charles³, Alice², Peter¹*). John was born in Sutton, Macclesfield, Cheshire, on 5 Feb 1846. ■ Census for Sutton, Macclesfield, Cheshire, in 1871. John a widower, is living with father at 15 St. Georges Street.

Birth Registration: Boy John Warburton, father John Warburton, weaver of St. George's Street, Sutton, mother Mary Warburton formerly Albinson. Registered 25th Feb 1846.

I cannot find the death of John but it is possible that he moved to the USA, maybe Massachusetts.

On 5 Jan 1868 when John was 21, he married **Mary Ann Holt**, daughter of **John Holt** & **Rachel Walmsley**, in Prestbury, St. Peter, Cheshire. Marriage register: John Warburton 21, bachelor, weaver of Sutton, father John Warburton, weaver. Mary Ann Holt 20, spinster of Sutton, father John Holt. Witnesses: Thomas Holt and Maria Warburton. John is back living with his father in 1871 as a widower. Mary Ann was born in Sutton, Macclesfield, Cheshire, in

1845. Mary Ann died bef 1871.

They had one child:

- 10 i. **Harry Warburton** (1868-1933)

6. Thomas Warburton (*John Charles³, Alice², Peter¹*). Thomas was born in Sutton, Macclesfield, Cheshire, in 1851. ■ Census for Gorton, Lancashire, in 1881. Thomas (30) born Macclesfield is a general labourer living at 17 Dalton St. with Sarah (28) born in Shropshire, and Herbert (1) born in Manchester. ■ Census for Wolstenholme, Heywood, Lancashire, in 1891. Thomas (37) carter, born in Macclesfield is living at Mill Street, Red Lumb, with Sarah (38) of Westbury, Staffordshire, Herbert (10), Helena (7), Martha Ann (6), and Olive (1 month). ■ Census for Spotlands, Rochdale, Lancashire, in 1901. Thomas (50) is a general labourer living at 470 Edenfield Rd with Sarah (49) of Worthen, Shropshire, Herbert (20) a grocer's manager, Helena (17), and Martha A (16) cotton weavers, Olive (10), and Thomas E (3).

Thomas married **Sarah**. Sarah was born in Worthen, Nr. Westbury, Shropshire, abt 1852.

Several Sarahs married a Thomas Warburton between 1871 and 1881, including a Sarah Steer in Whitchurch, Shropshire in 4q1873, though this is not near where Sarah was born.

They had the following children:

- i. **Herbert Warburton**. Herbert was born in Manchester, Lancashire, in 1881. Herbert died on 15 Mar 1969.

The following comment came from another researcher "He was my grandfather. I have little knowledge of his background. His wife was Edith Holden. He died 15 Mar 1969, aged 88."

Herbert married **Edith Holden**.

- ii. **Helena Warburton**. Helena was born in Rochdale, Lancashire, abt 1883.
 iii. **Martha Ann Warburton**. Martha Ann was born in Rochdale, Lancashire, abt 1884.
 iv. **Olive Warburton**. Olive was born in Rochdale, Lancashire, in 1891.
 v. **Thomas E Warburton**. Thomas E was born in Rochdale, Lancashire, abt 1897.

7. James John Warburton (*John Charles³, Alice², Peter¹*). James John was born in Sutton, Macclesfield, Cheshire, on 21 May 1853. James John died in Paterson, Passaic County, New Jersey, on 31 Dec 1920. He was buried in Cedar Lawn Cemetery, Paterson, New

Jersey, on 3 Jan 1921. ■ Census for Sutton, Macclesfield, Cheshire, in 1881. James (27) a silk weaver is living at 15 St. Georges Street with Emma (27) also a silk weaver, John (5), Charles (4), and Ann (2). ■ Census for Paterson, Passaic County, New Jersey, in 1900. James (46) born May 1853 in England, parents English, immigrant in 1886, silk weaver was living at 14 Seeley Street with wife Emma (46) born April 1854 in England, parents English, immigrant in 1886. She had 6 kids, 5 living. The five were present also: John born July 1875, and Charles born Feb 1877 silk warpers, Ann born Mar 1879 a silk weaver, James Jr. born Aug 1883 a shipping clerk, and William H born Mar 1888 at school. All the children were born in England and were immigrants in 1886 except William who was born in NJ. ■ Census for Paterson, Passaic County, New Jersey, in 1920. James (65) is living at 187 Hamilton Street with Emma (64) and Anna (40) a silk weaver. All were immigrants in 1884, naturalised in 1892.

At time of his death in 1920, James was residing at 187 Hamilton Ave, Paterson NJ. Wife Emma was living at 186 Hamilton in 1926, when she died.

On 21 May 1874 when James John was 21, he married **Emma Clayton**, daughter of **Charles Clayton** & **Ann Brinley\Brindley**, in Prestbury, St. Peter, Cheshire. Emma was born in England on 3 Apr 1854. Emma died in Paterson, Passaic County, New Jersey, on 24 Jul 1926. She was buried in Cedar Lawn Cemetery, Paterson, New Jersey, on 26 Jul 1926.
